FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof;

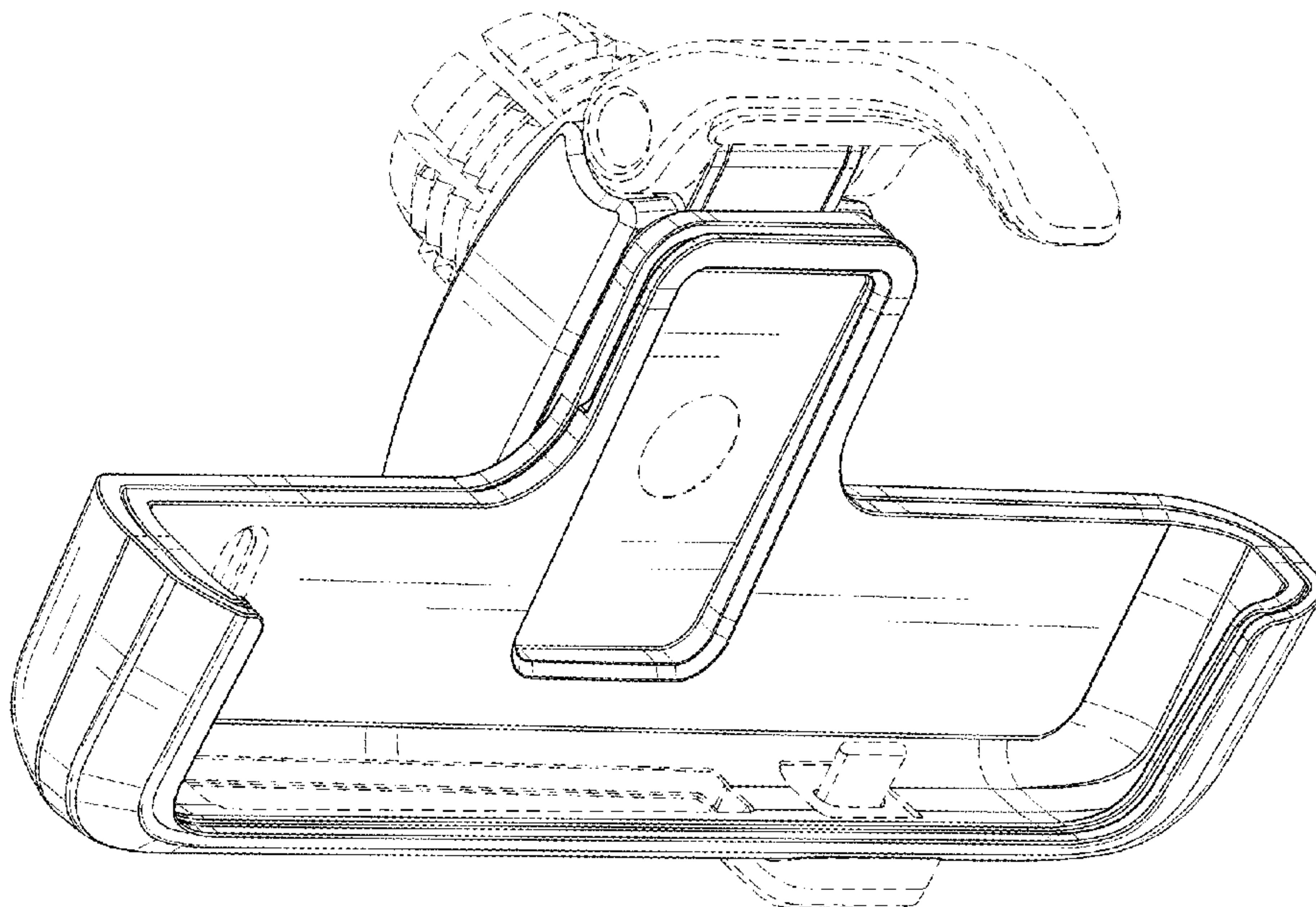
FIG. 6 is a top