DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a an upper perspective view of my domed practice golf platform, with rectangular perimeter shape shading and oval shaped dome;

FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 1; FIG. 4 is a front plan view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 1; the back plan view is the same; and,

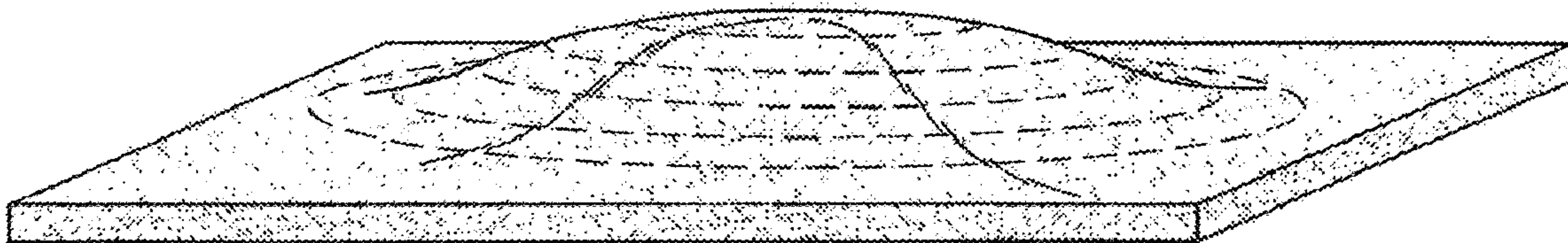

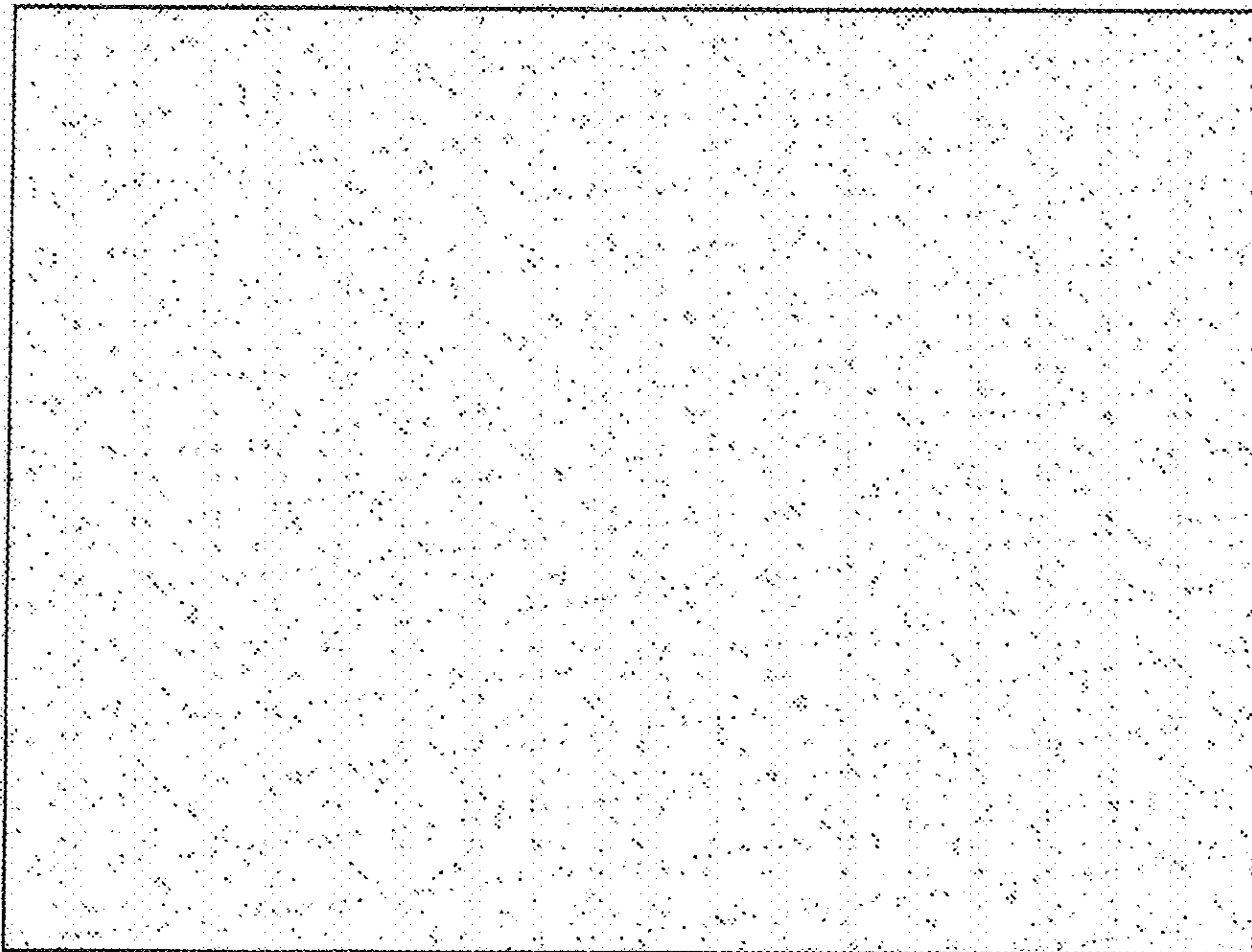

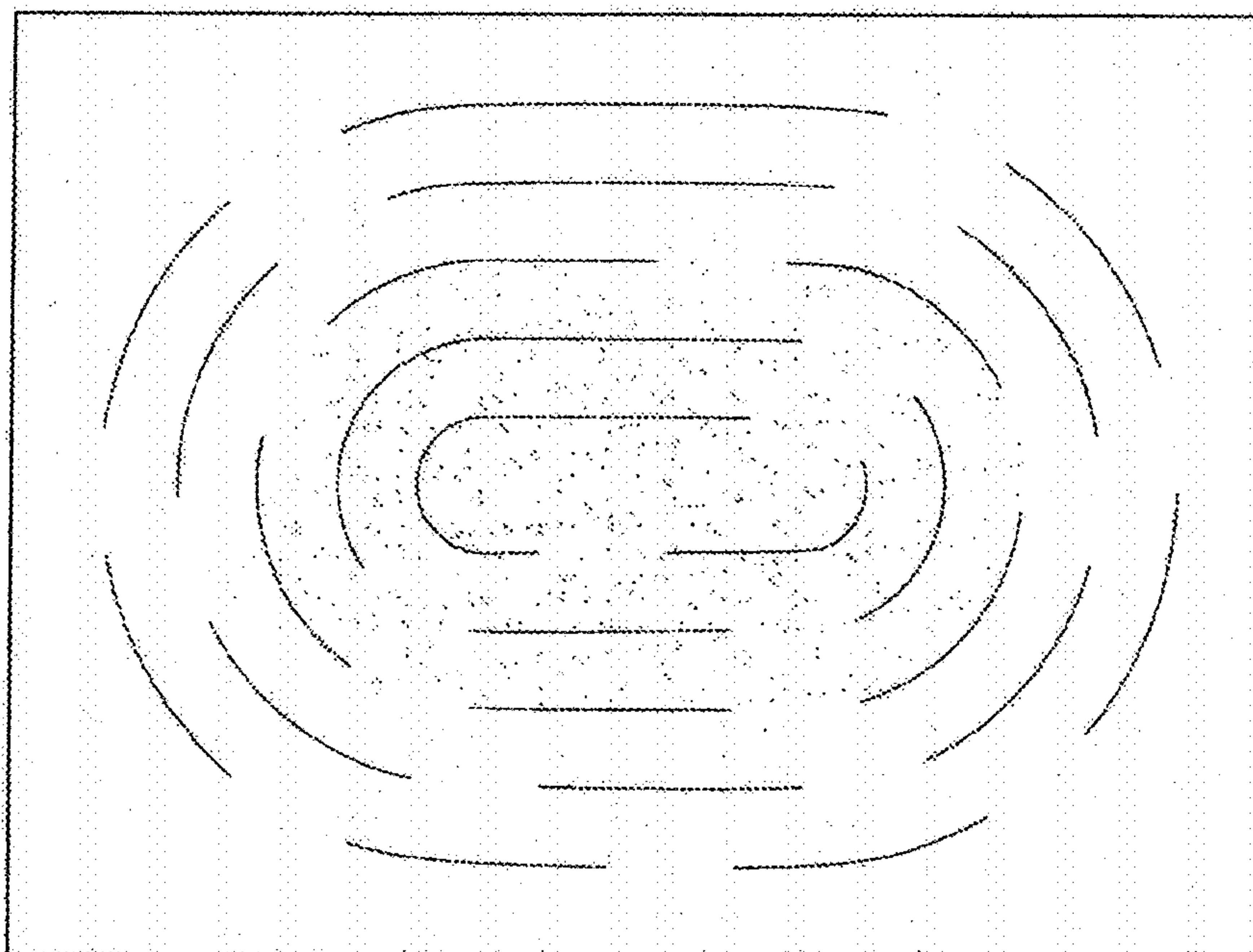

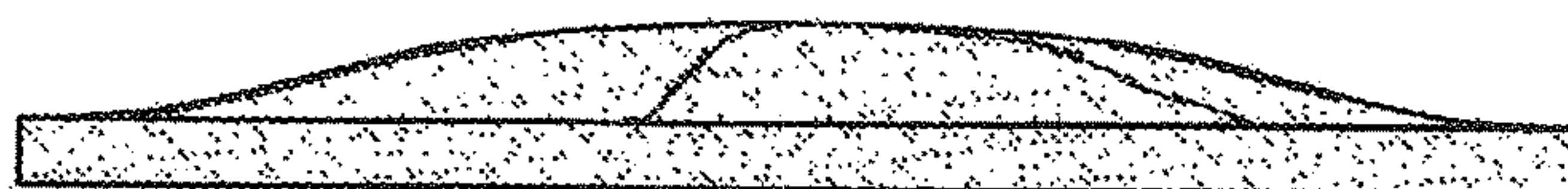
