FIG. 9 is a bottom view thereof;

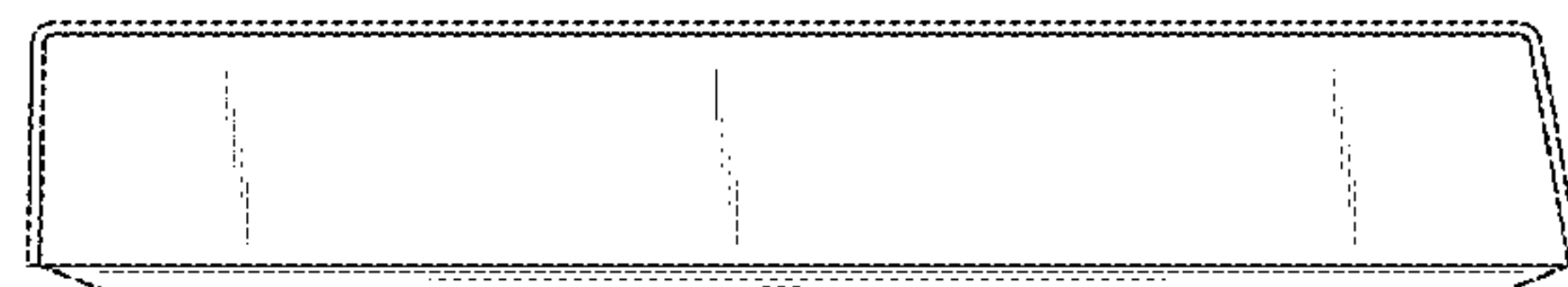
