FIG. 4 is a front elevation view;

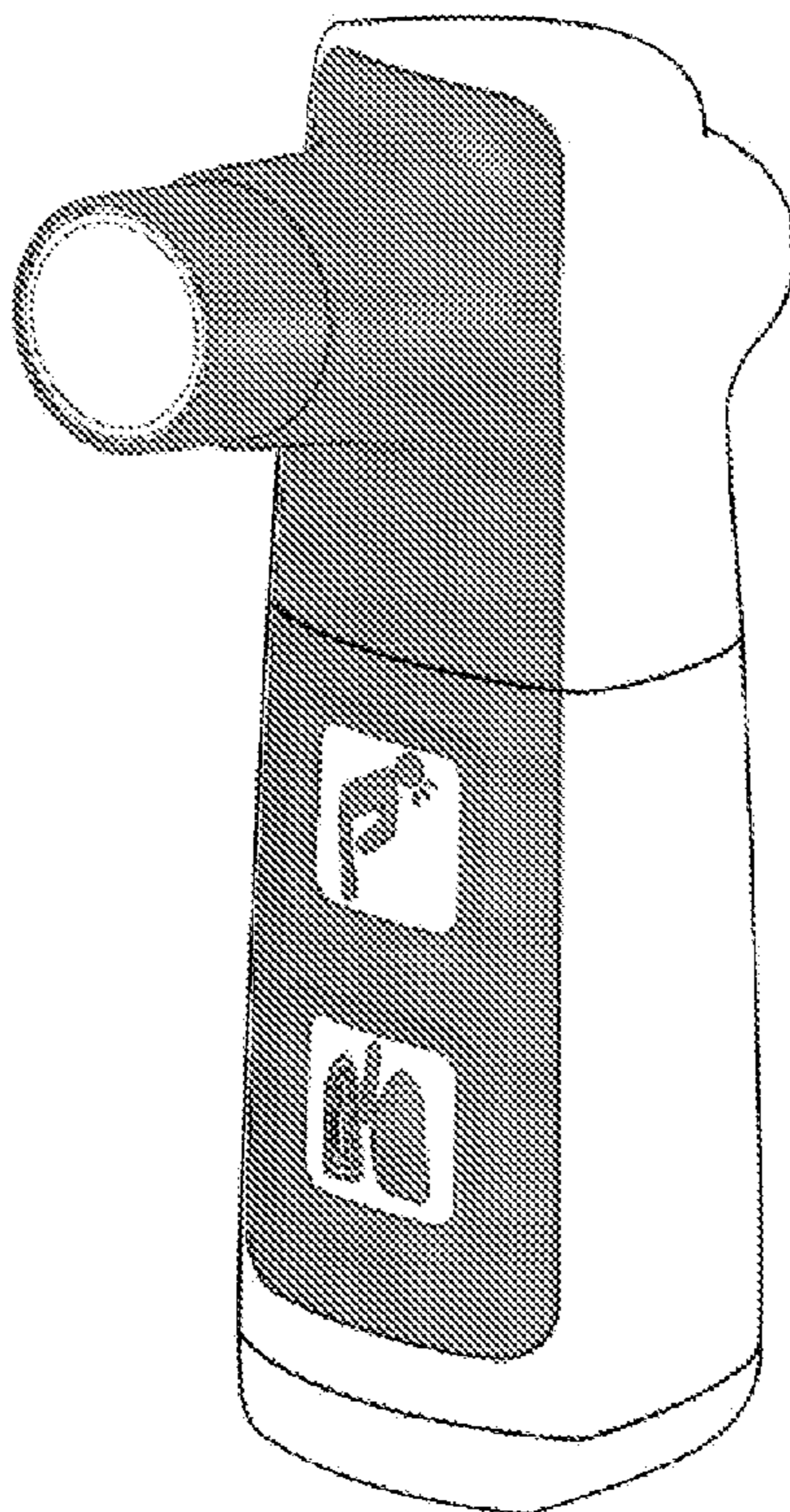
