FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof.

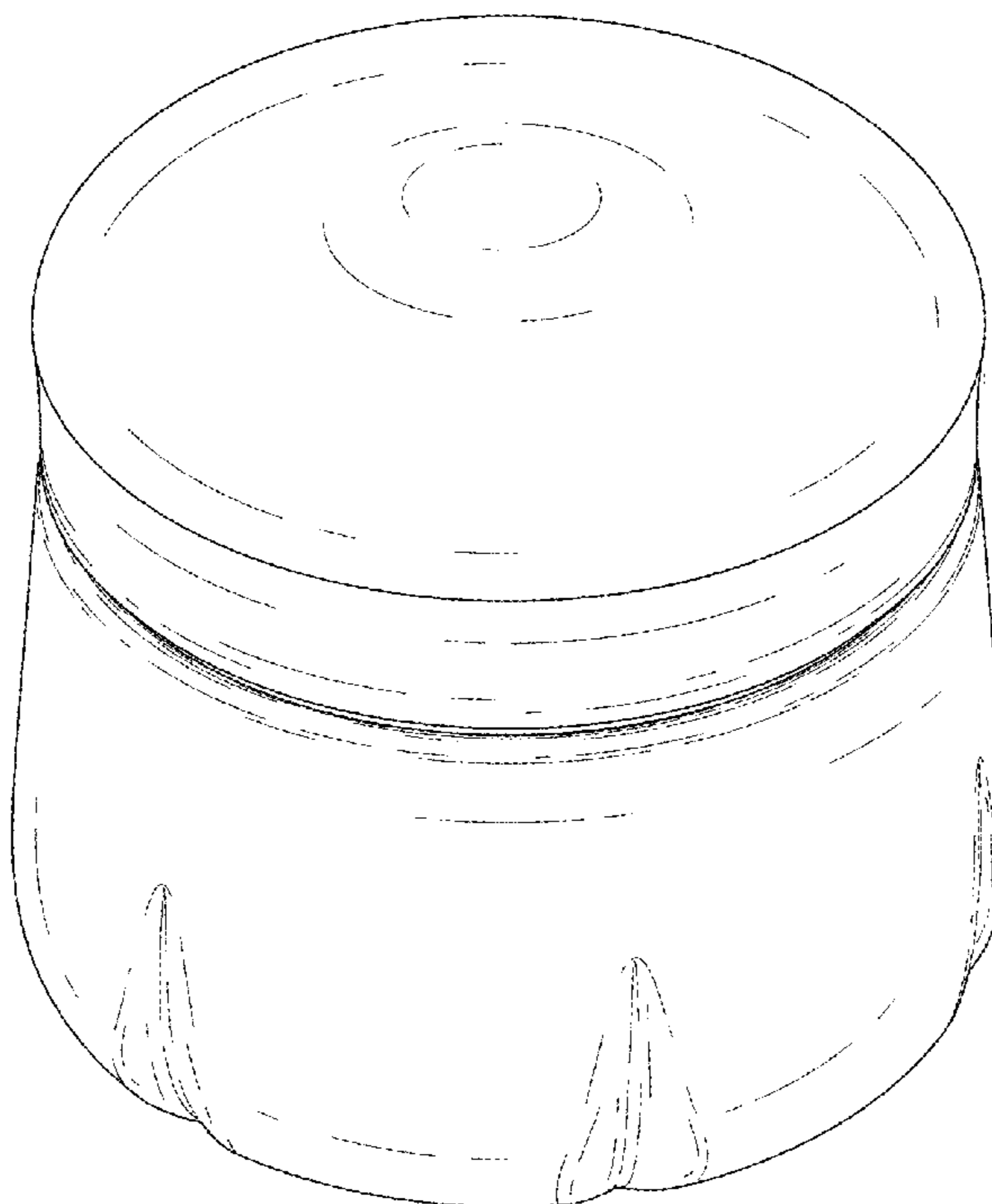
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof.

