(57) **CLAIM**

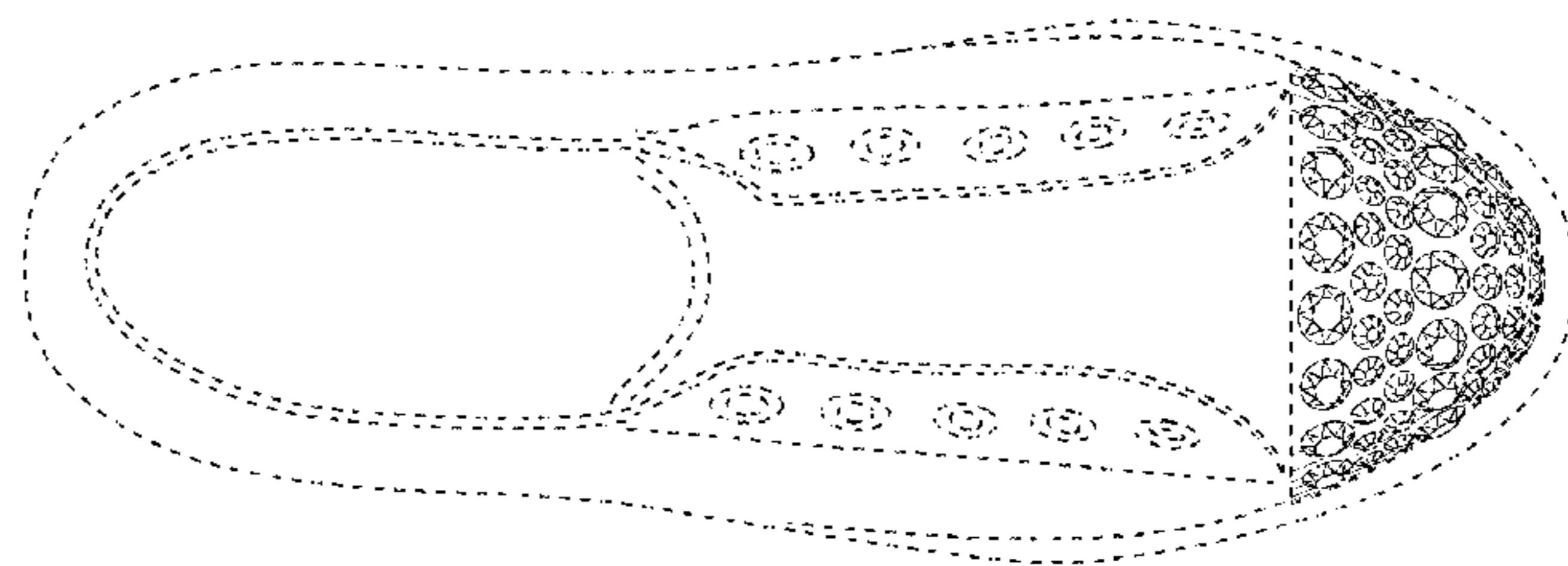
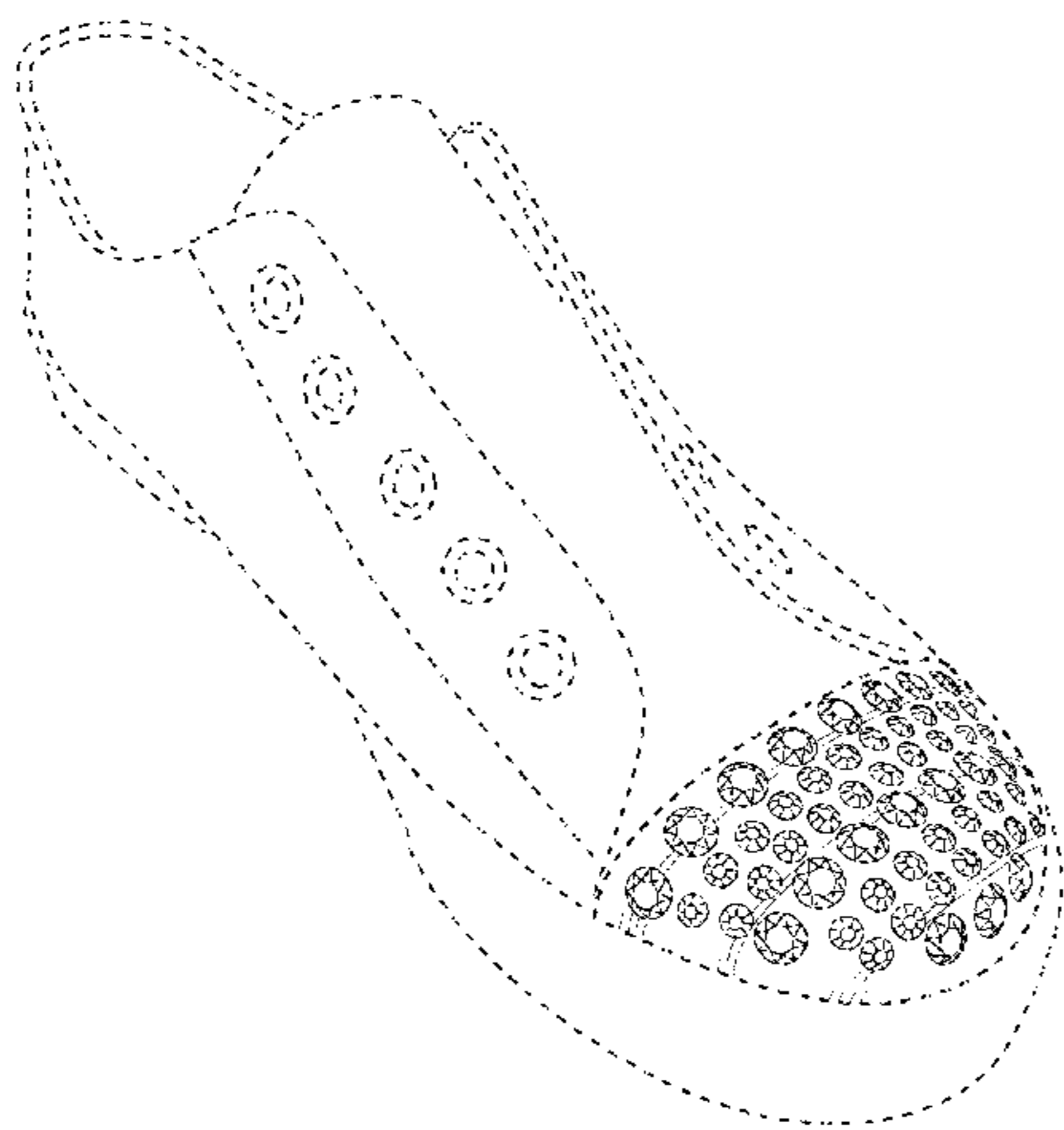
I claim the ornamental design for a toe cap for shoe, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a shoe having a toe cap embodying the new design;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view of the shoe of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view of the shoe of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of the shoe of FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a back elevational view of the shoe of FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the shoe of FIG. 1.

