1 in the assembled condition;

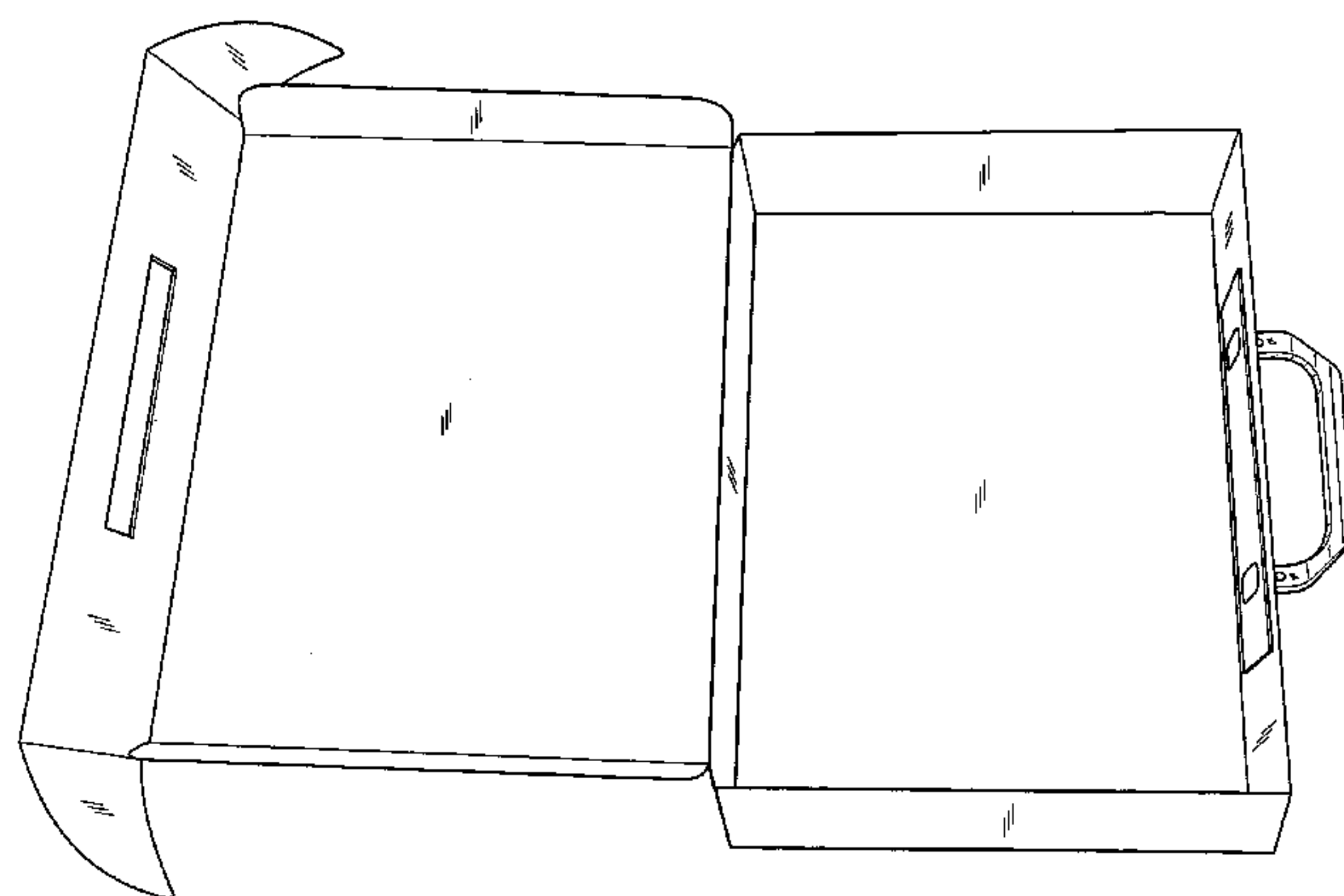
