device of FIG. 1.

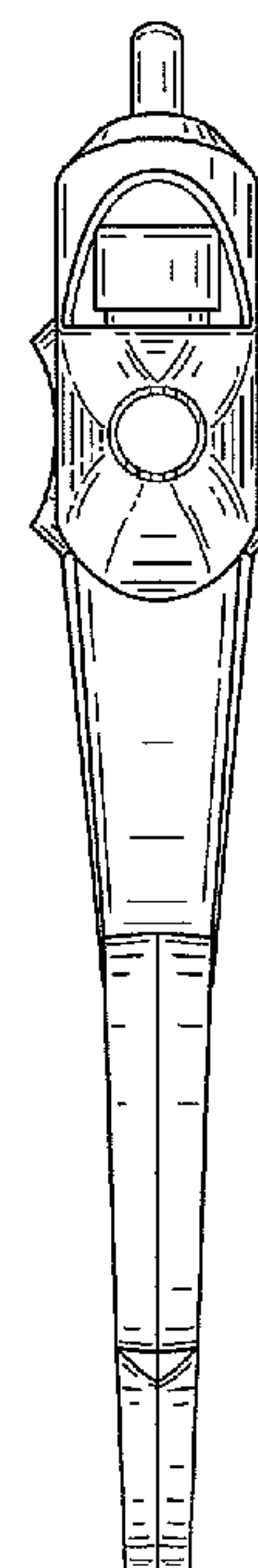
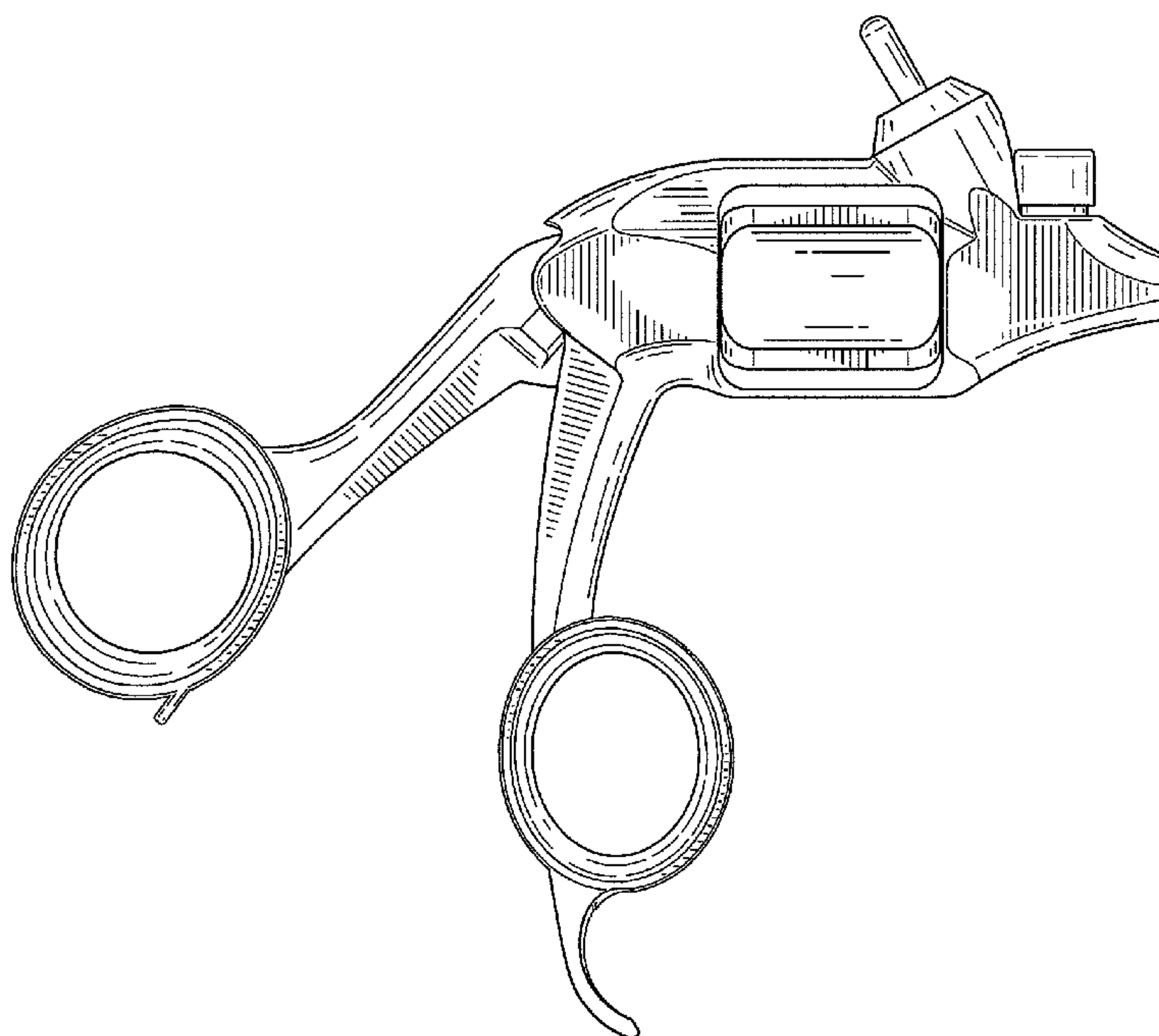
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