DESCRIPTION

FIG. 5 is a right, front perspective view thereof with the panels apart;

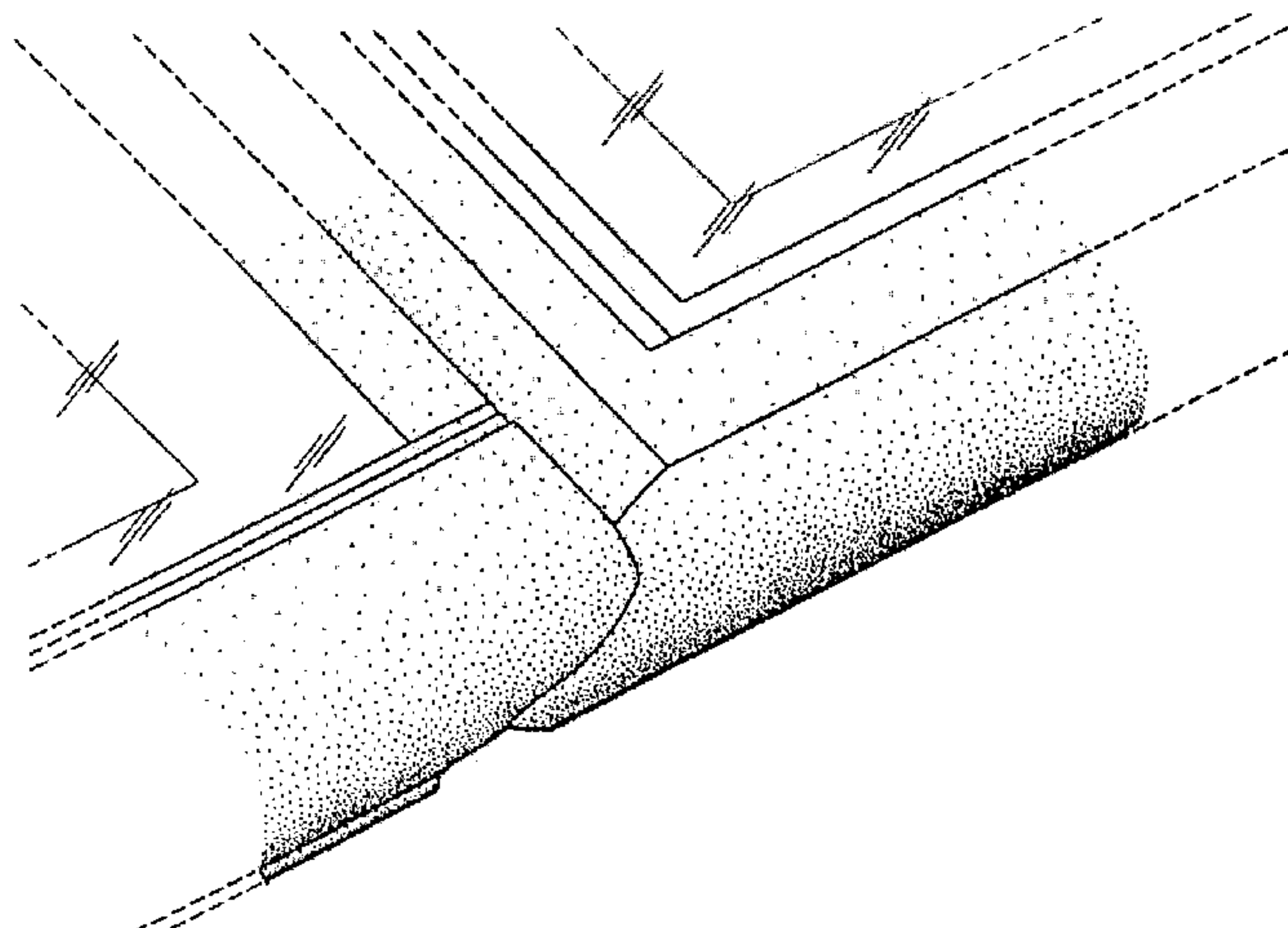
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof with the panels apart;

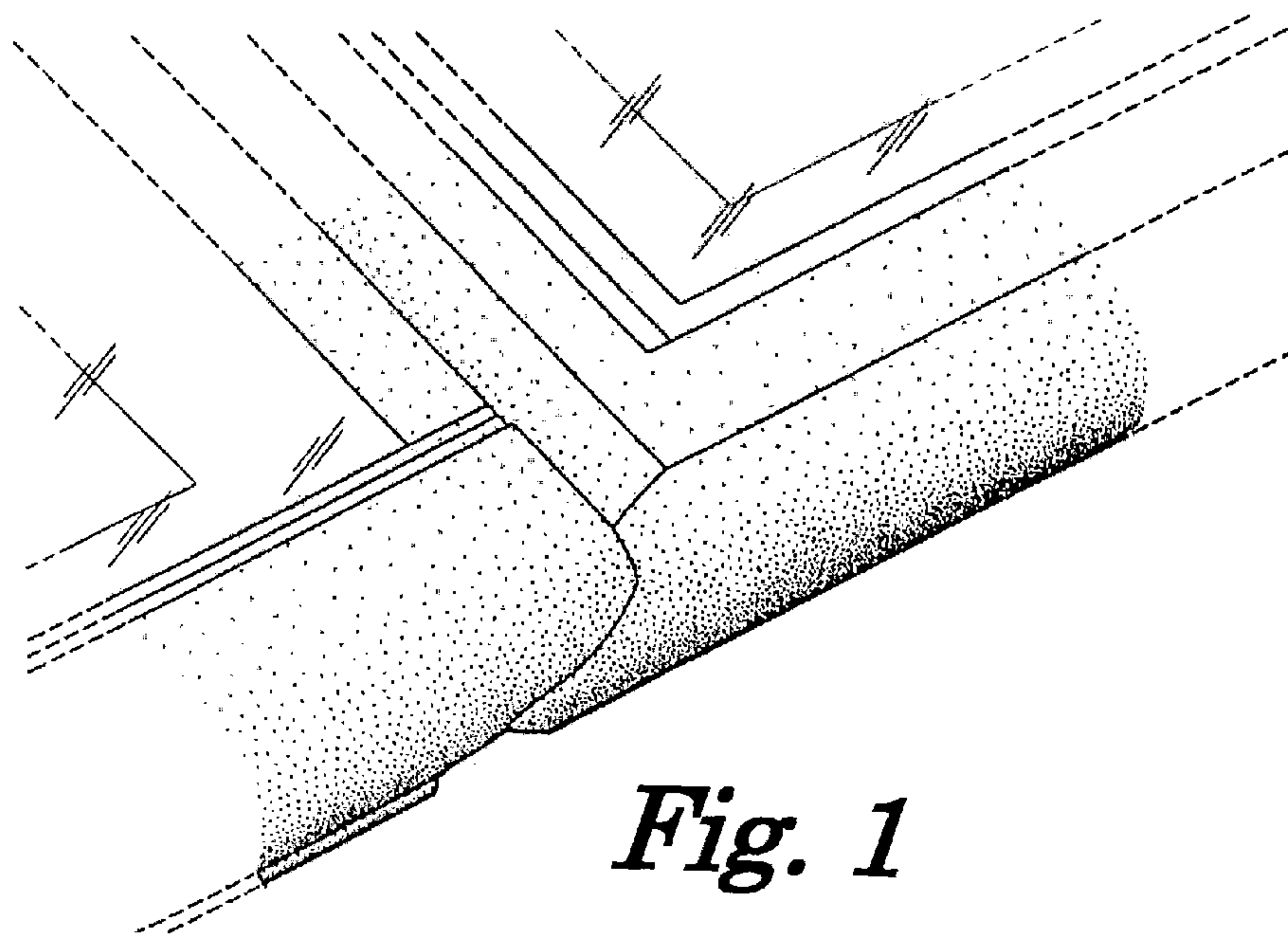

