DESCRIPTION

ment of a ladder rail;

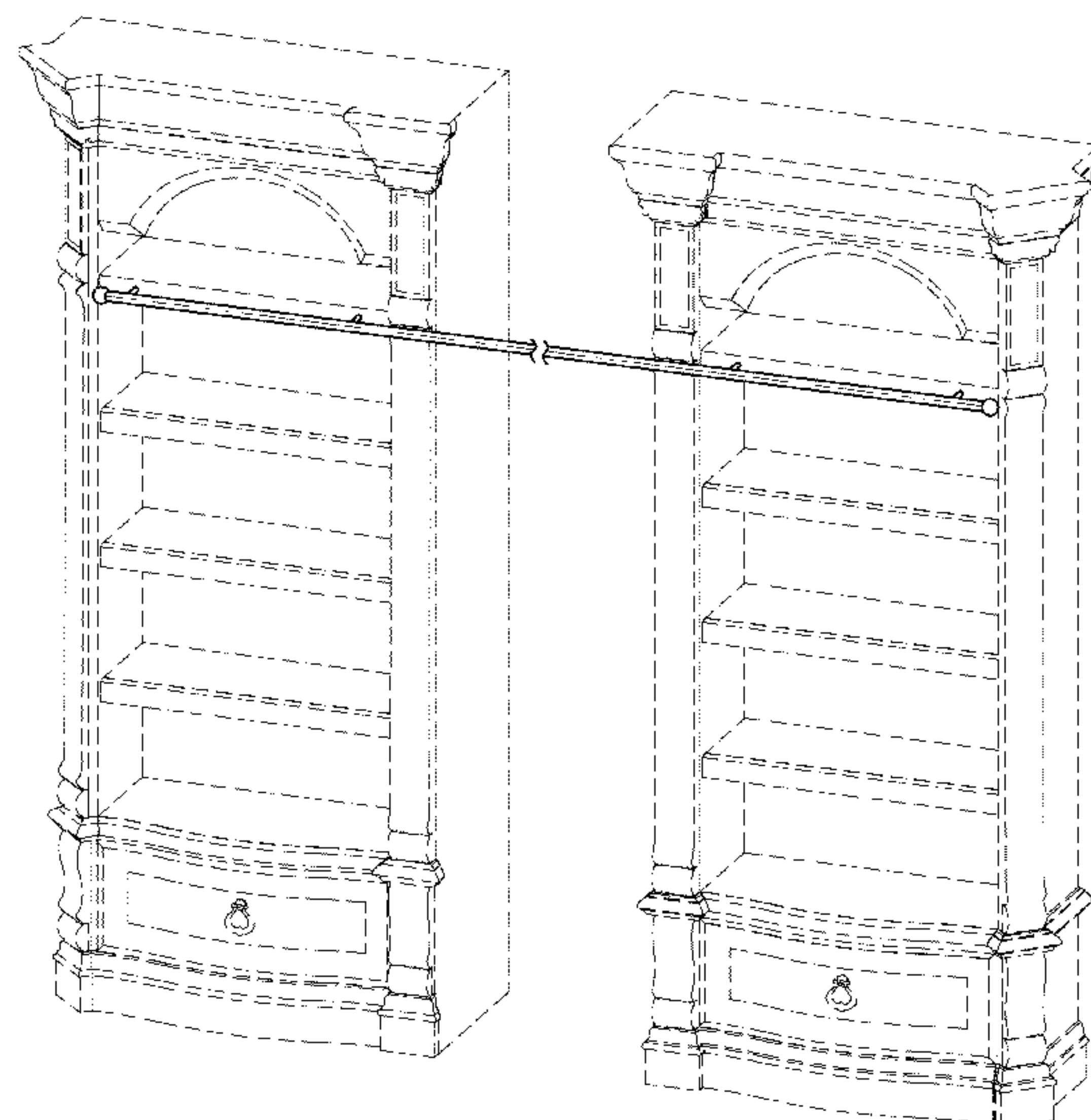