the handle for medical
device of FIG. 1.

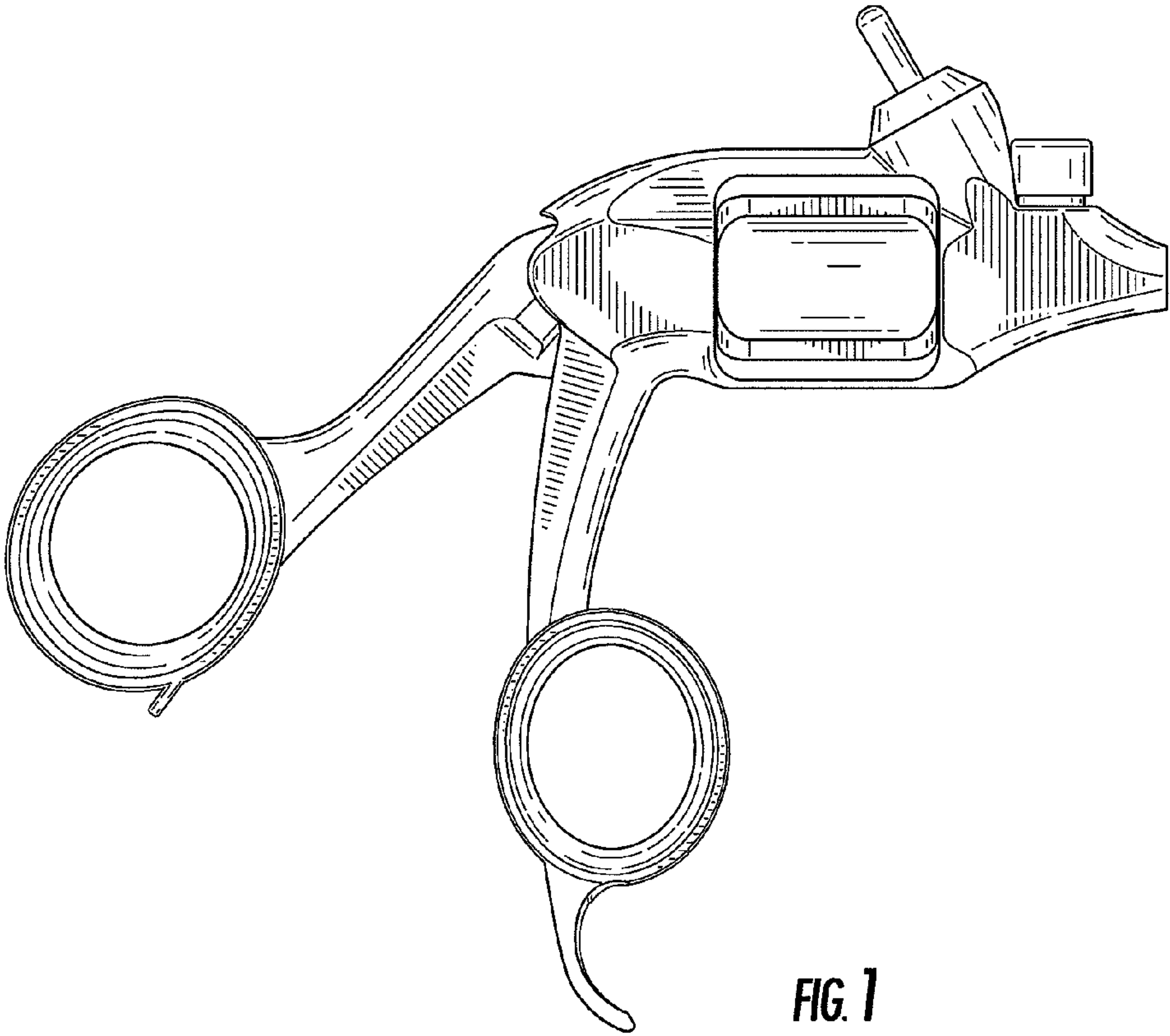
FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