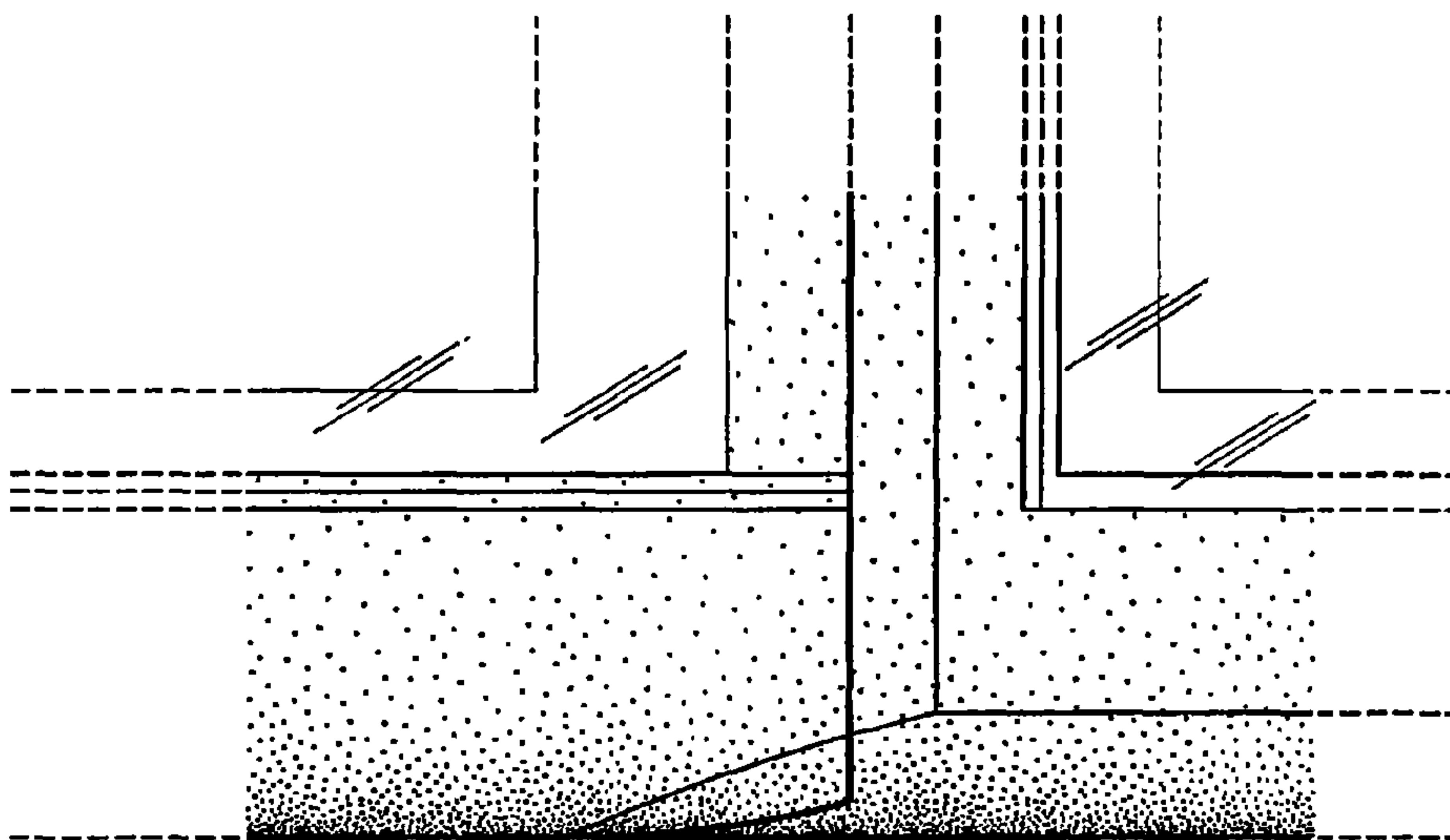

