(57) **CLAIM**

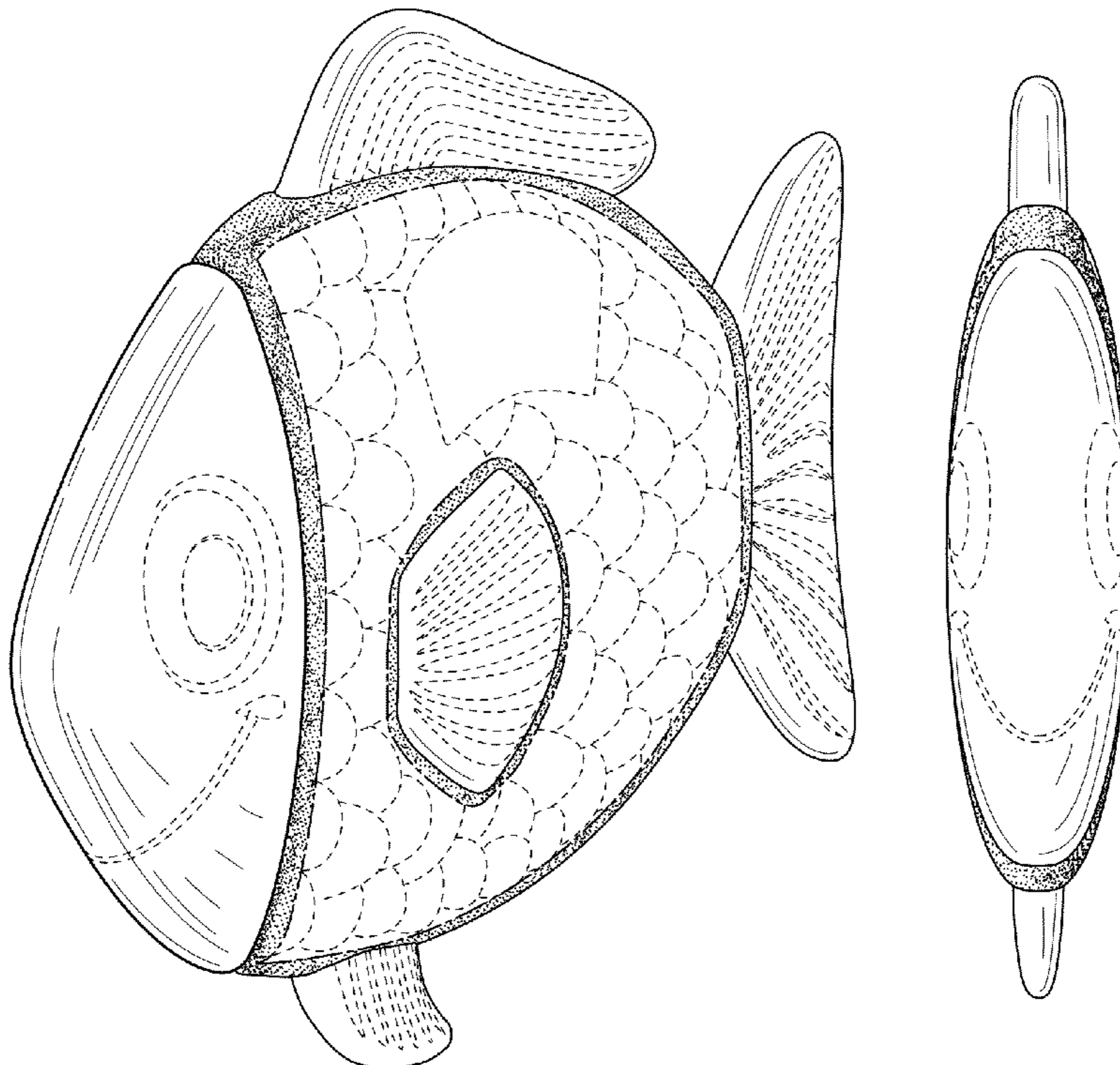
We claim the ornamental design for a pet chew