(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a tomato knife, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a tomato knife, showing my new design.

FIG. 2 is a top view of the tomato knife.

FIG. 3 is a front view of the tomato knife.

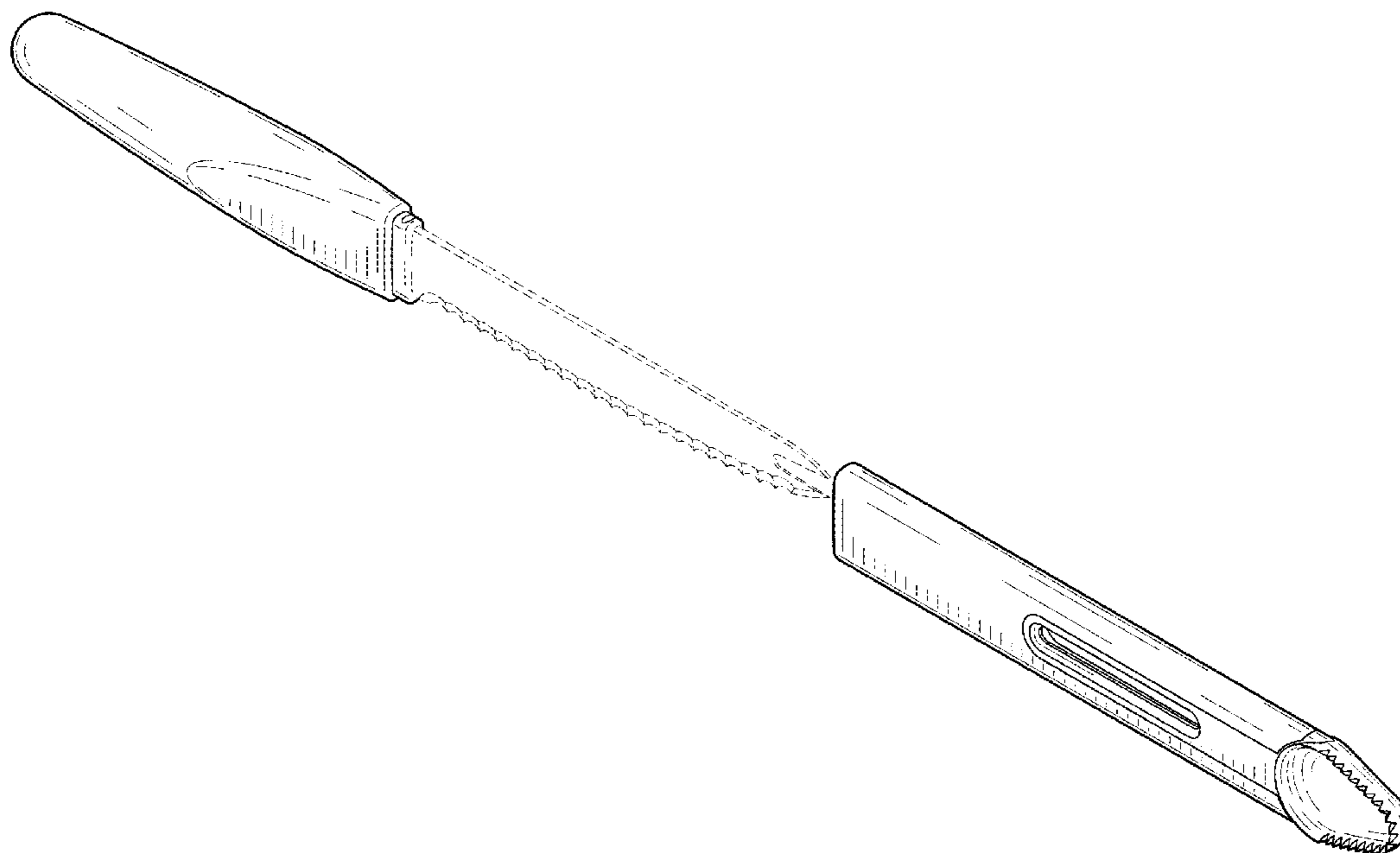
FIG. 4 is a back view of the tomato knife.

