FIG. 14 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 10;

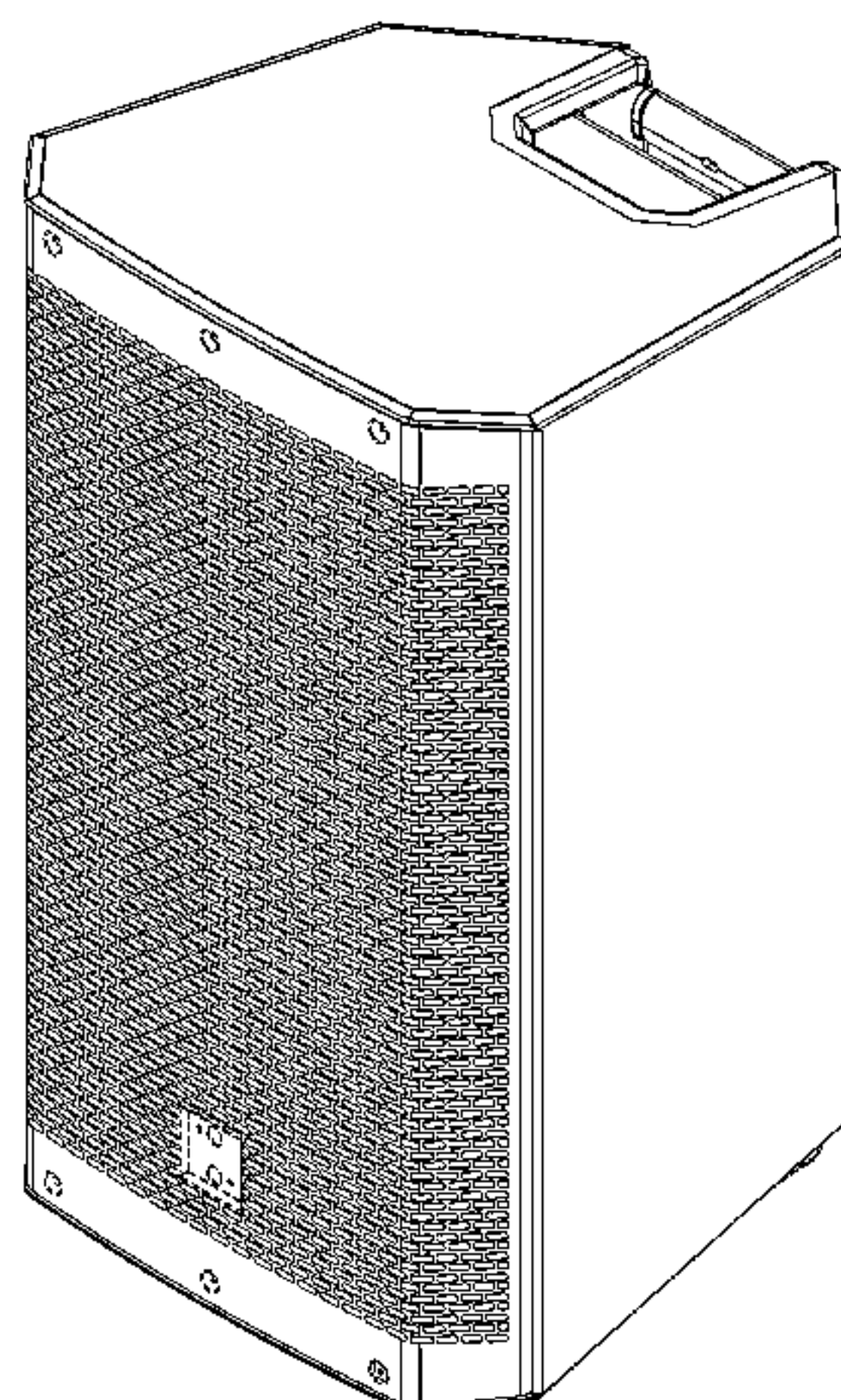
FIG. 15 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 10;

