DESCRIPTION

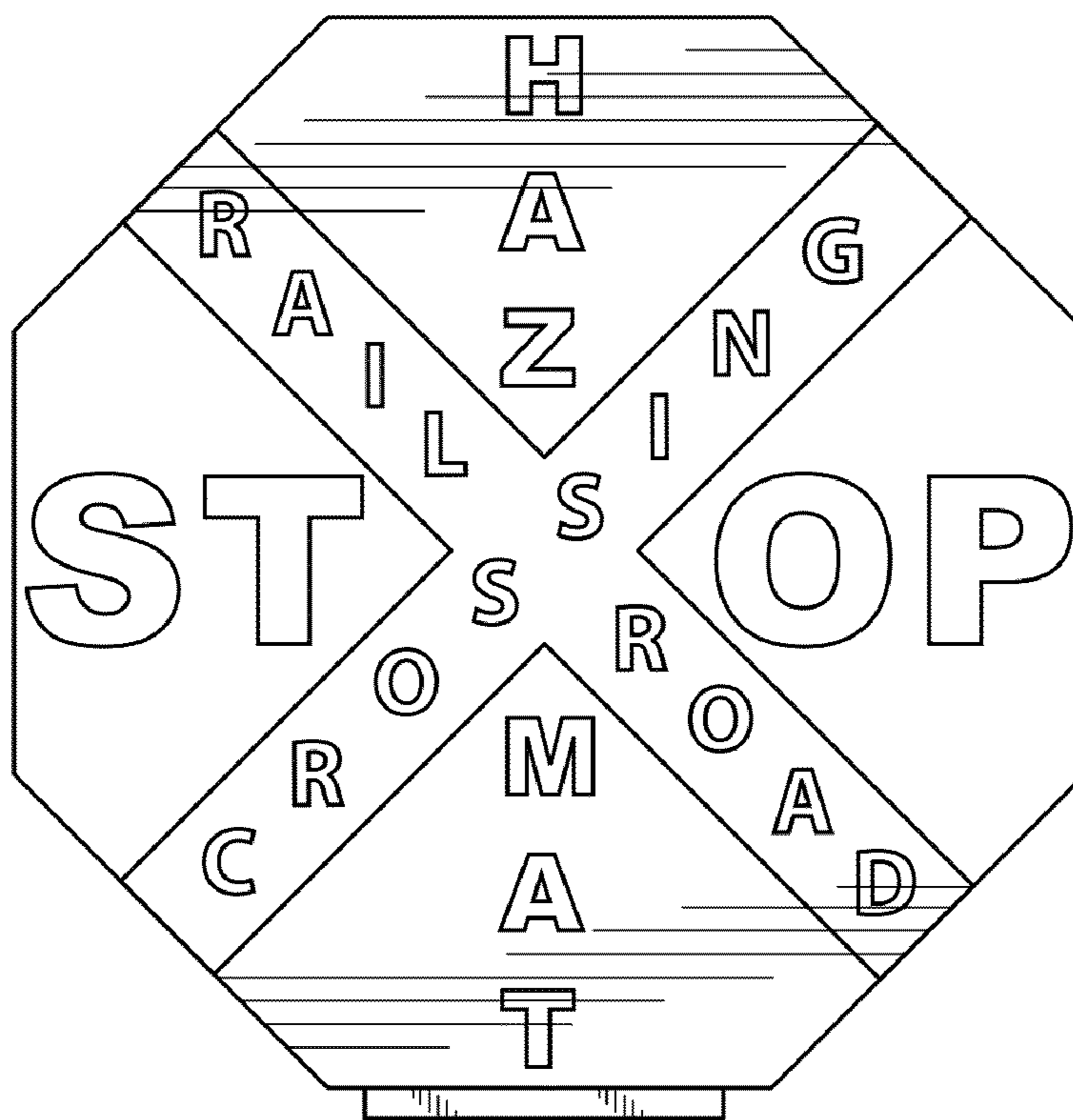
FIG. 1 is a front view of a dashboard-mounted hazardous materials sign, showing my new design;