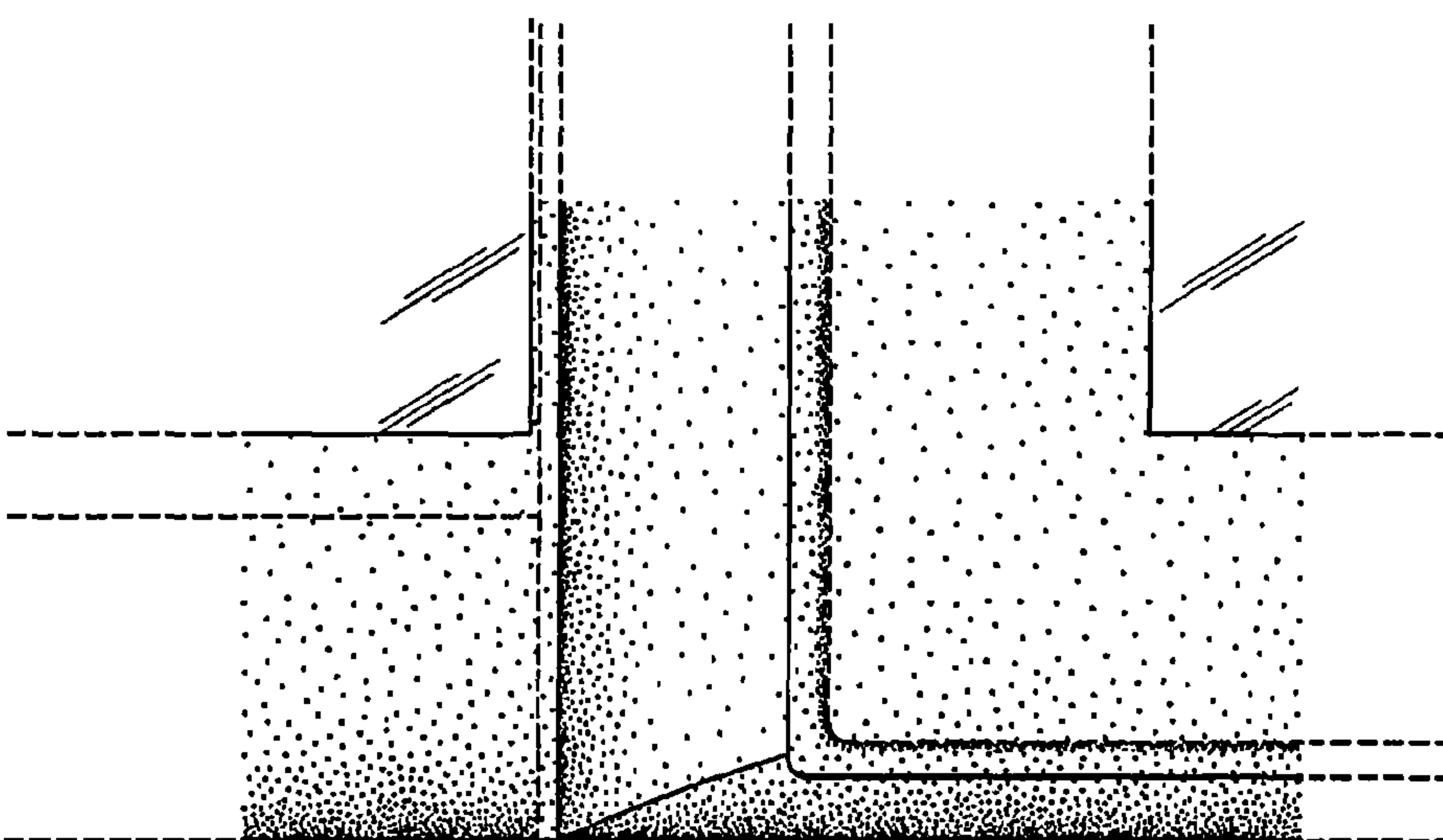

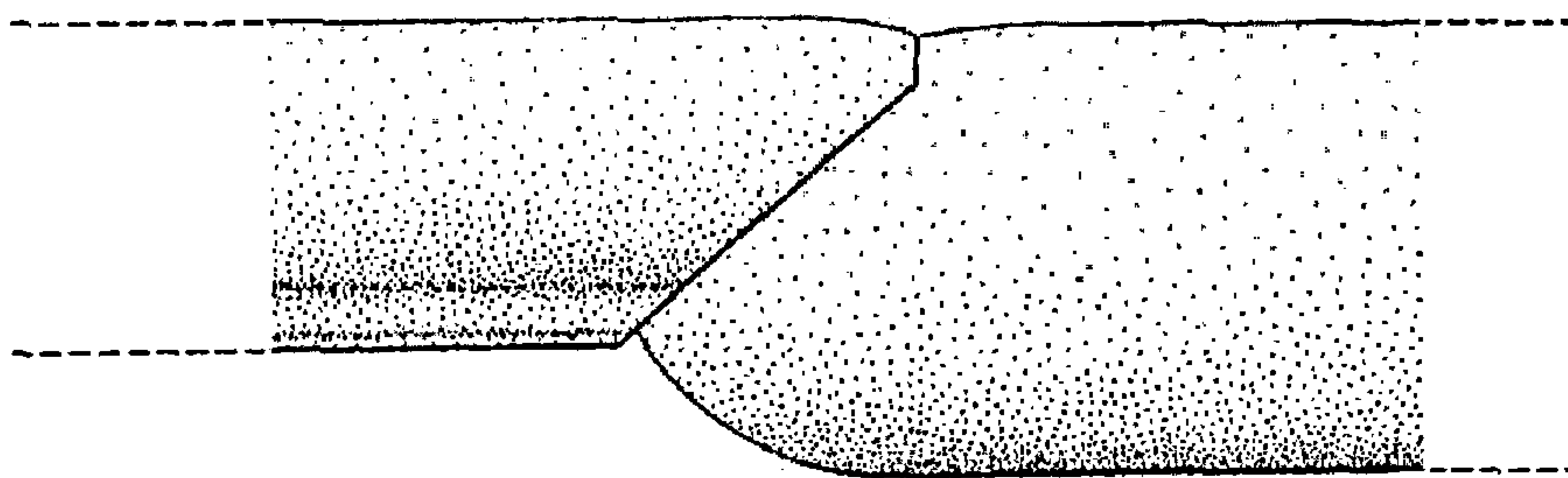

