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(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a leg kit for a pipefitting/welding stand, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a leg kit for a pipefitting/welding stand showing my new design wherein the leg kit has two fixed legs shown at the front and one adjustable leg shown at the rear;

FIG. 2 is another perspective view of the leg kit of FIG. 1 with the two fixed legs shown at the rear and the adjustable leg shown at the front;

FIG. 3 is another perspective view of the leg kit of FIG. 1 with the adjustable leg shown to the right;

FIG. 4 is another perspective view of the leg kit of FIG. 1 with the adjustable leg shown to the left;

FIG. 5 is a side elevational view of one of two fixed legs of the leg kit of FIG. 1 (each leg being identical, and the opposite side view of the fixed leg being a mirror image of the view of FIG. 5);

FIG. 6 is a top view of the fixed leg of FIG. 5;

FIG. 7 is a bottom view of the fixed leg of FIG. 5;

FIG. 8 is a left side view of the fixed leg of FIG. 5;

FIG. 9 is a right side view of the fixed leg of FIG. 5;

FIG. 10 is a side elevational view of a bottom portion of an adjustable third leg of the leg kit of FIG. 1 with a base portion shown to the left, a telescoping portion shown to the right, and a ground portion therebetween;

FIG. 11 is a top view of the bottom portion of the adjustable leg of FIG. 10;

FIG. 12 is a bottom view of the bottom portion of the adjustable leg of FIG. 10;

FIG. 13 is a left side view of the bottom portion of the adjustable leg of FIG. 10;

FIG. 14 is a right side view of the bottom portion of the adjustable leg of the leg kit of FIG. 10;

FIG. 15 is a side elevational view of the upper portion of the adjustable leg of FIG. 1 adapted to receive the telescoping portion of the bottom portion of FIG. 10;

FIG. 16 is a top view of the upper portion of the adjustable leg of FIG. 15;

FIG. 17 is a bottom view of the upper portion of the adjustable leg of FIG. 15;

FIG. 18 is a side view of the upper portion of the adjustable leg of FIG. 15 (the right side view being the same view as shown in FIG. 18);

FIG. 19 is a front view of the adjustment handle;

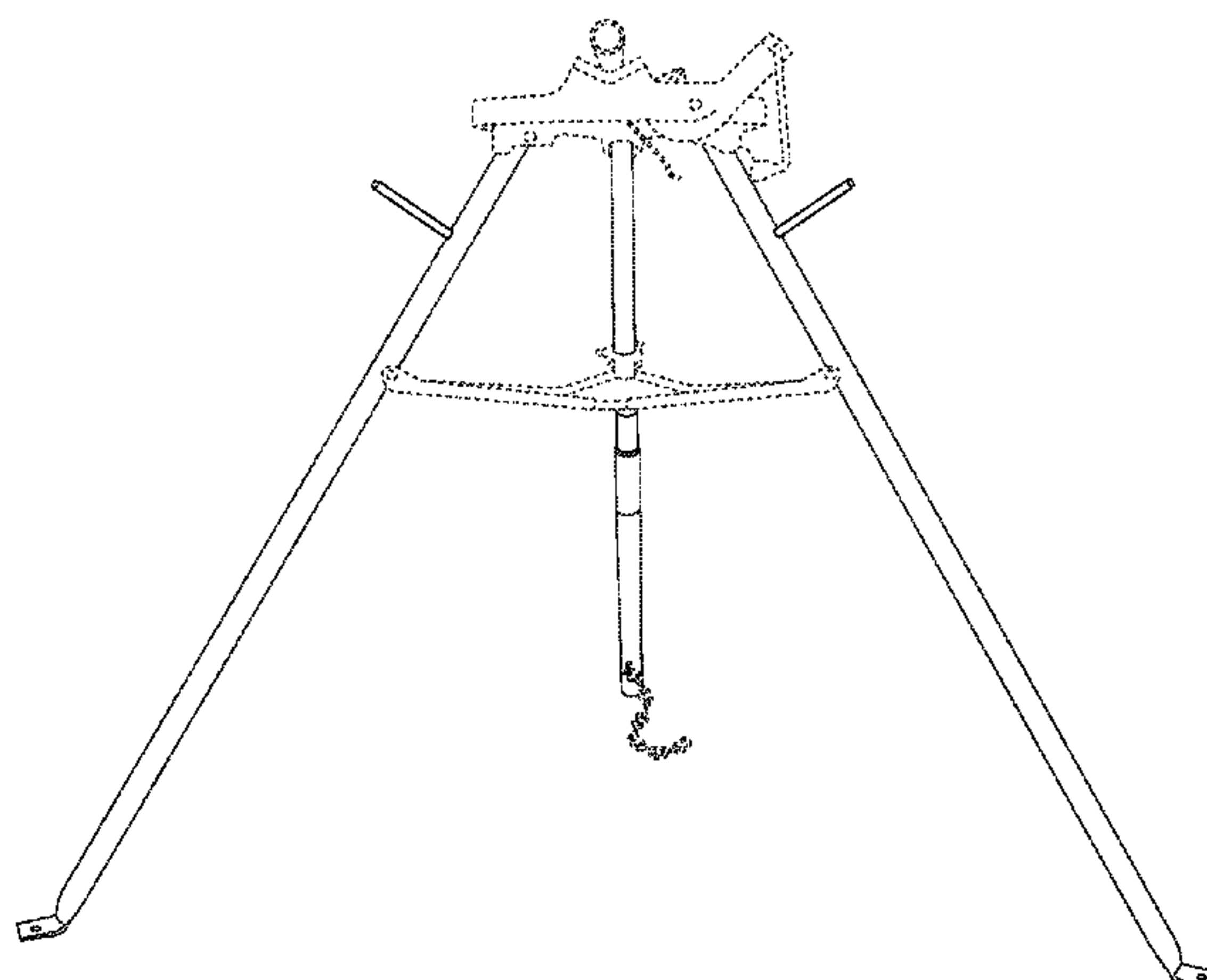
FIG. 20 is a side view of the adjustment handle of FIG. 19;

