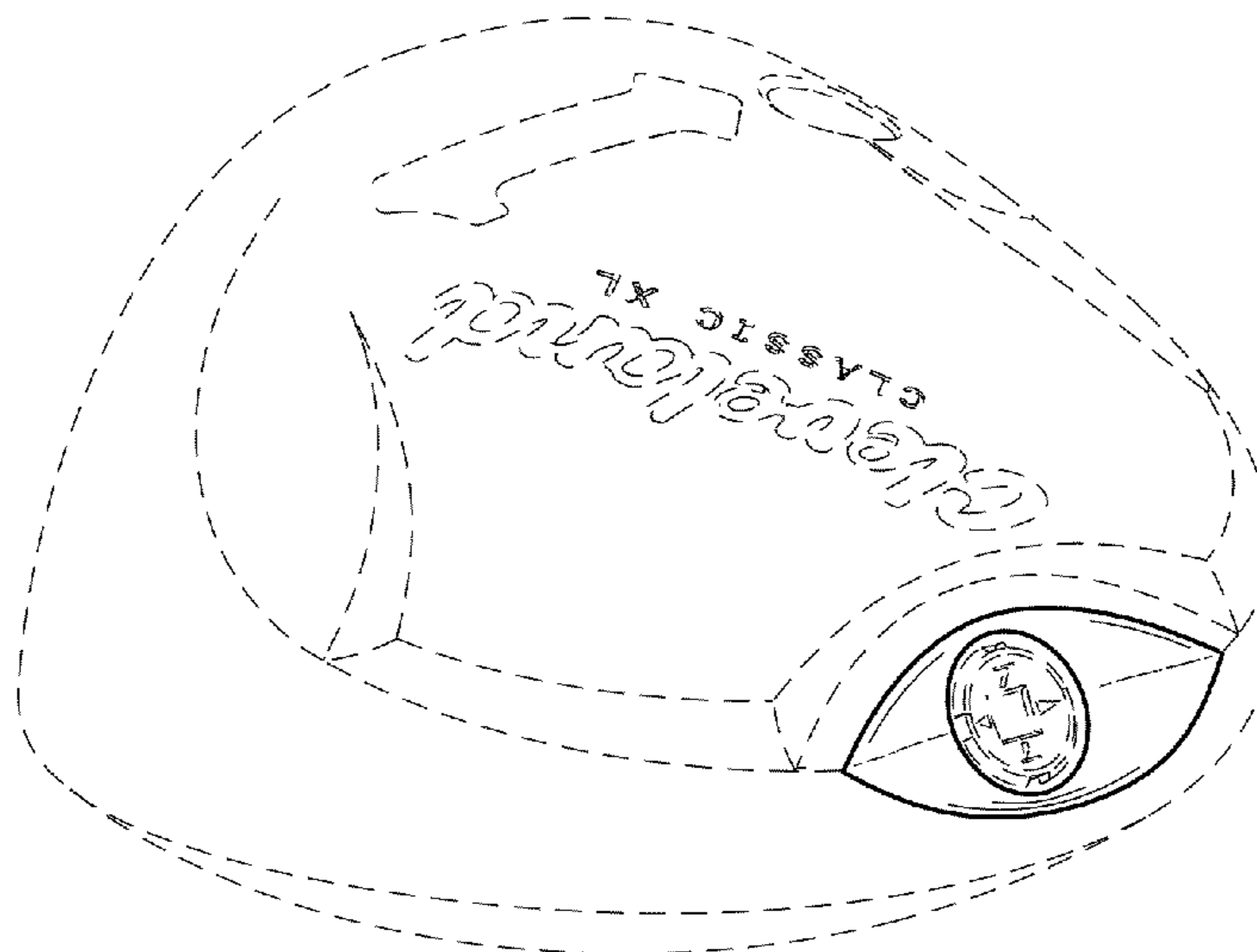

FIG. 1 is a front-side toe perspective view embodying the inventive design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a heel-side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a toe-side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom toe perspective view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof.