toy, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a pet chew toy;  
FIG. 2 is a right side view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof;

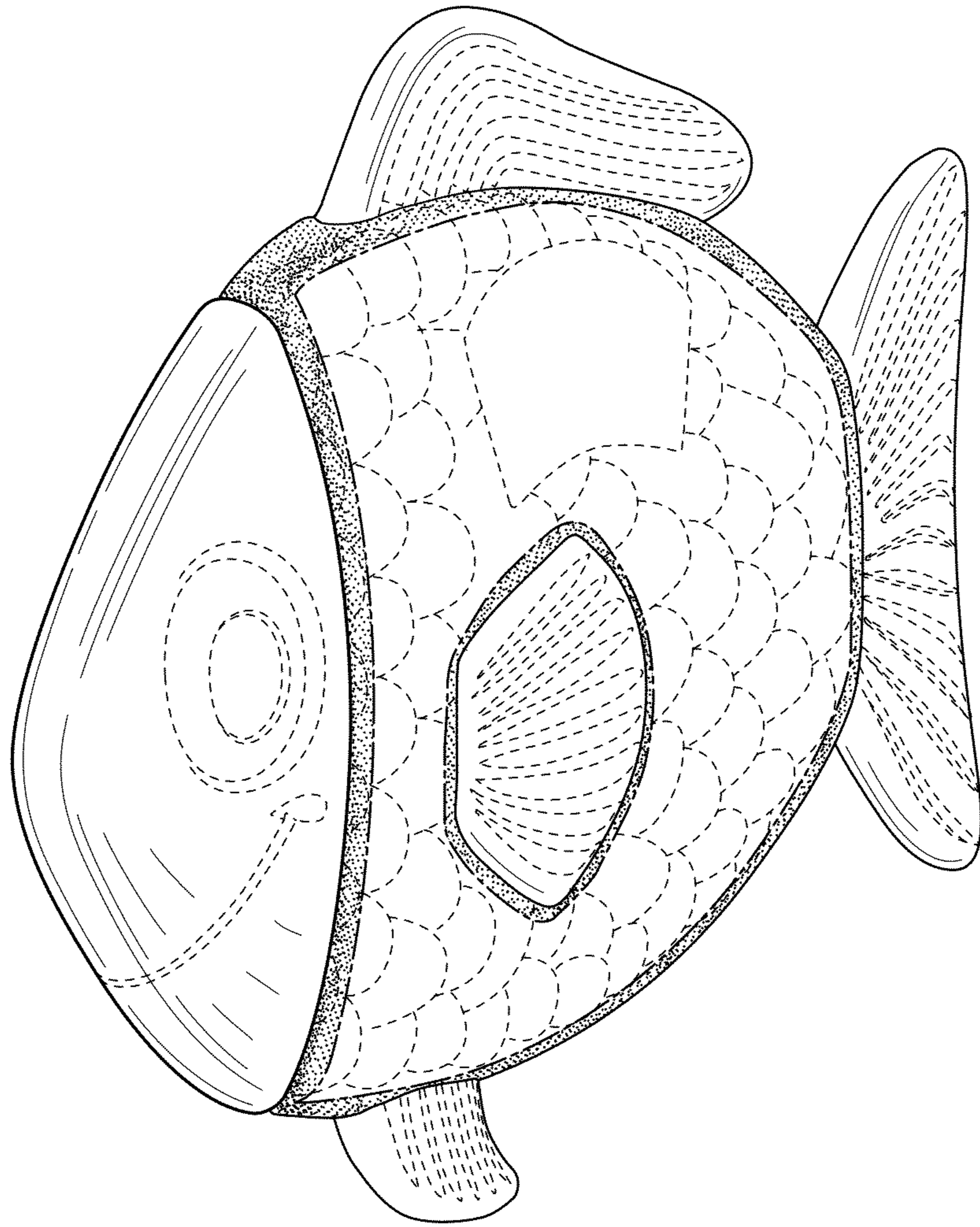

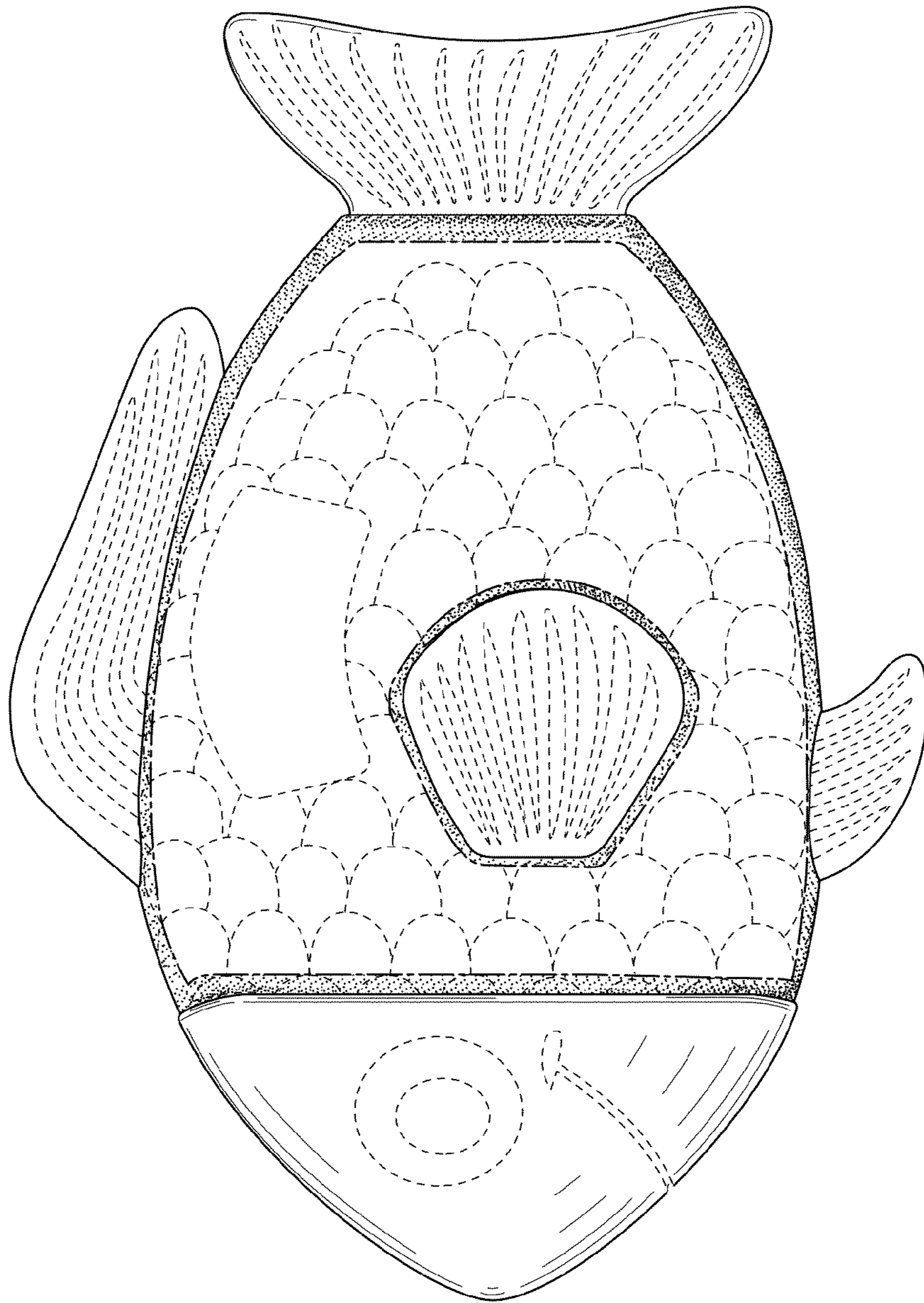