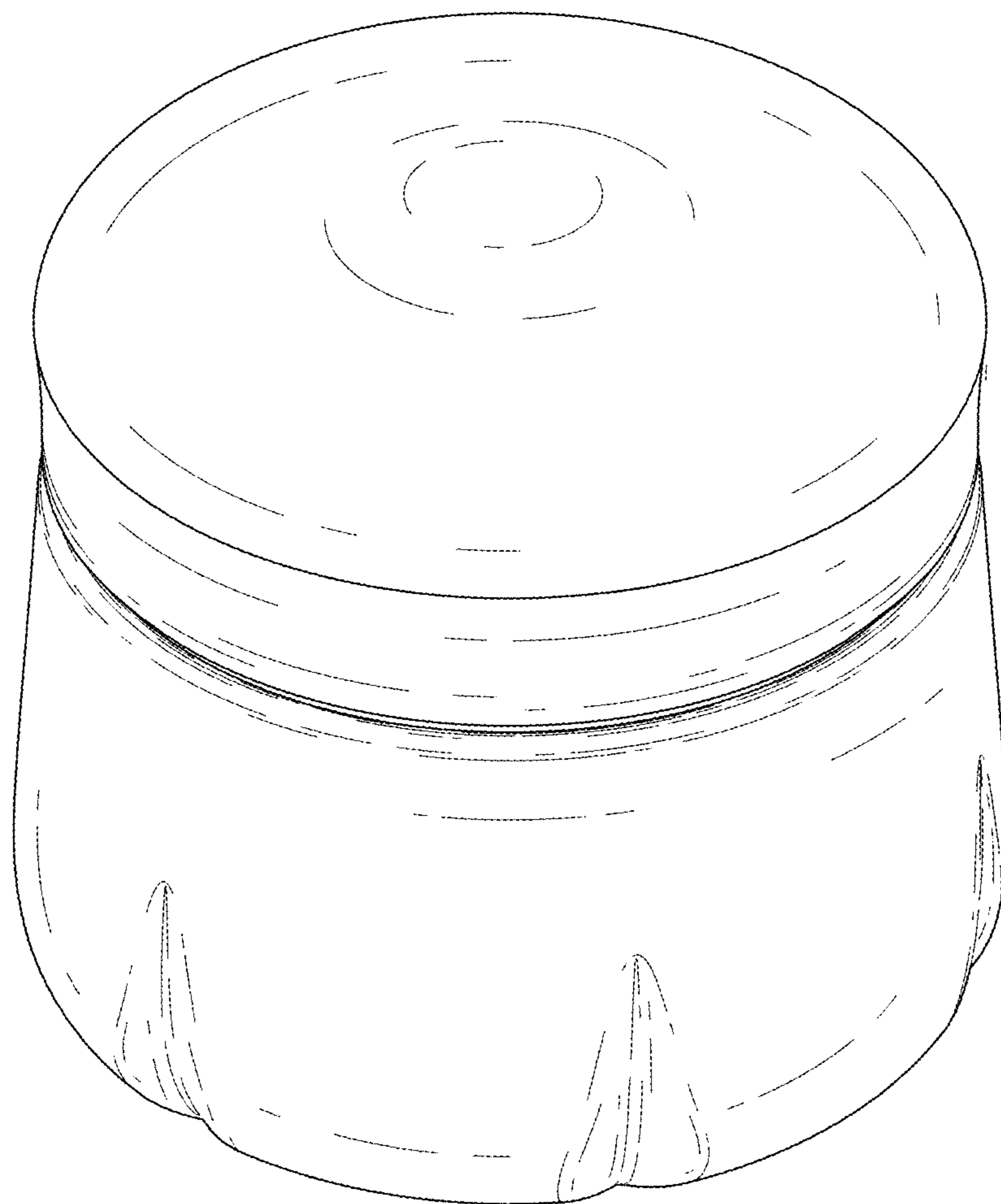
FIG. 4 is a front elevation view thereof; the rear elevation view is identical thereto; and,

FIG. 5 is a left side elevation view thereof; the right side elevation view is identical thereto.