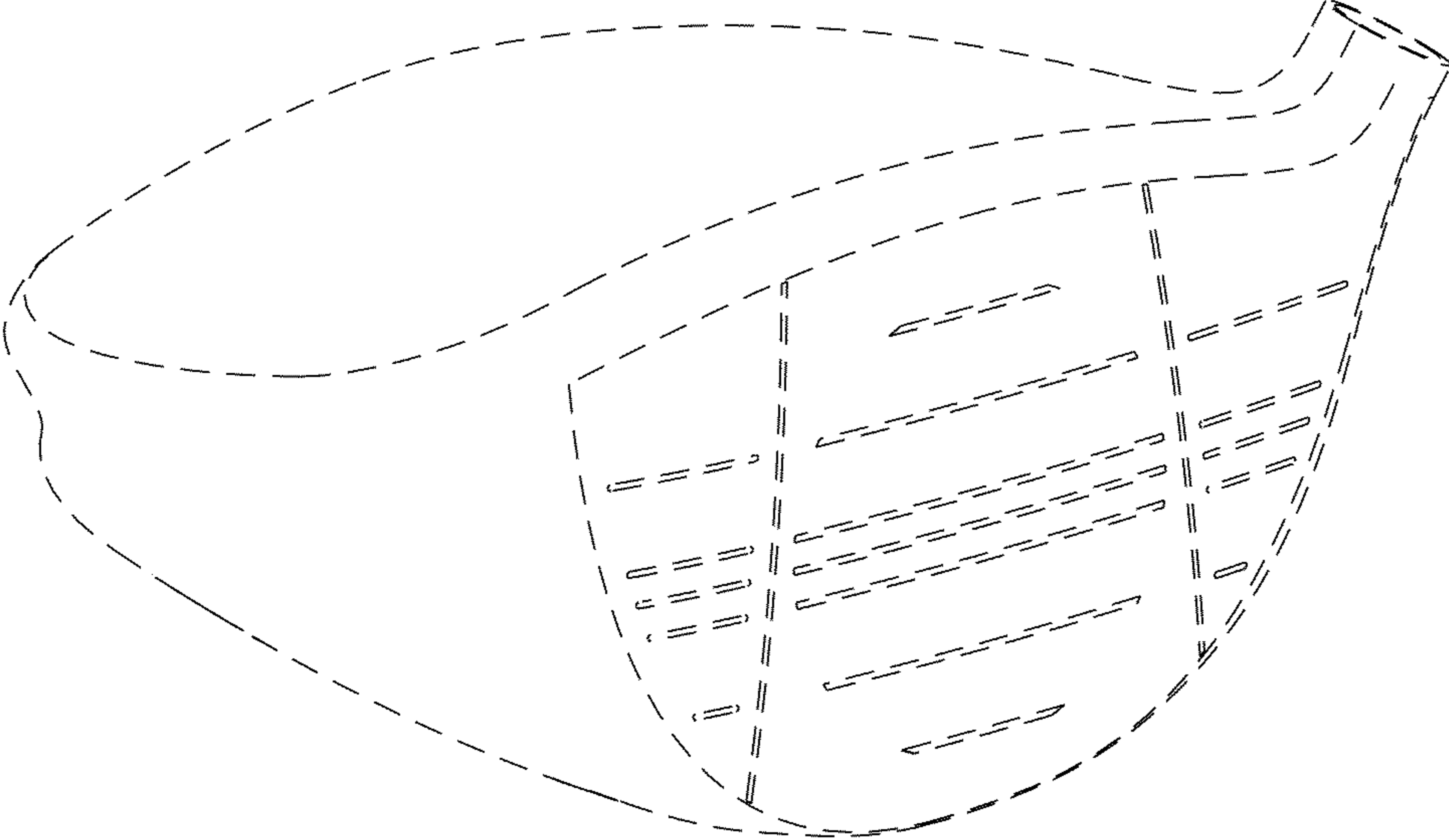

