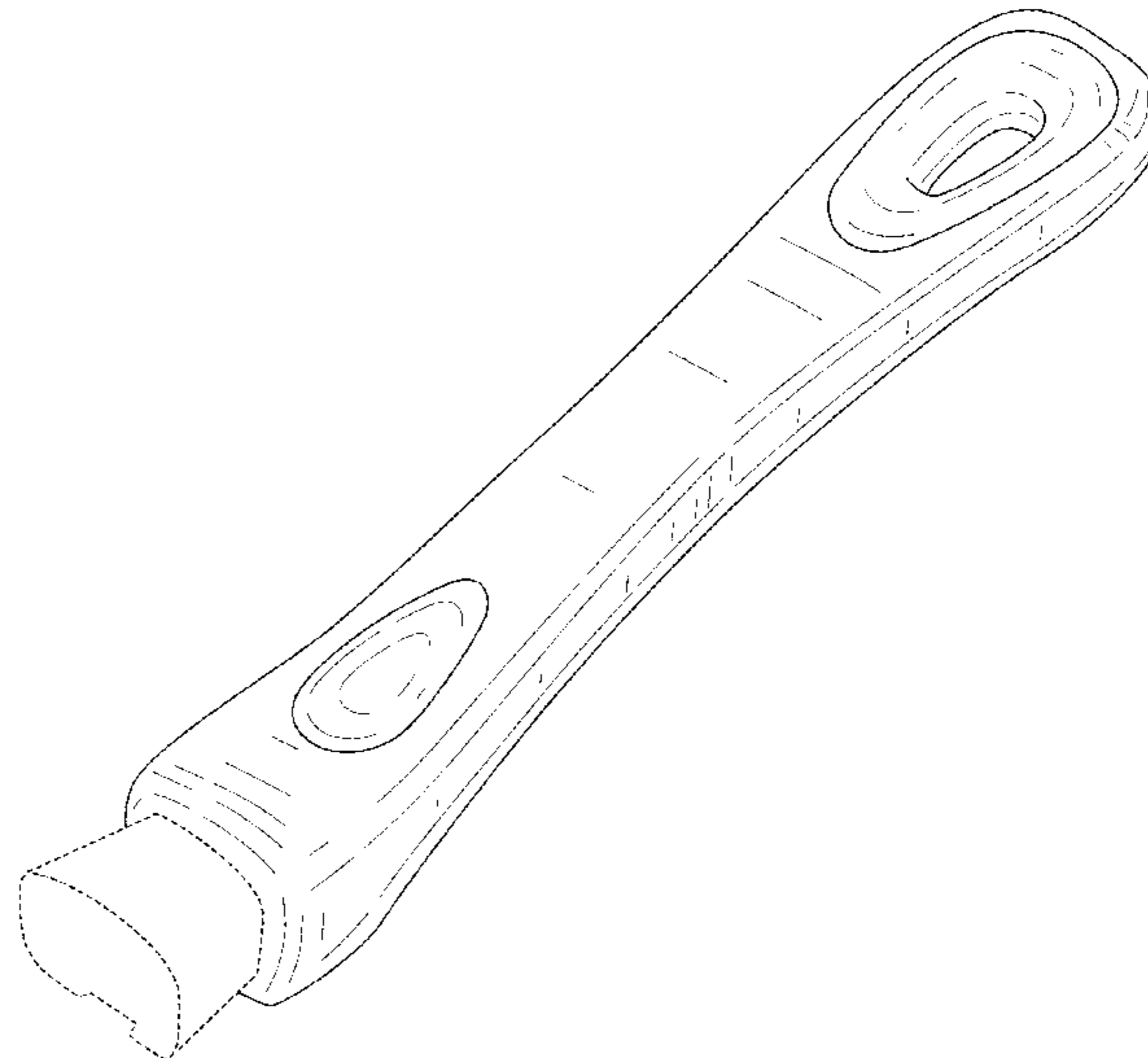
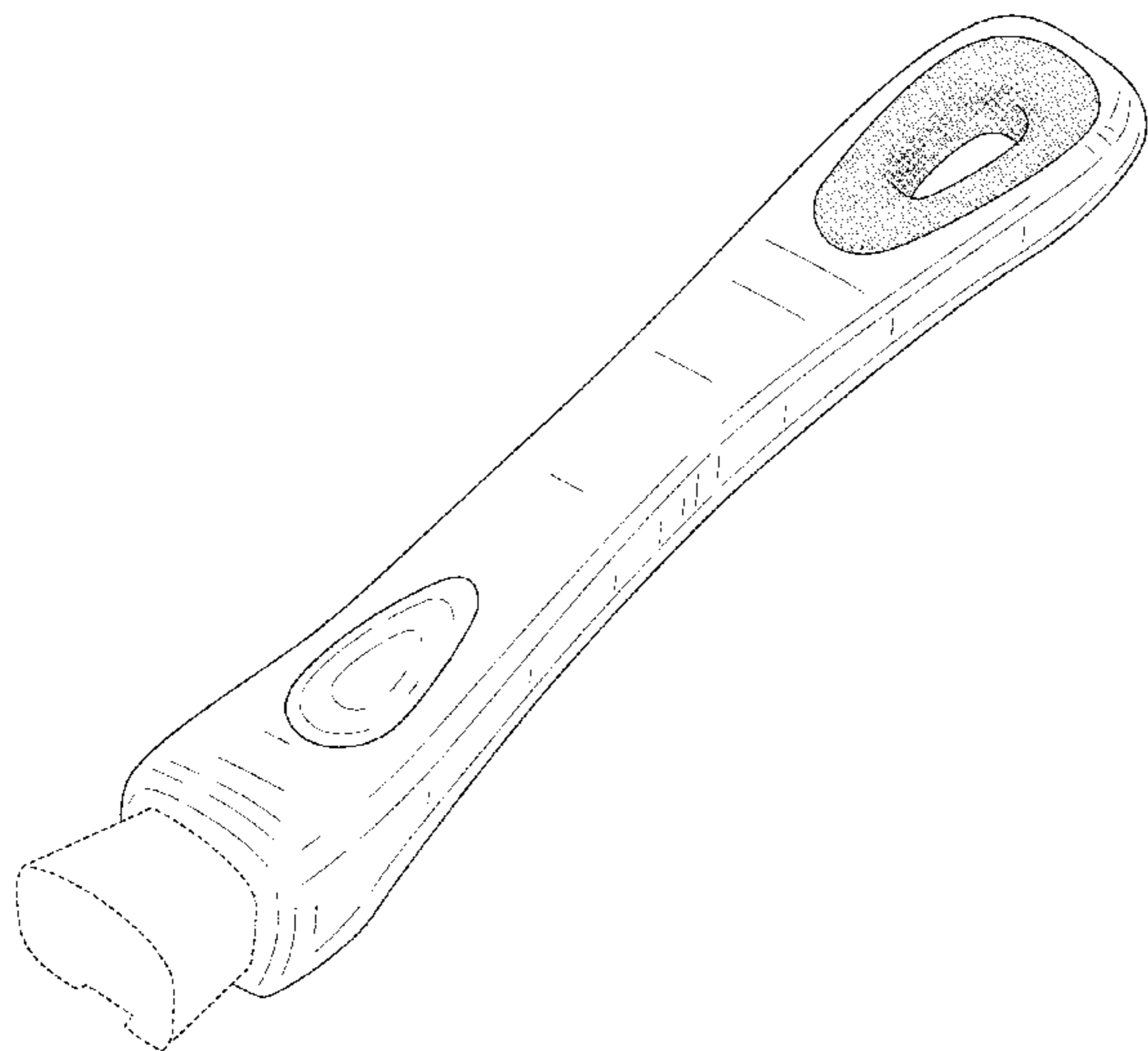
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an elongated cookware