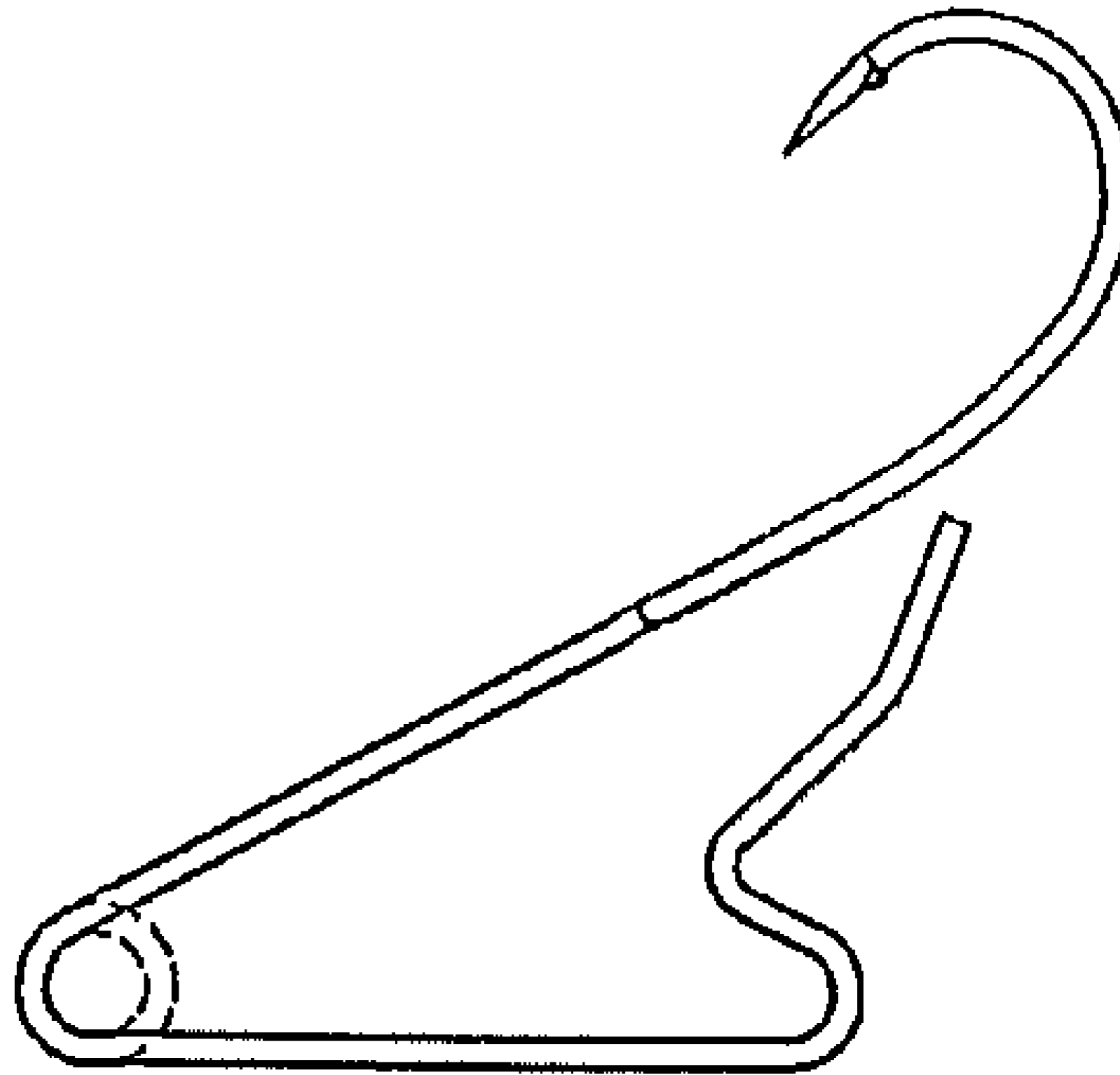
(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a fishing hook, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side view of the fishing hook in an unloaded condition;
FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the fishing hook in the unloaded condition;
FIG. 3 is a top view of the fishing hook in a spring-loaded condition;
FIG. 4 is a perspective view of the fishing hook in the spring-loaded condition; and,
FIG. 5 is a side view of the fishing hook in the spring-loaded condition.