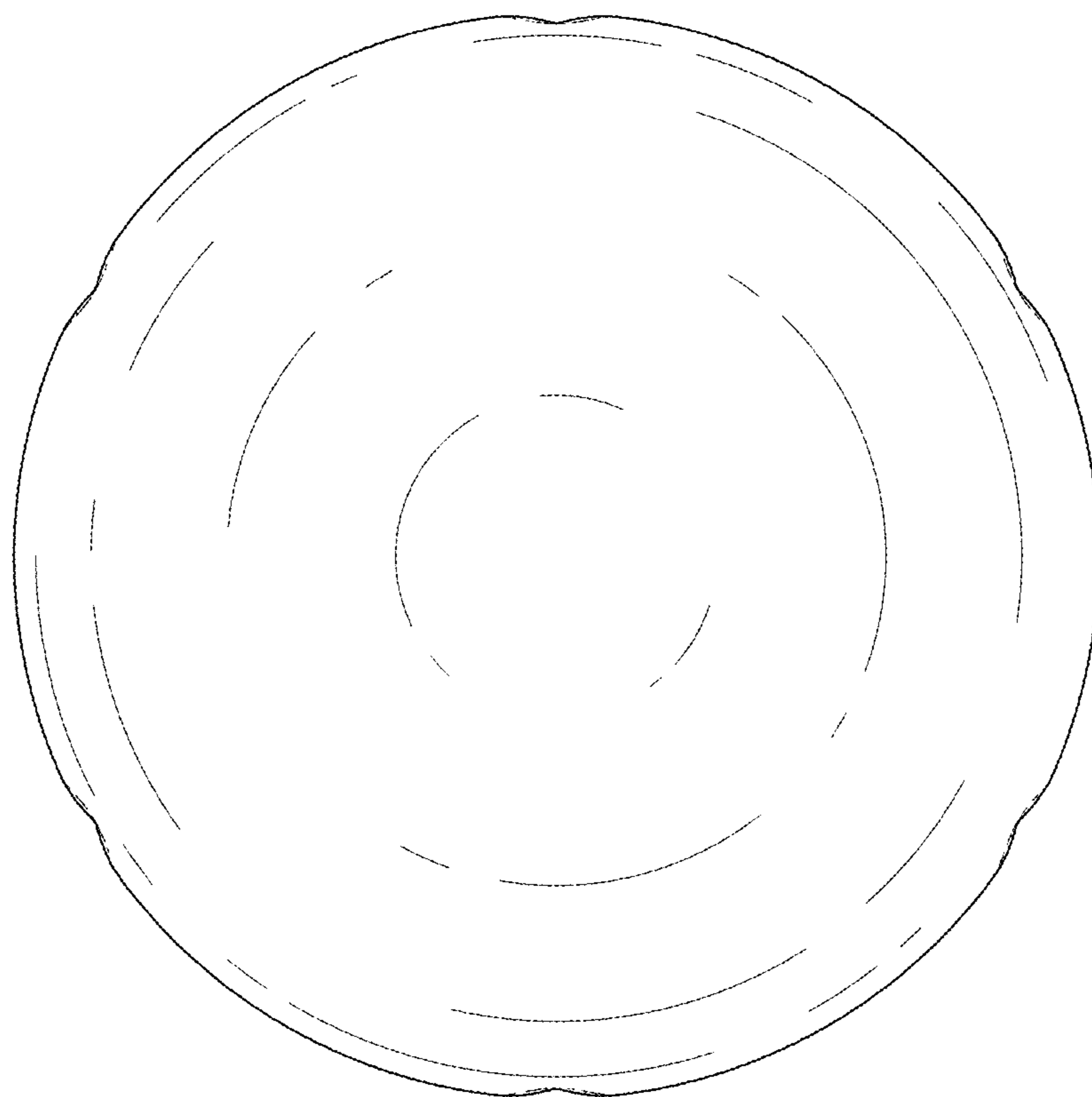

