(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an extending cookware handle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the extending cookware handle;

FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view of the extending cookware handle, the opposite side of which is a mirror image;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the extending cookware handle;

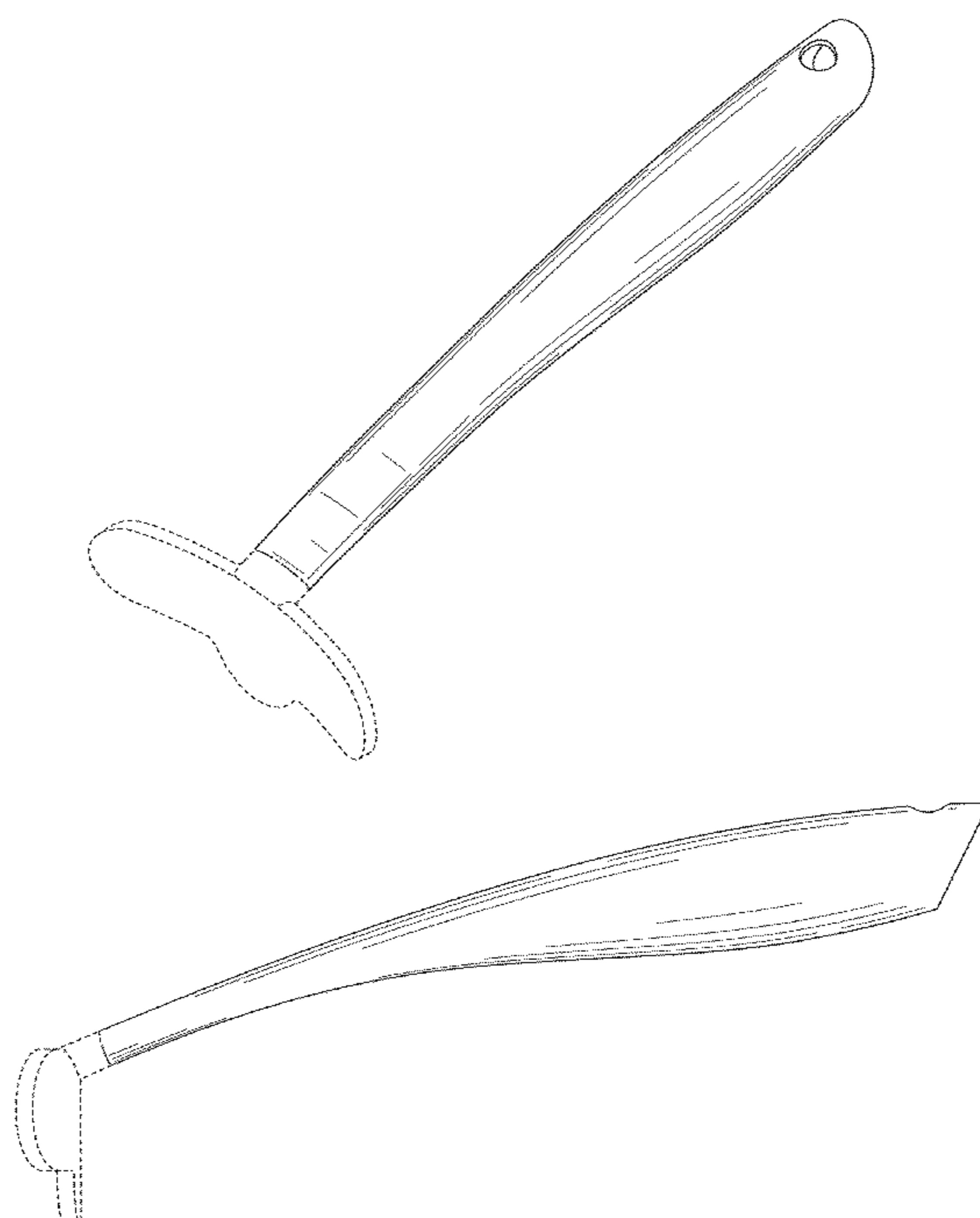
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the extending cookware handle.

