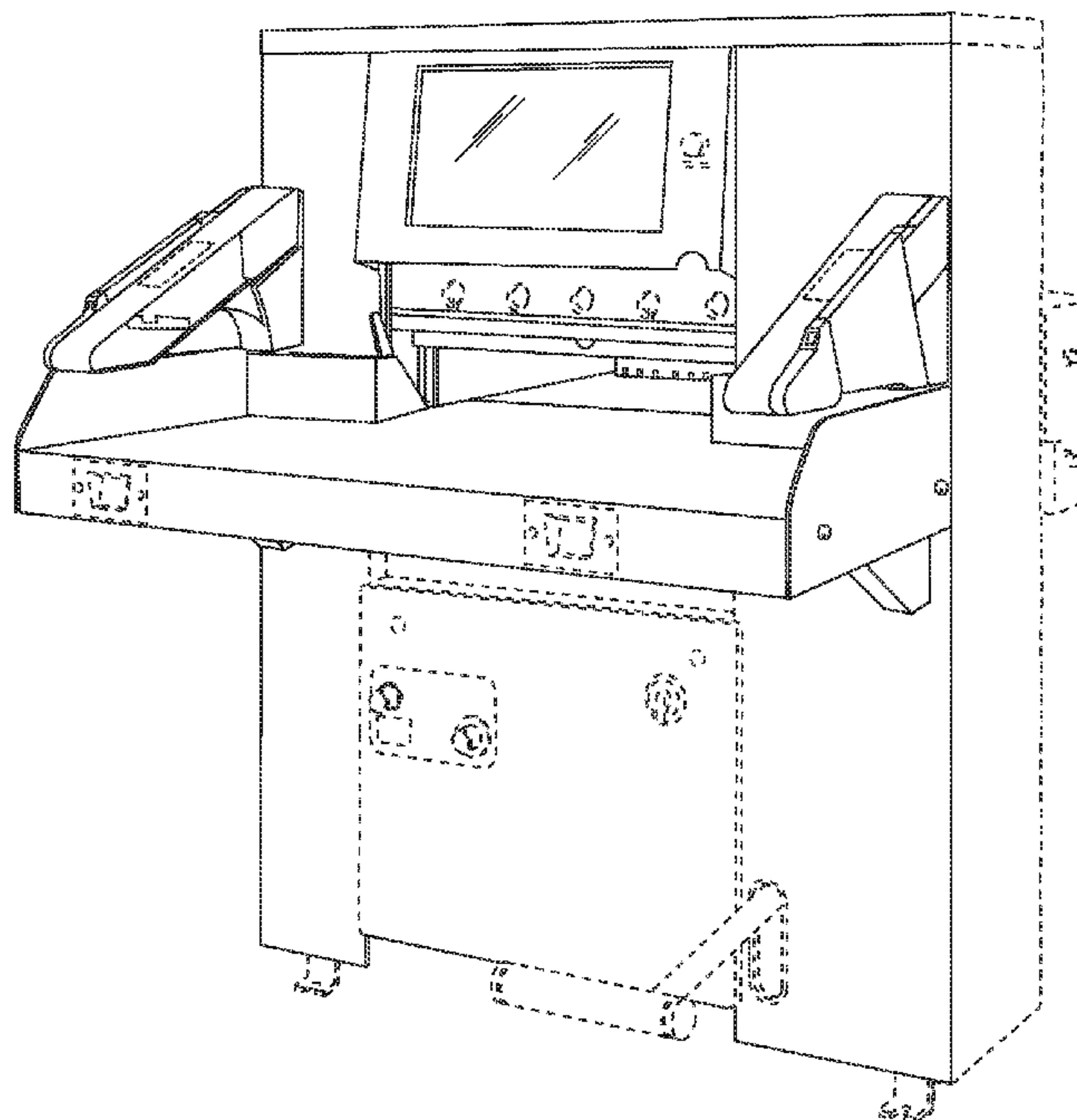
I claim the ornamental design for a guillotine-type cutting machine, as shown and described.

