The ornamental design for a foldable bottle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is top, front and right perspective view of the foldable bottle showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof;

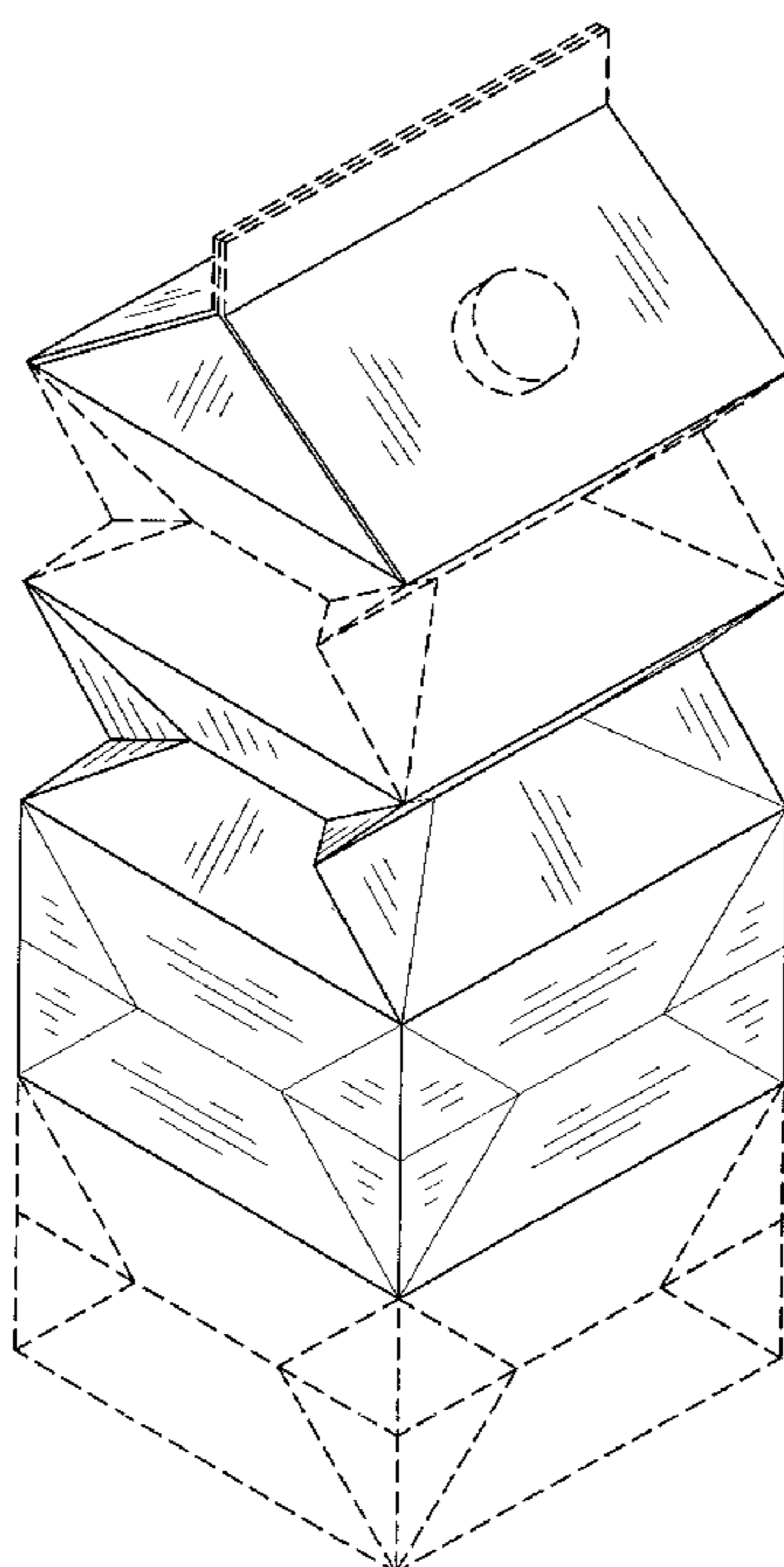
FIG. 3 is a right side elevation view thereof, the left side view being a mirror image;