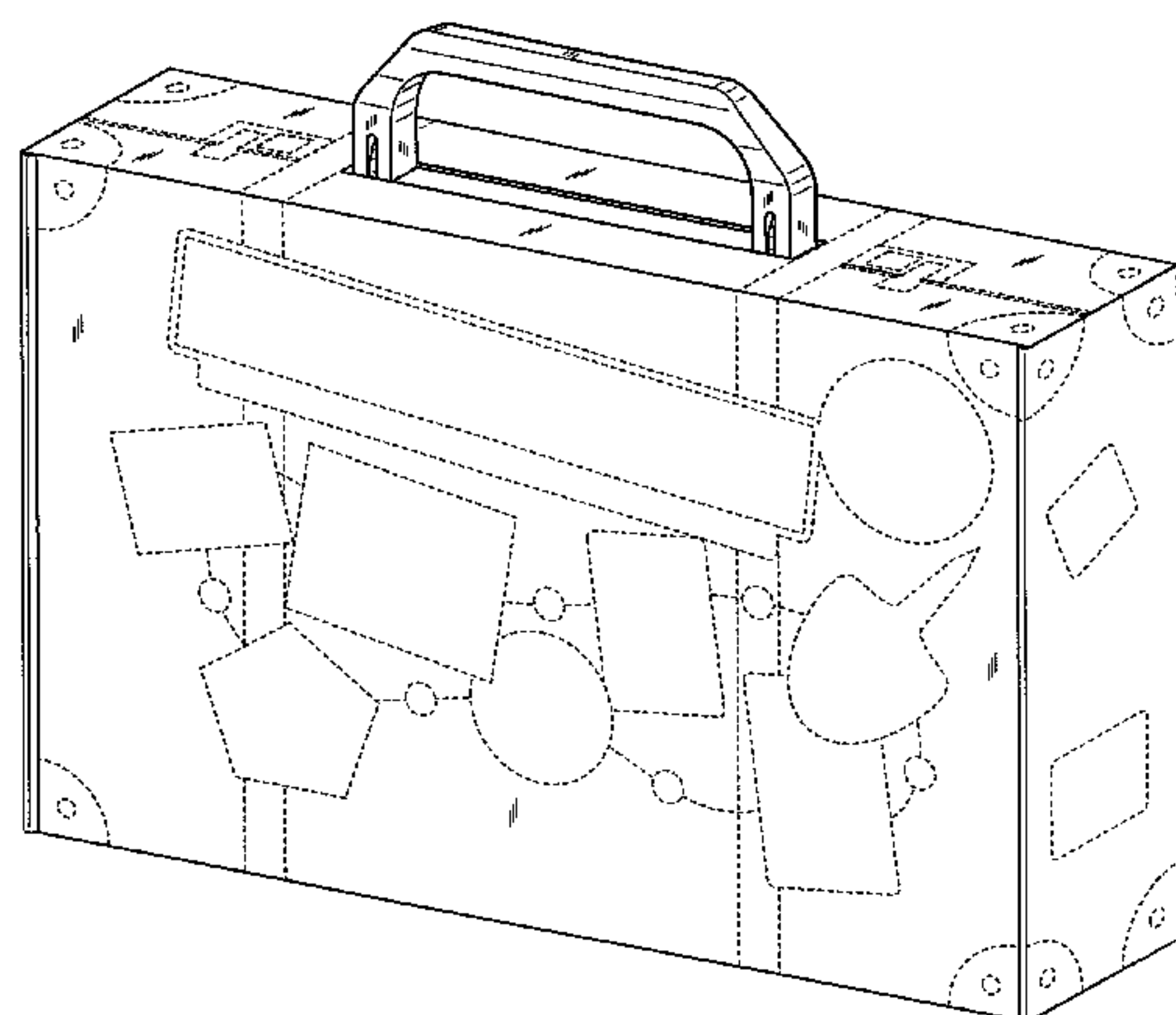
FIG. 7 is a fourth side