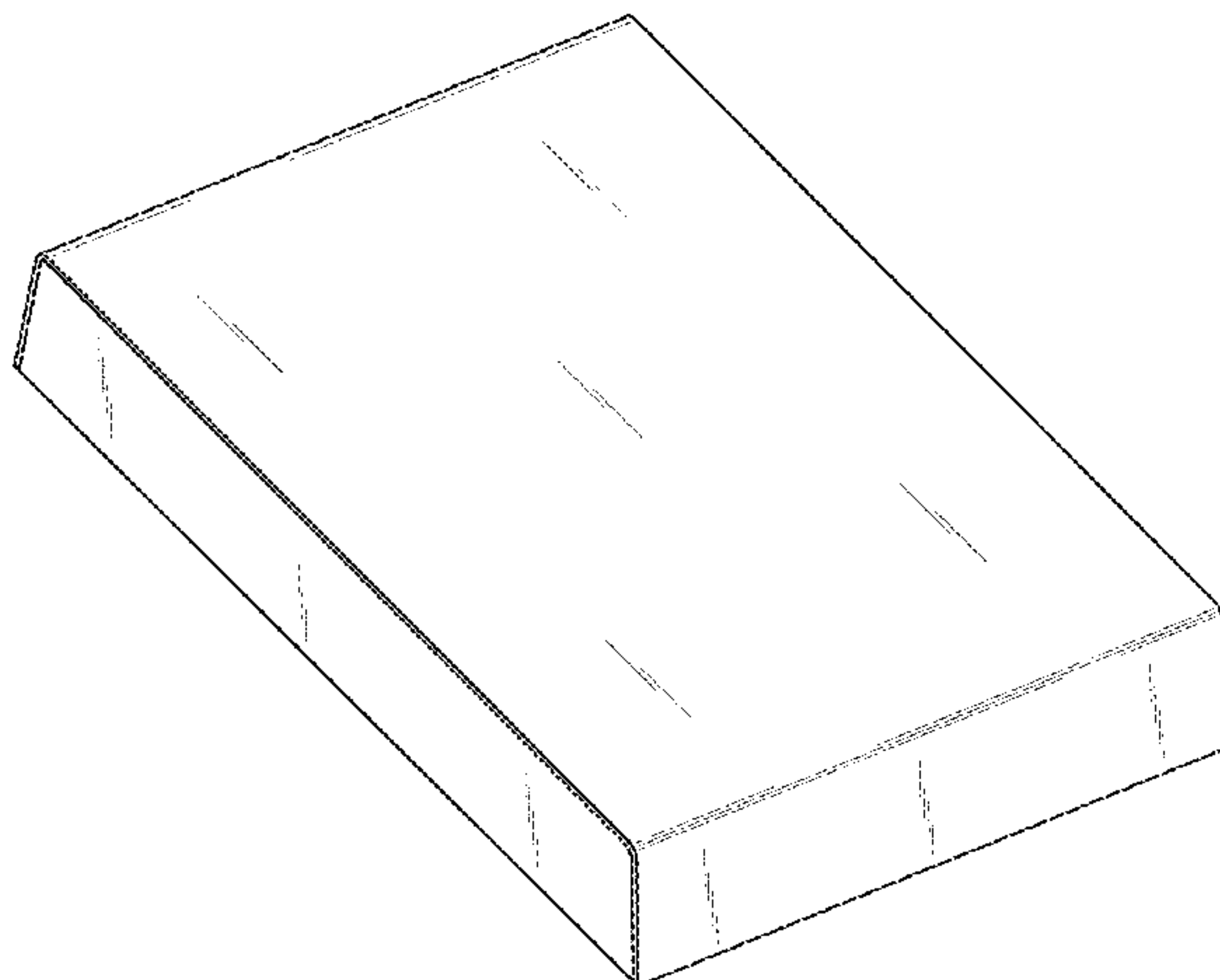
FIG. 10 is a front view thereof;

