DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a wireless communications
gateway showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is top plan view of the wireless communications gate-

of FIG. 1;

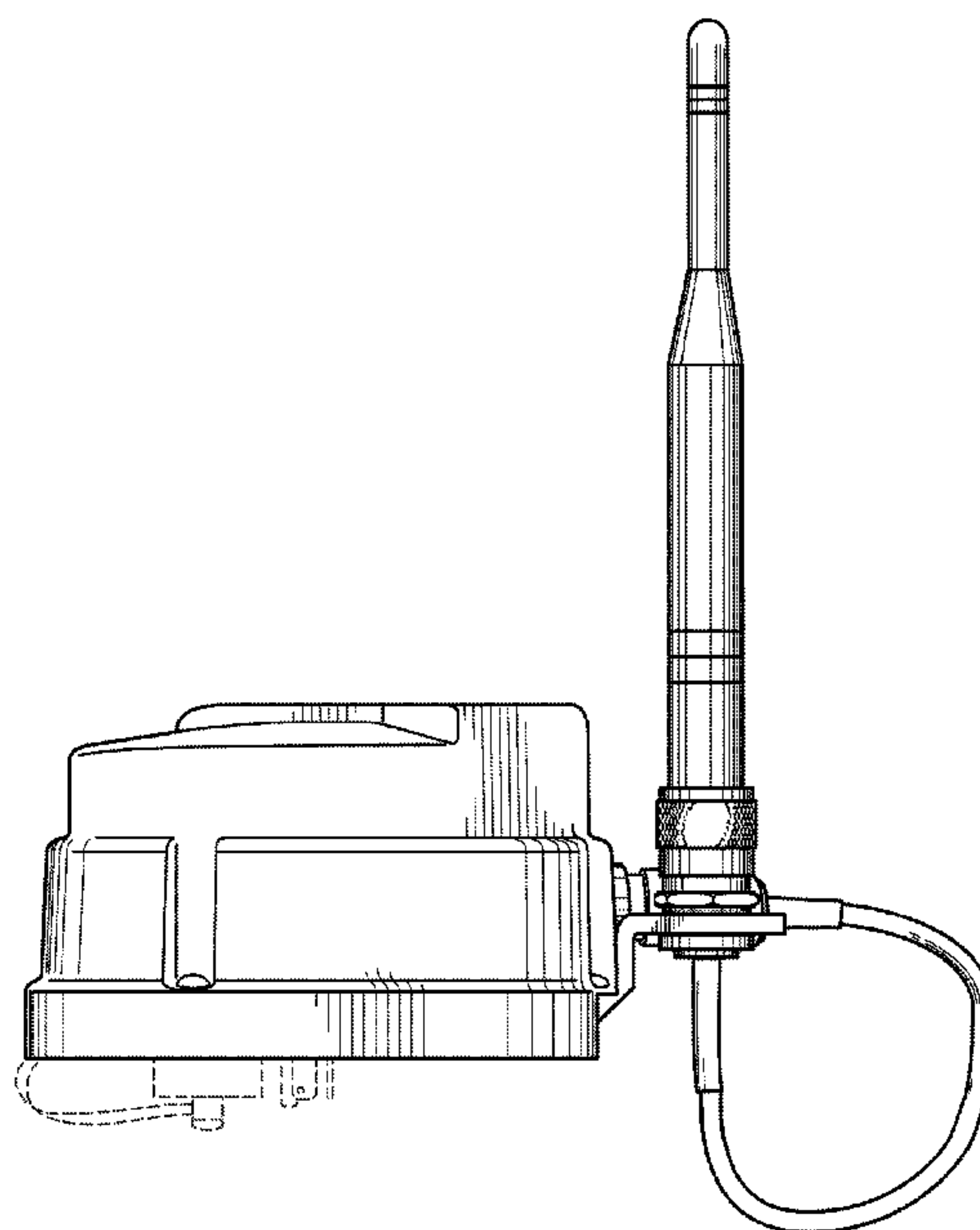
