FIG. 4 is a side elevational view of FIG. 1 showing the opposite side of FIG. 3;

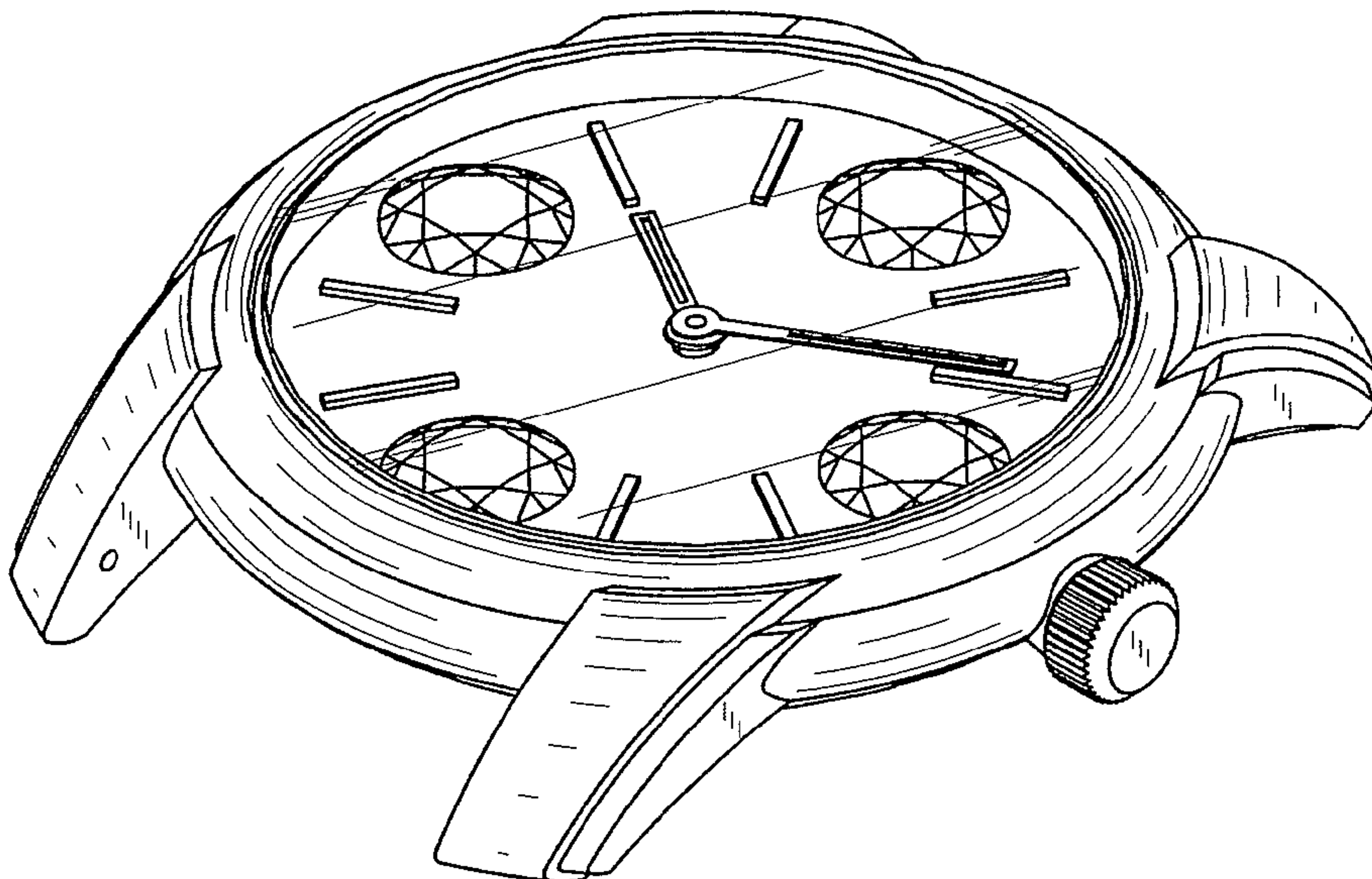
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view of