FIG. 17 perspective rear and bottom view thereof;

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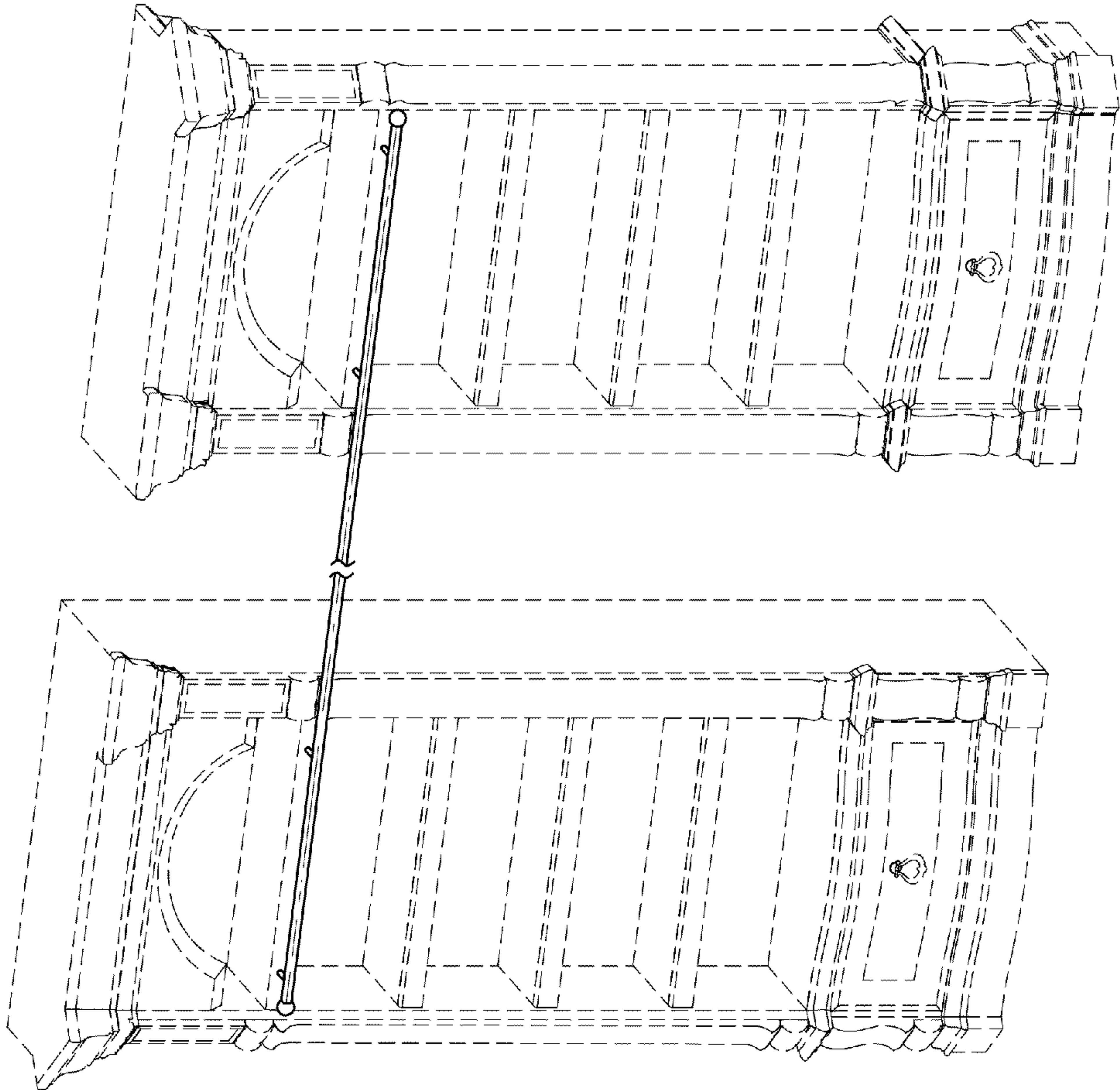
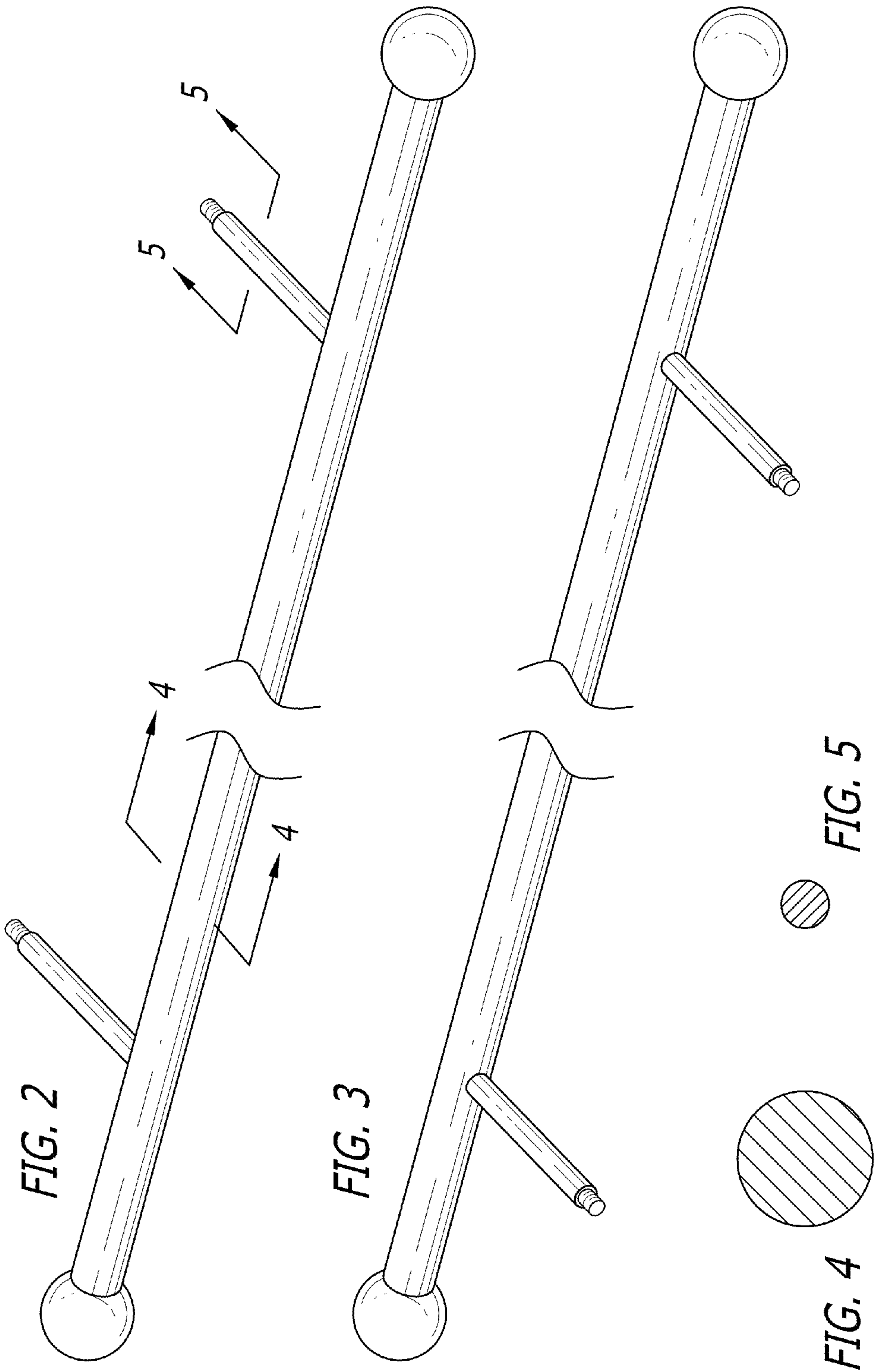