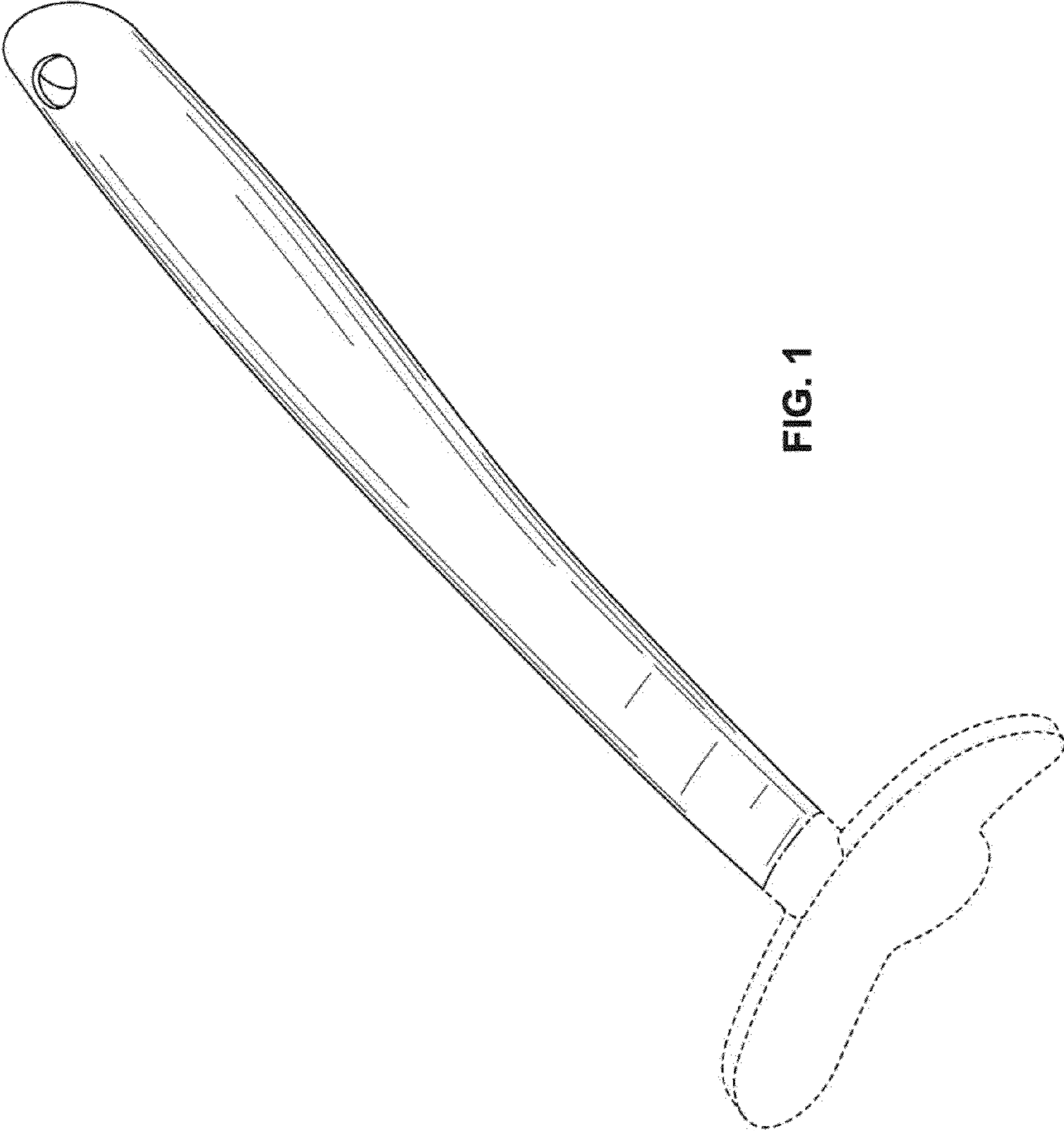
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