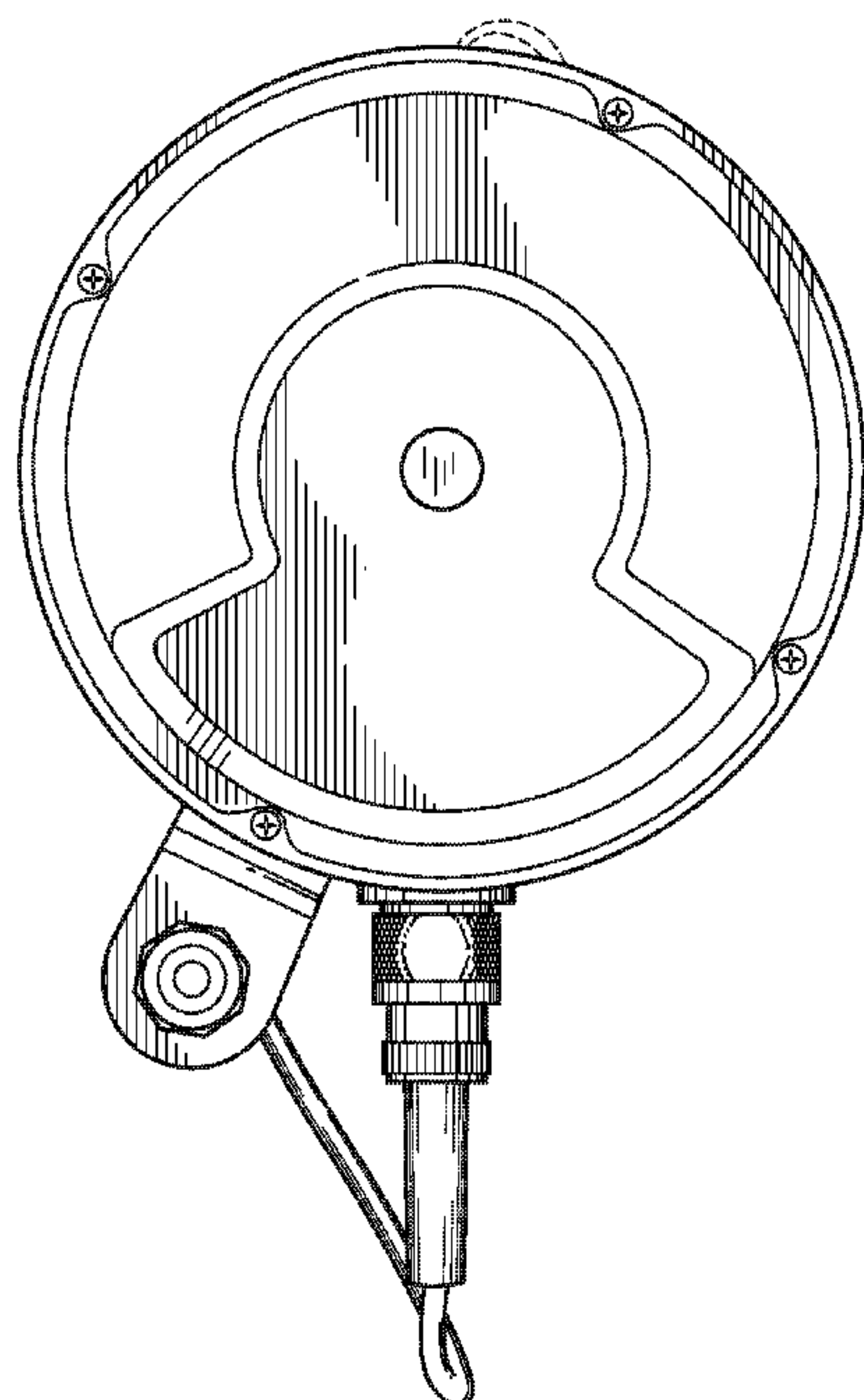
FIG. 6 is a front view of the