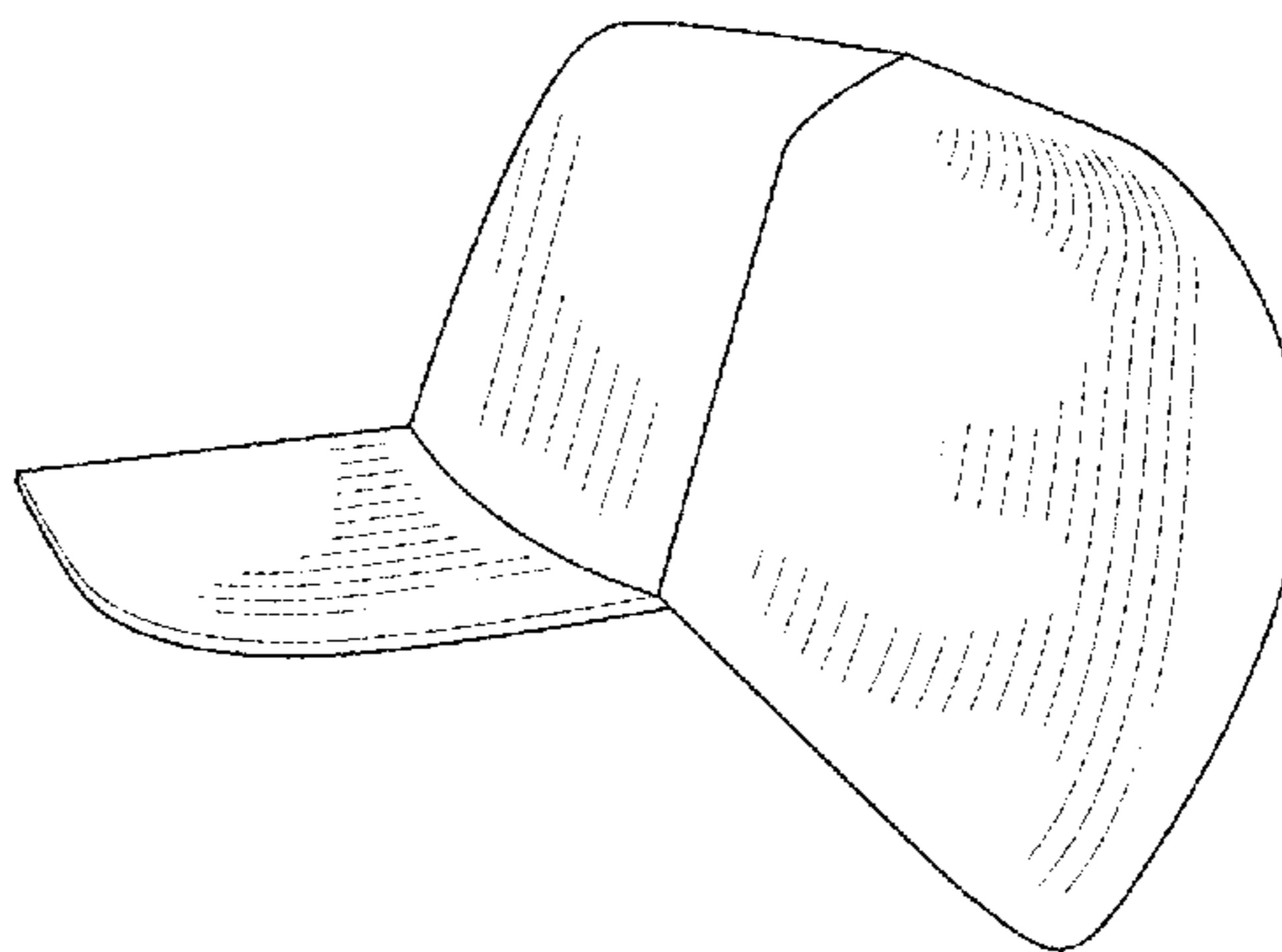