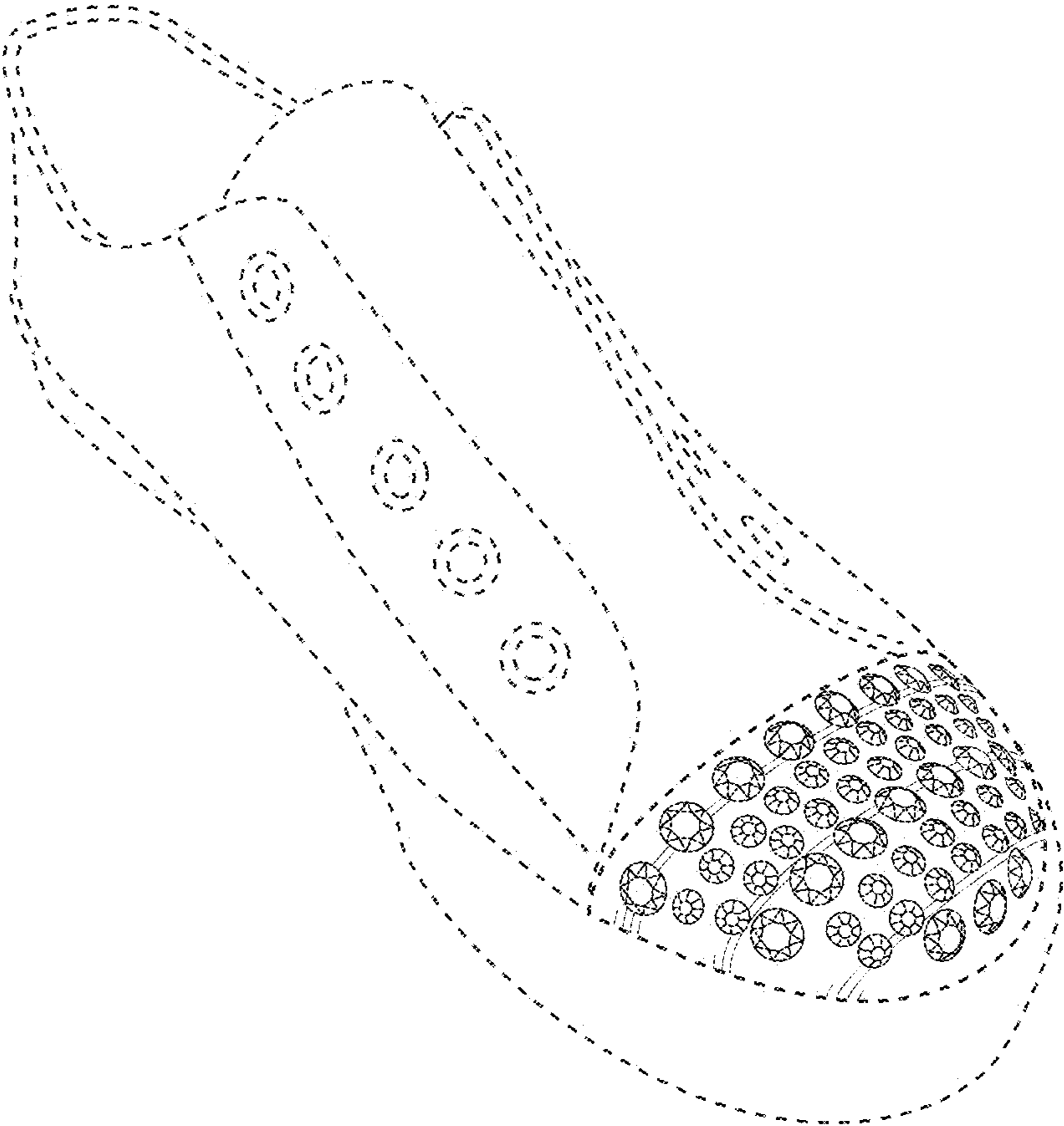

