(57) **CLAIM**

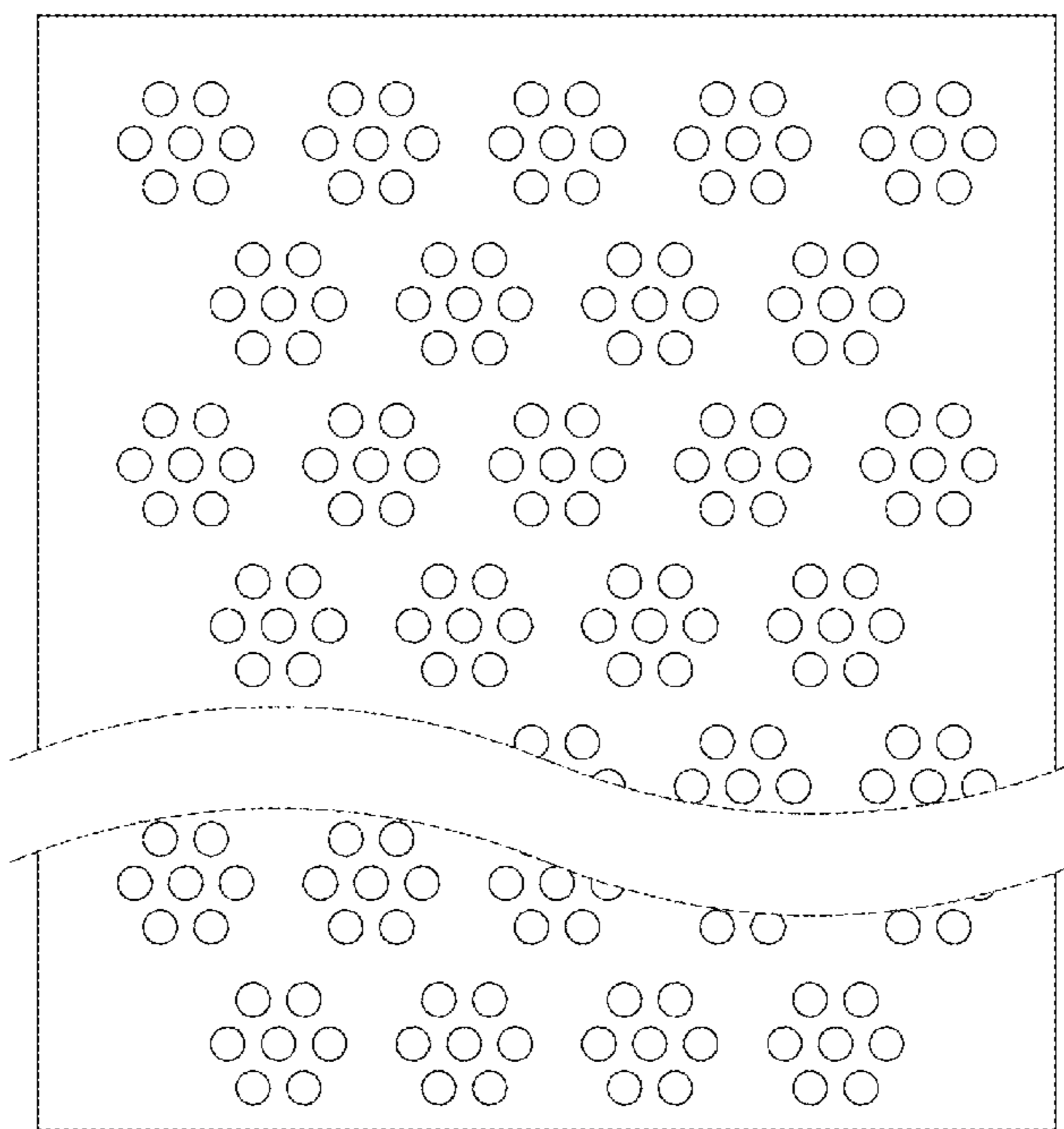
The ornamental design for a non-woven fabric, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a non-woven fabric of the applicant's design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right side view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a back view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a perspective view of the front, right side view of the non-woven fabric.