FIG. 5 is a front perspective view;

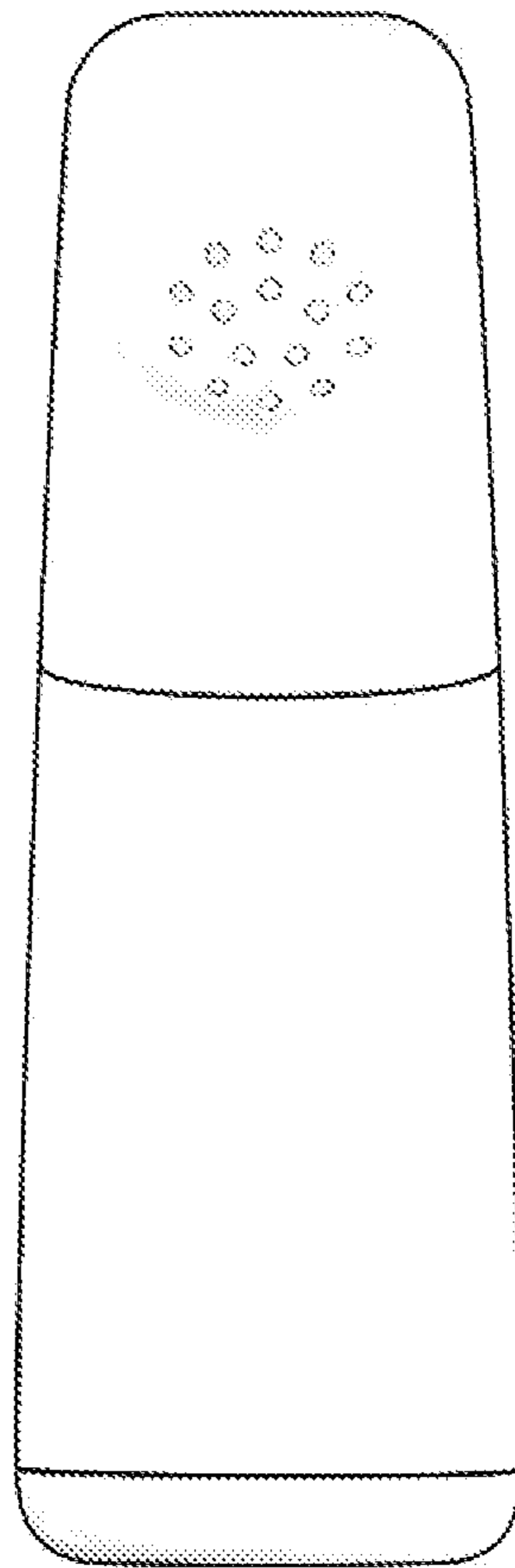