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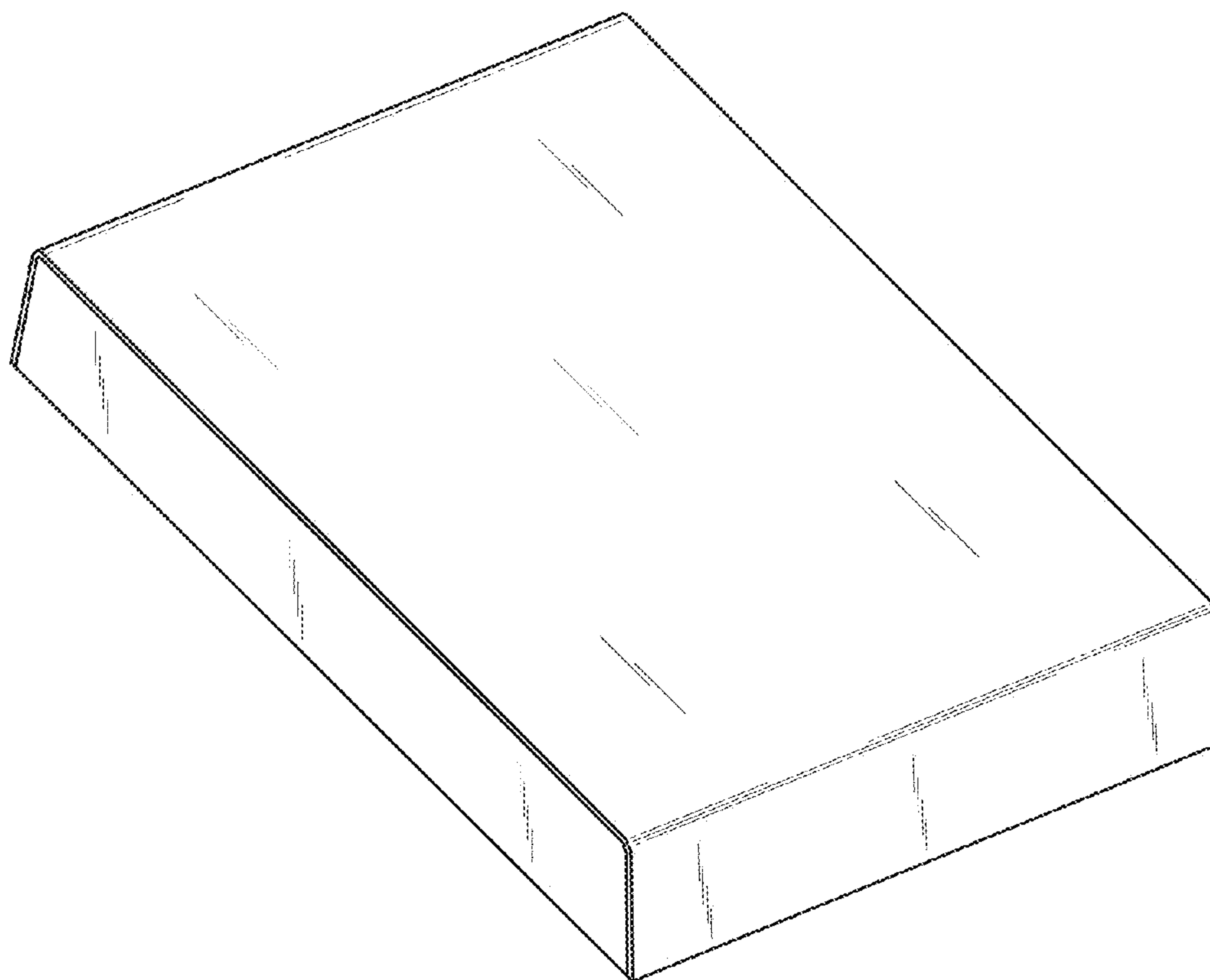