of the extending cookware handle; and,

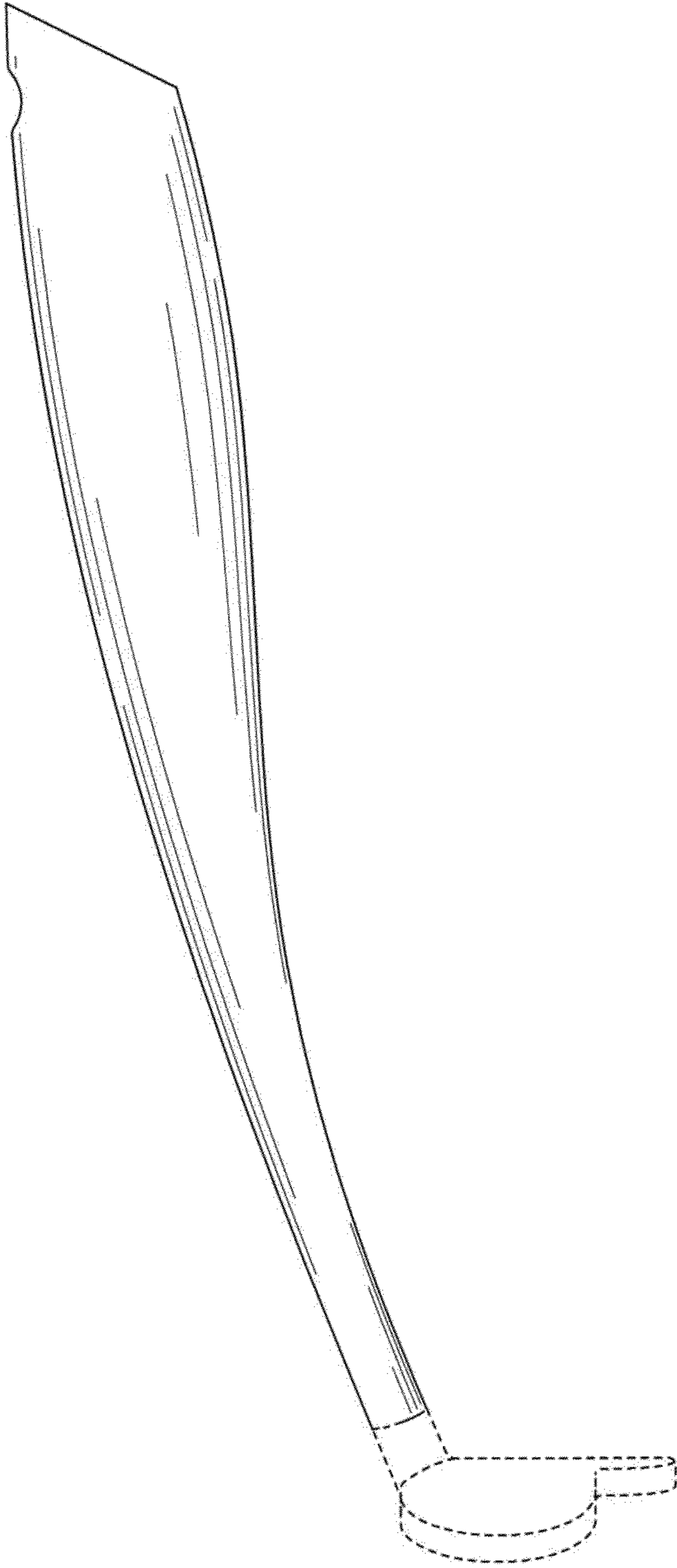

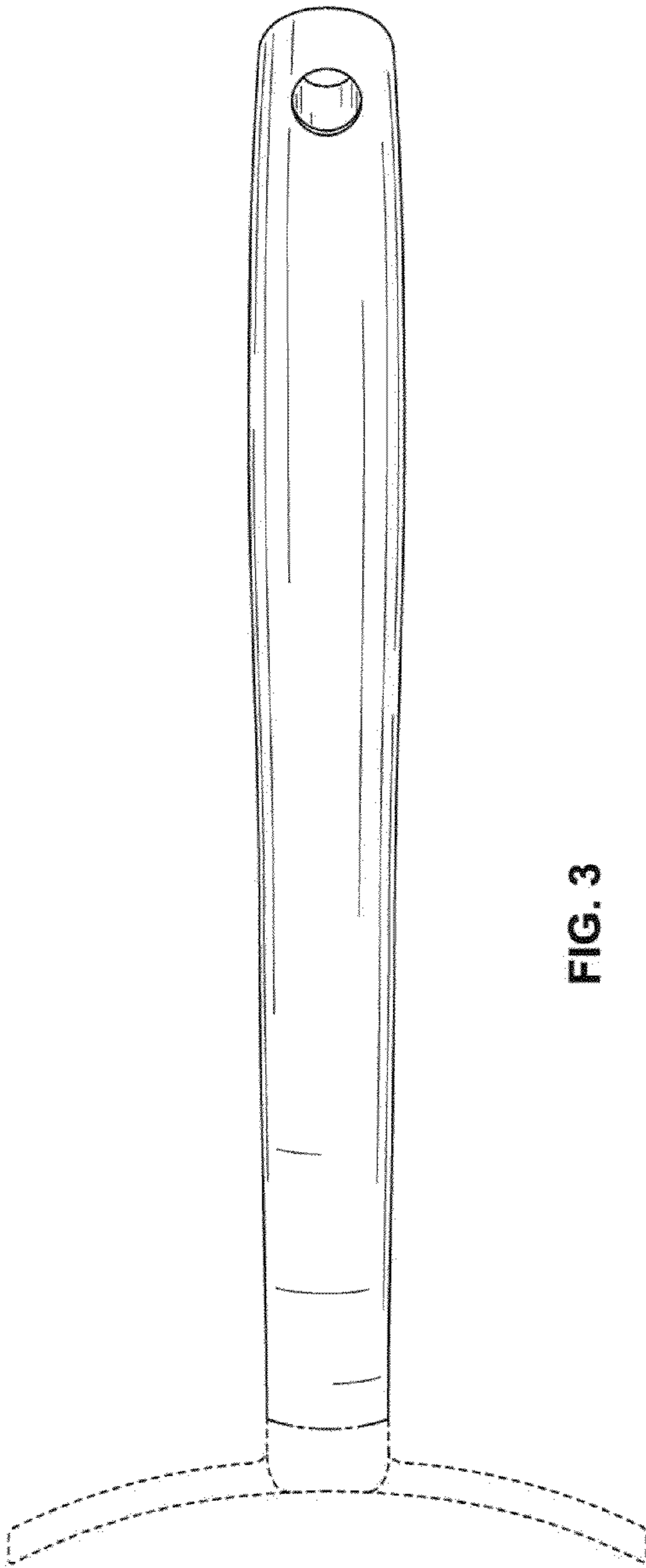