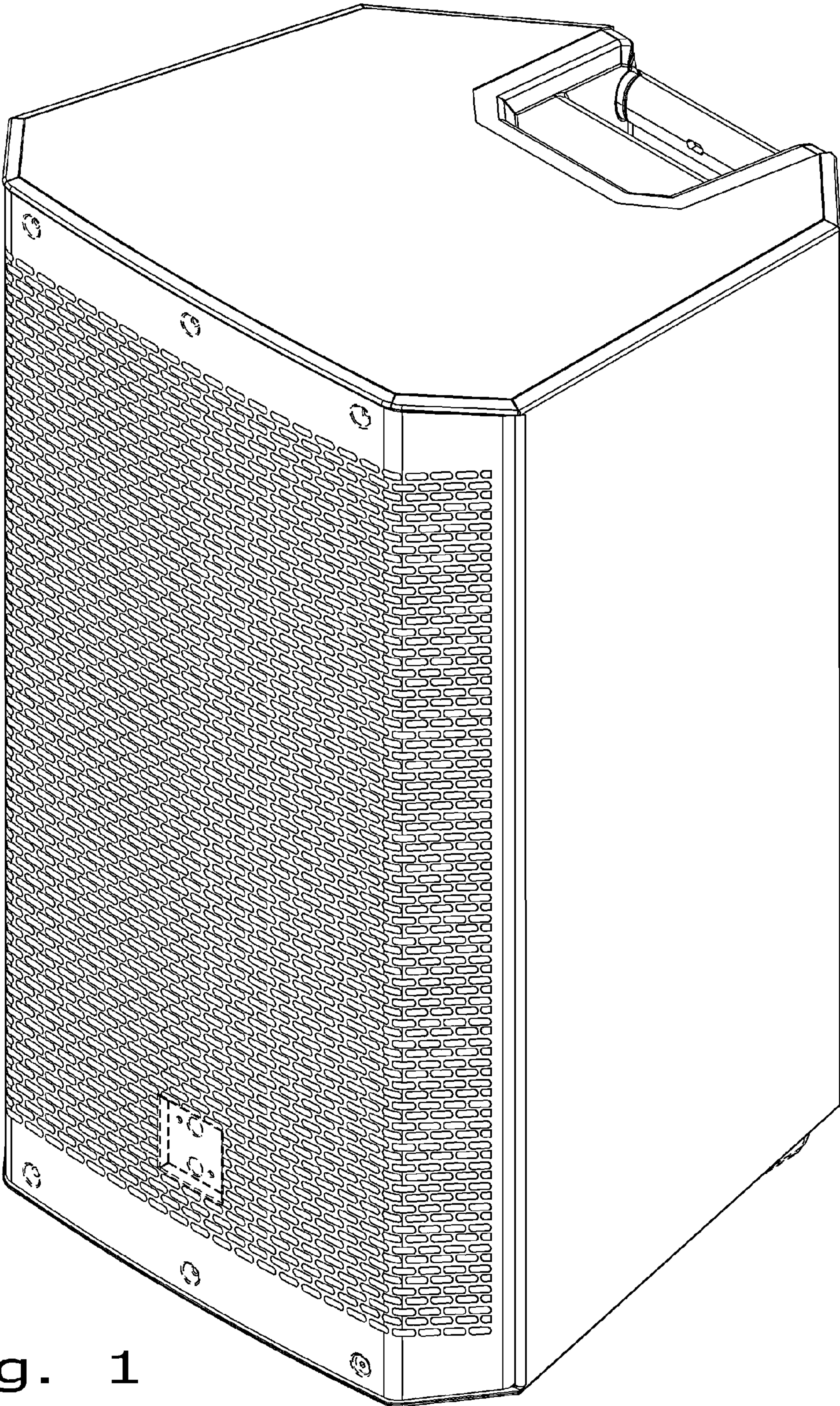

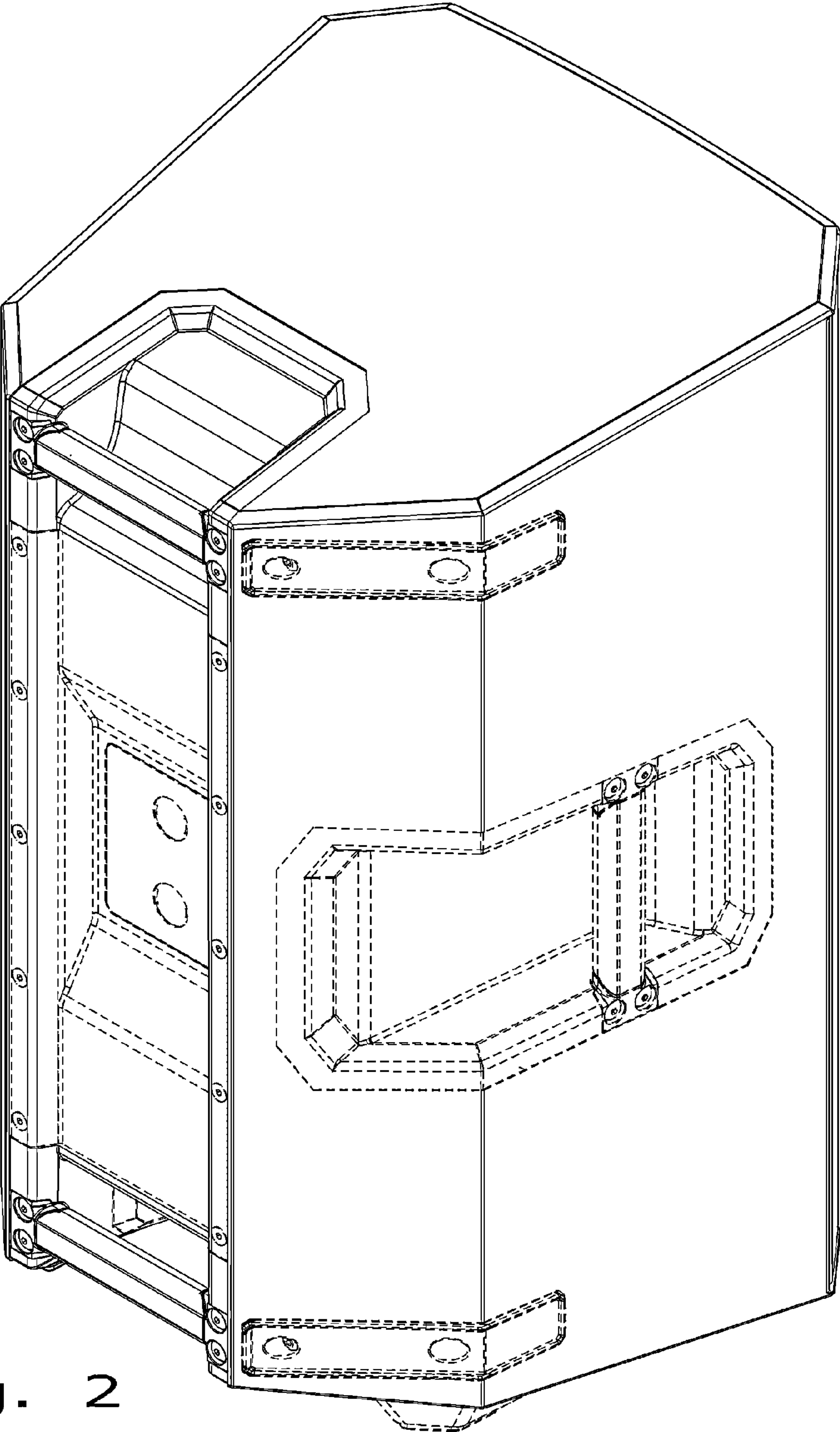