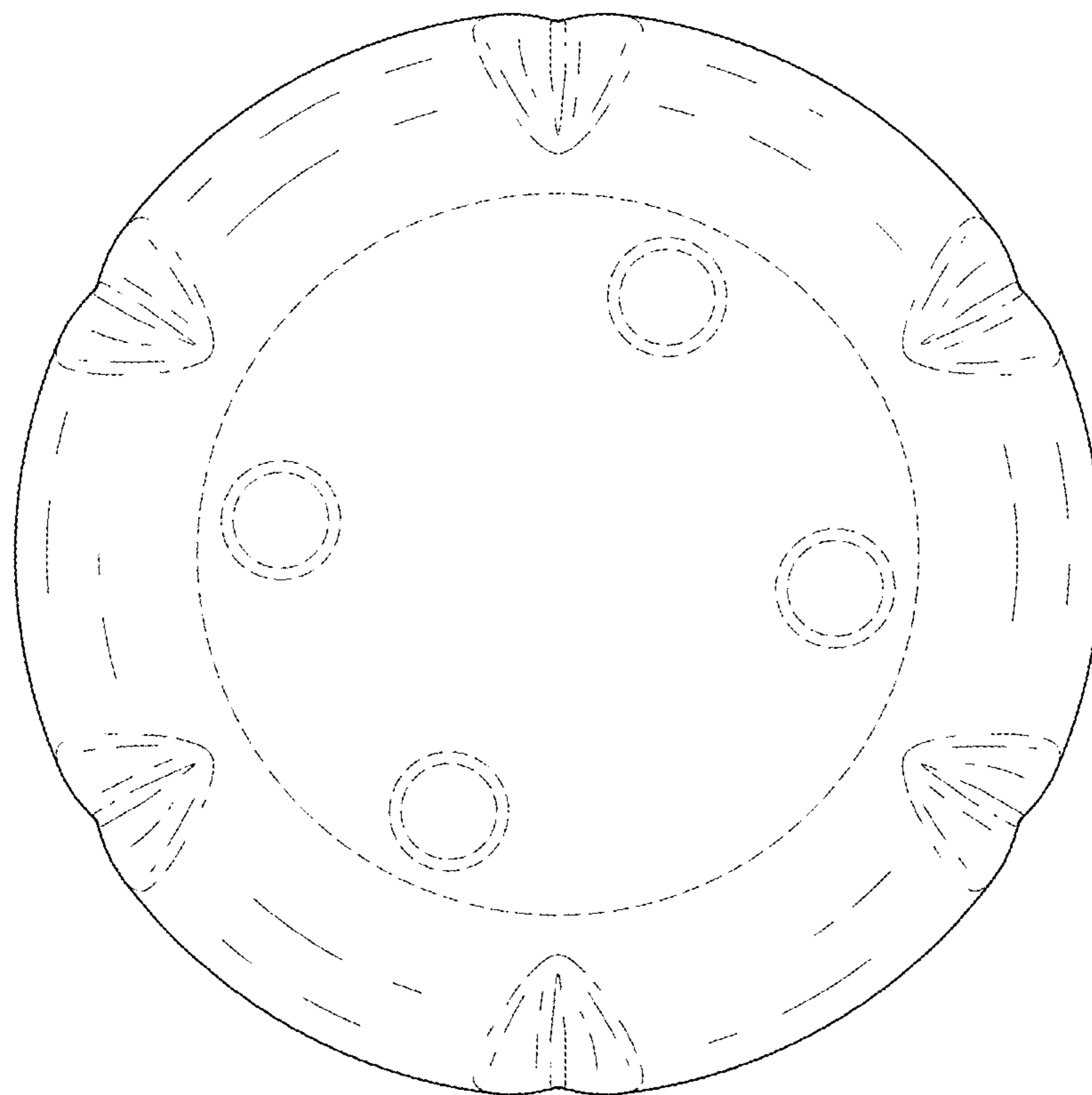




