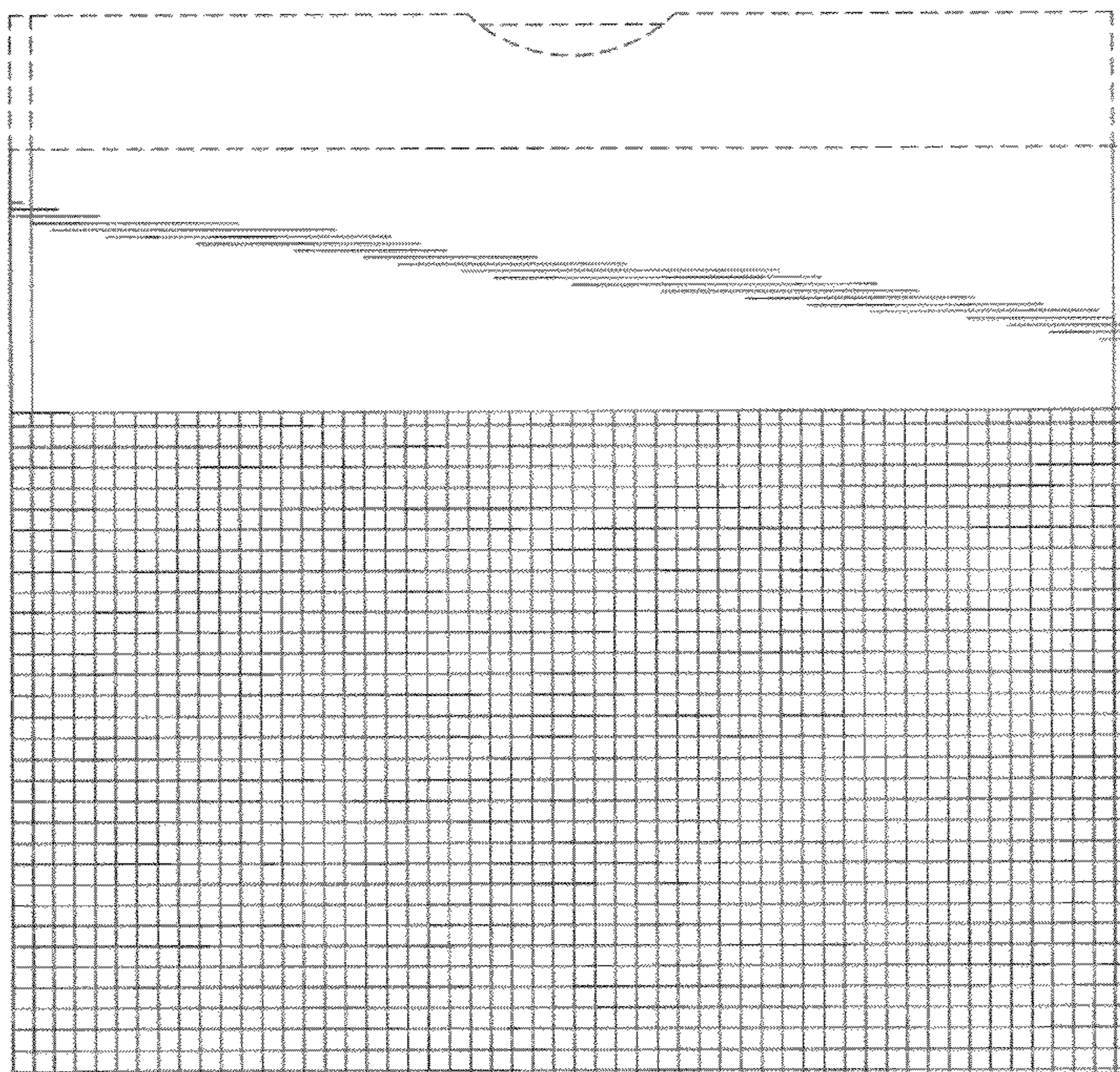

The ornamental design for a “trash bag”, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a trash bag showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a side view of the trash bag of FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a top view of the trash bag of FIG. 1; and, FIG. 4 is a bottom view of the trash bag of FIG. 1. The broken lines shown form no part of the claimed design.

