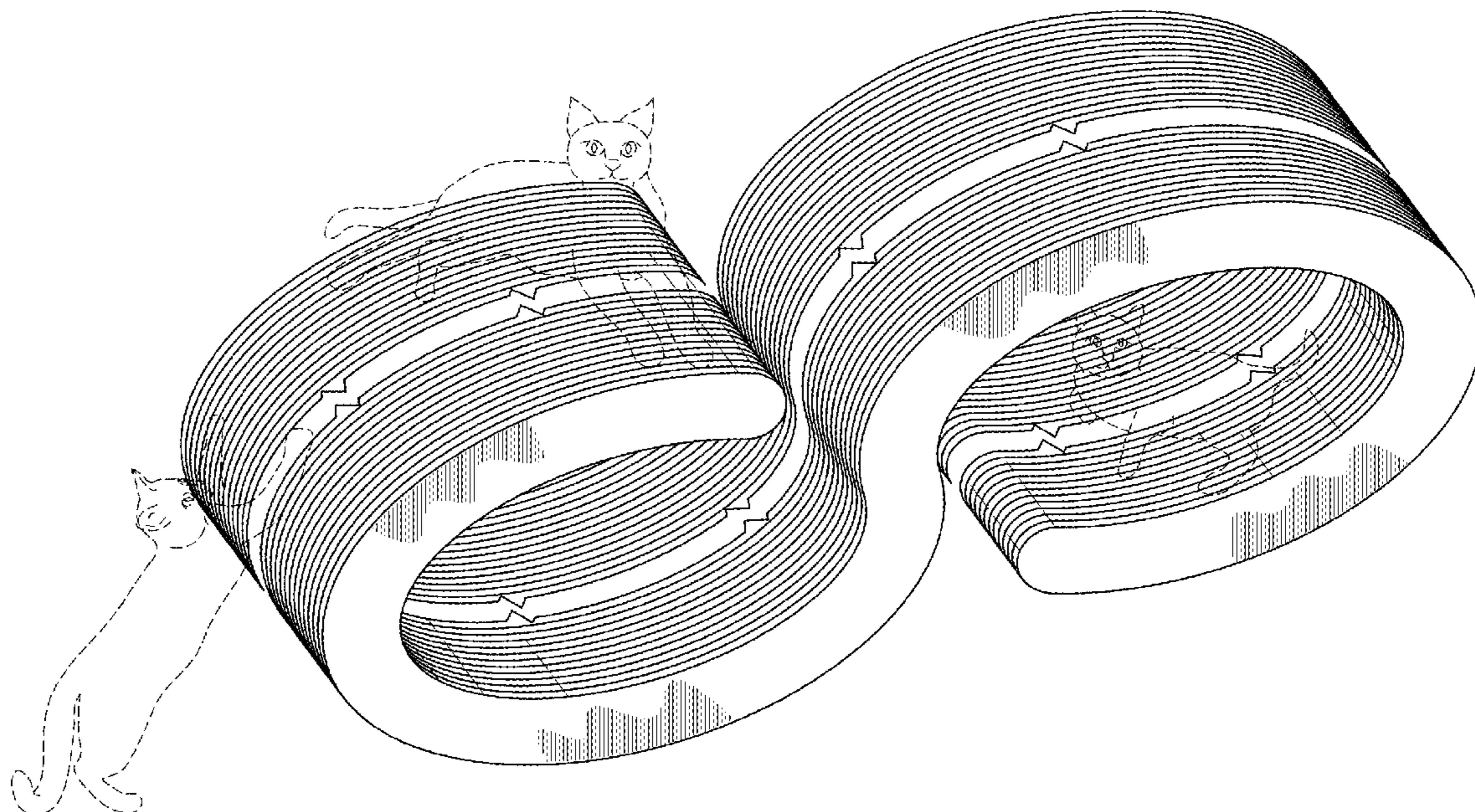
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a cat scratcher lounger, as shown  
and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top front perspective view of a cat scratcher  
lounger, showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a front view of my cat scratcher lounger of FIG. 1,  
the rear view being identical to the front view shown;  
FIG. 3 is a left side view of my cat scratcher lounger of FIG.  
1, the right side view being identical to the left side shown;  
and,  
FIG. 4 is a top view of my cat scratcher lounger of FIG. 1.  