FIG. 21 is a bottom view of the adjustment handle of FIG. 19; and,

FIG. 22 is a top view of the adjustment handle of FIG. 19.

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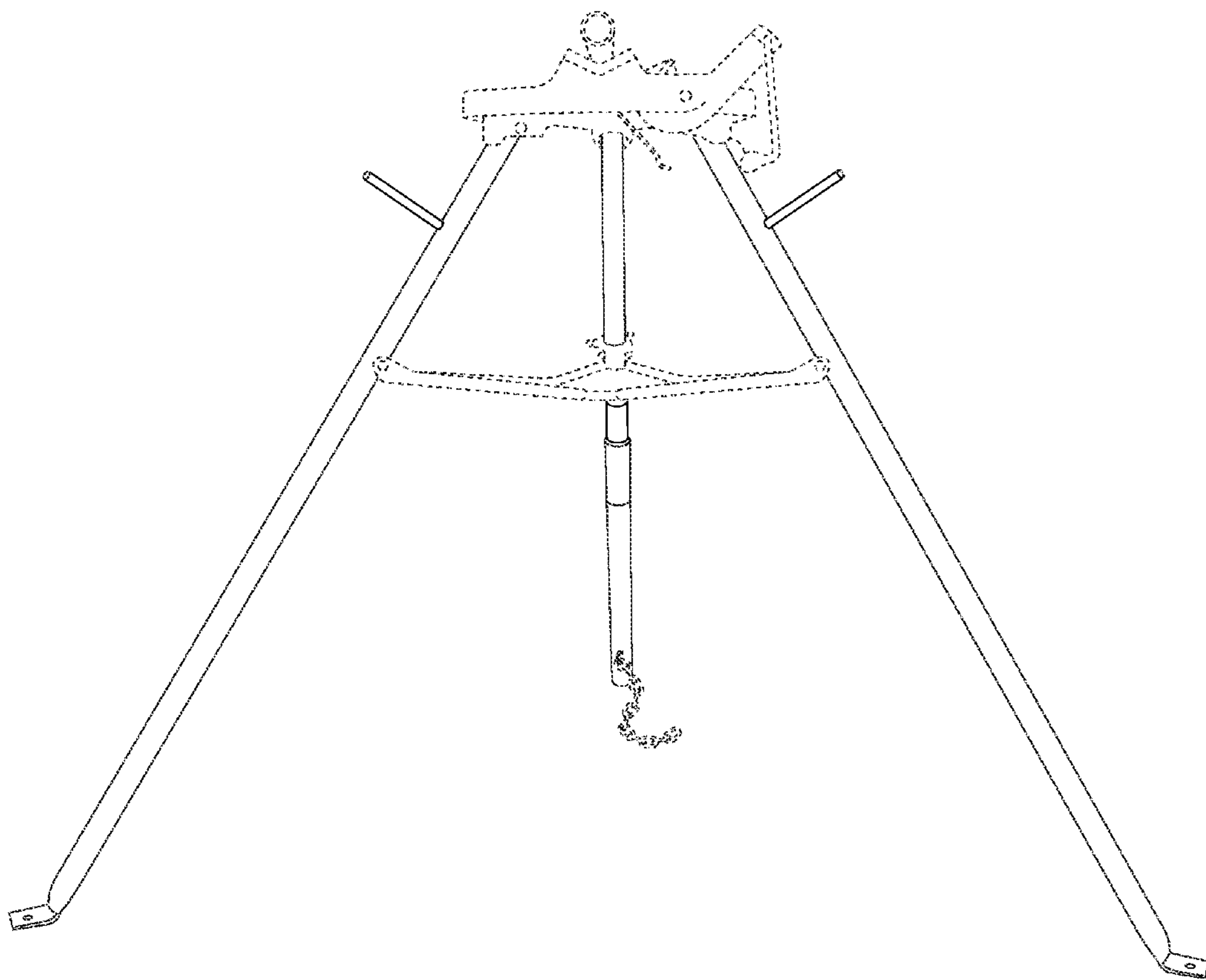