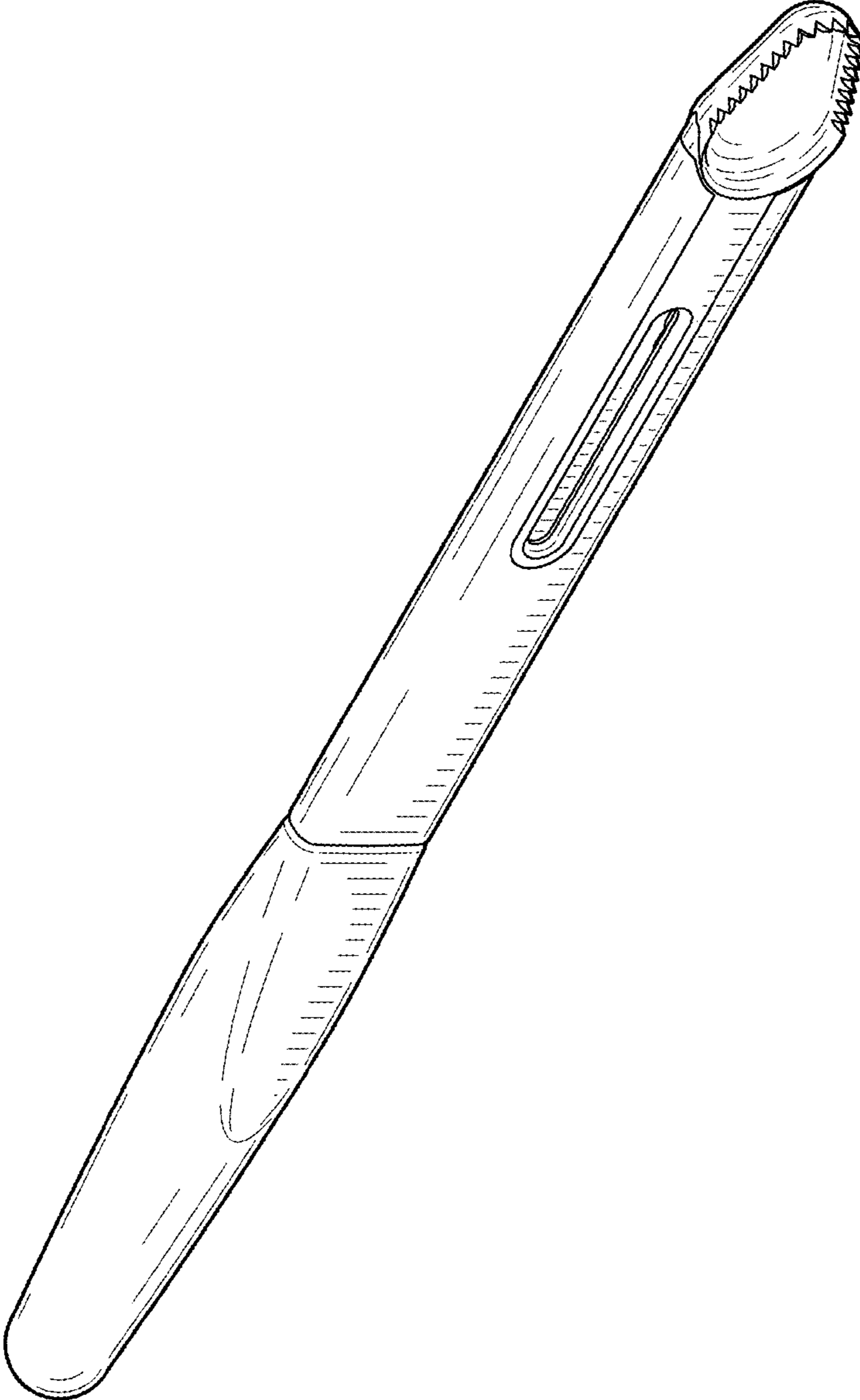

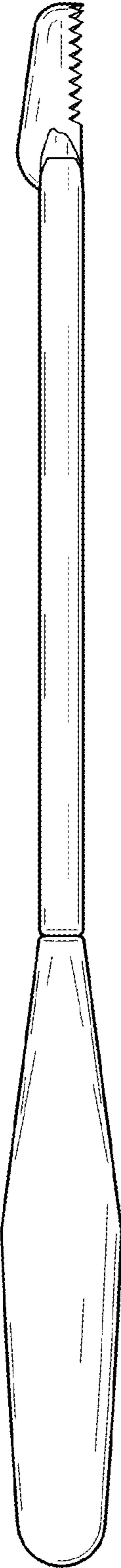