FIG. 1 showing the stem;

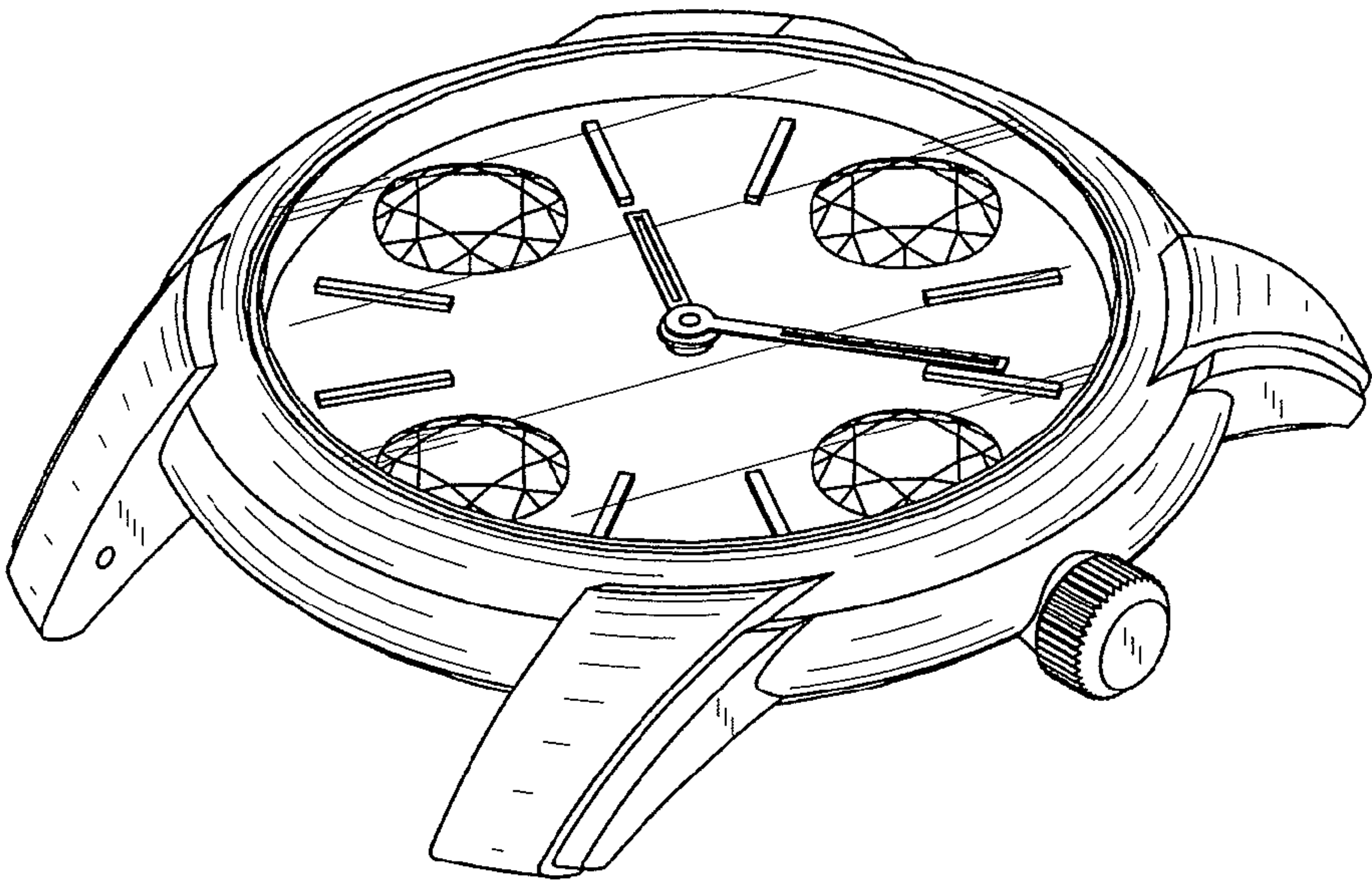

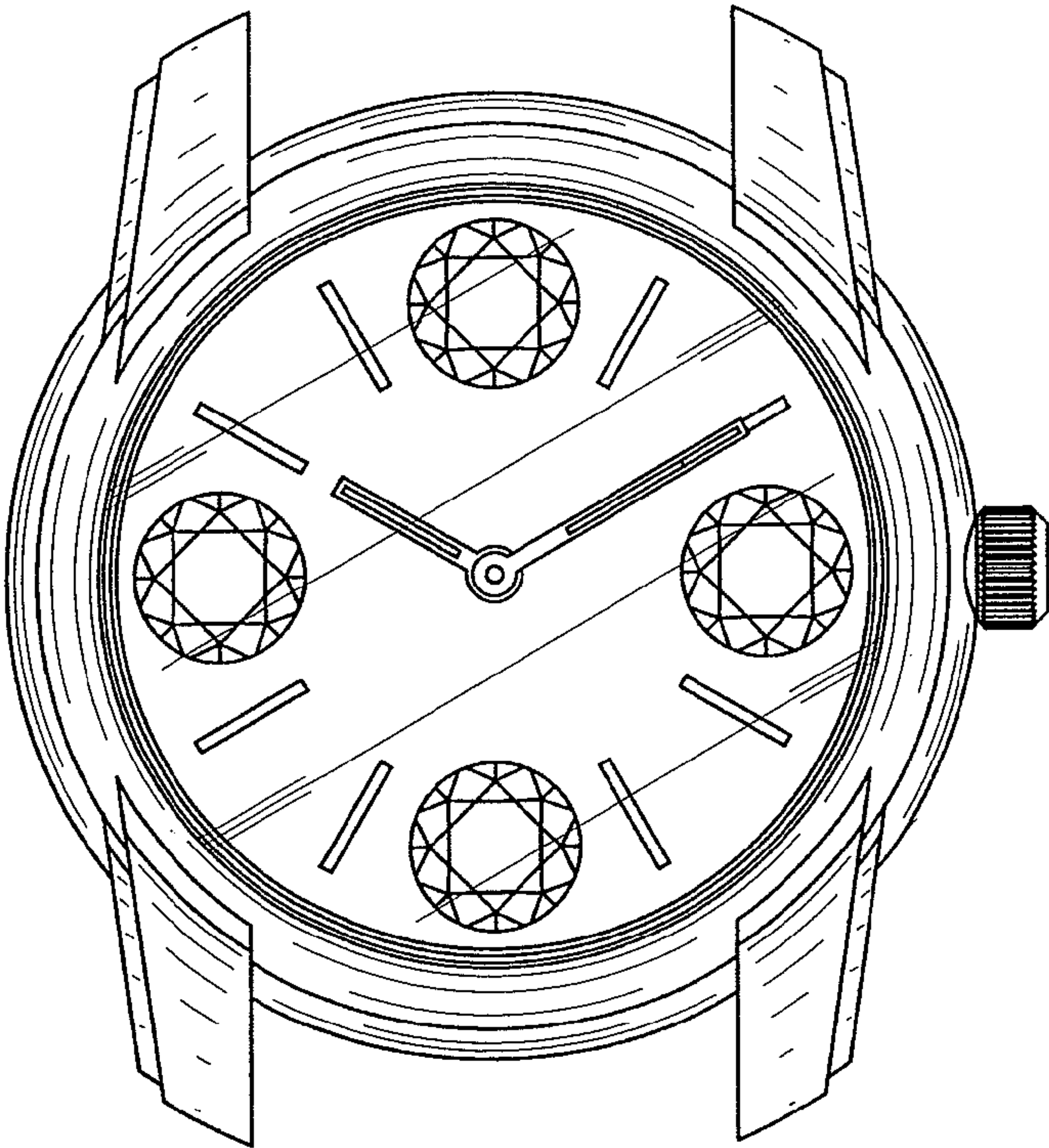