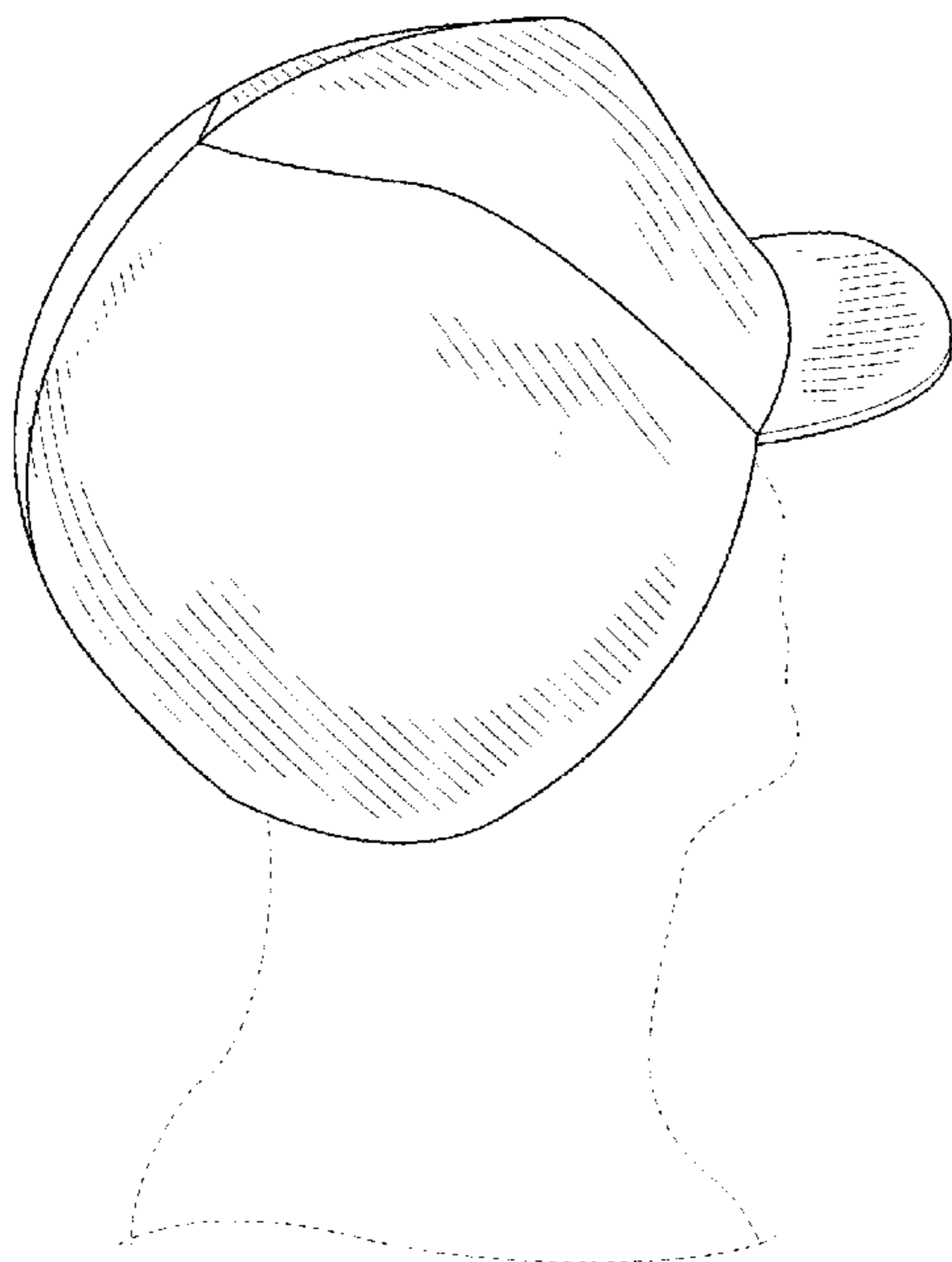

FIG. 1 is a rear perspective