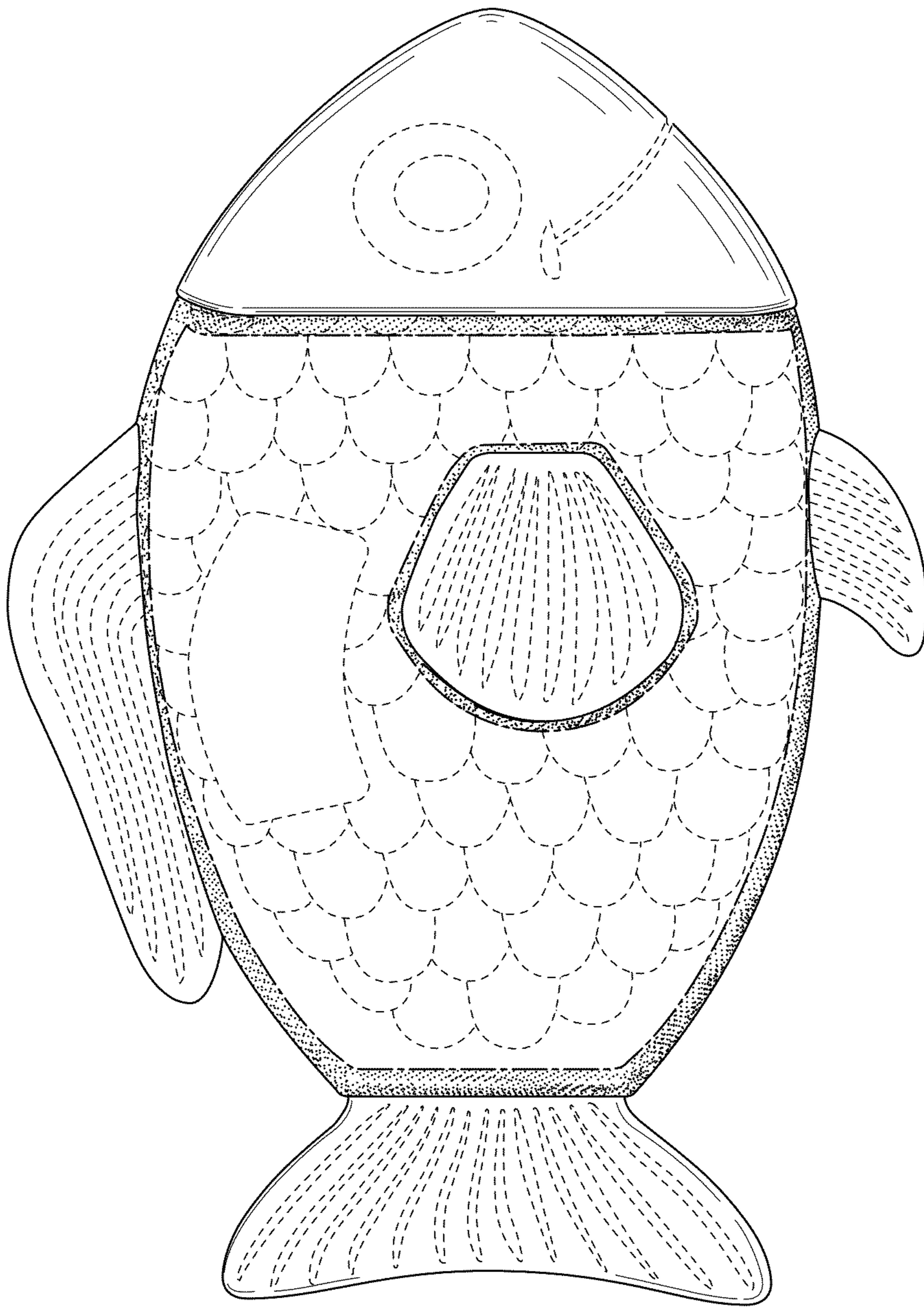

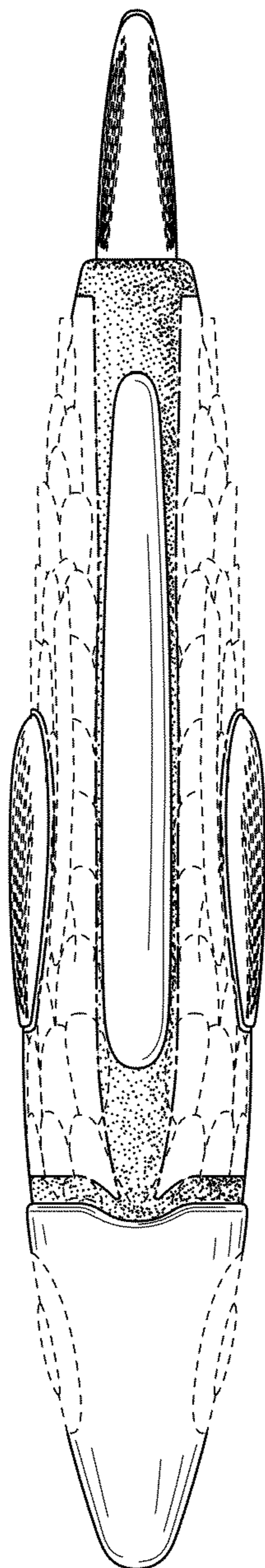

