(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a shoe sole, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front side perspective view of the embodiment of the present invention.

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a front elevation view of FIG. 1.

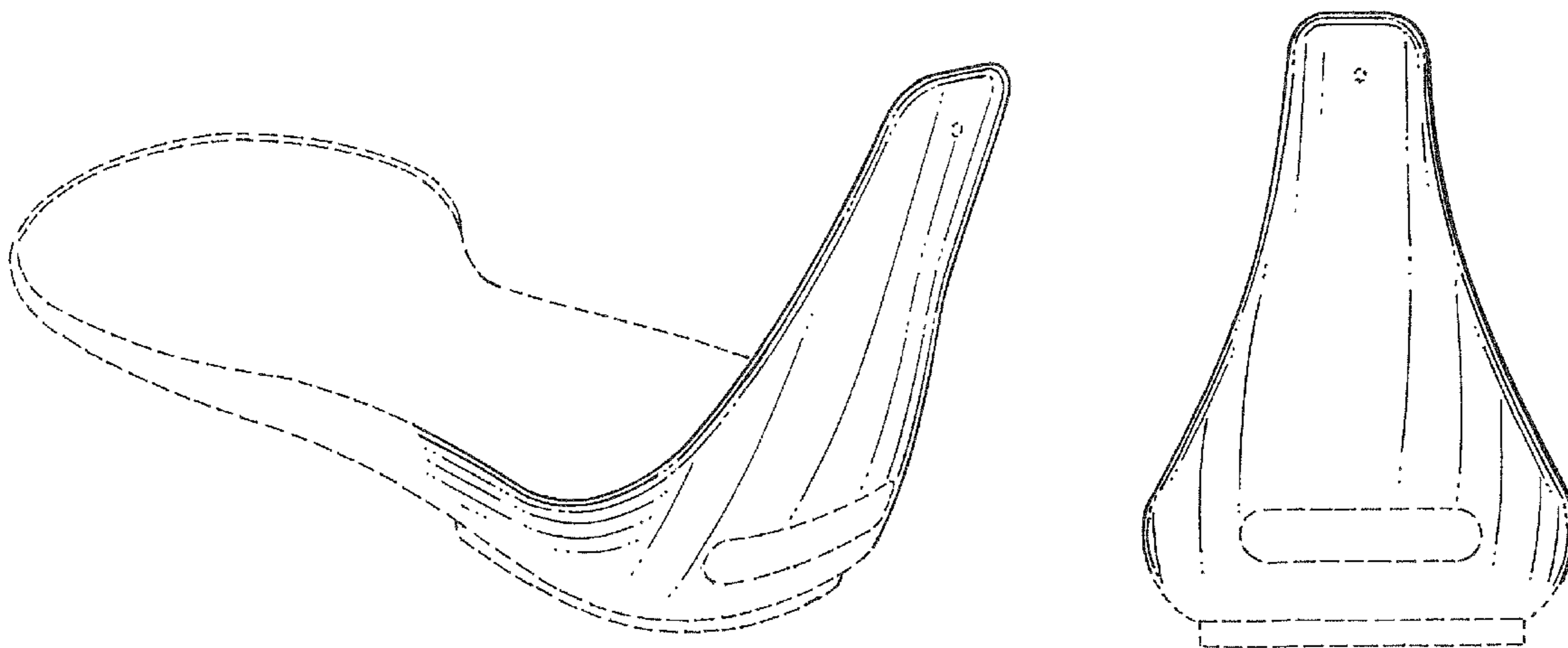
FIG. 4 is a left side elevation view of FIG. 1, the right side being a mirror image.

FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view of FIG. 1, in partial section along Section 5-5 in FIG. 4, to aid the viewer; and,

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 1.

No claim is made to the dashed line regions on the shoe sole, including the tread-region, and heel-region below the display shield region, or the forward portion of the shoe sole, as the dashed lines indicate disclaimed portions forming no part of the claimed design. The boundaries are demarked by the limits of the solid lining and shading shown. No claim is made to the shoe sole portions other than in claimed-lining and shaded surfaces in any of the figures, and this is shown as an environmental illustration only to aid the public.