the handle for medical device of
FIG. 1.

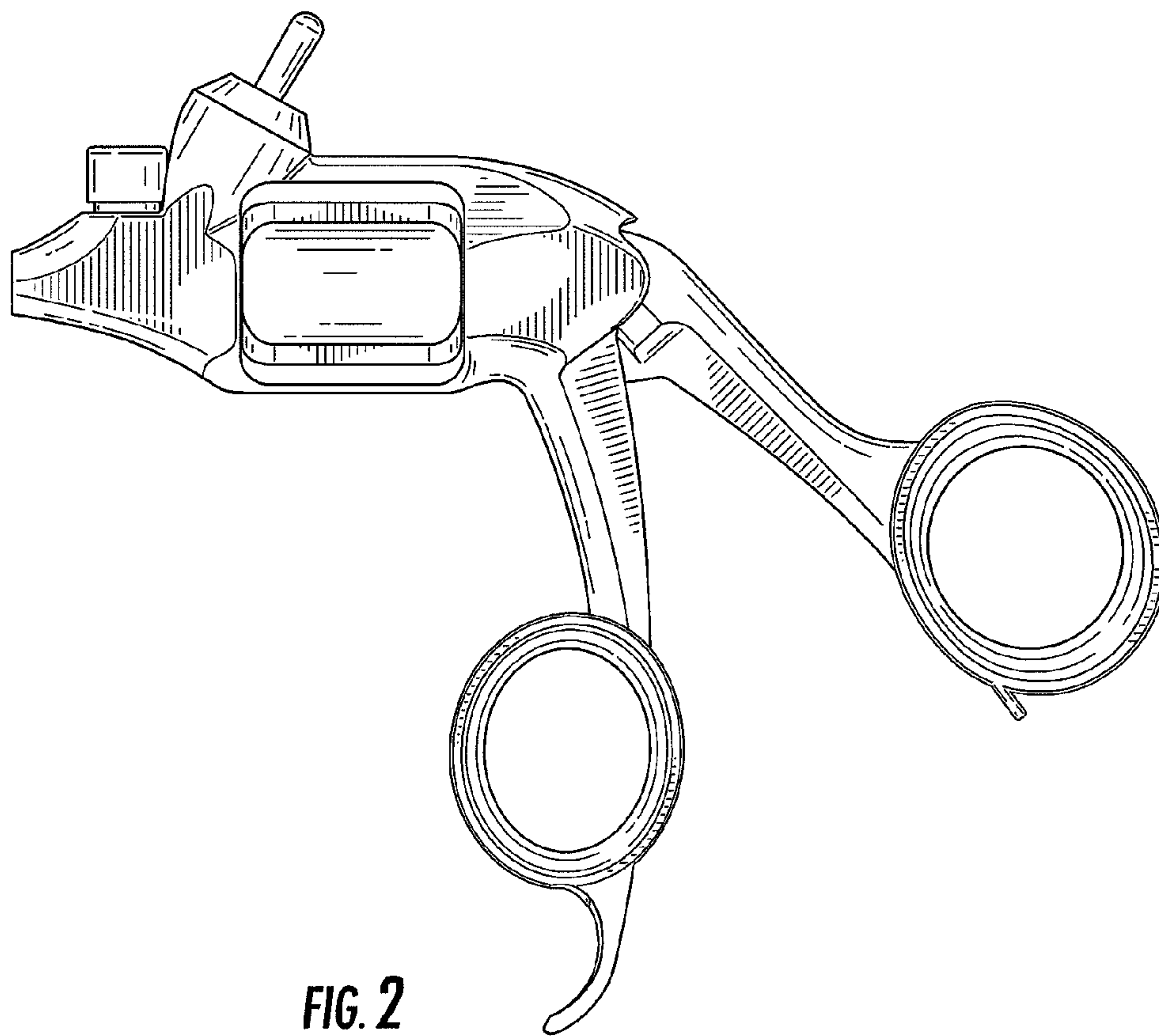
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