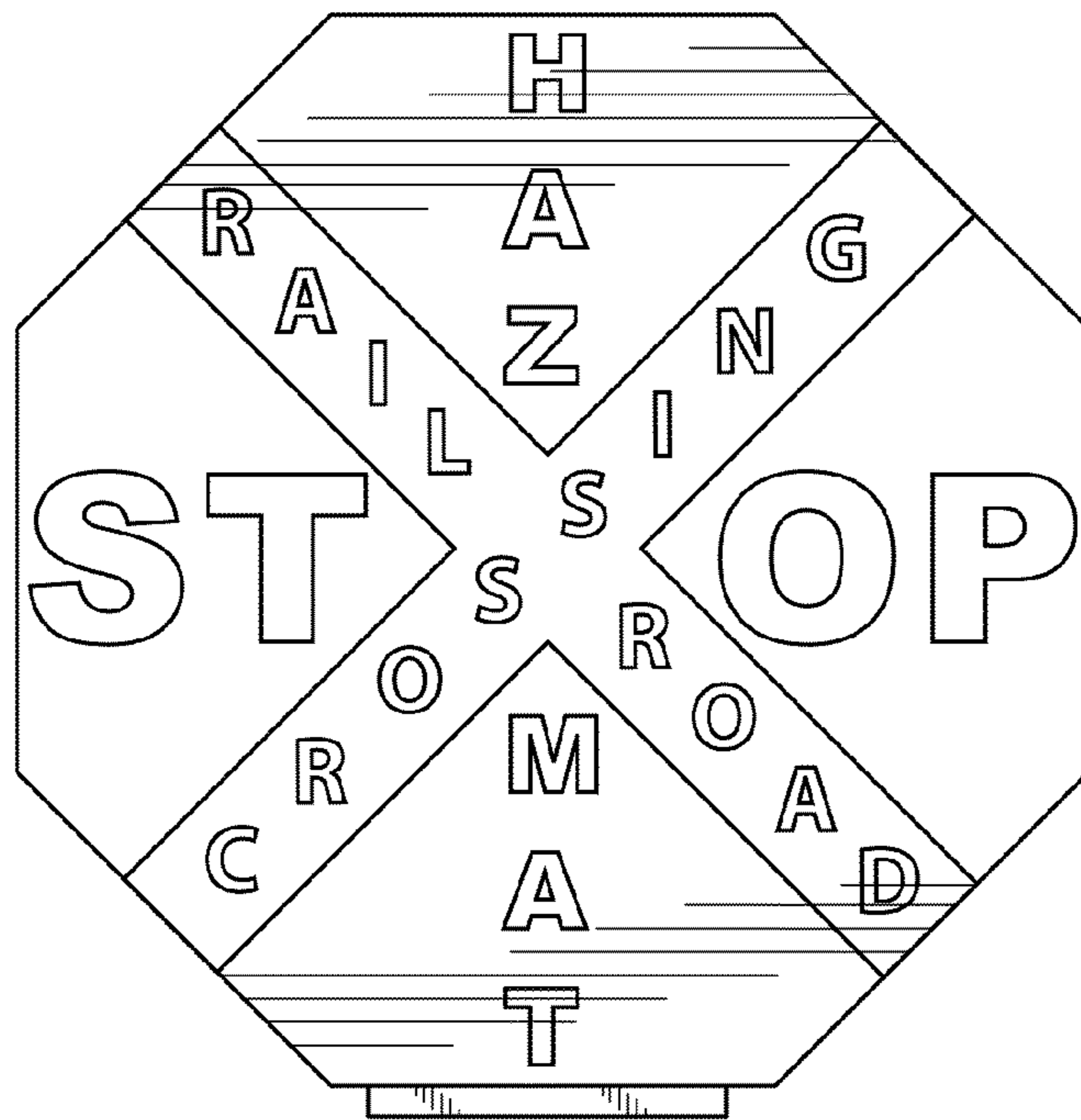

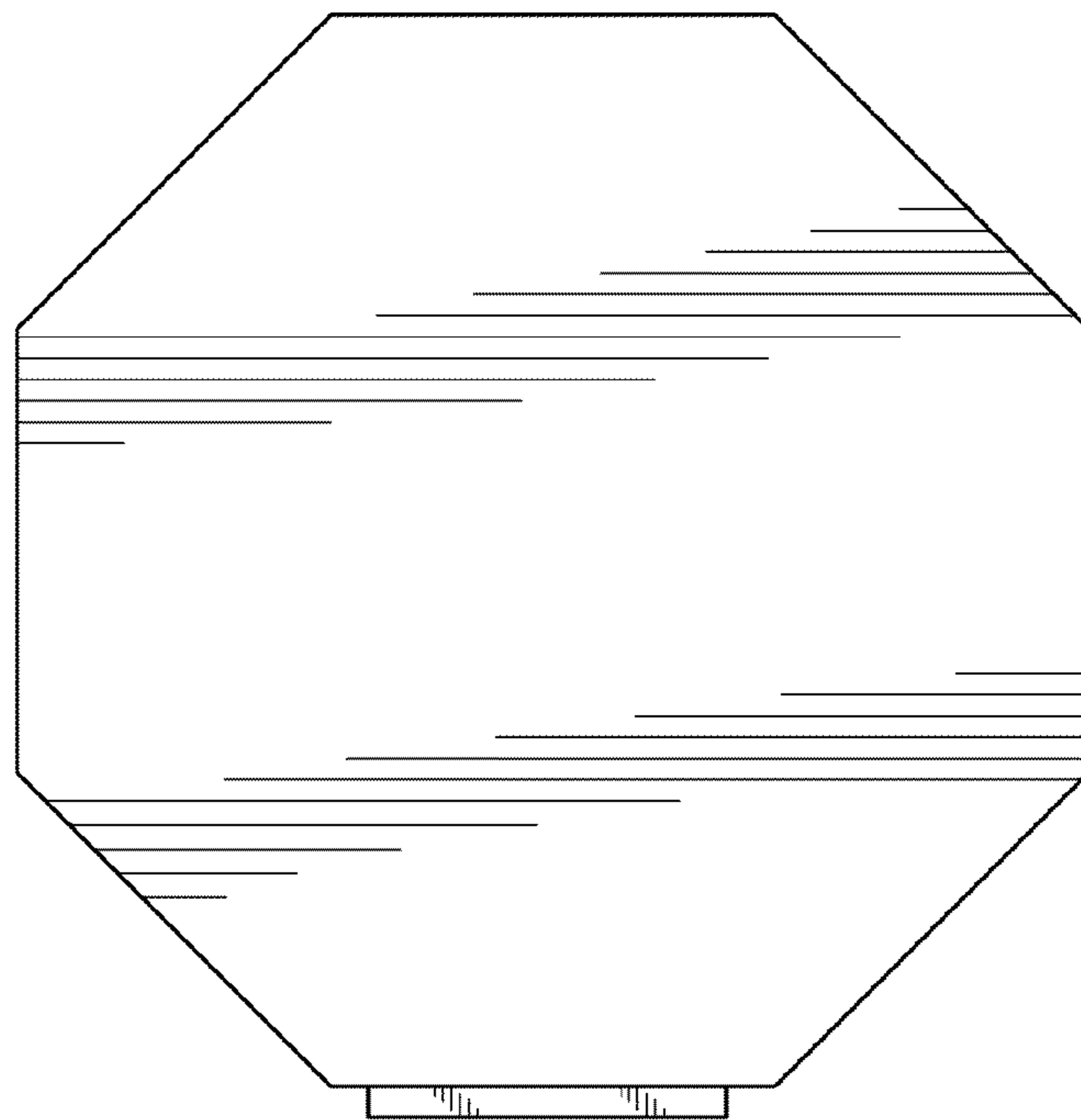

