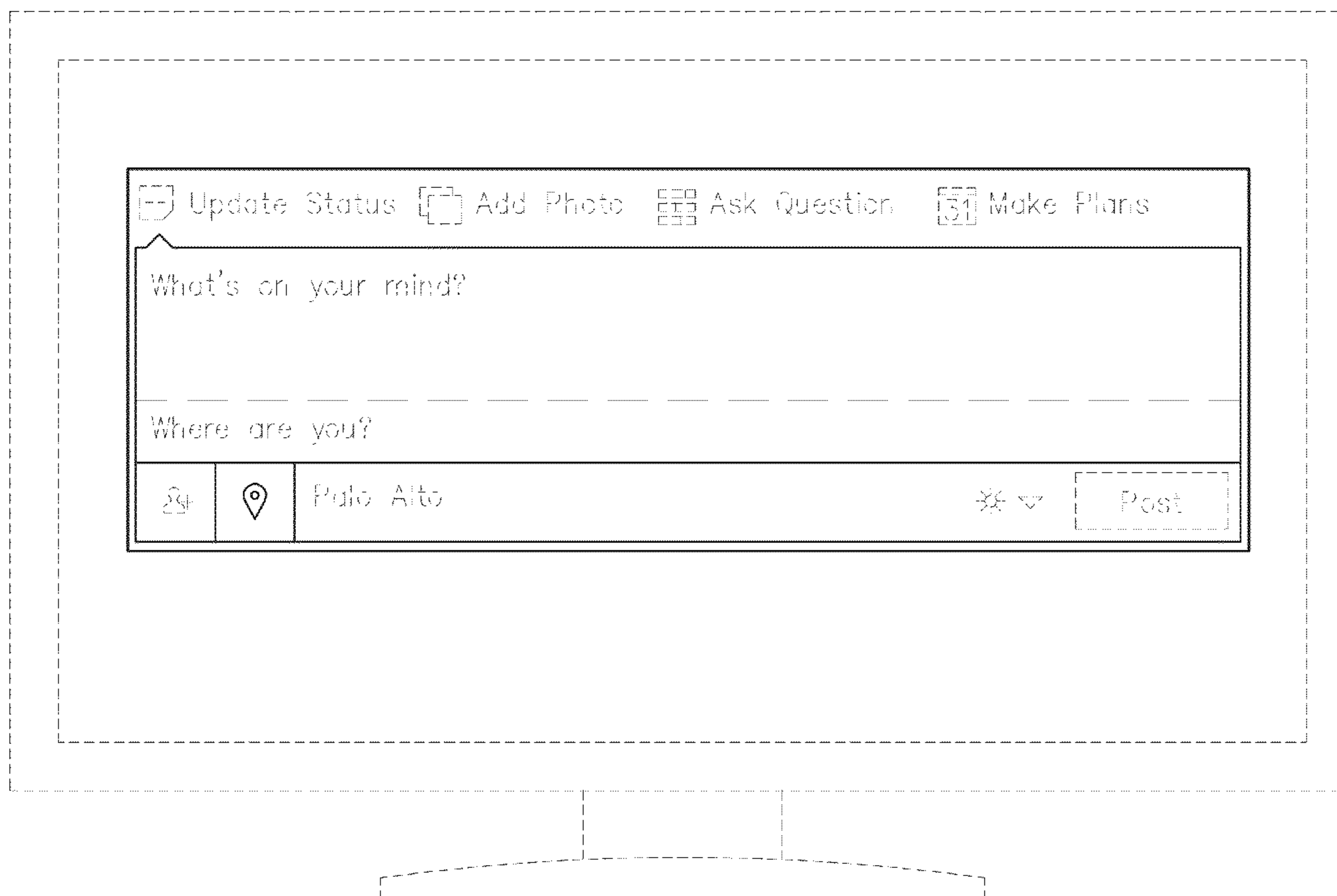
(57) **CLAIM**  
I claim the ornamental design for a display panel with graphical user interface, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front view of a first embodiment of a display panel of a programmed computer system with a graphical user interface; and,  
FIG. 2 is a front view of a second embodiment of a display panel of a programmed computer system with a graphical user interface.