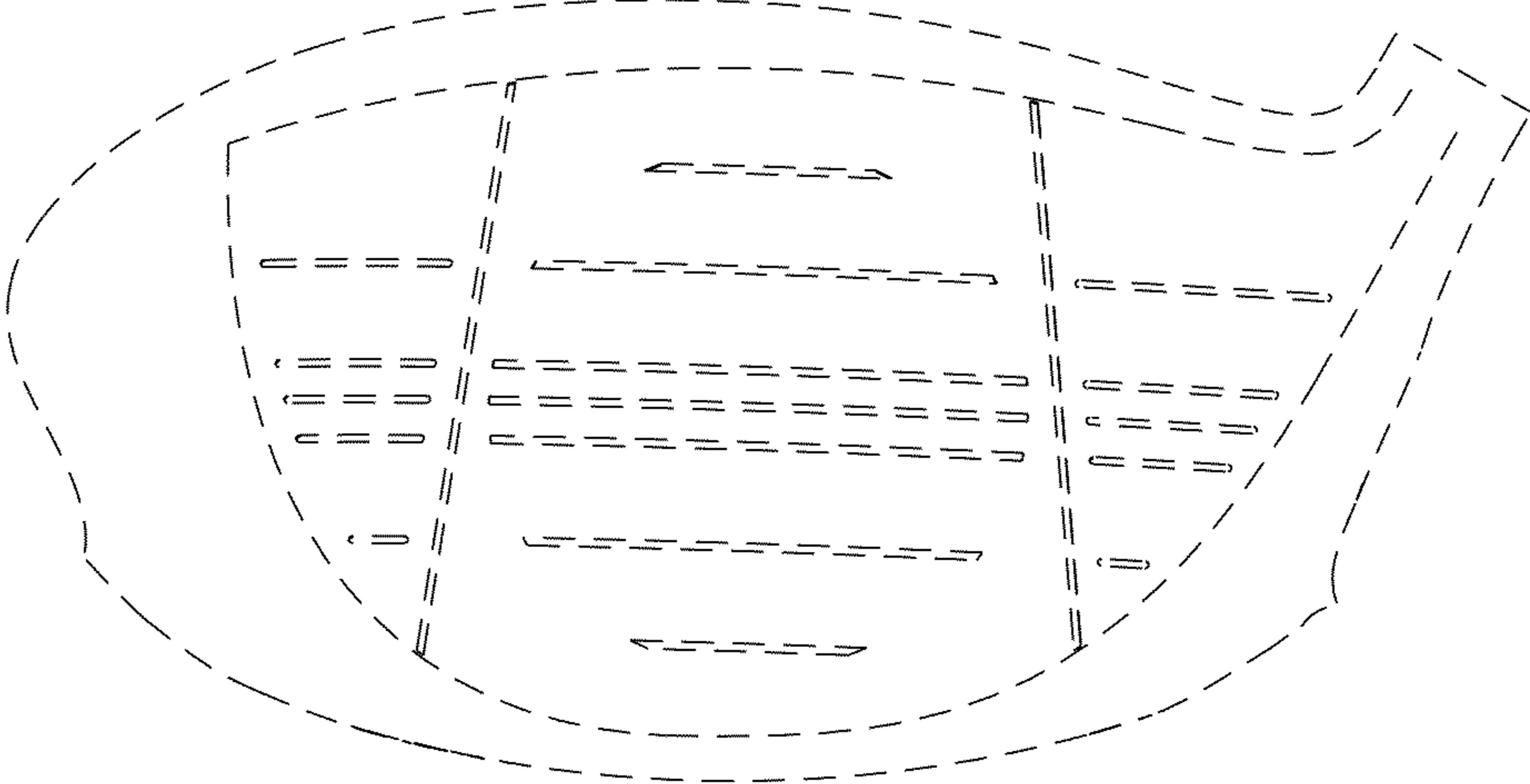