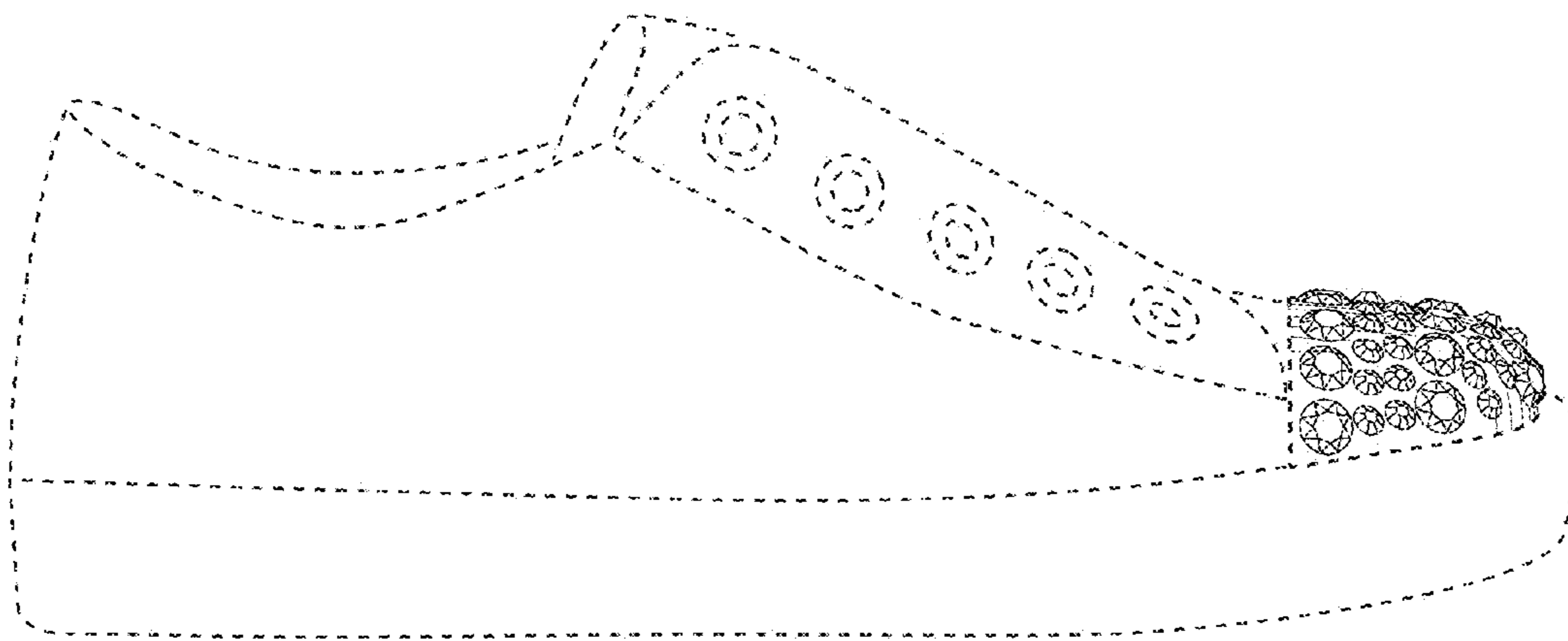