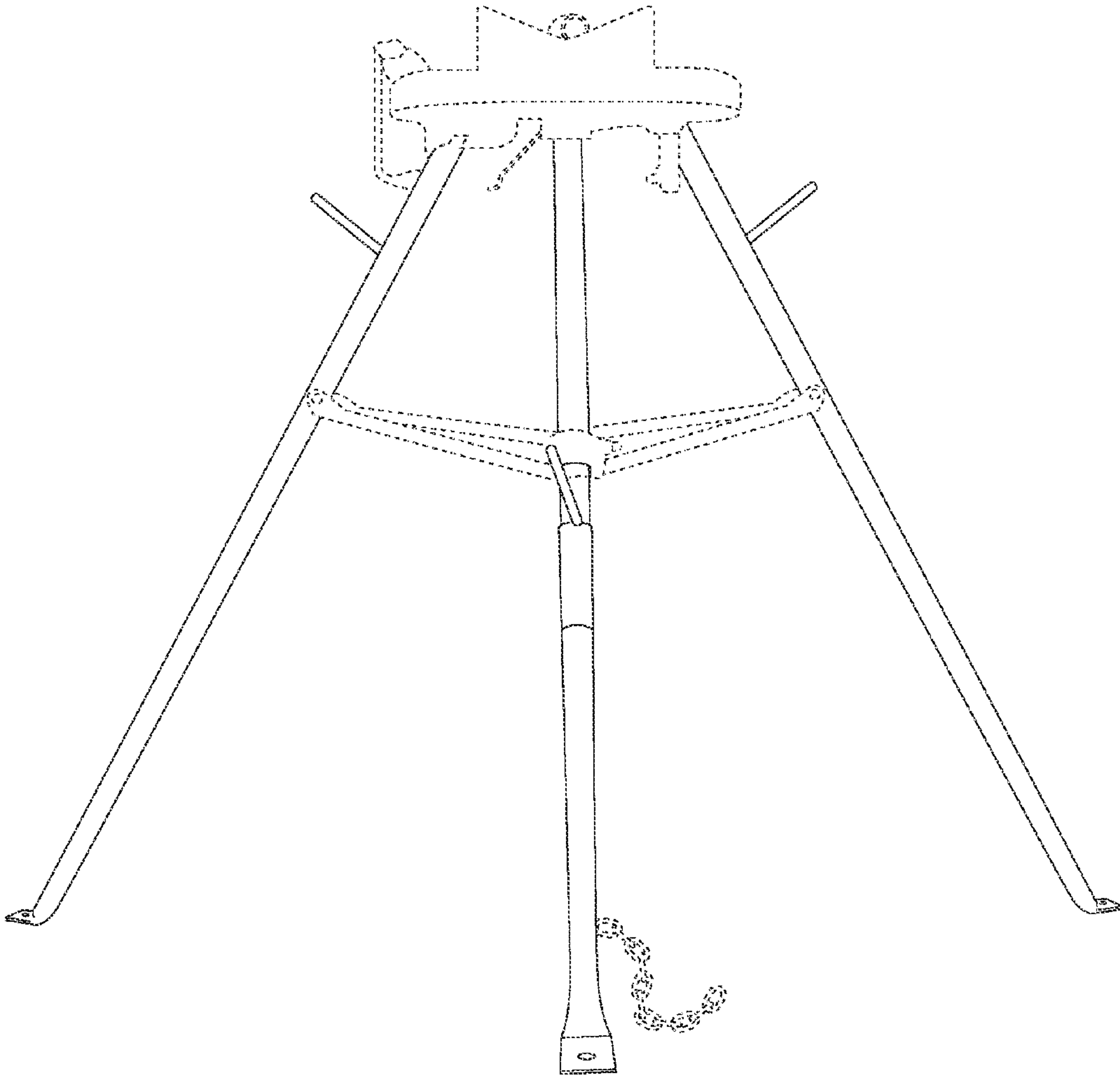

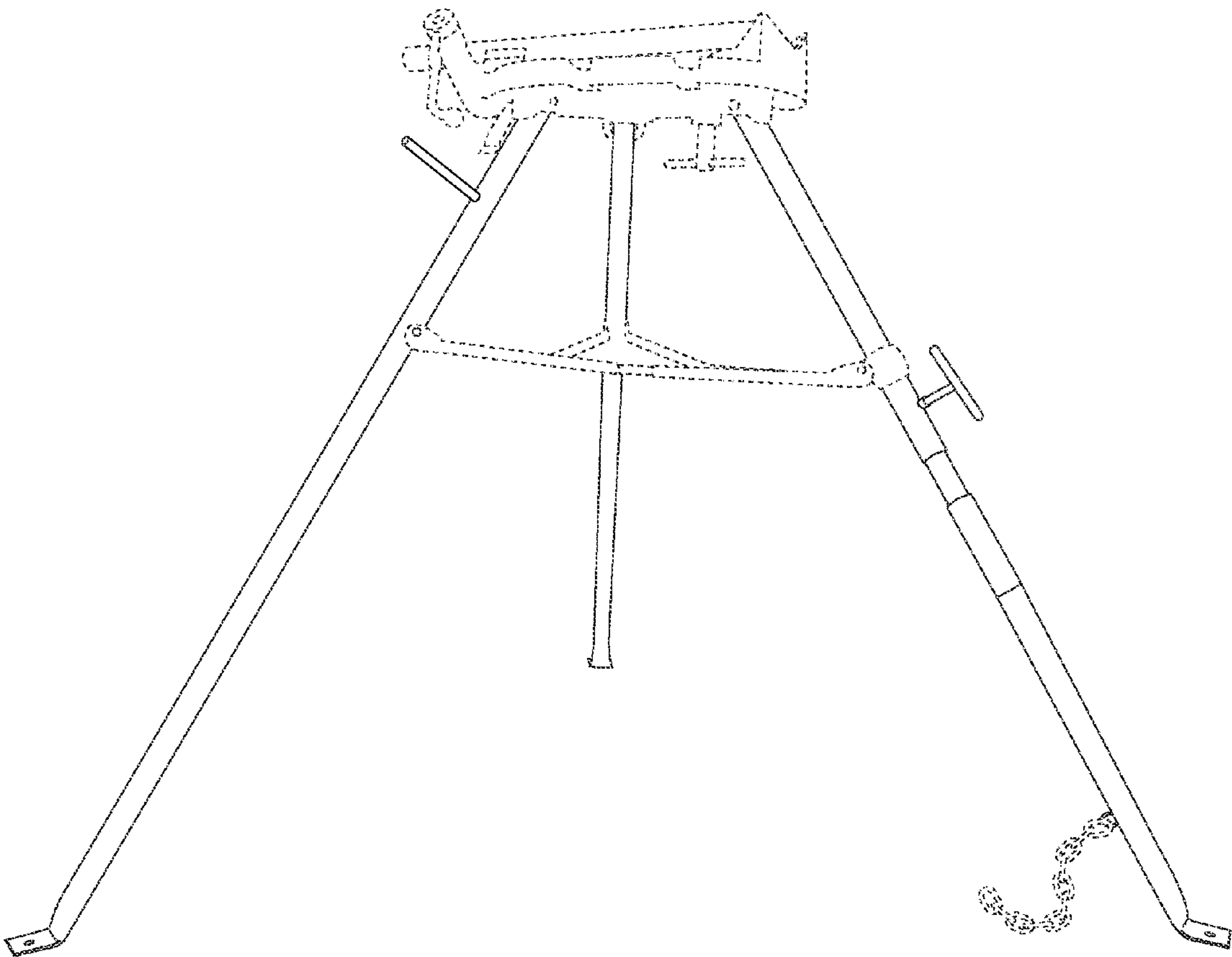

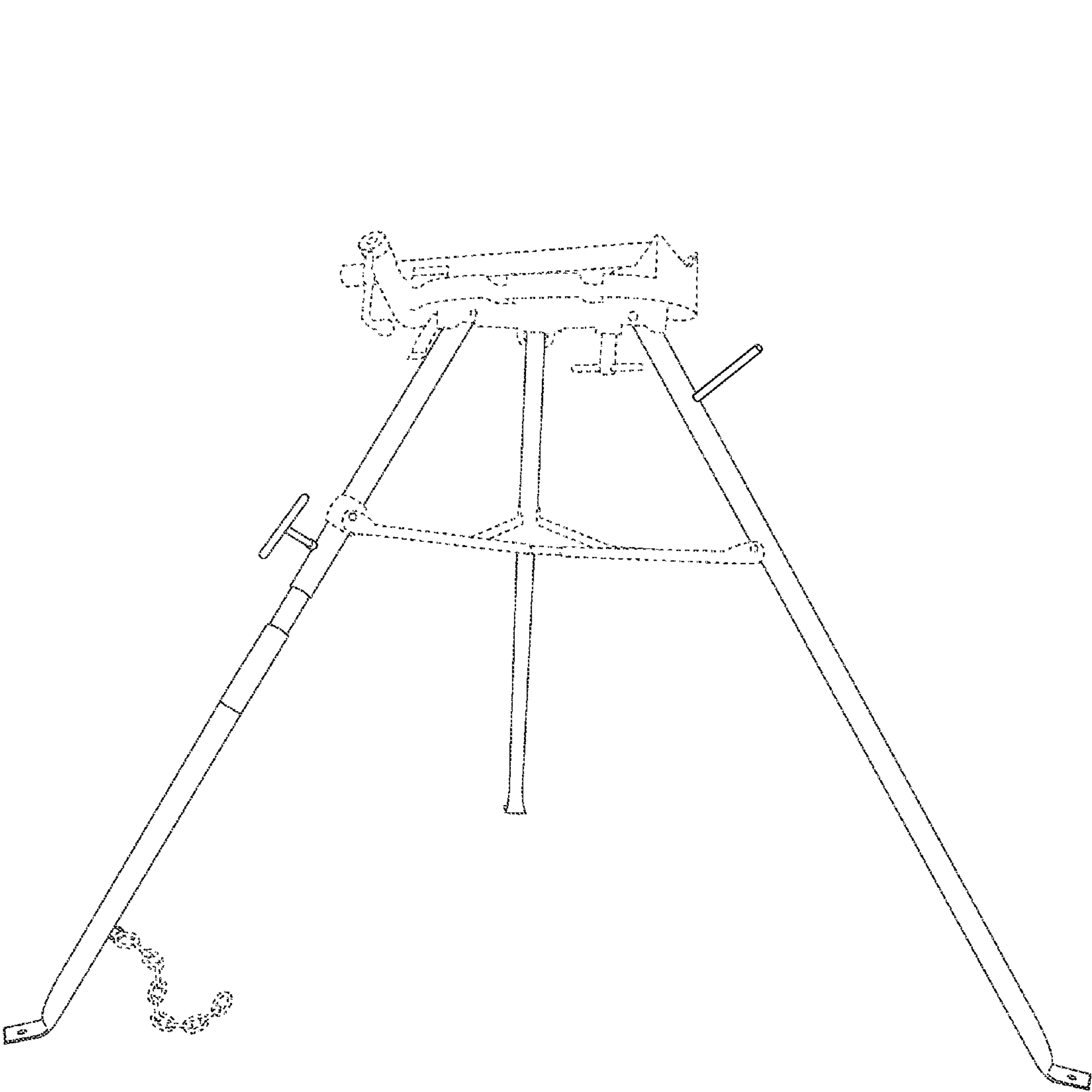