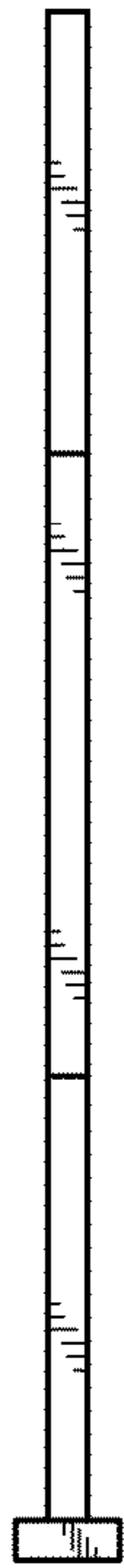

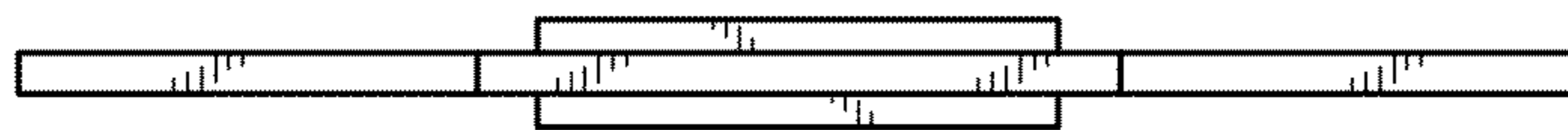

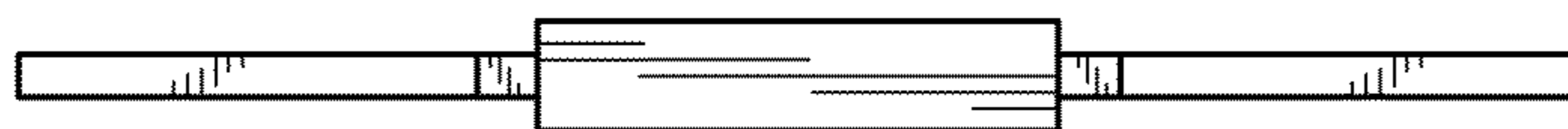