The Non-Woven Fabric is shown with a symbolic break along the width drawn in broken lines. The broken lines and any portion of the article between the break lines form no part of the claimed invention.

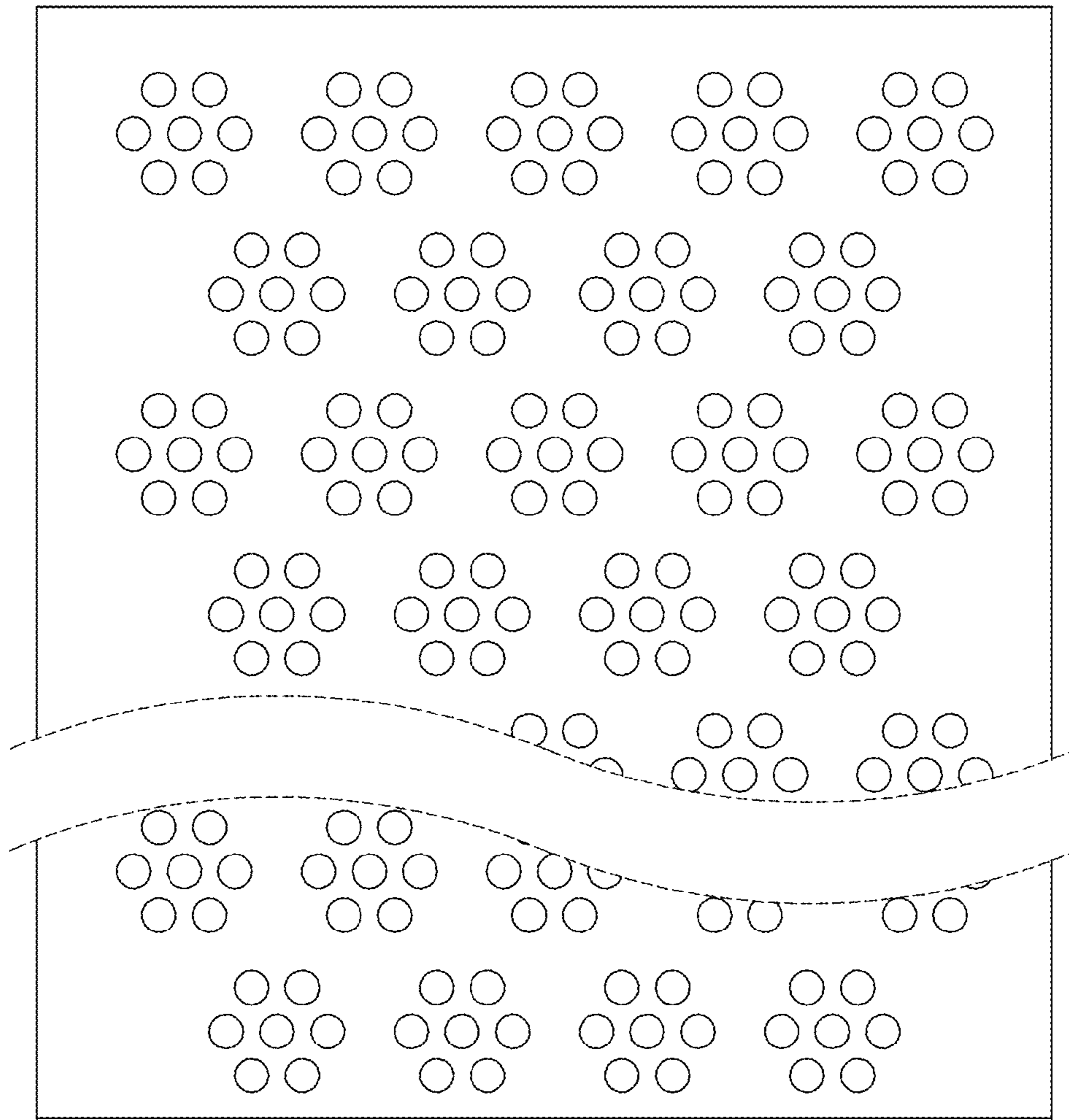

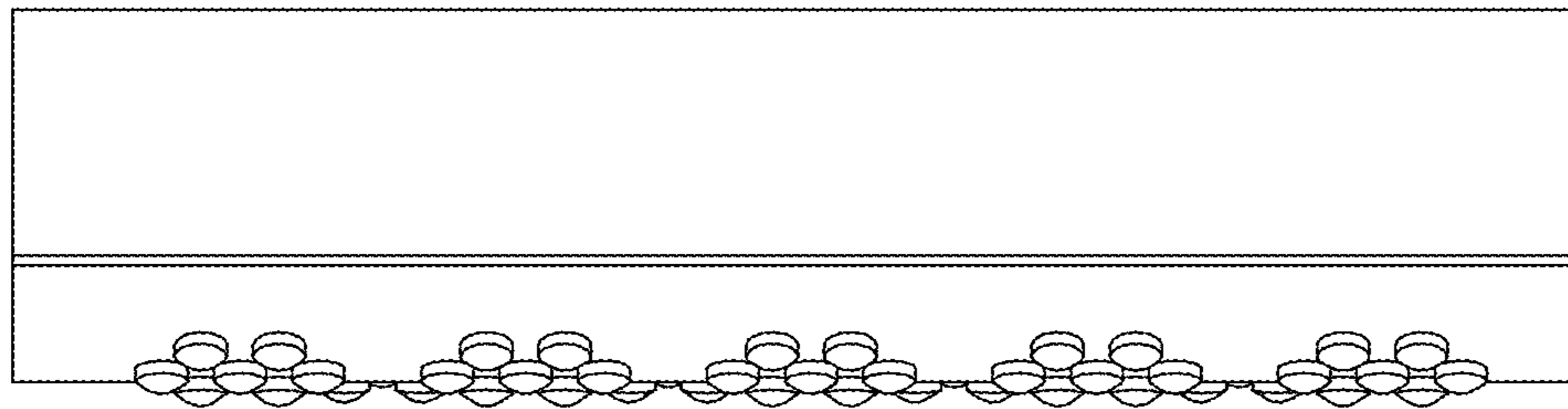