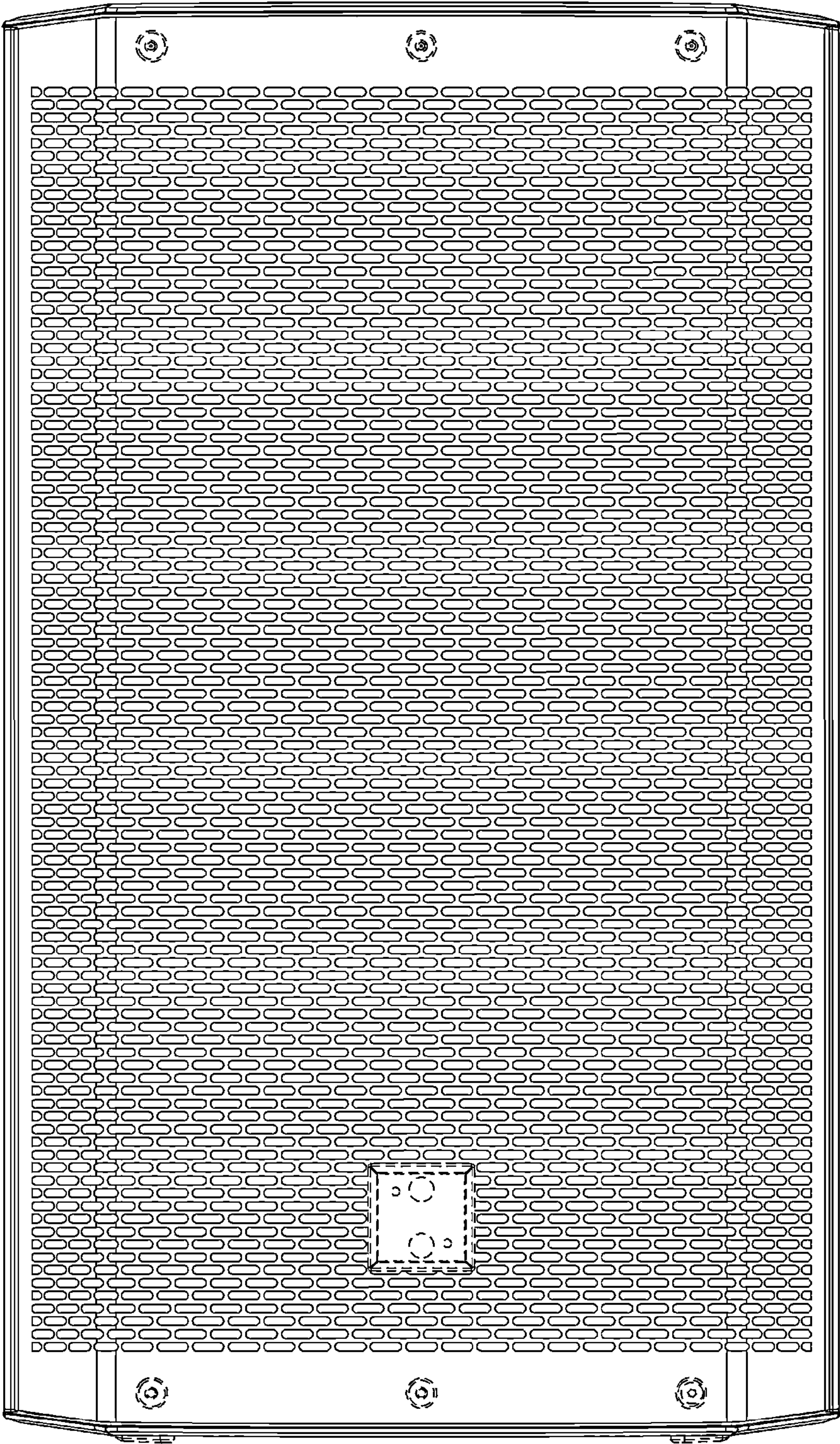

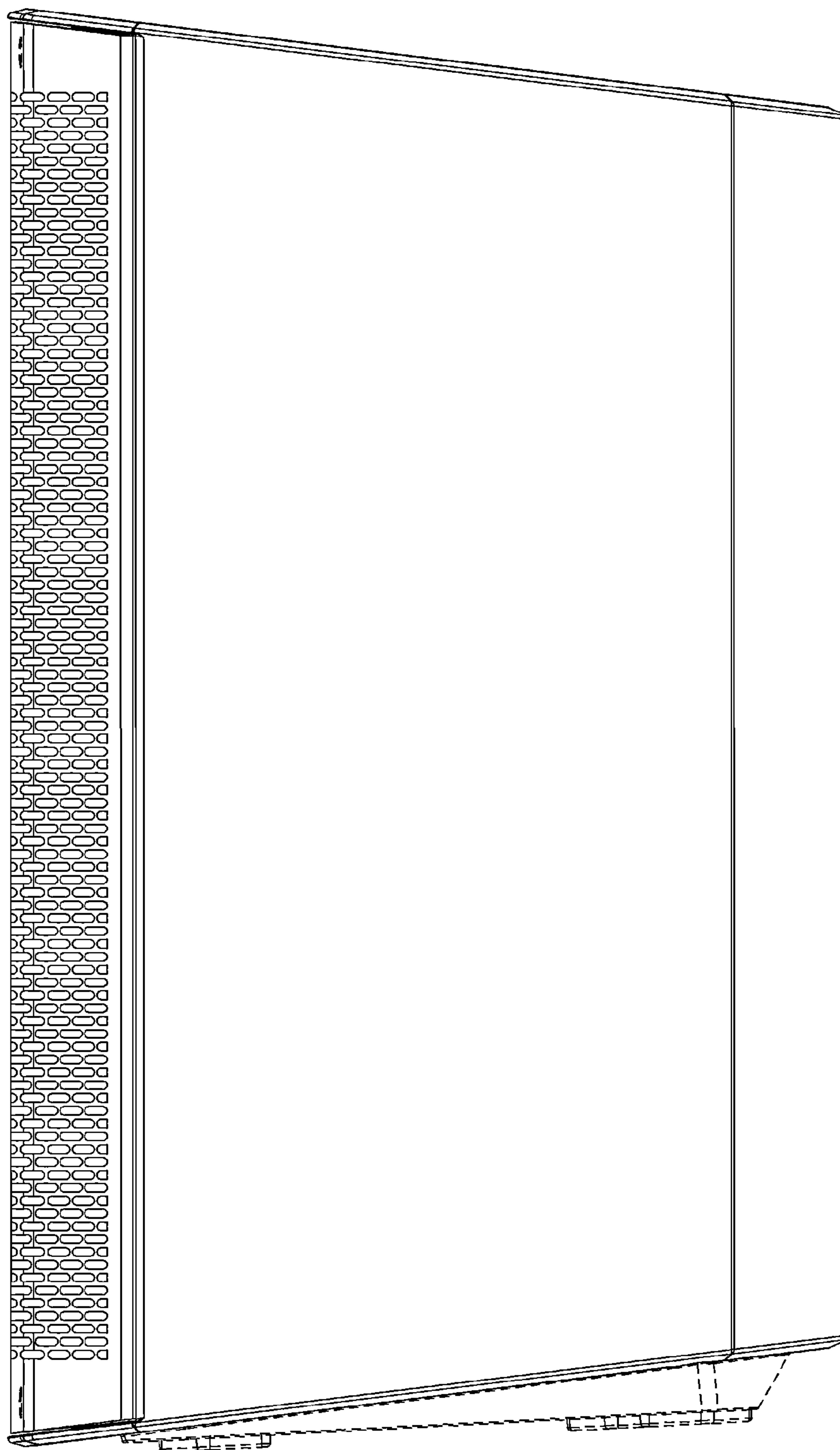

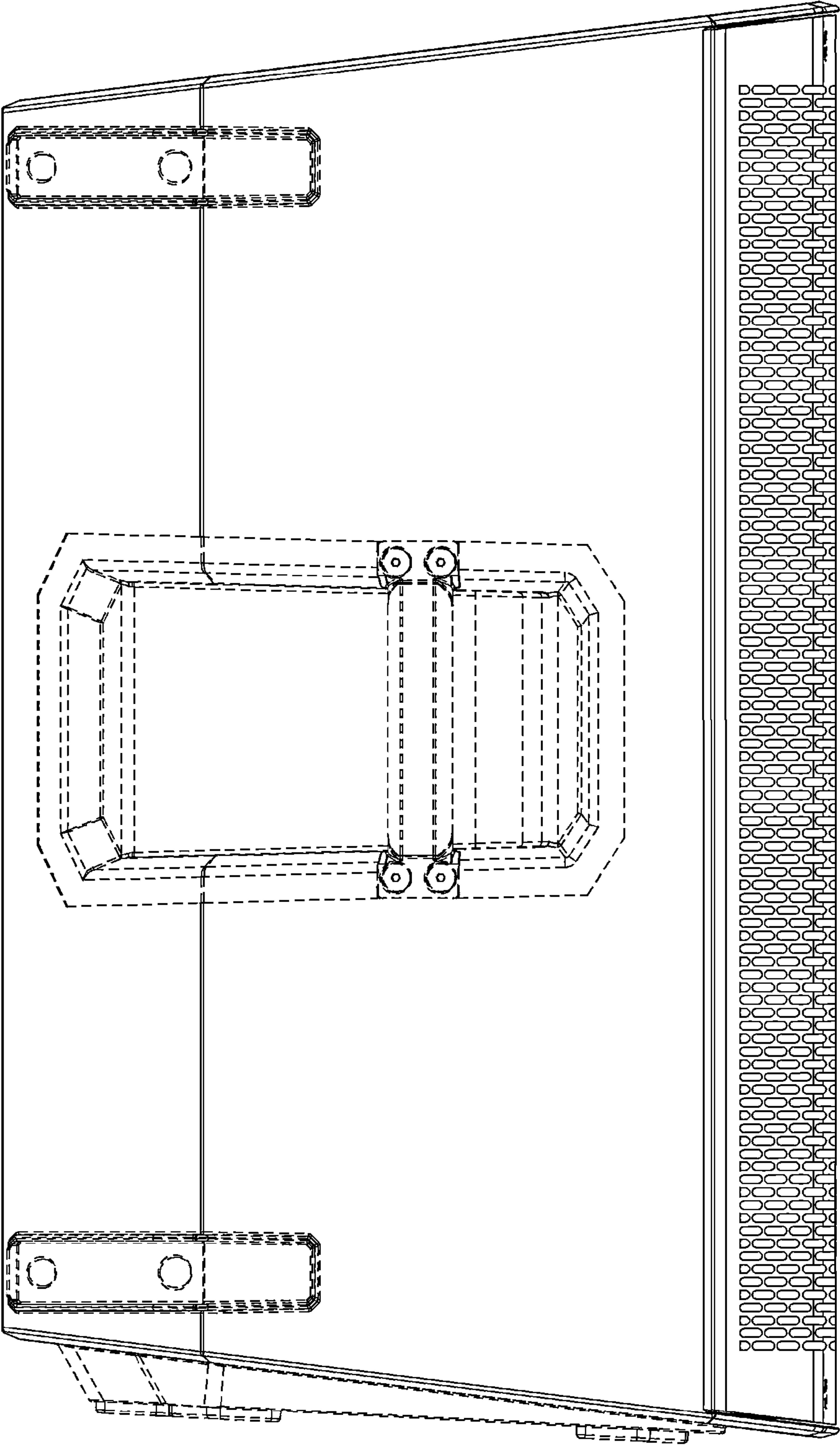

