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(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for the pocket with secure fold, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of our new pocket with secure fold, with dotted lines indicating lateral boundaries of the pocket;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevation view thereof, with dotted lines indicating lateral boundaries of the pocket;
FIG. 3 is a front elevation view thereof, with dotted lines indicating lateral boundaries of the pocket;
FIG. 4 is a side elevation view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof, with dotted lines indicating lateral boundaries of the pocket;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof, with dotted lines indicating lateral boundaries of the pocket;
FIG. 7 is a cross sectional view shown along line 7-7 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 8 is a perspective view thereof with top fold lifted, with dotted lines indicating lateral boundaries of the pocket;

FIG. 9 is a perspective view thereof with top and bottom folds lifted to show a single internal divider, with dotted lines indicating lateral boundaries of the pocket;

FIG. 10 is a perspective view of a first alternate embodiment of our new pocket with secure fold with top and bottom folds lifted to show two internal dividers, with dotted lines indicating lateral boundaries of the pocket;

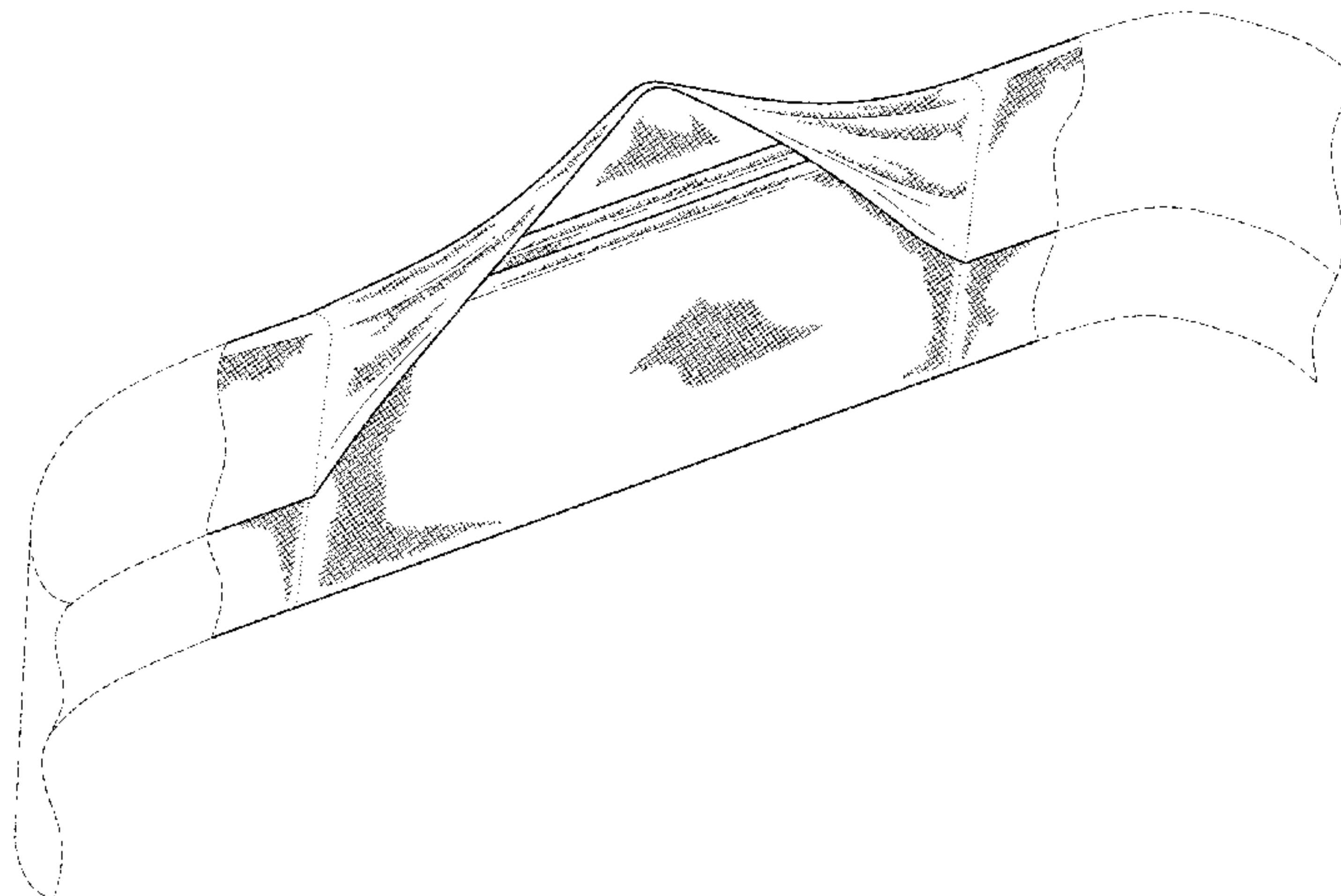
FIG. 11 is a perspective view of a second alternate embodiment of our new pocket with secure fold with top and bottom folds lifted to show the absence of an internal divider, with dotted lines indicating lateral boundaries of the pocket; and, FIG. 12 is a cross sectional view shown along line 12-12 of the pocket with secure fold of FIG. 4, with dotted lines indicating lateral boundaries of the pocket.