view thereof;

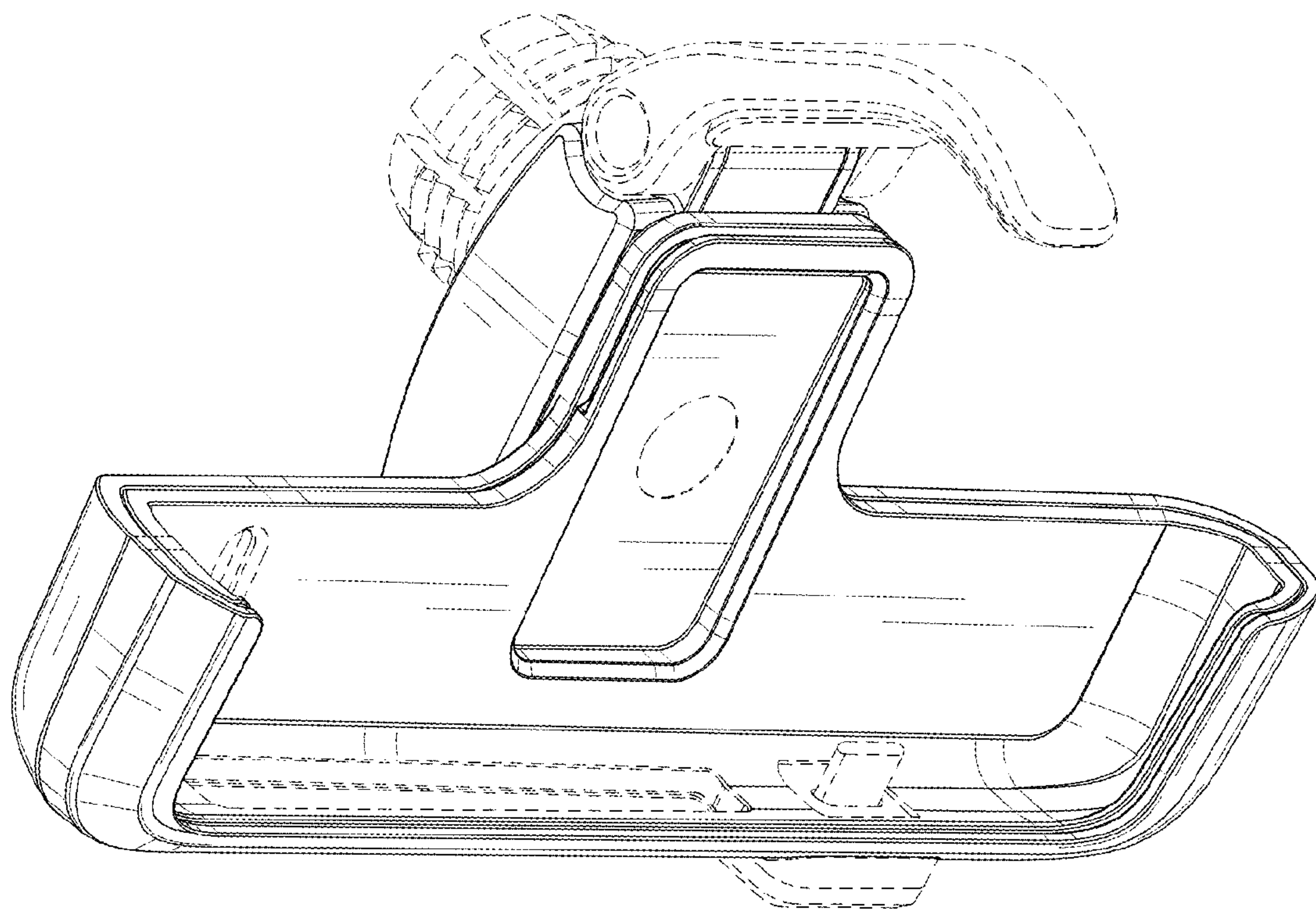