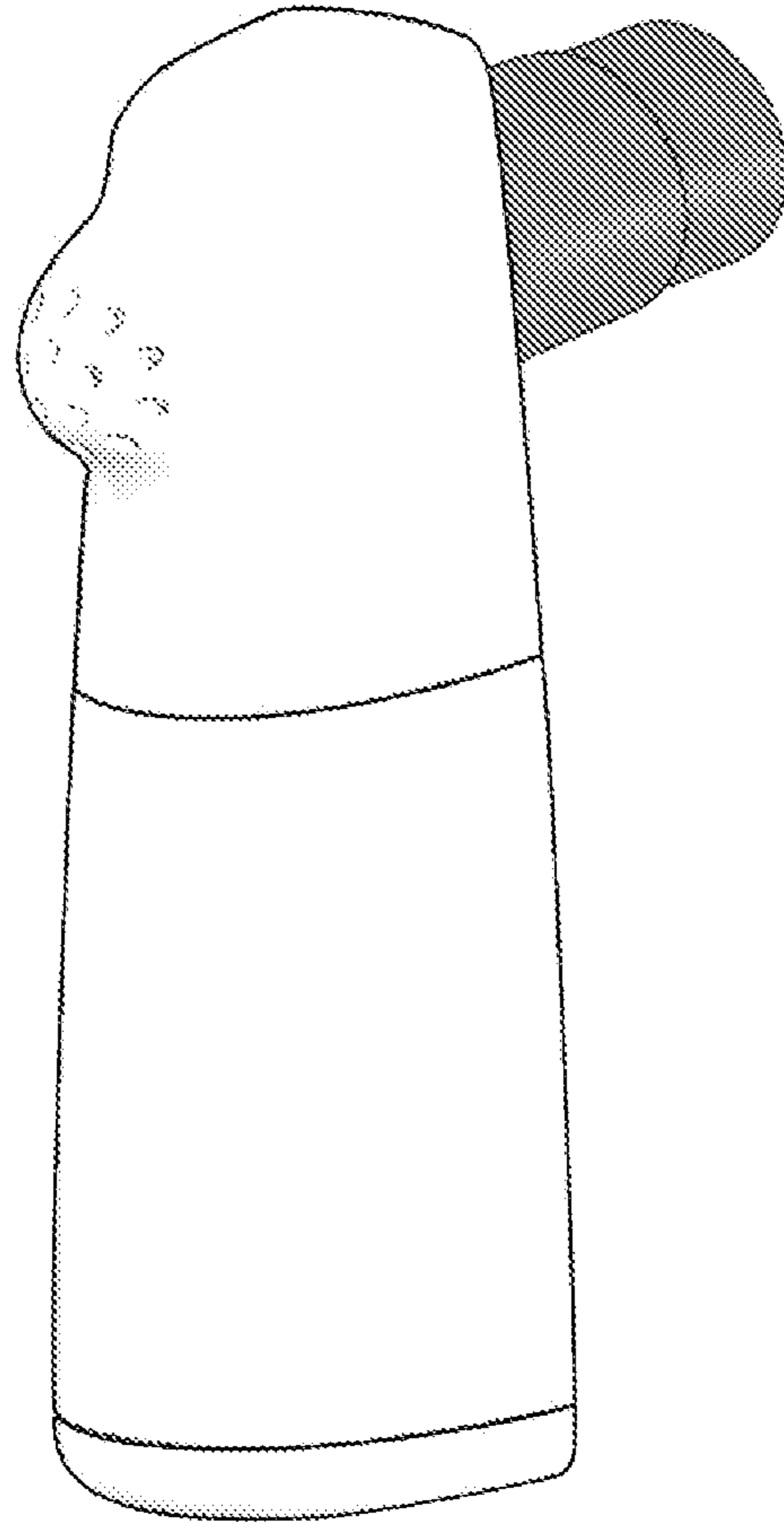

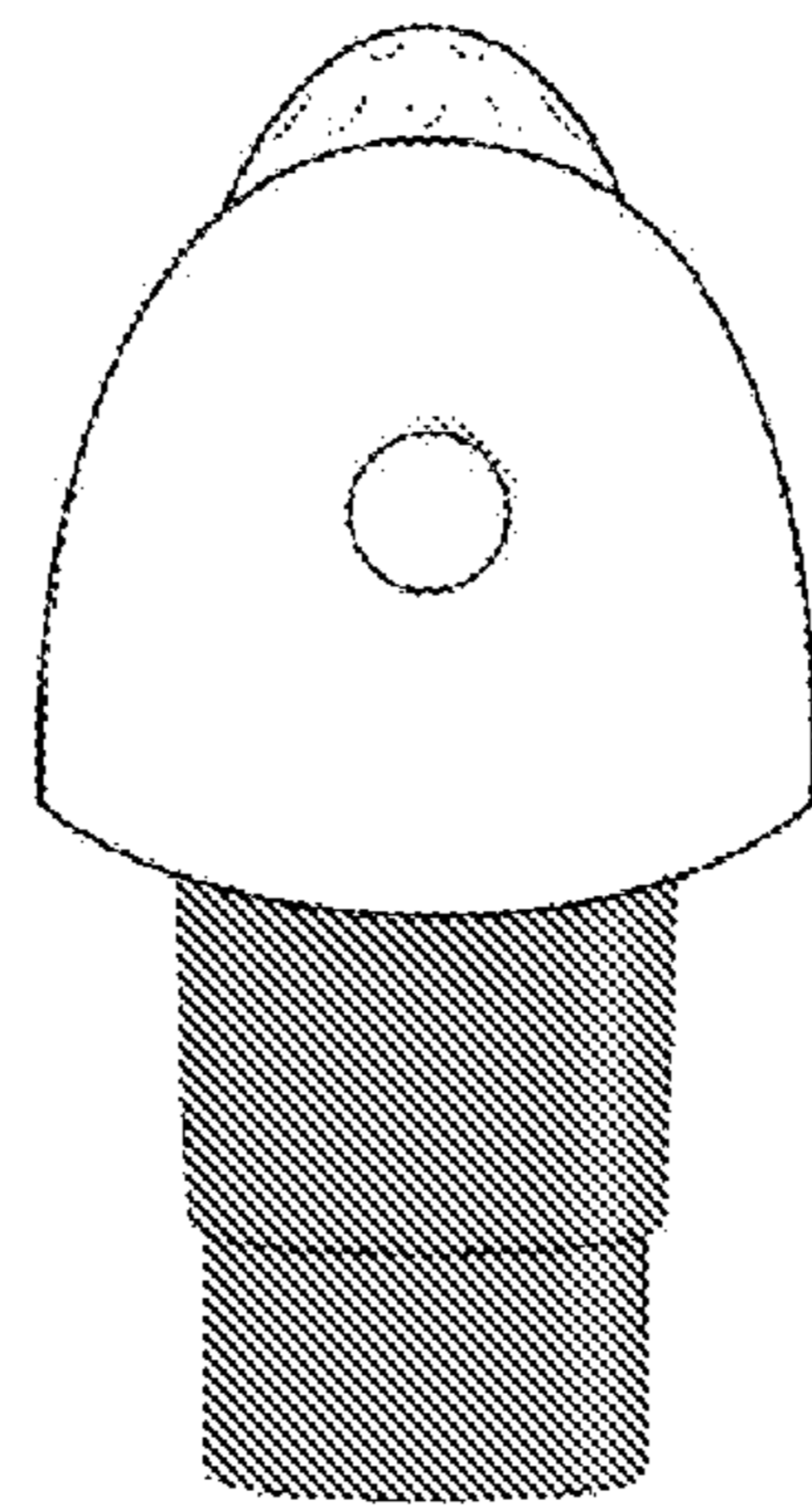