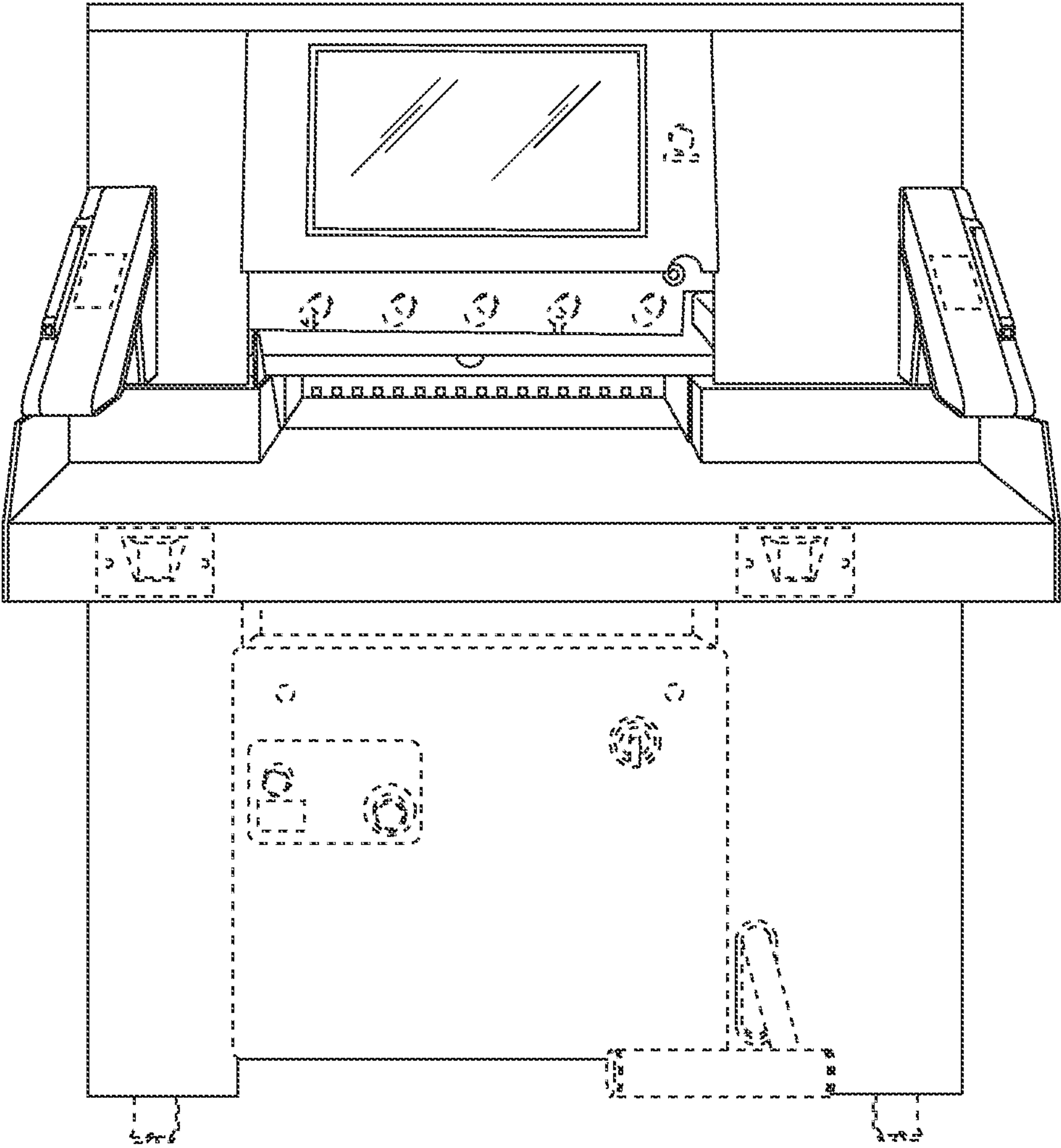

