The ornamental design for a pen, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an upper front left perspective view of a pen showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 6 is an enlarged top plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is an enlarged bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 8 is an upper front left perspective view of another embodiment of the pen shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 9 is a right side elevation view thereof, with the left side elevation view being a mirror image of the right side elevation view;

FIG. 10 is a front elevation view thereof;

FIG. 11 is a rear elevation view thereof;

FIG. 12 is an enlarged top plan view thereof;

FIG. 13 is an enlarged bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 14 is a lower front right perspective view of the pen cap shown separate from the pen in FIG. 1 for convenience of illustration;

FIG. 15 is a right side elevation view thereof, with the left side elevation view being a mirror image of the right side elevation view;

FIG. 16 is a front elevation view thereof;

FIG. 17 is a rear elevation view thereof;

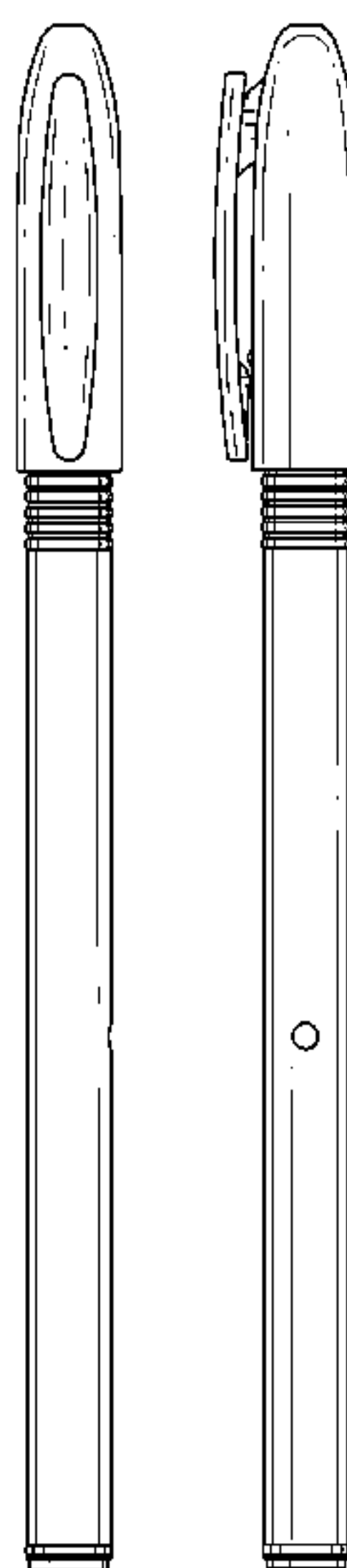
FIG. 18 is an enlarged top plan view thereof; and,

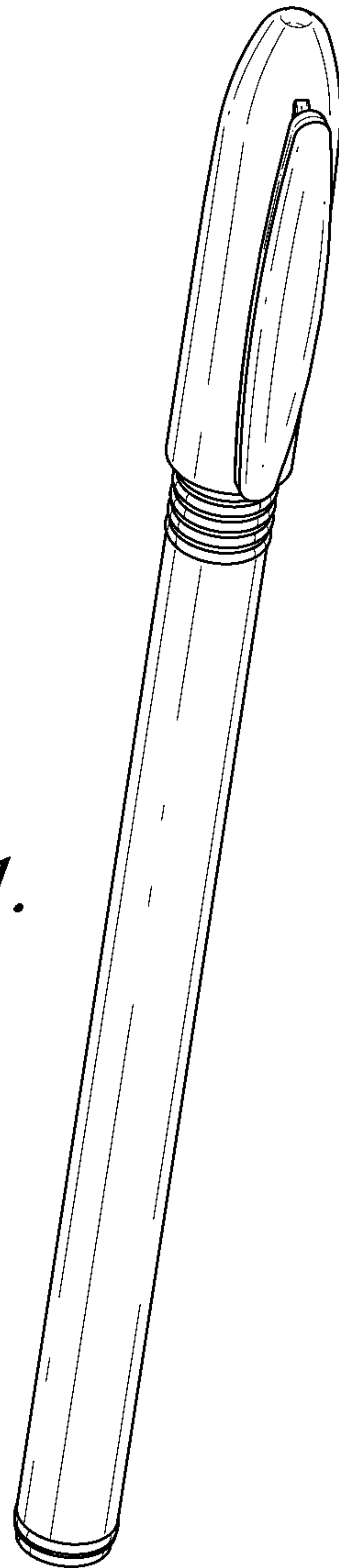

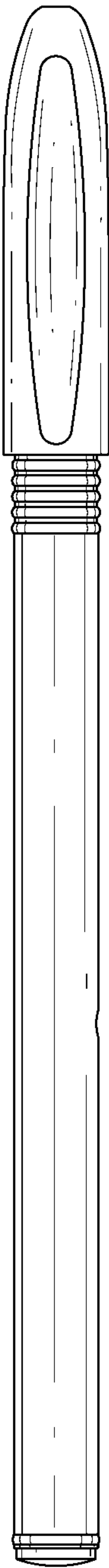
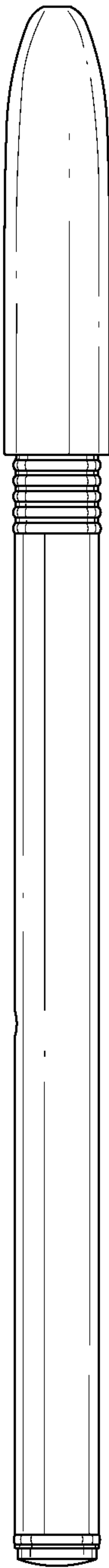

