**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the shoe, showing my new design;

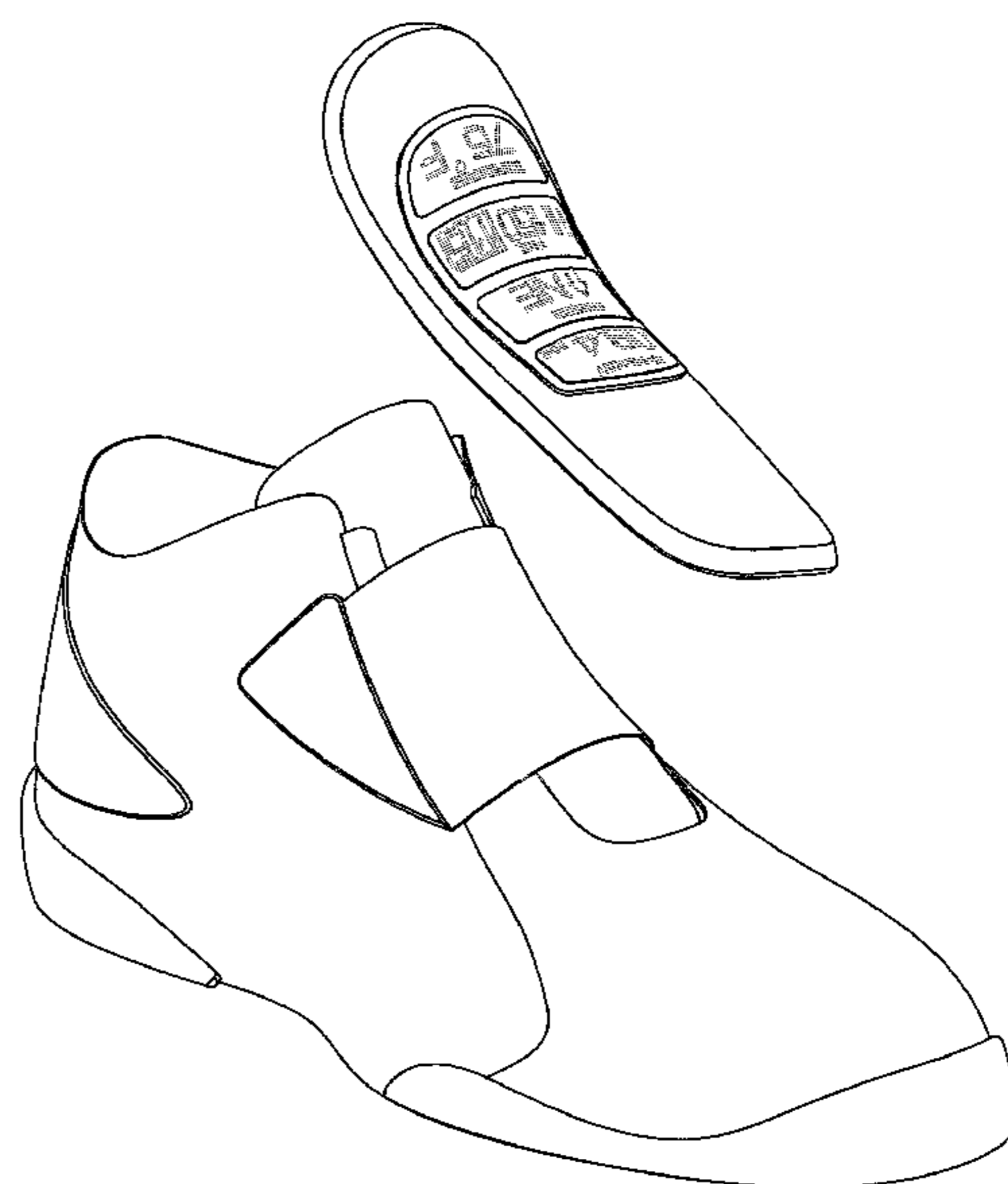