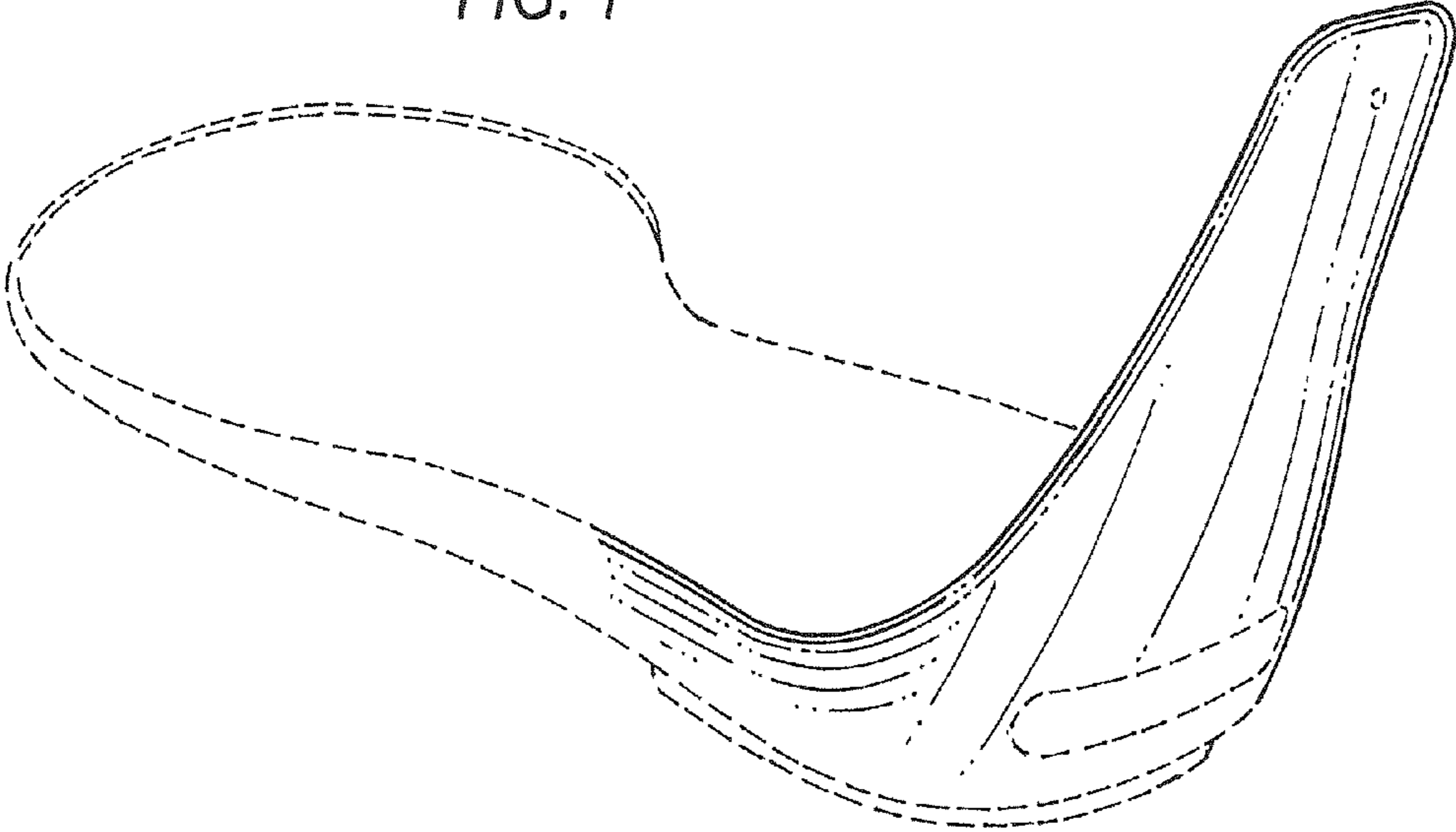