view of the design of the package of

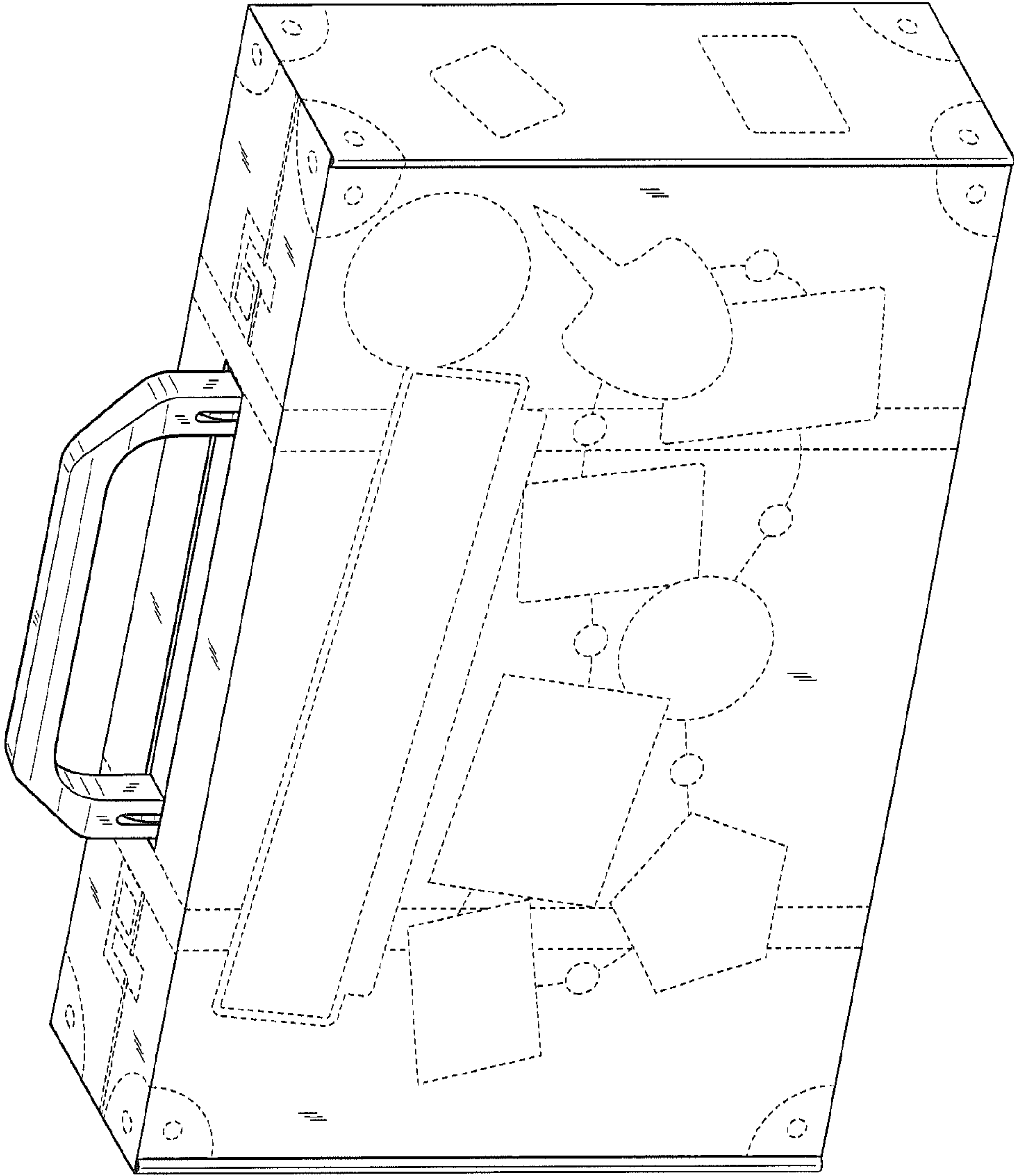