view of a cap, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

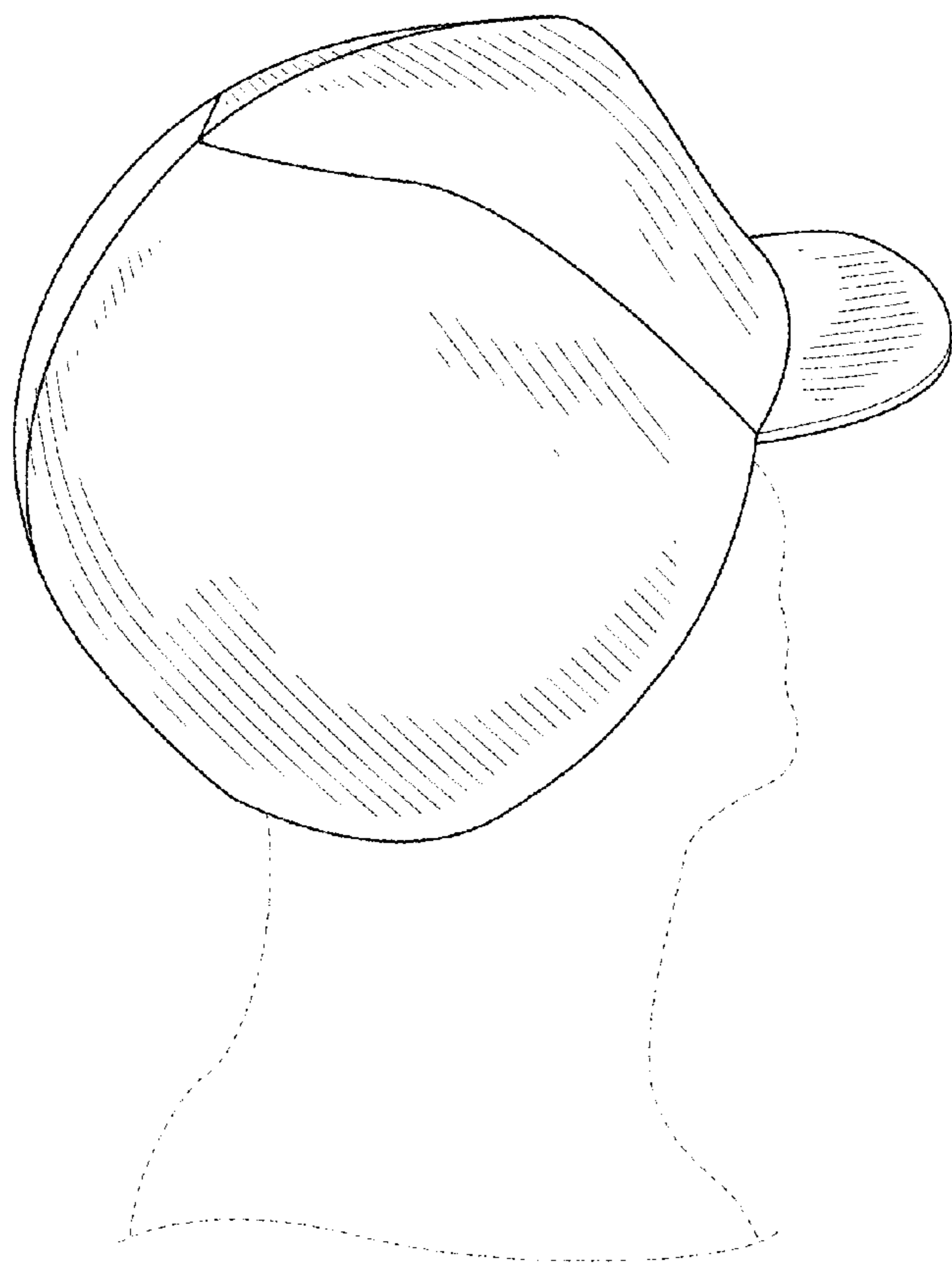