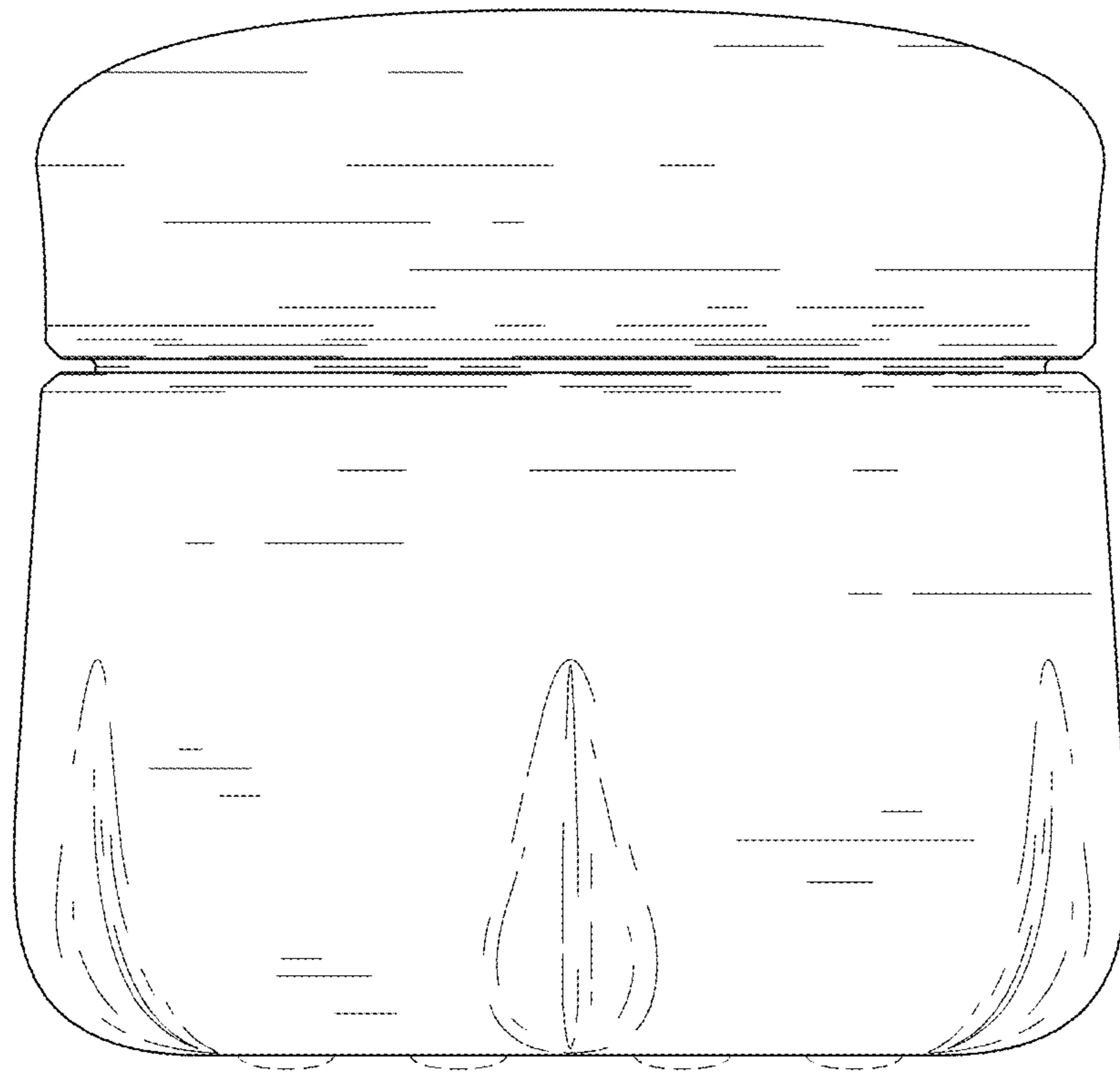