handle, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment an “elongated cookware handle” showing my new design;  
 FIG. 2 is a right side elevation view thereof; the left side elevation view being the mirror image thereof,  
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;  
 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
 FIG. 5 is a front elevation view thereof;  
 FIG. 6 is a rear elevation view thereof;  
 FIG. 7 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of my new design;  
 FIG. 8 is a right side elevation view thereof; the left side elevation view being the mirror image thereof,  
 FIG. 9 is a top plan view thereof;  
 FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
 FIG. 11 is a front elevation view thereof; and,  
 FIG. 12 is a rear elevation view thereof.

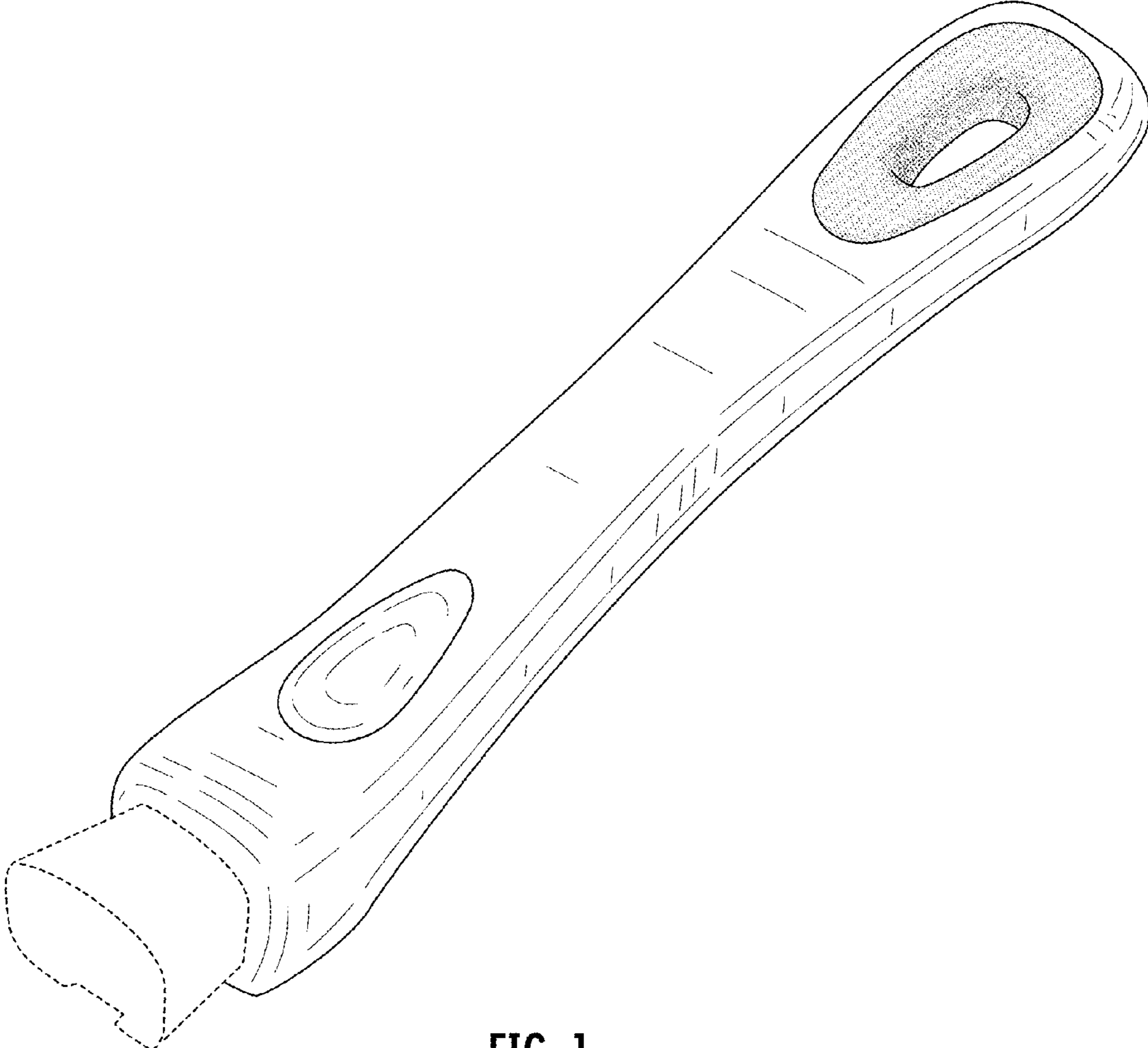

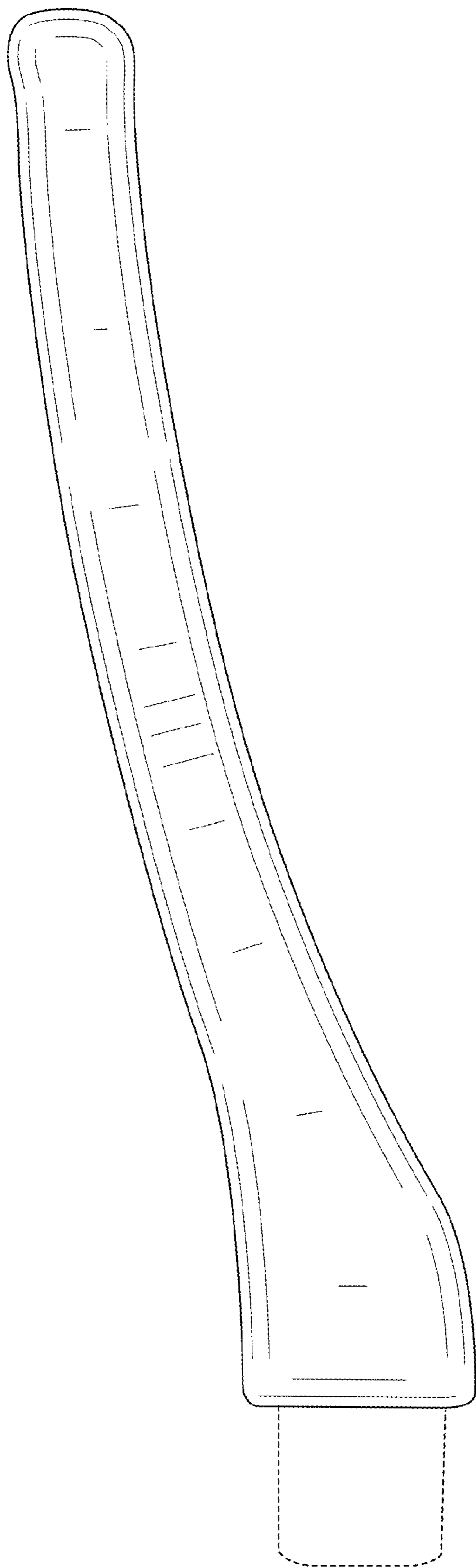

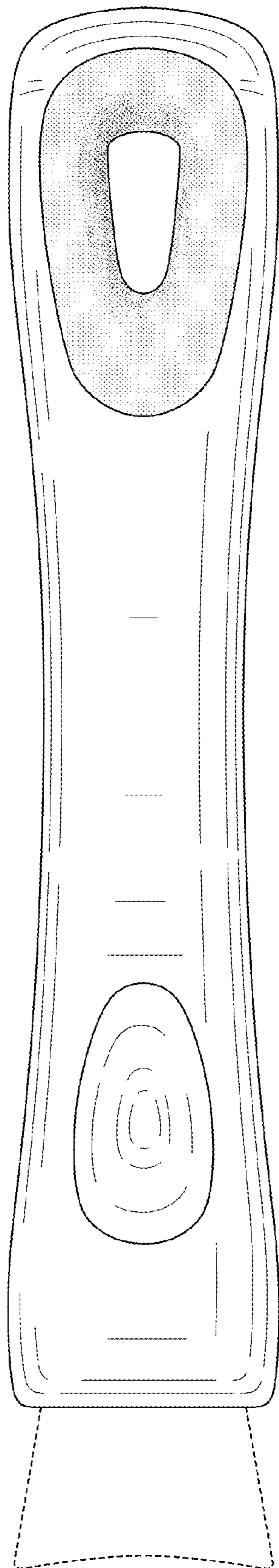