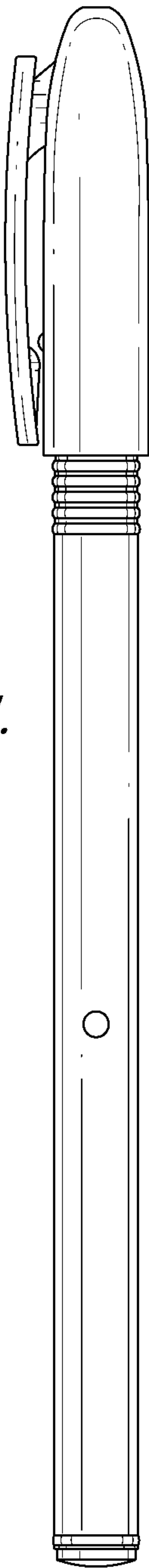

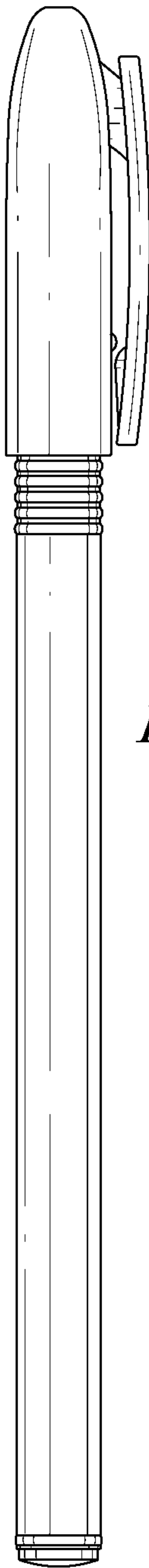