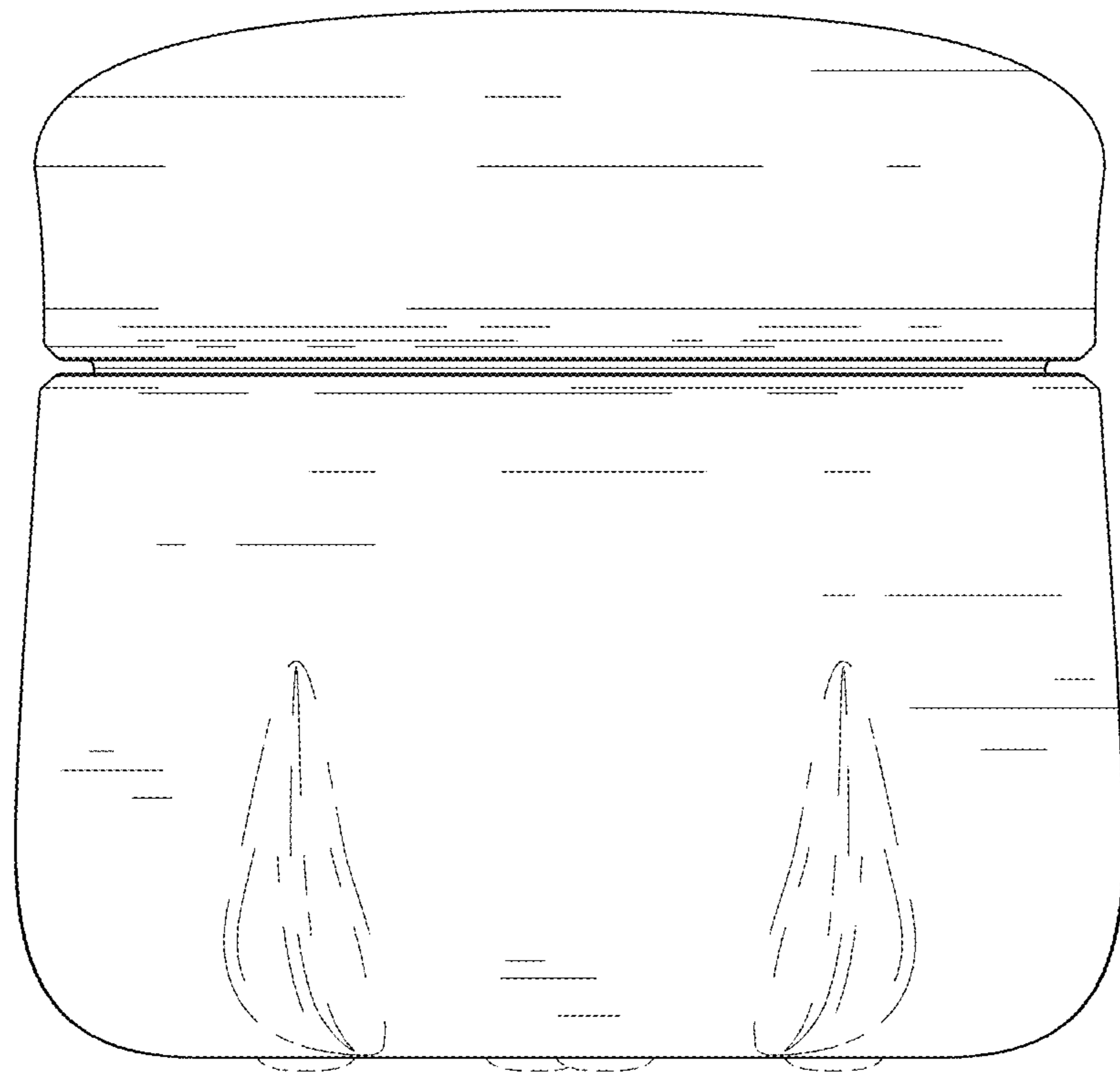