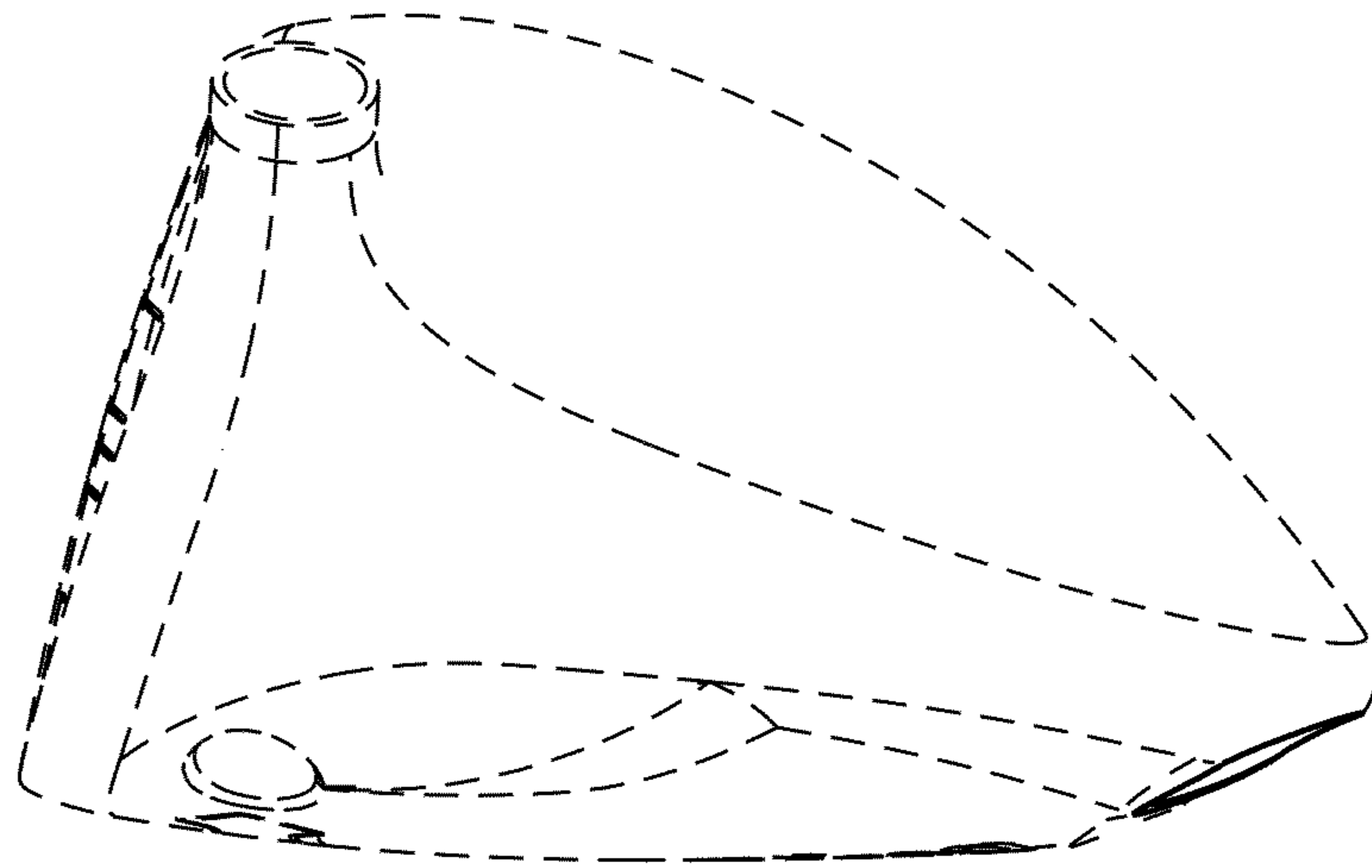