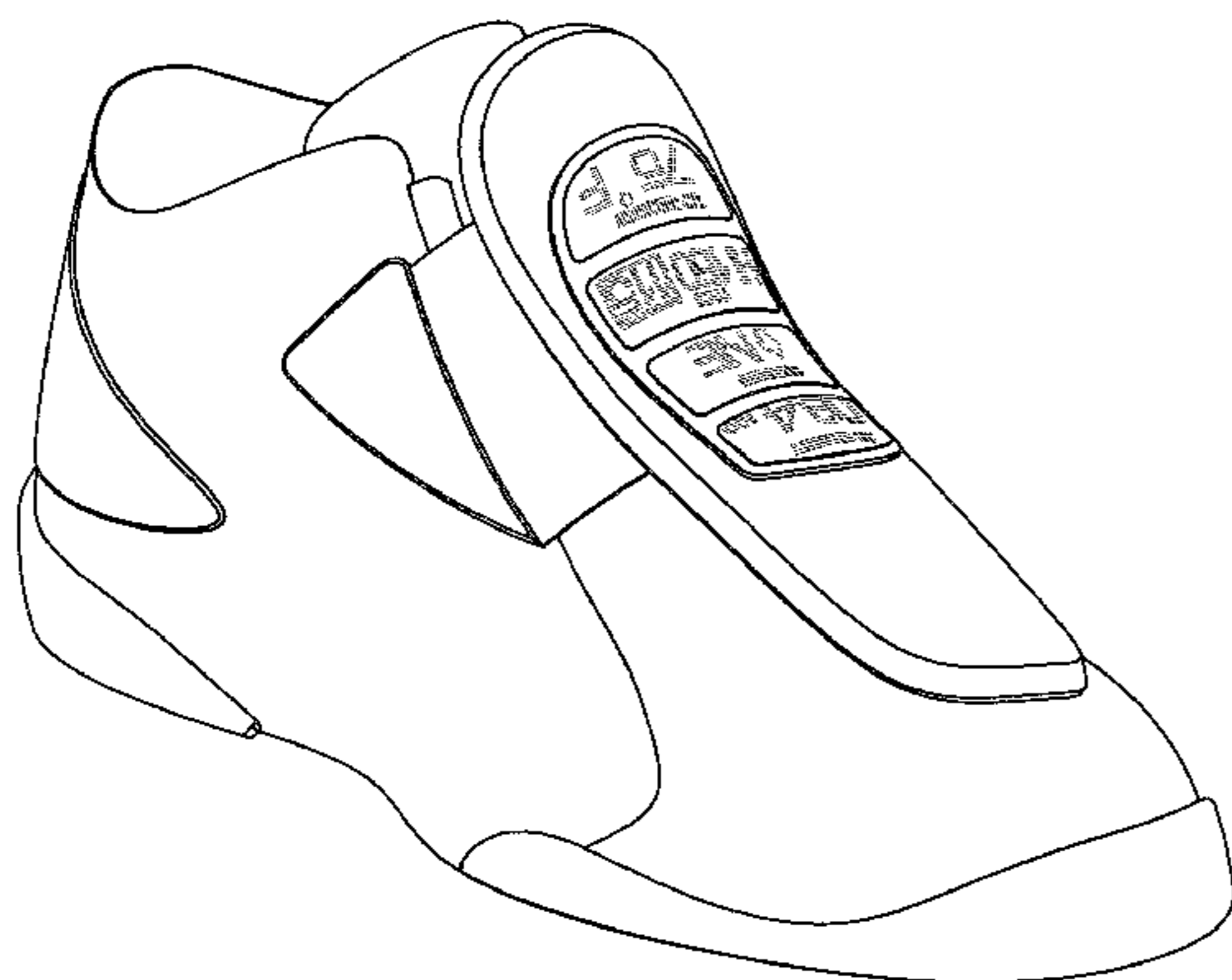

