DESCRIPTION

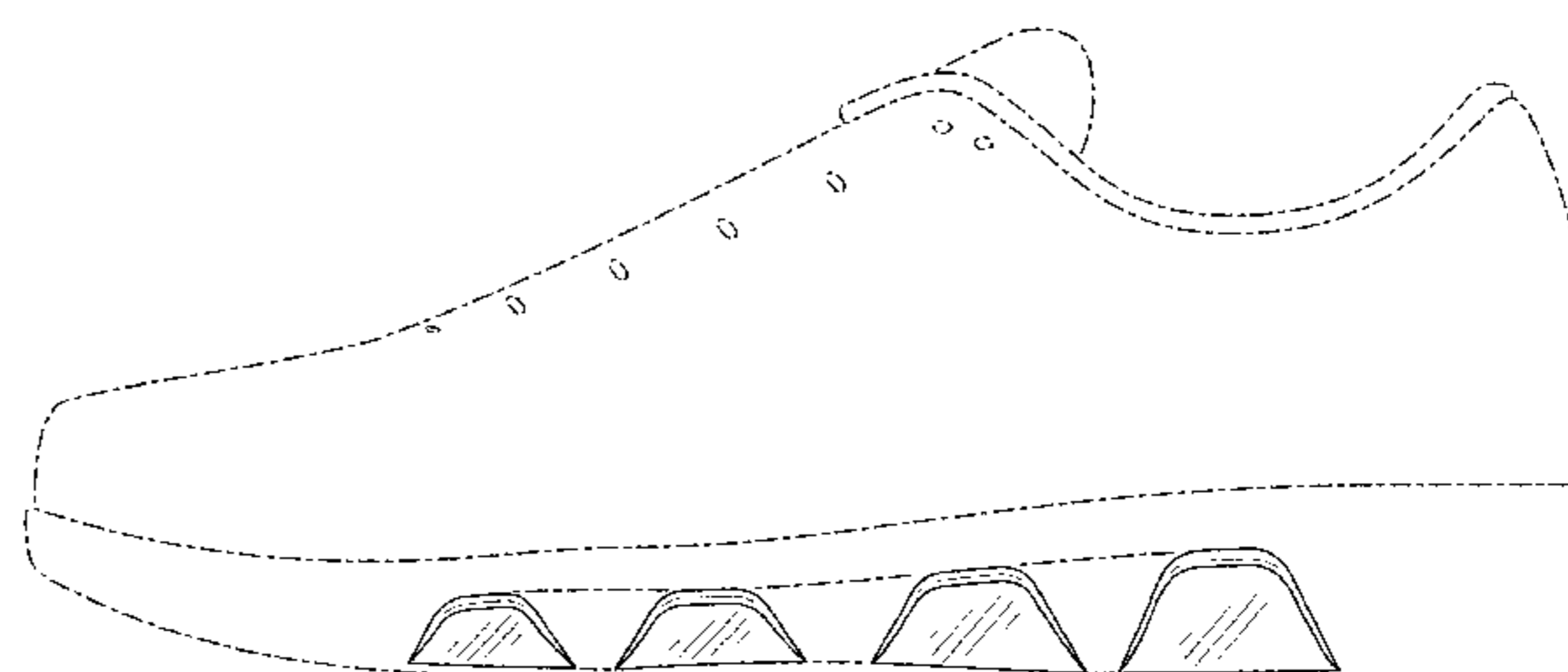
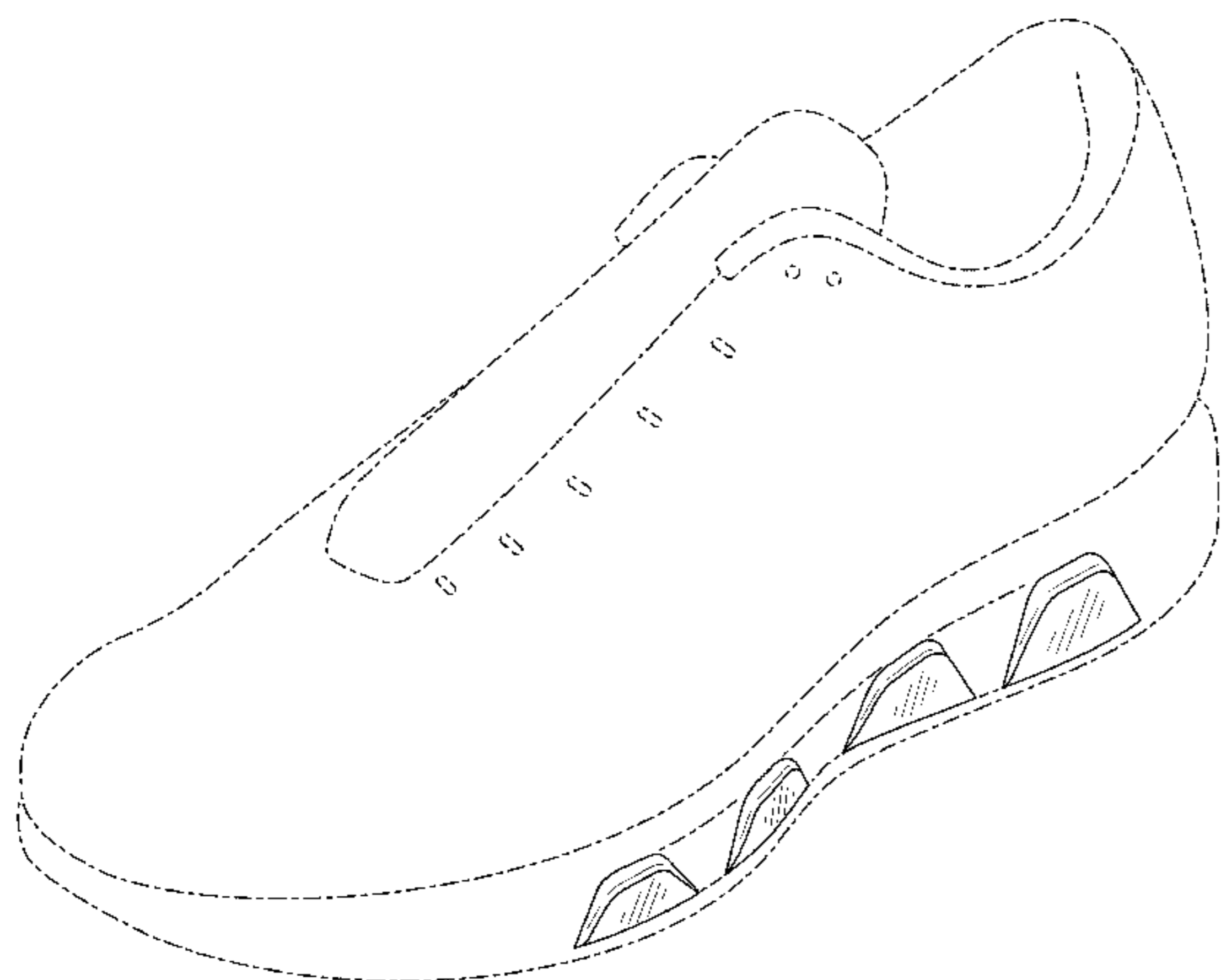