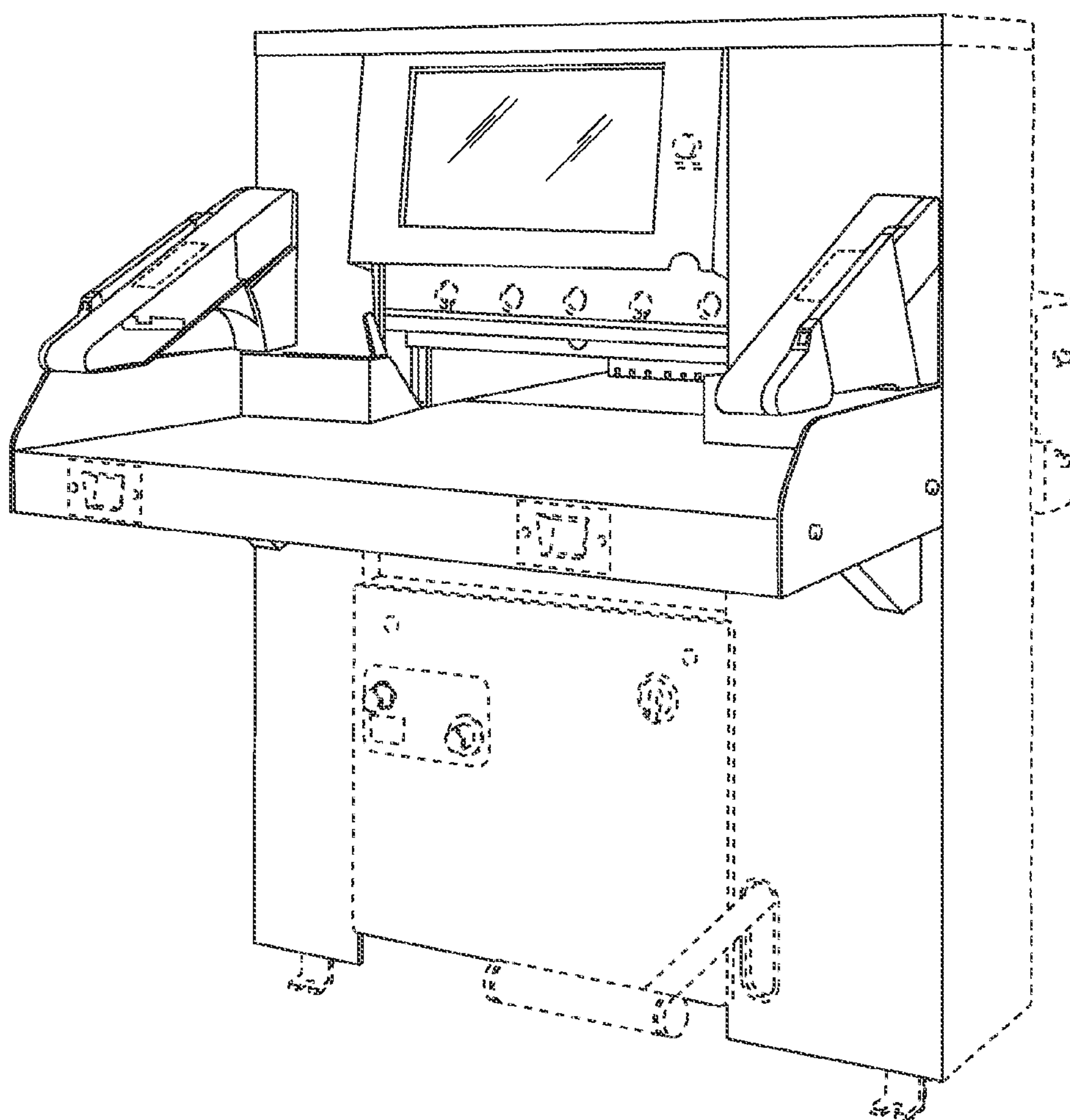