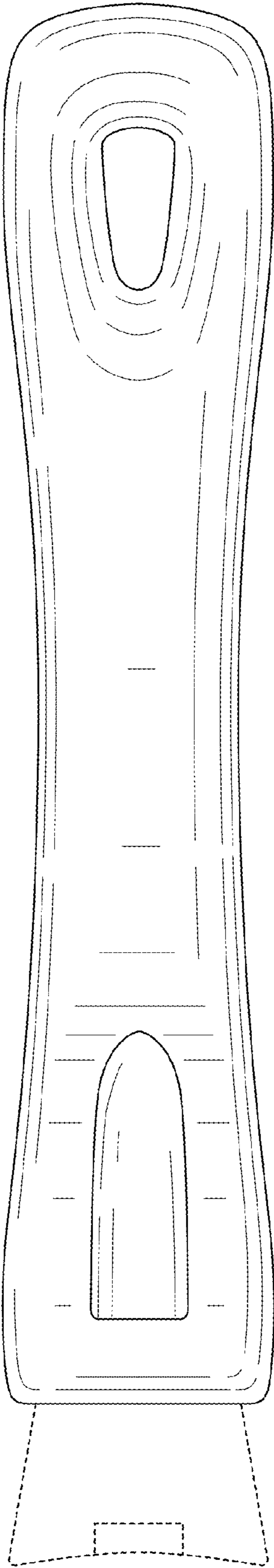

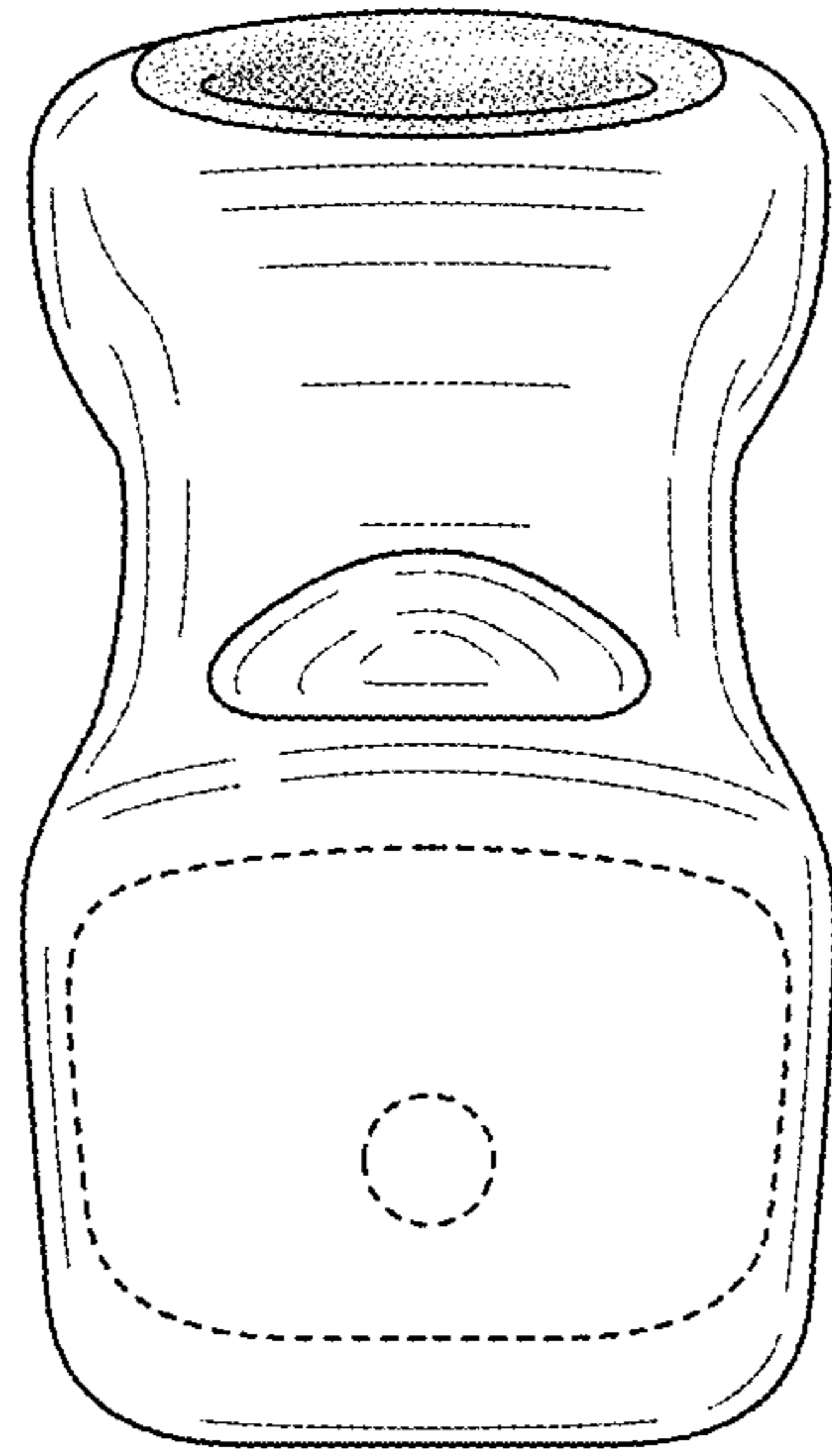

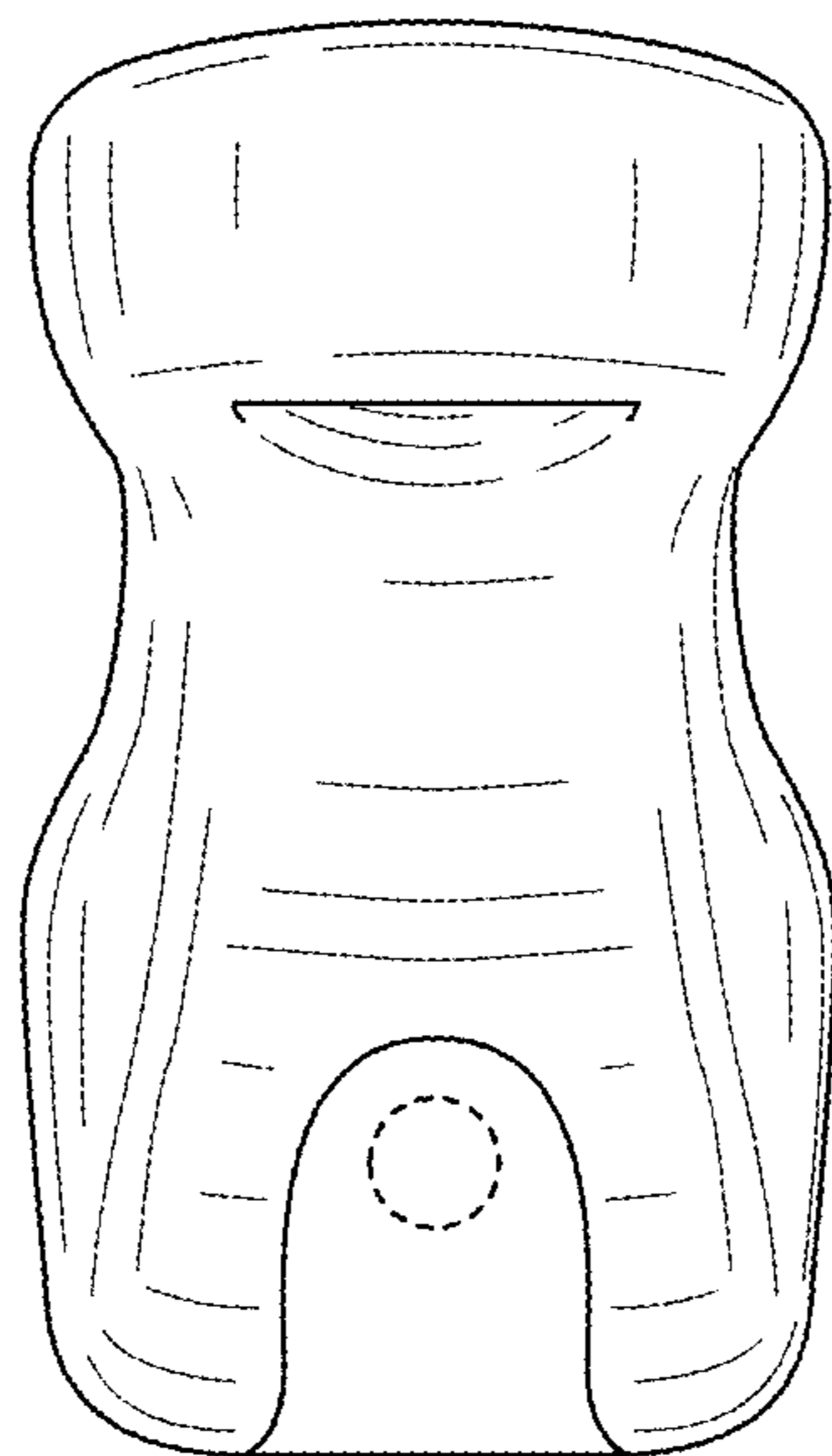

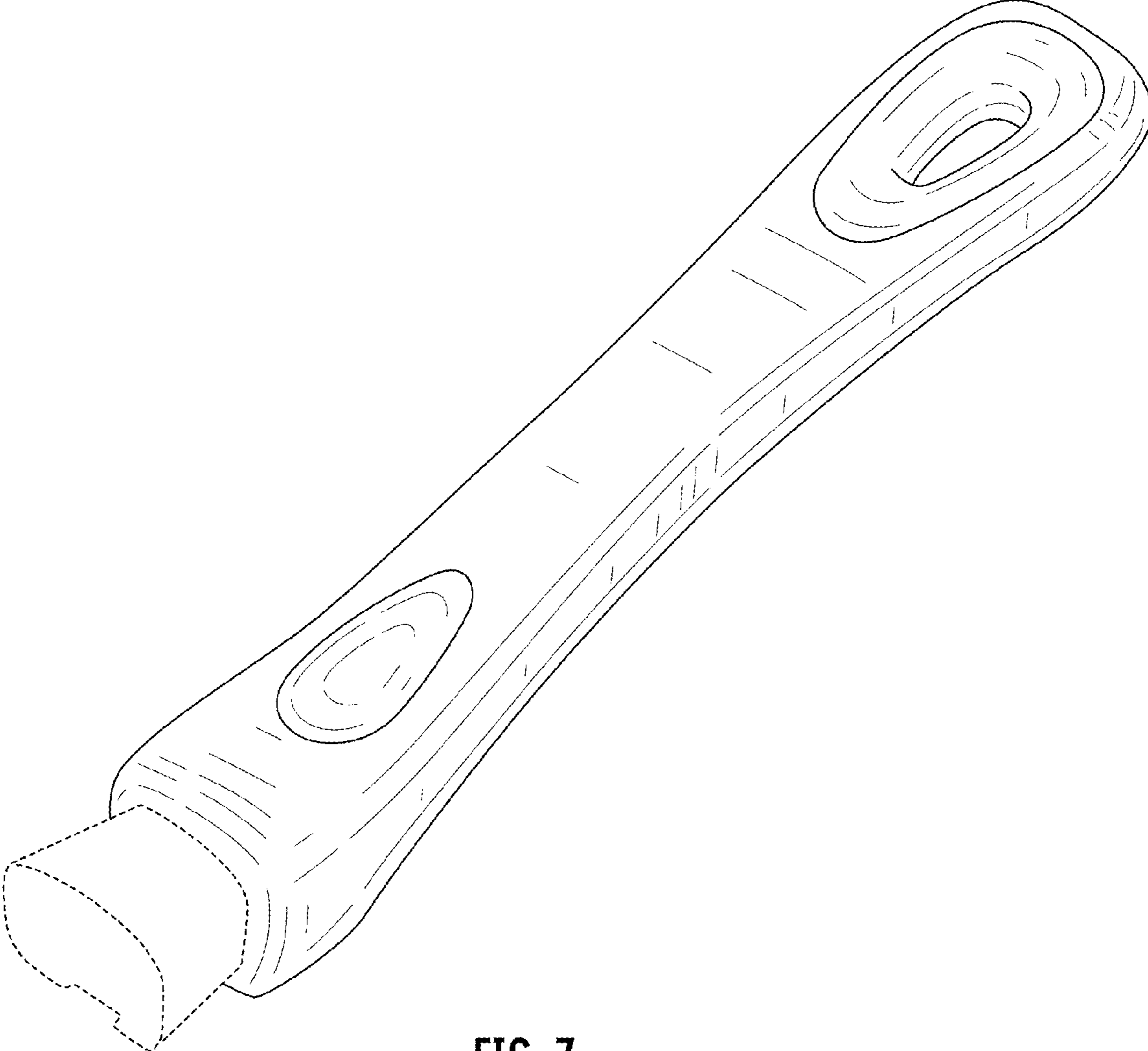

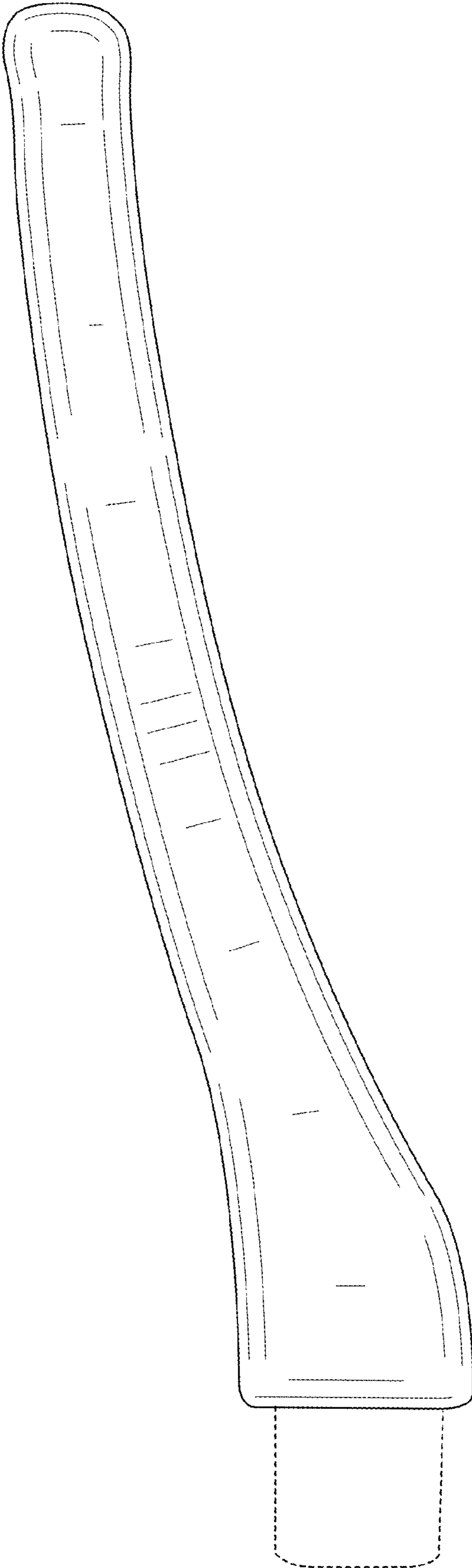