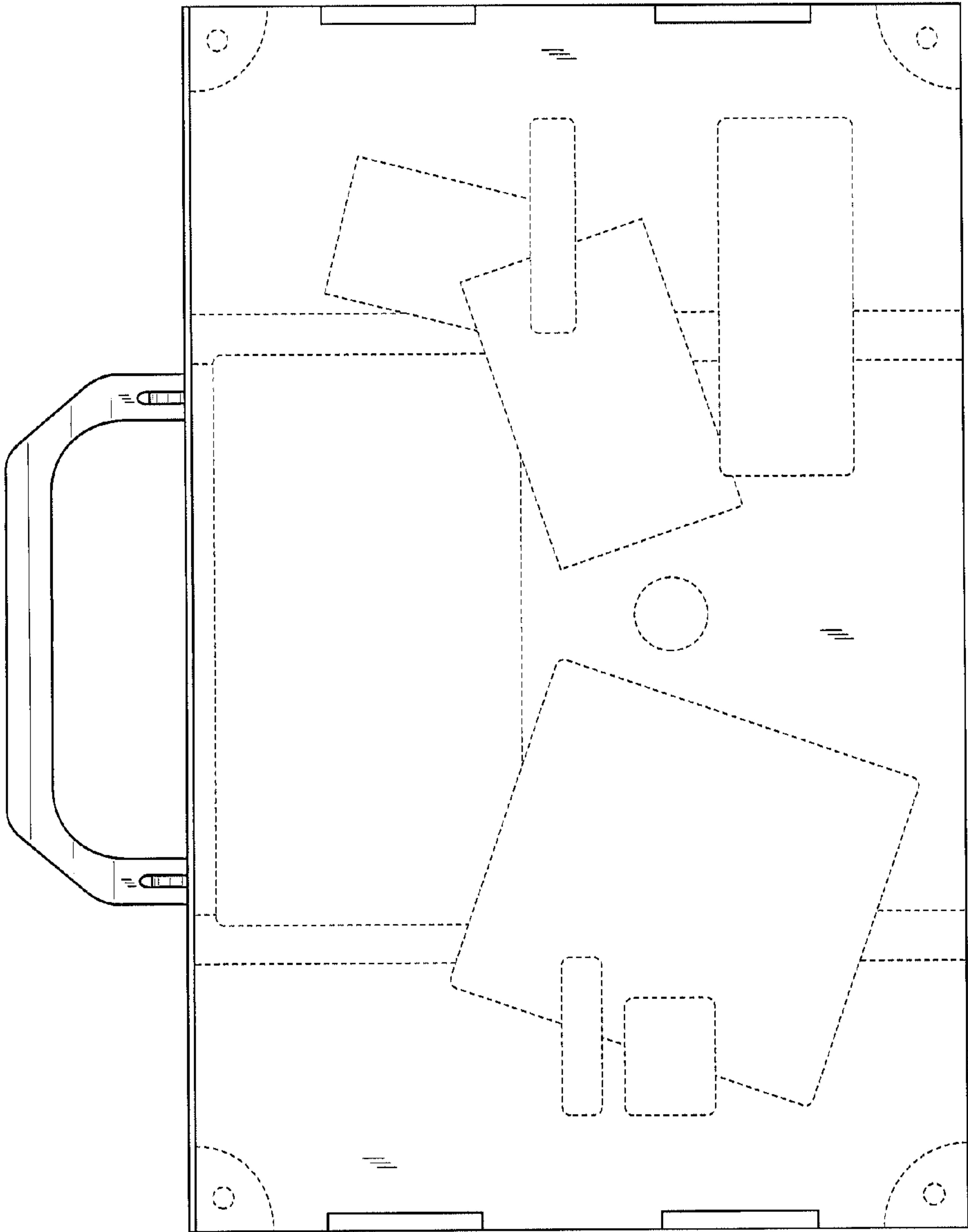