The Figure description of the alternate embodiments are the same as the first embodiment with the exception of the internal dividers.

As opposed to the dotted lines described above, the broken or dashed lines shown in the drawings are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

The article in which the design is embodied is a garment with a sleek, expandable pocket containing a fold or flap to securely contain items absent any securing devices such as a zipper, VELCRO200, etc. The secure fold feature of the pocket is created by folding the fabric to create a flap. The flap is held in place by stitching, as shown by the dotted lines, the sides in two places; to the left and to the right of the pocket. The pocket is constructed of stretch fabric which forms the outer enclosing wall of the pocket and wraps around the other side and over the top to form the secure fold.

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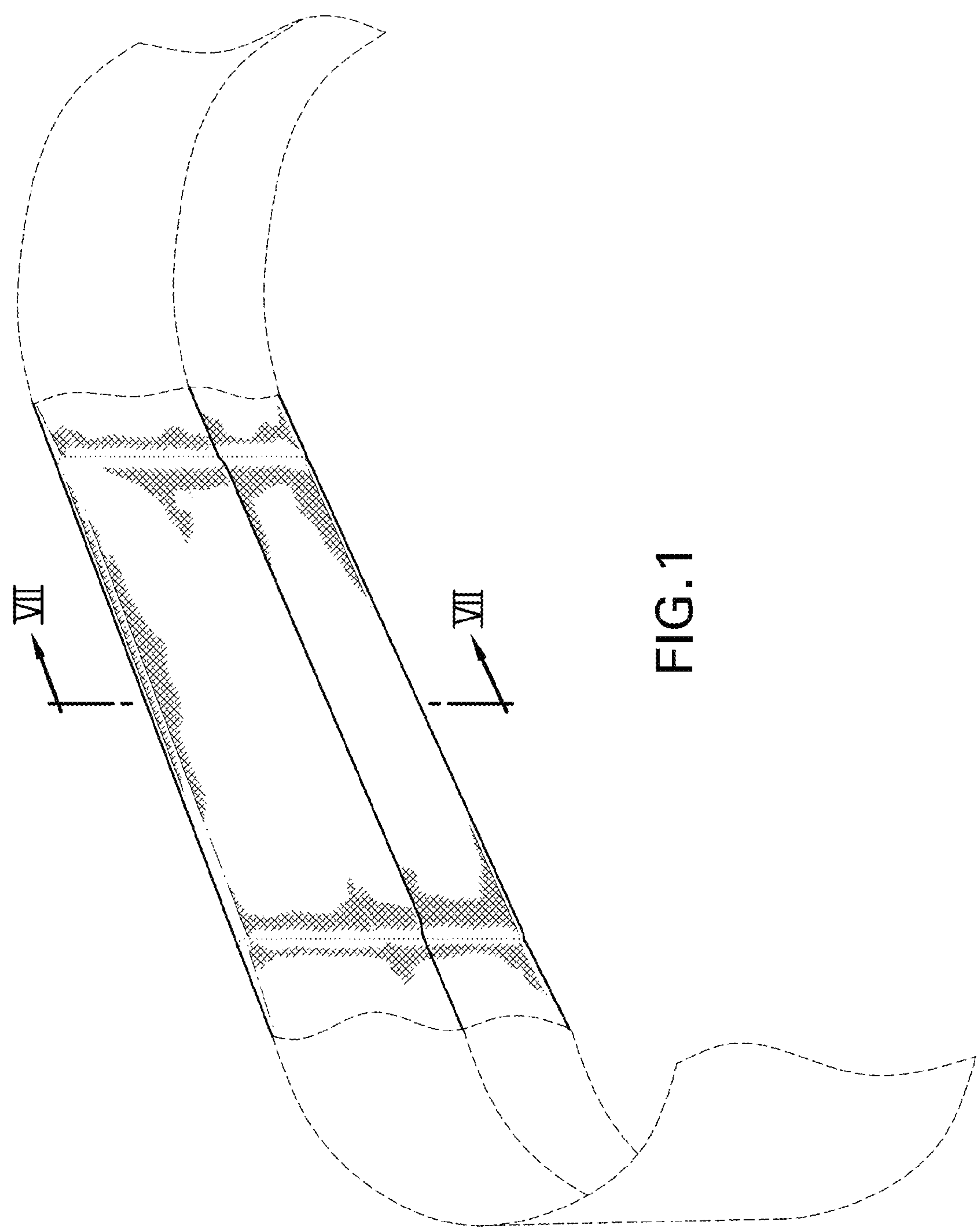