wireless communications gate-

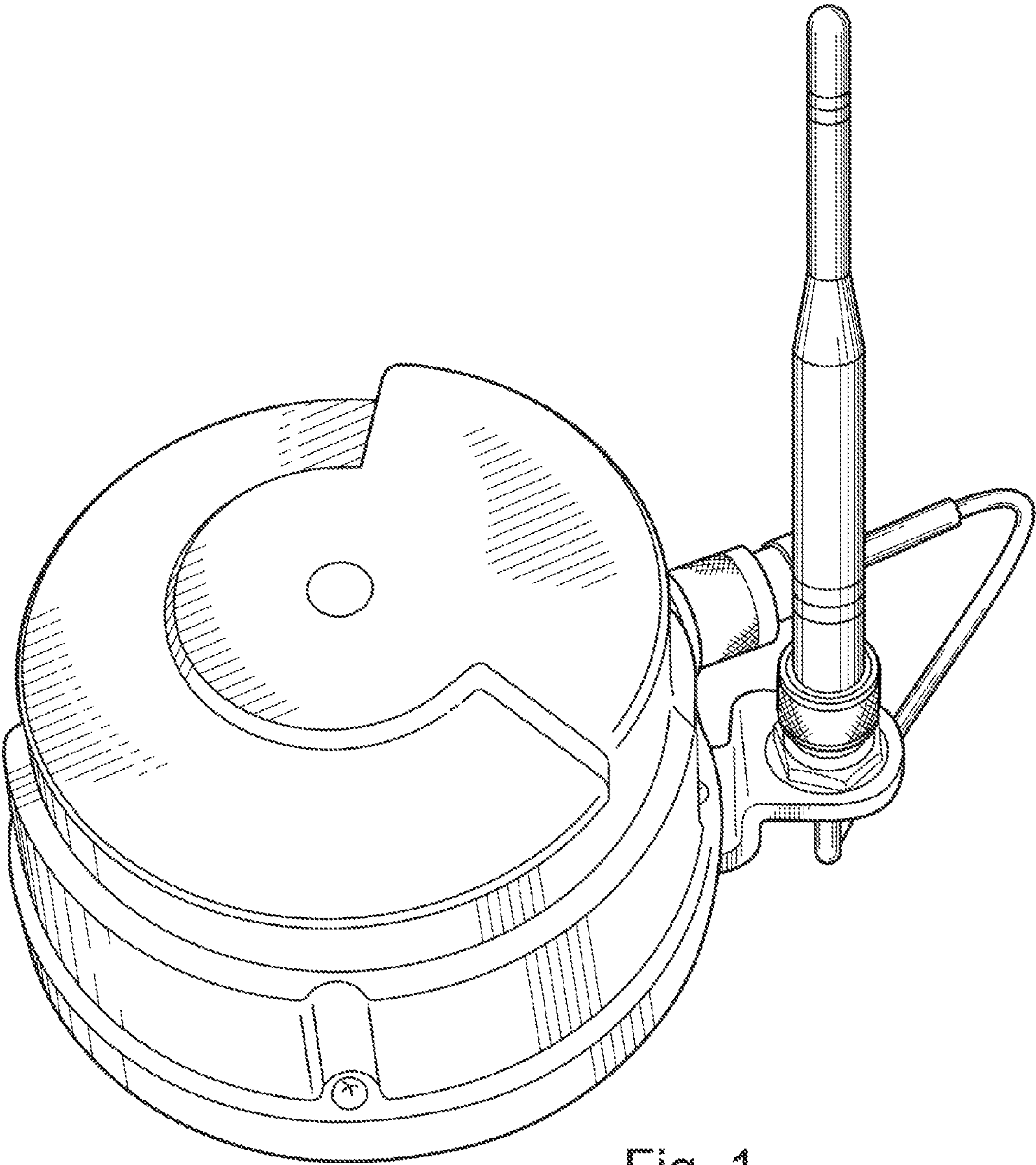