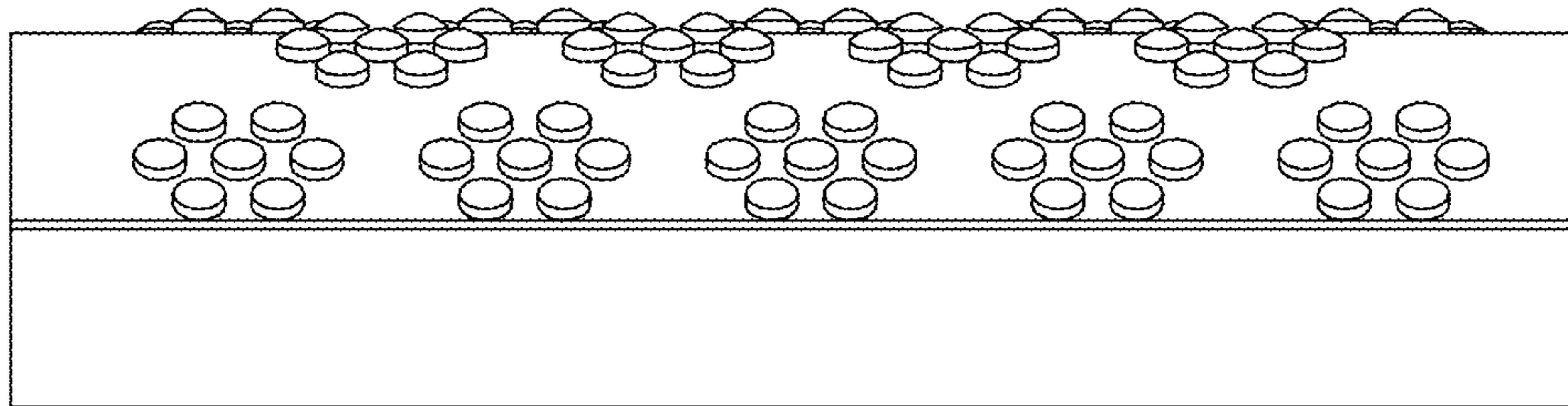

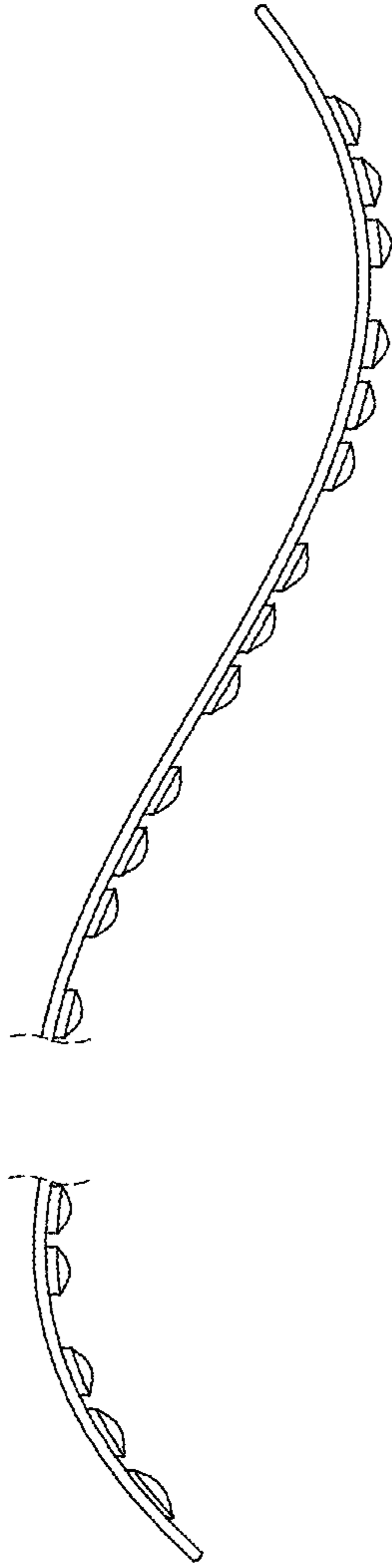

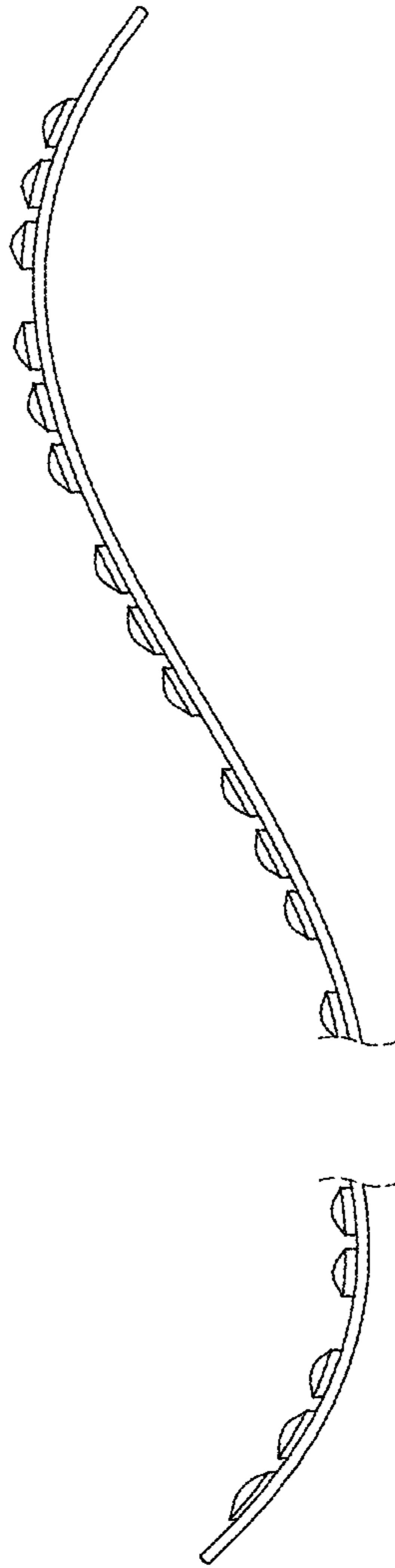