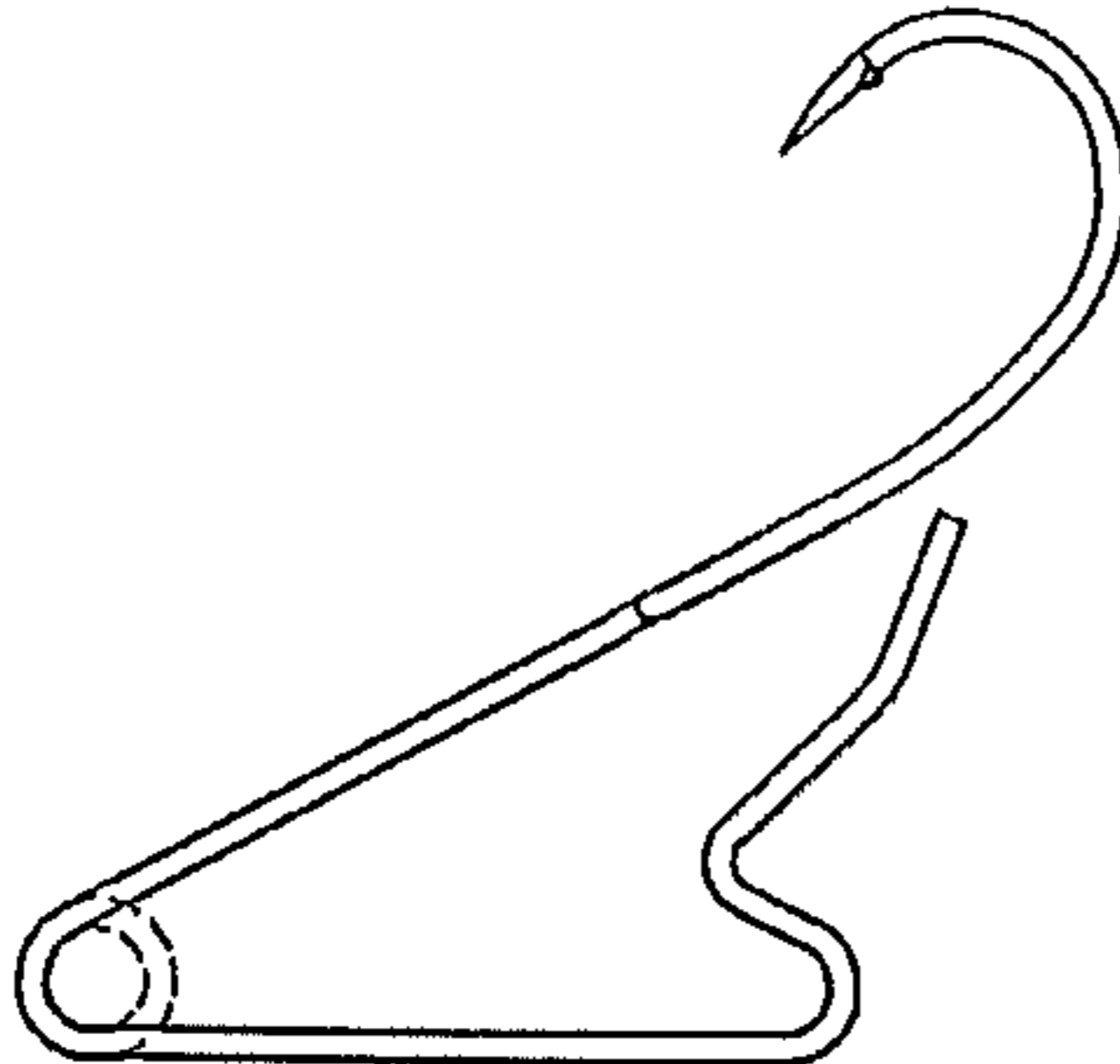

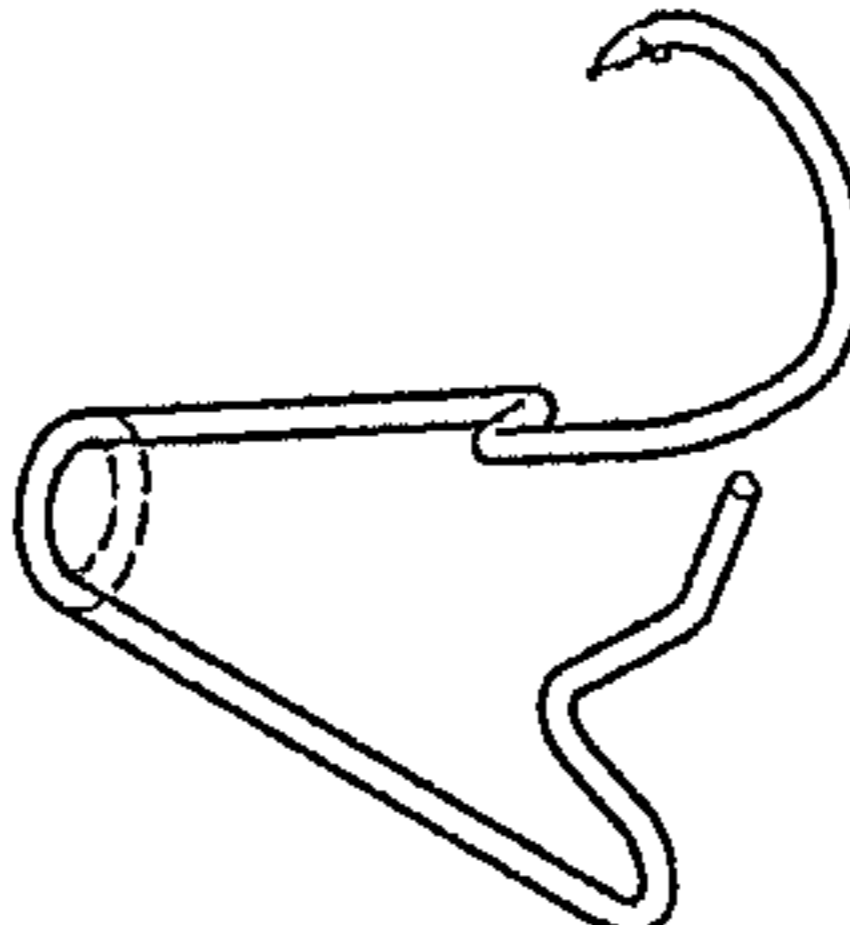