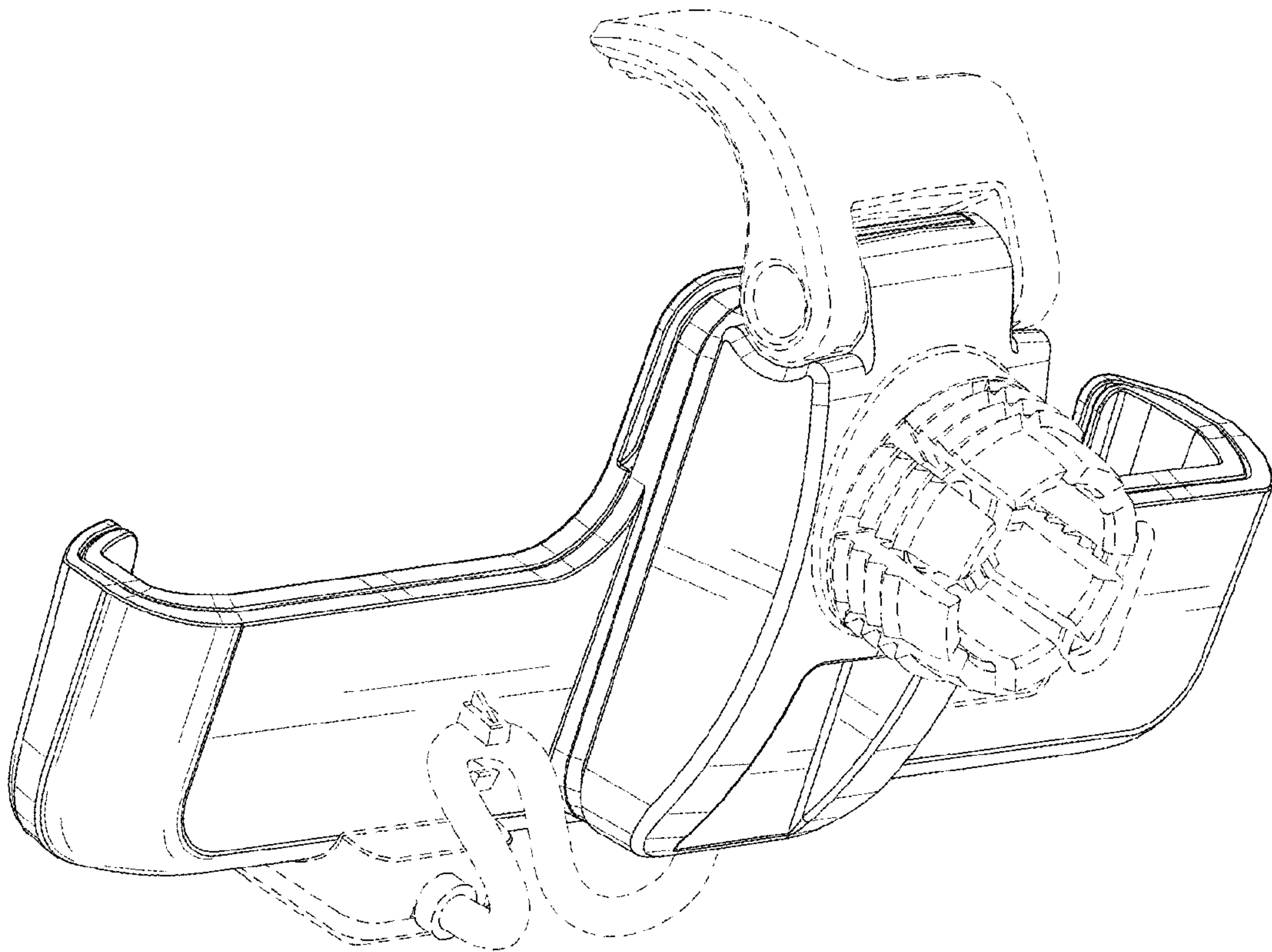