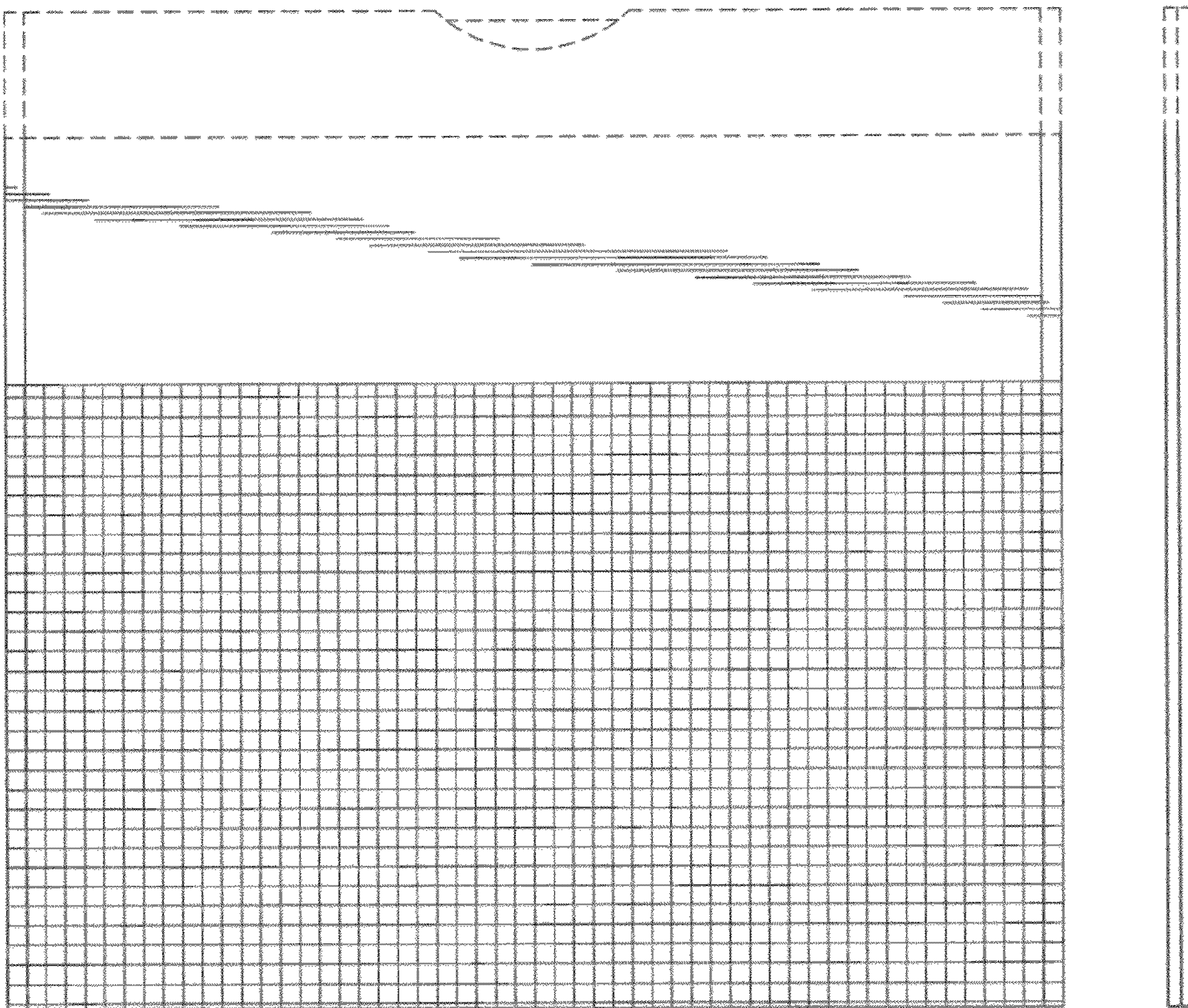