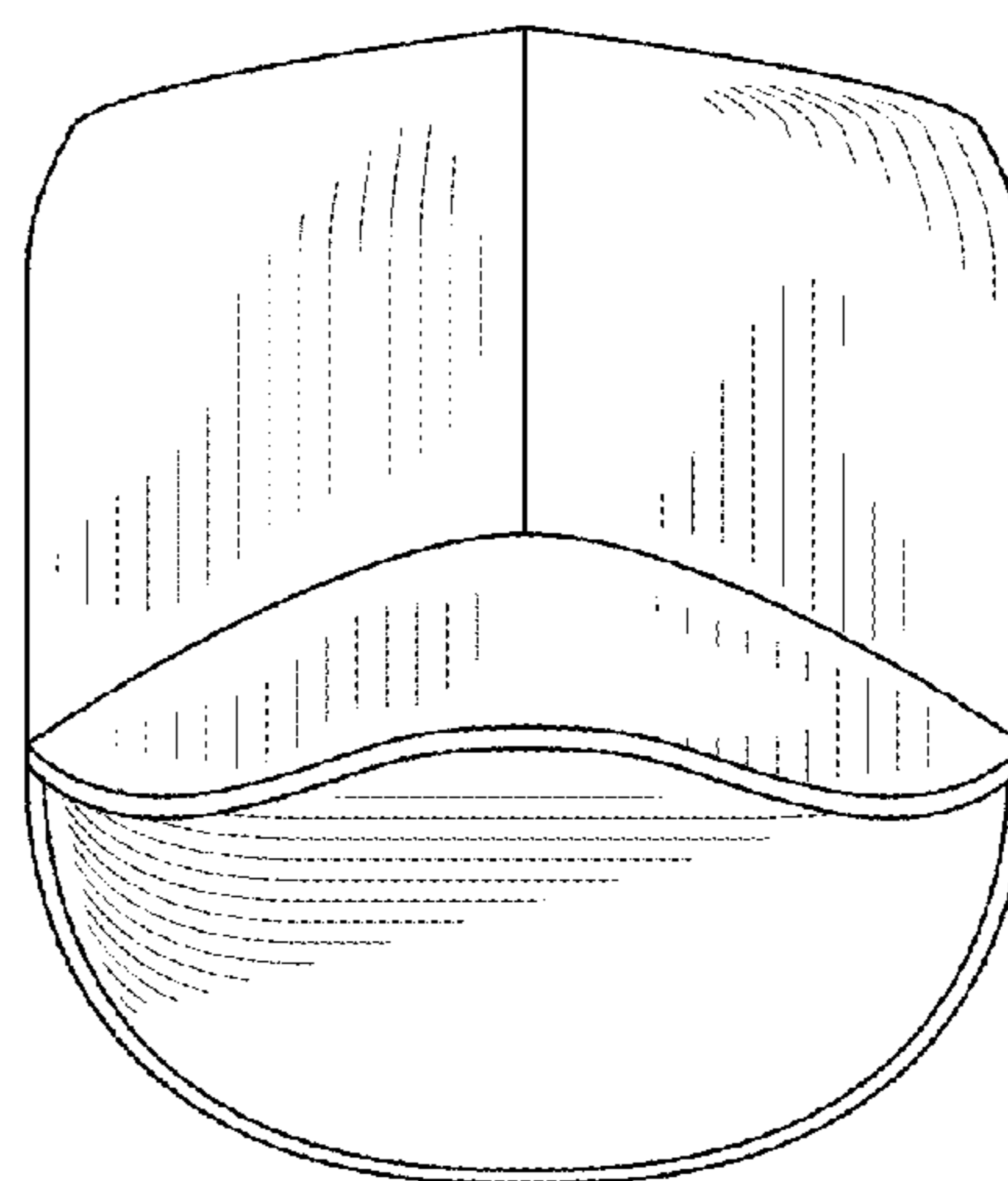