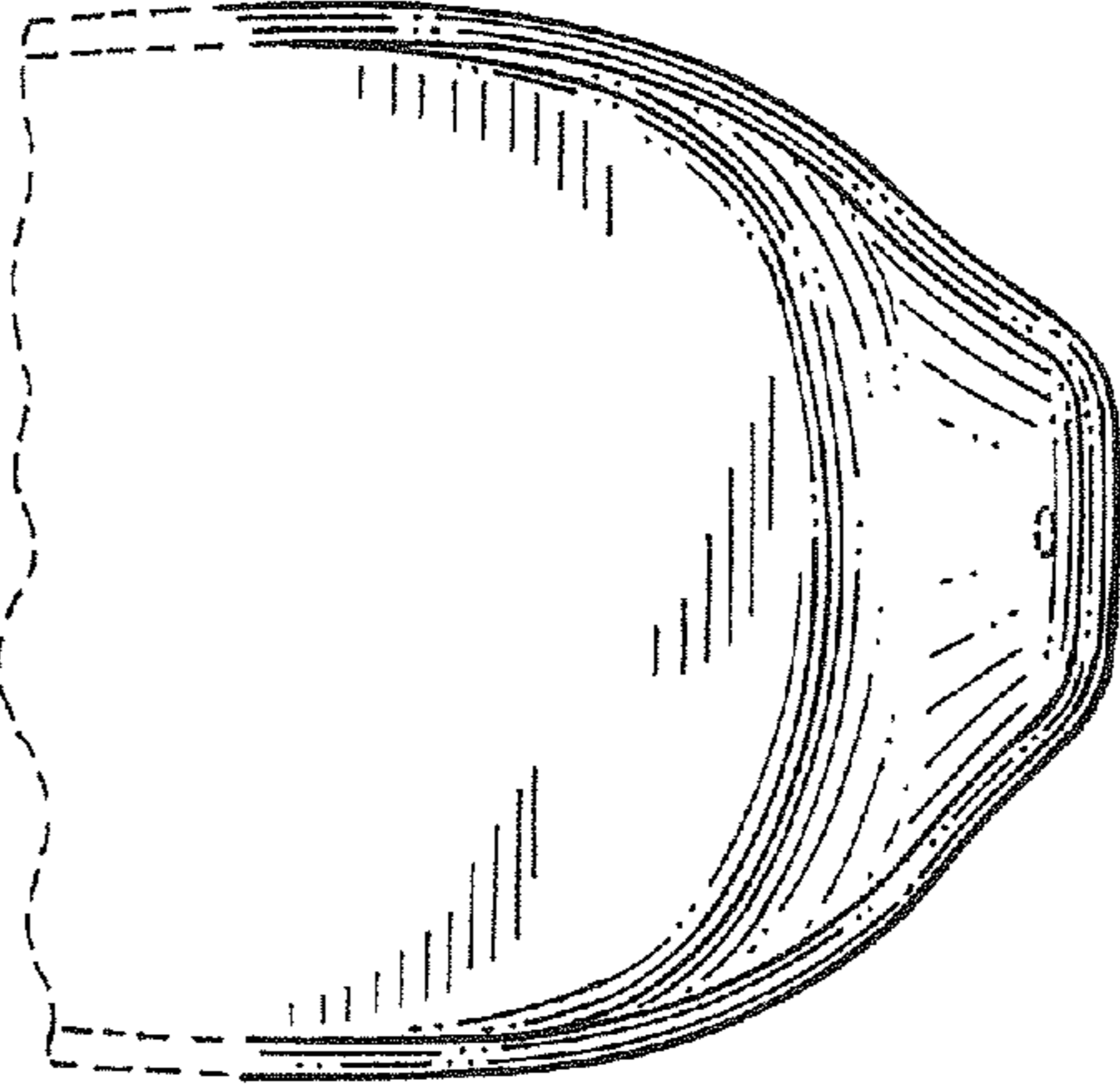