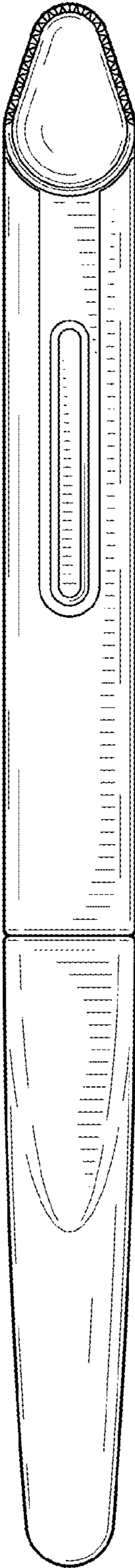

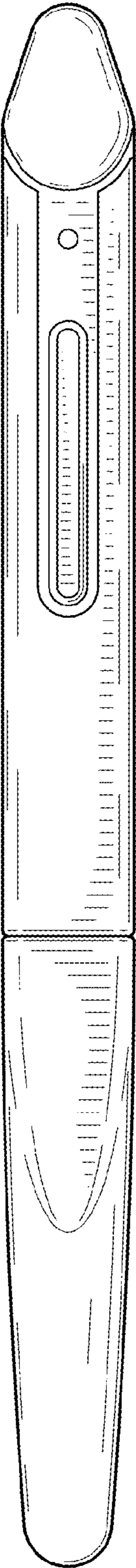

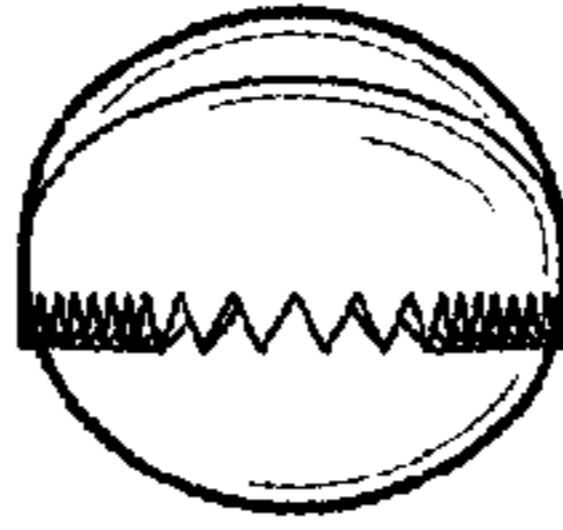