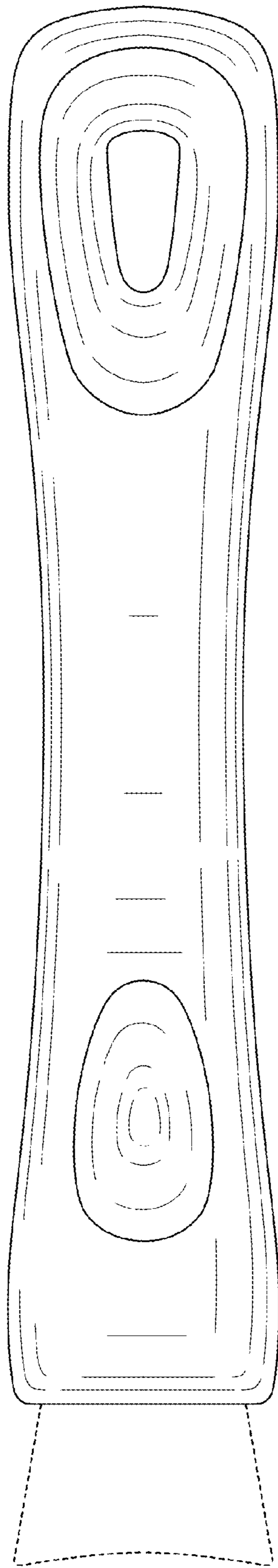

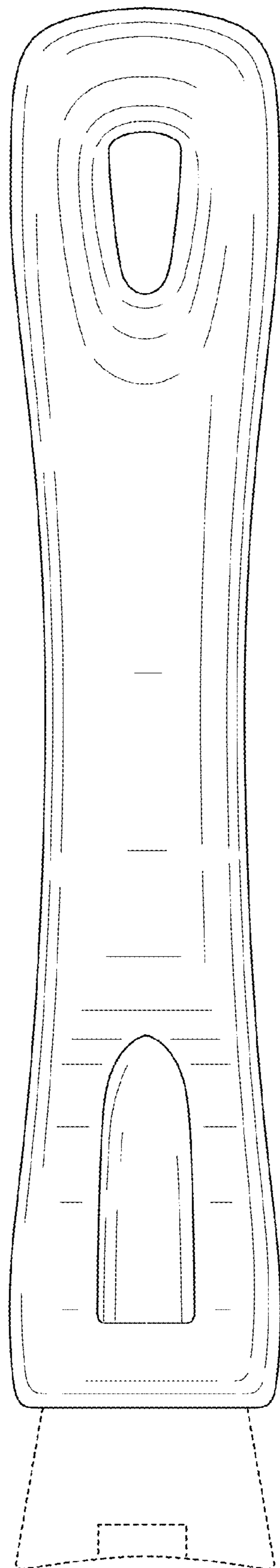

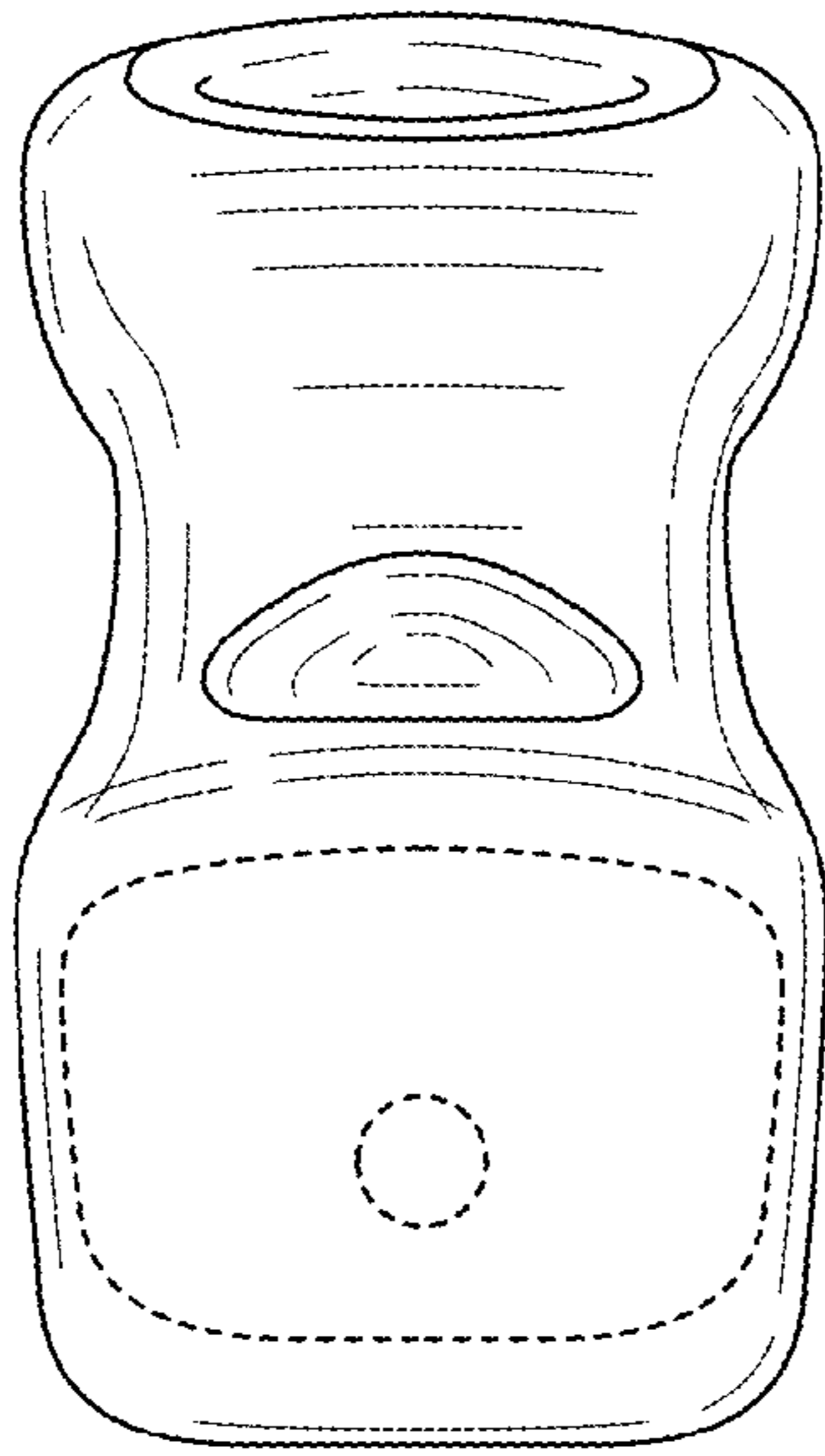

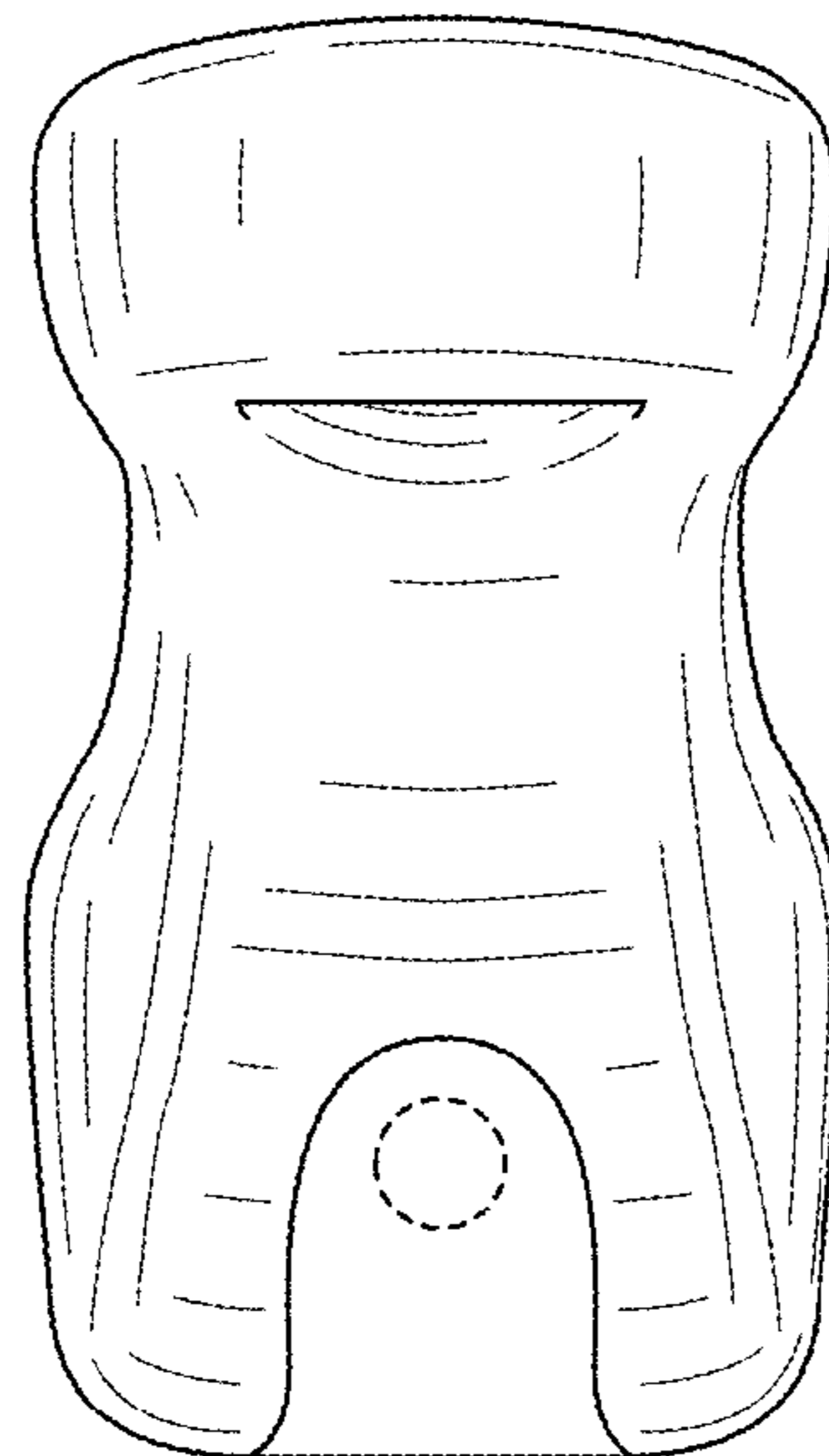