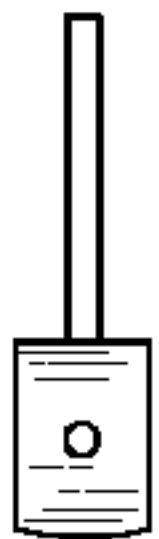

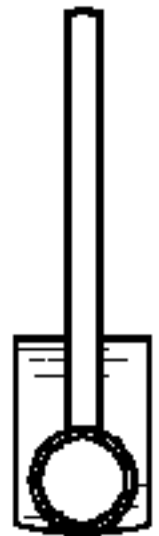

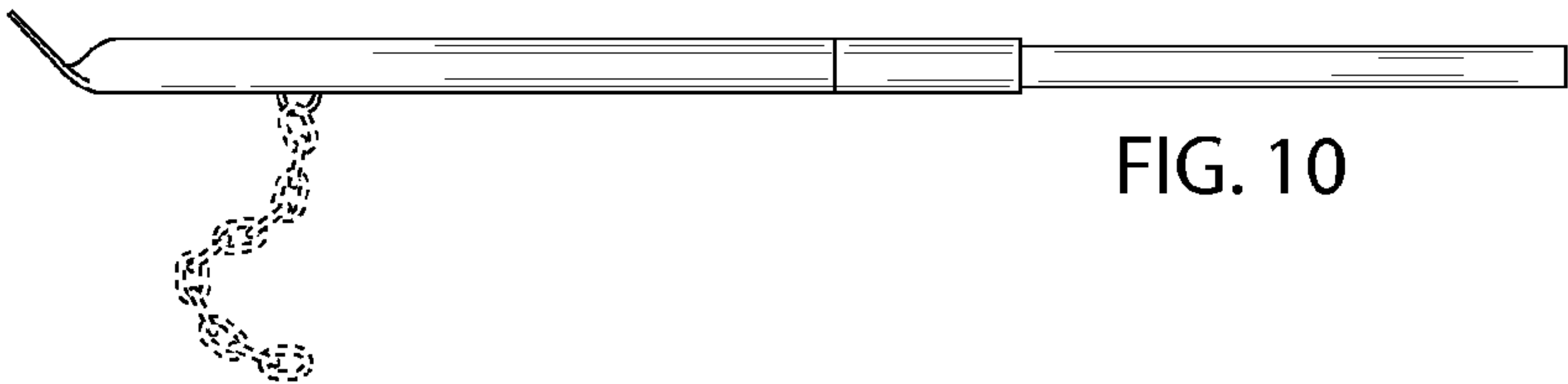

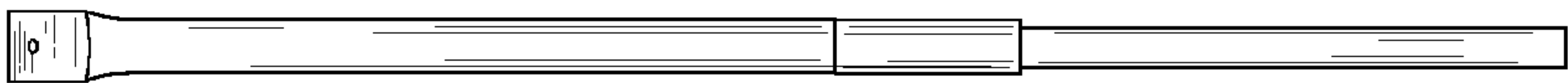

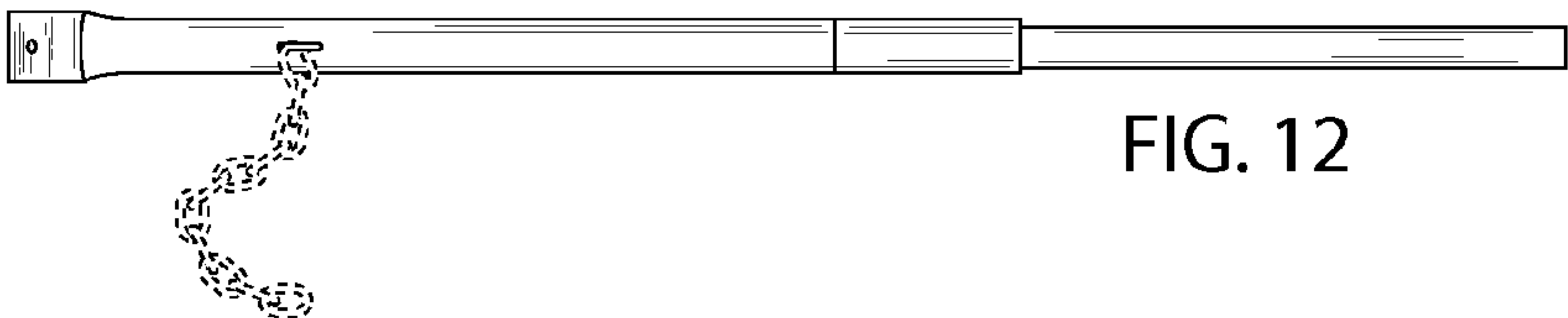