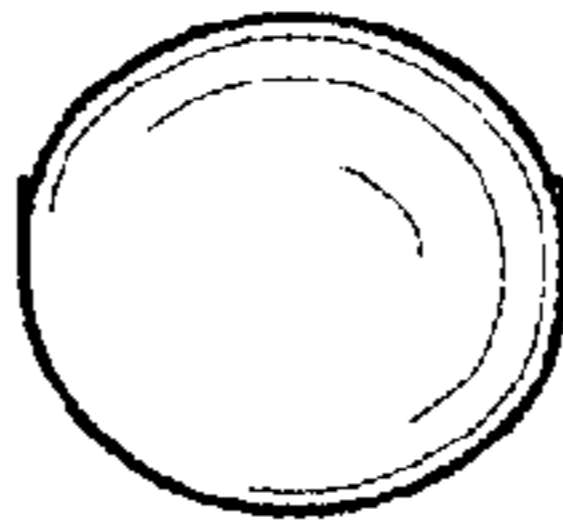

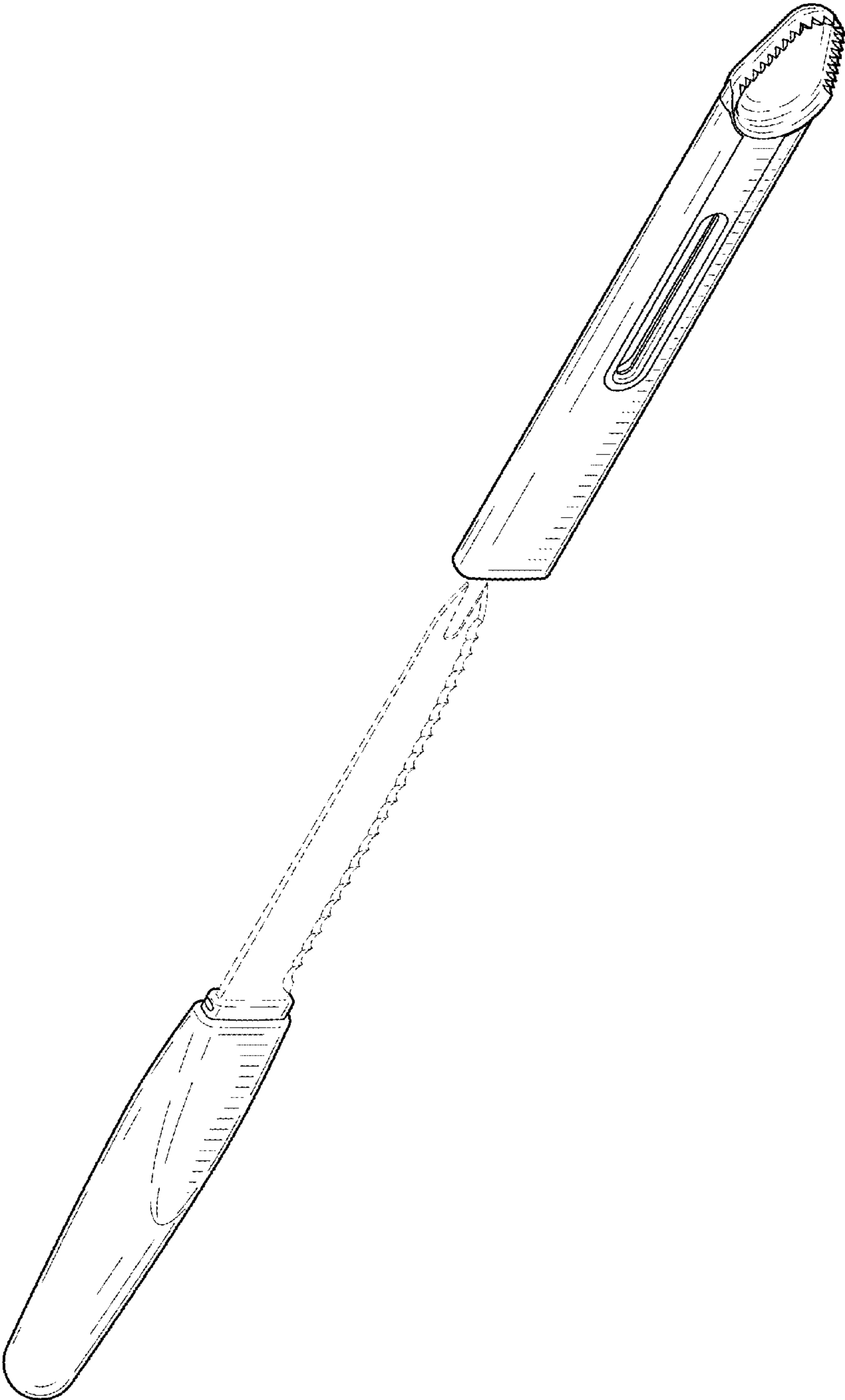