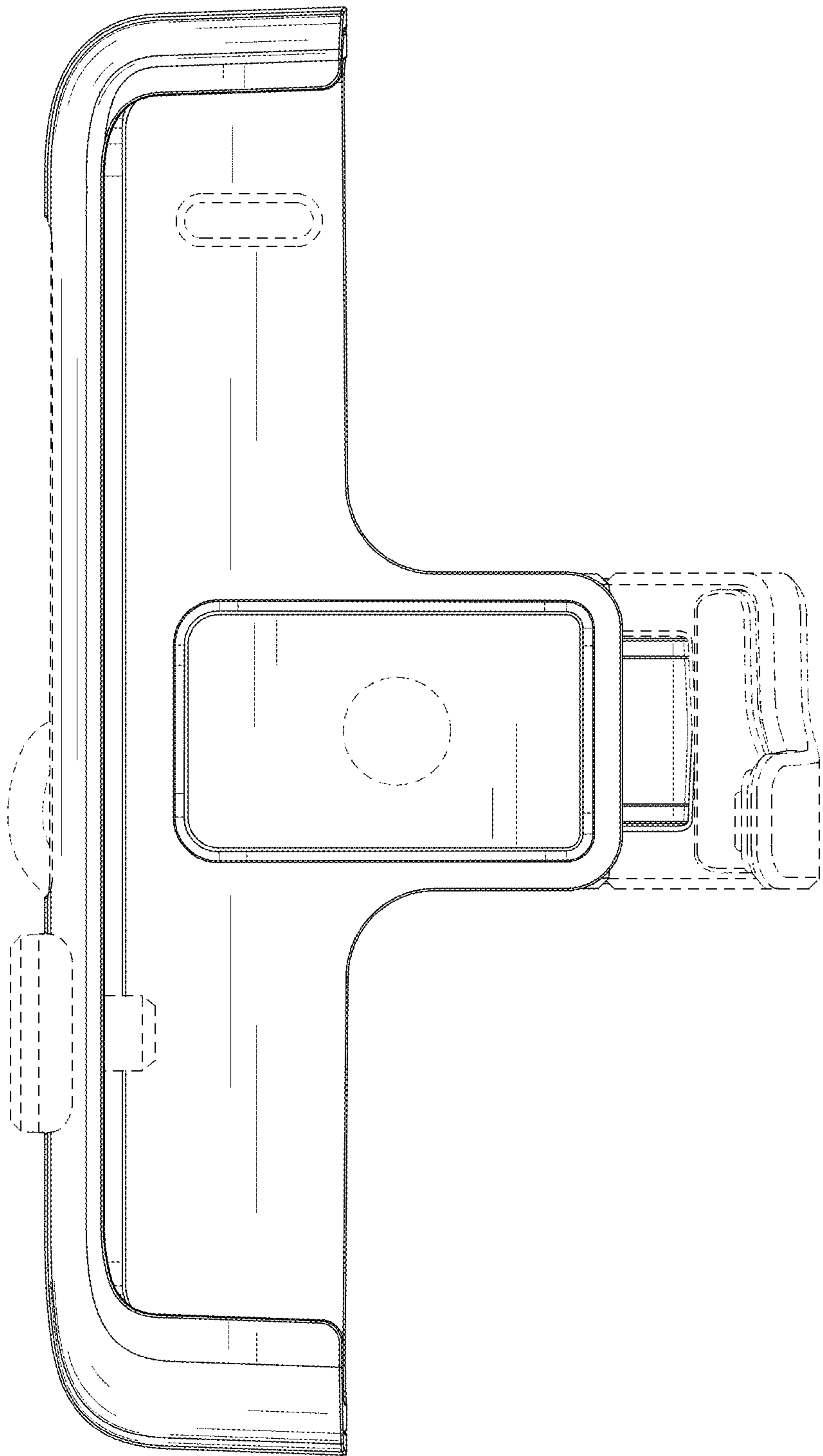

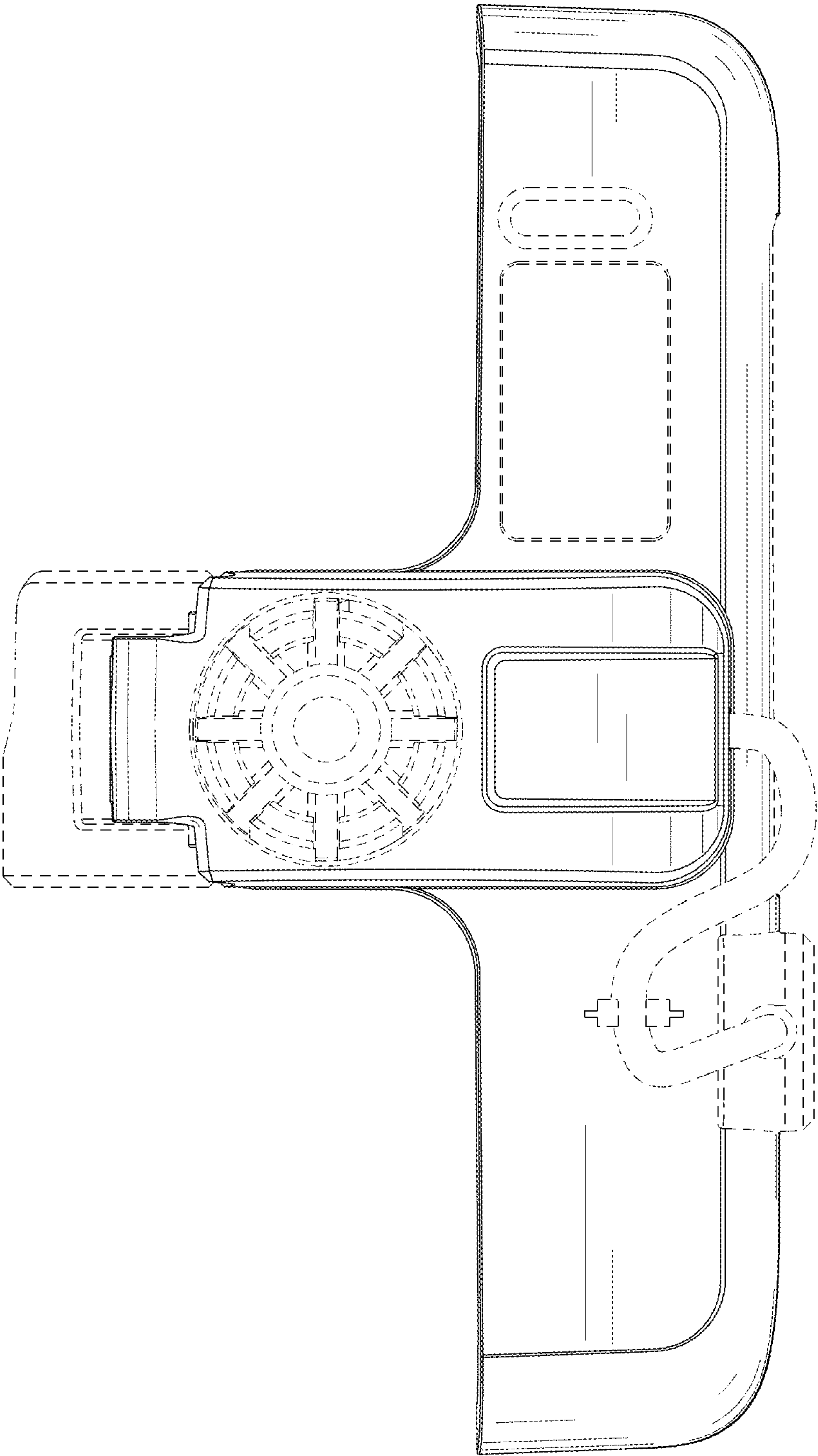