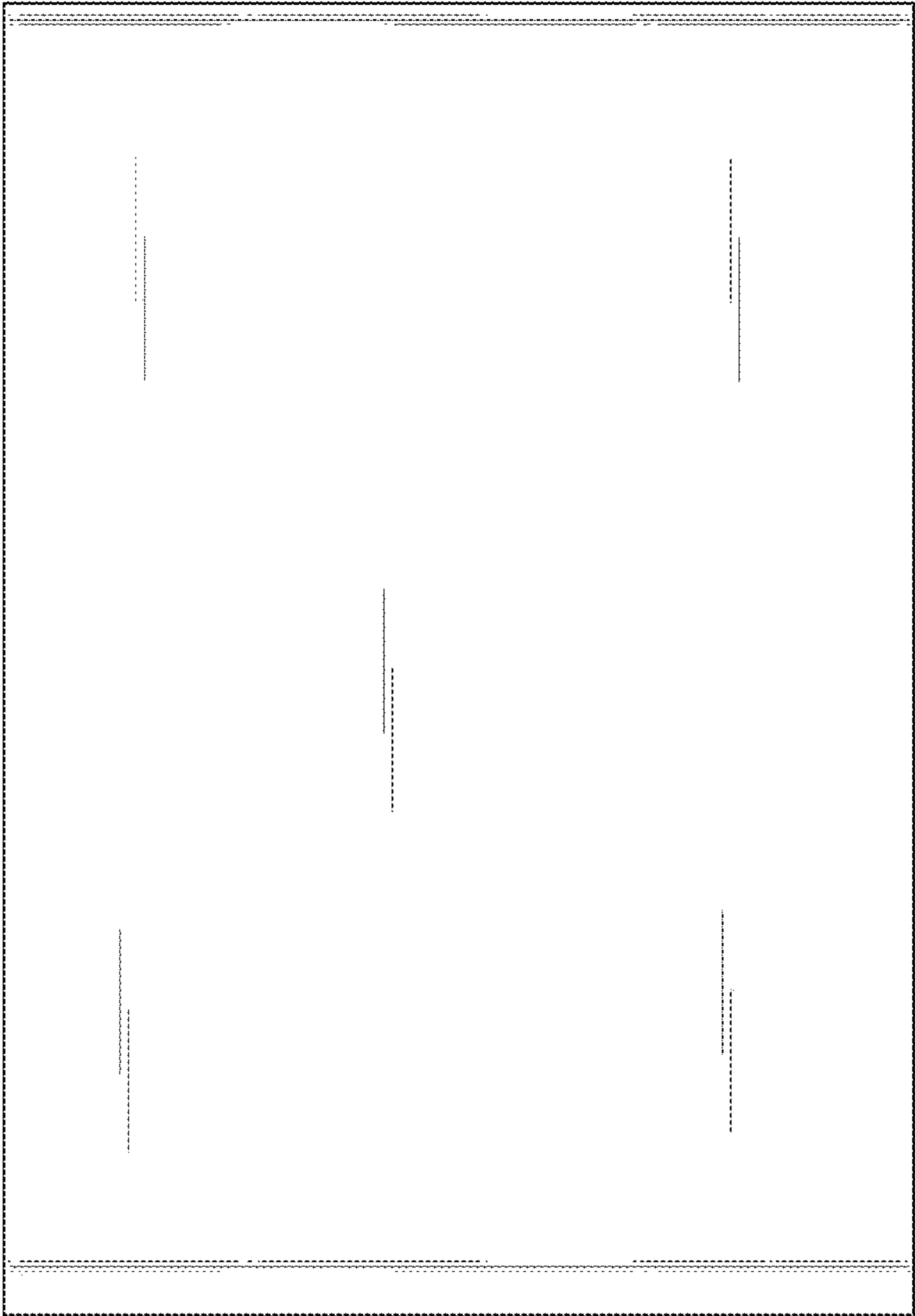

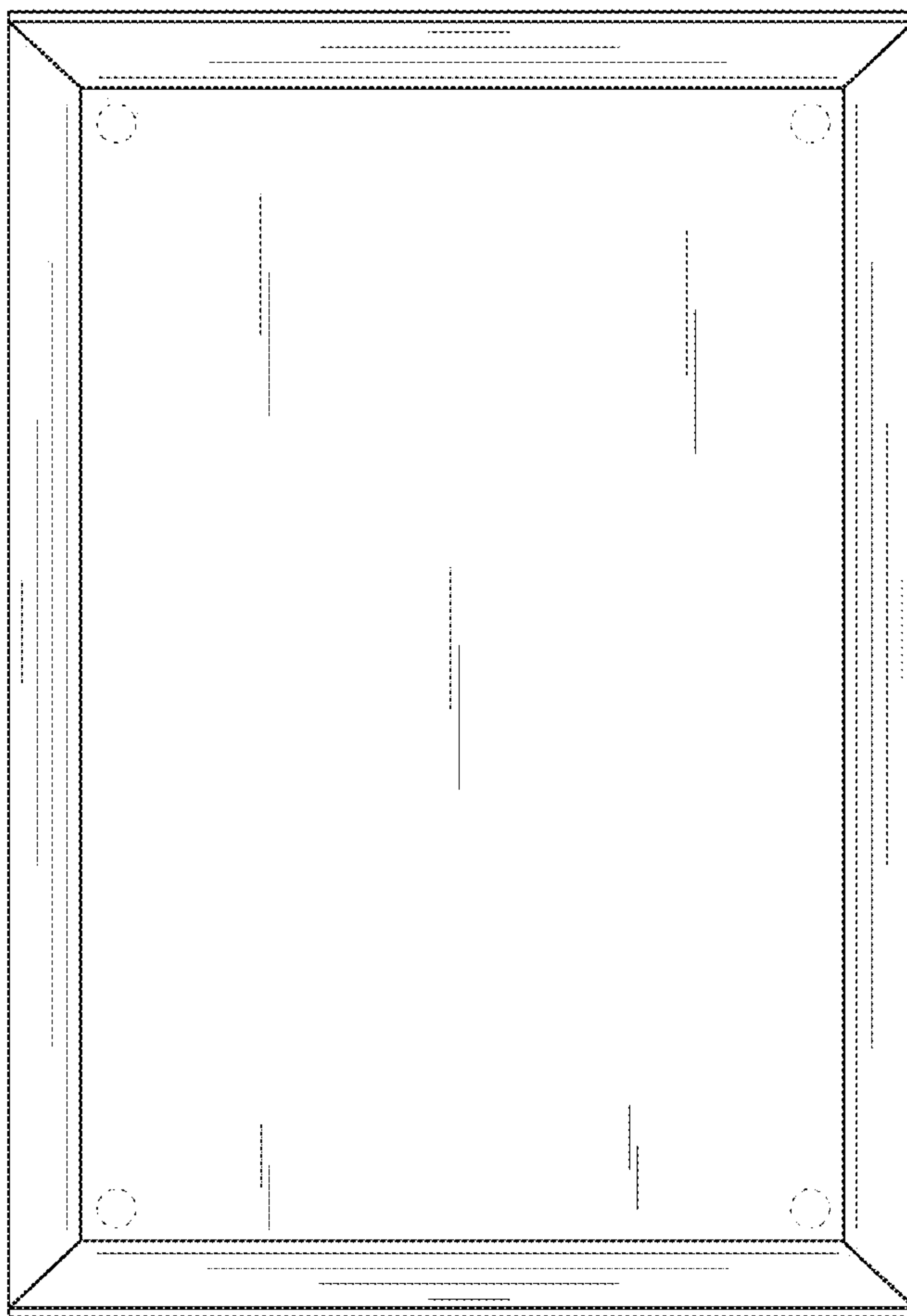

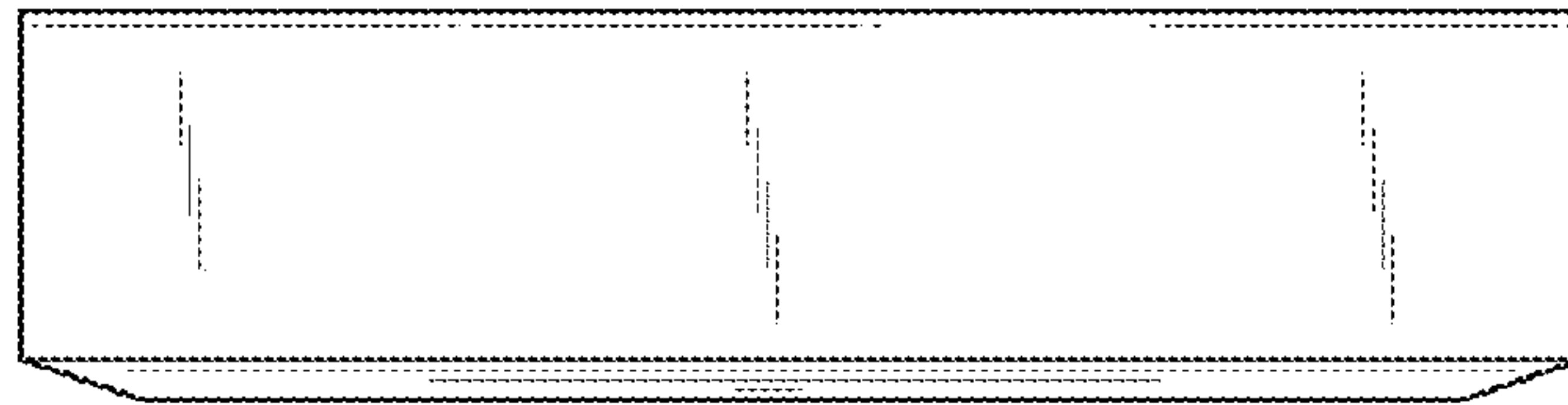