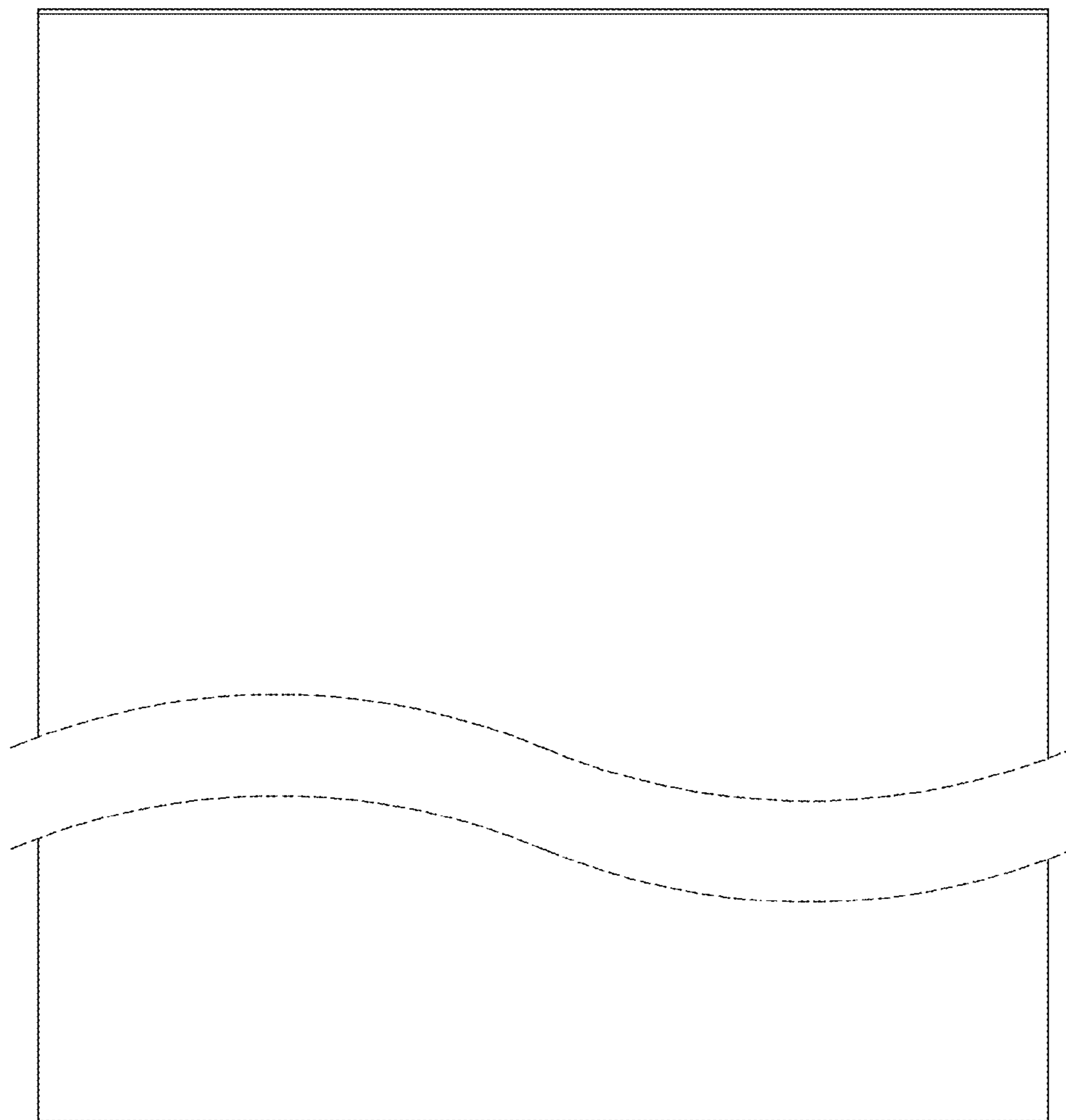

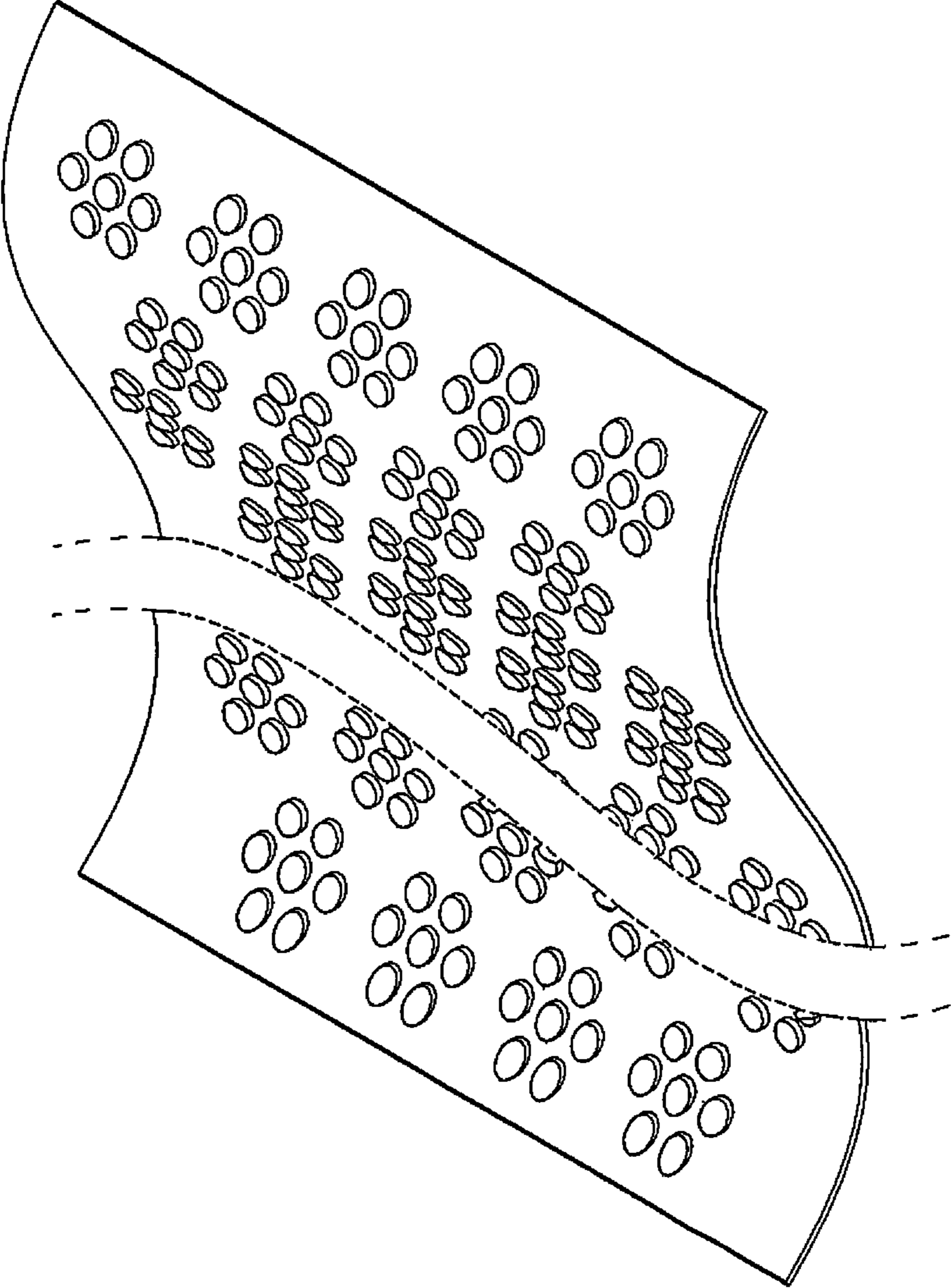