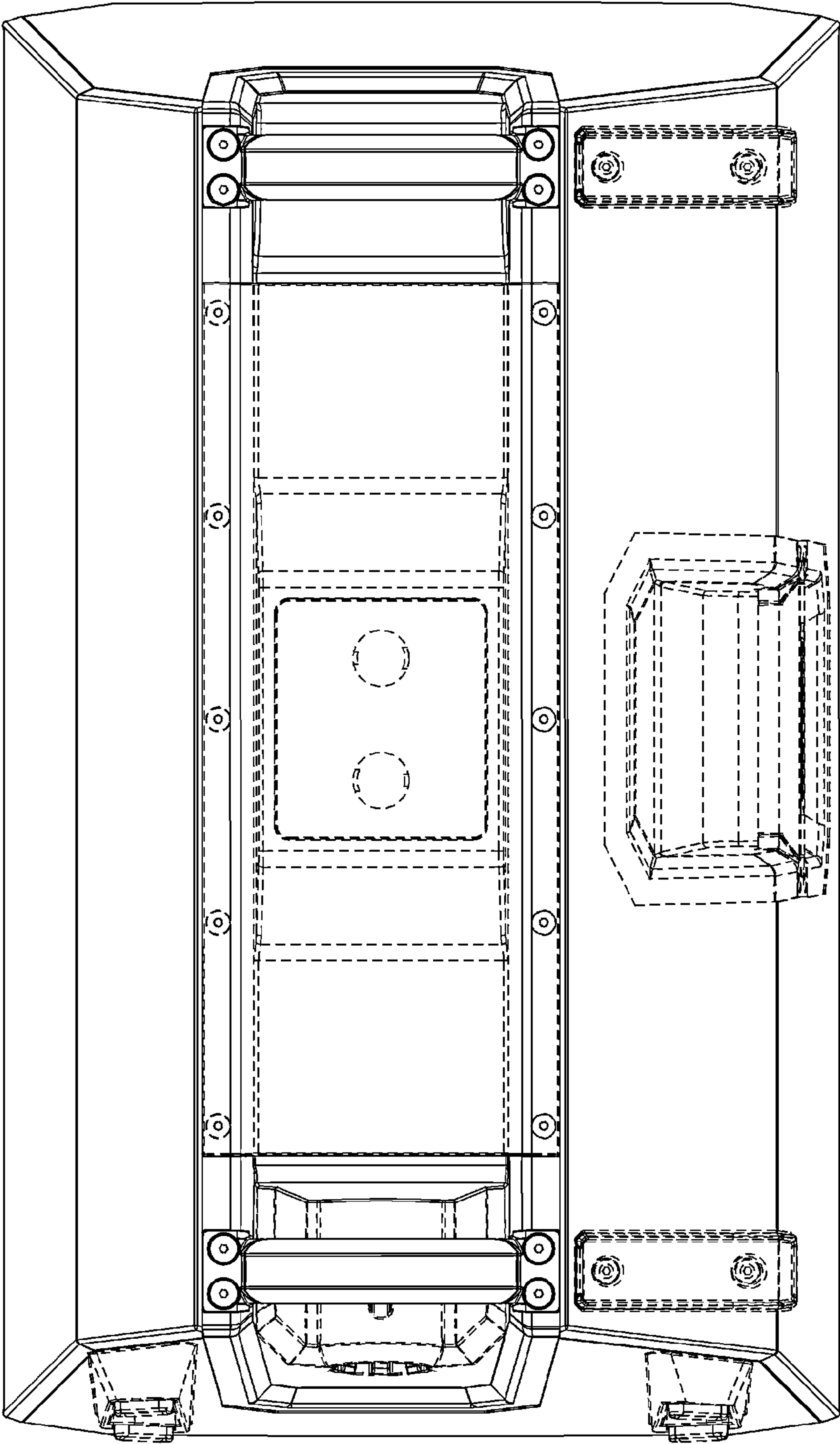

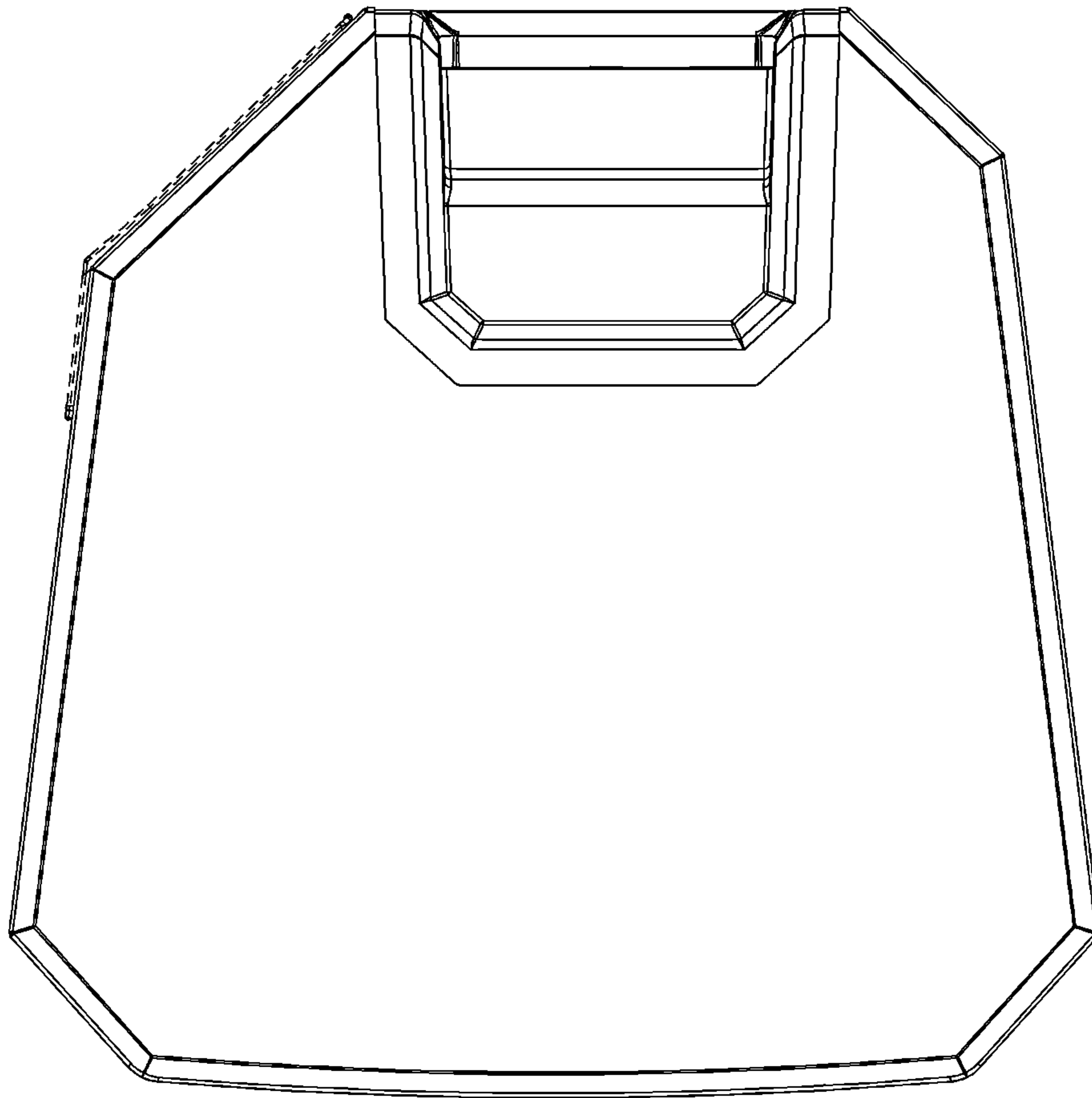