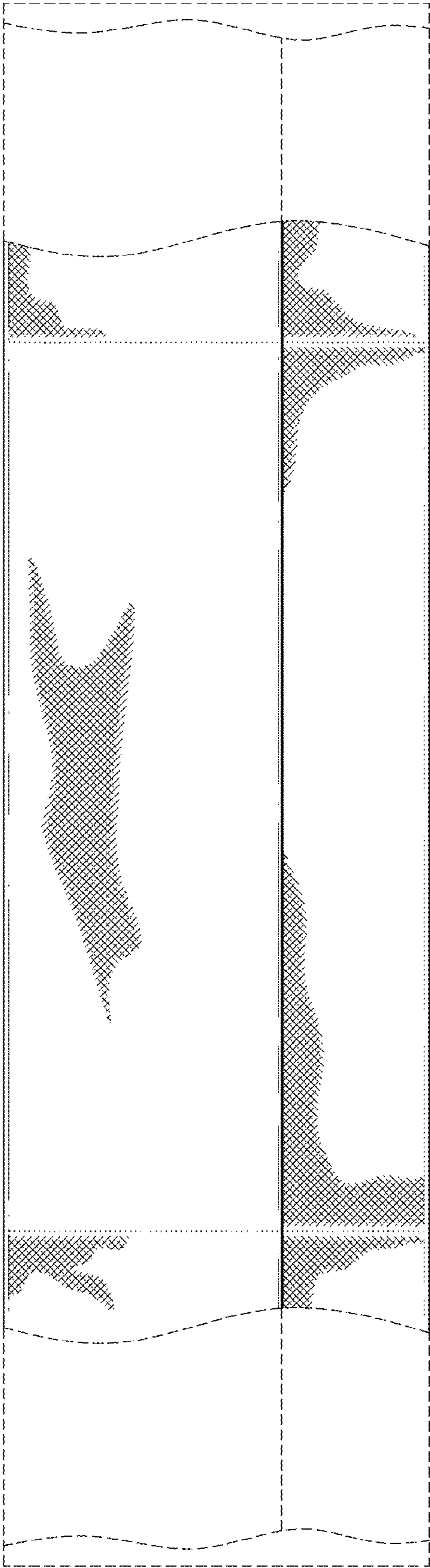

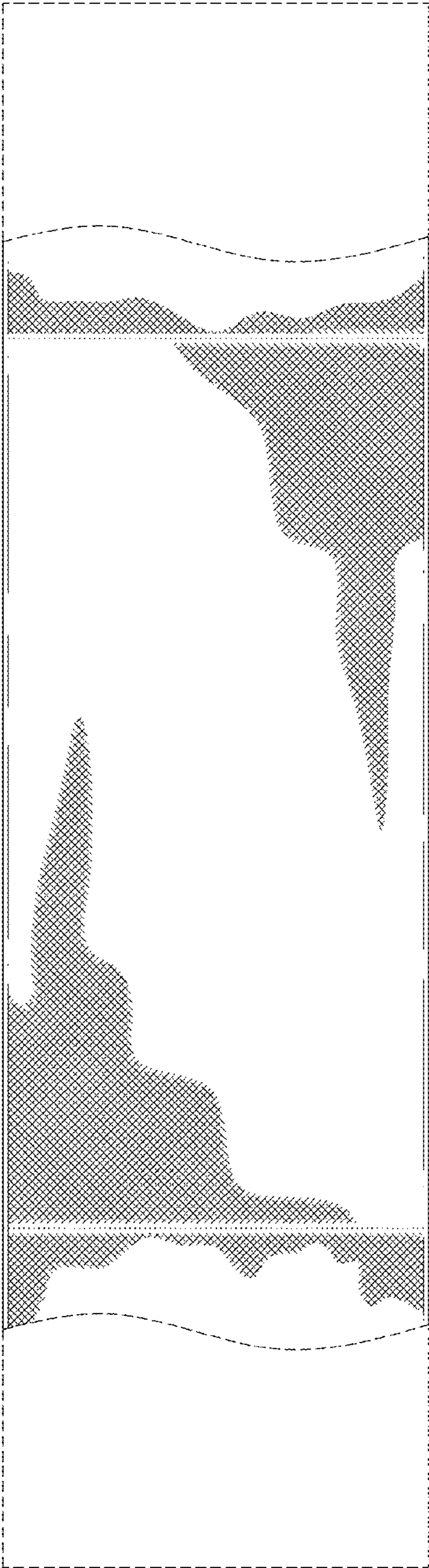