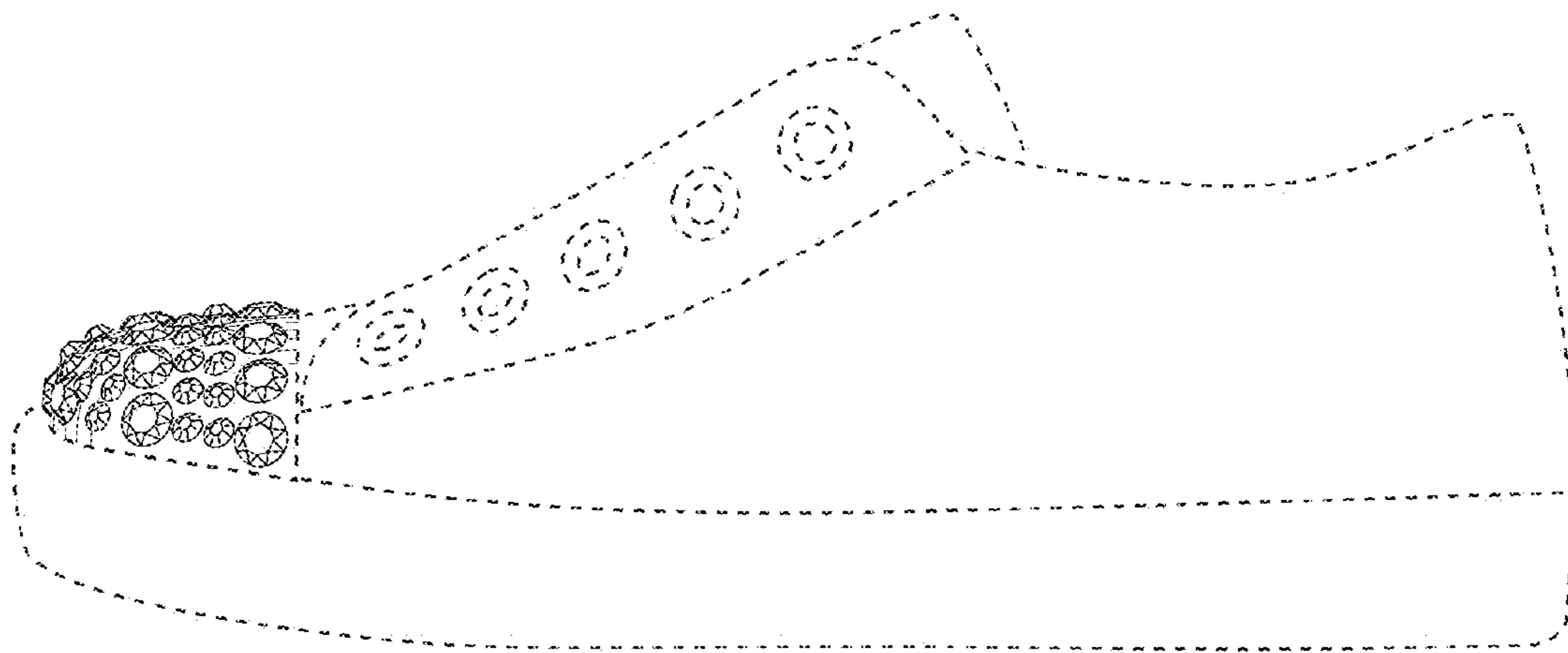

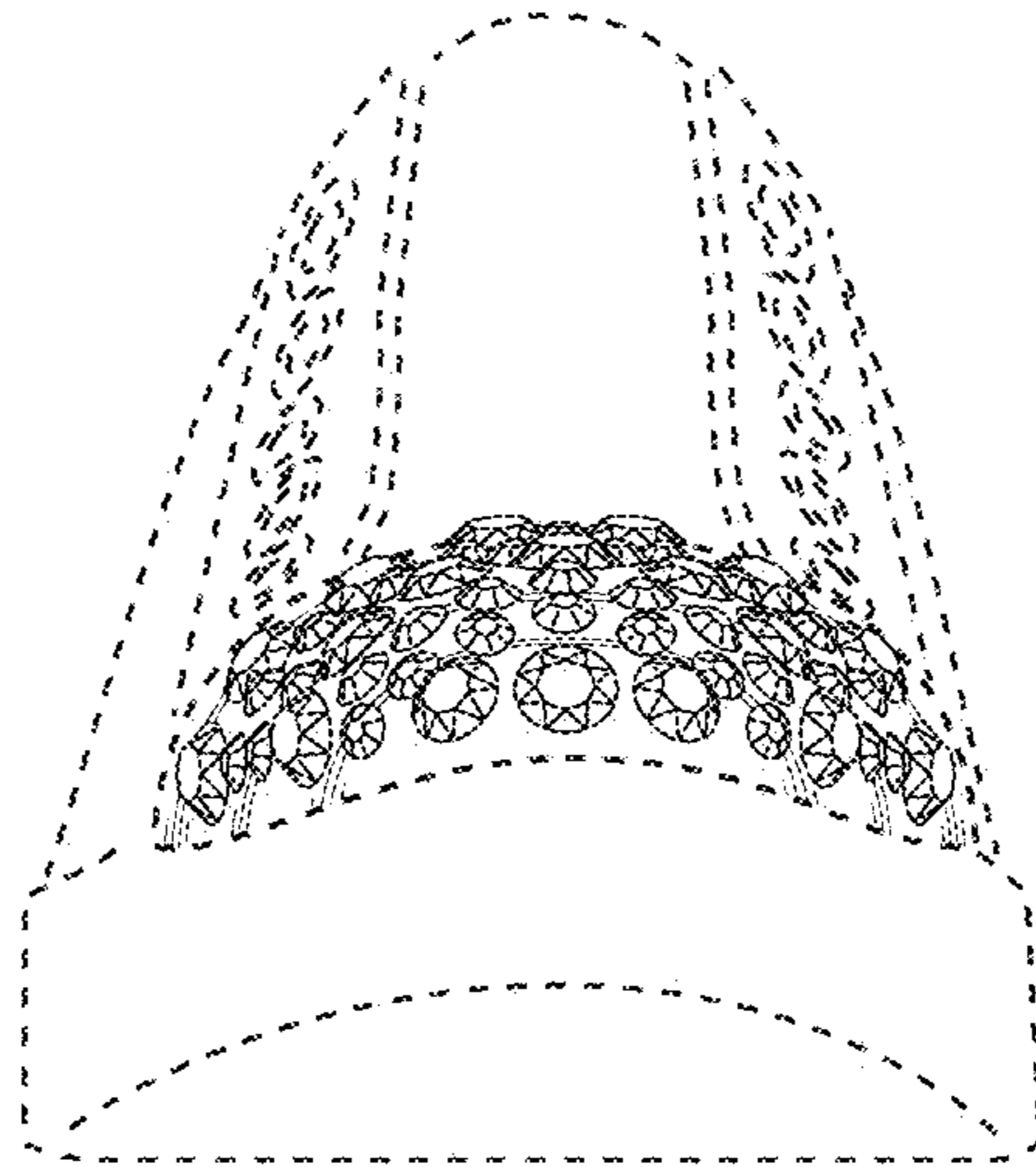

