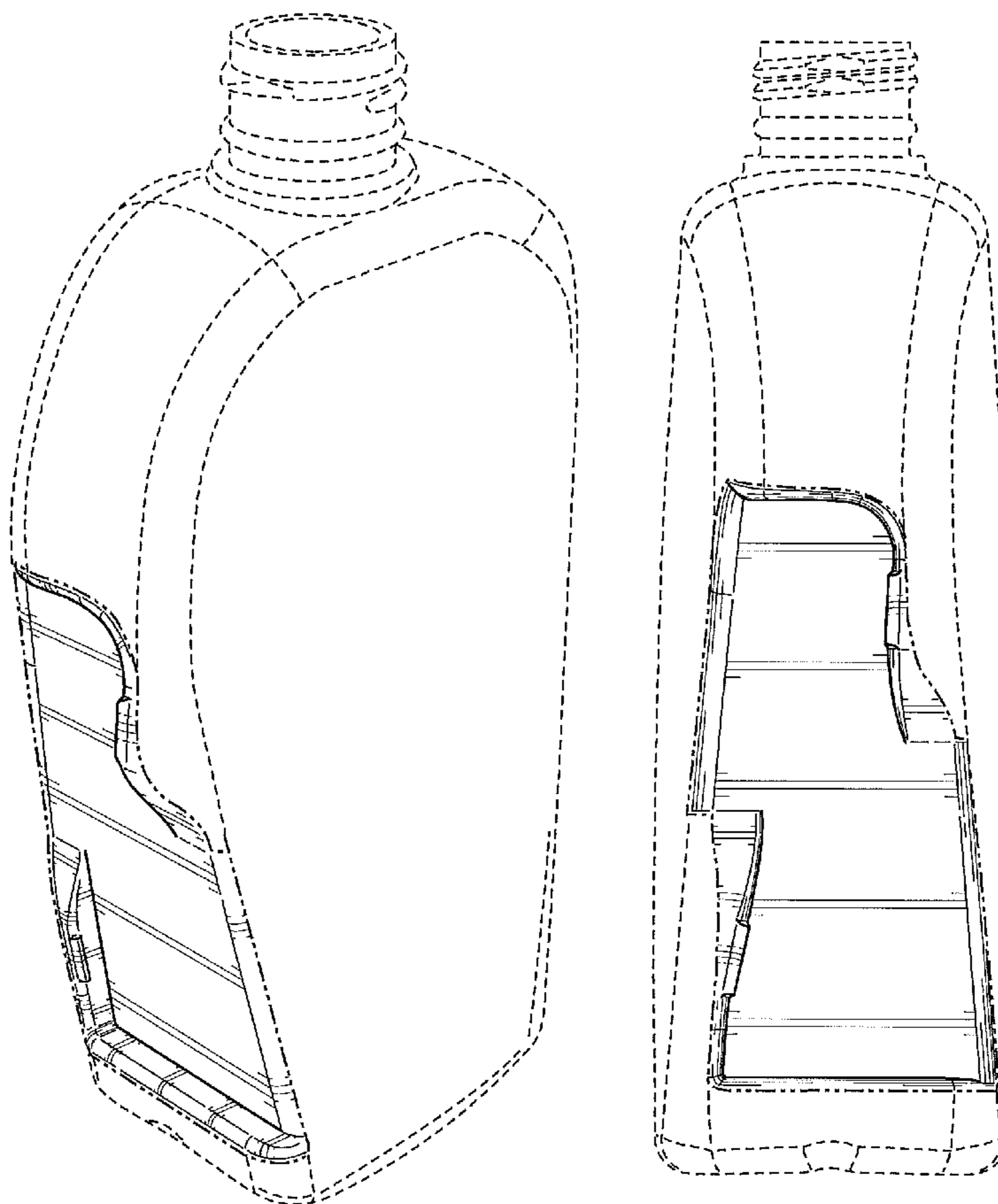
(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