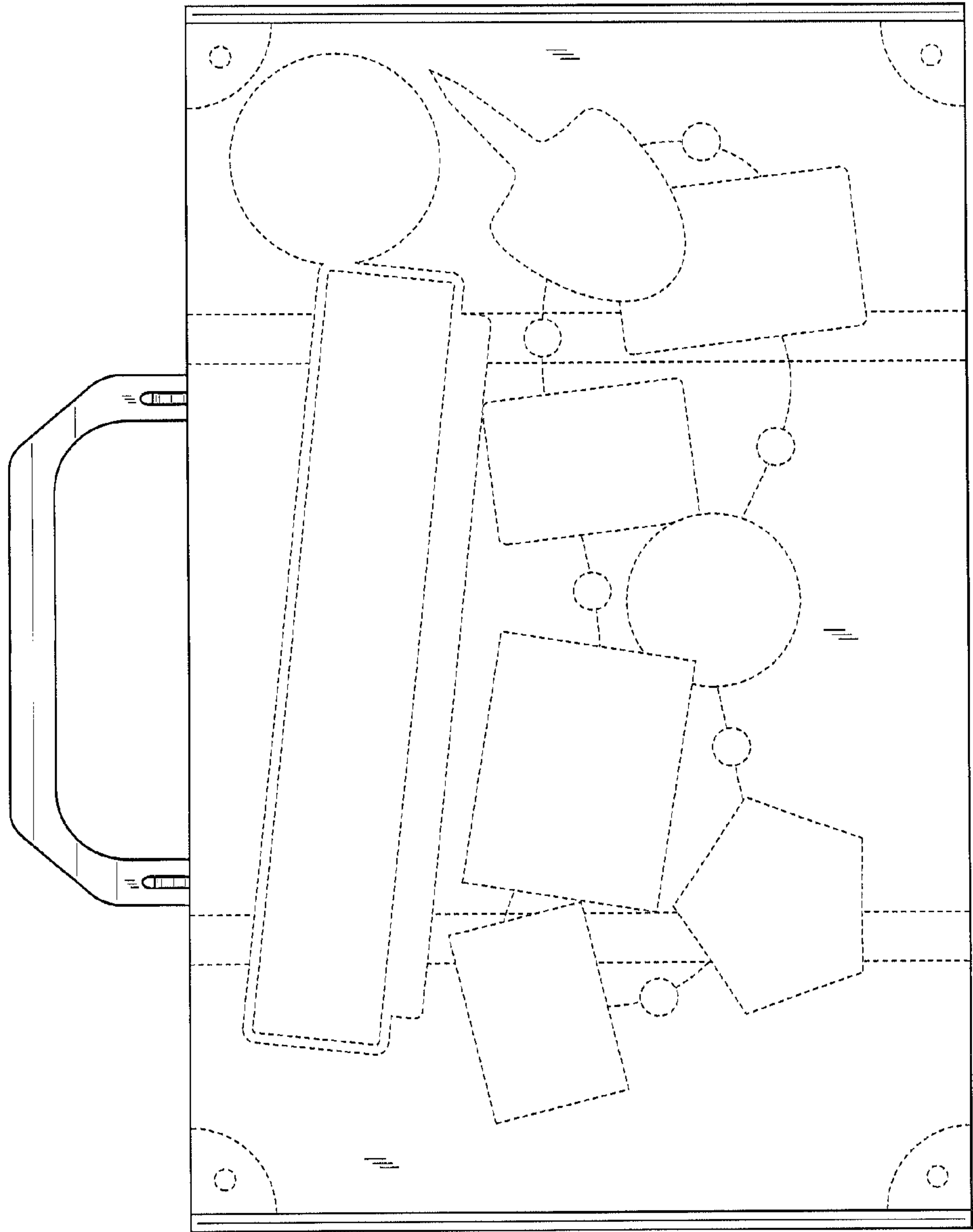

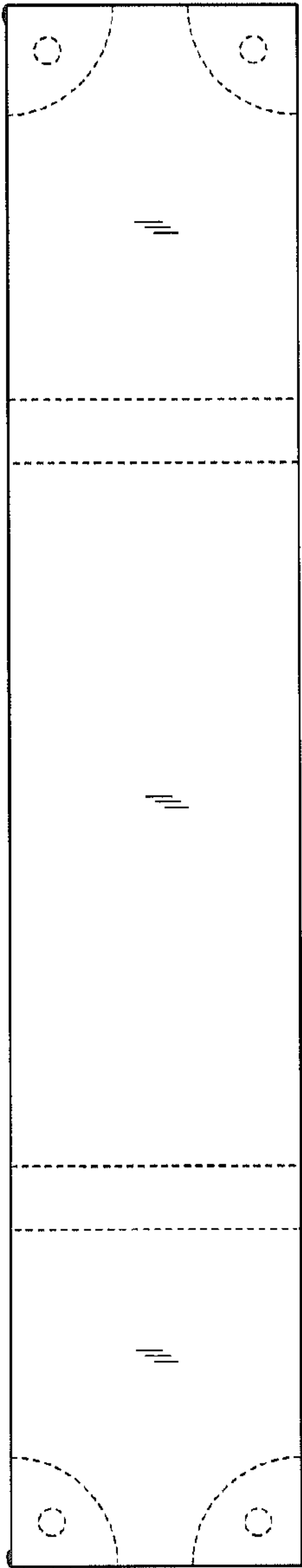