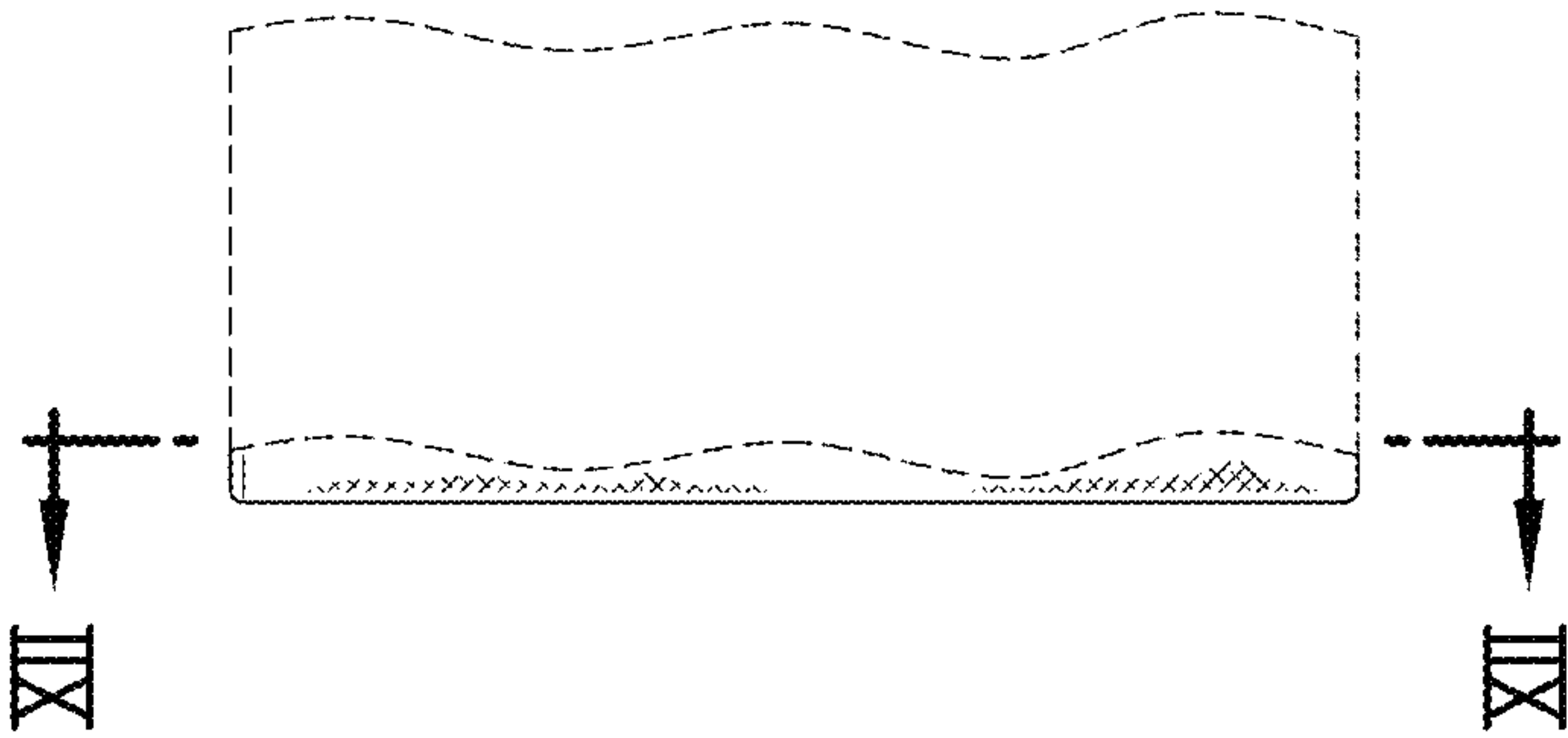