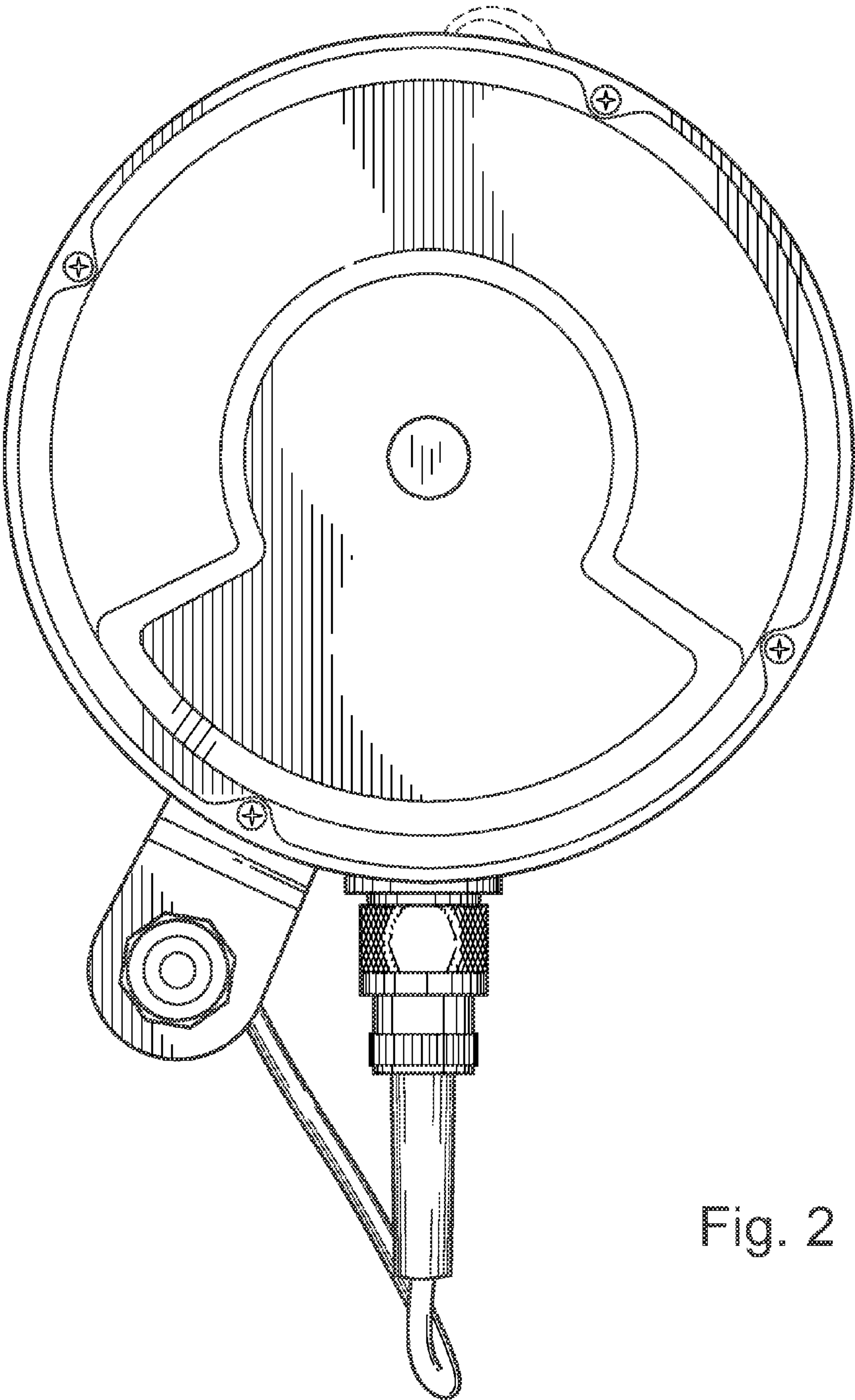

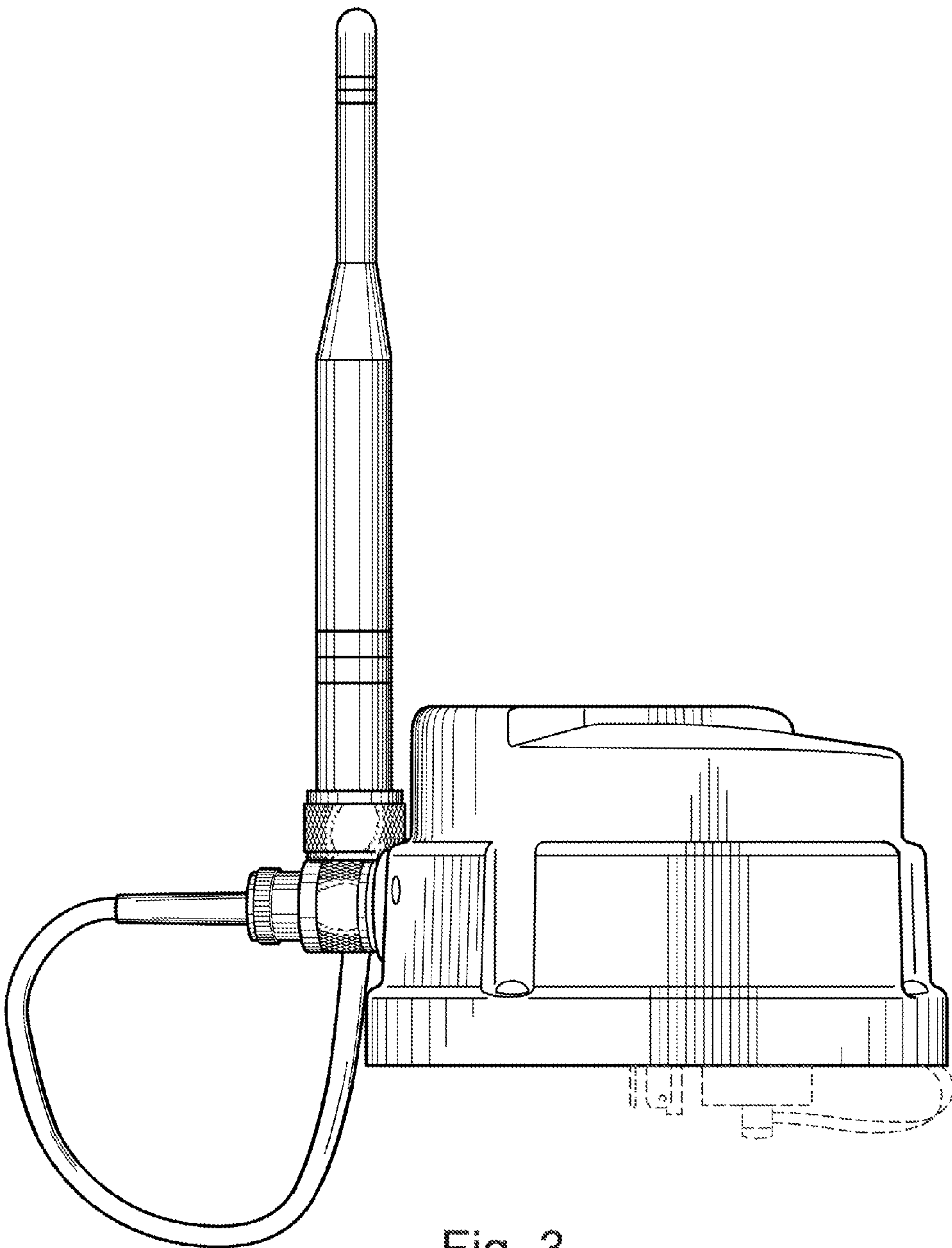