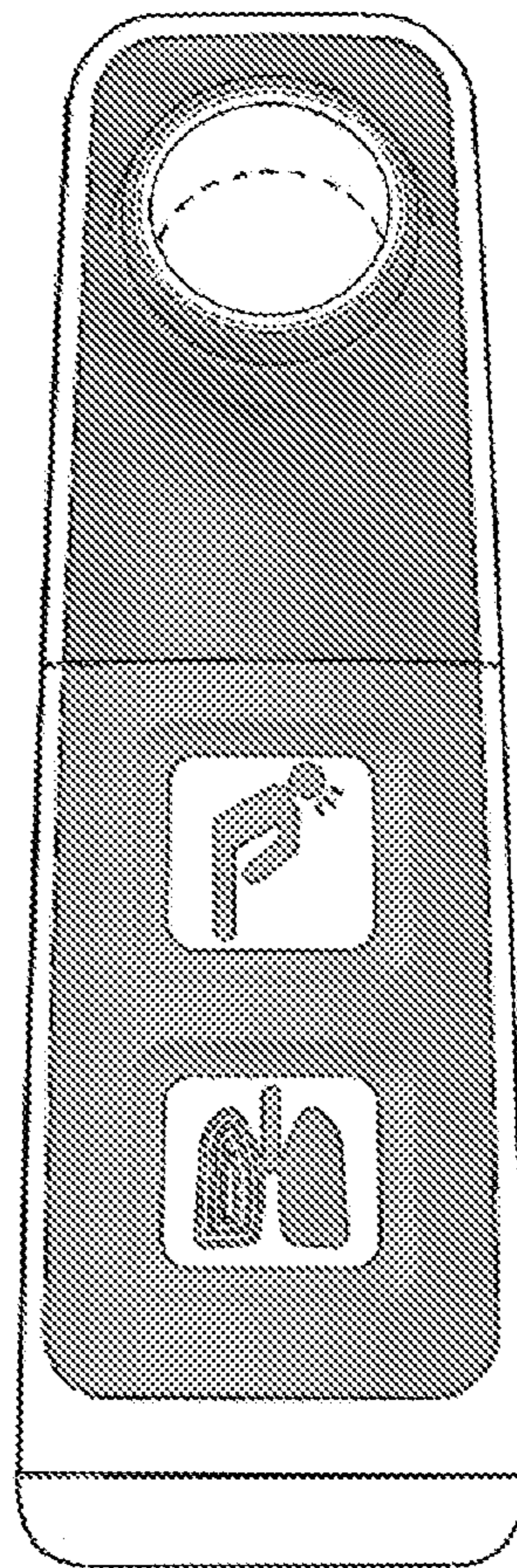