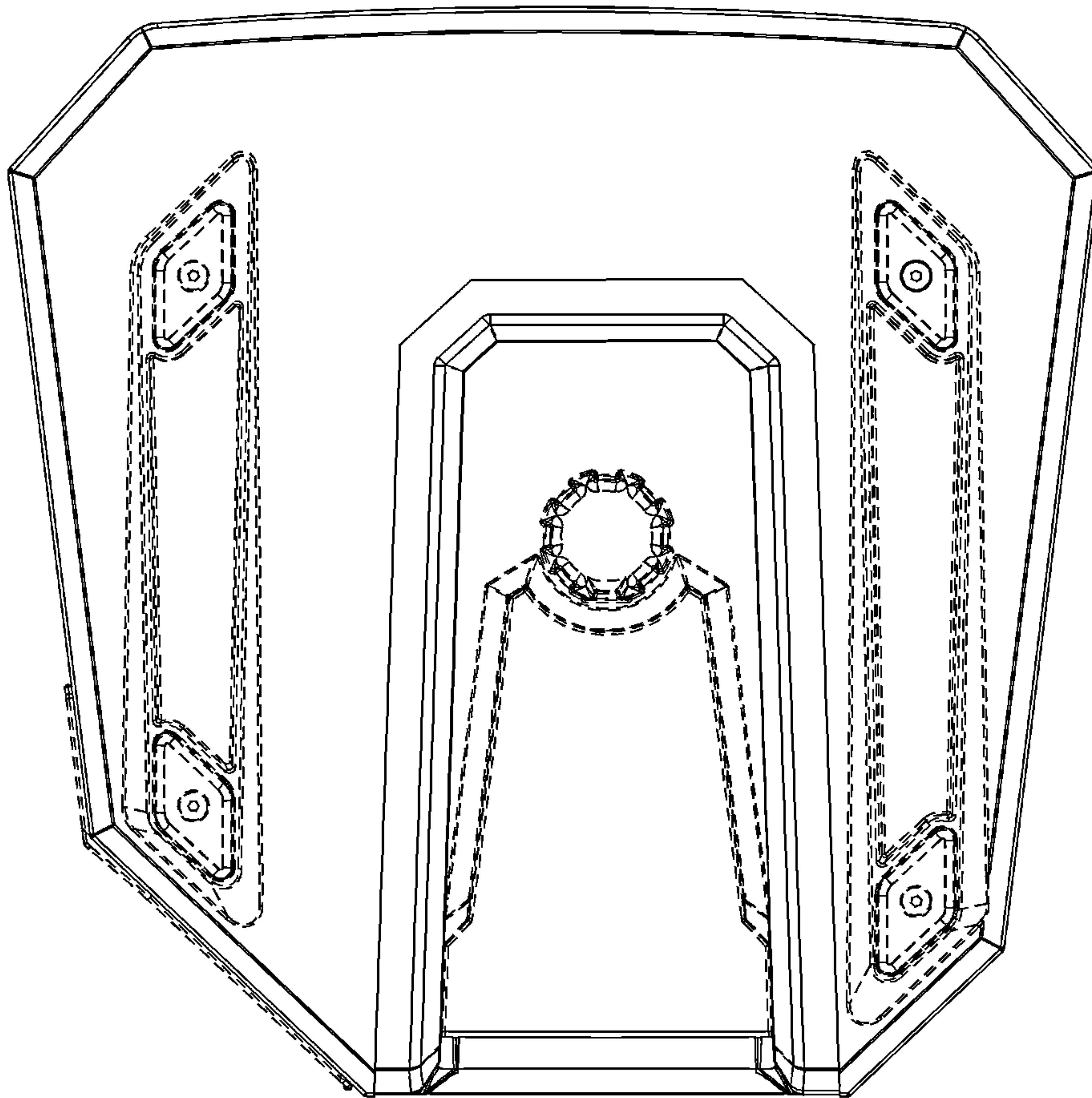

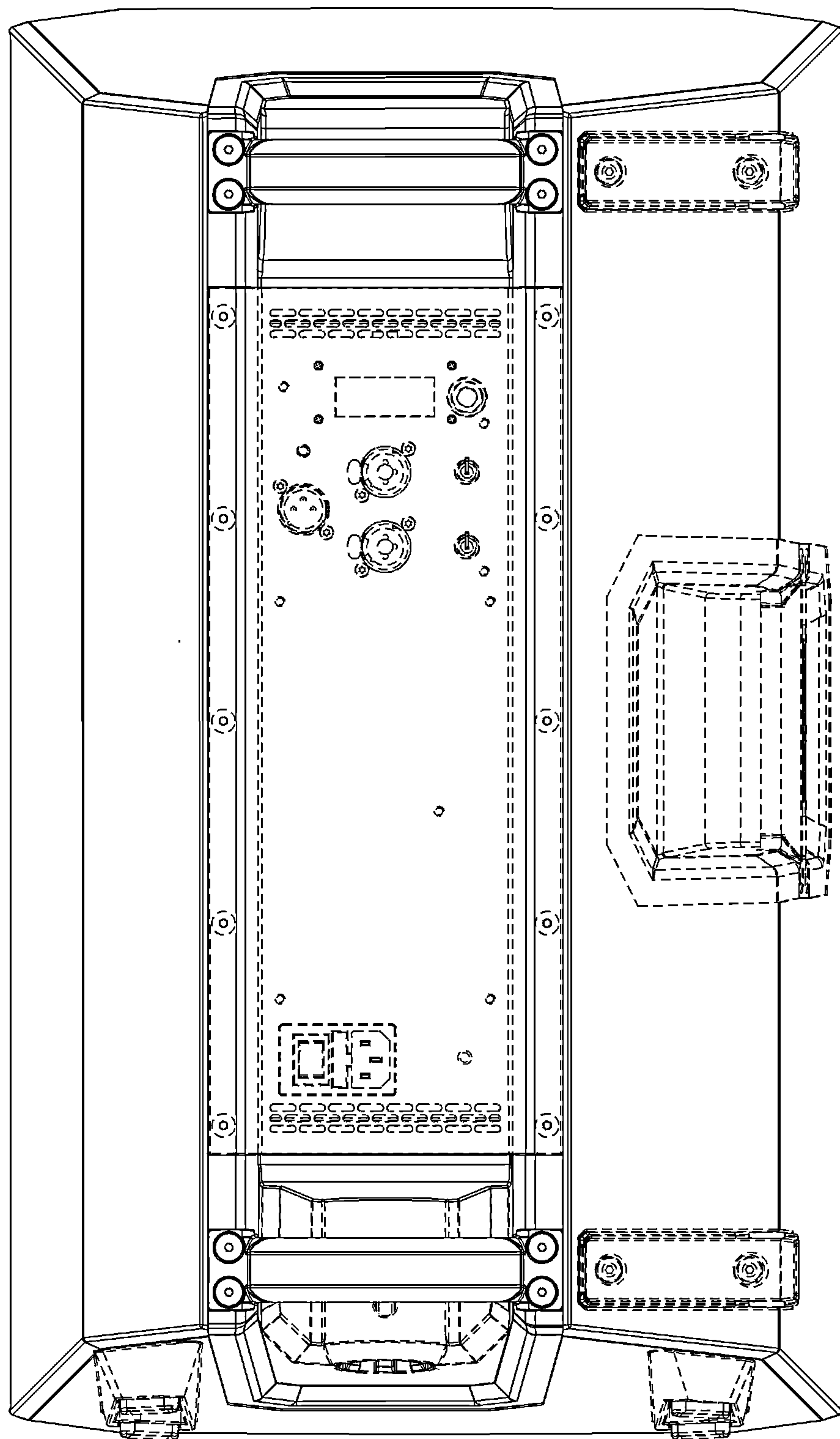

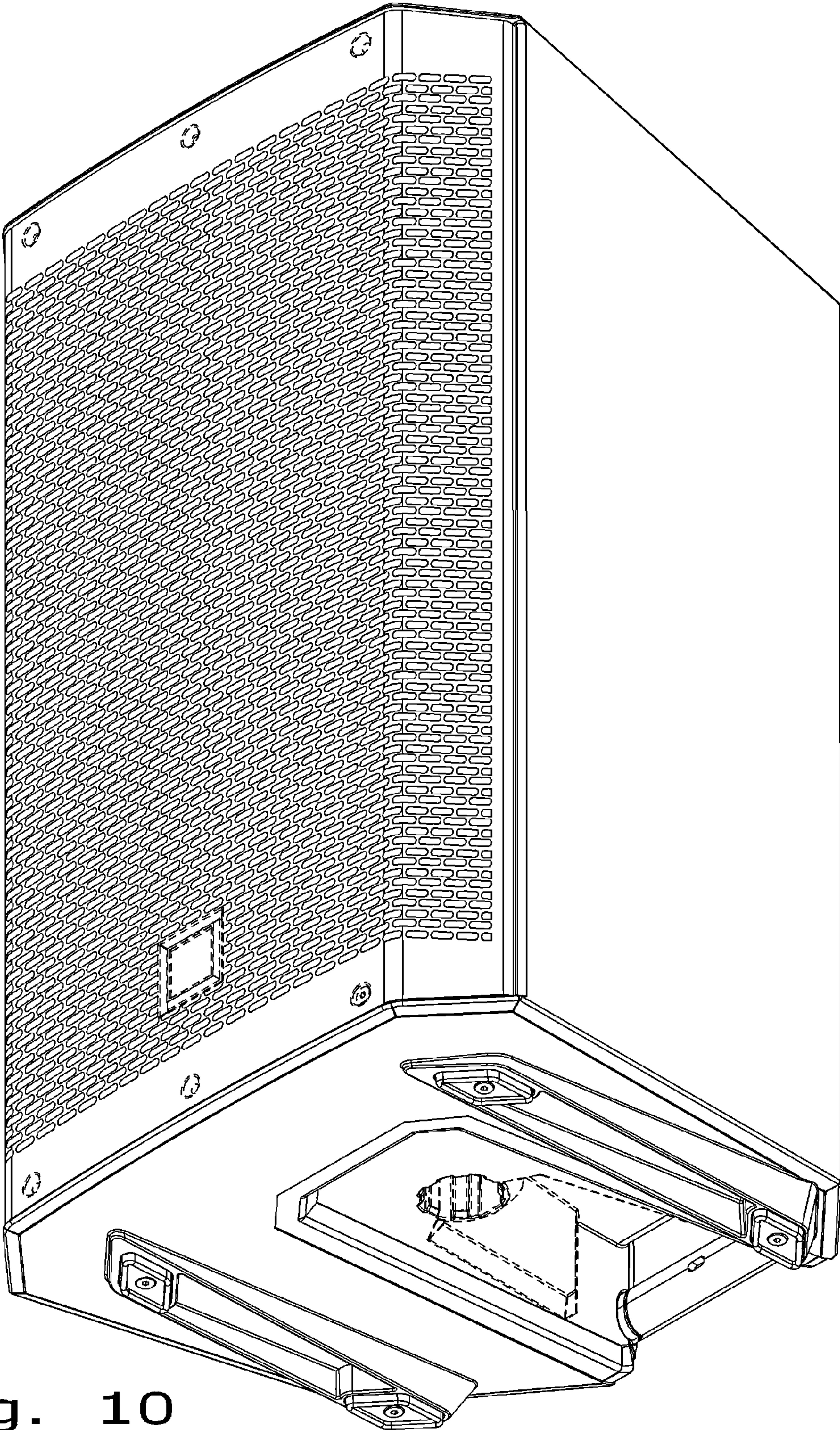