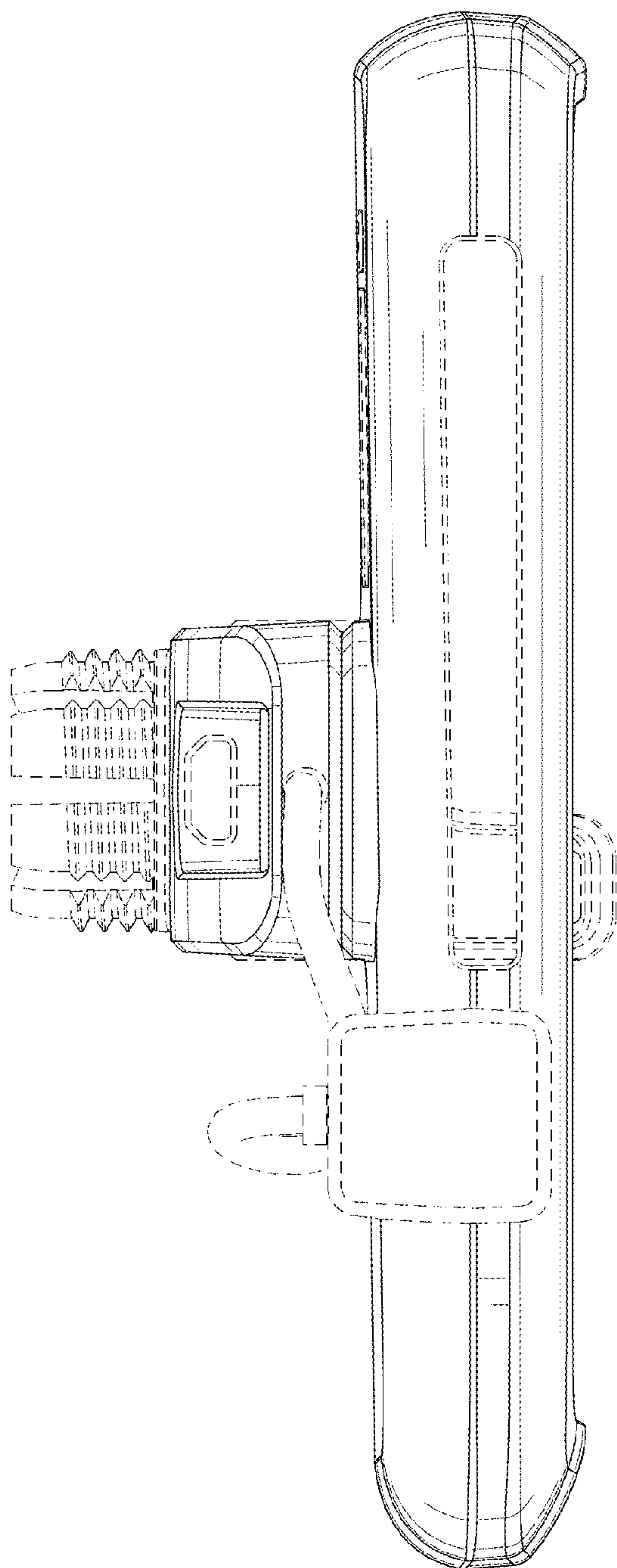