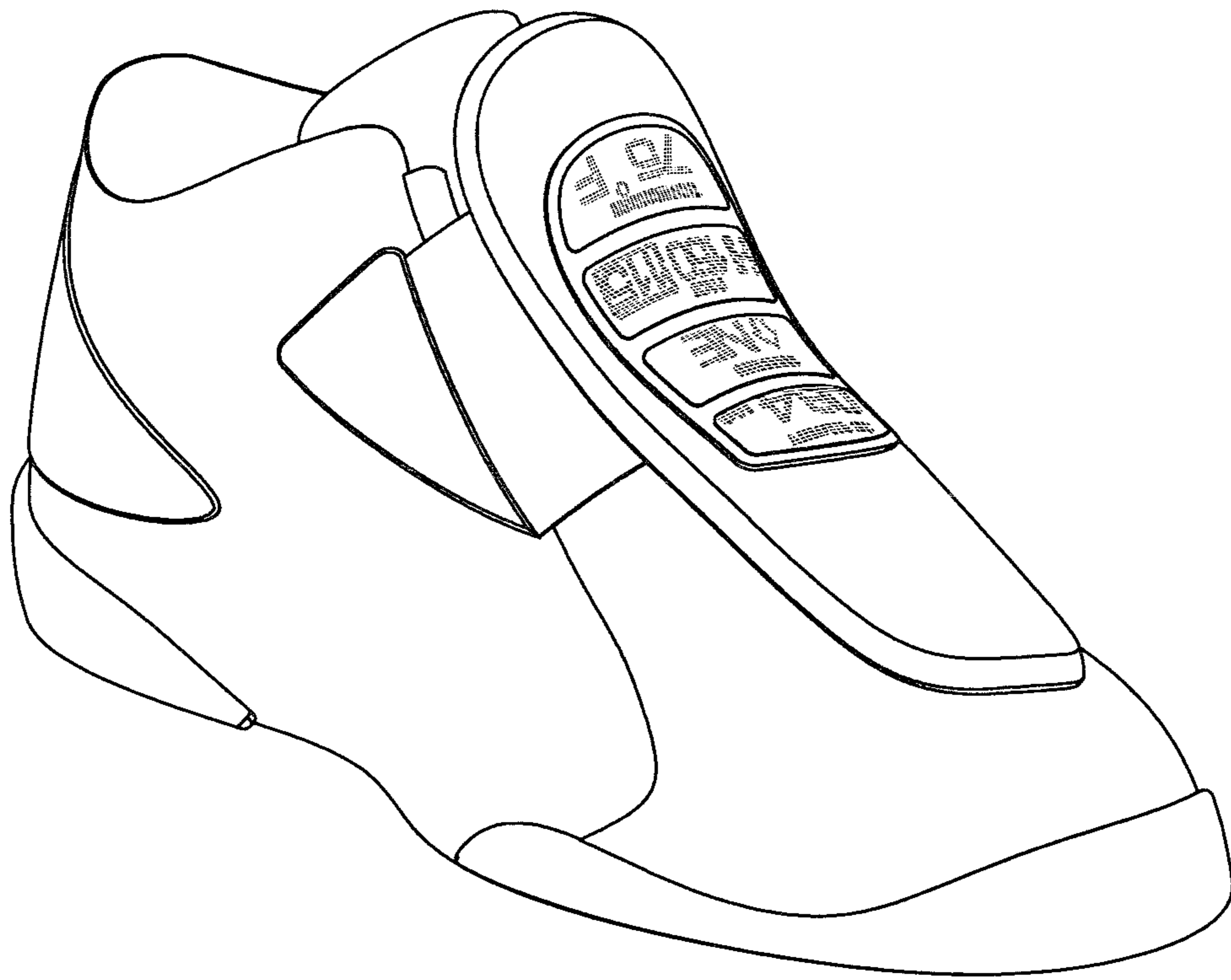