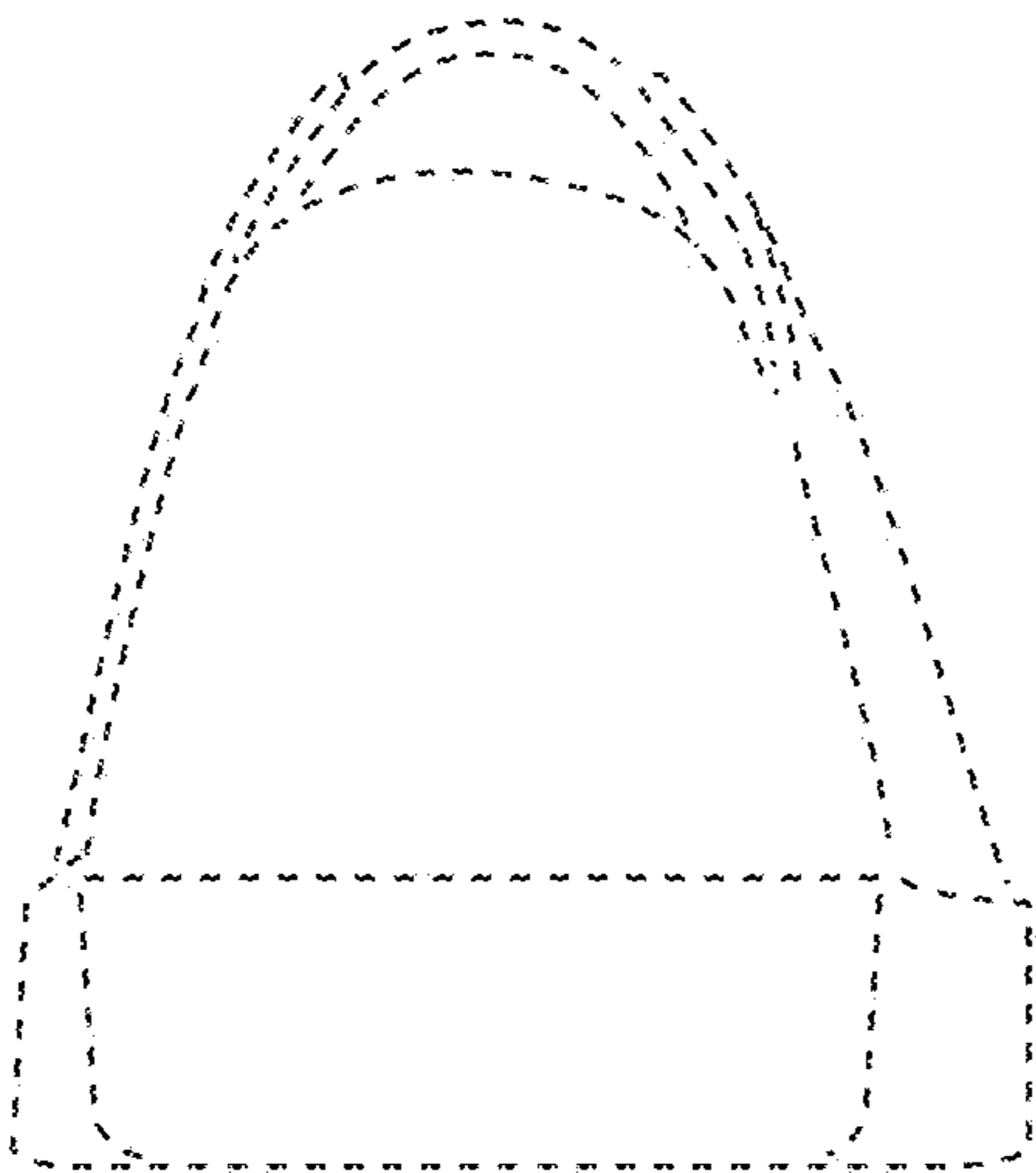