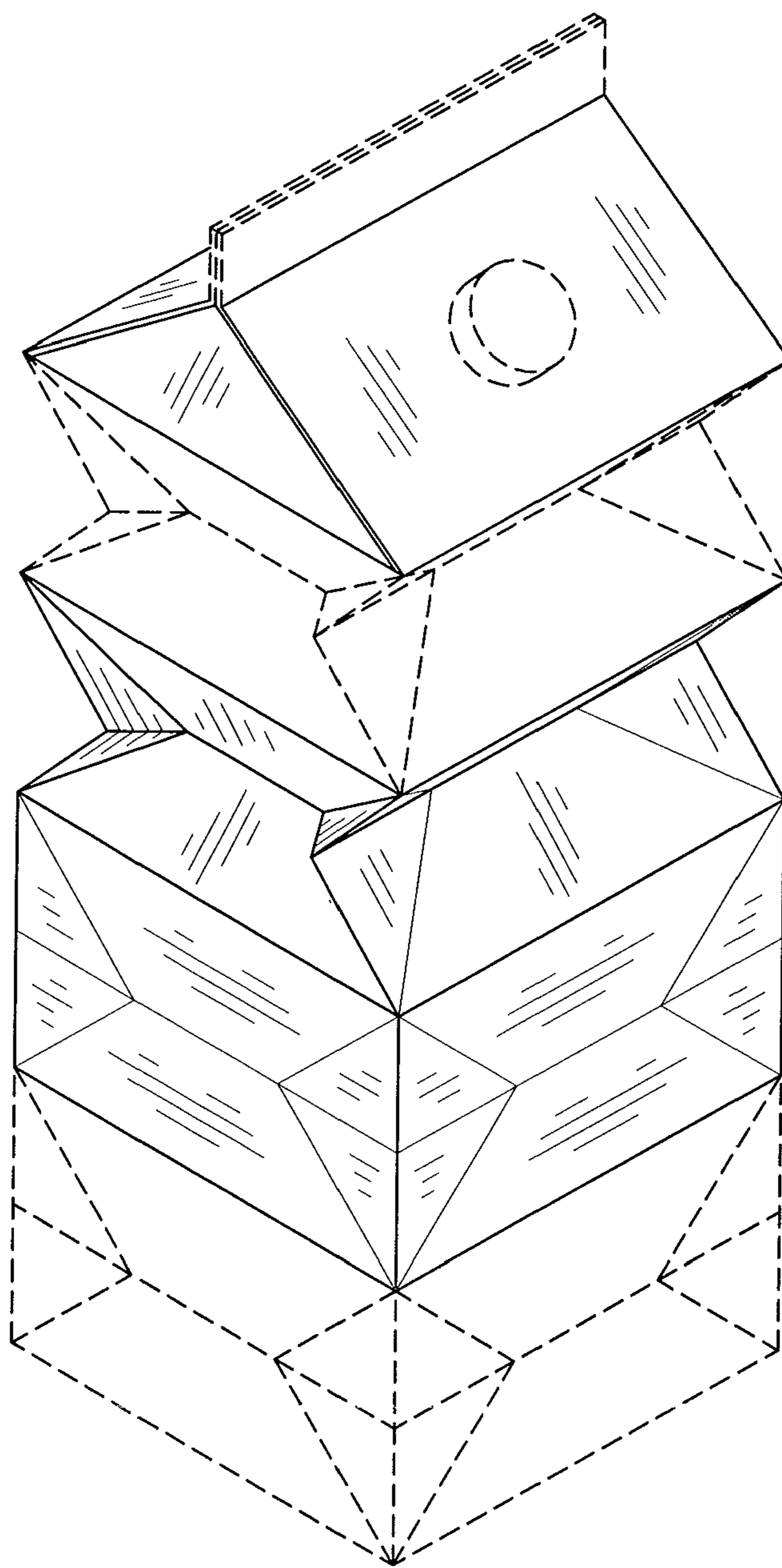

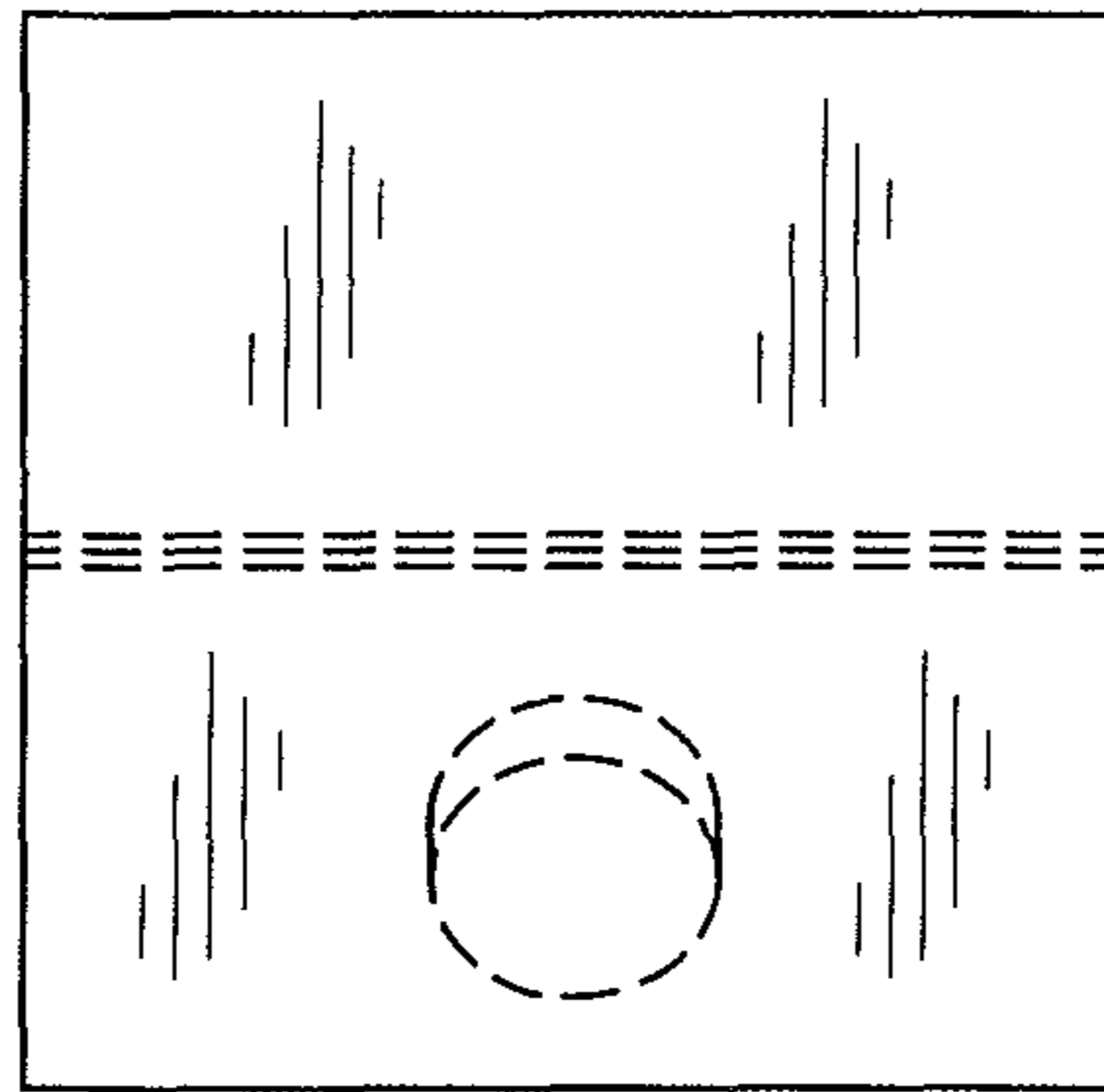