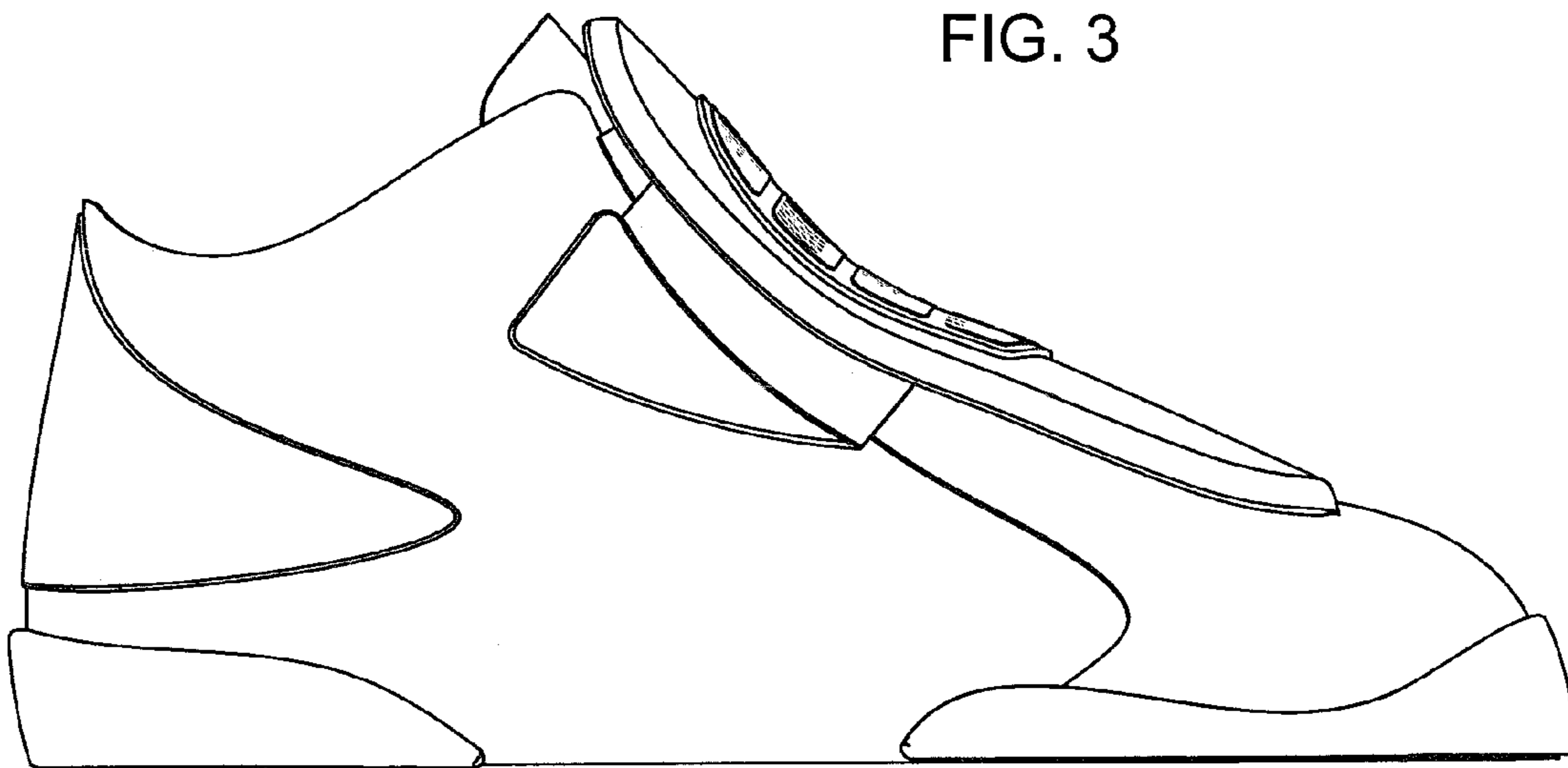

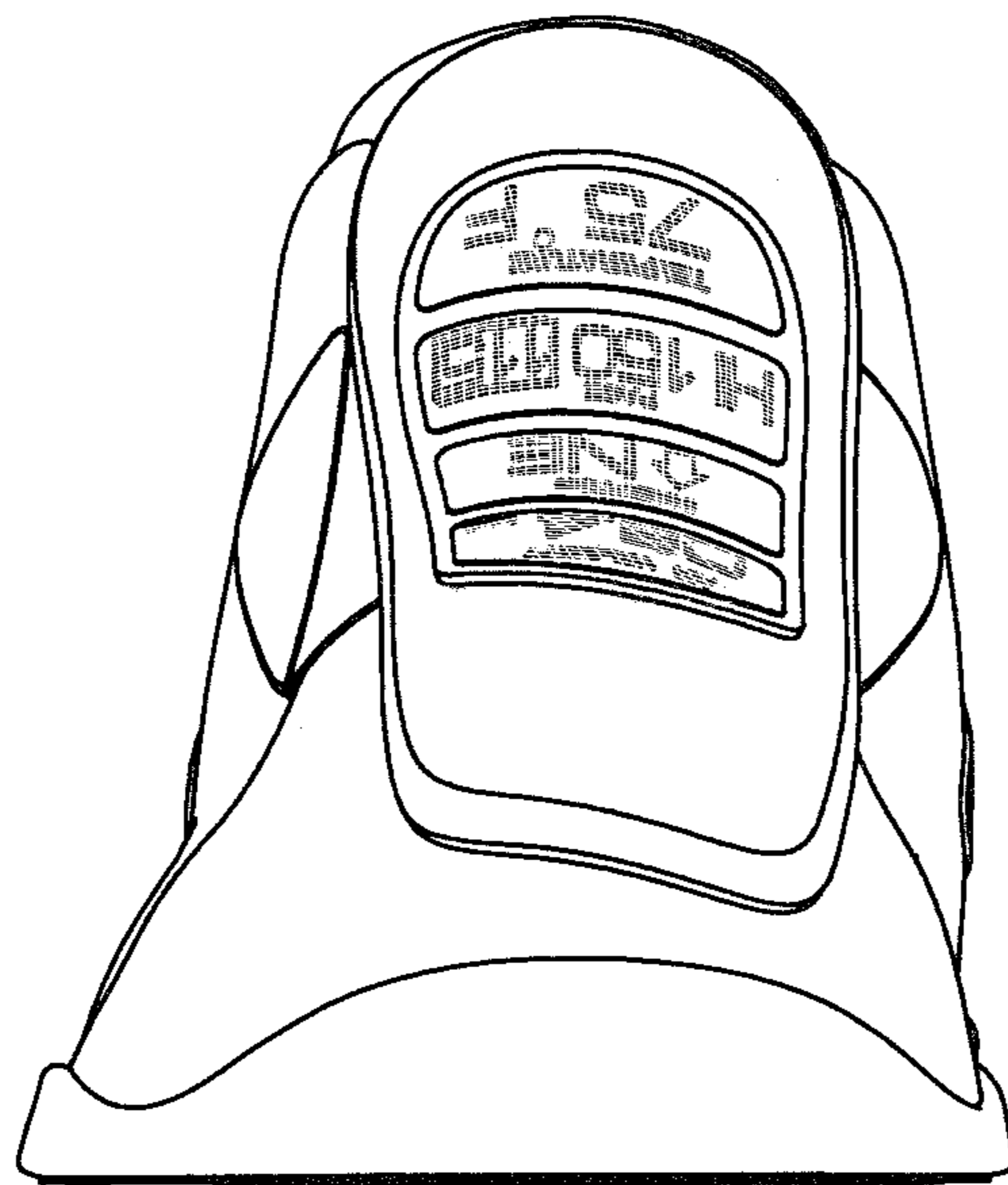