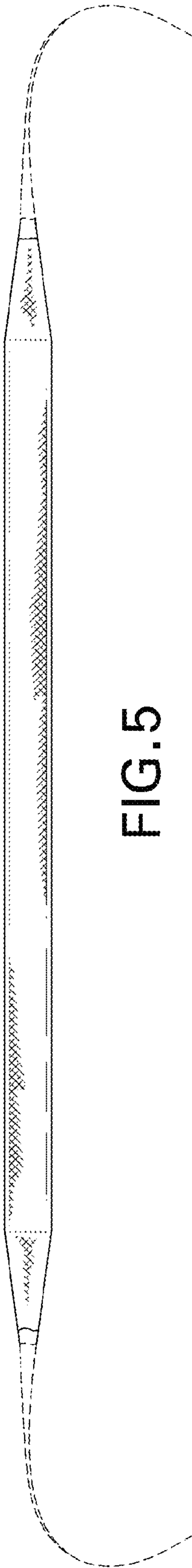

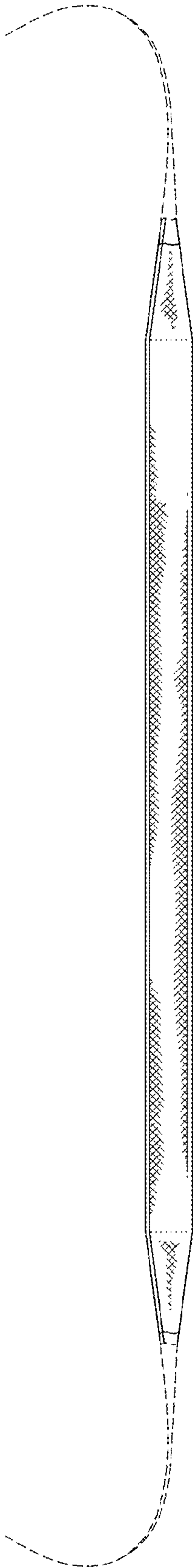