The broken line cats in FIG. 1 depict environment only and  
form no part of the claimed design. The cat scratcher lounger  
is shown with a symbolic break in its width in FIGS. 1, 3 and  
4. The appearance of any portion of the article between the  
break lines forms no part of the claimed design.

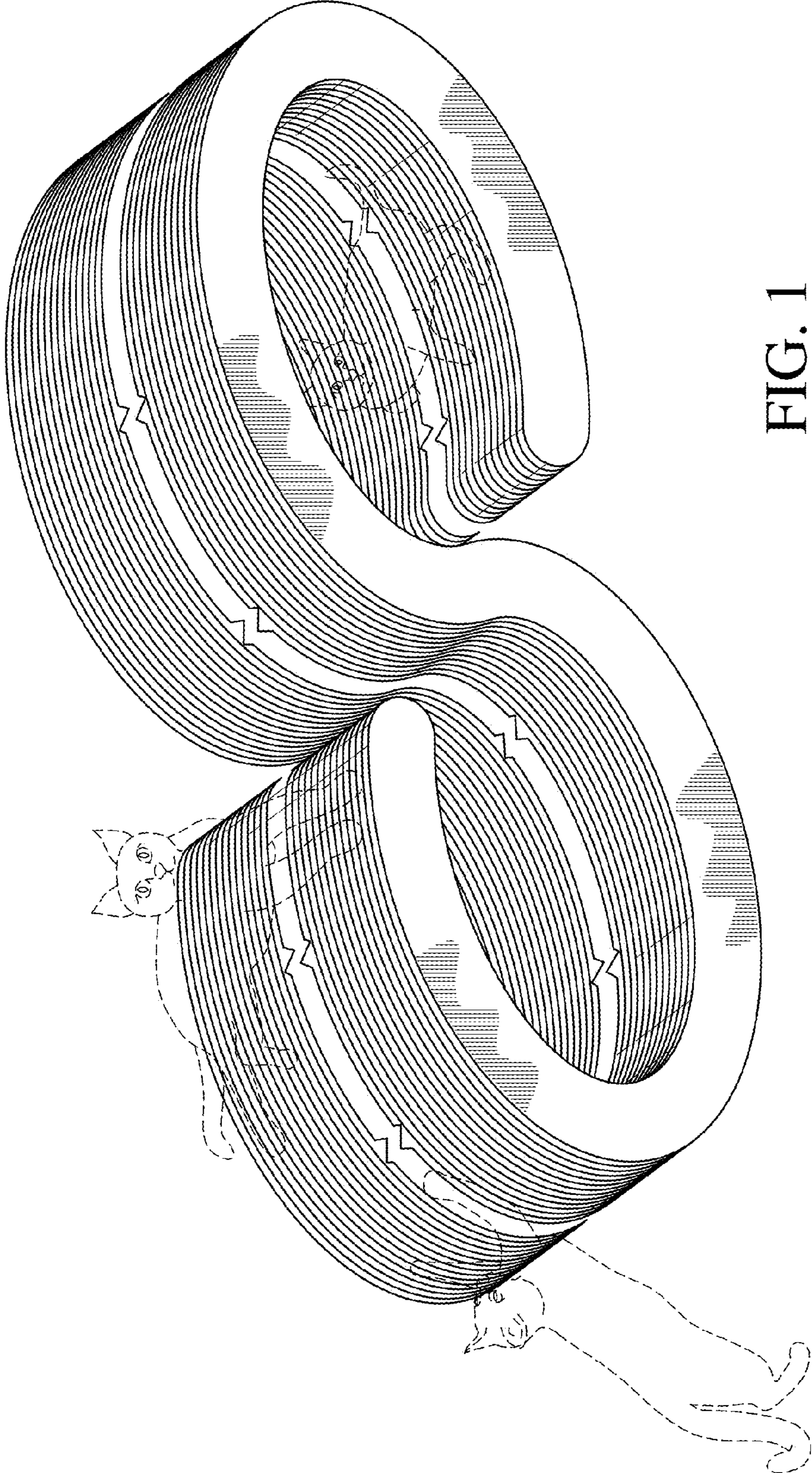

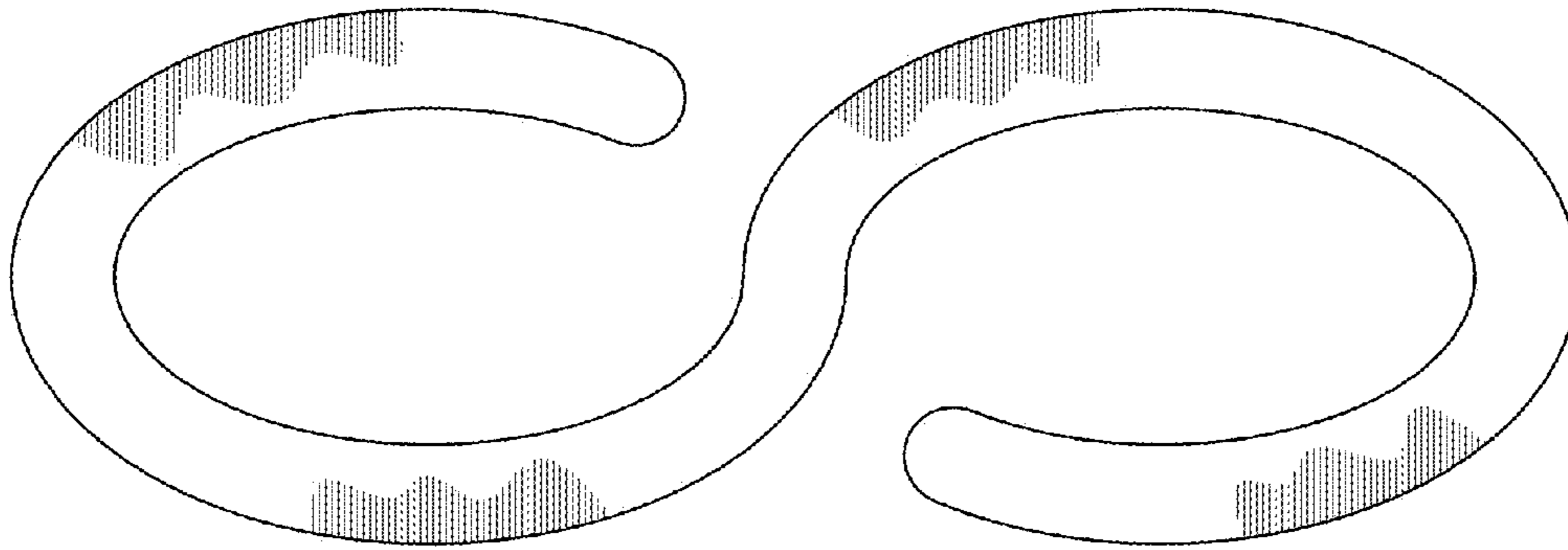

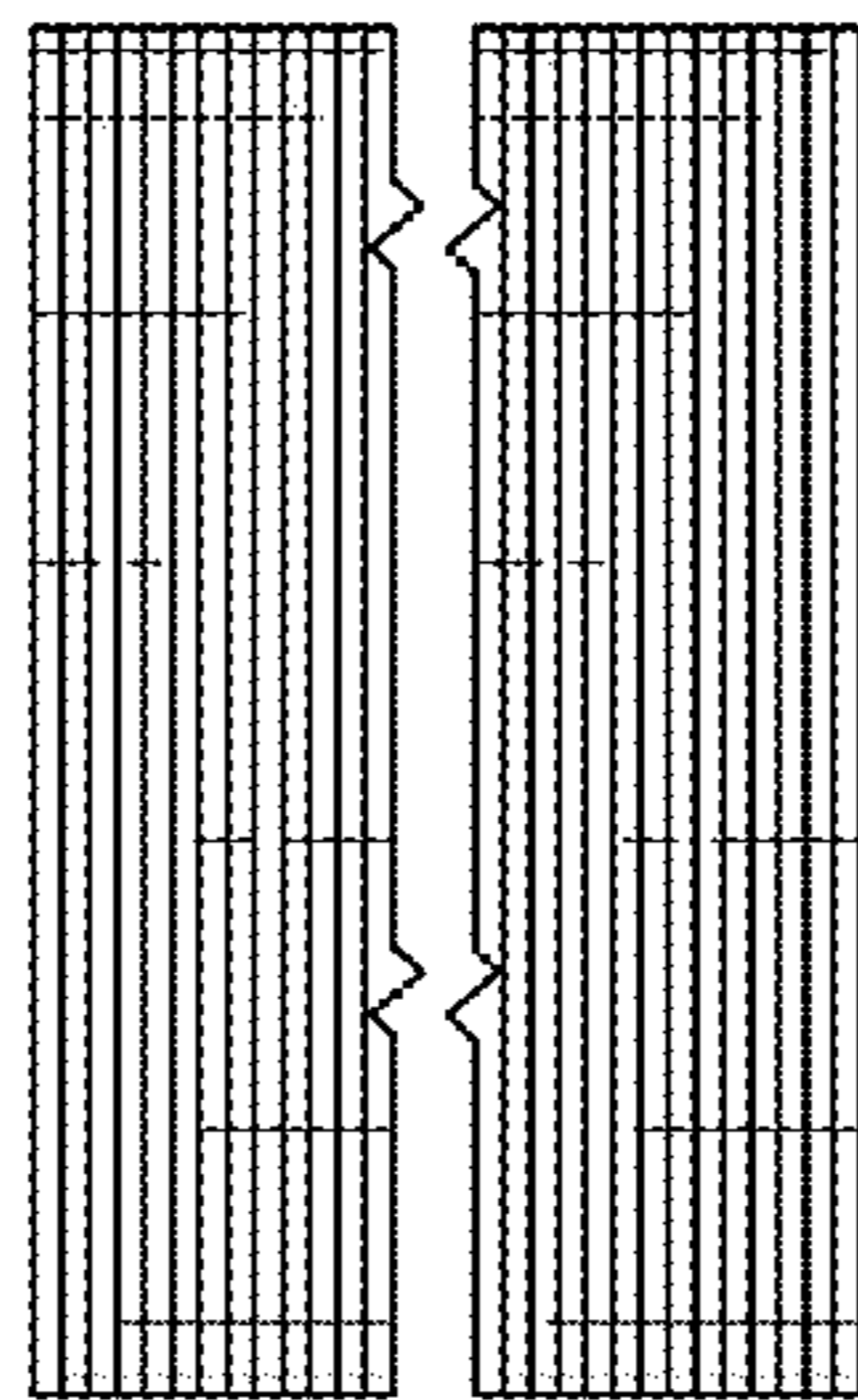

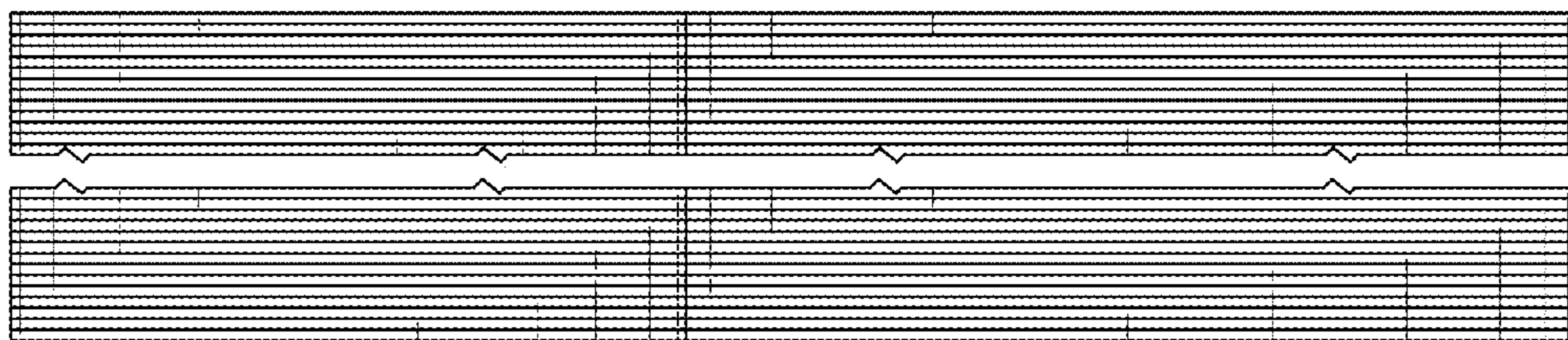