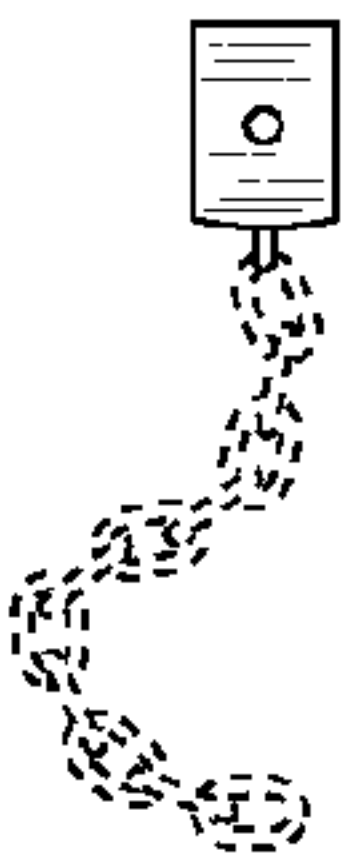

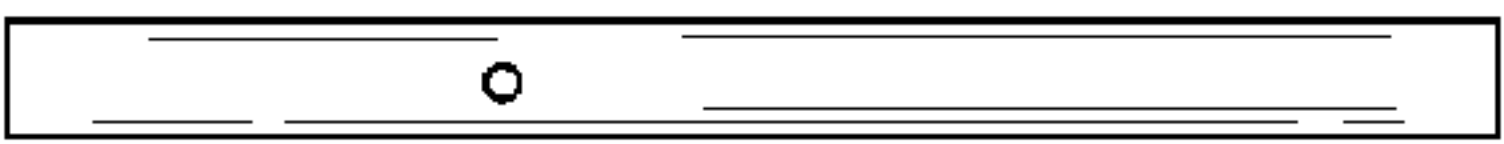

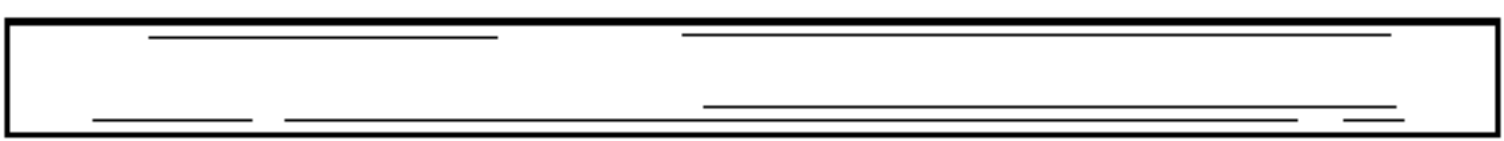

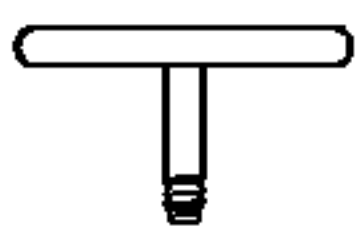

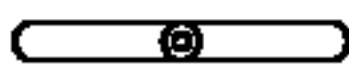