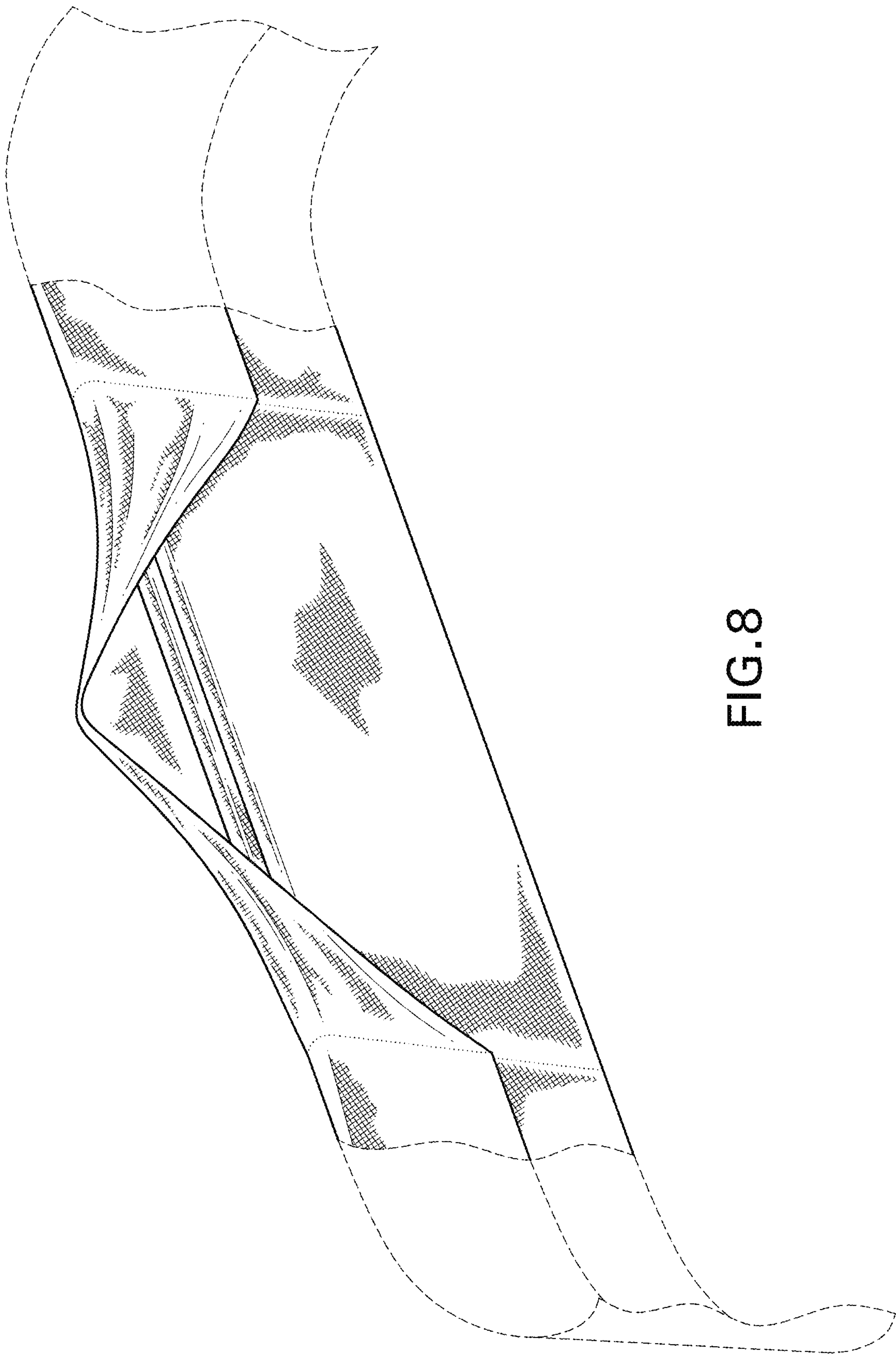

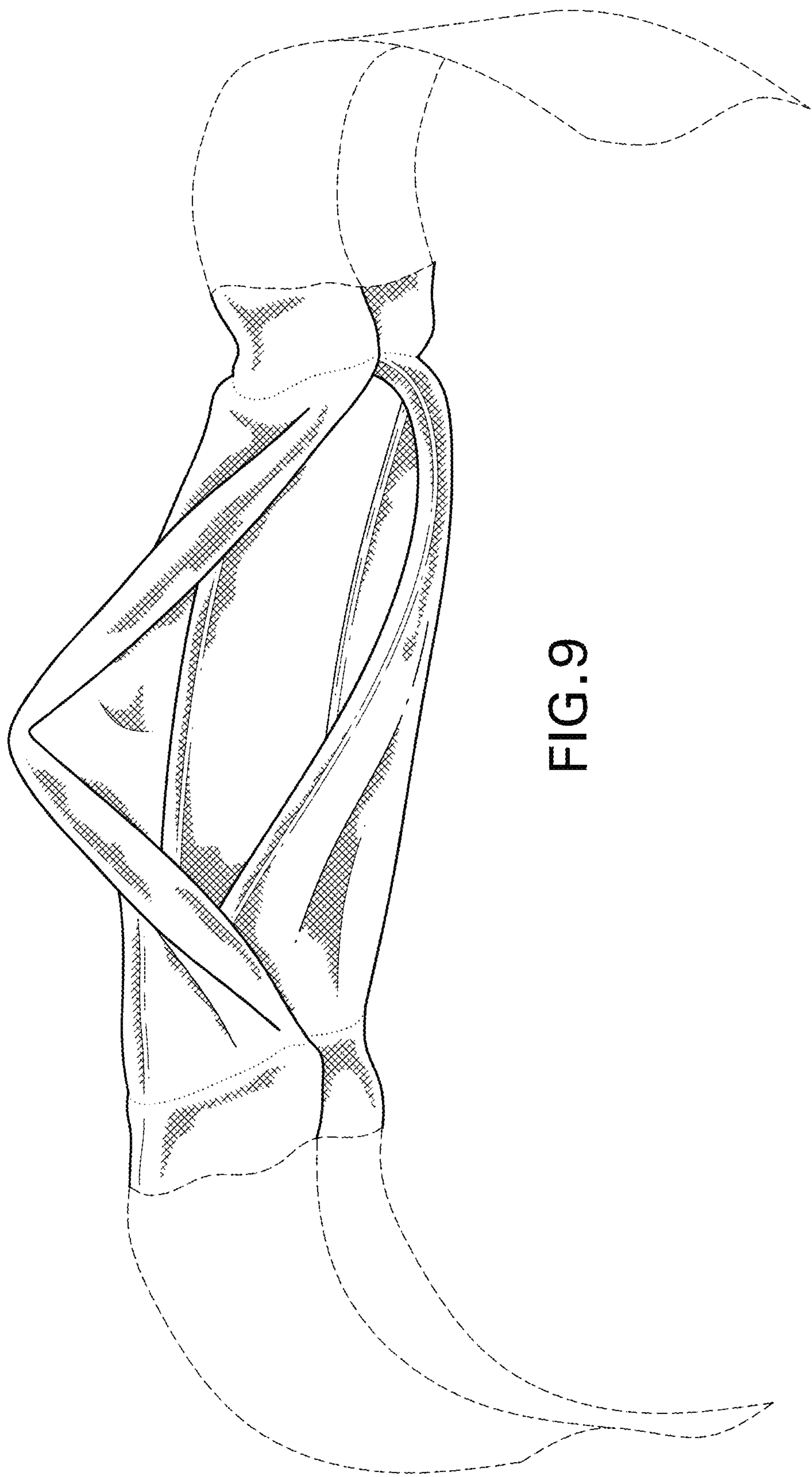