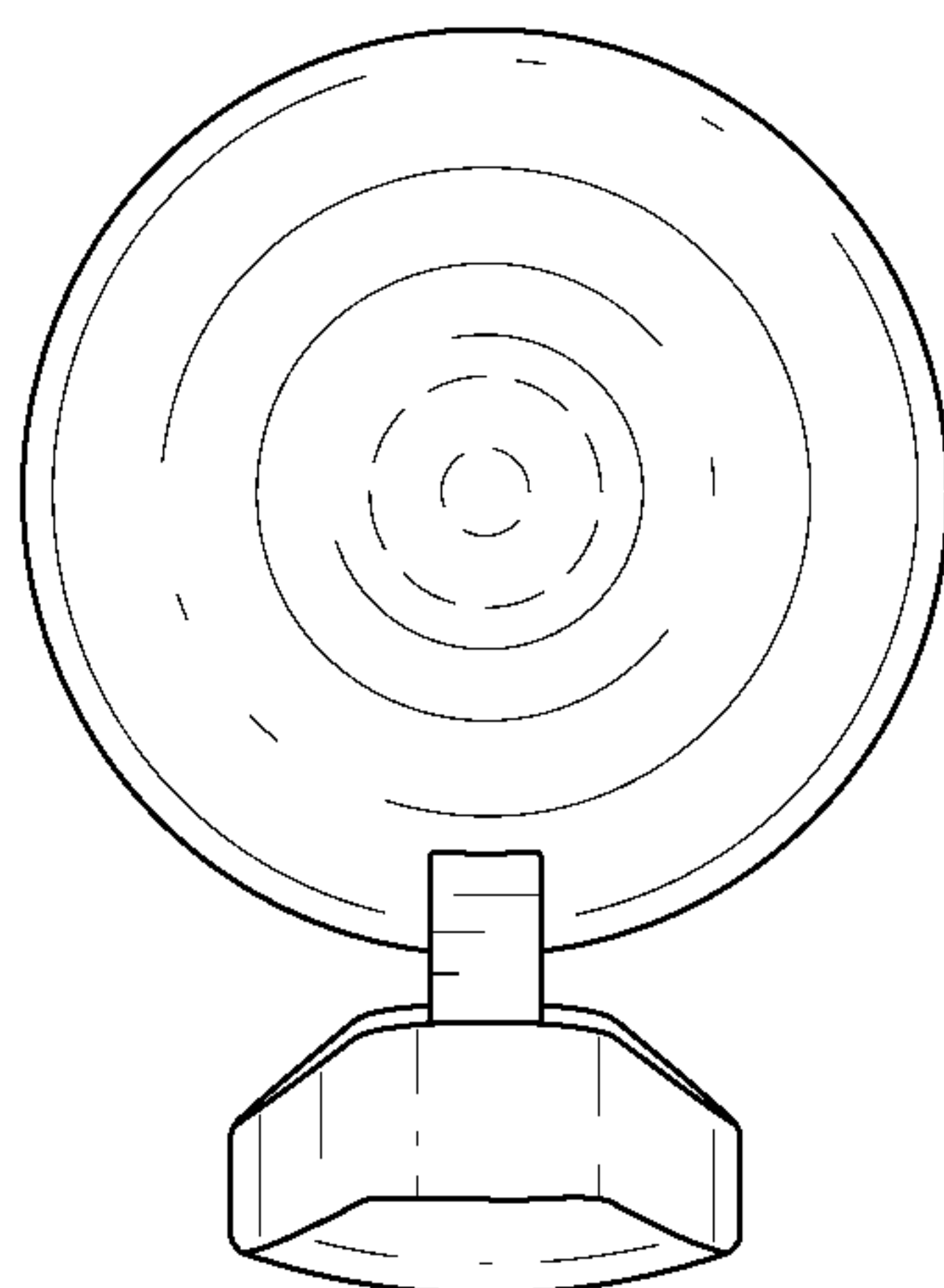

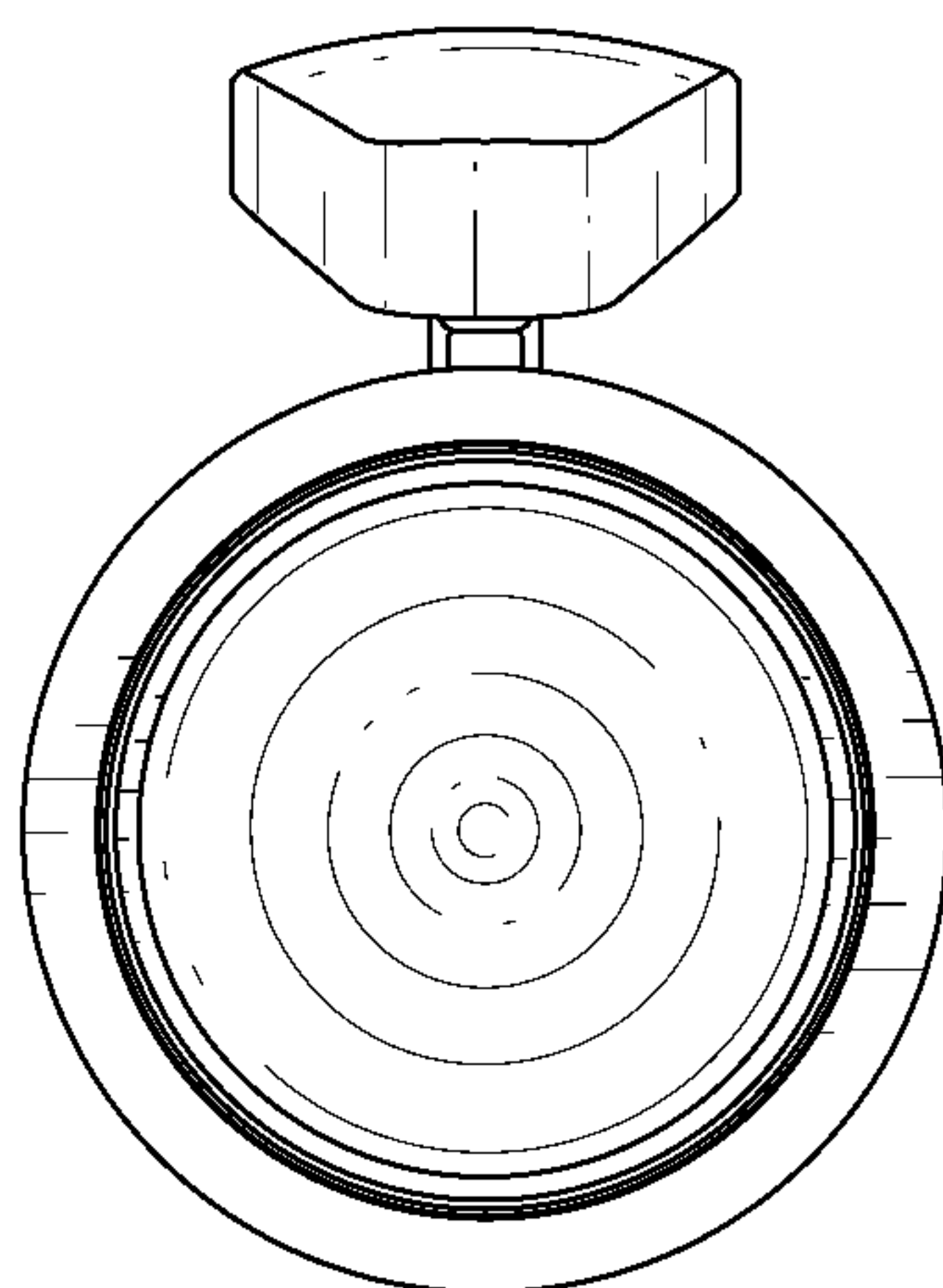

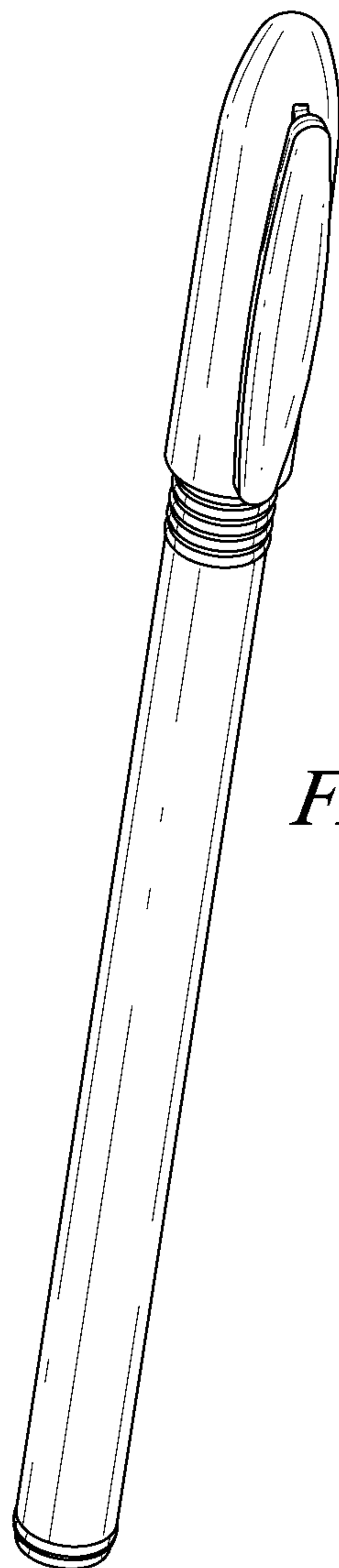