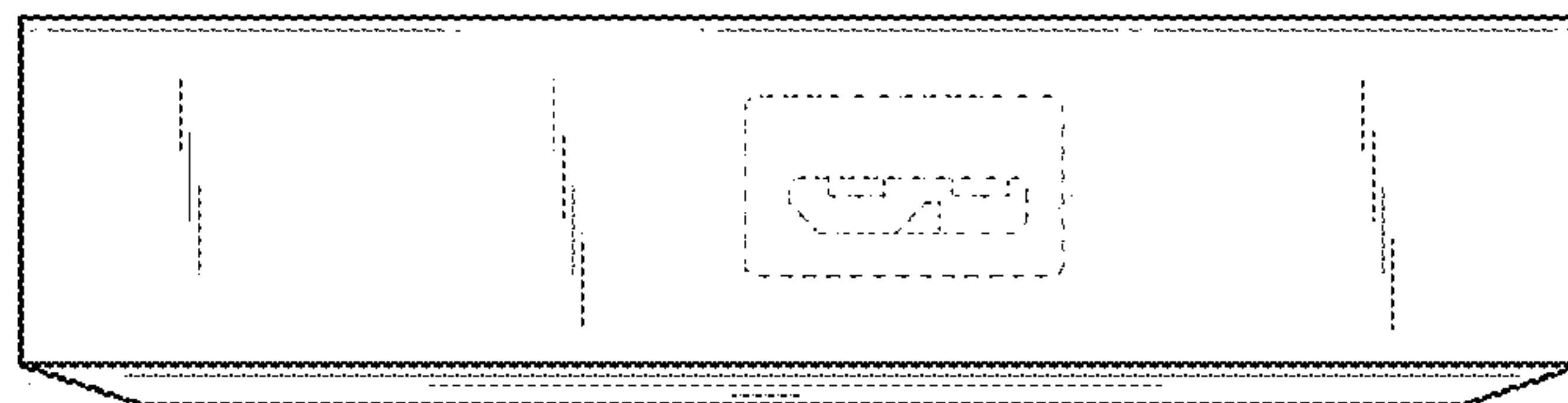

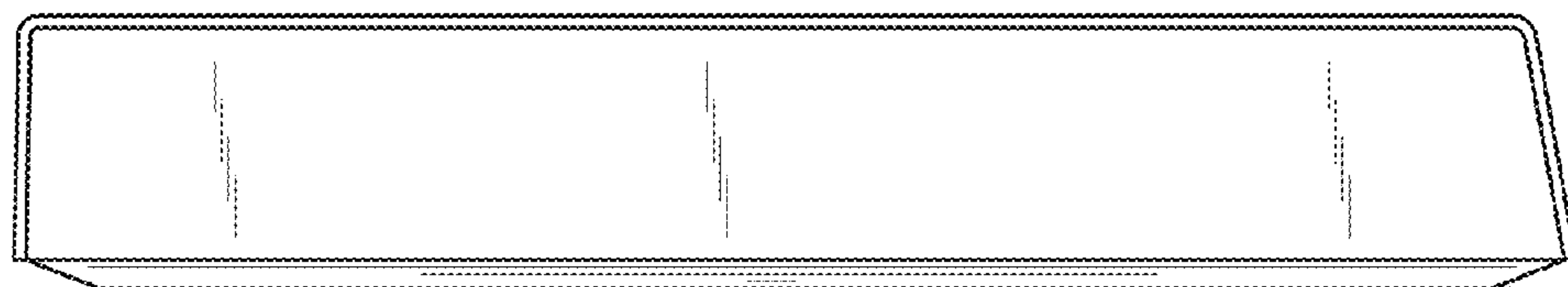