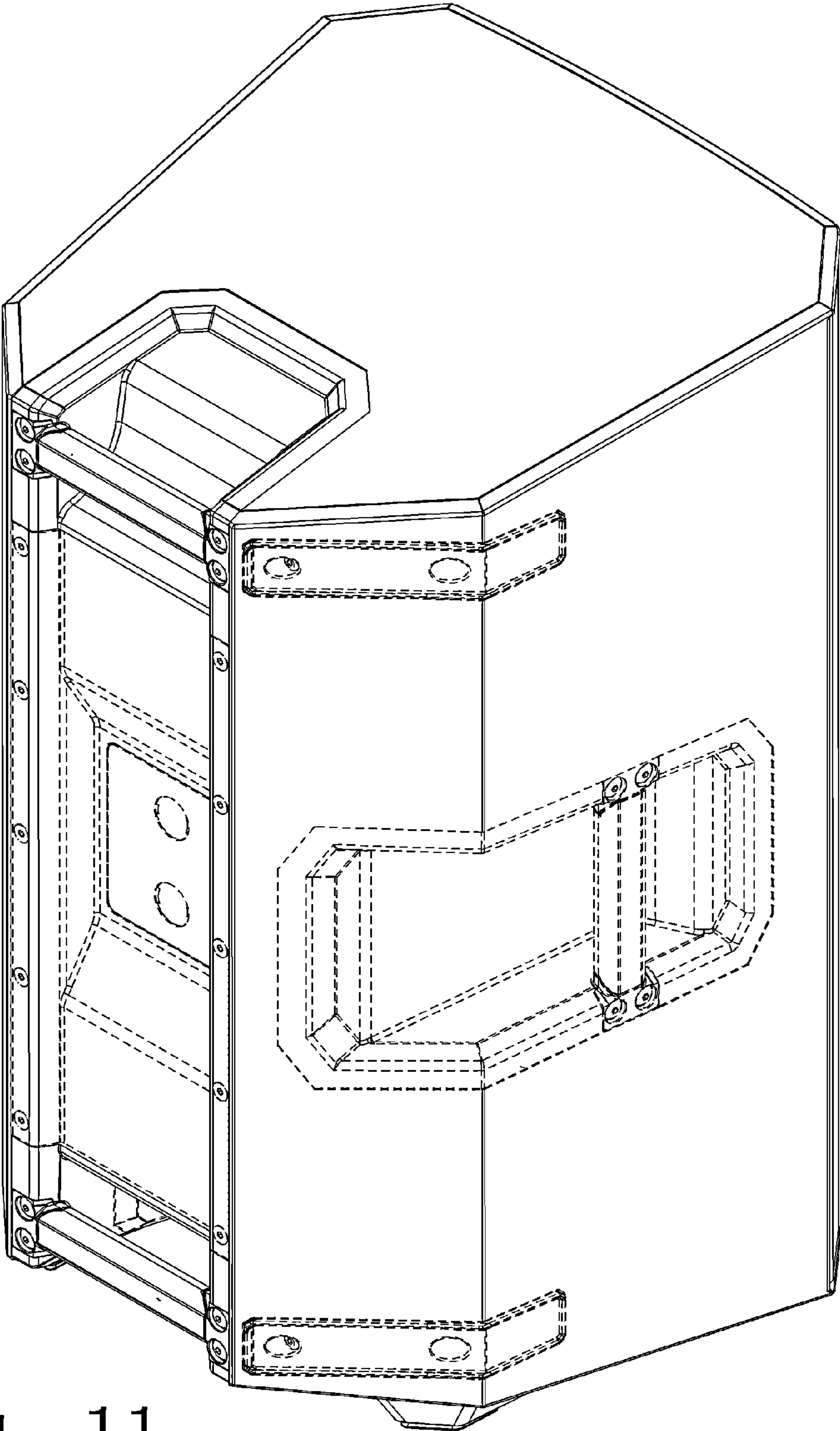

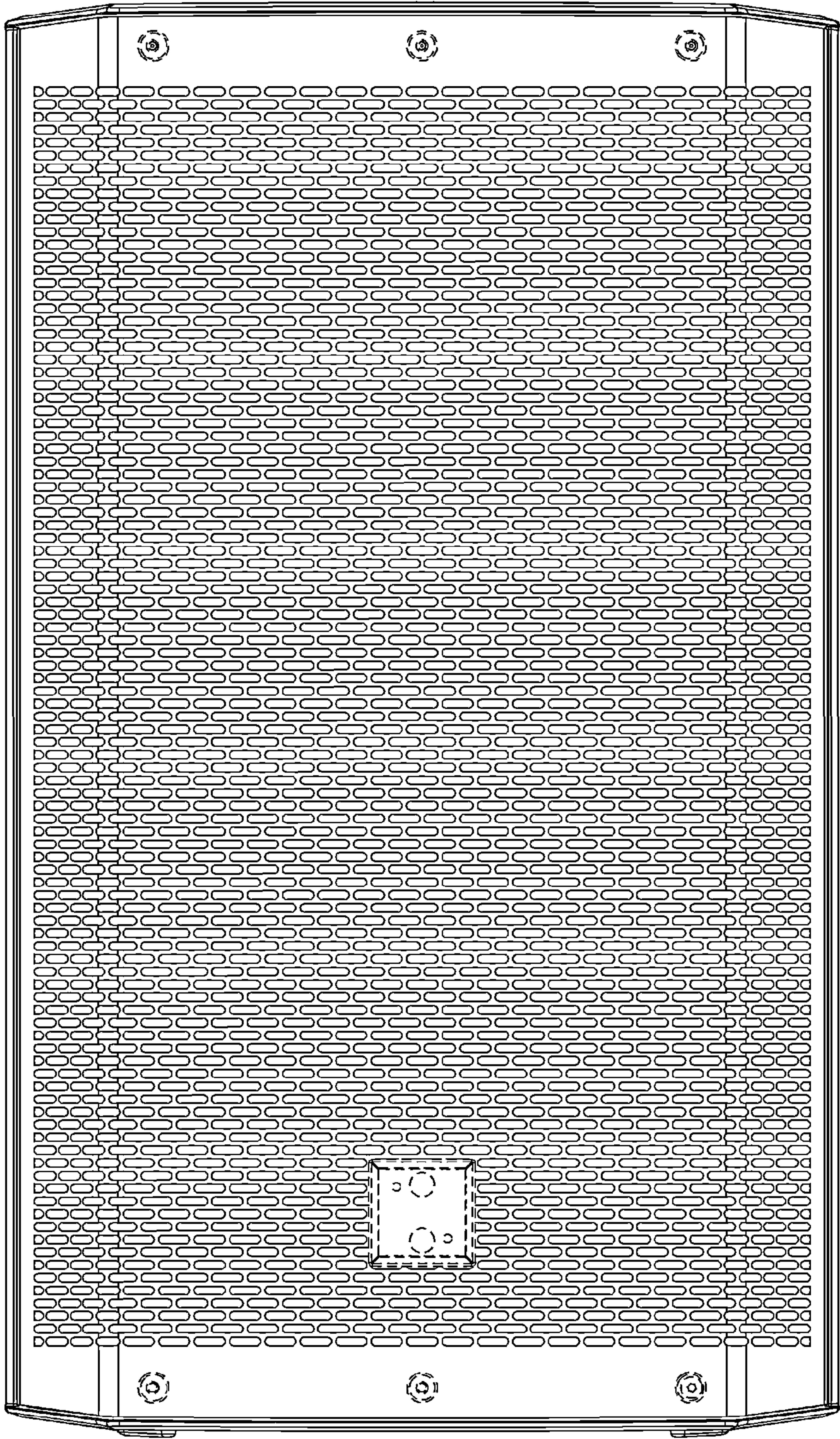