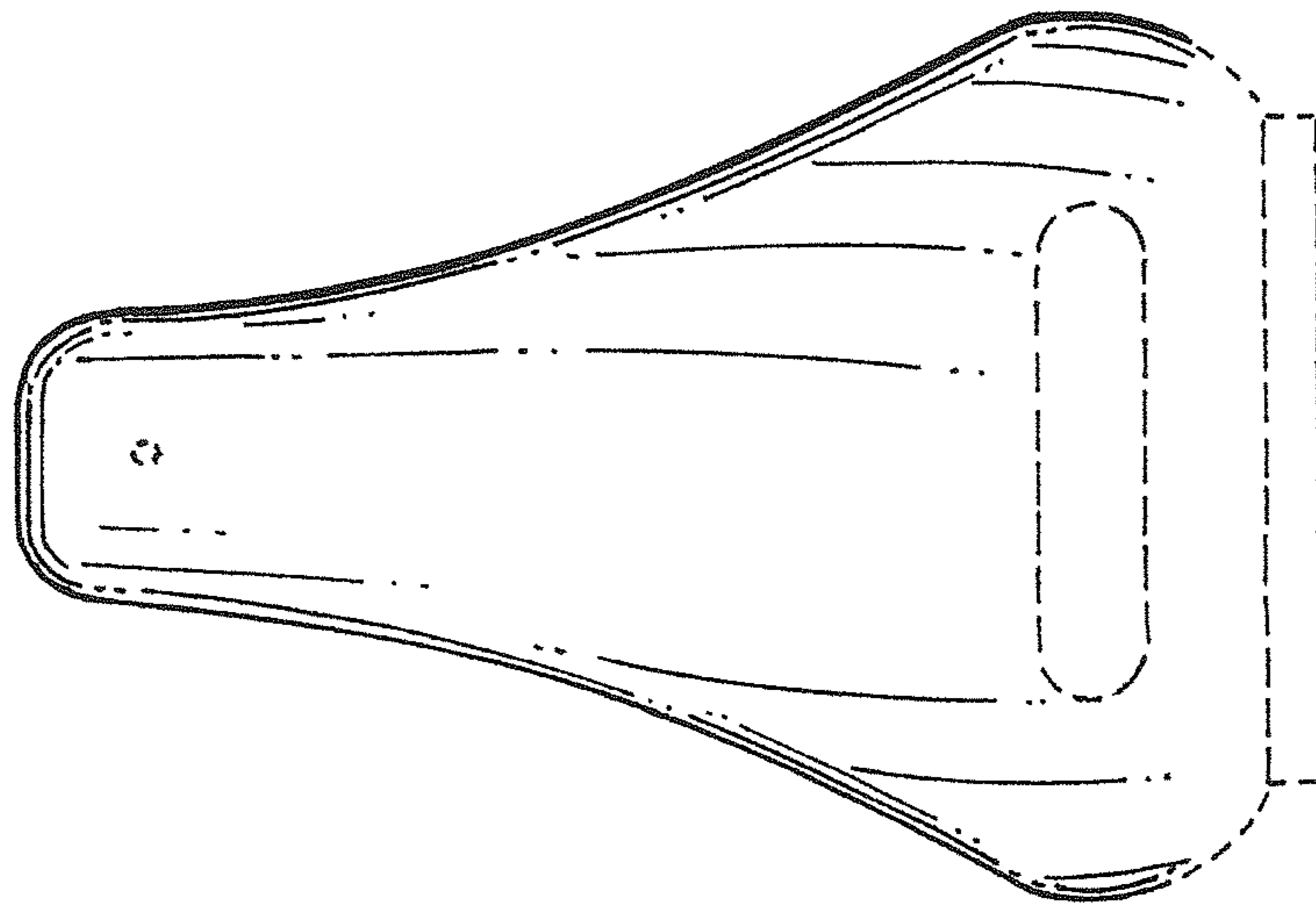