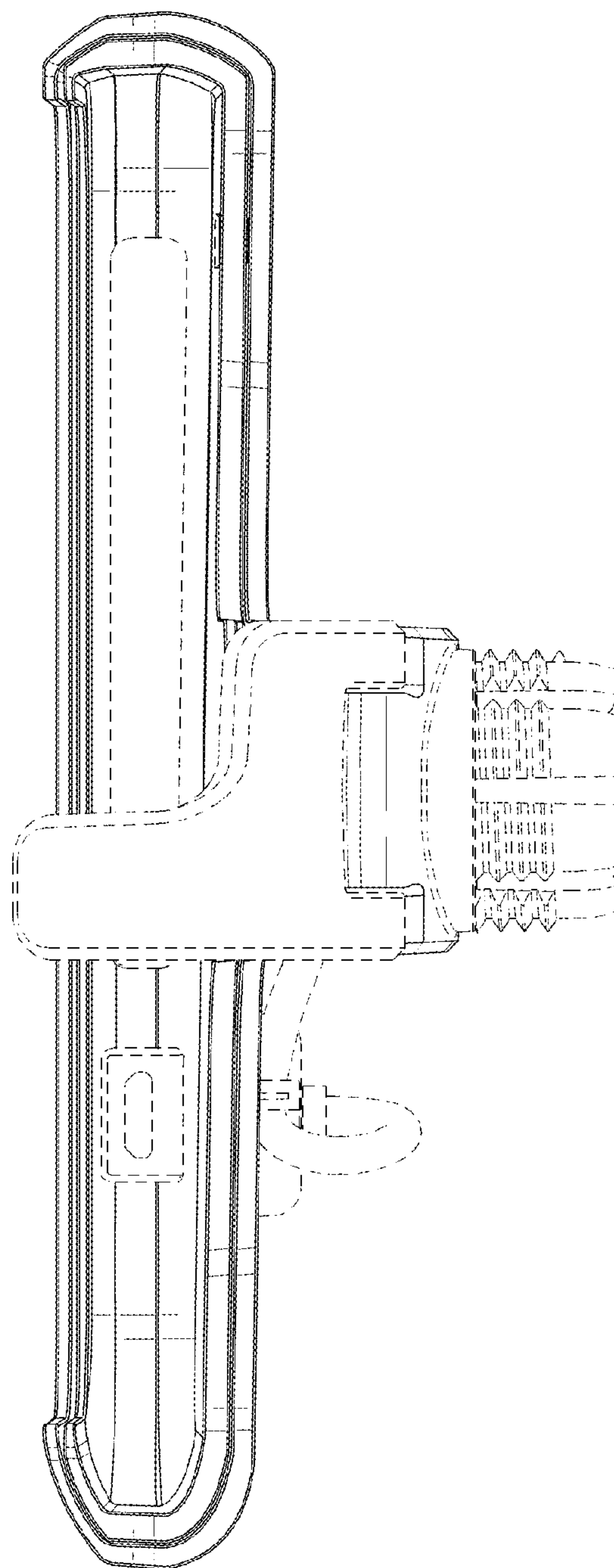

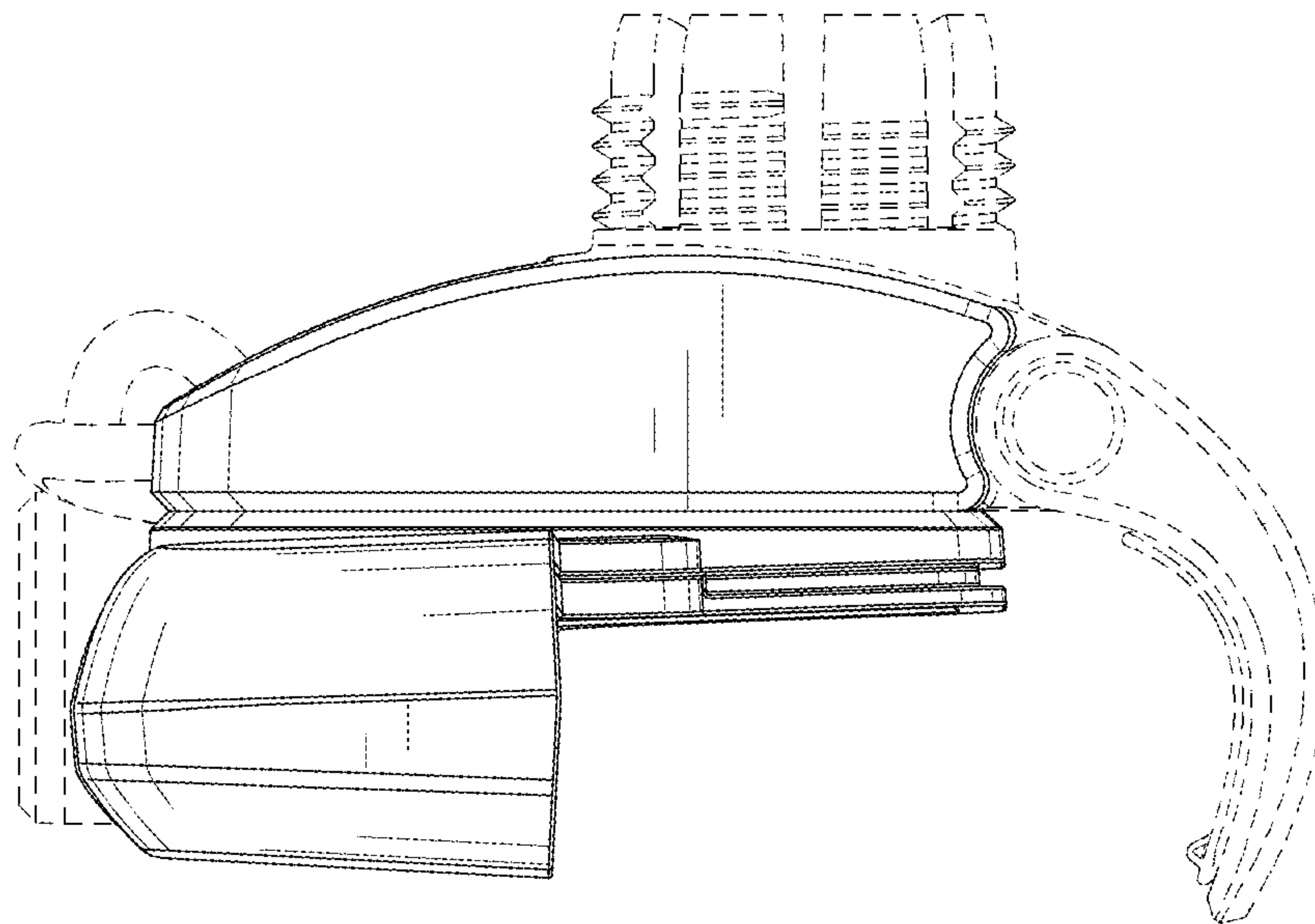