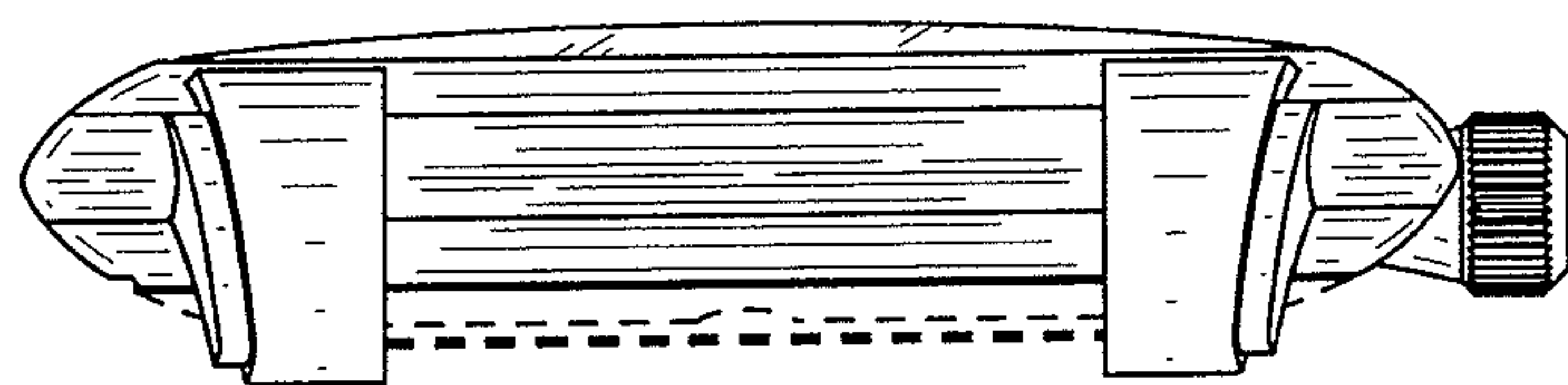

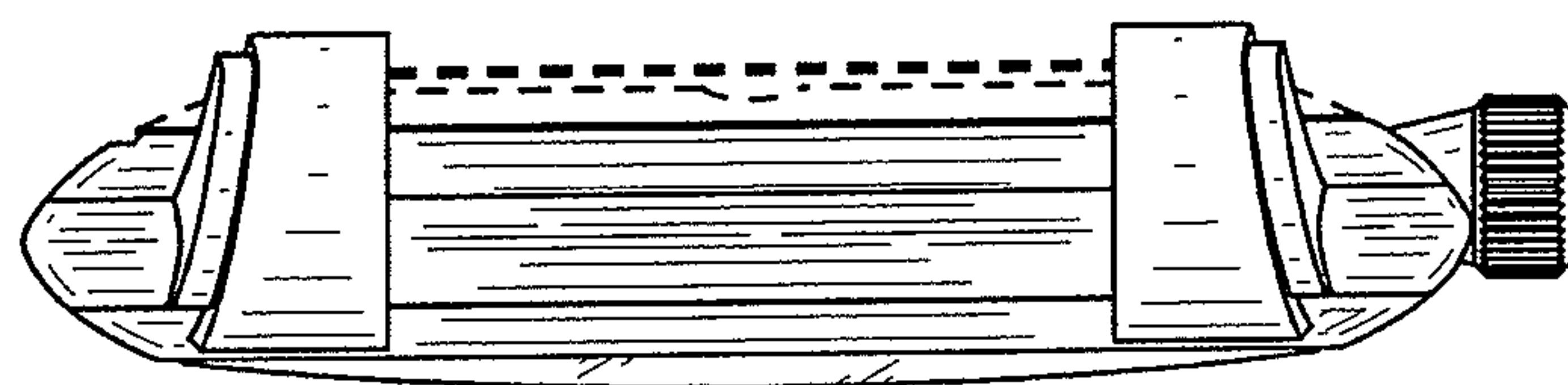