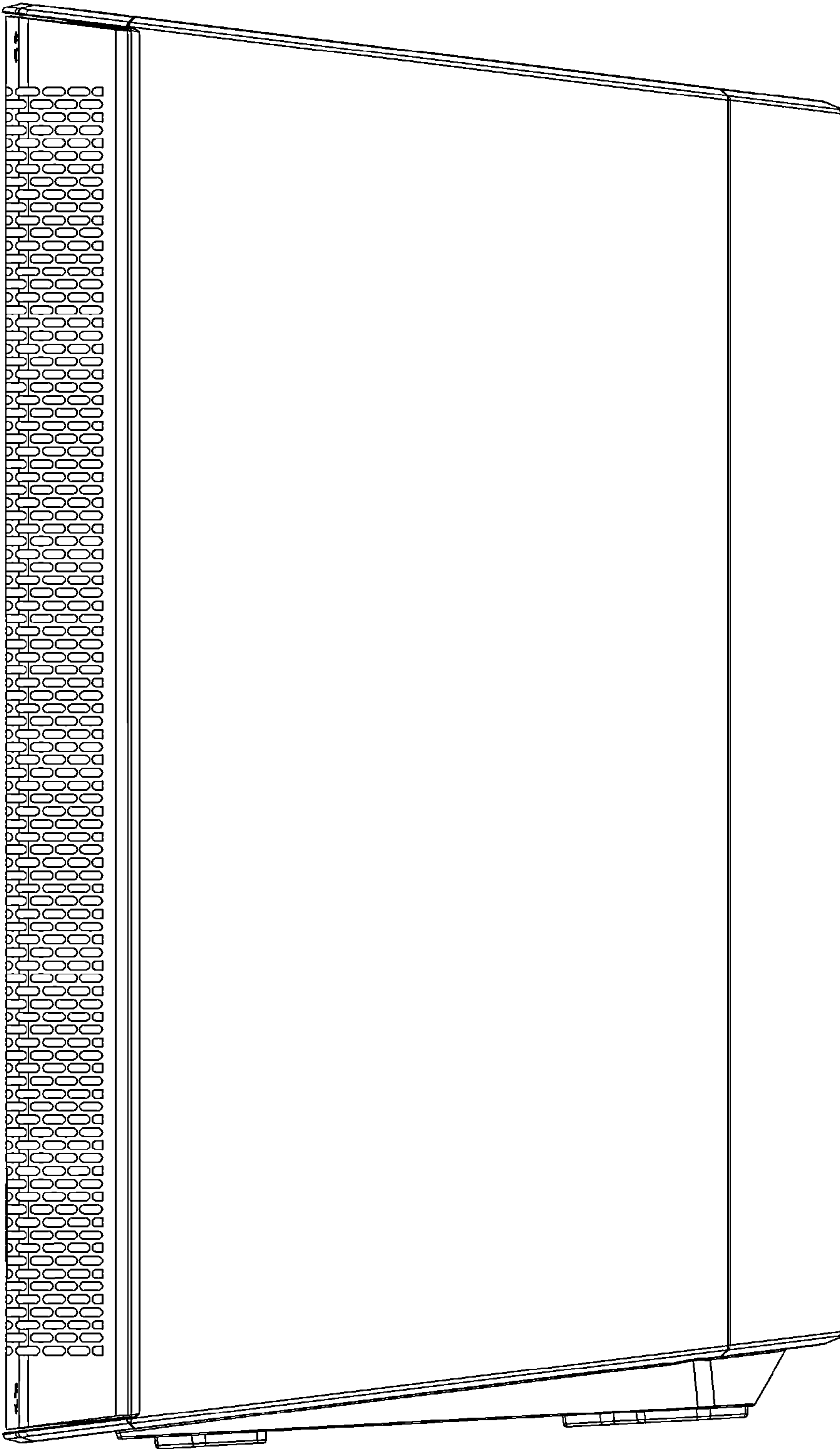

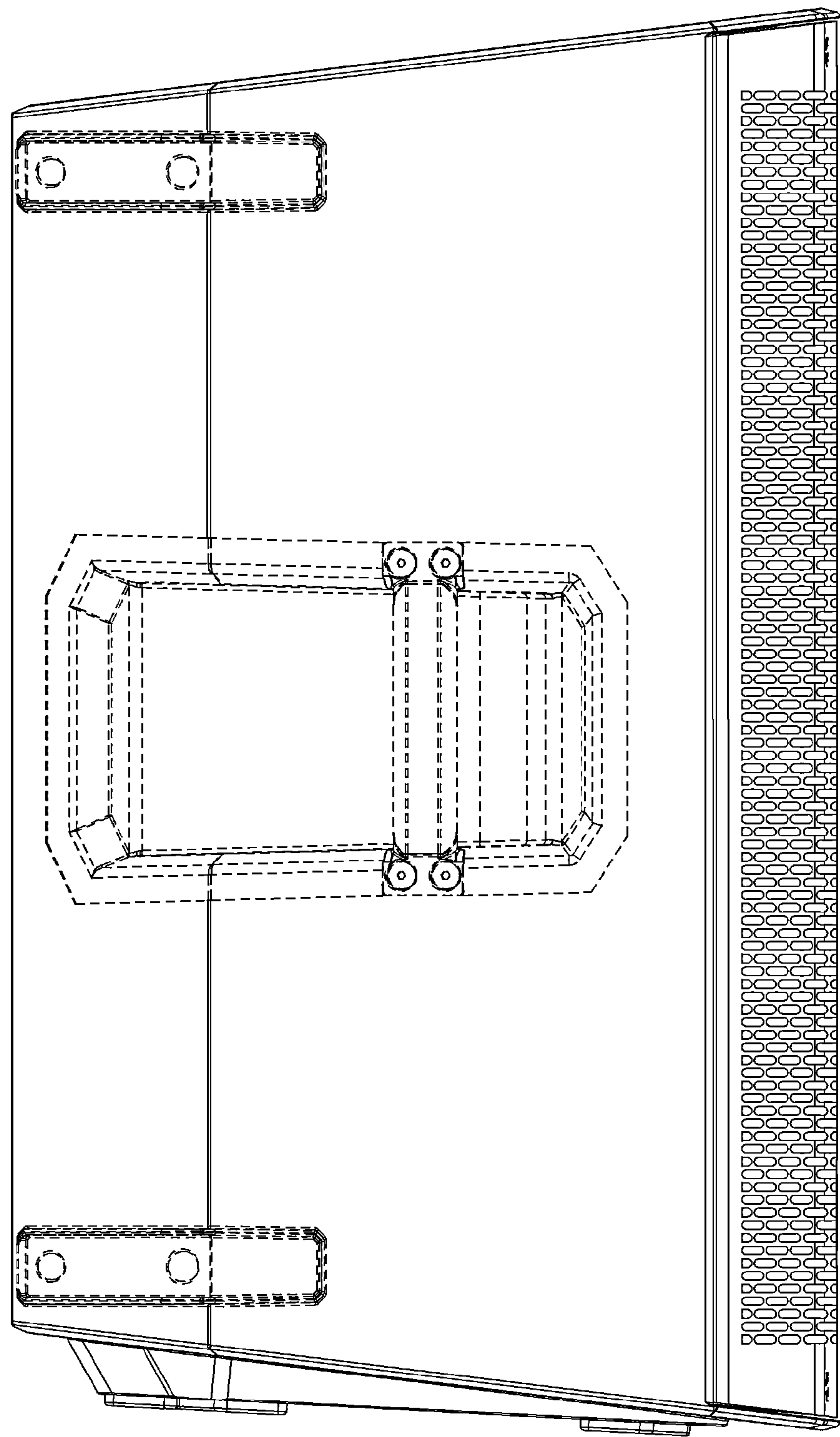

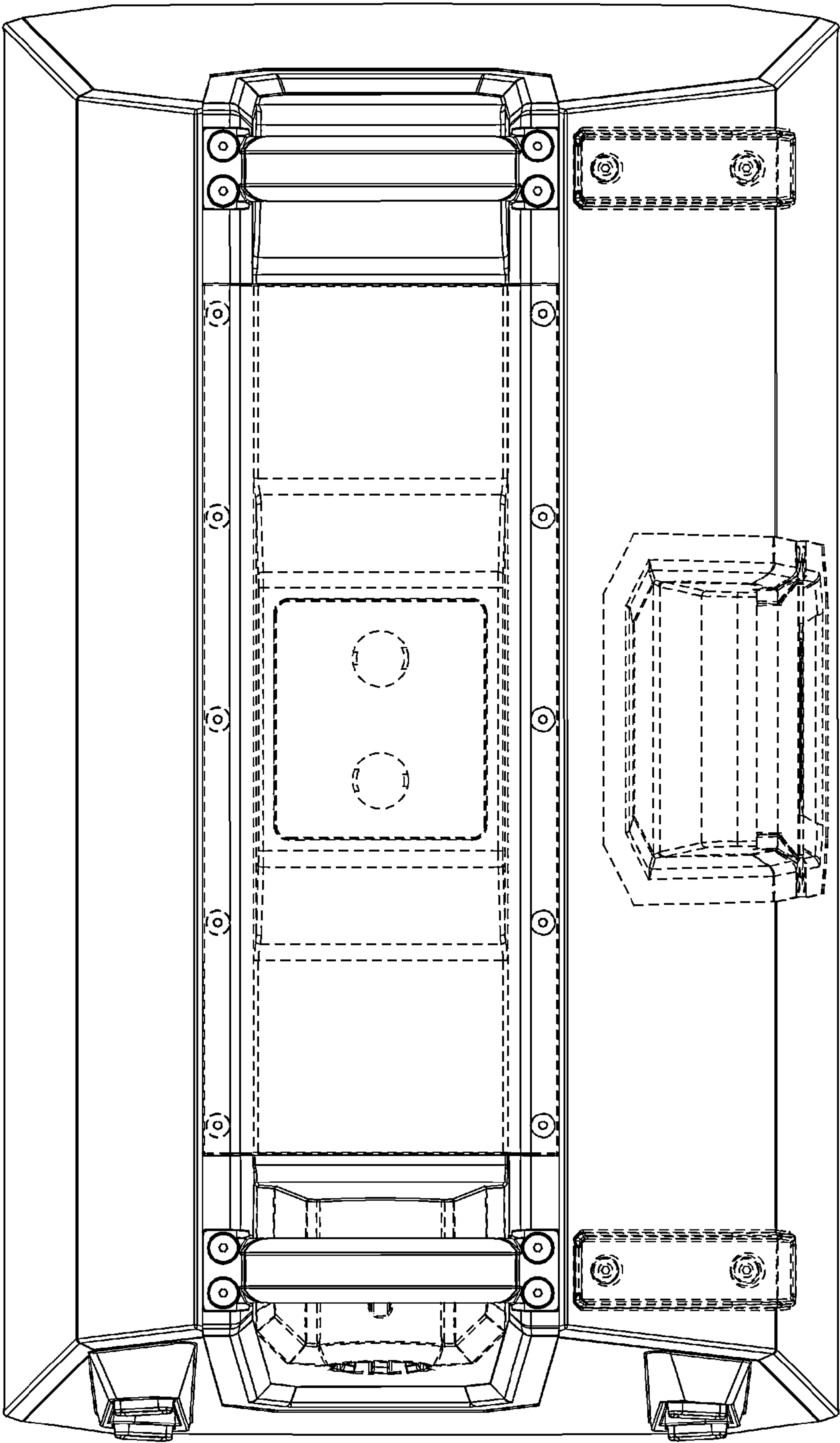