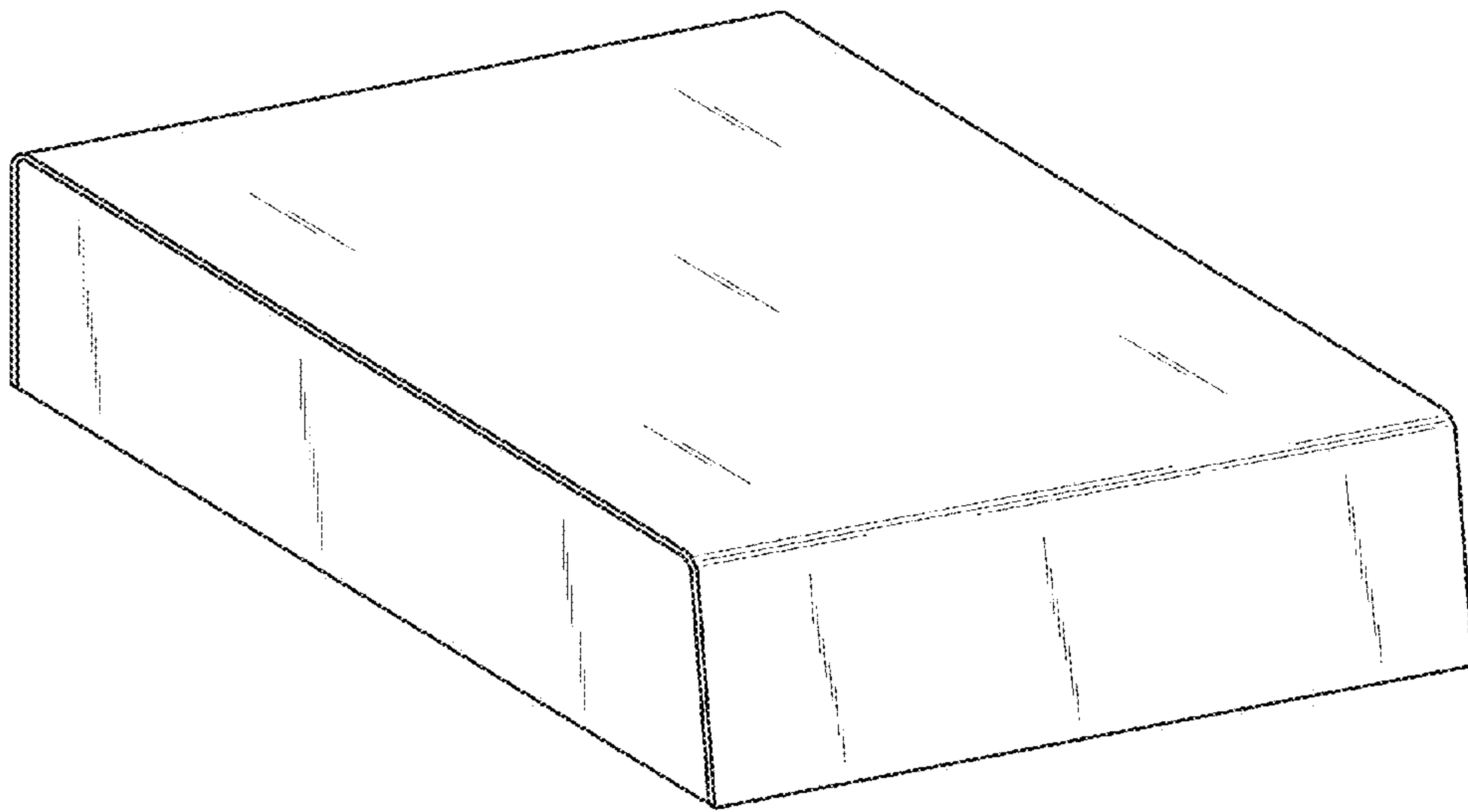

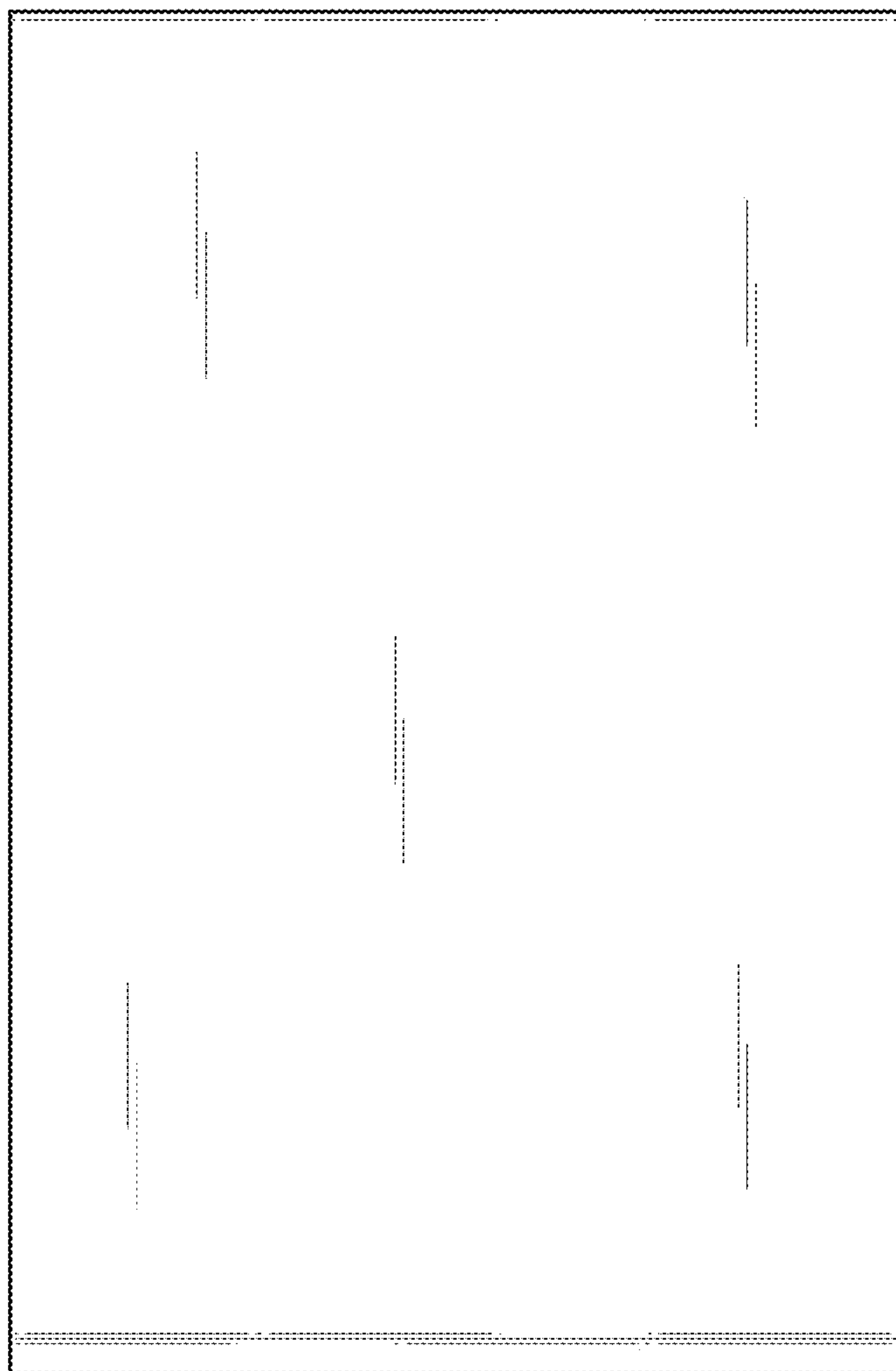