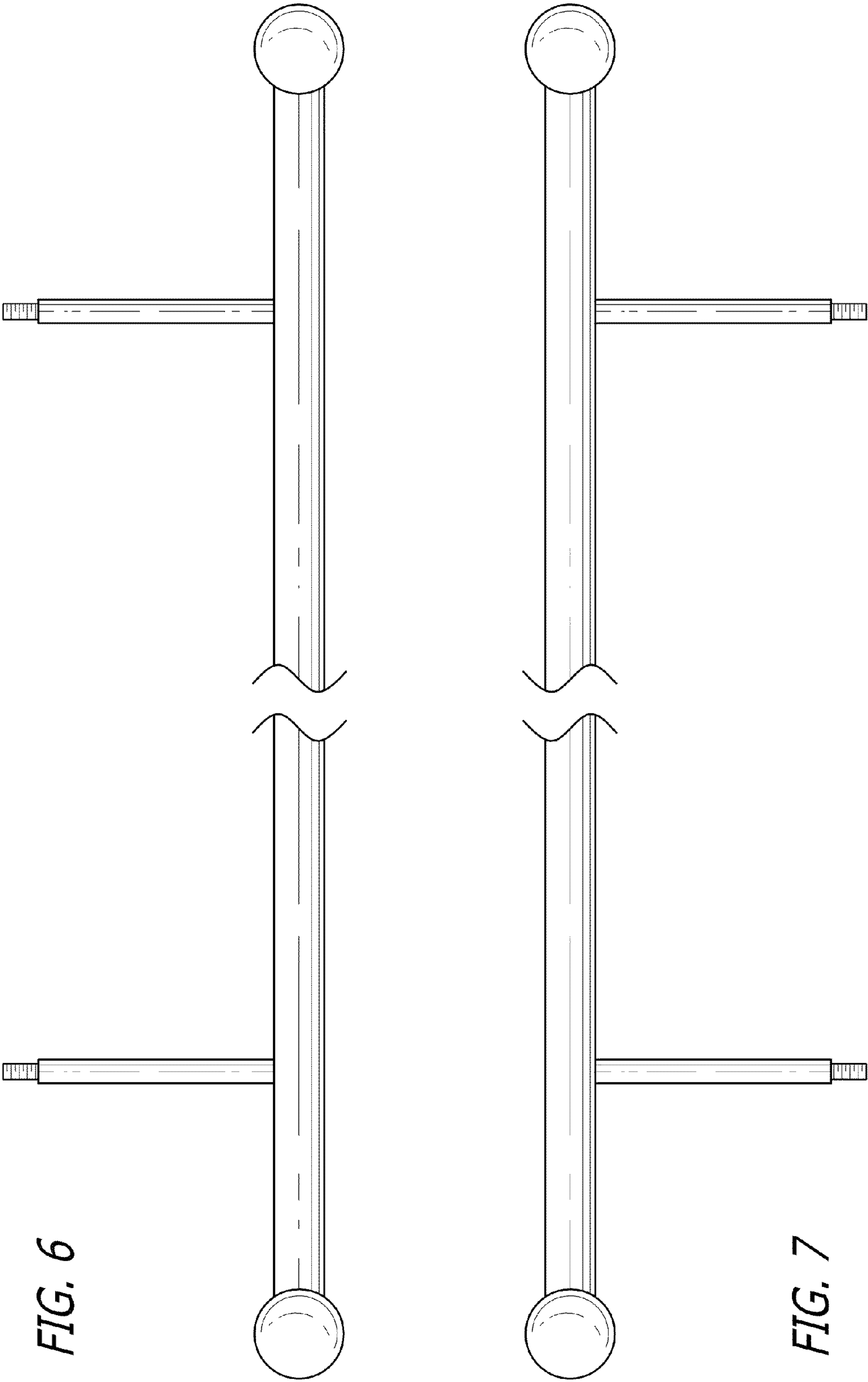

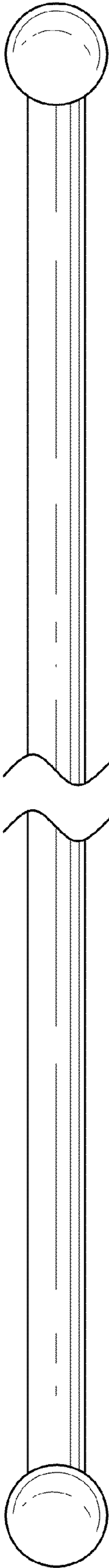