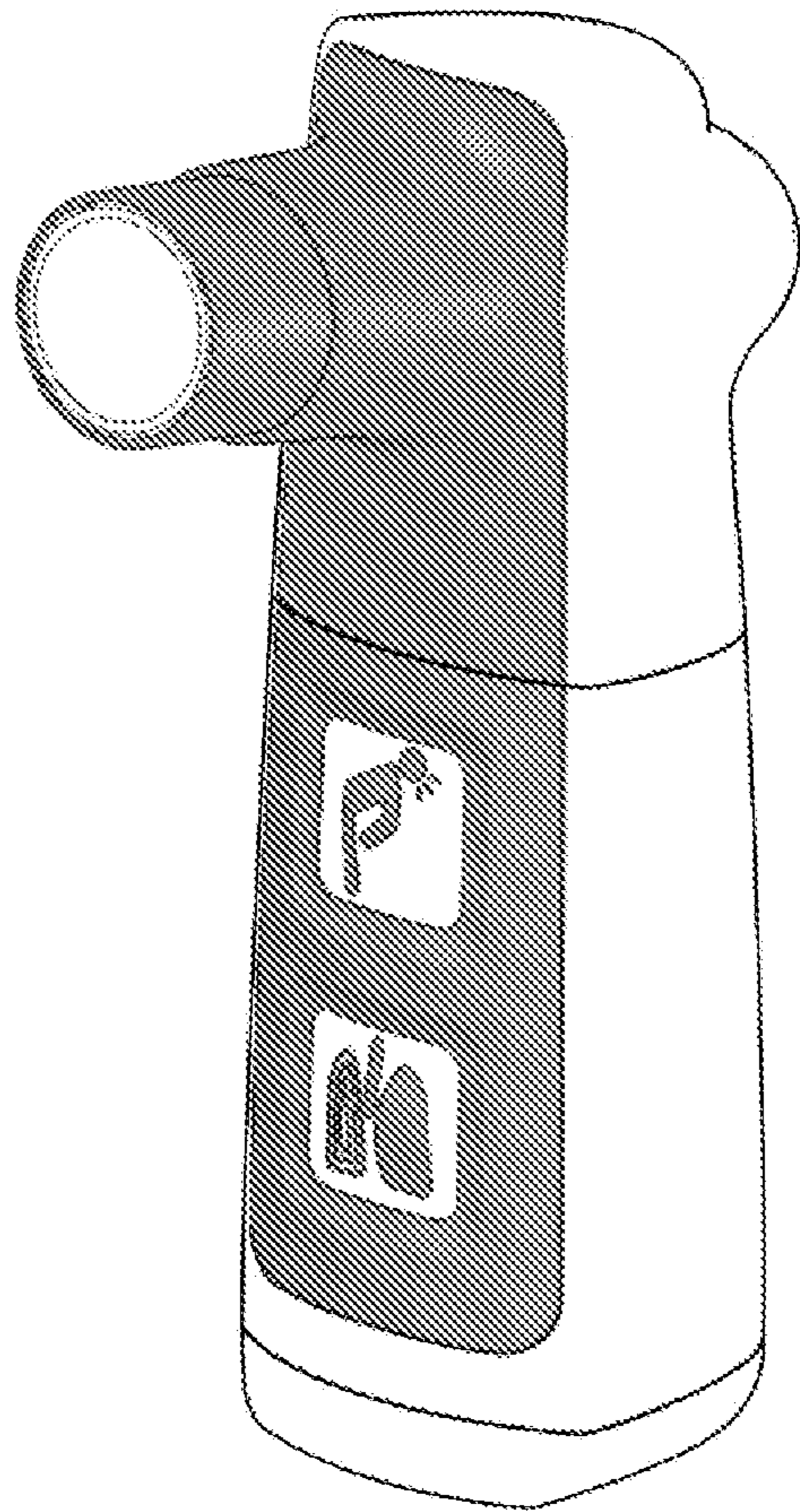

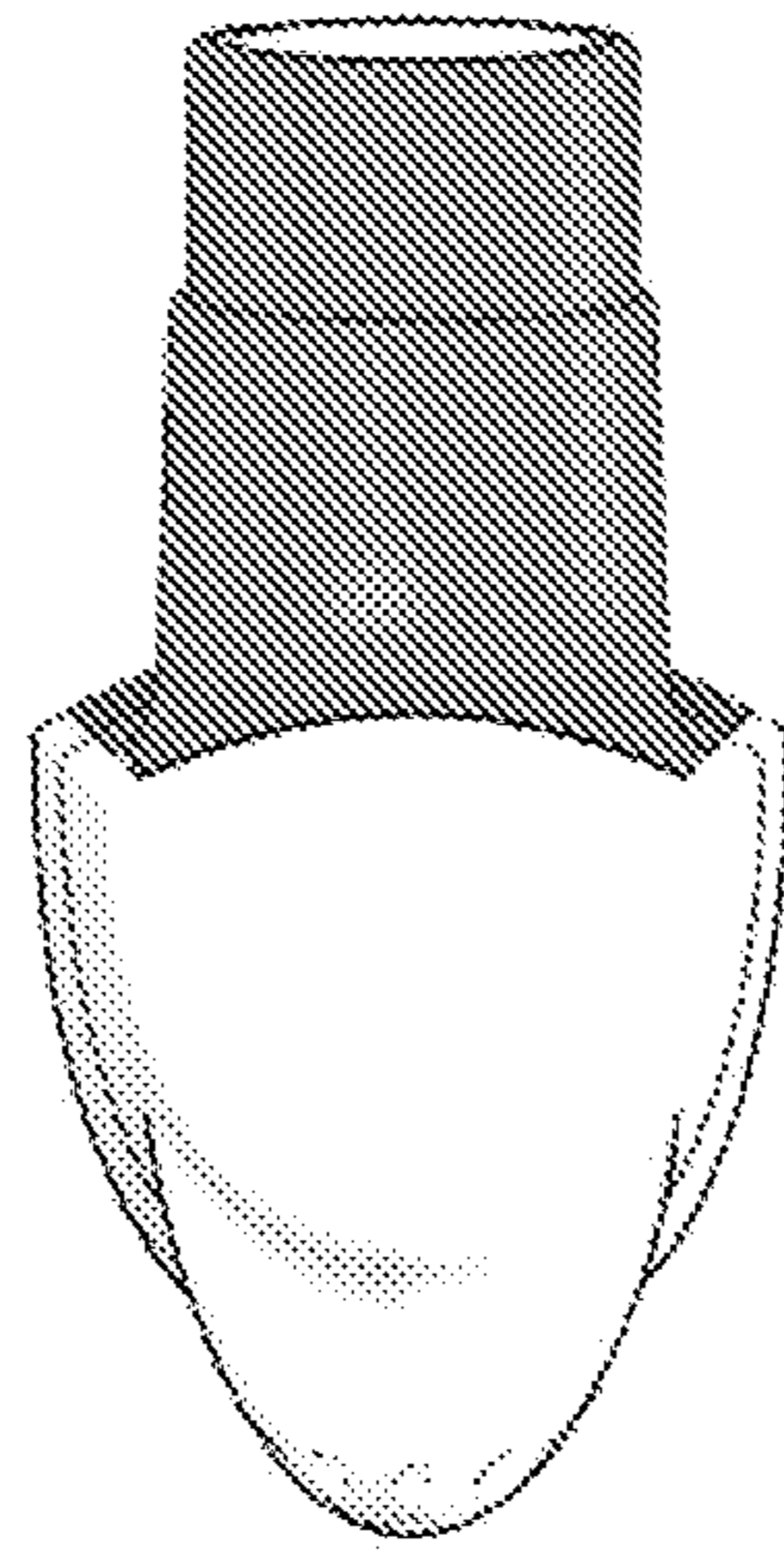

