The ornamental design for a shoulder strap for an infant carrier, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

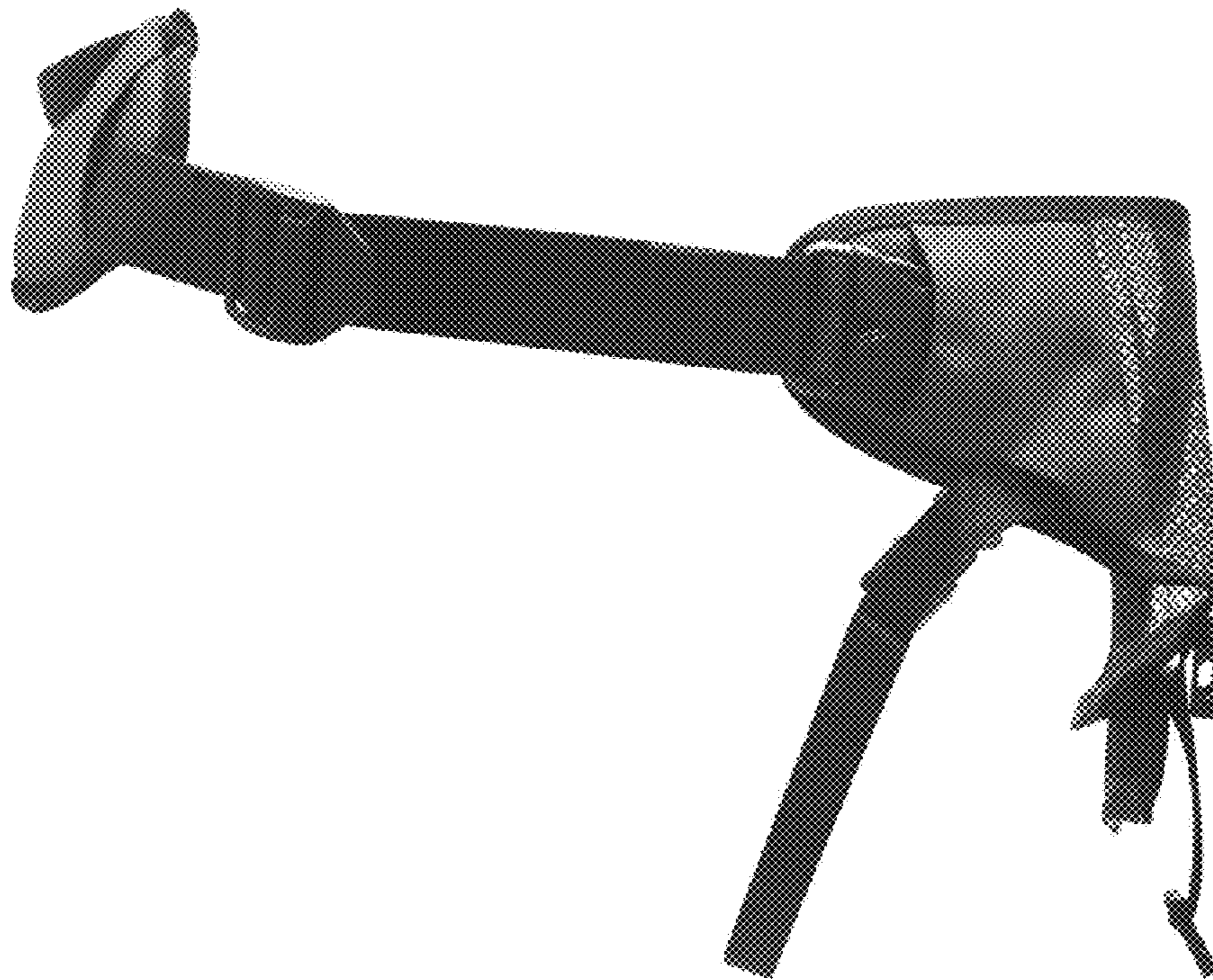