a bottle, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a bottle showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;

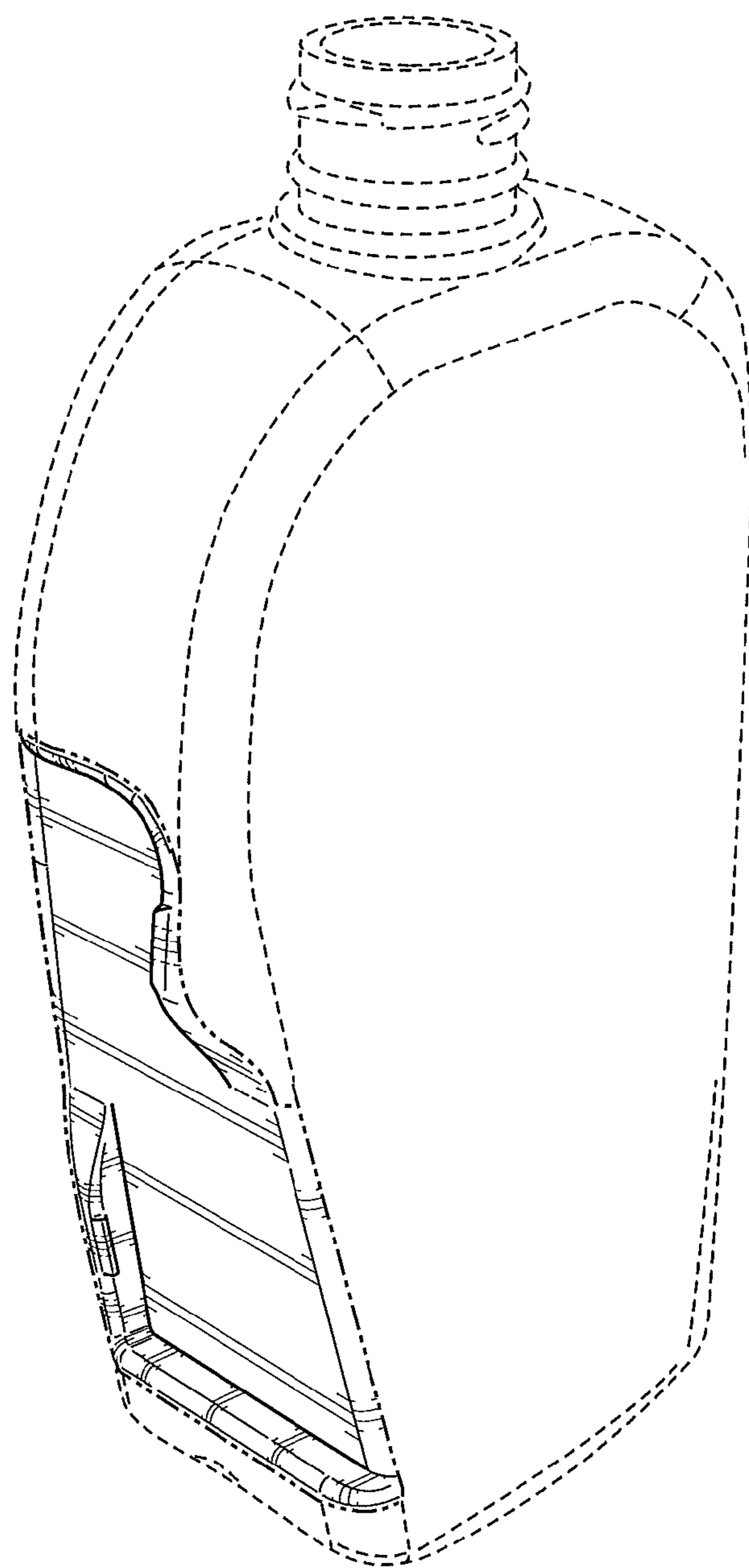

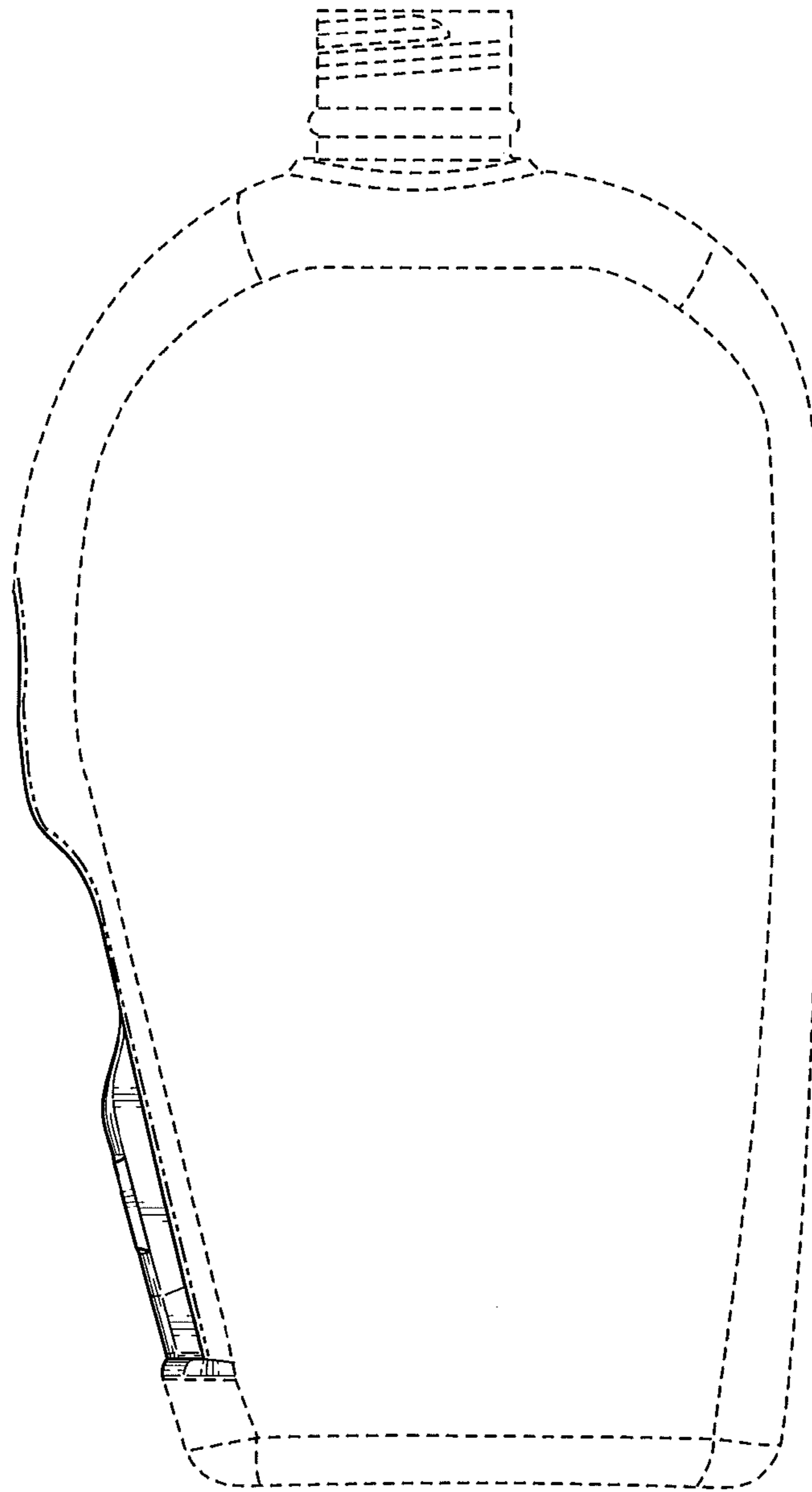

