FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a muzzle brake, showing my new design;

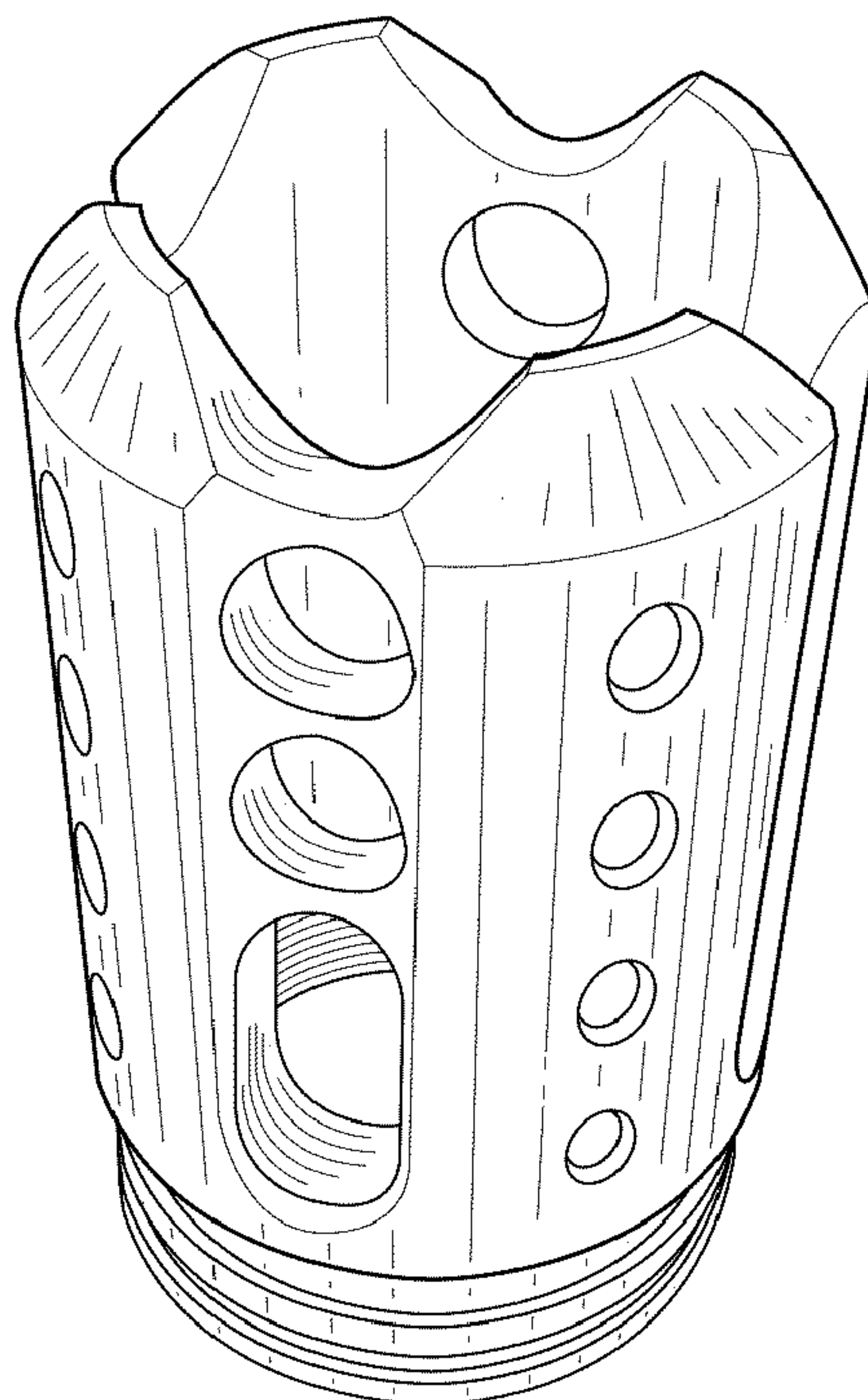
FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof;

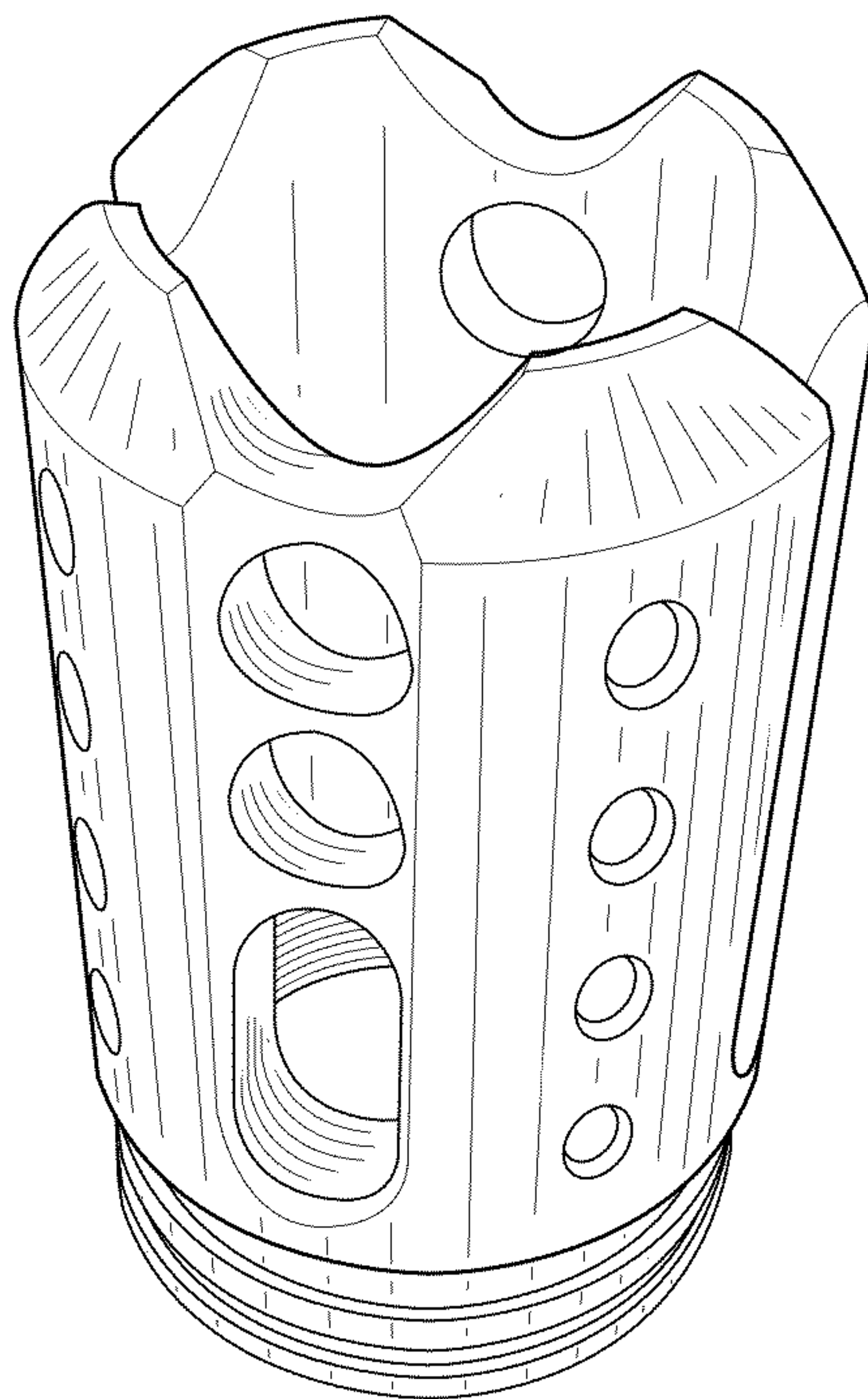

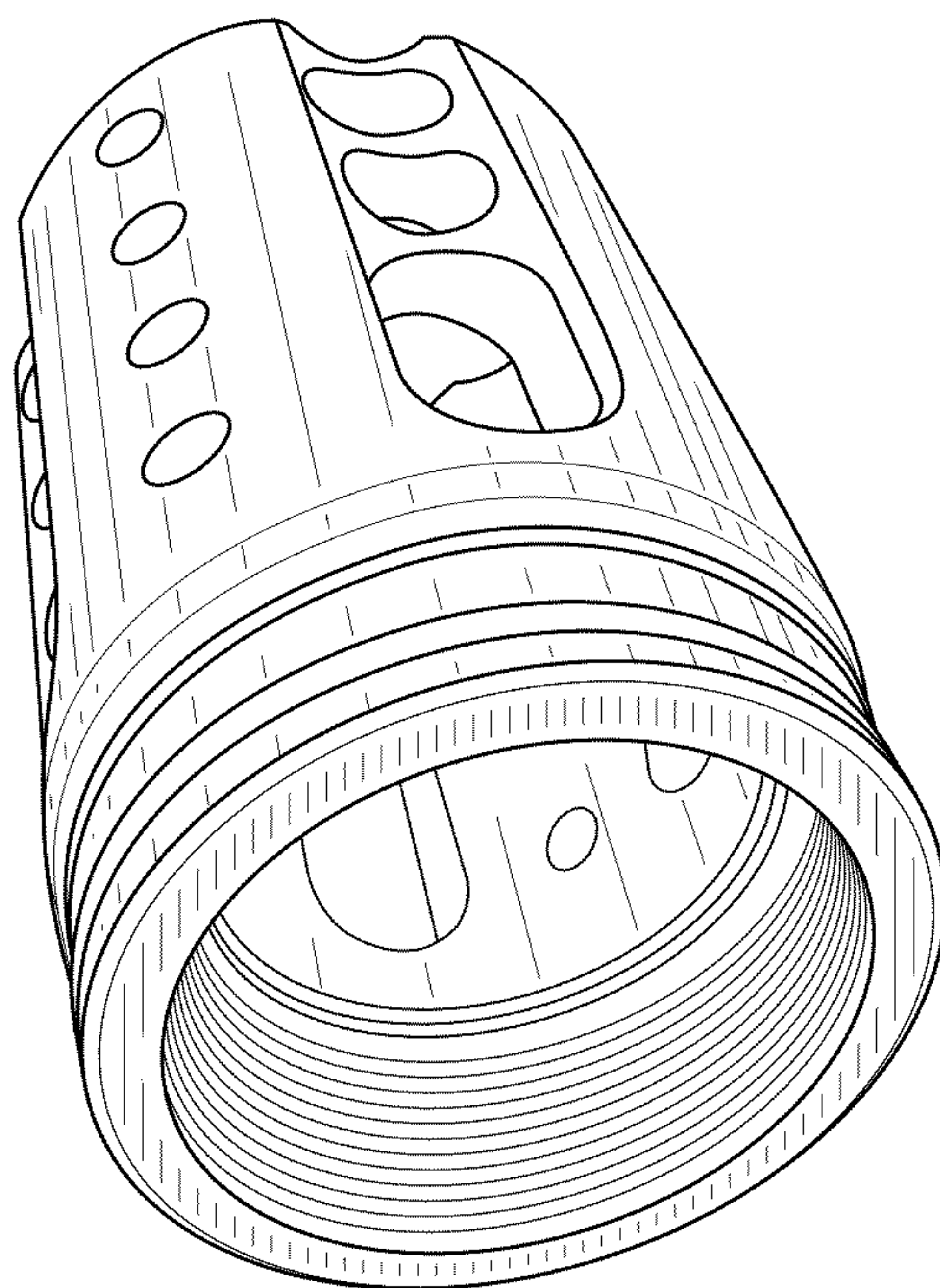