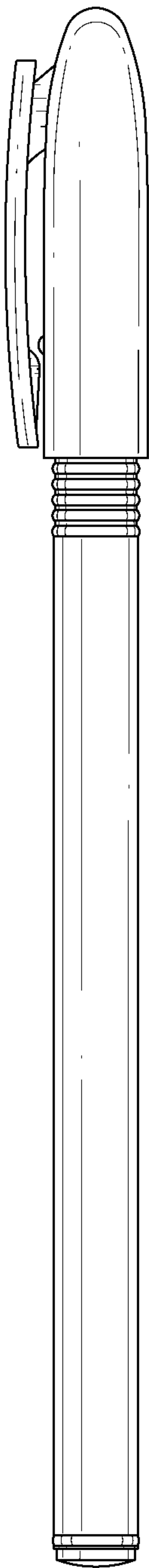

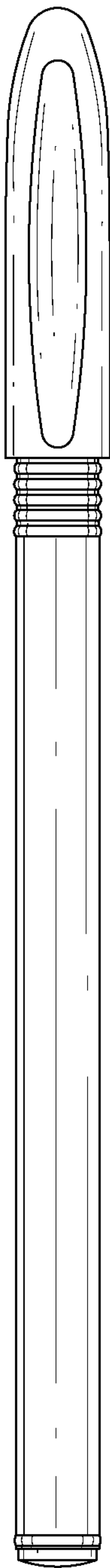