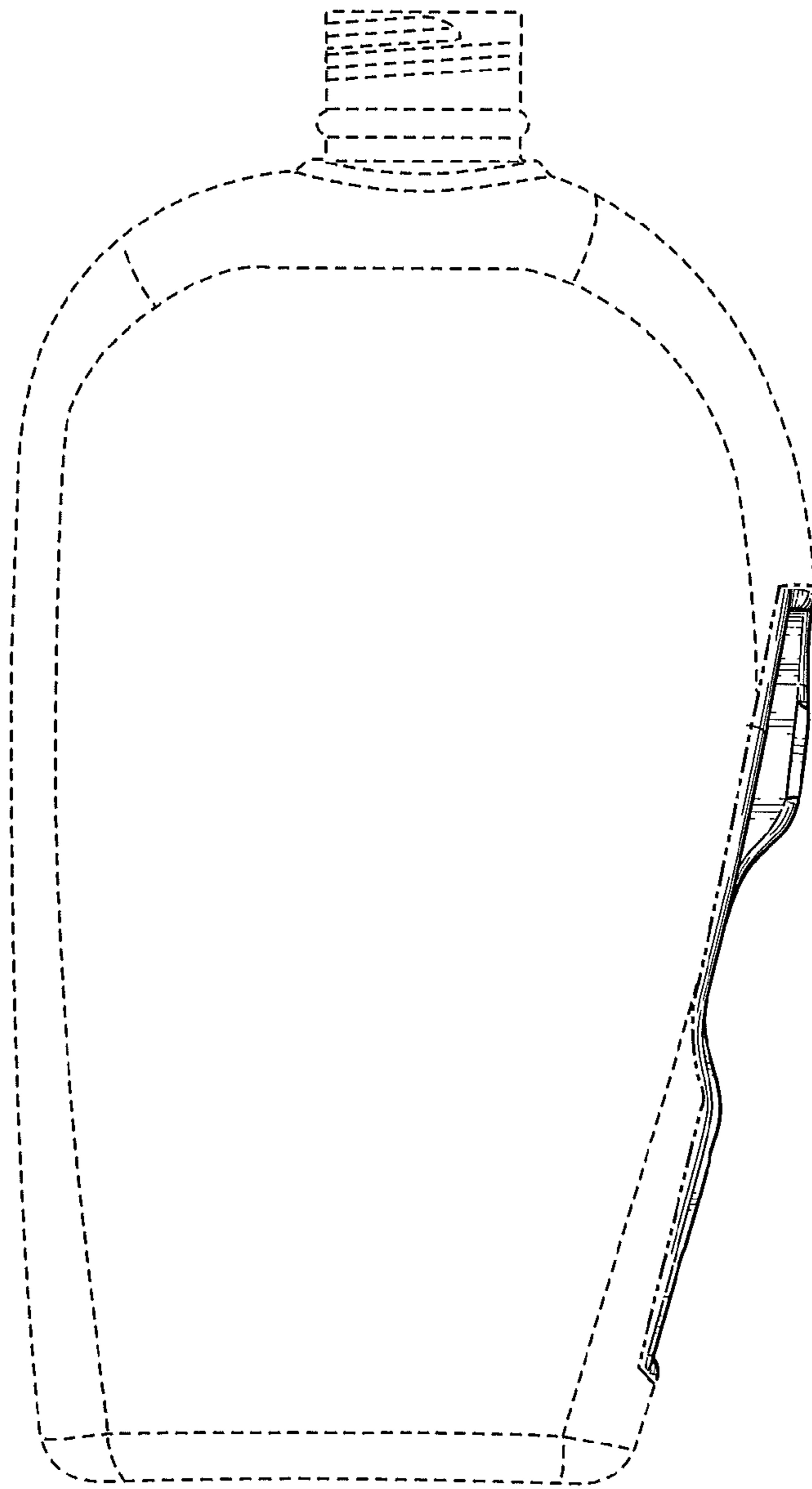