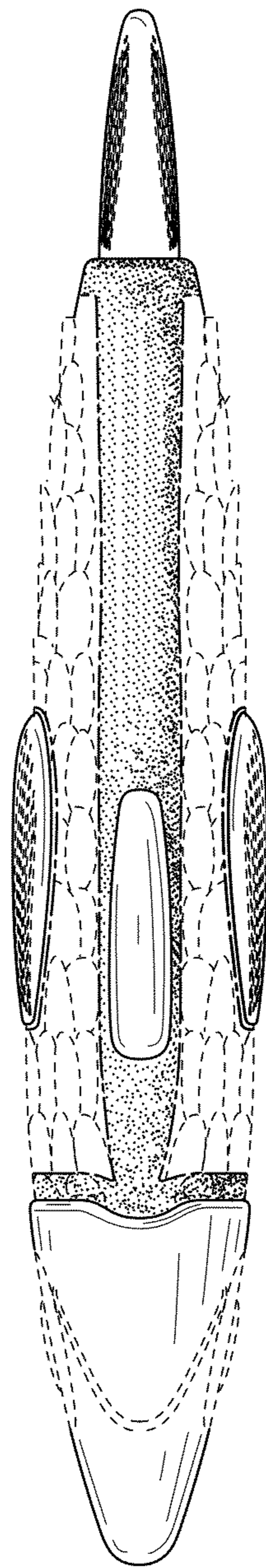
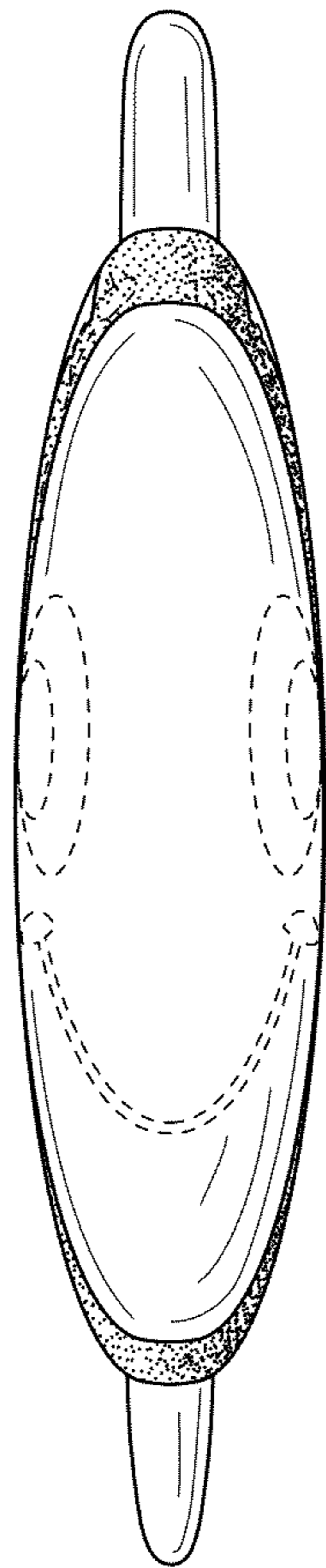
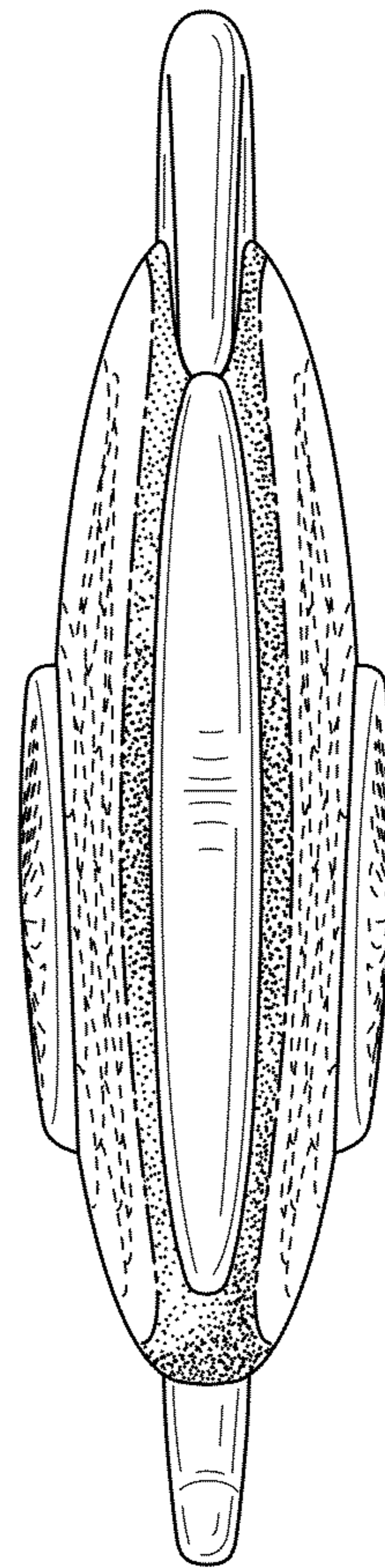