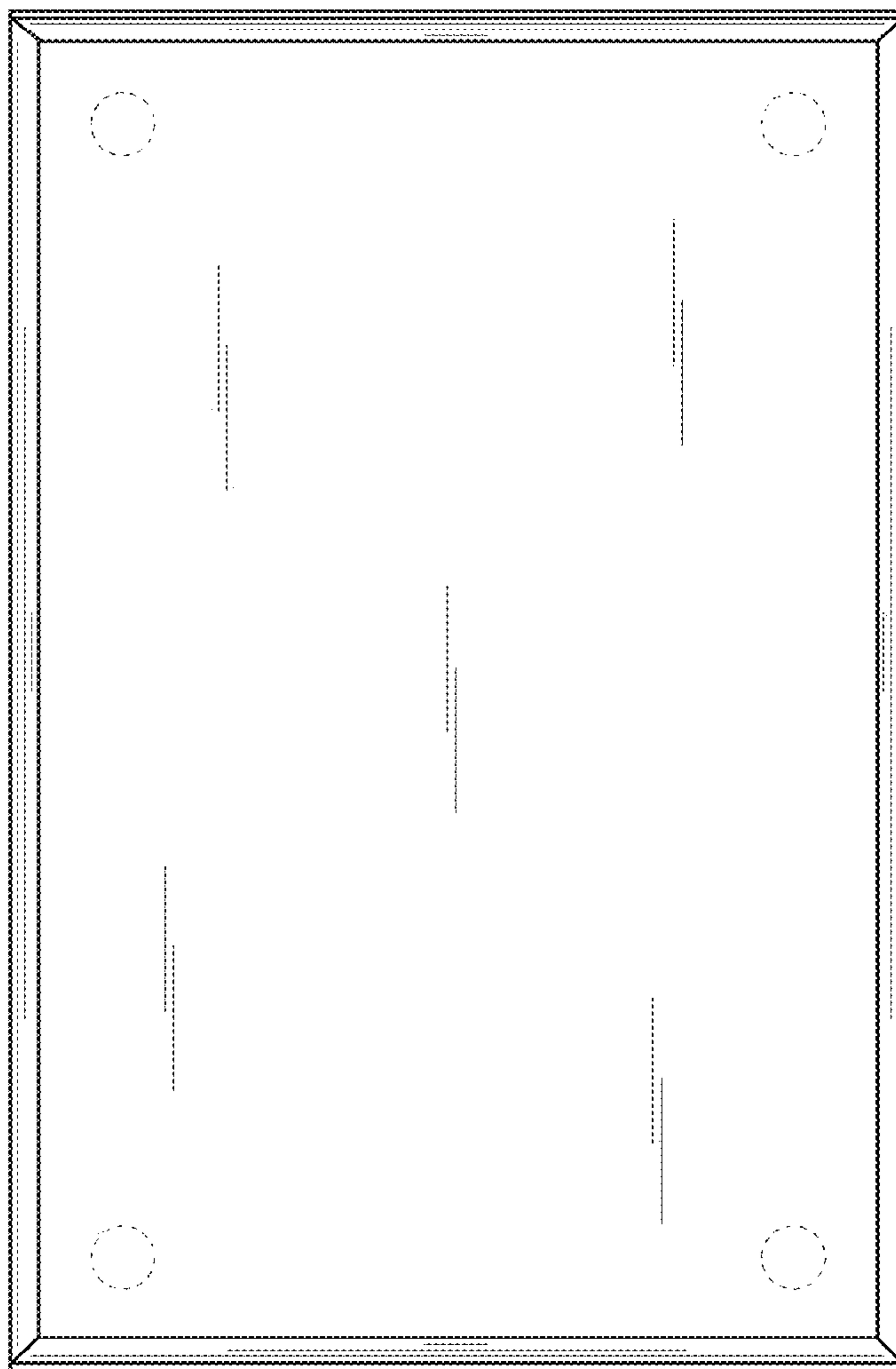

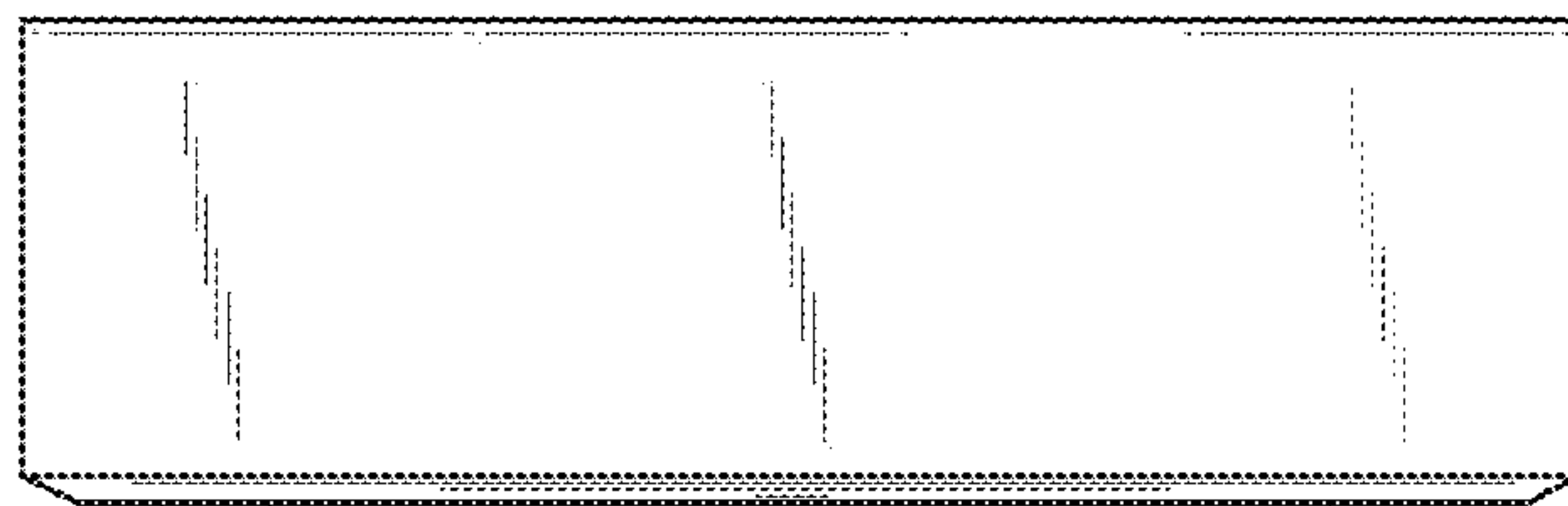