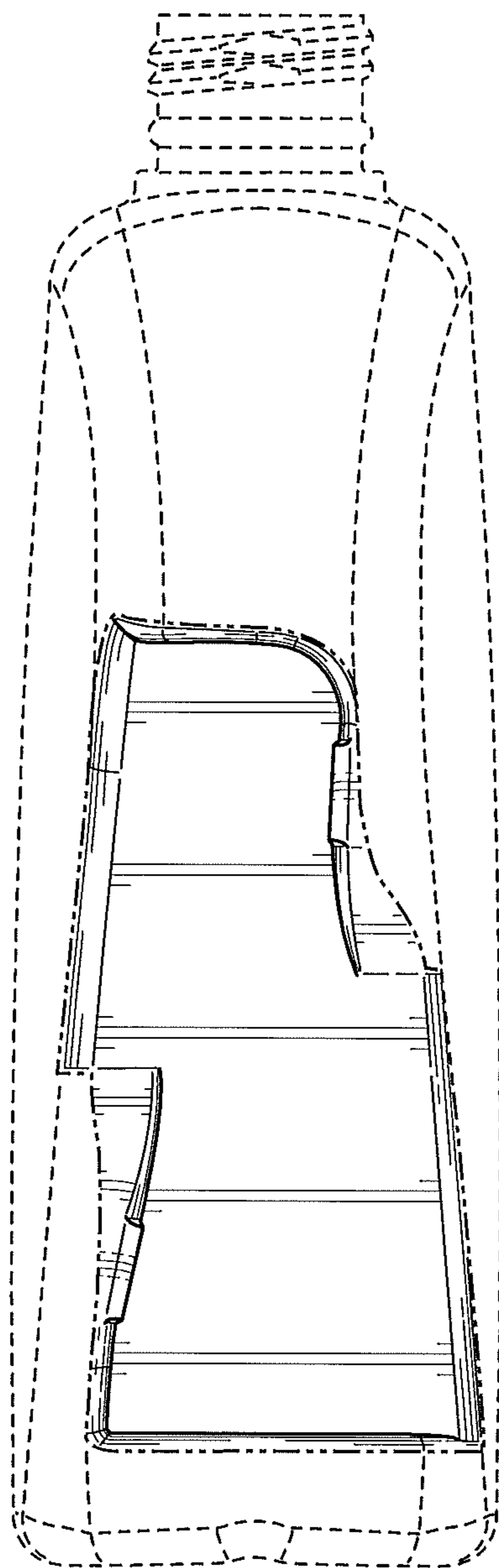

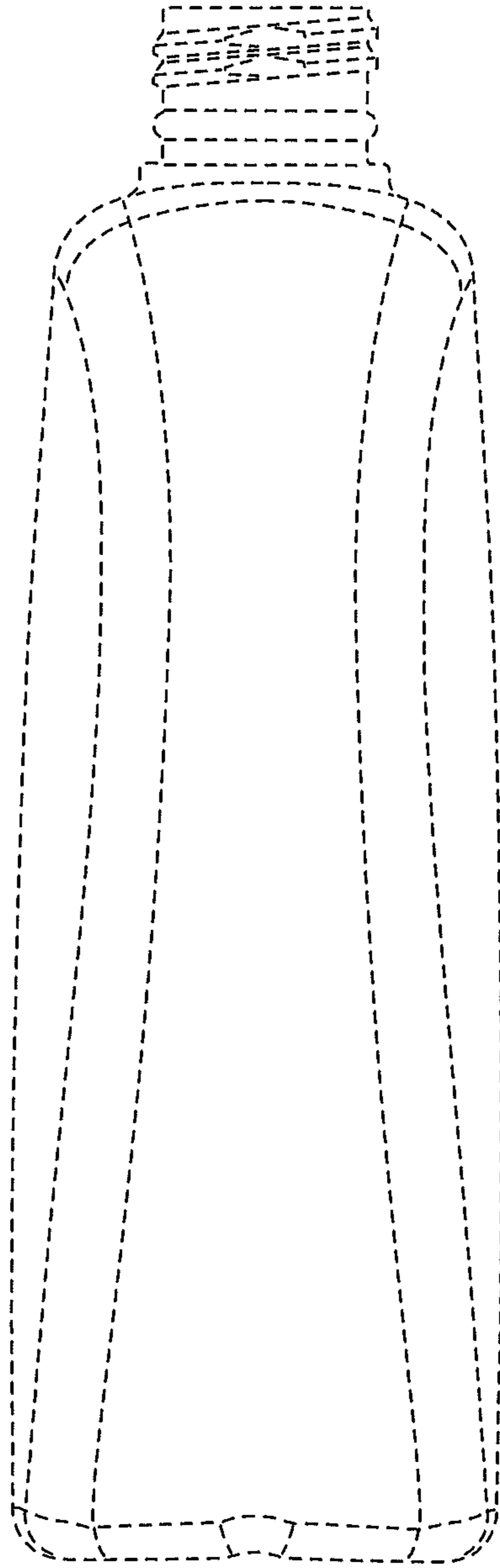