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a shoe midsole with translucent regions showing my new design;

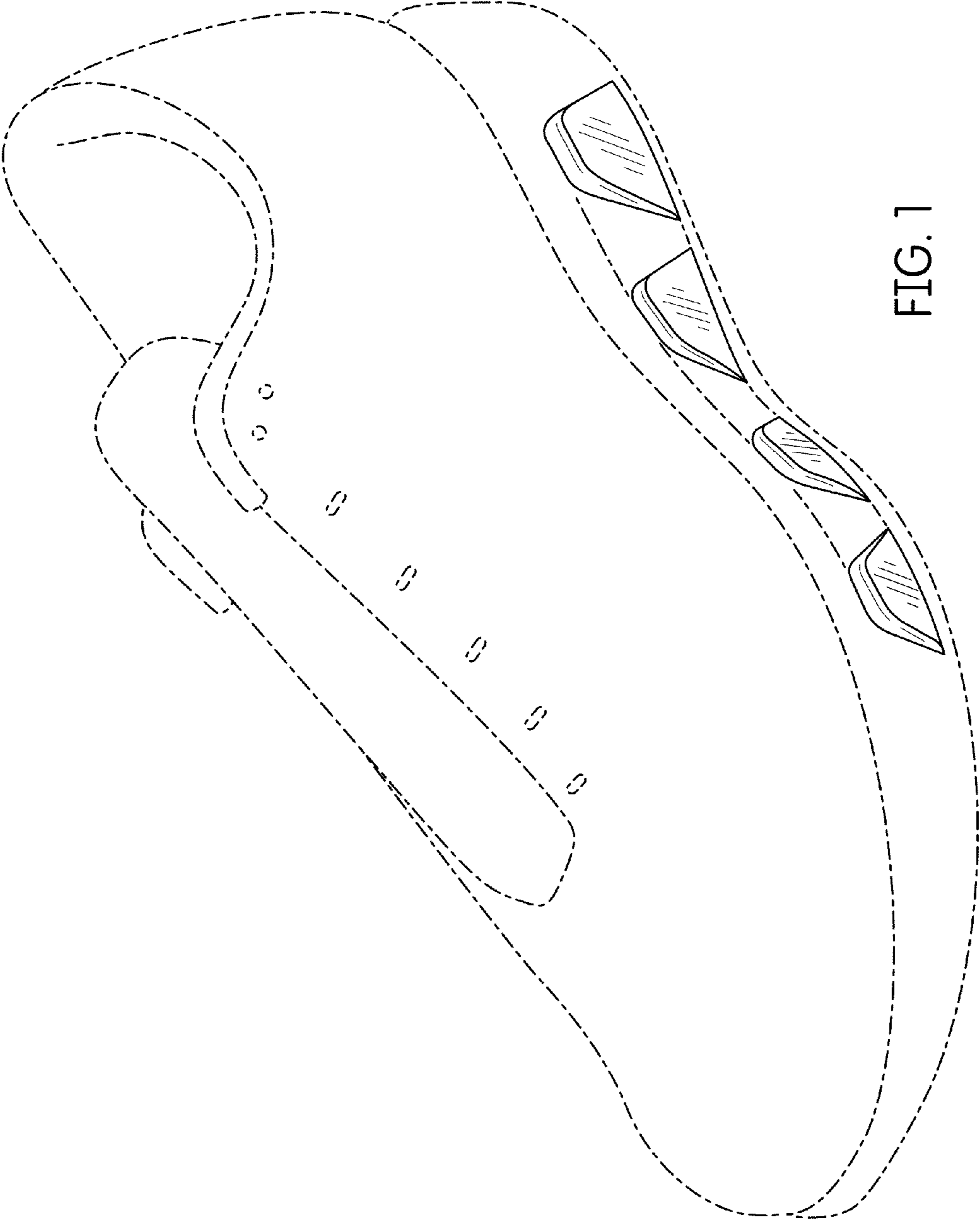