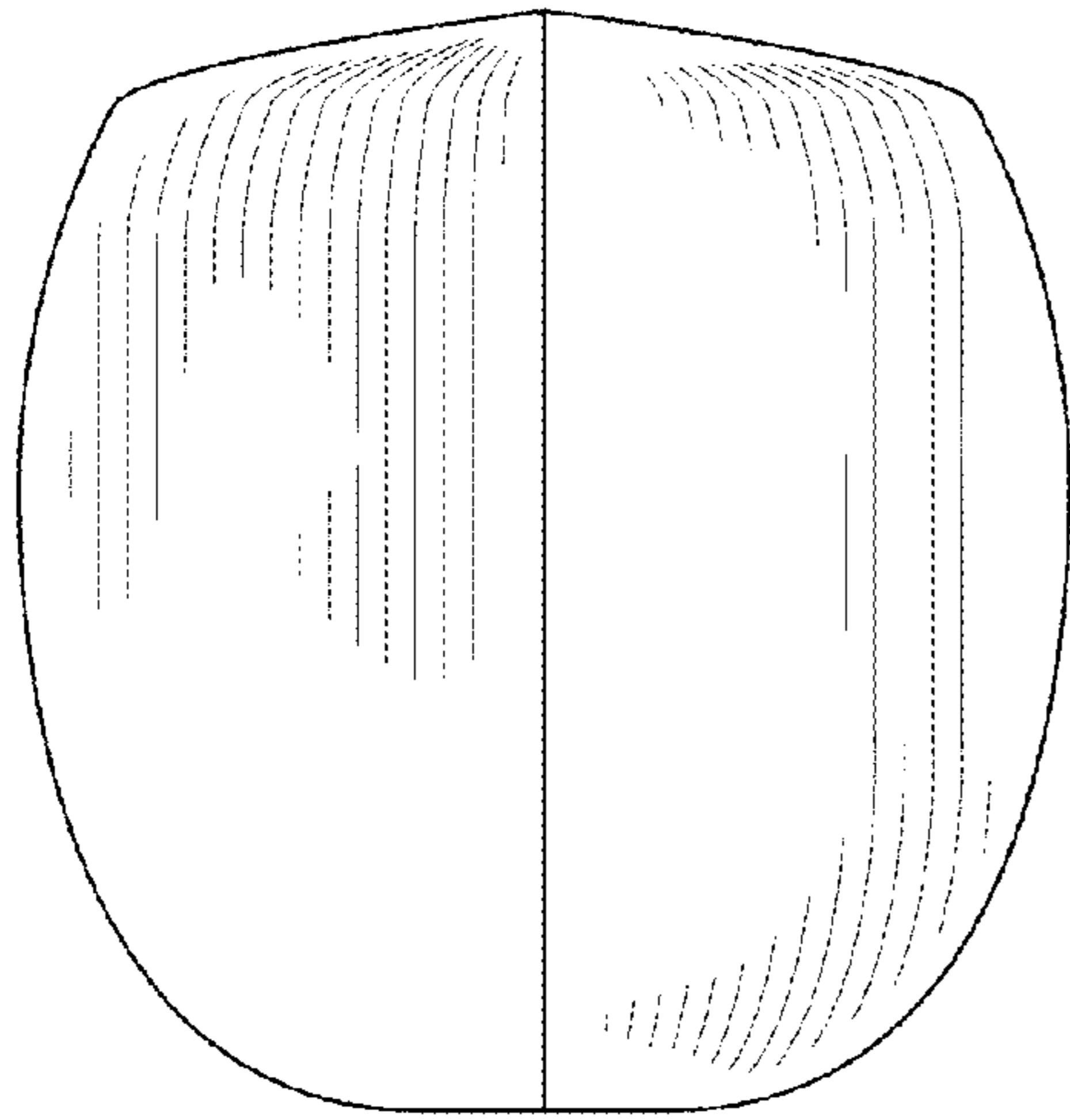