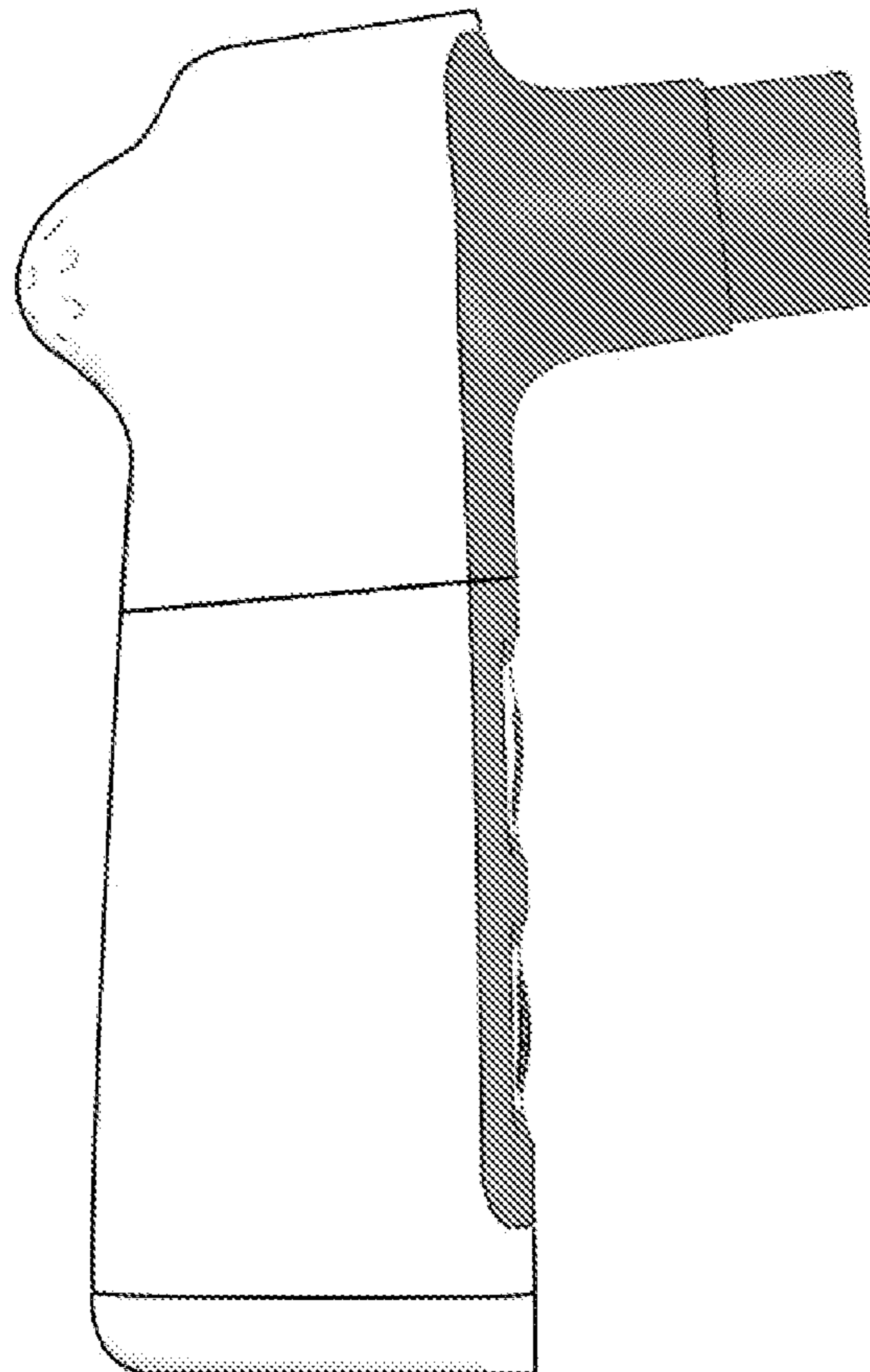