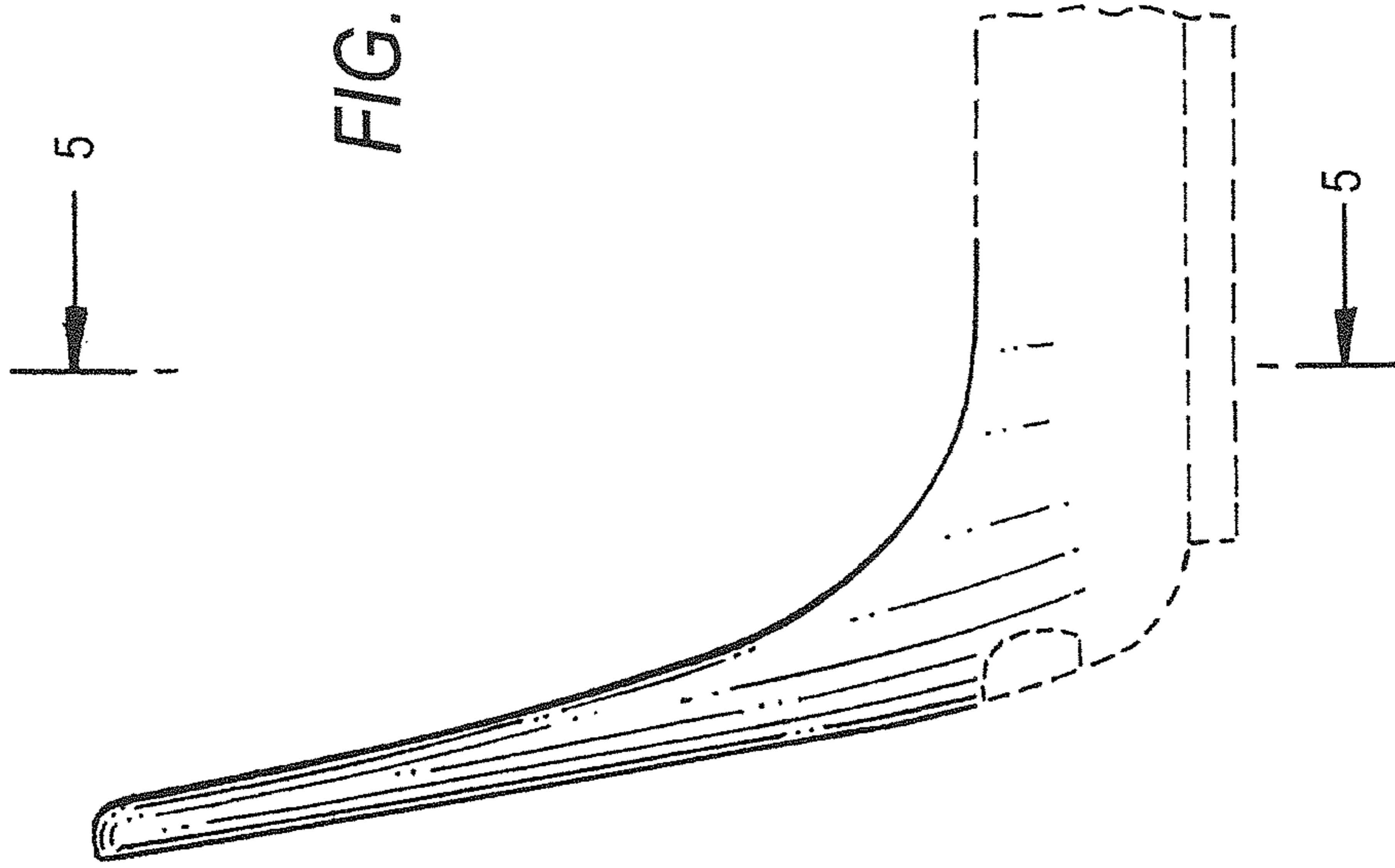