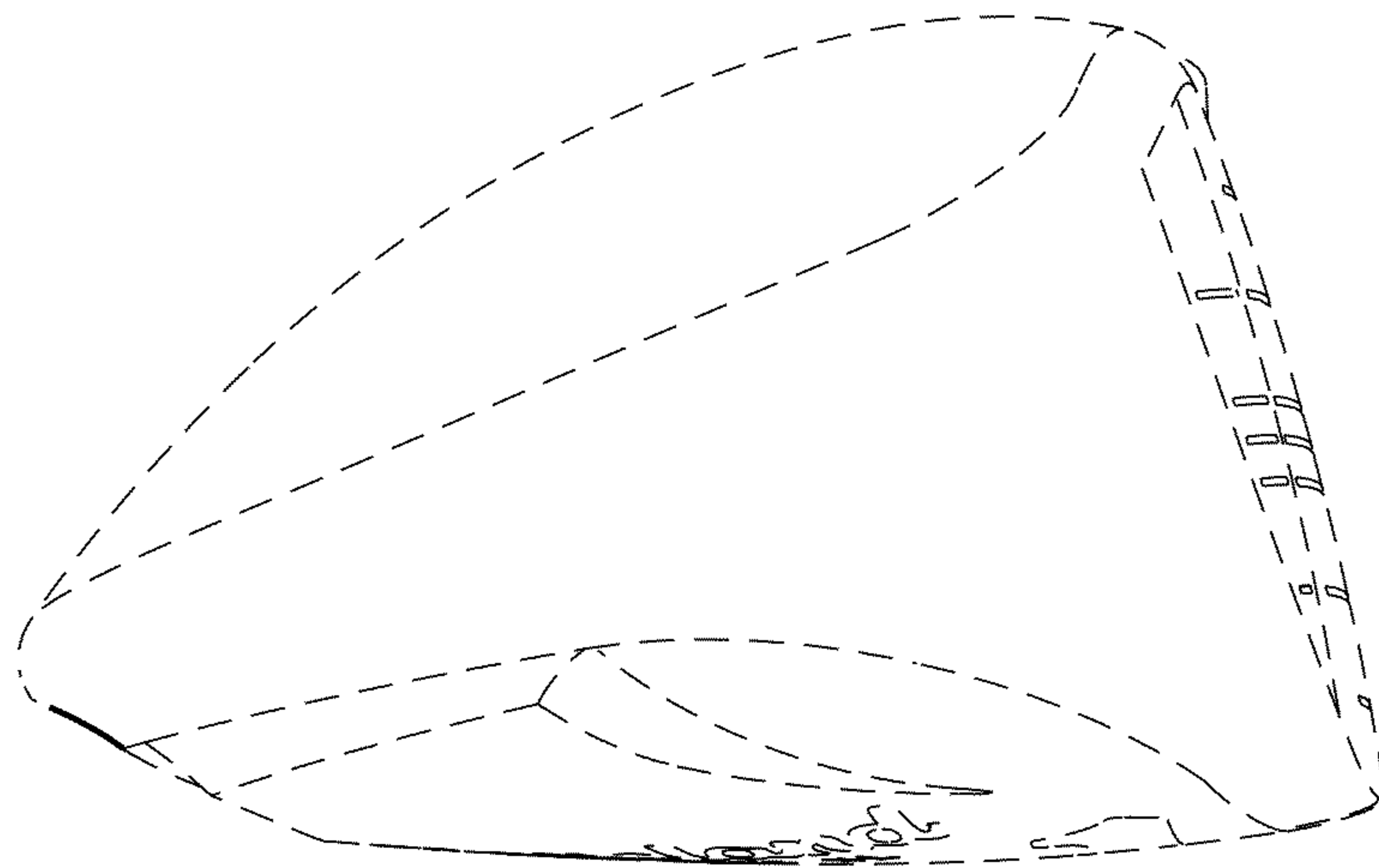