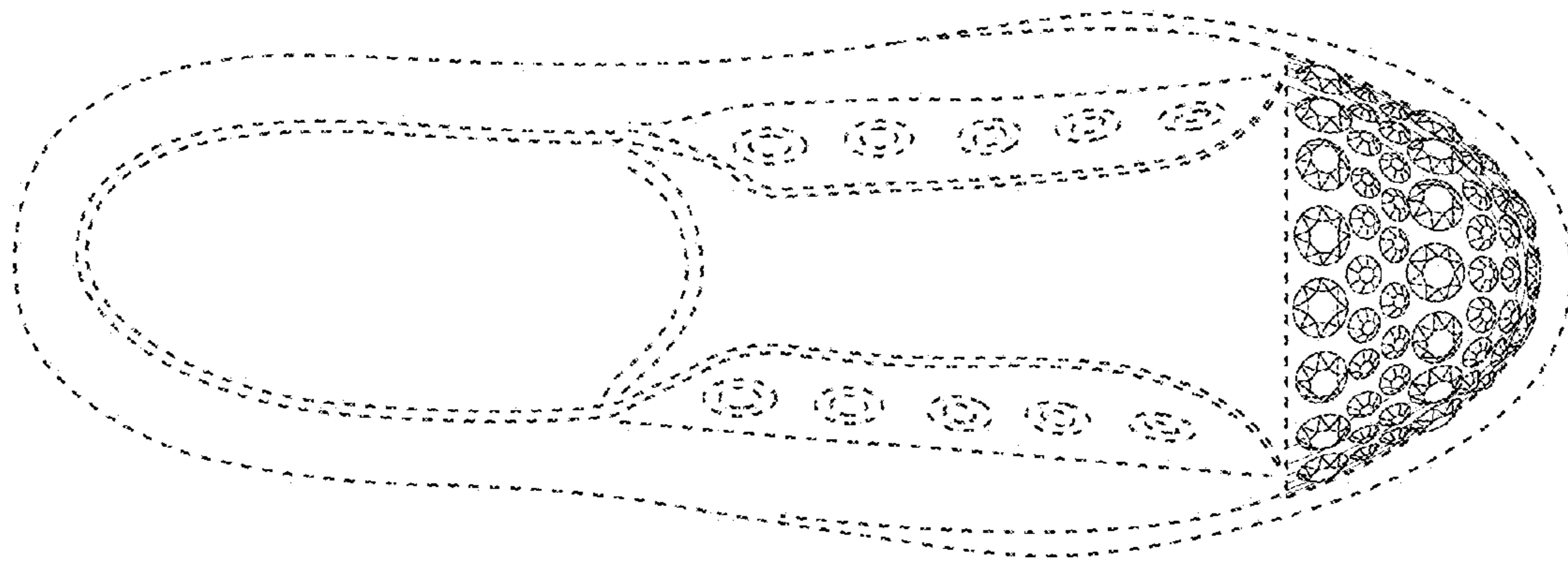