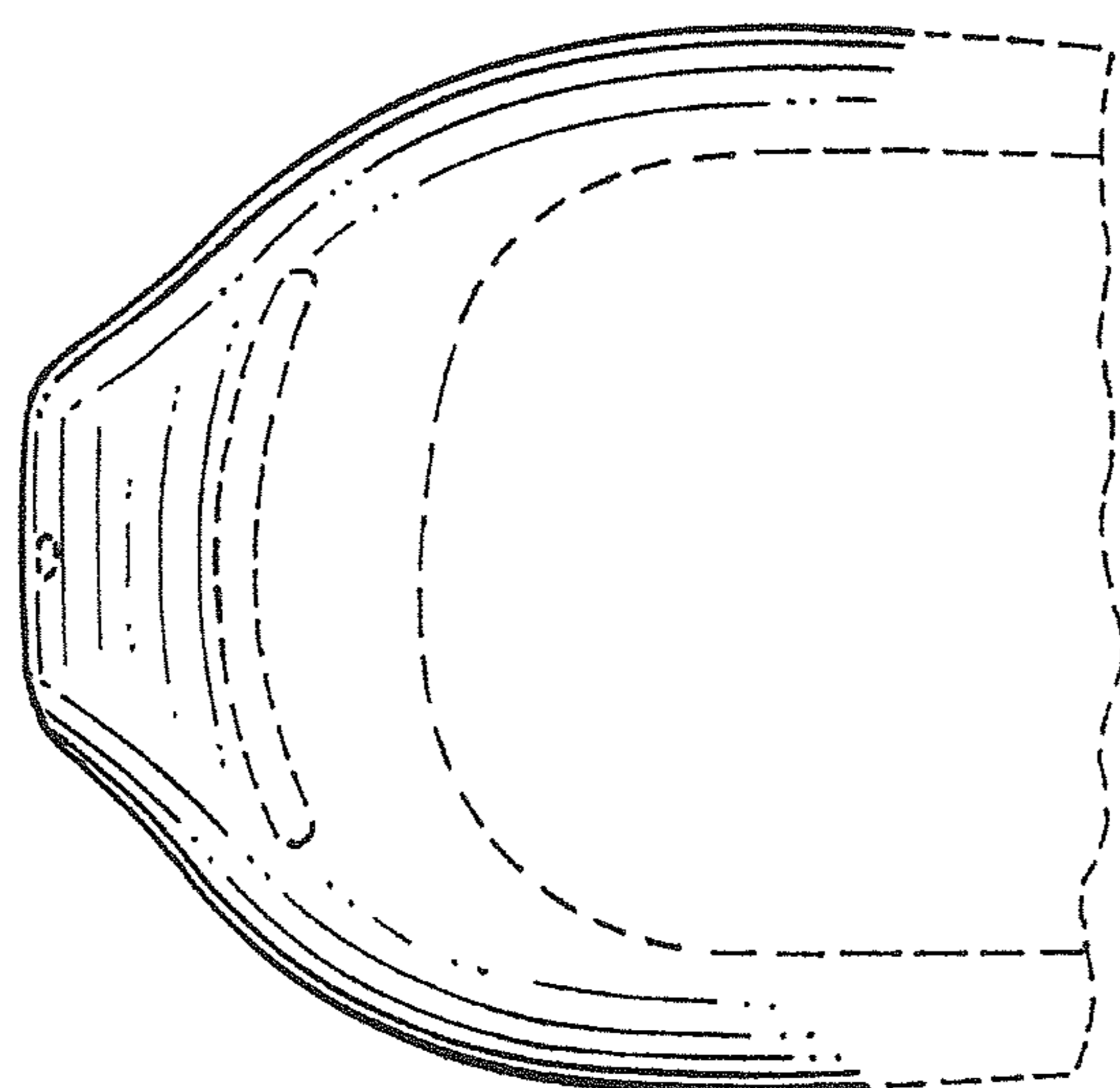