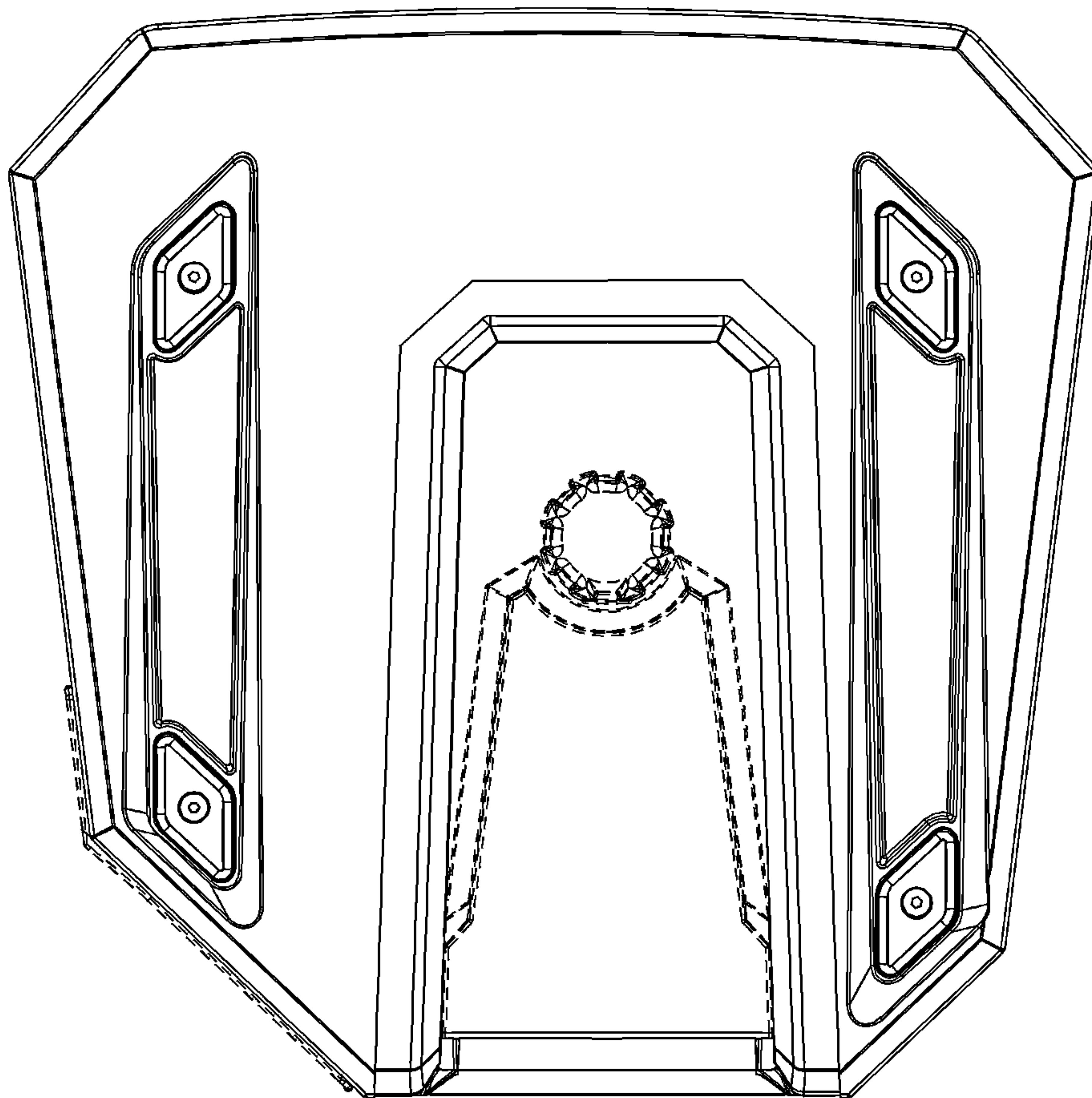

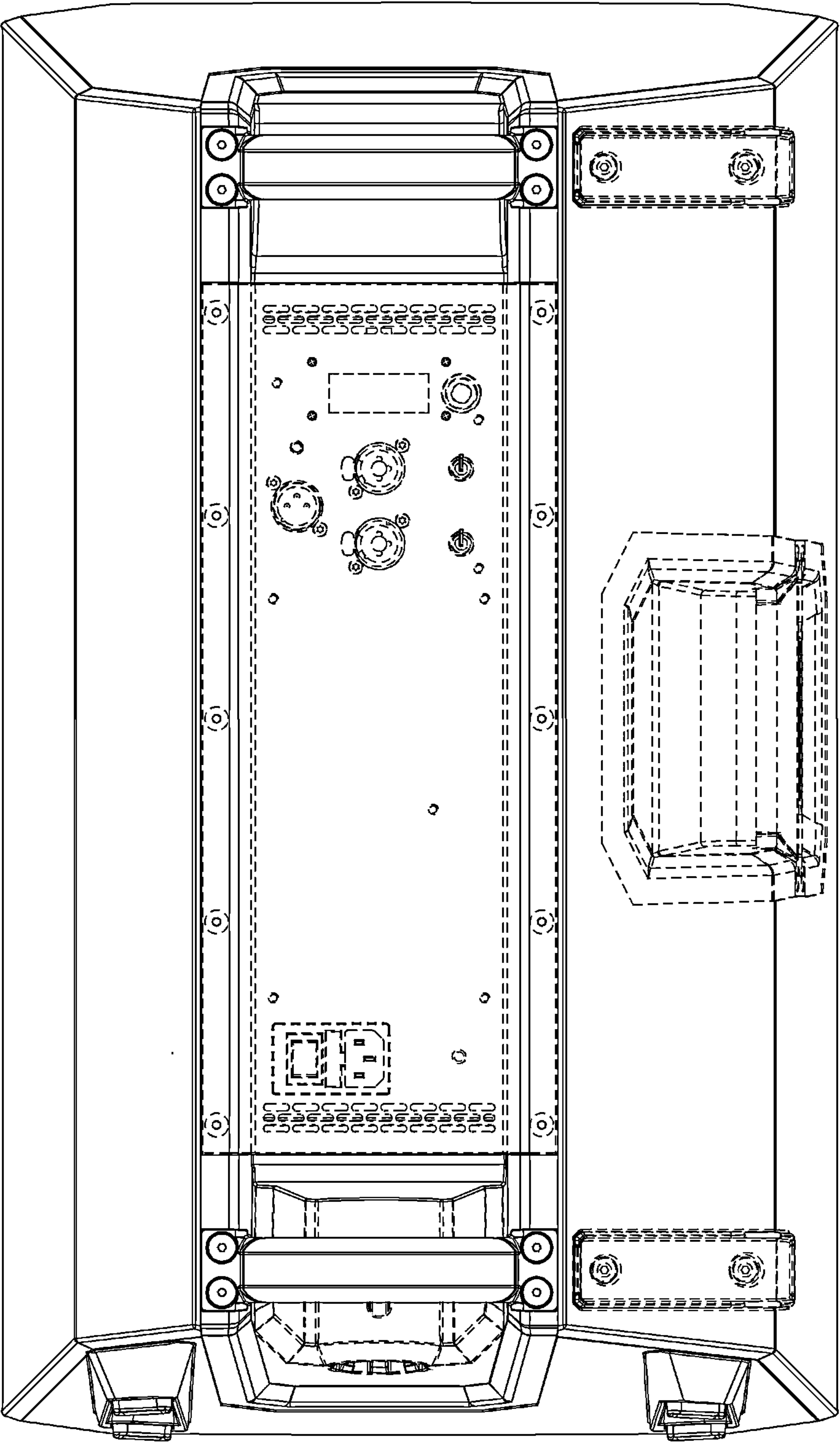