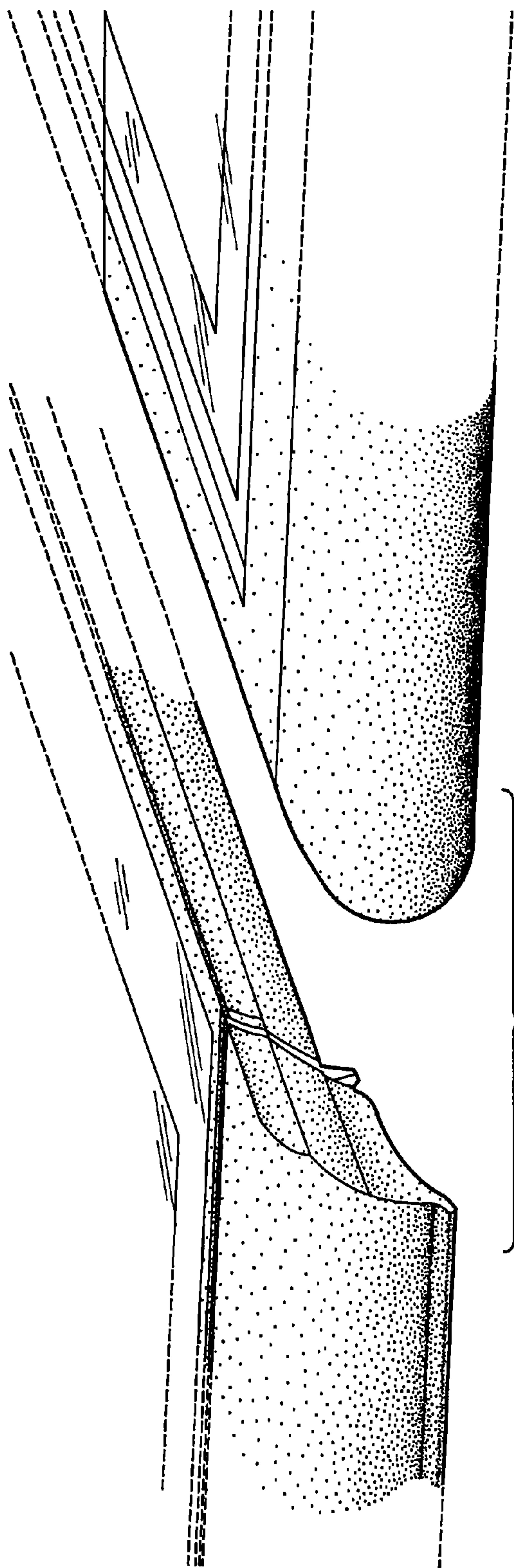

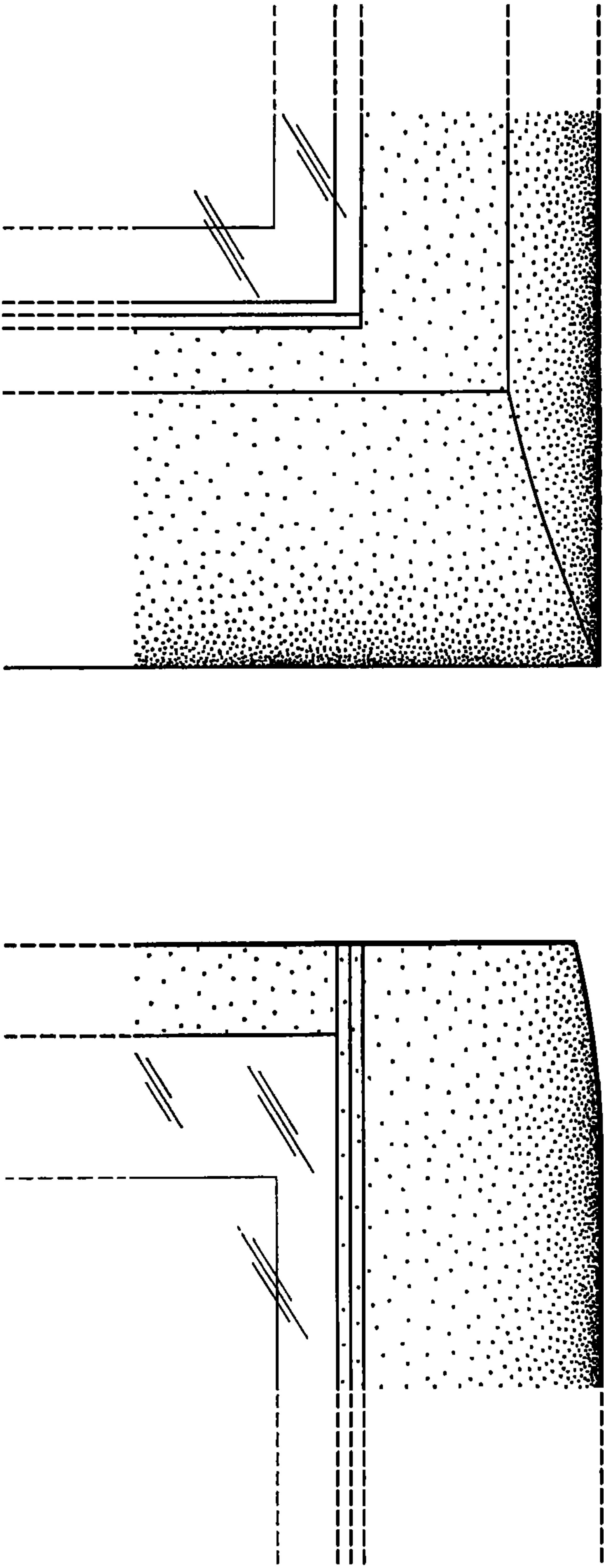