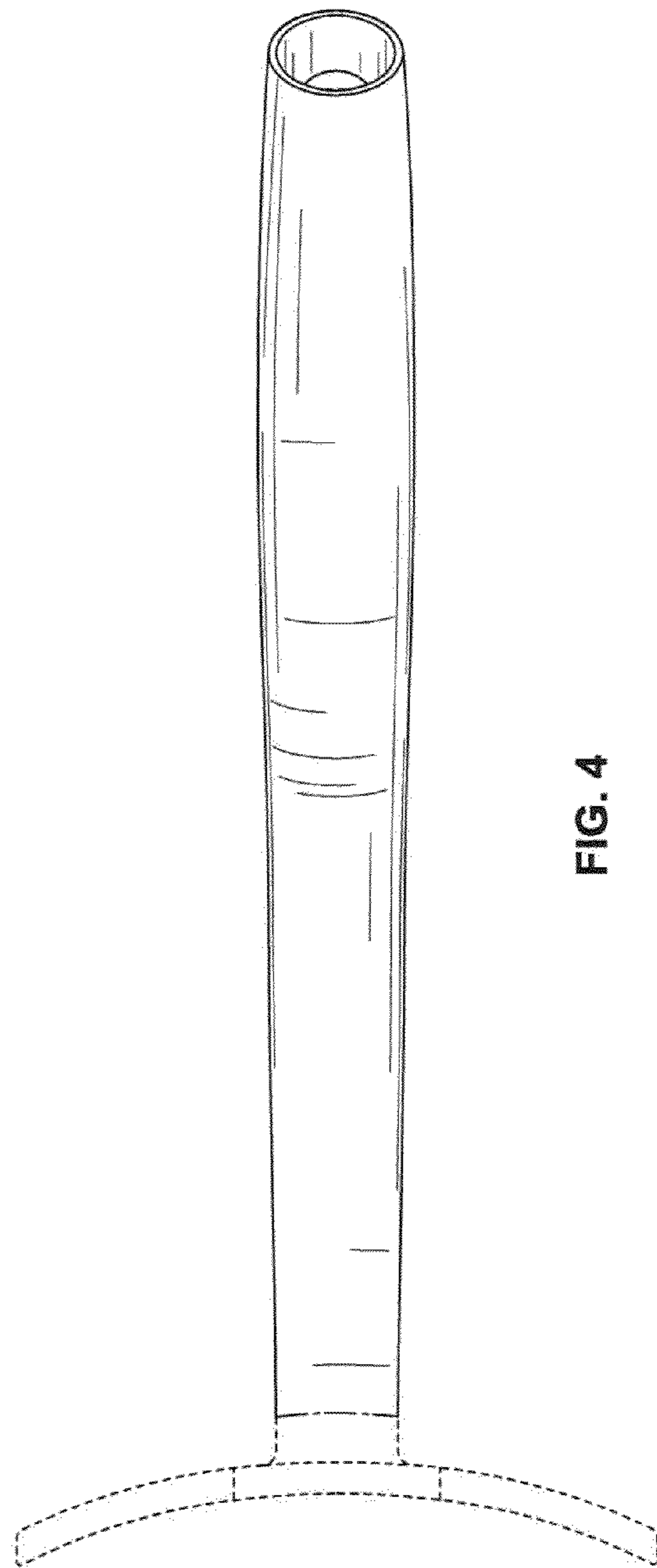