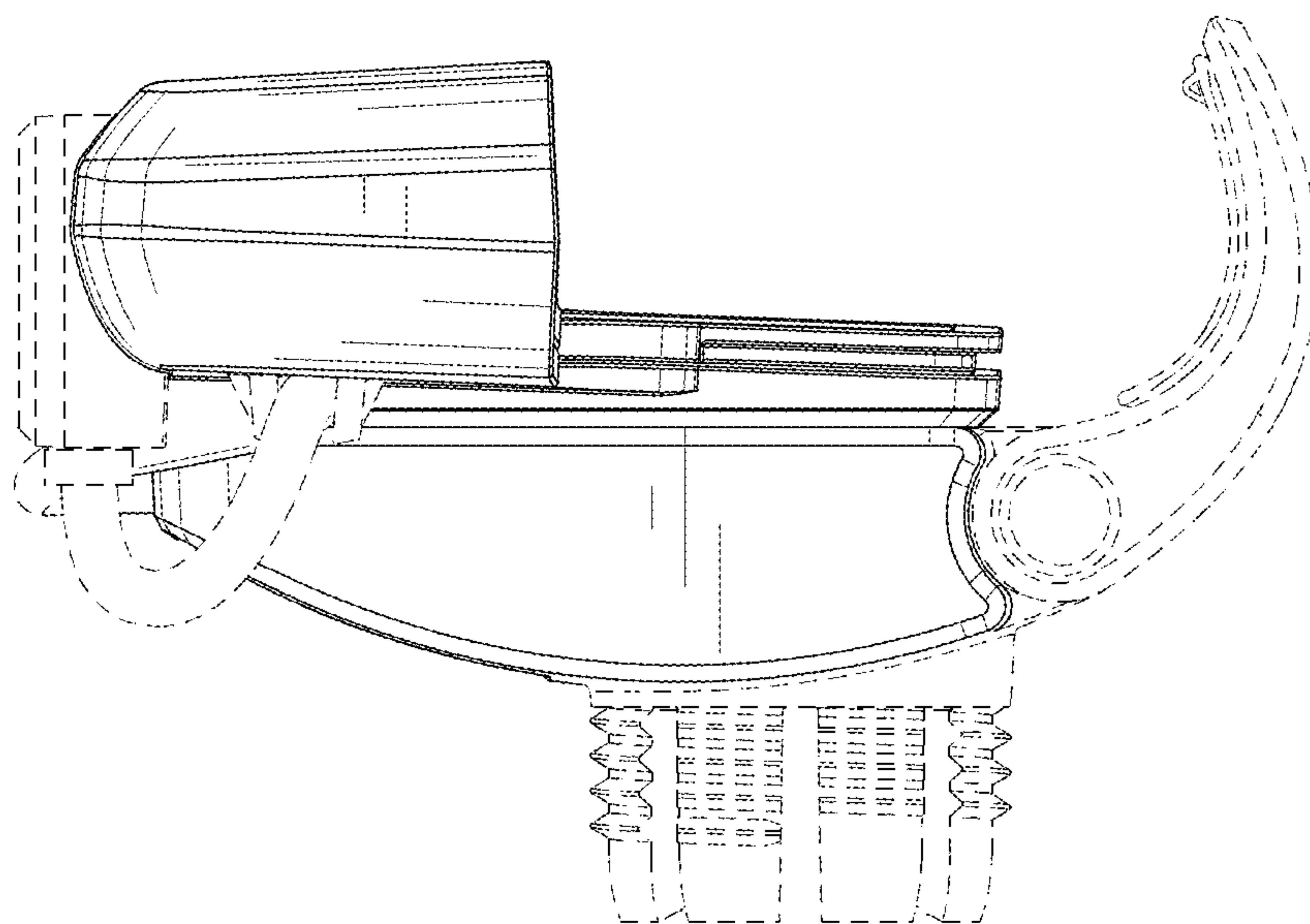