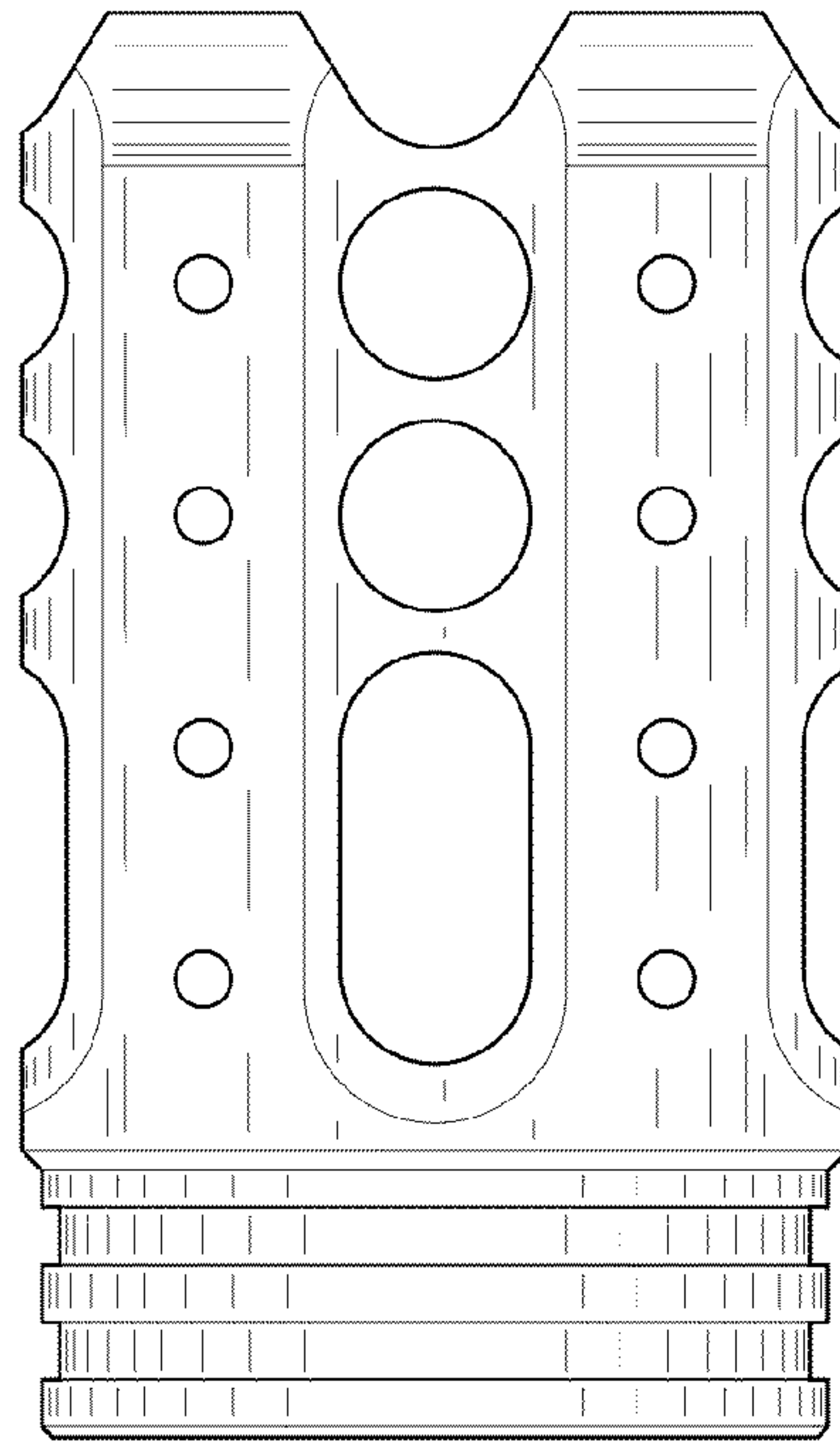