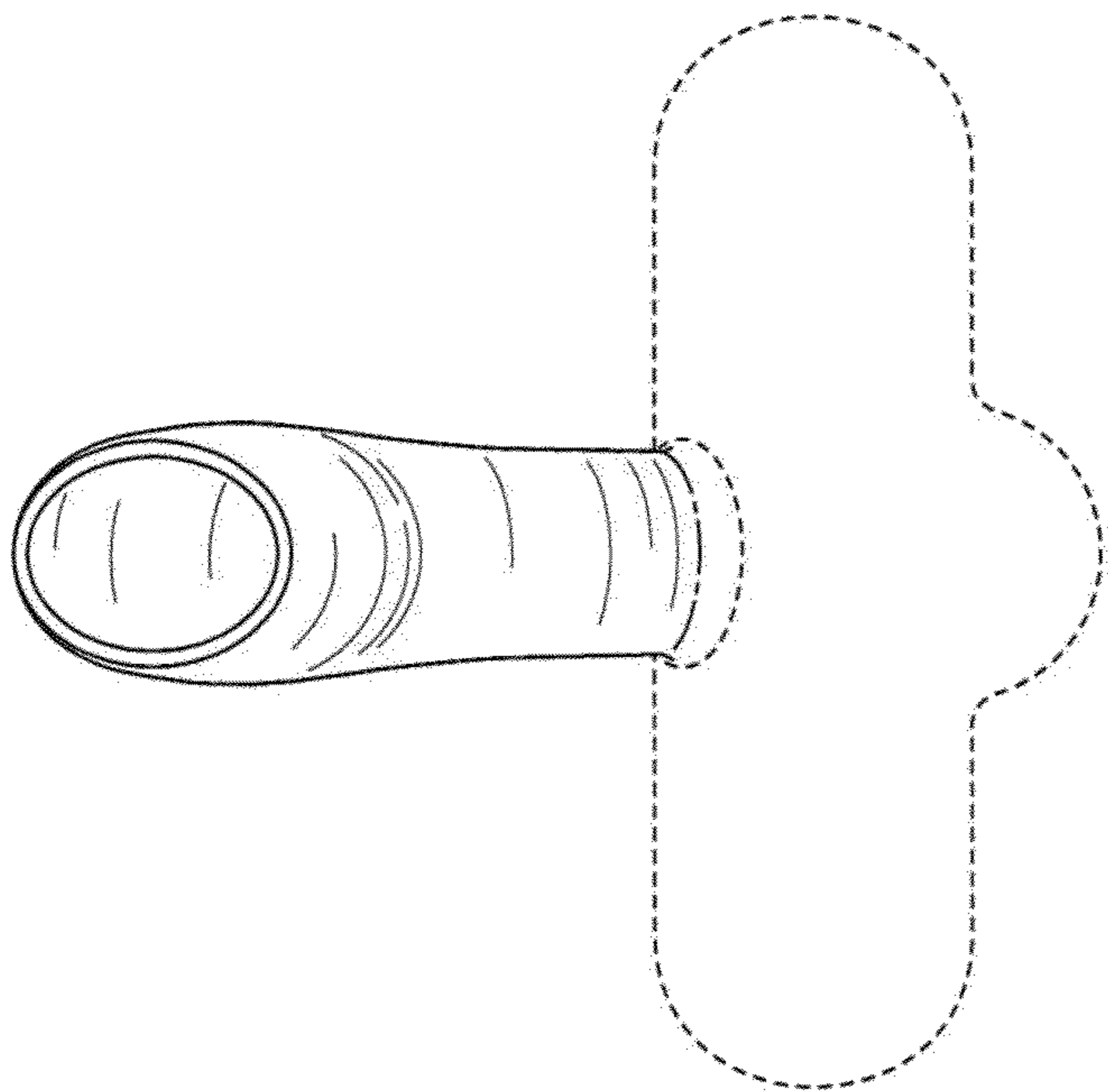

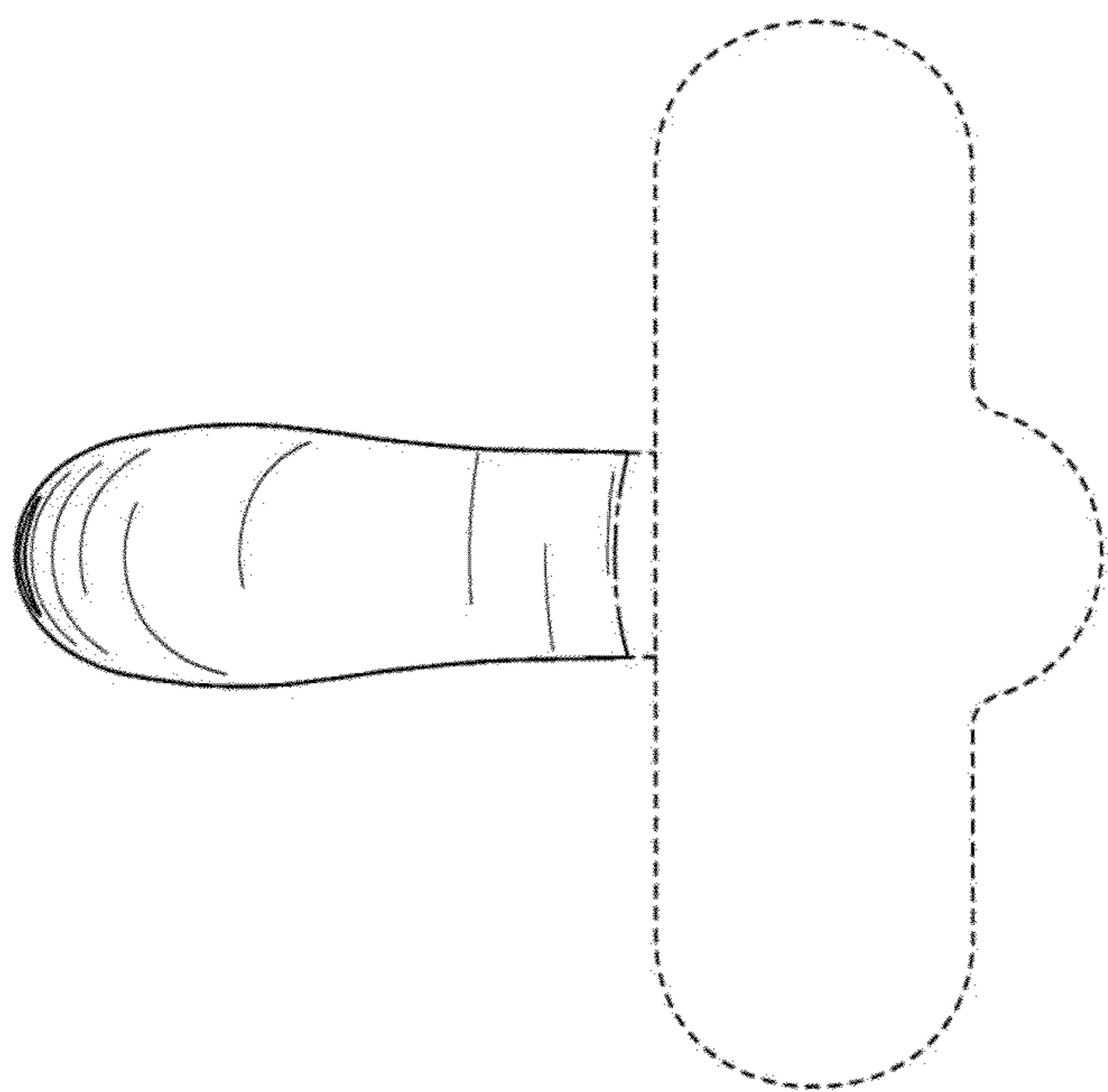