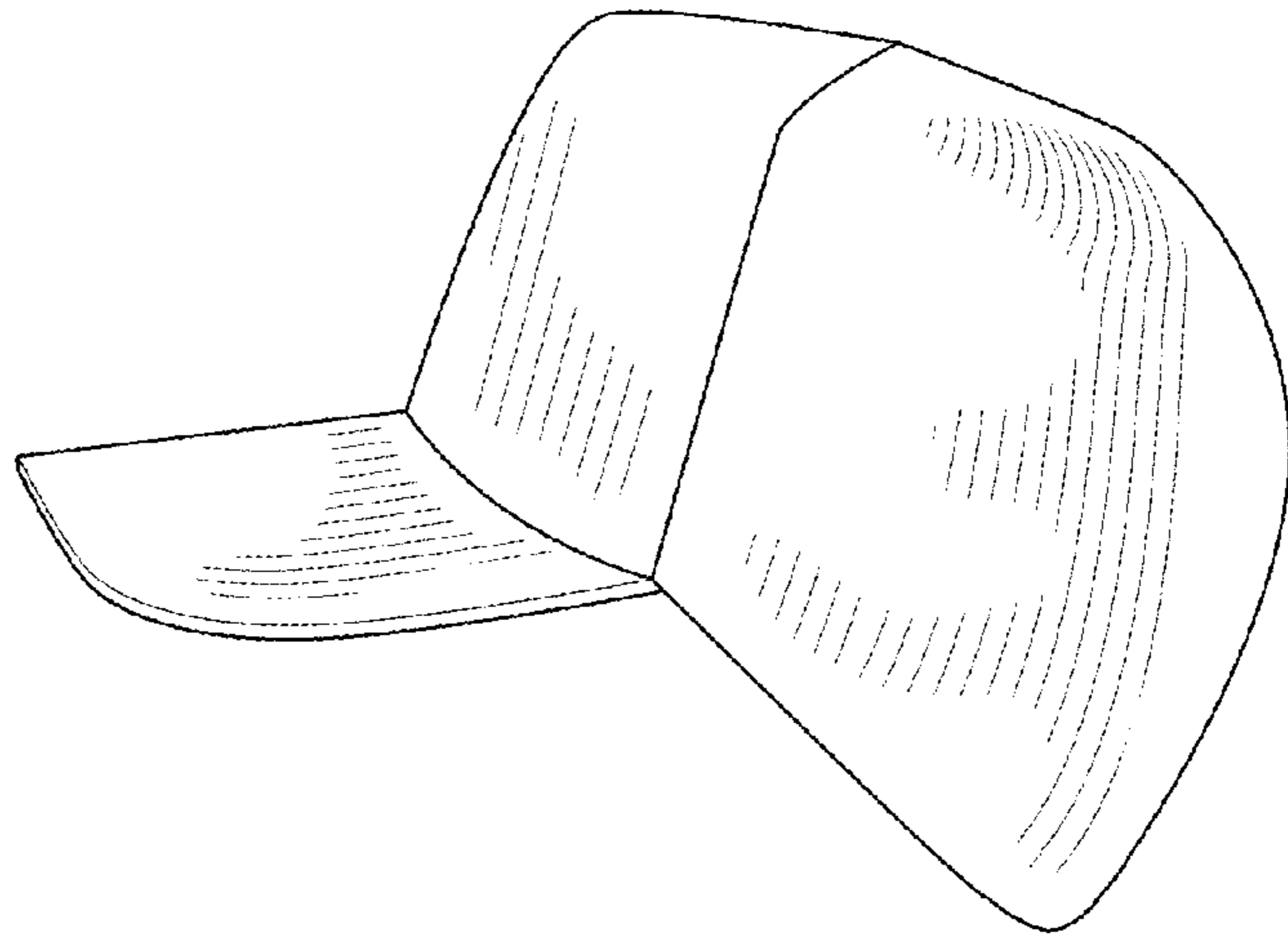

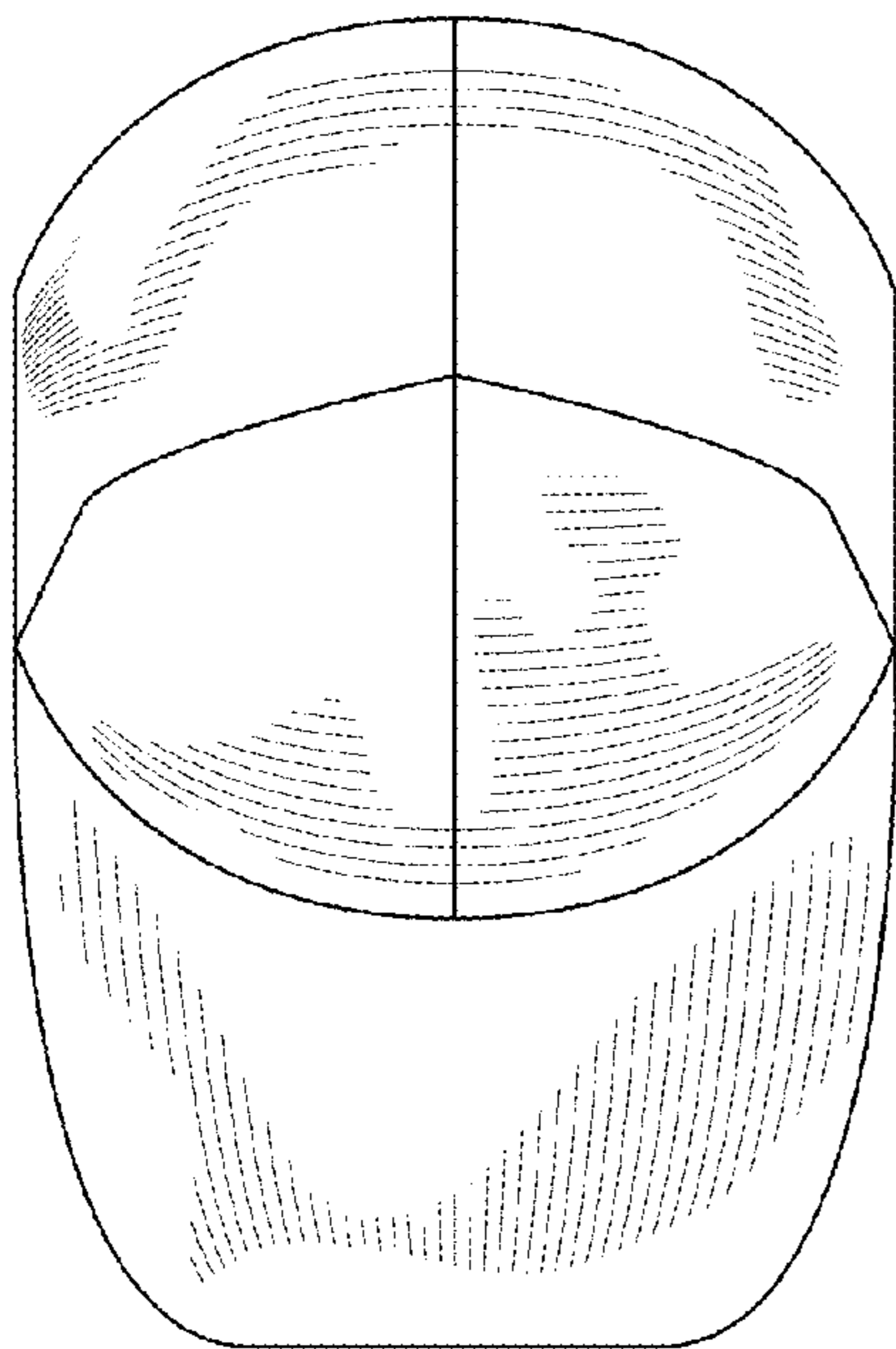