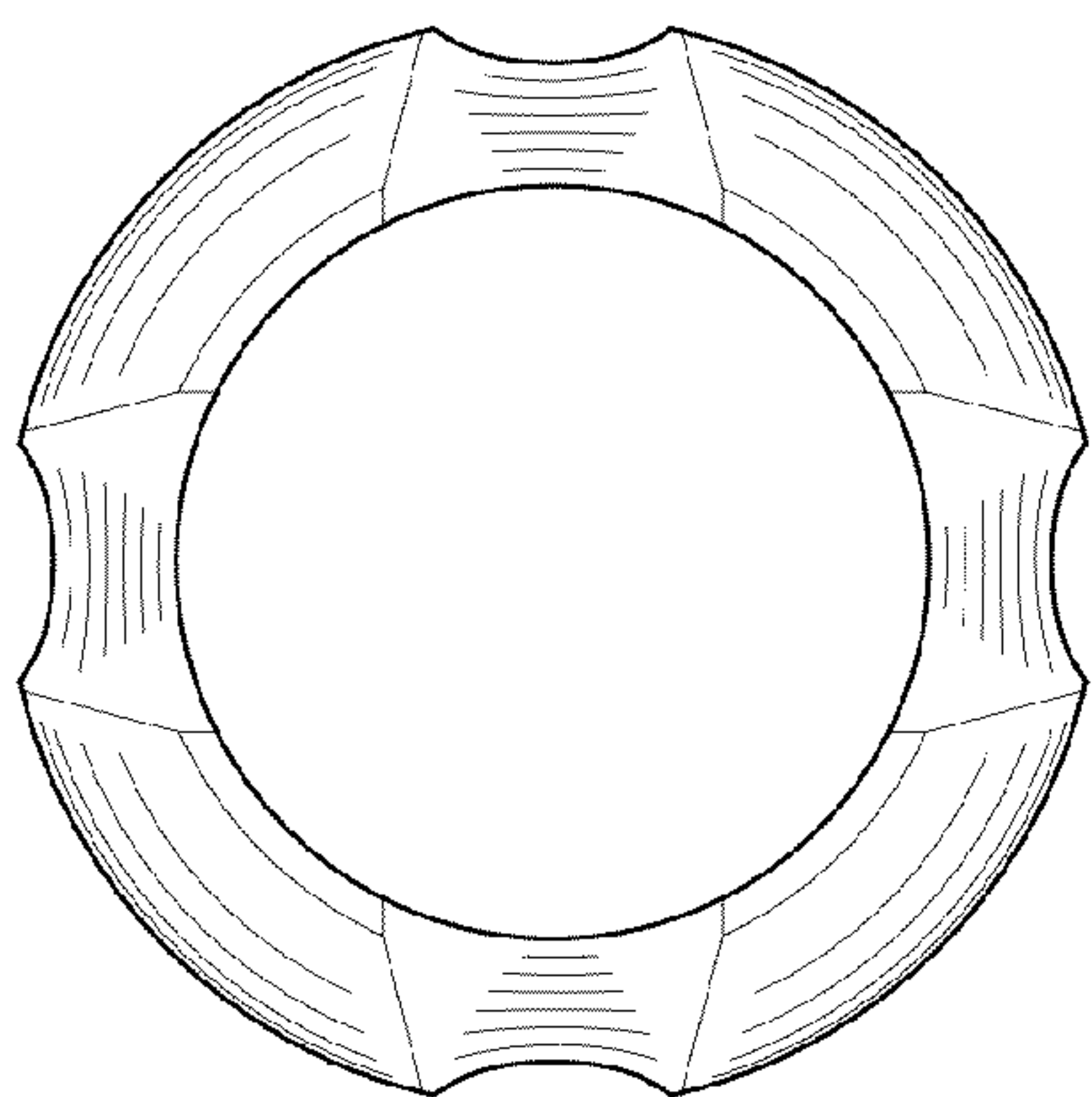

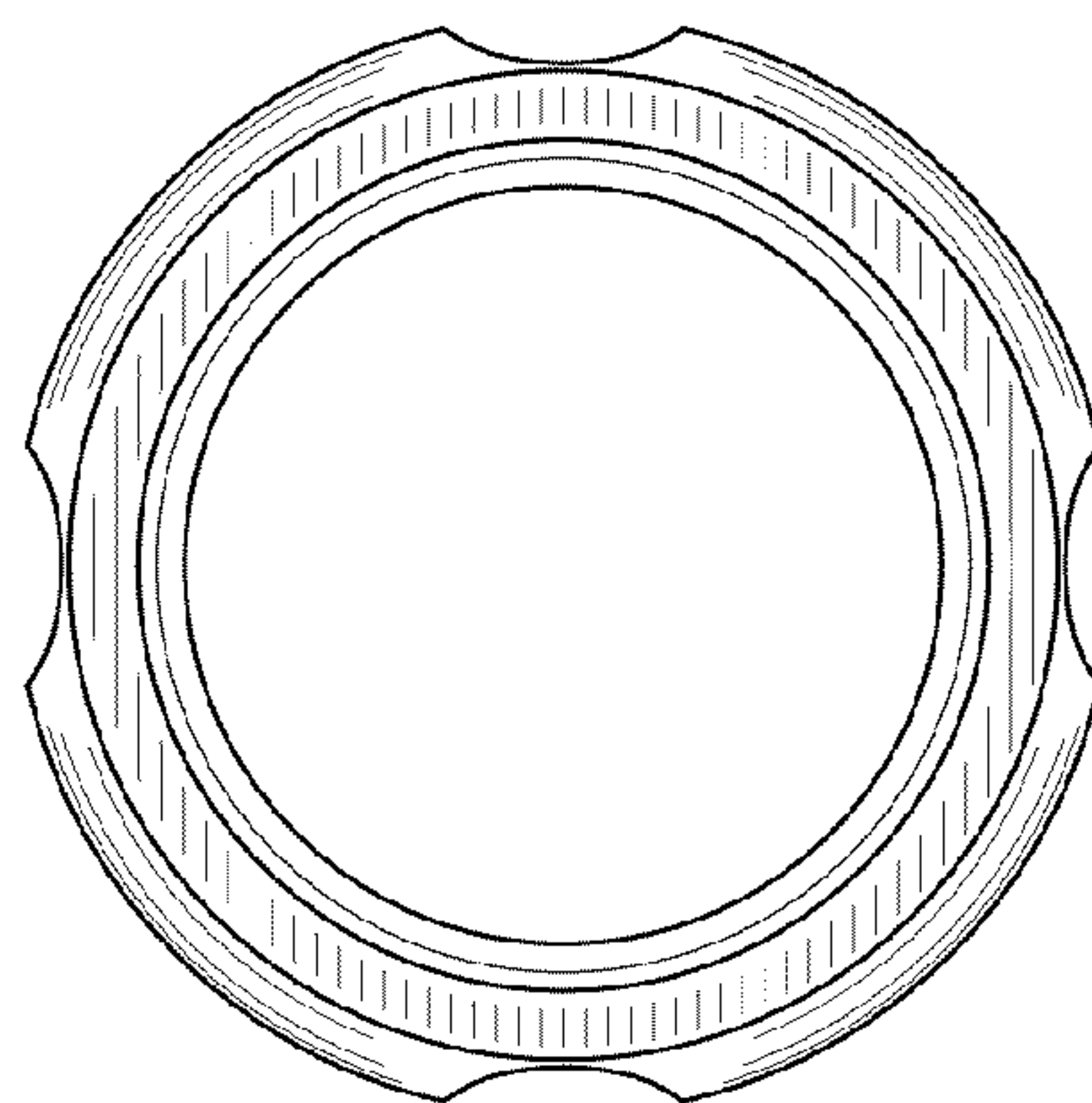