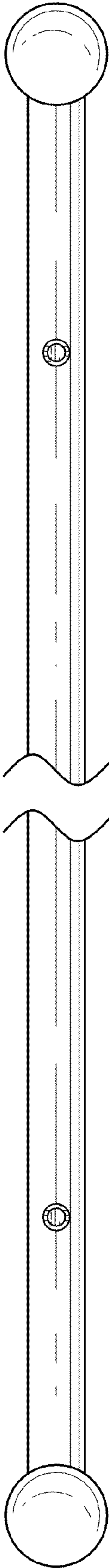

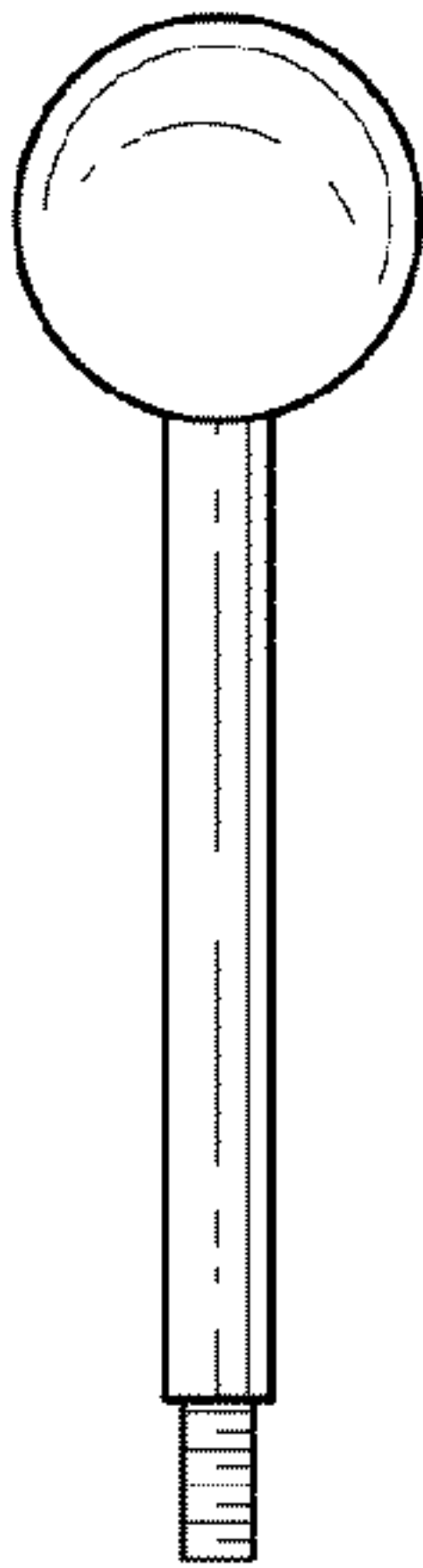