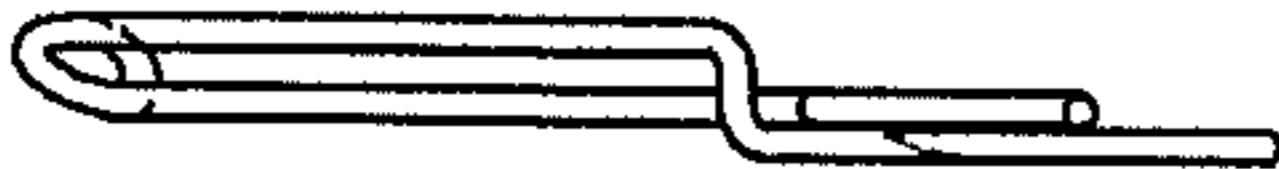

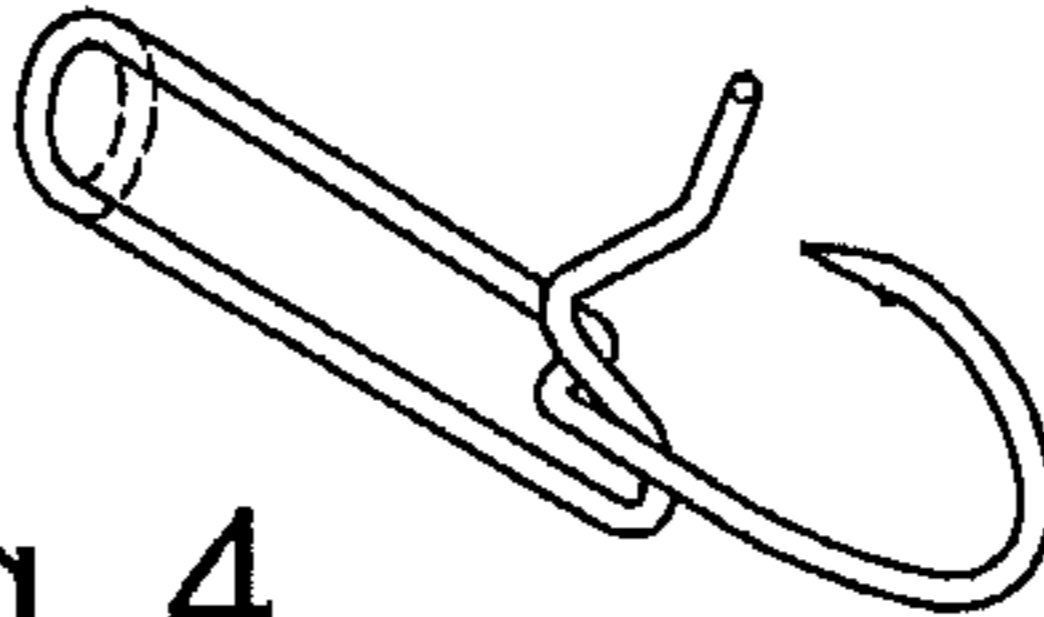

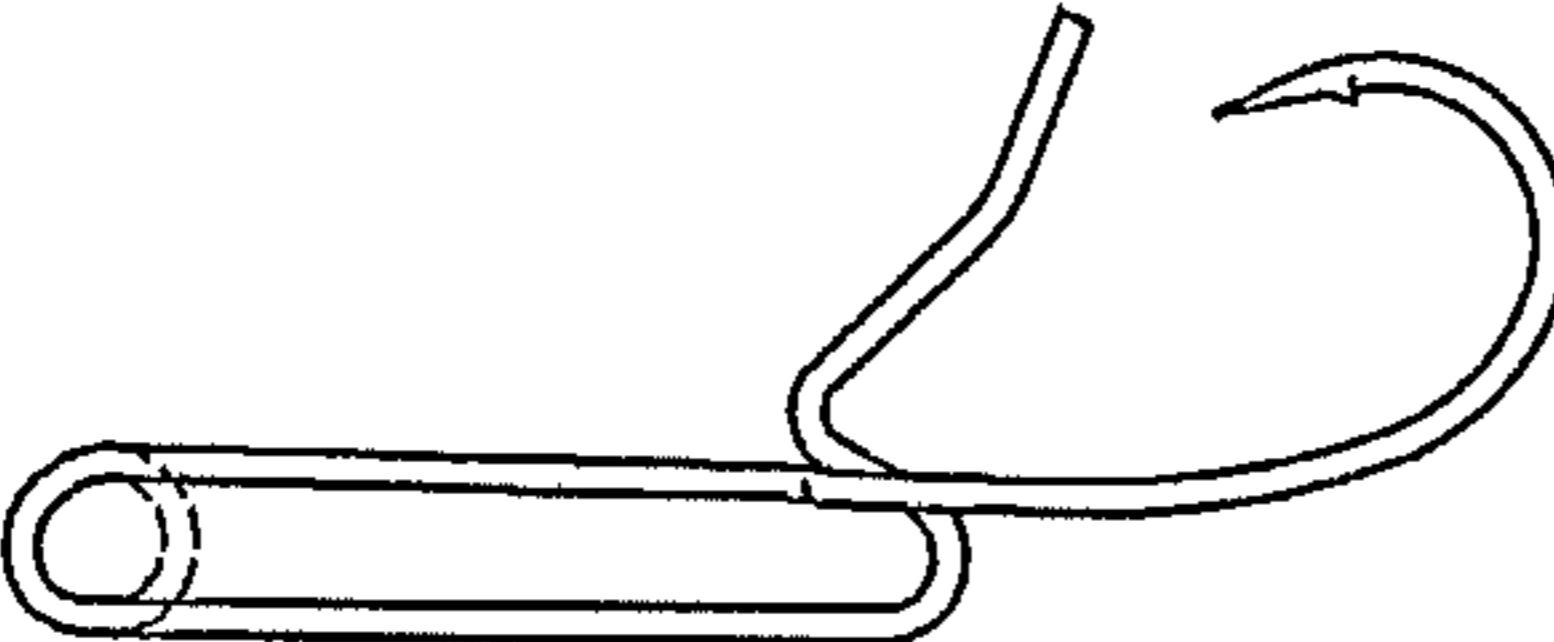