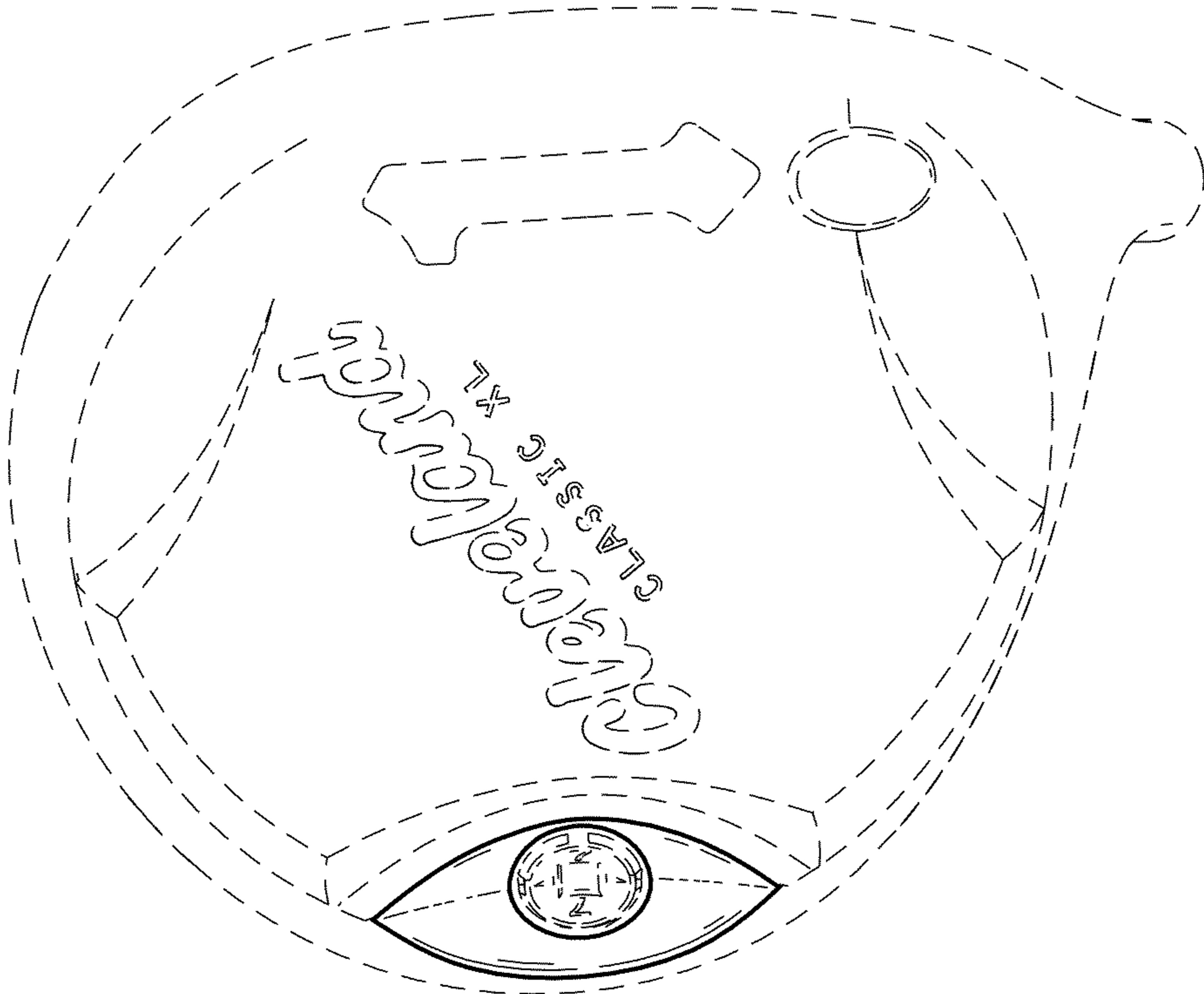