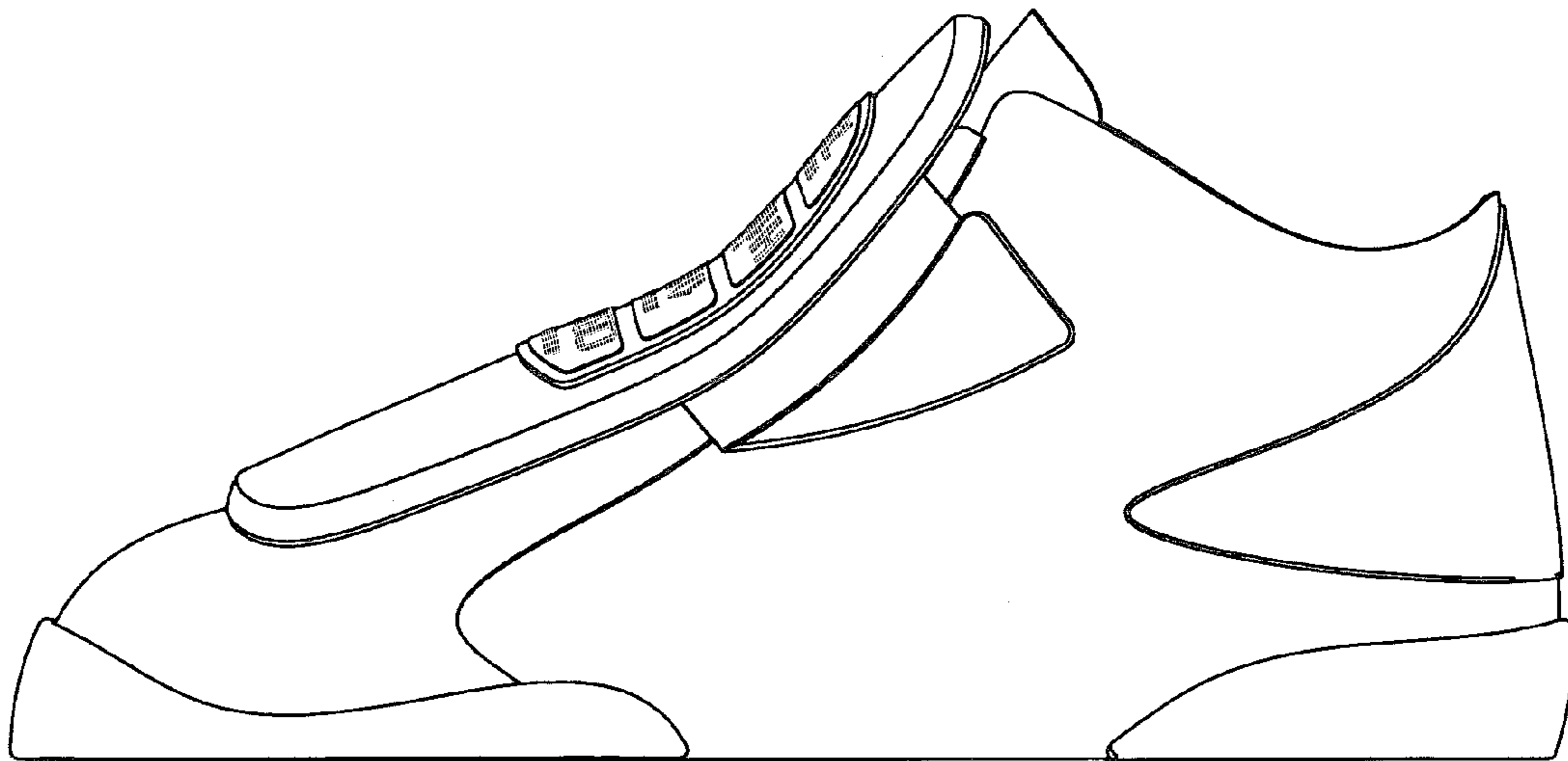