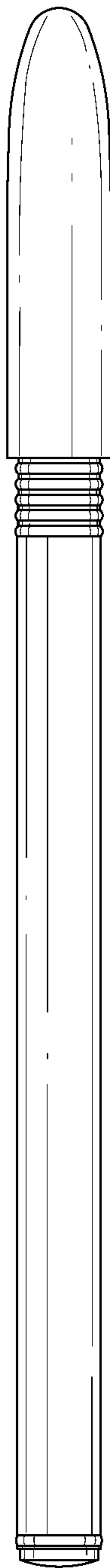

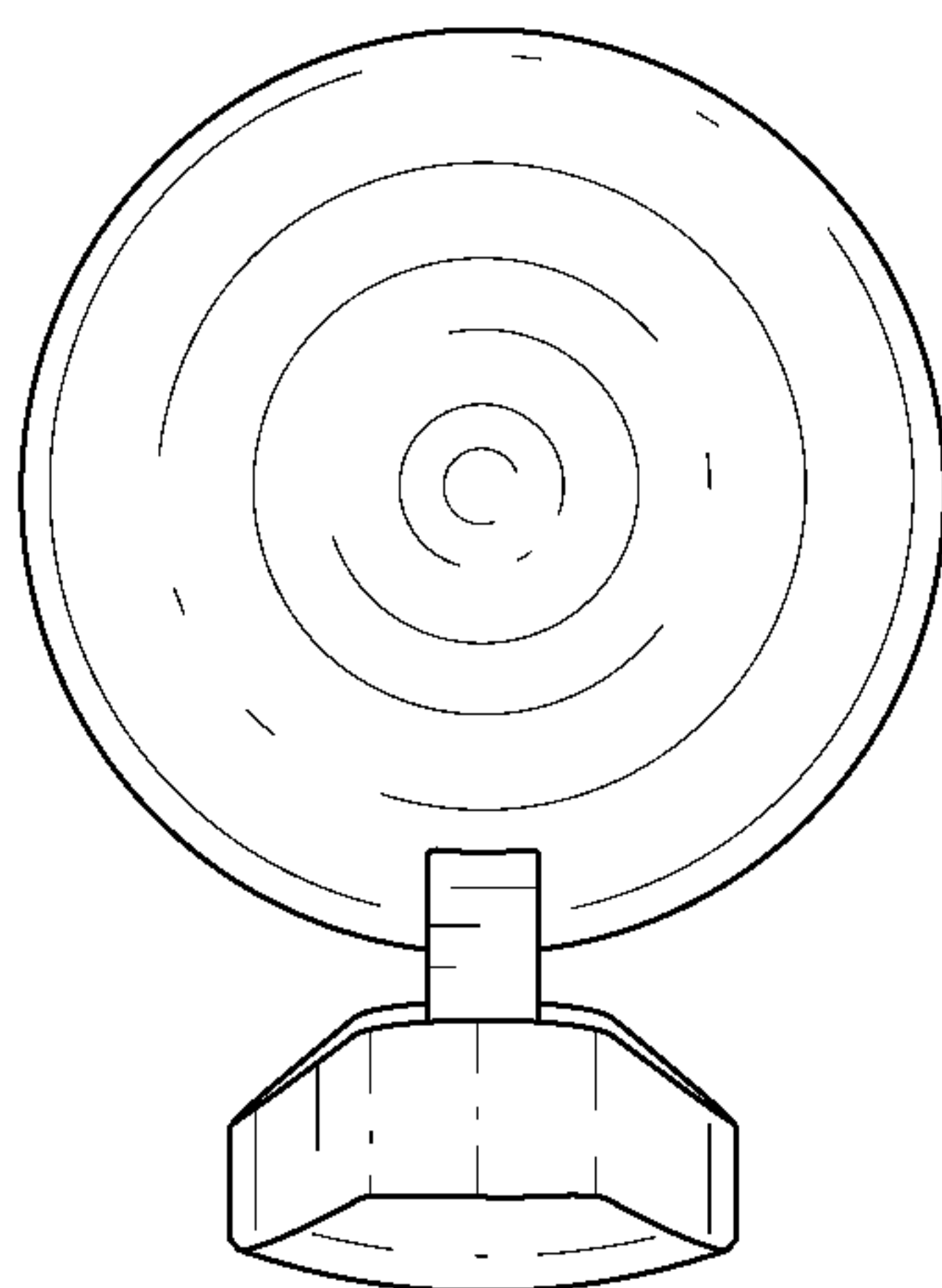

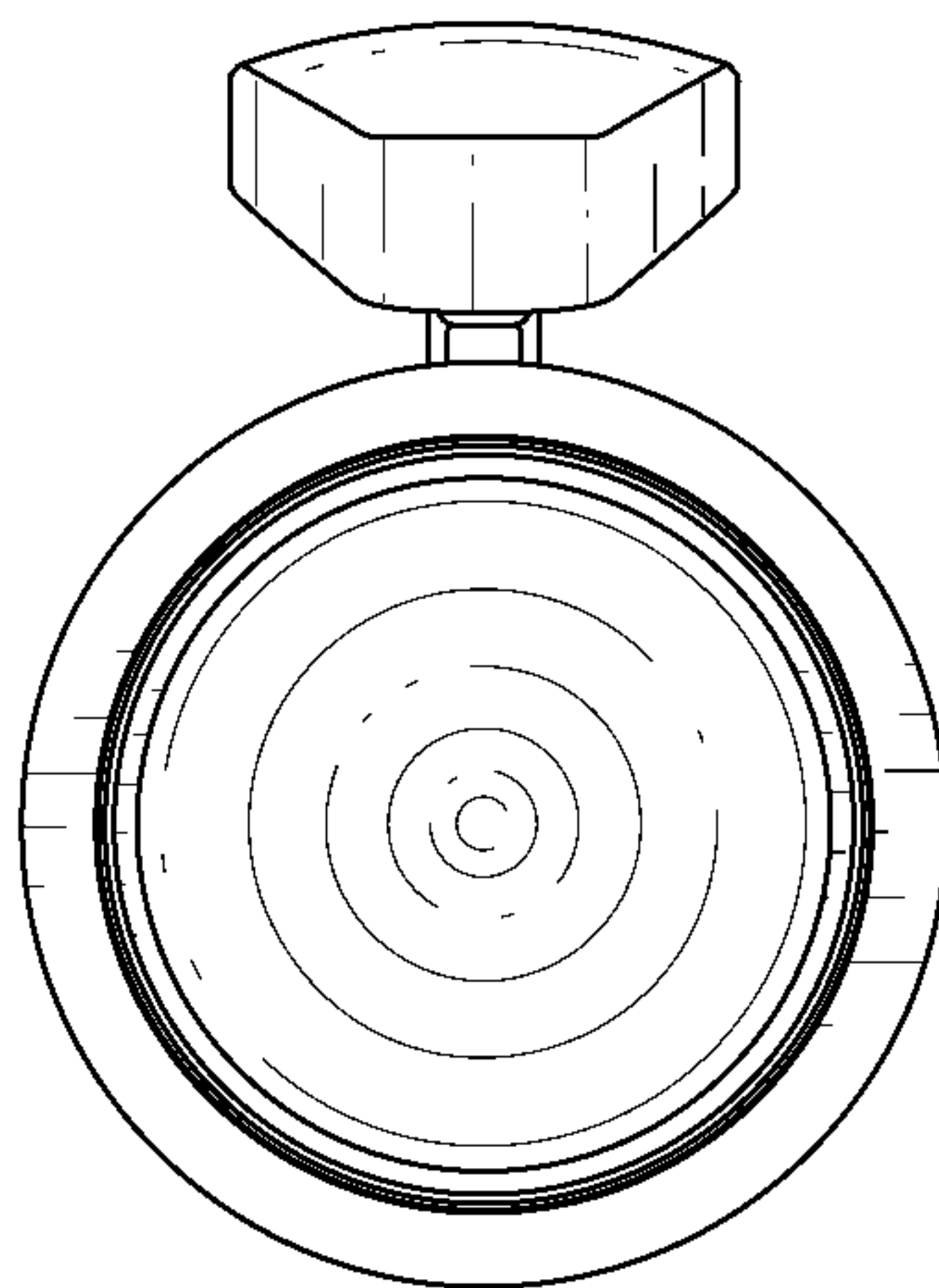