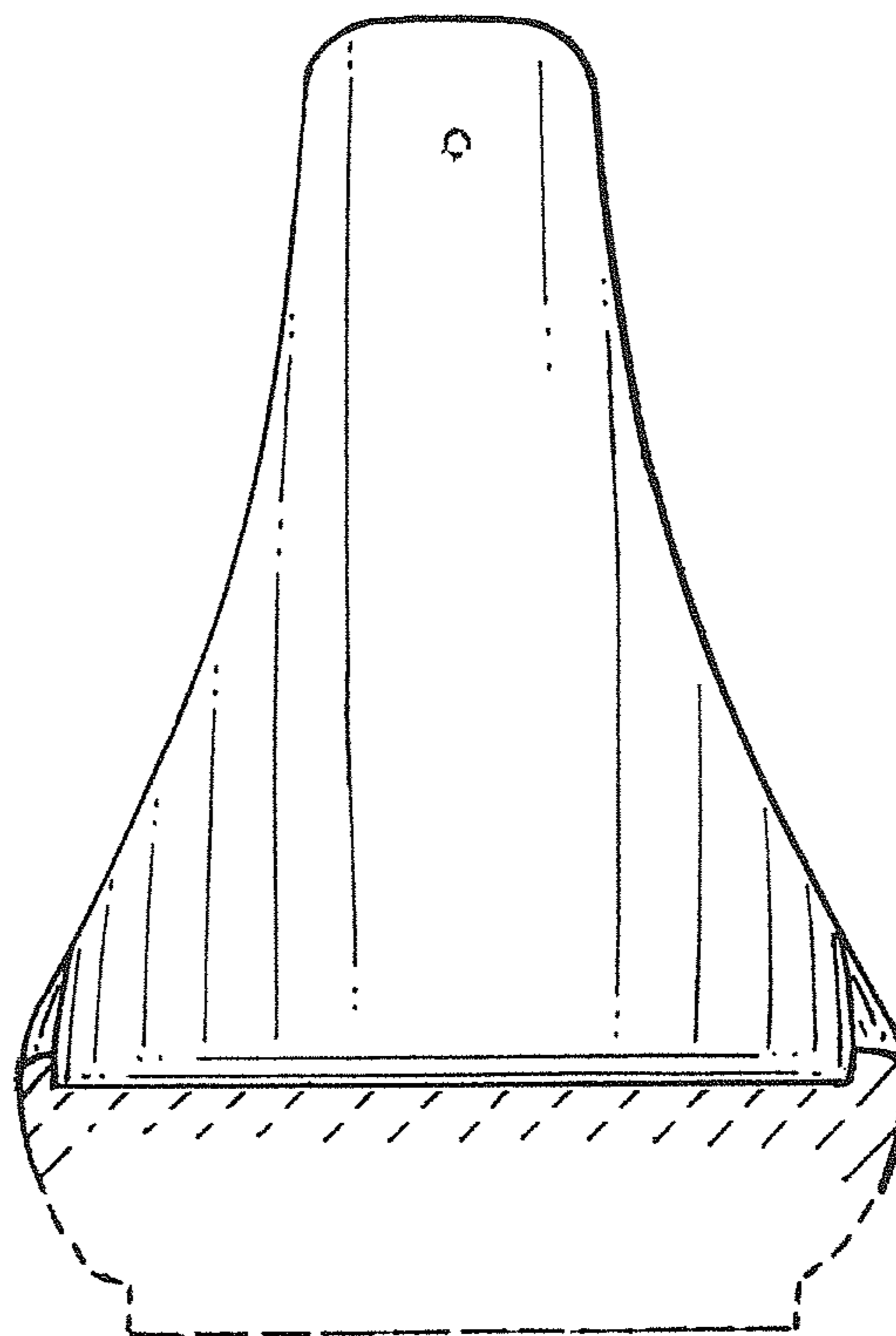