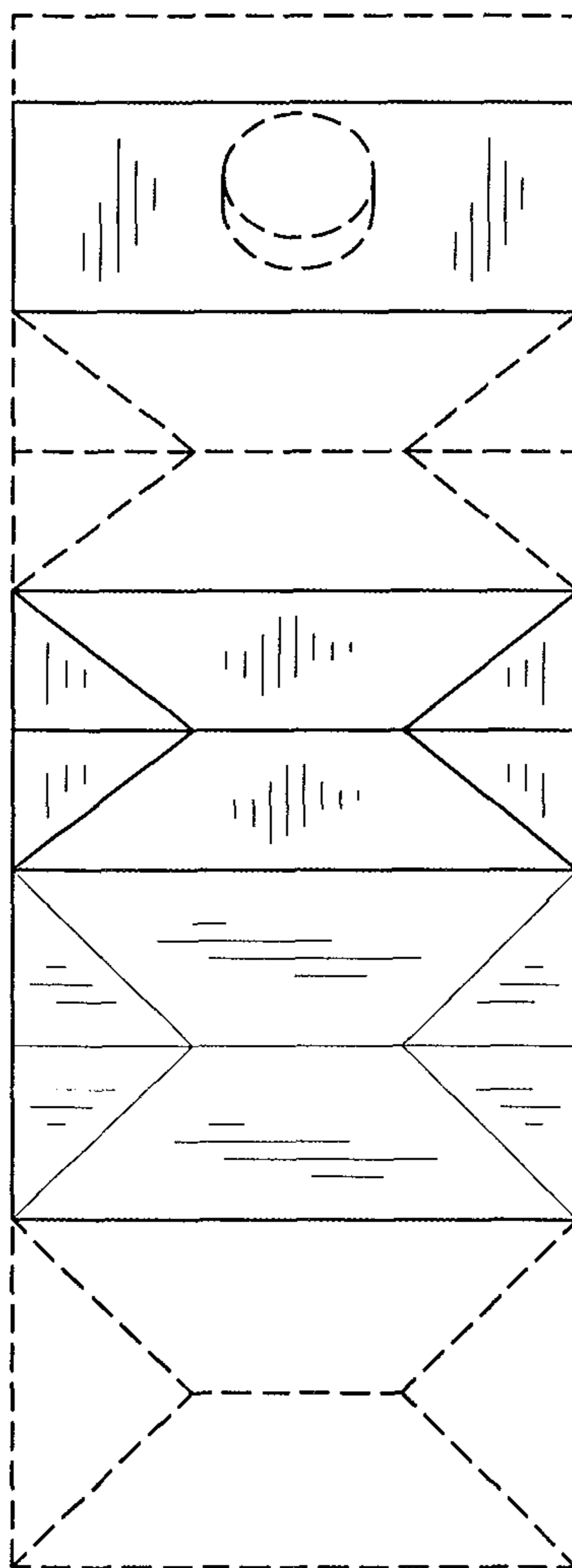

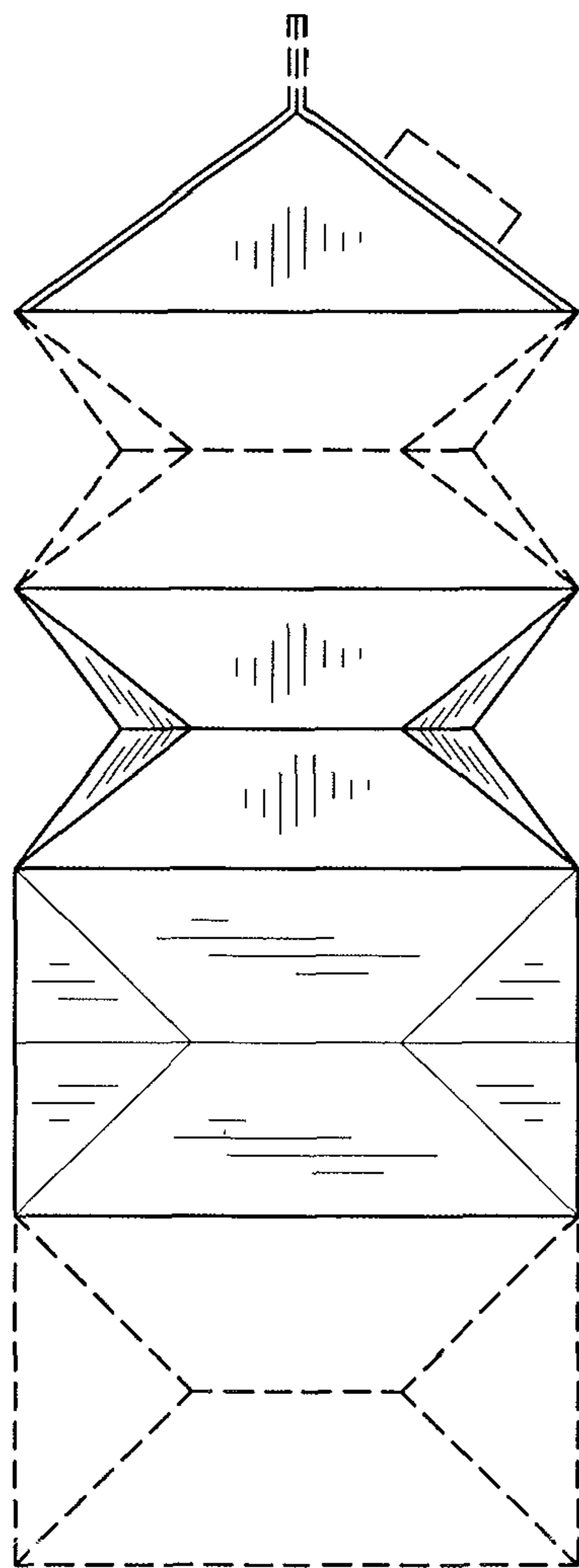

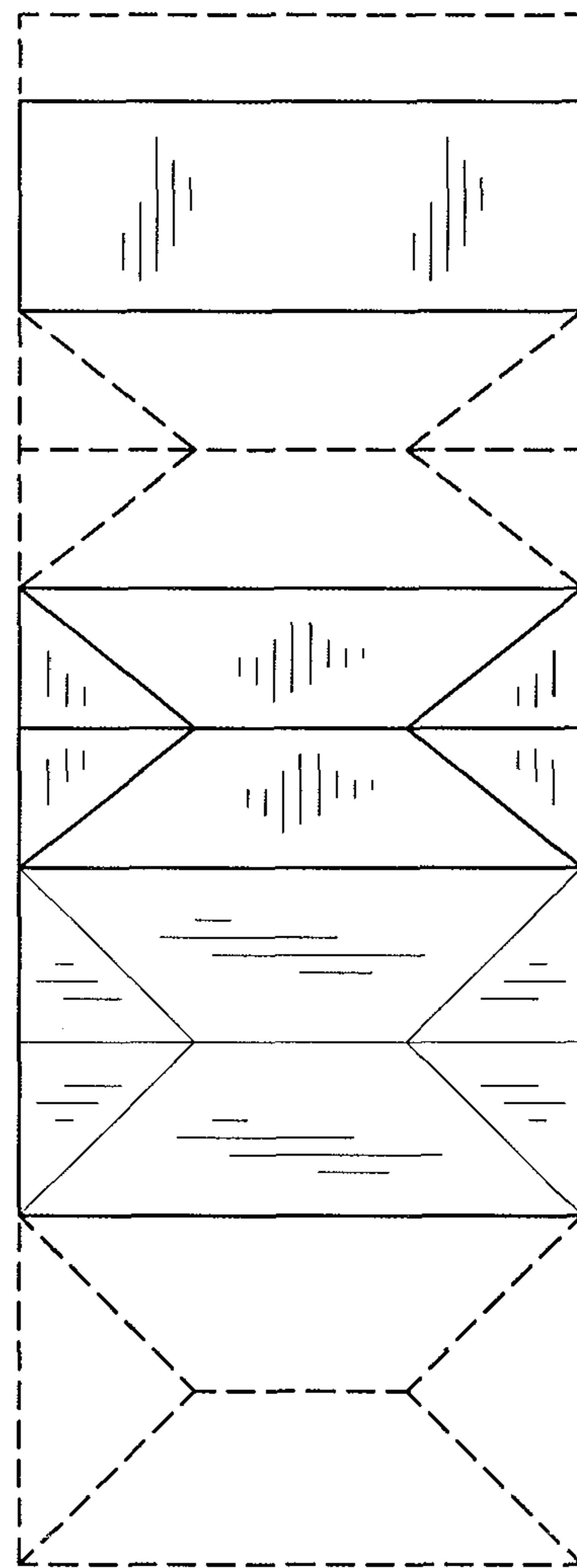