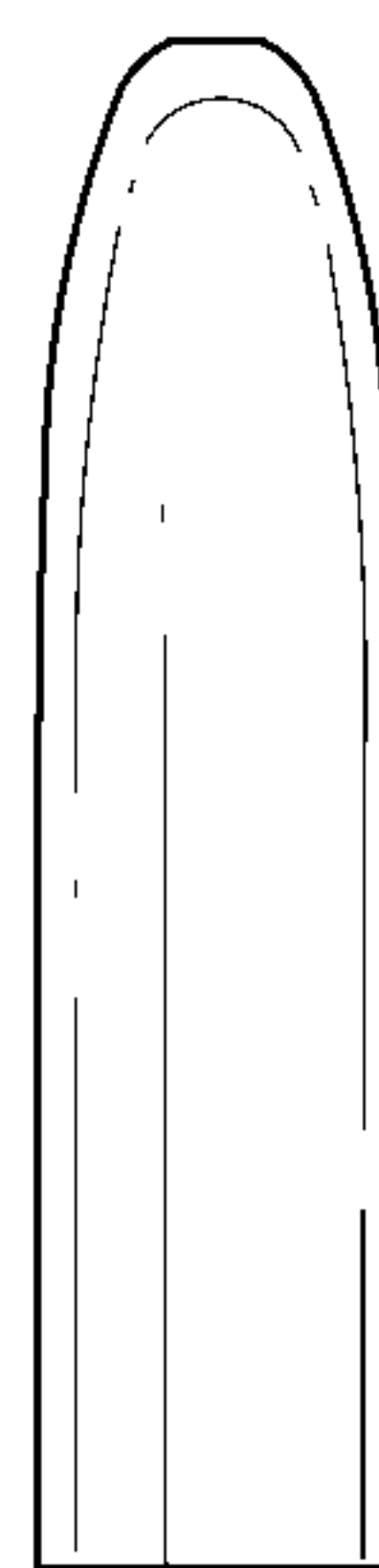
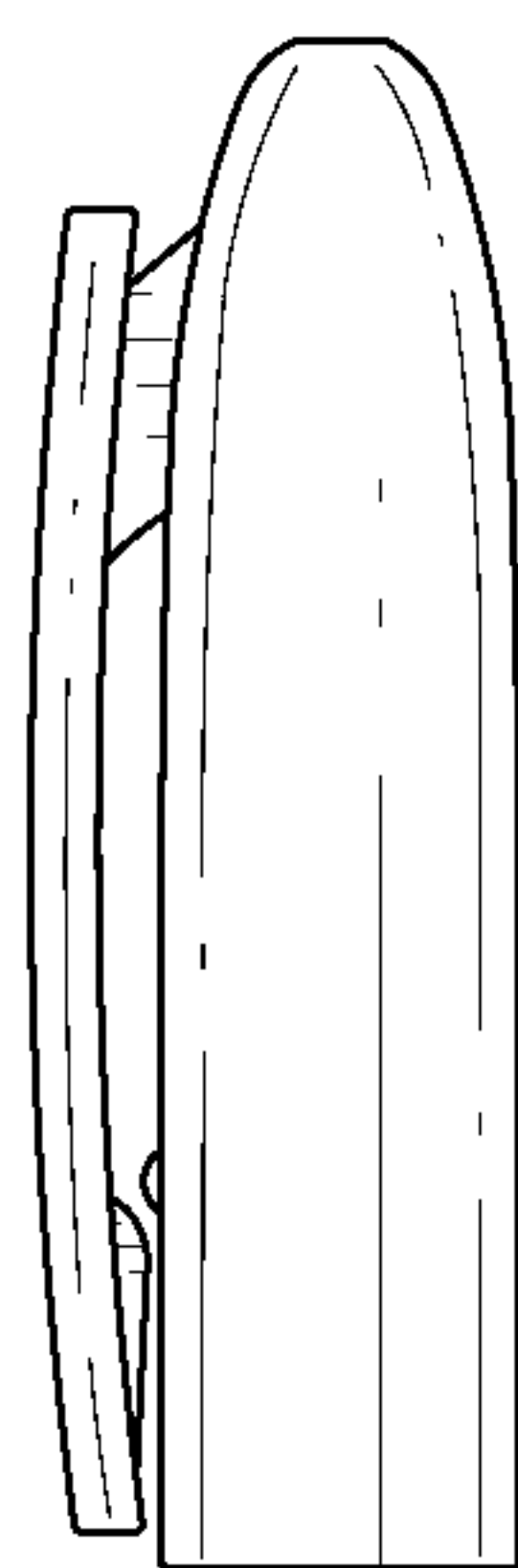