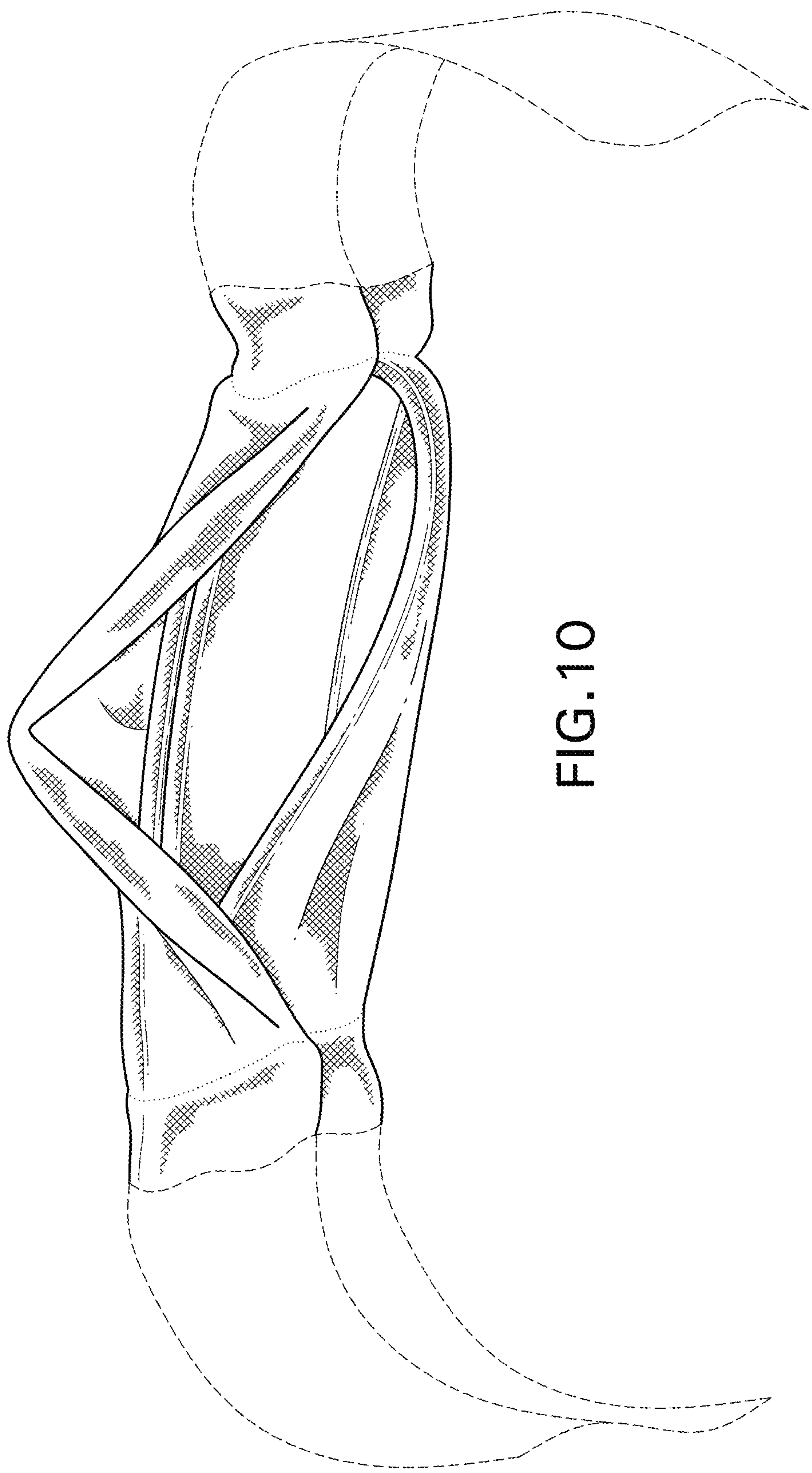