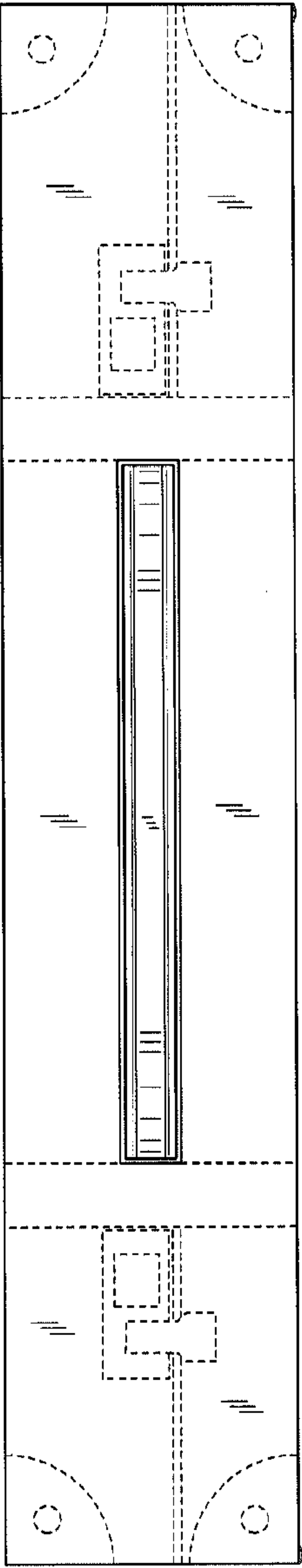

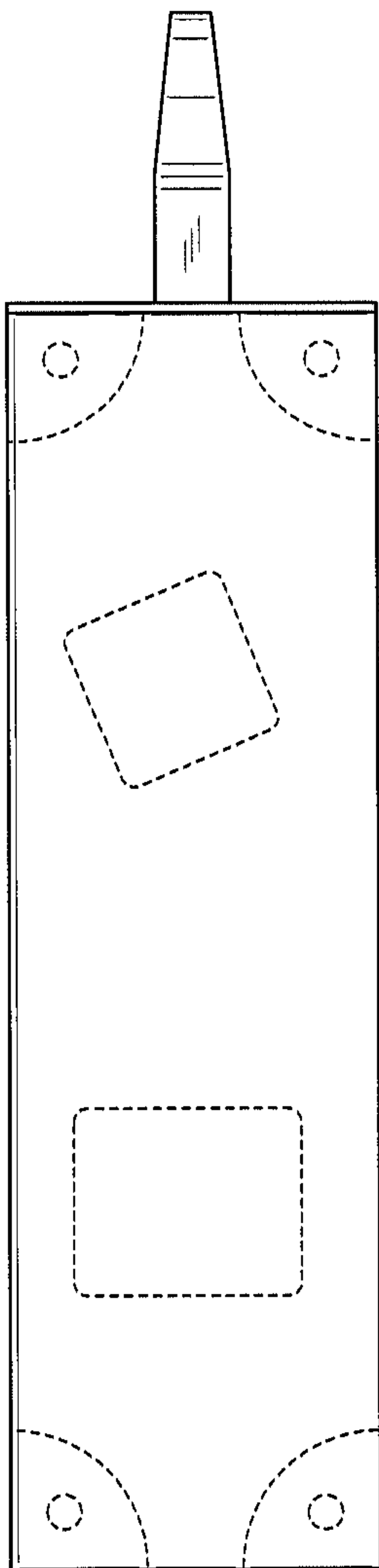