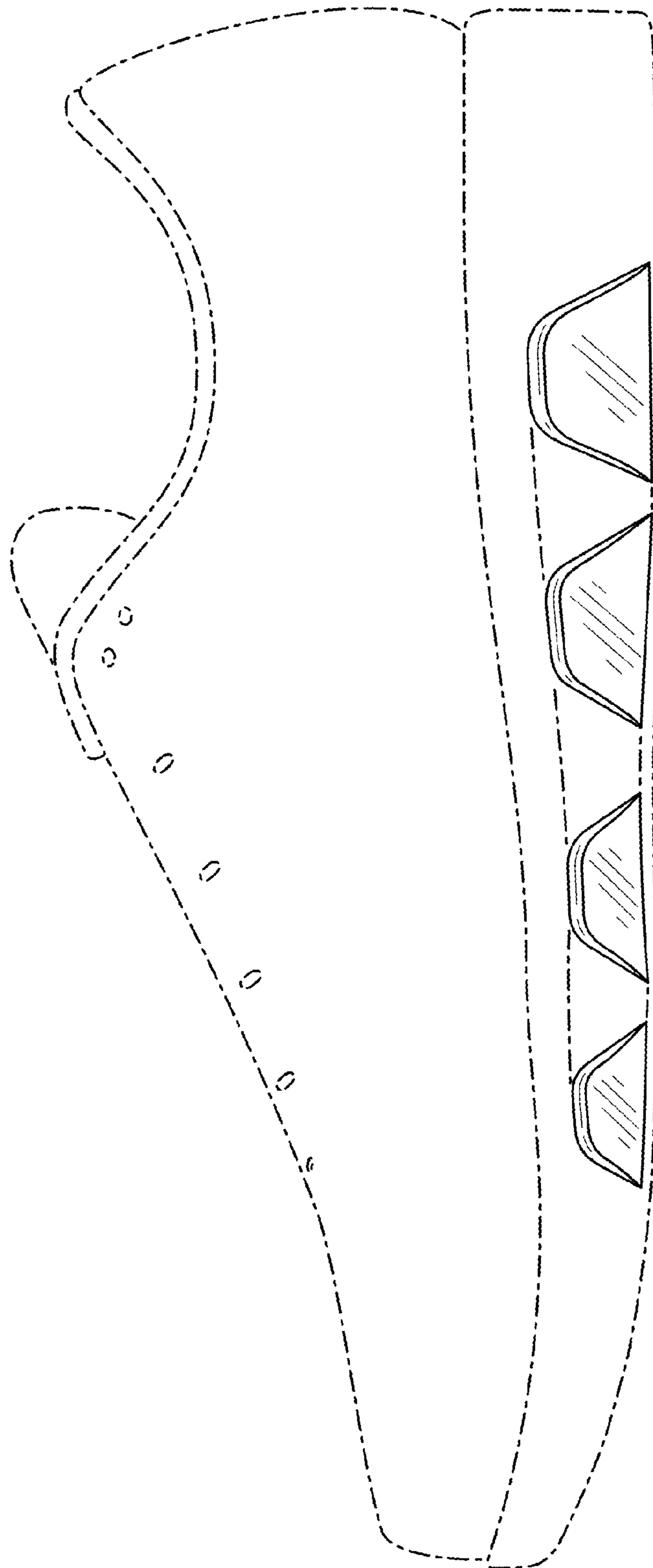

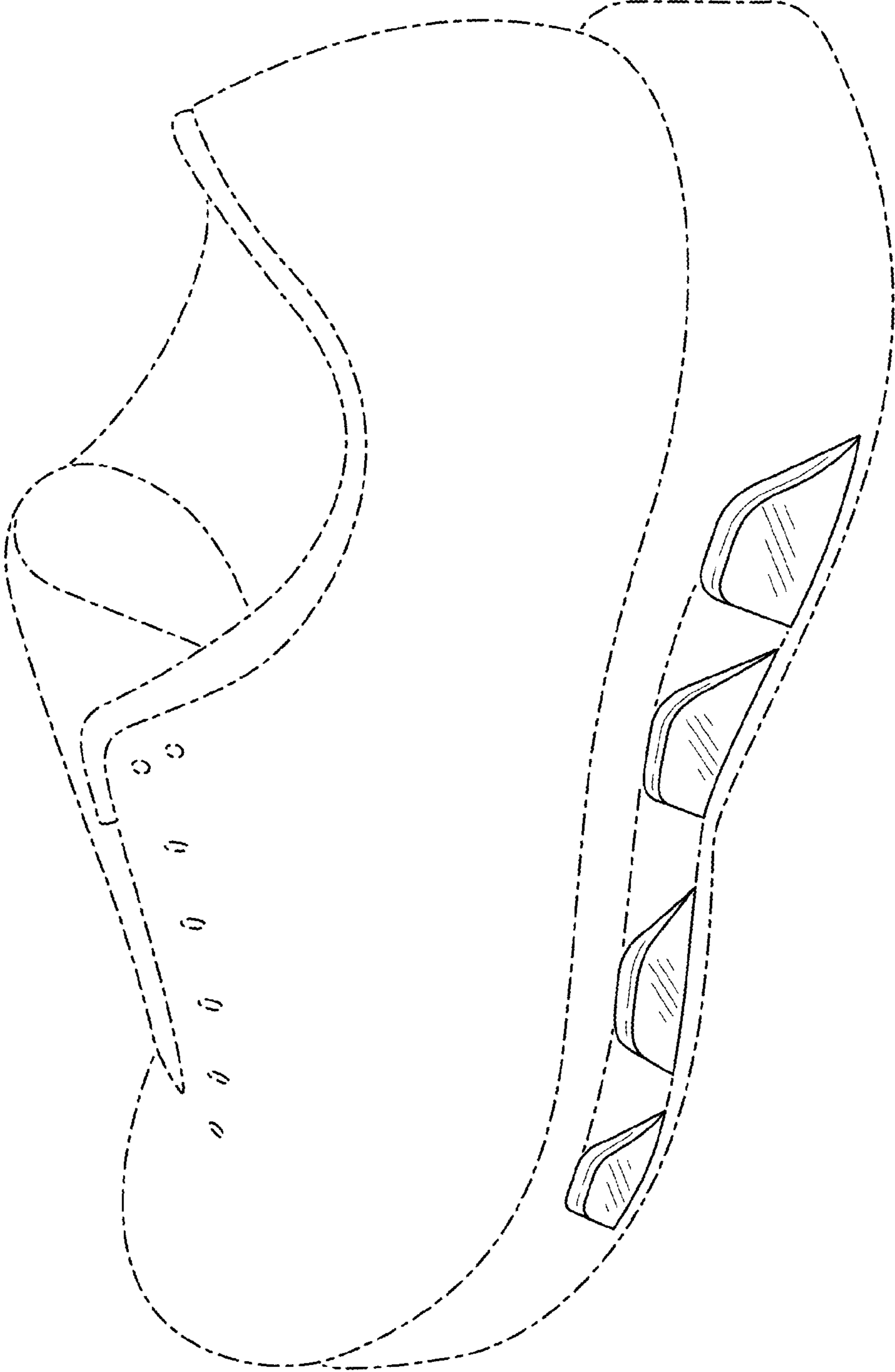