the handle for medical device

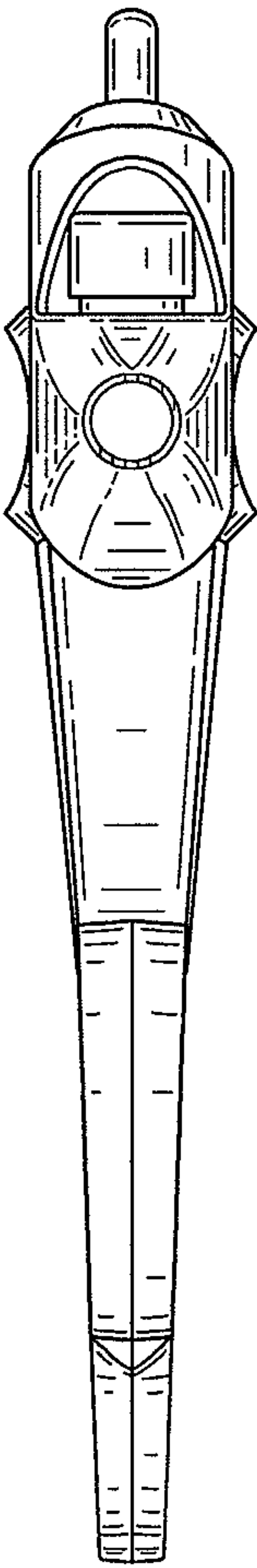

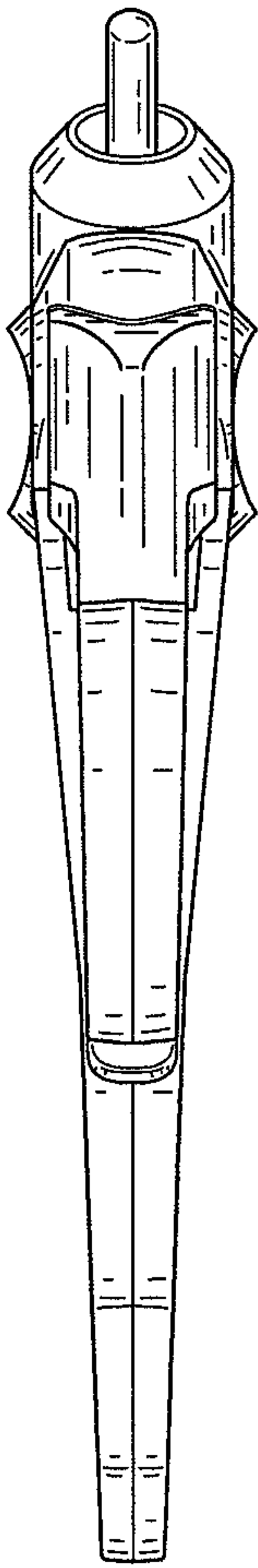