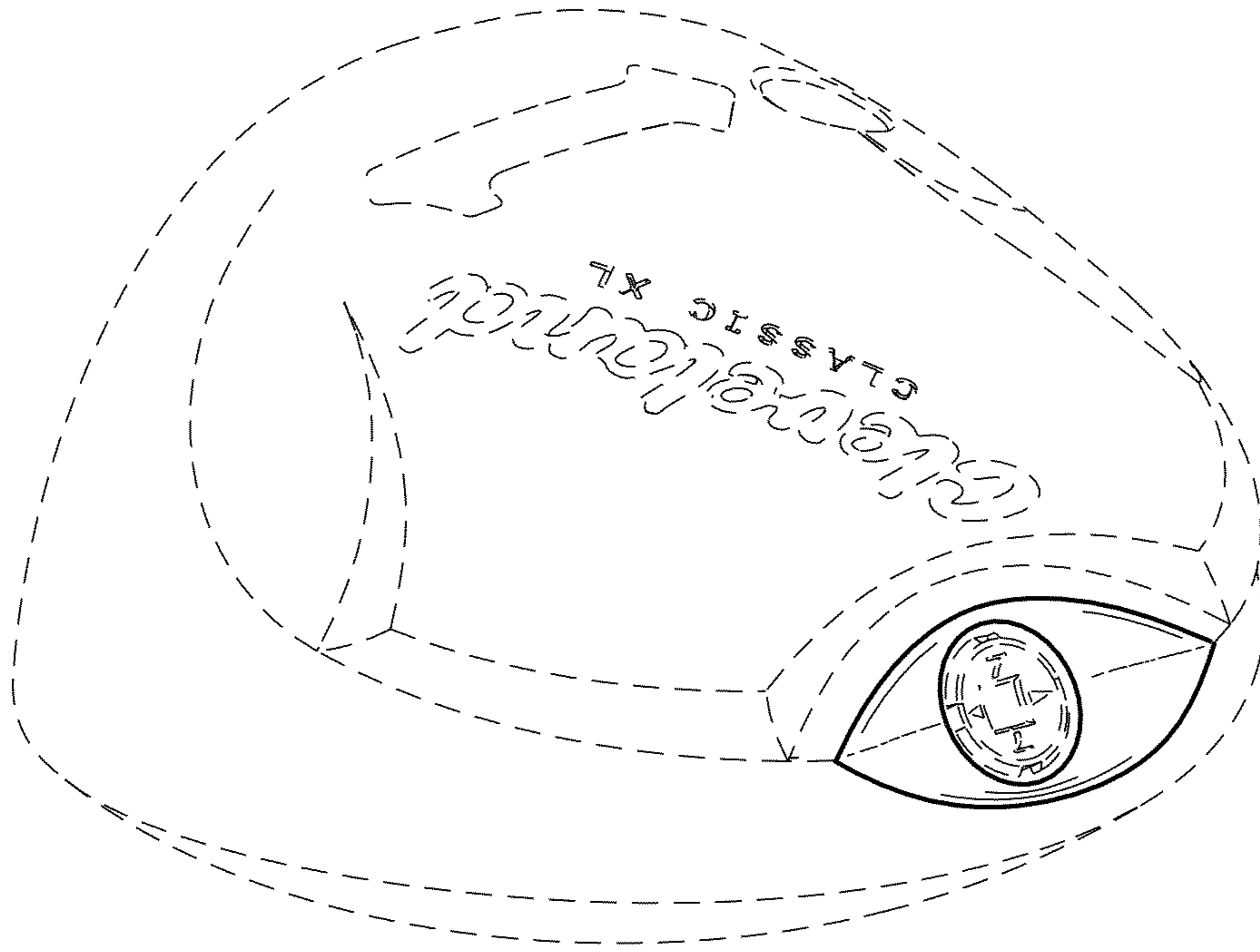