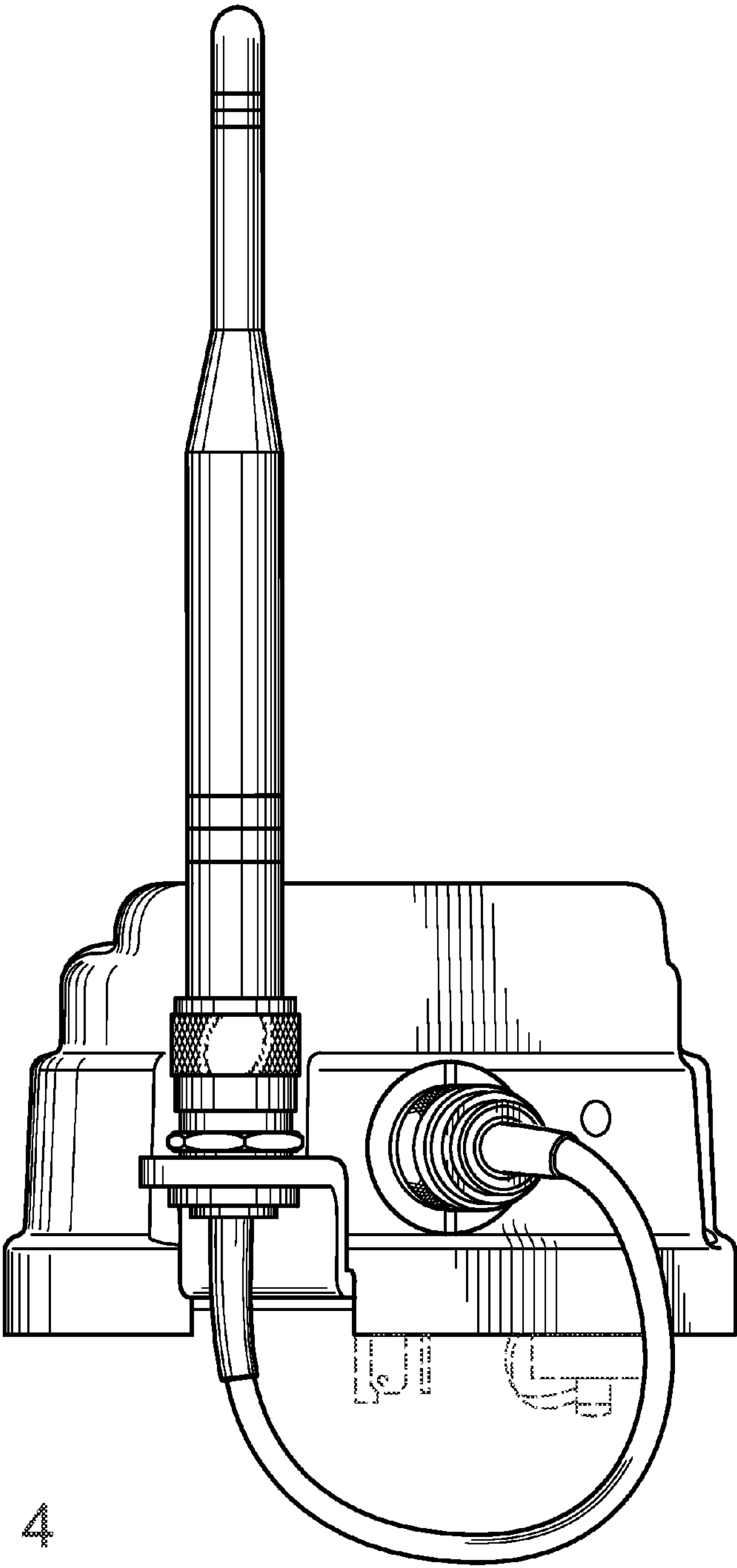

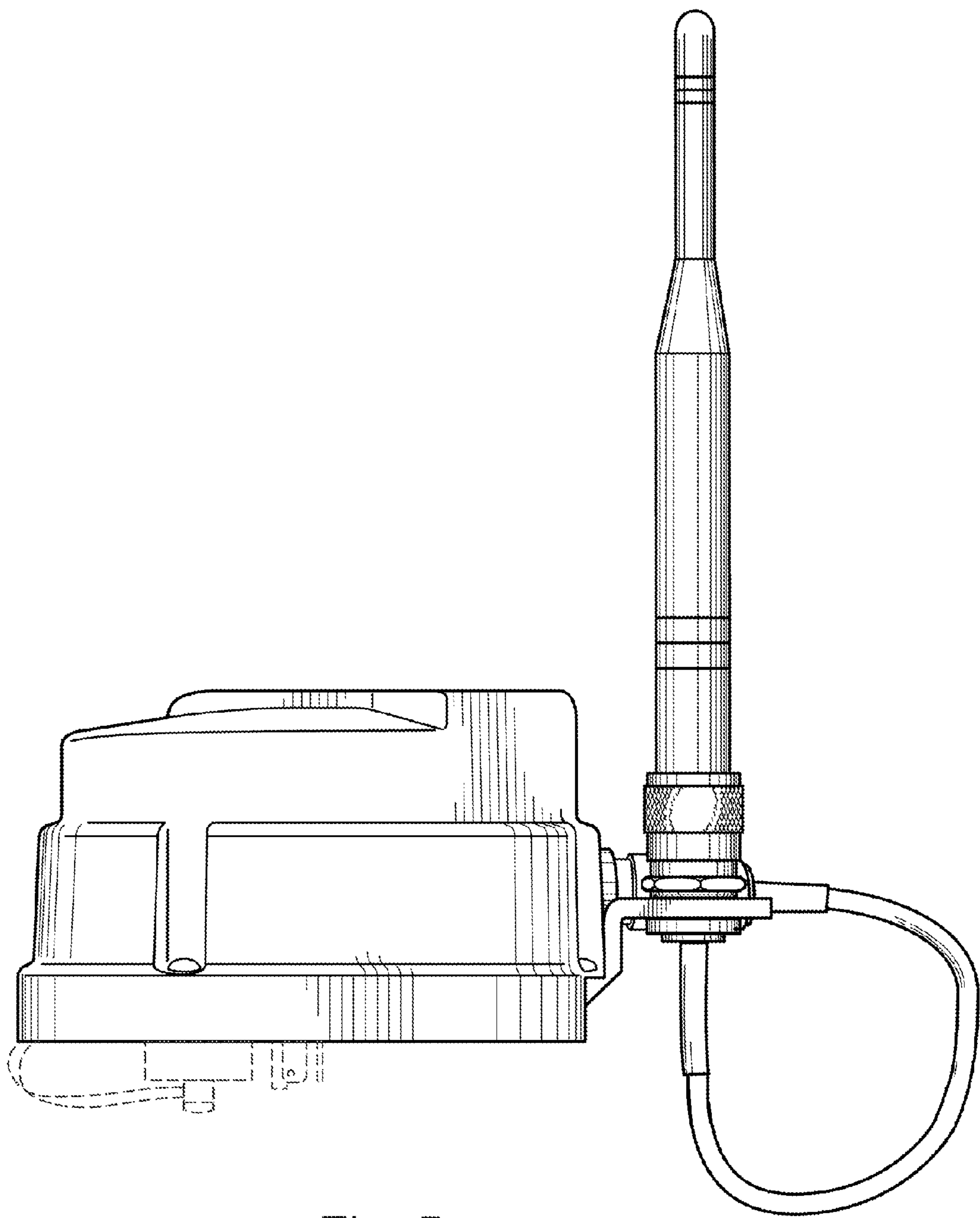