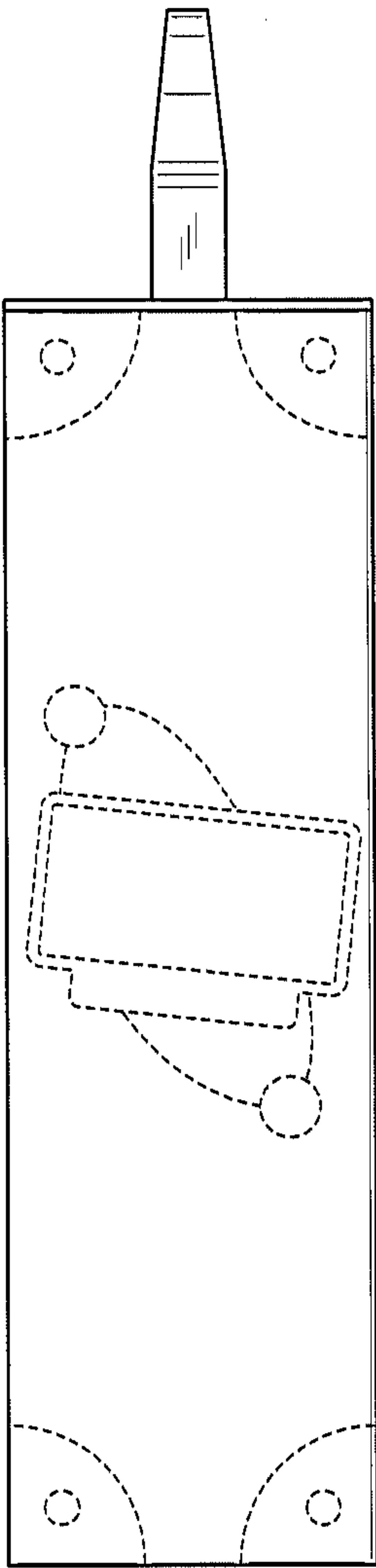