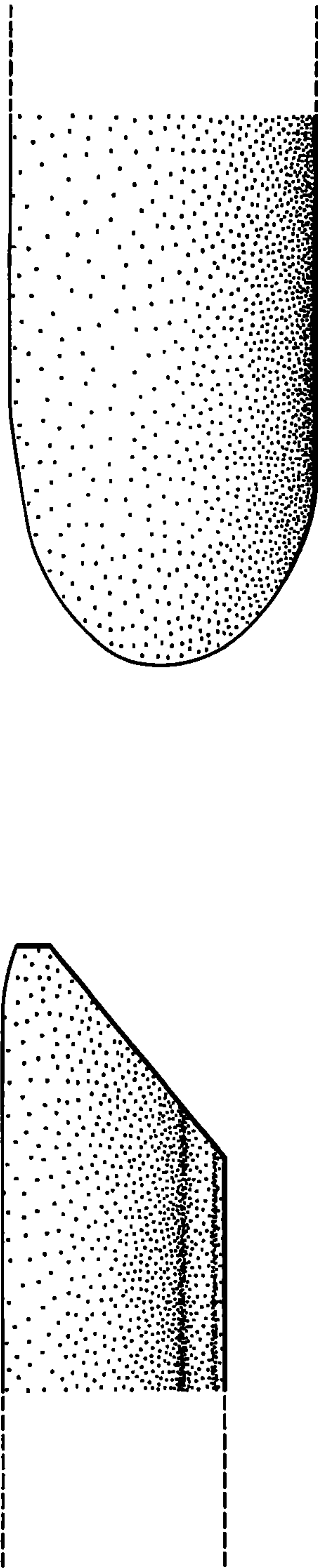

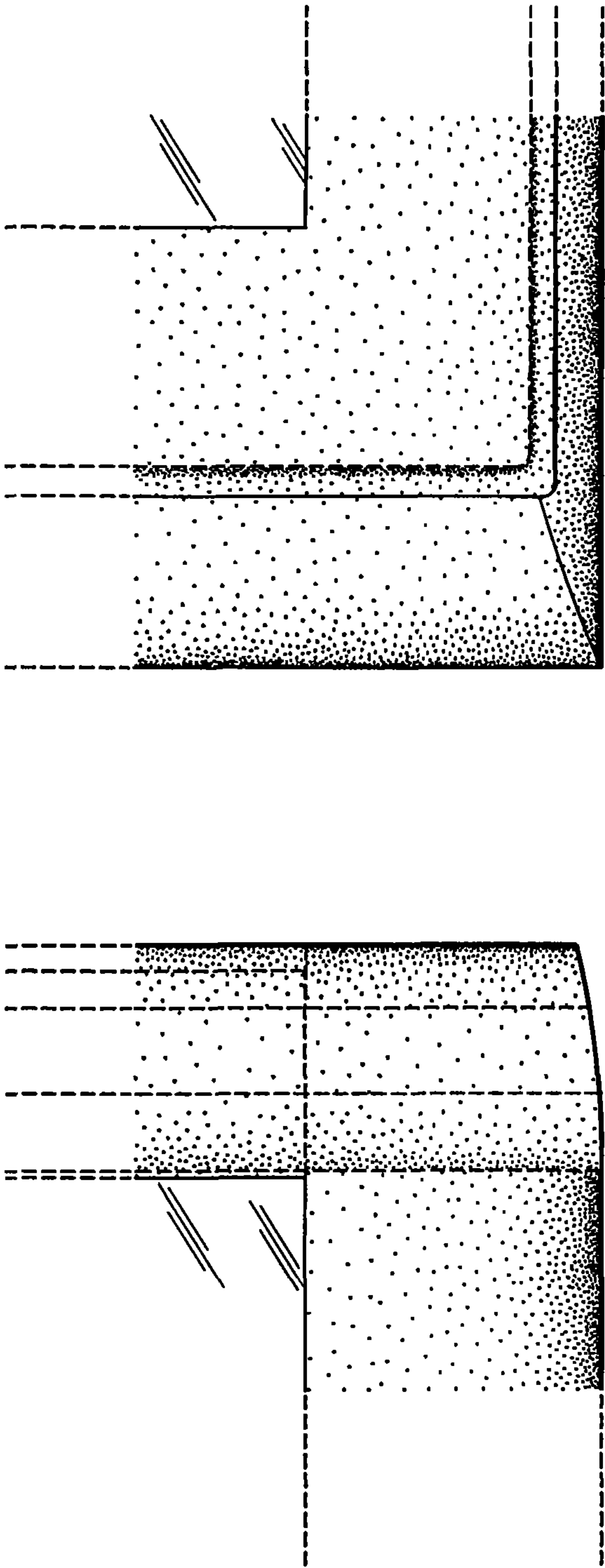