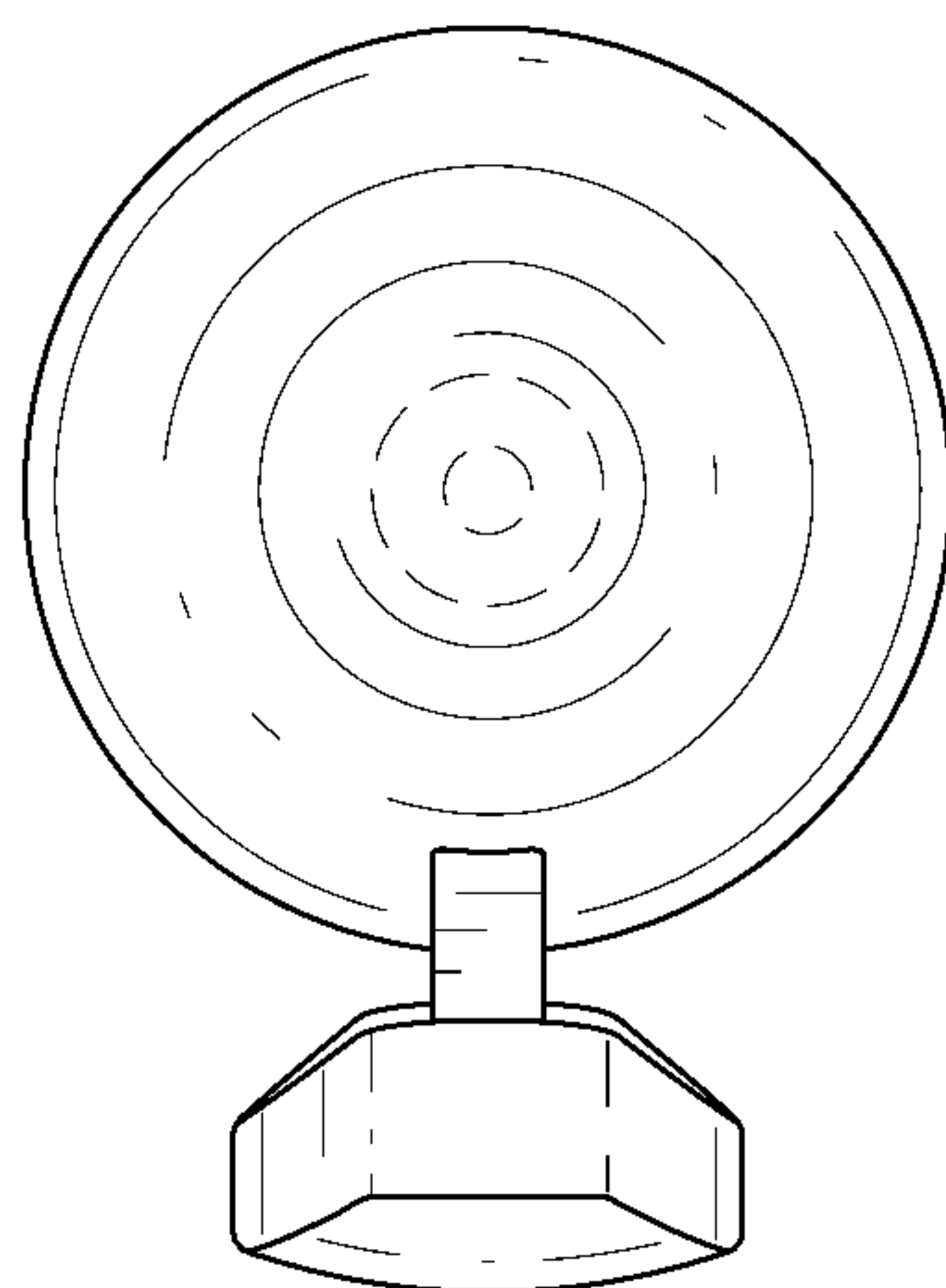