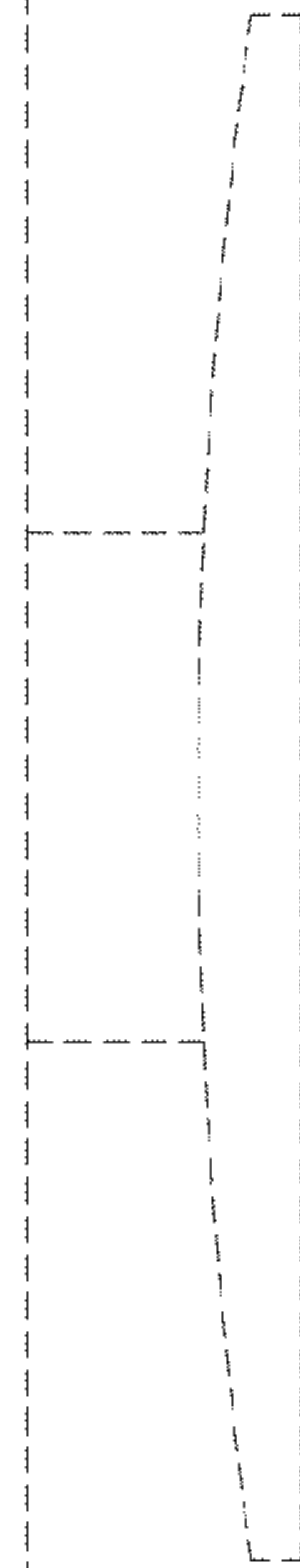

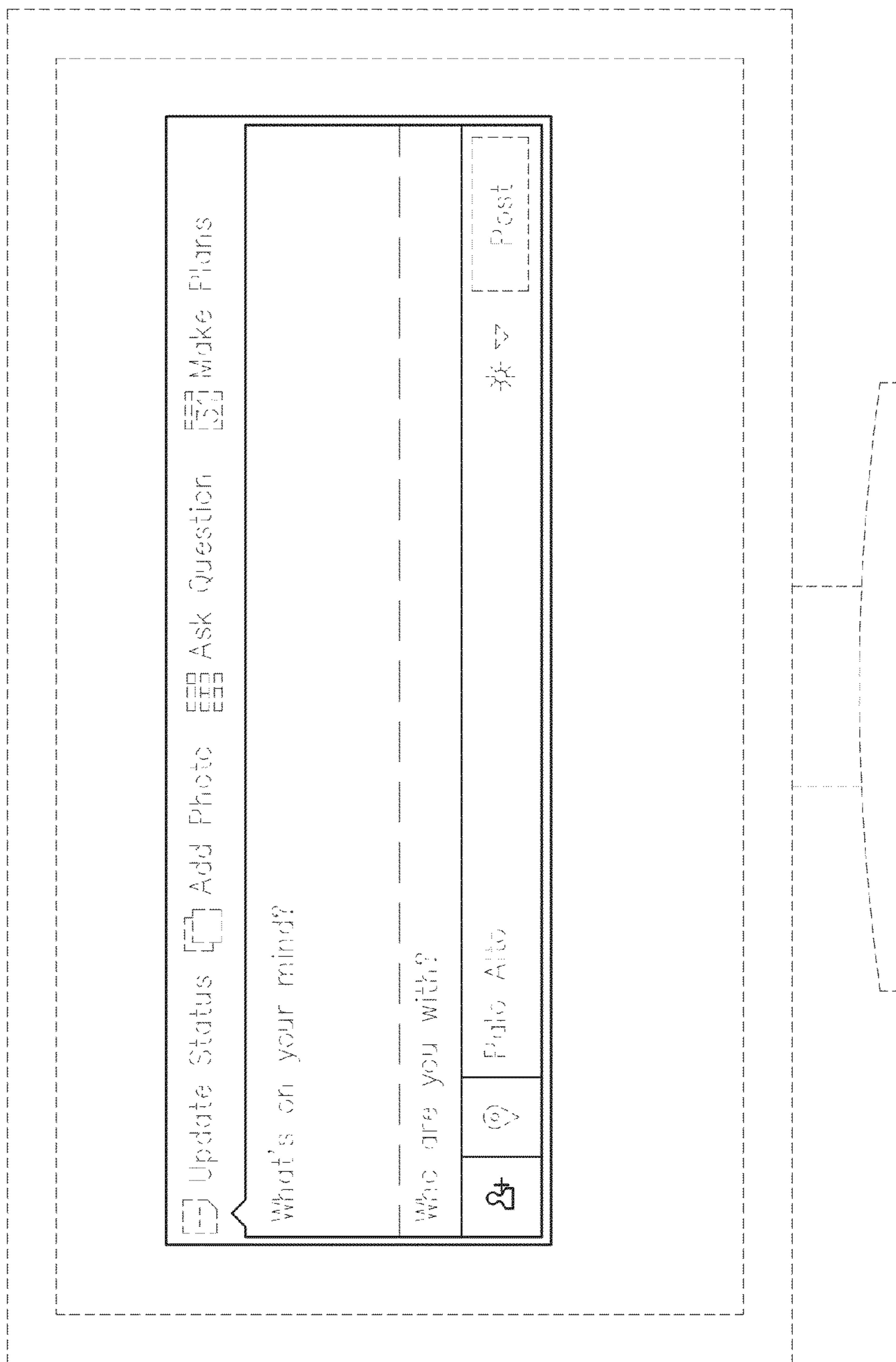