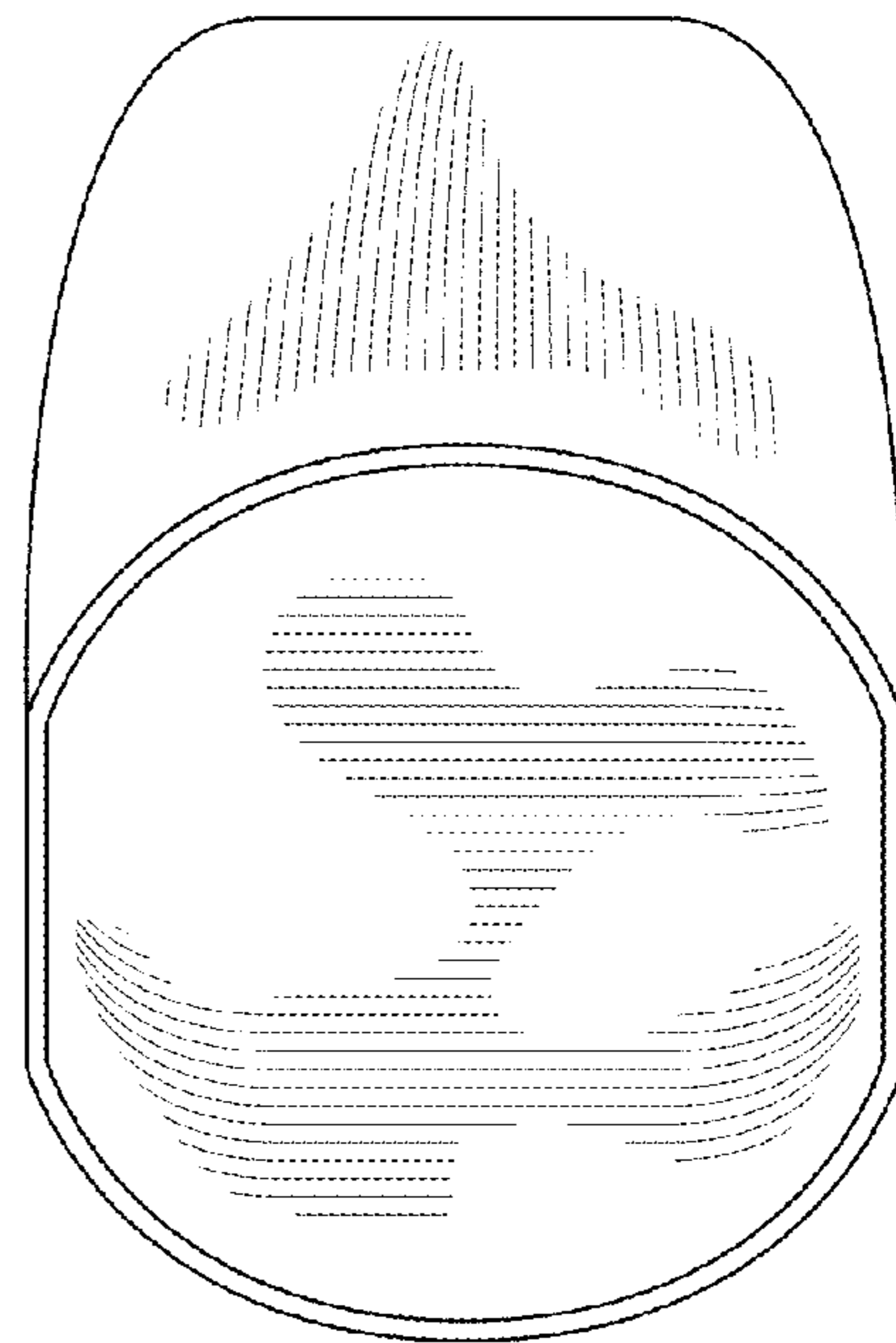