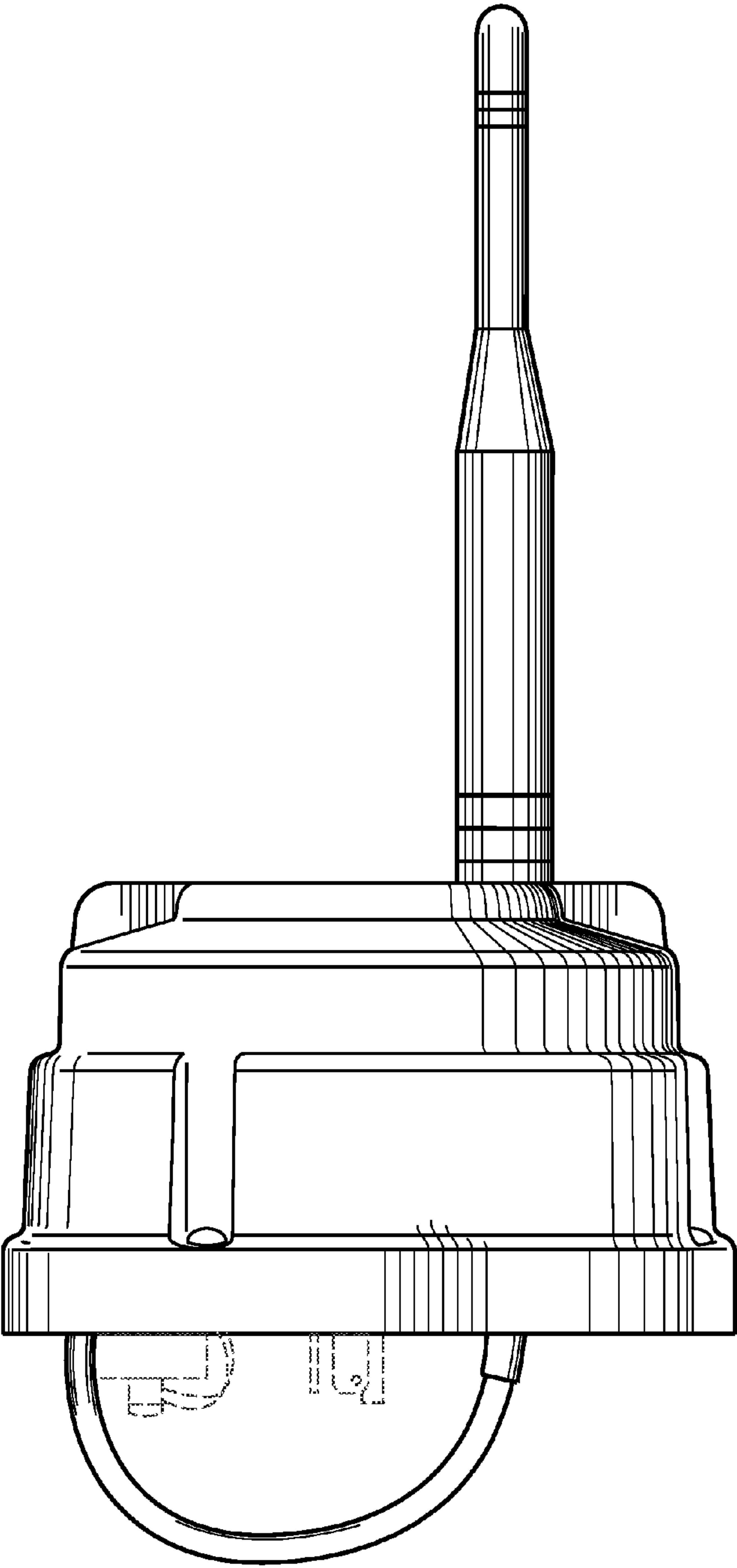

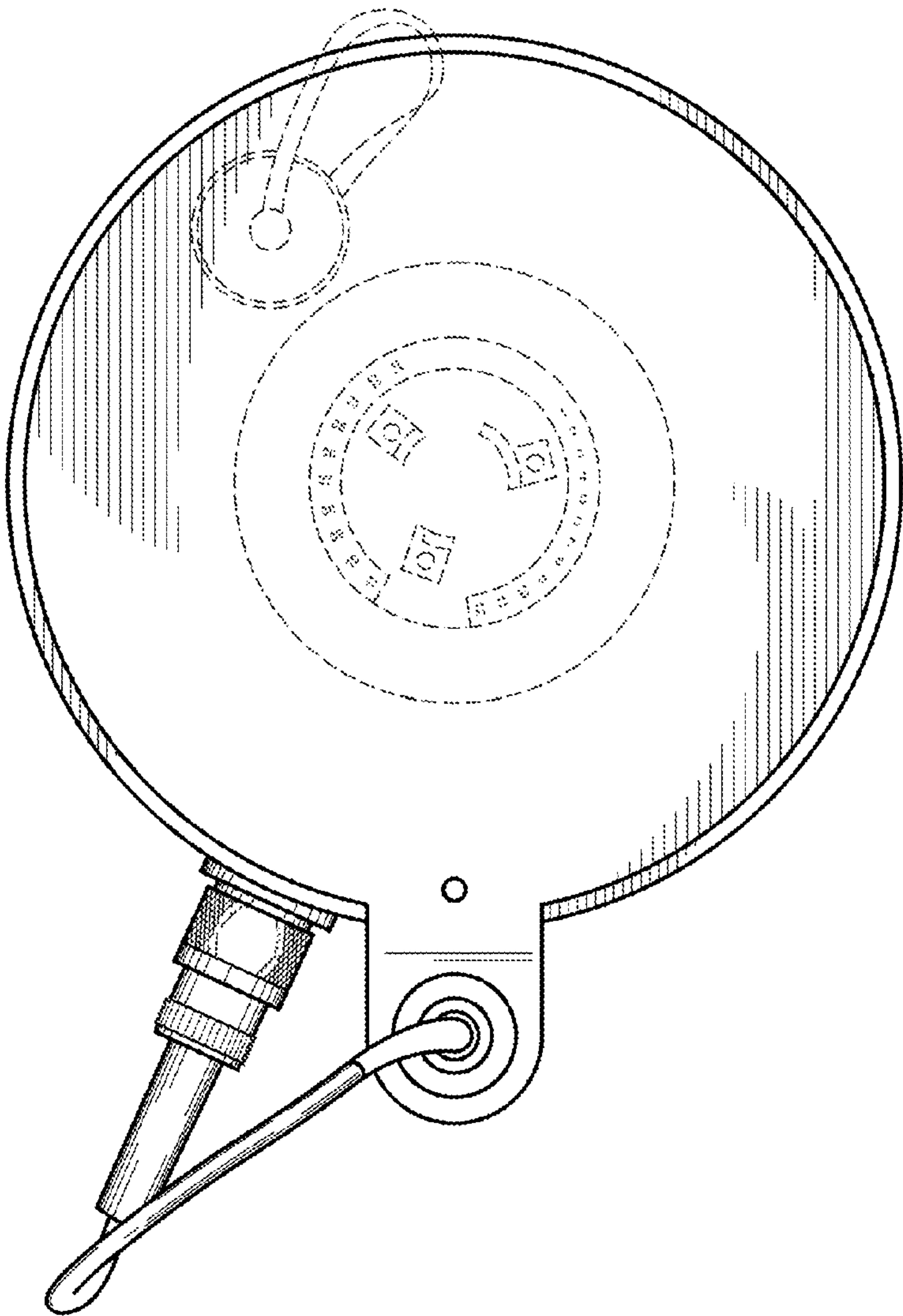