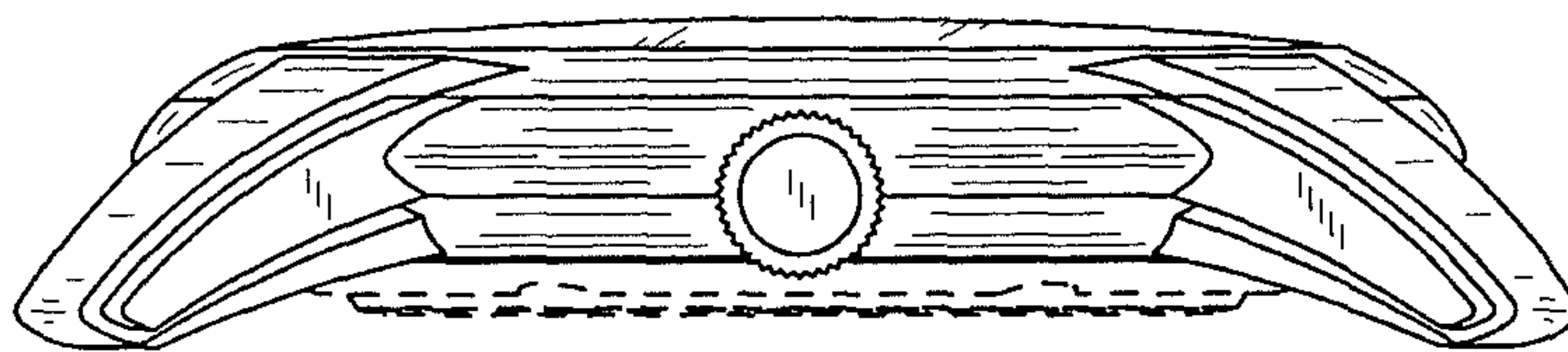

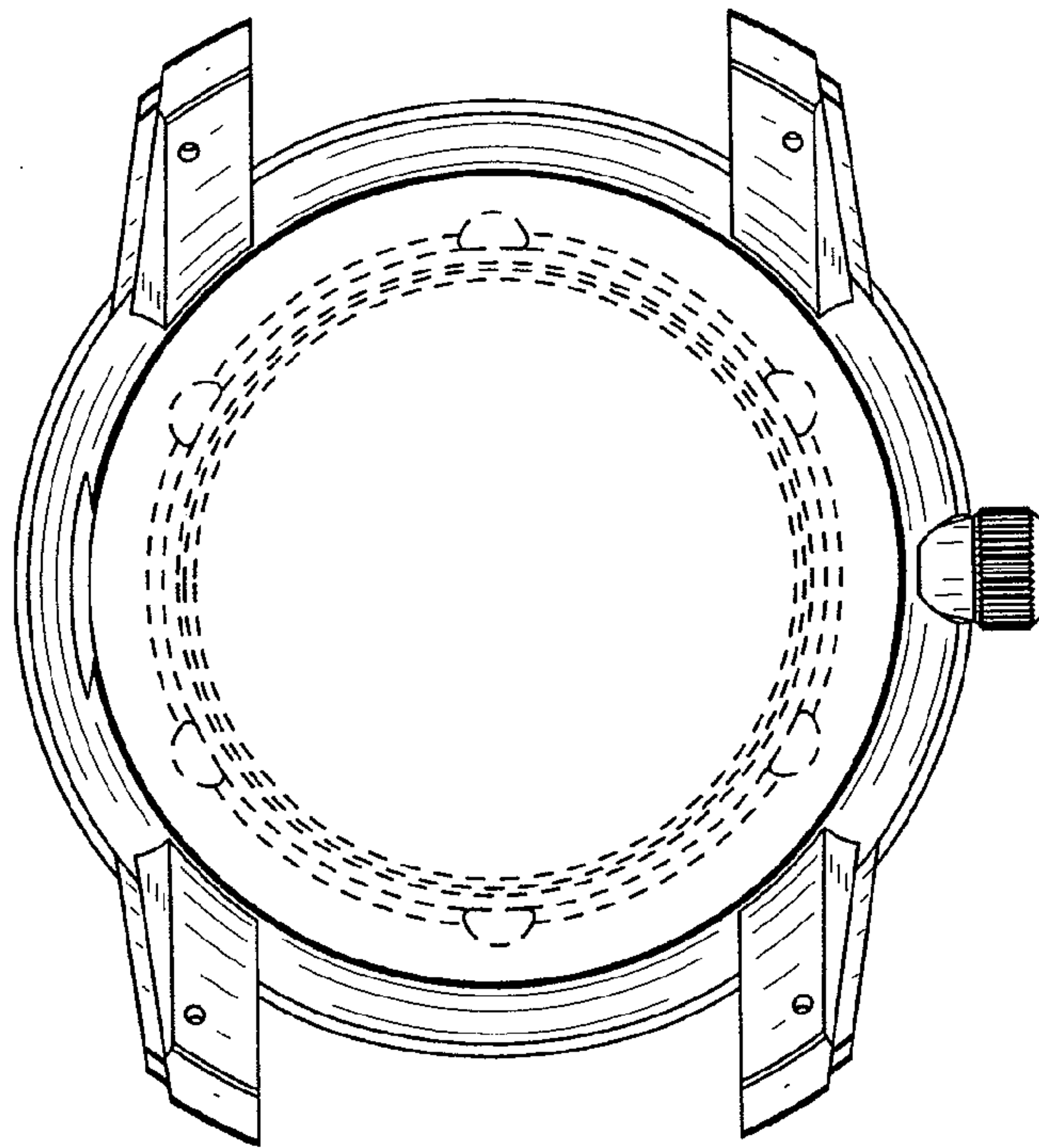