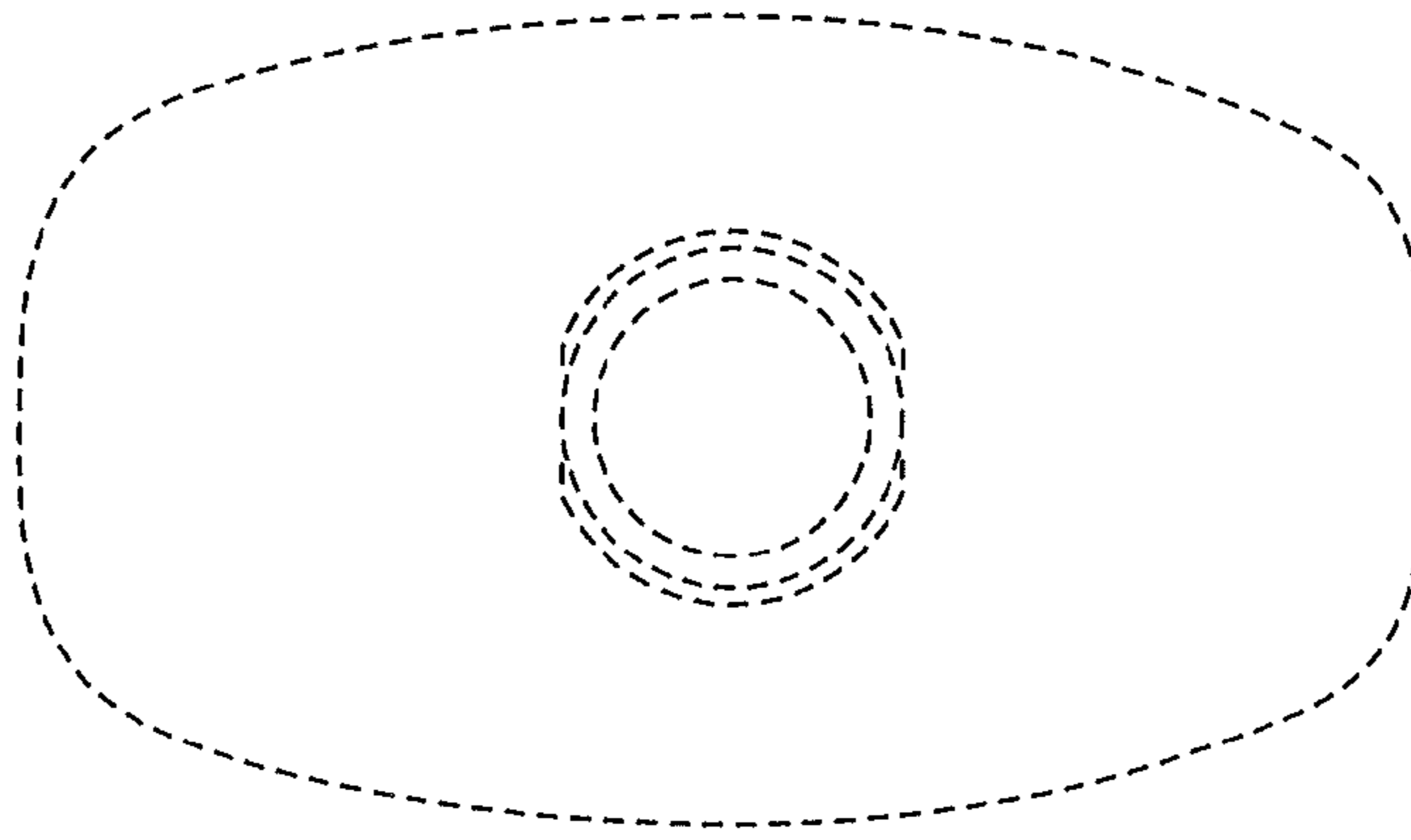

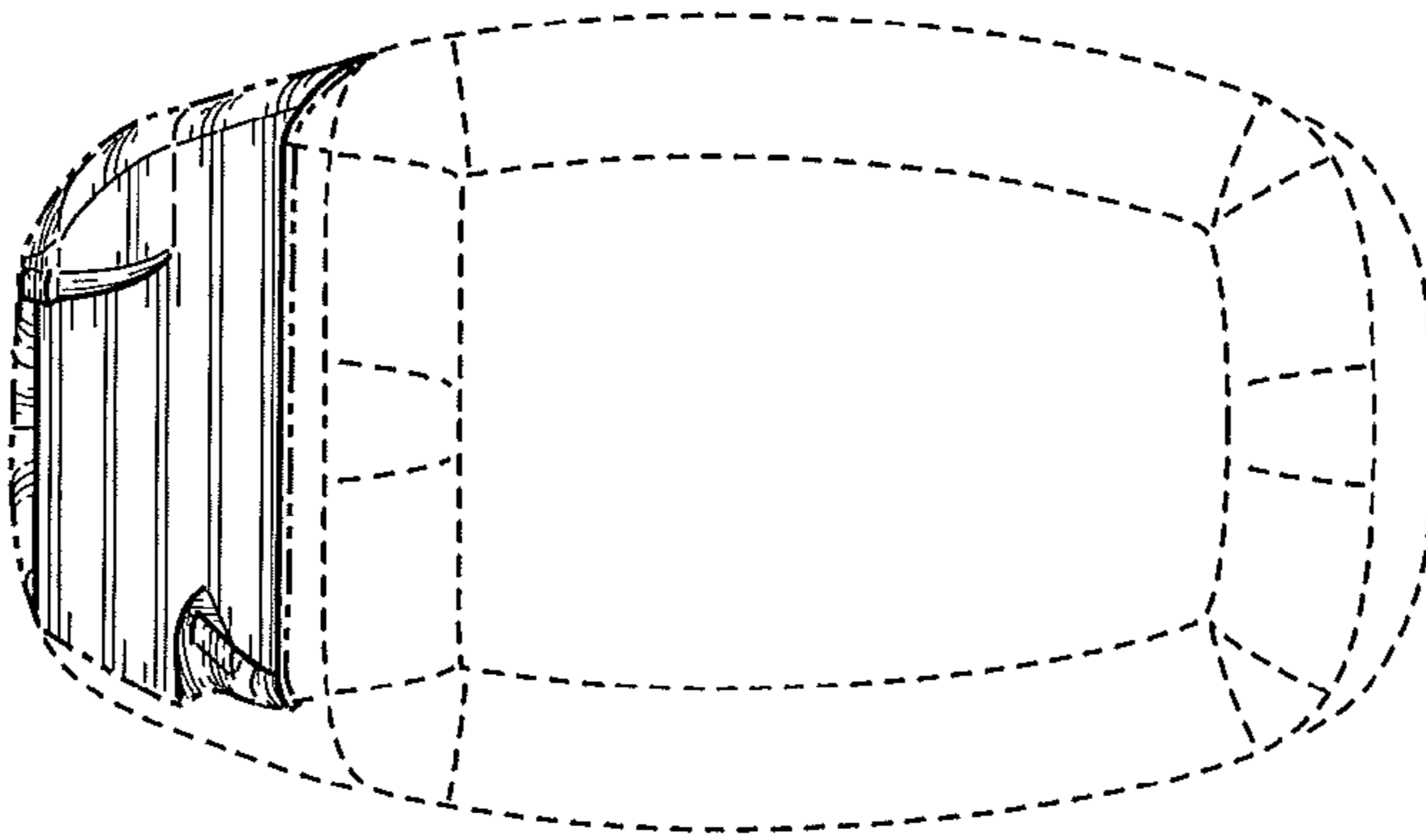