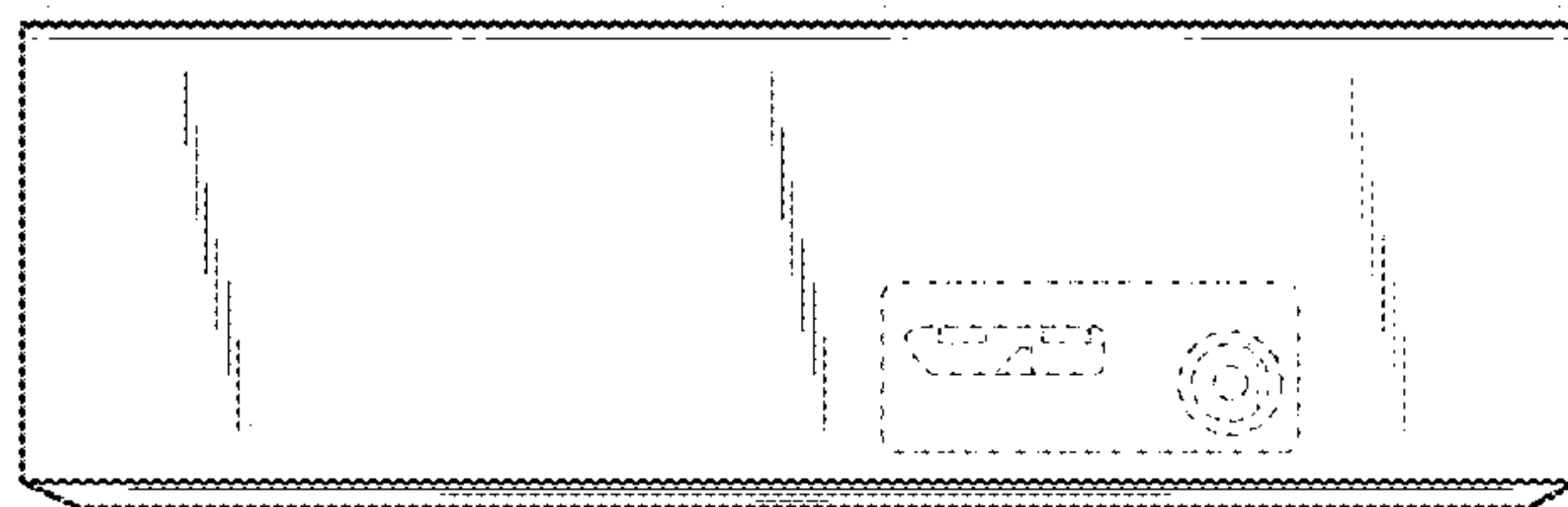

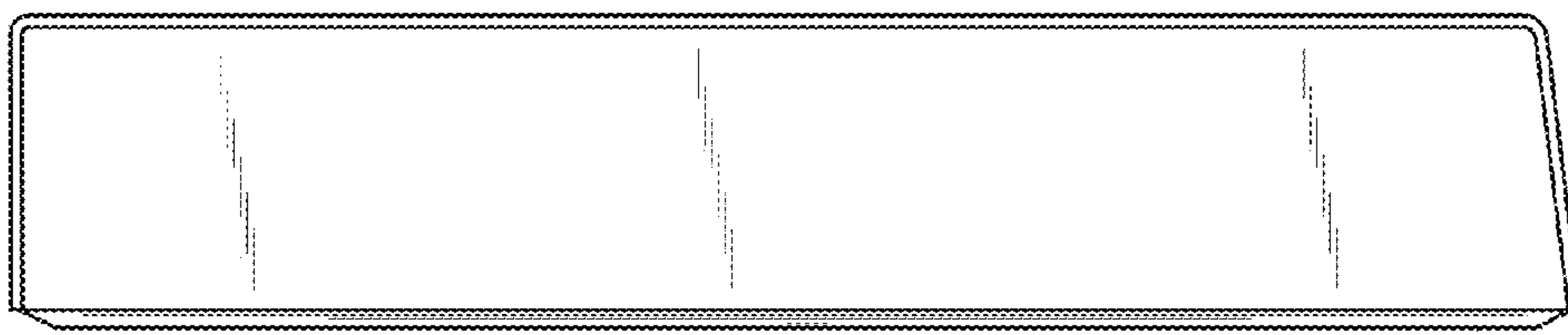