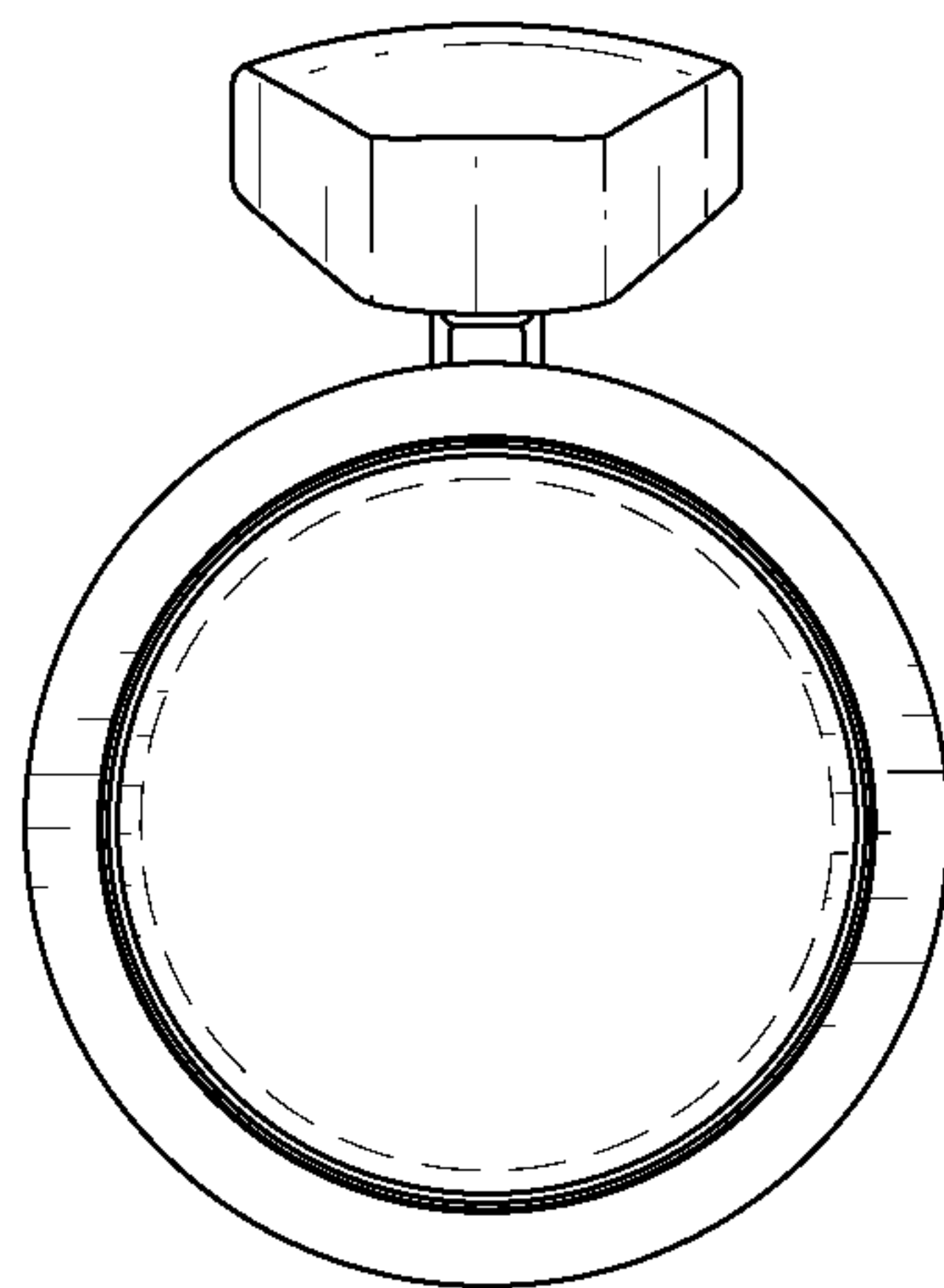