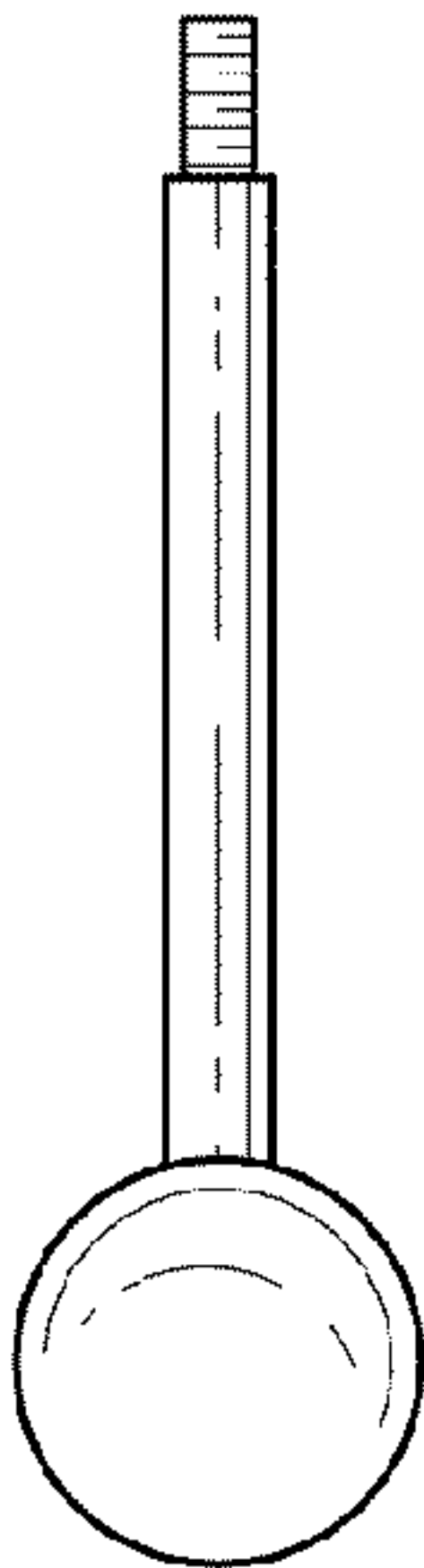

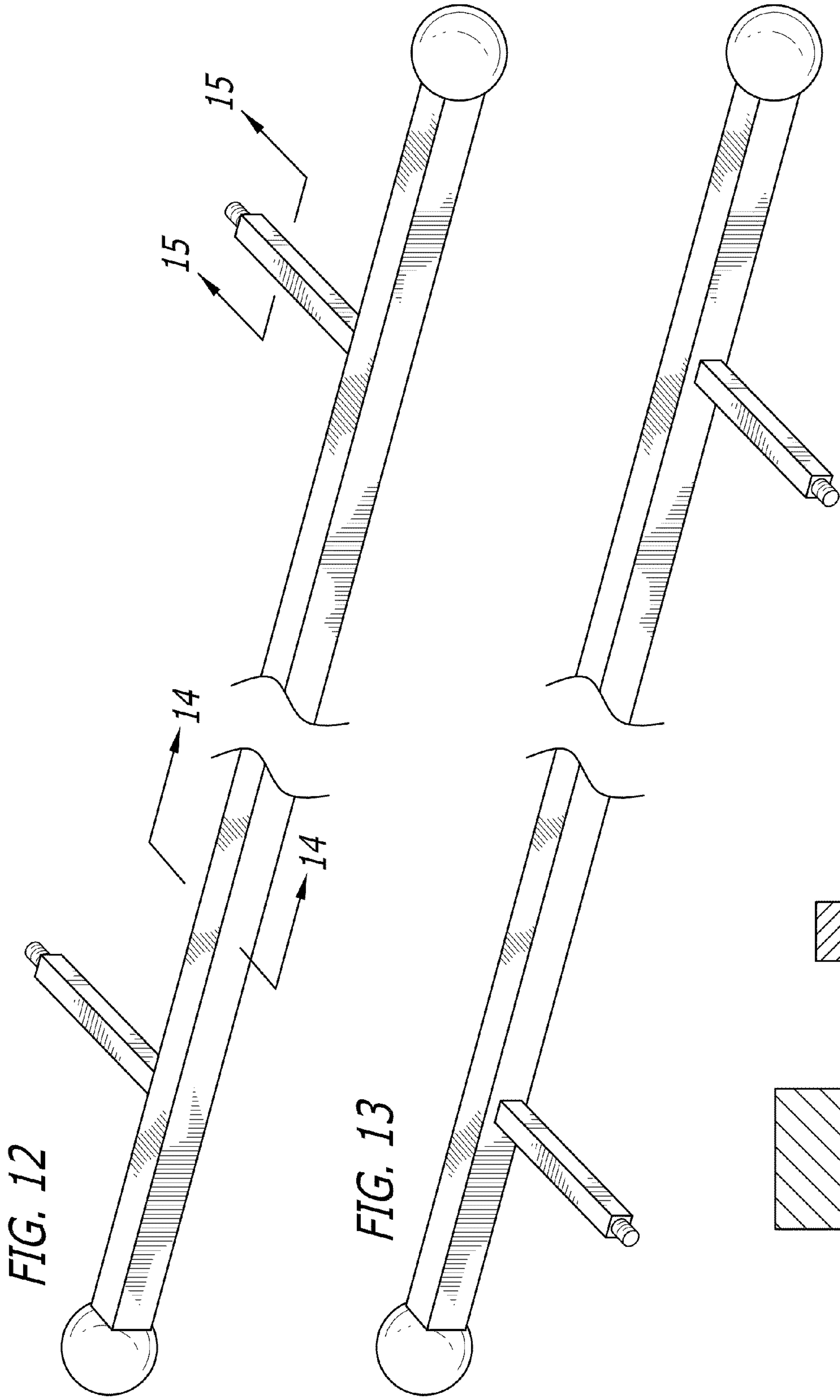