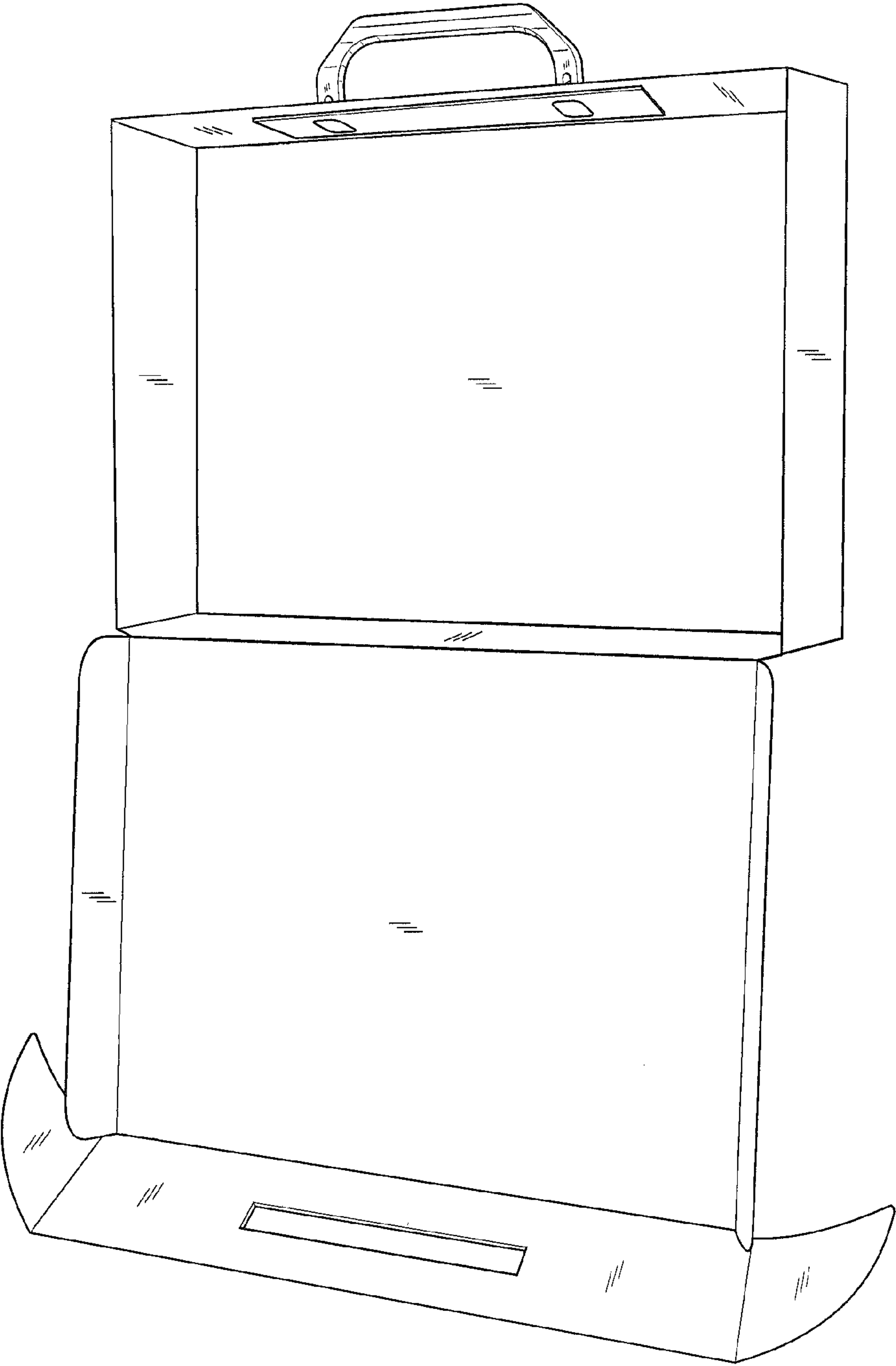

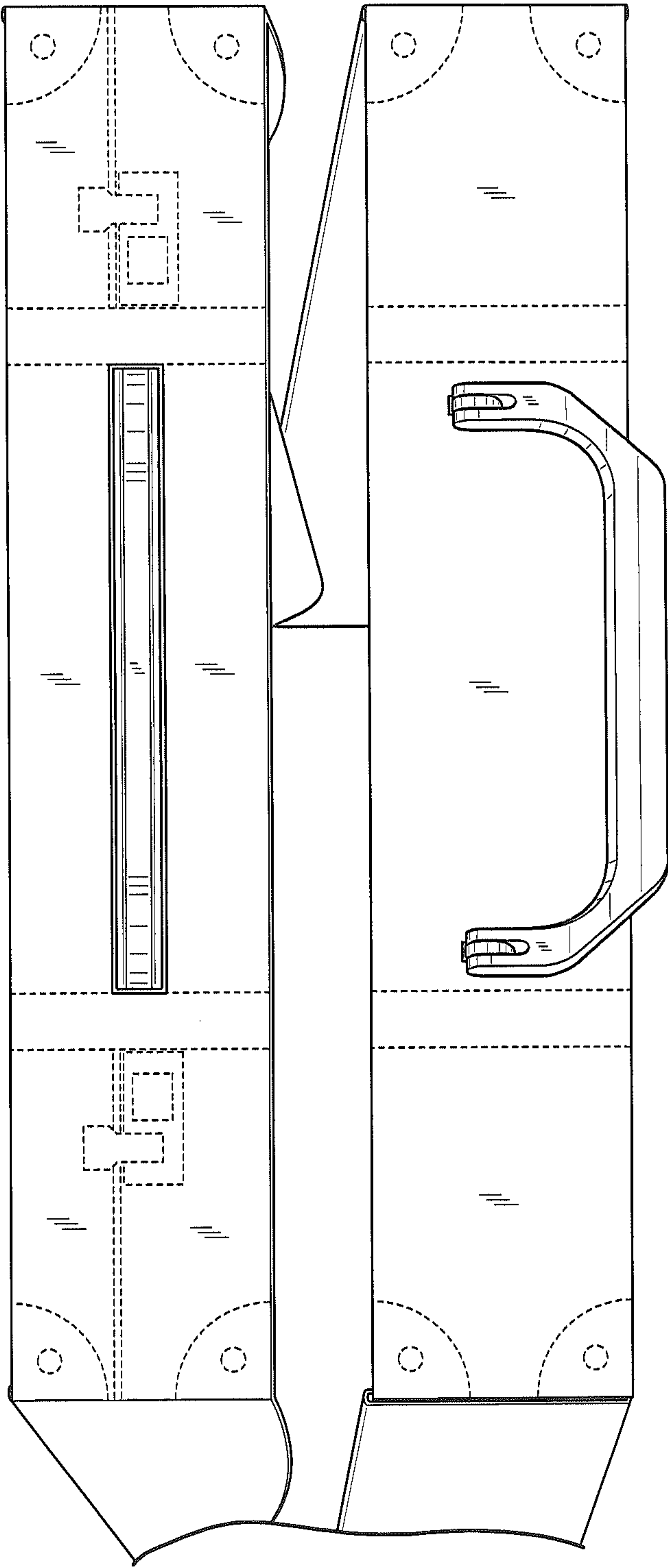