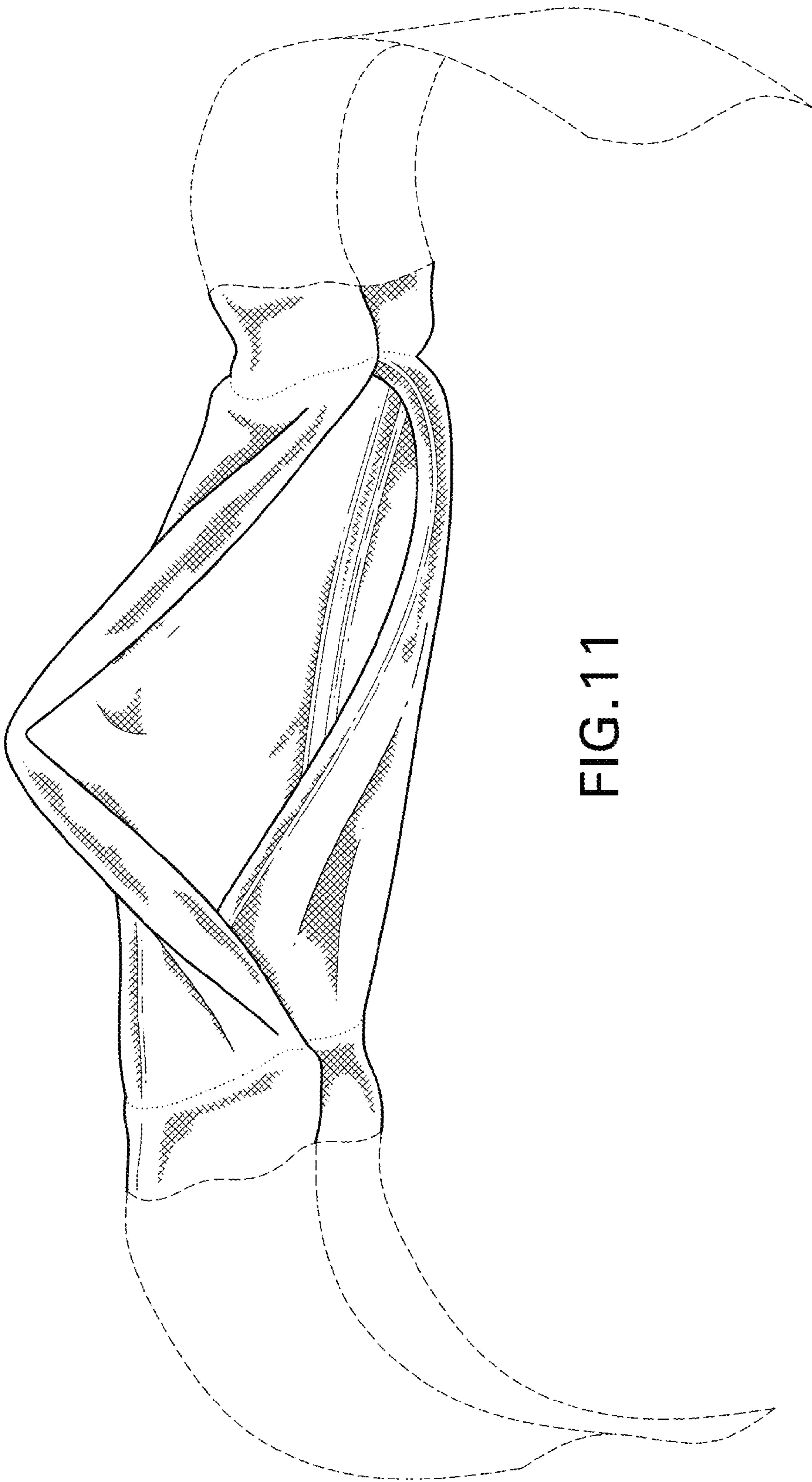

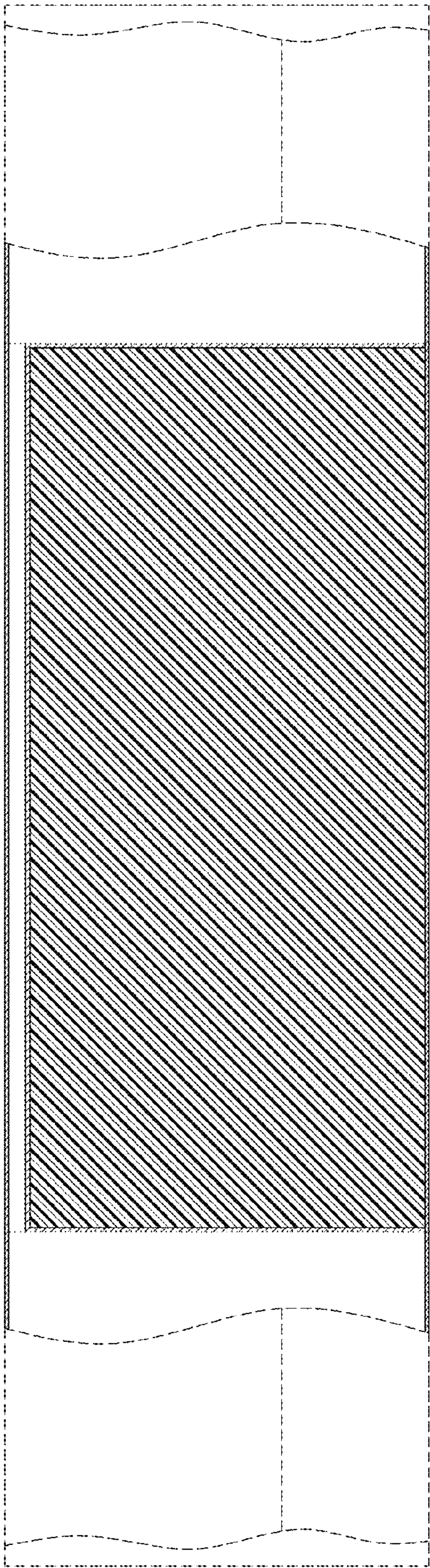