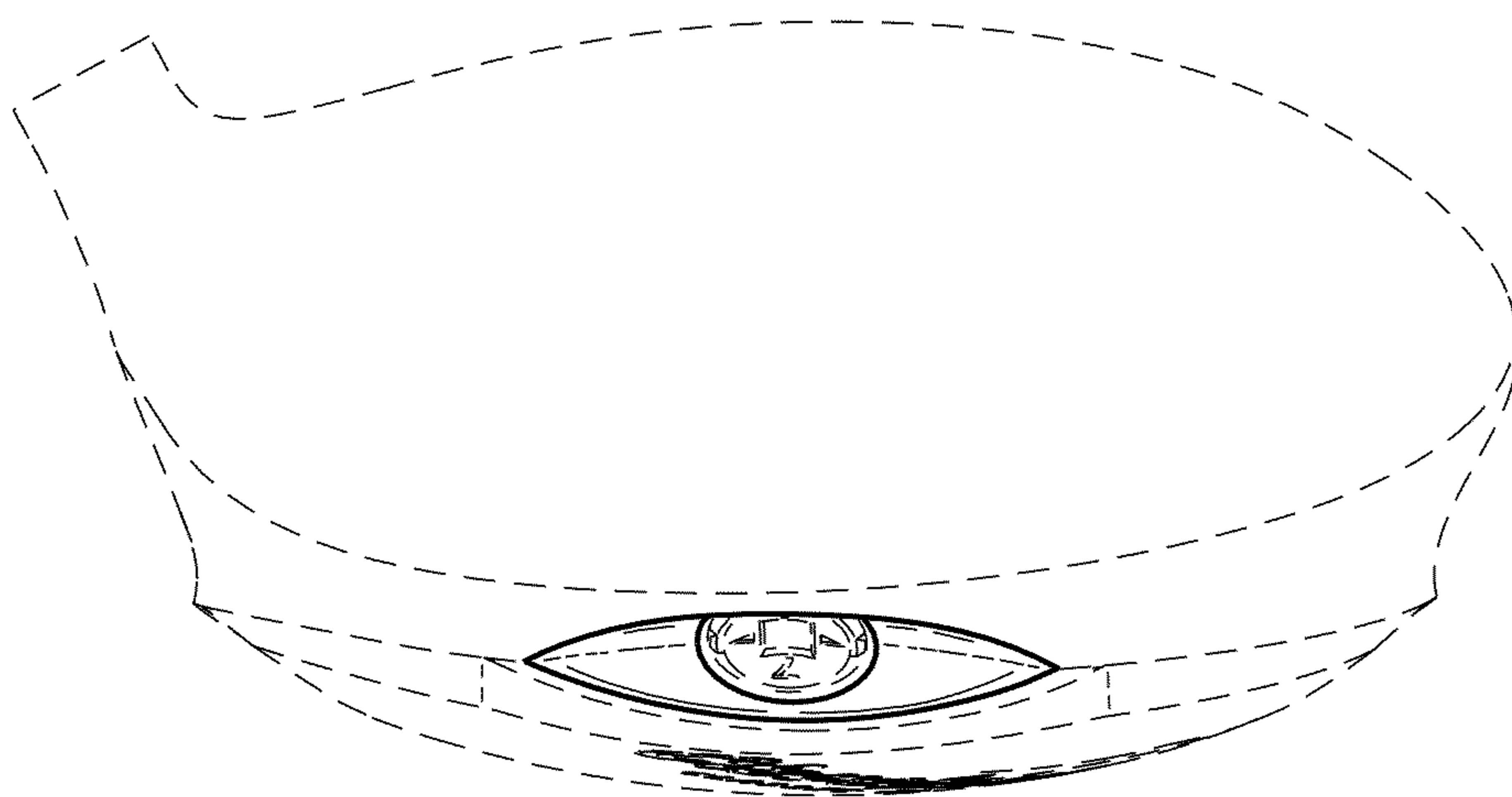
