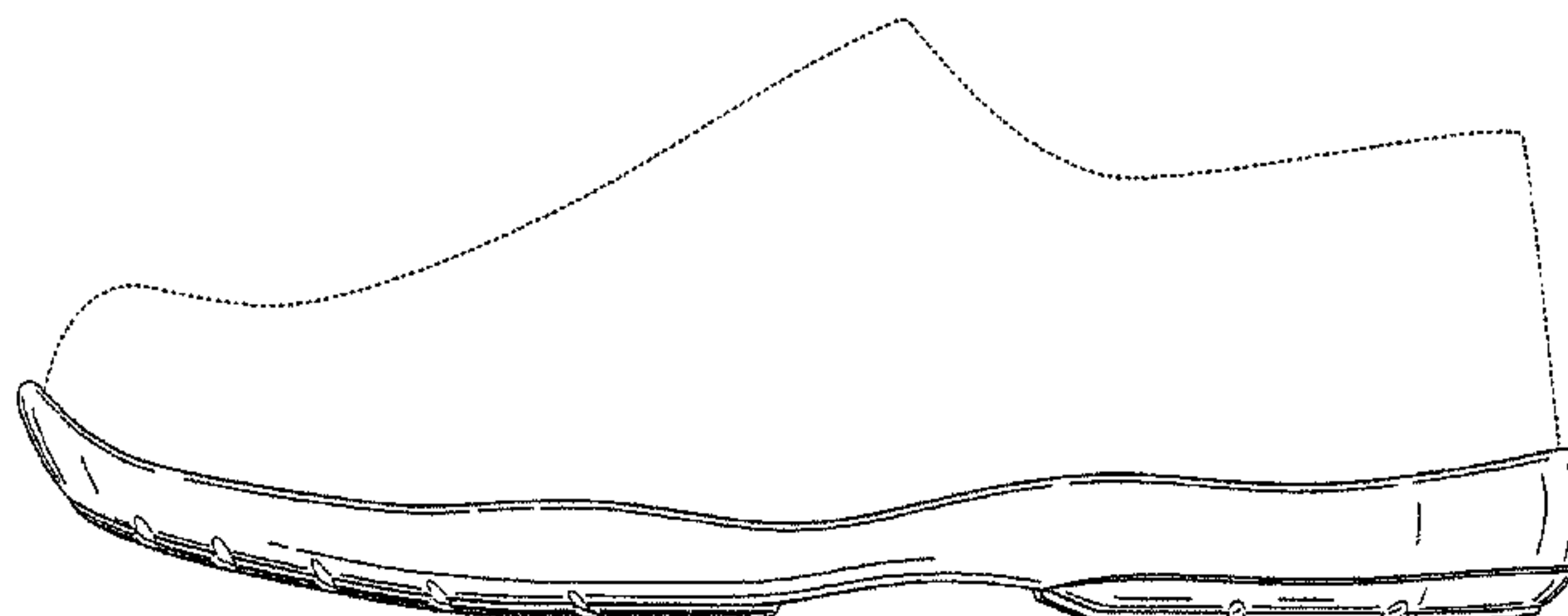
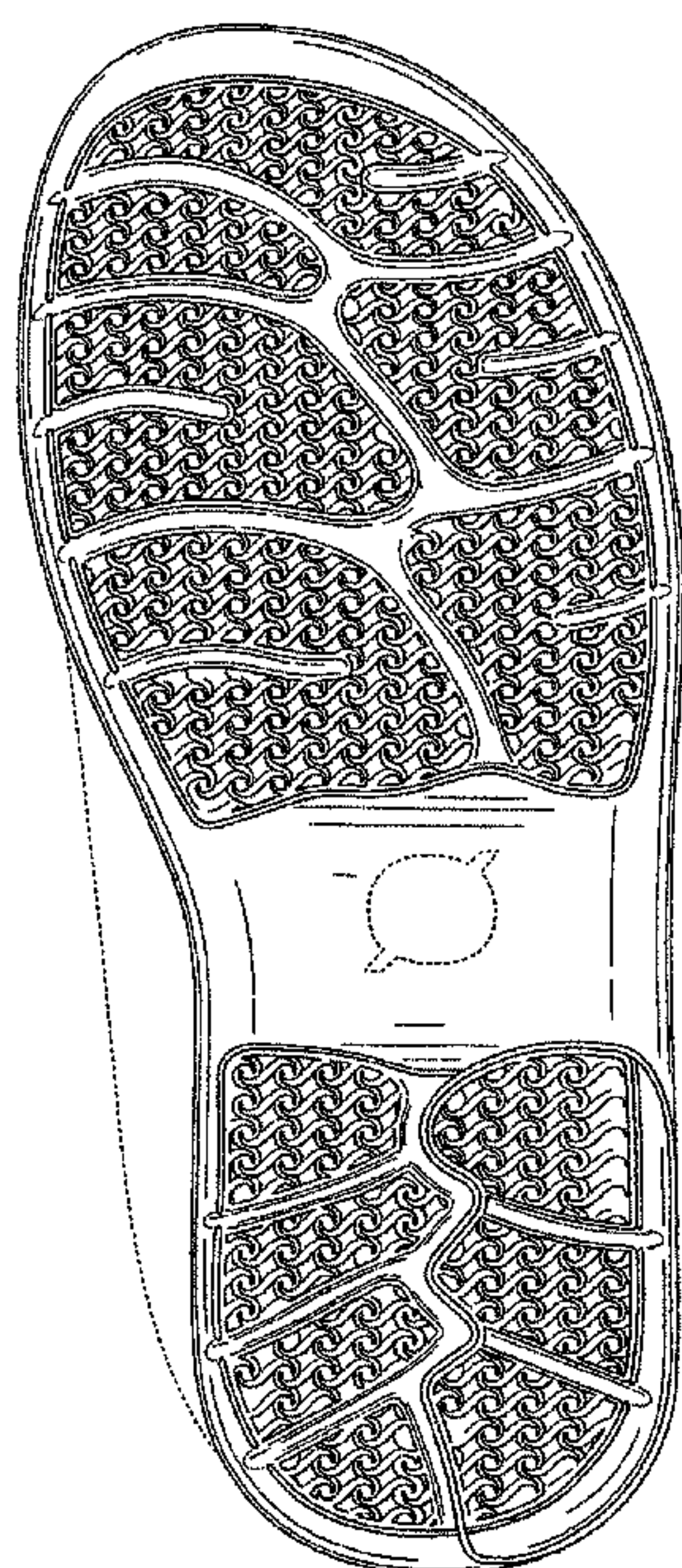
The ornamental design for an outsole for a shoe, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

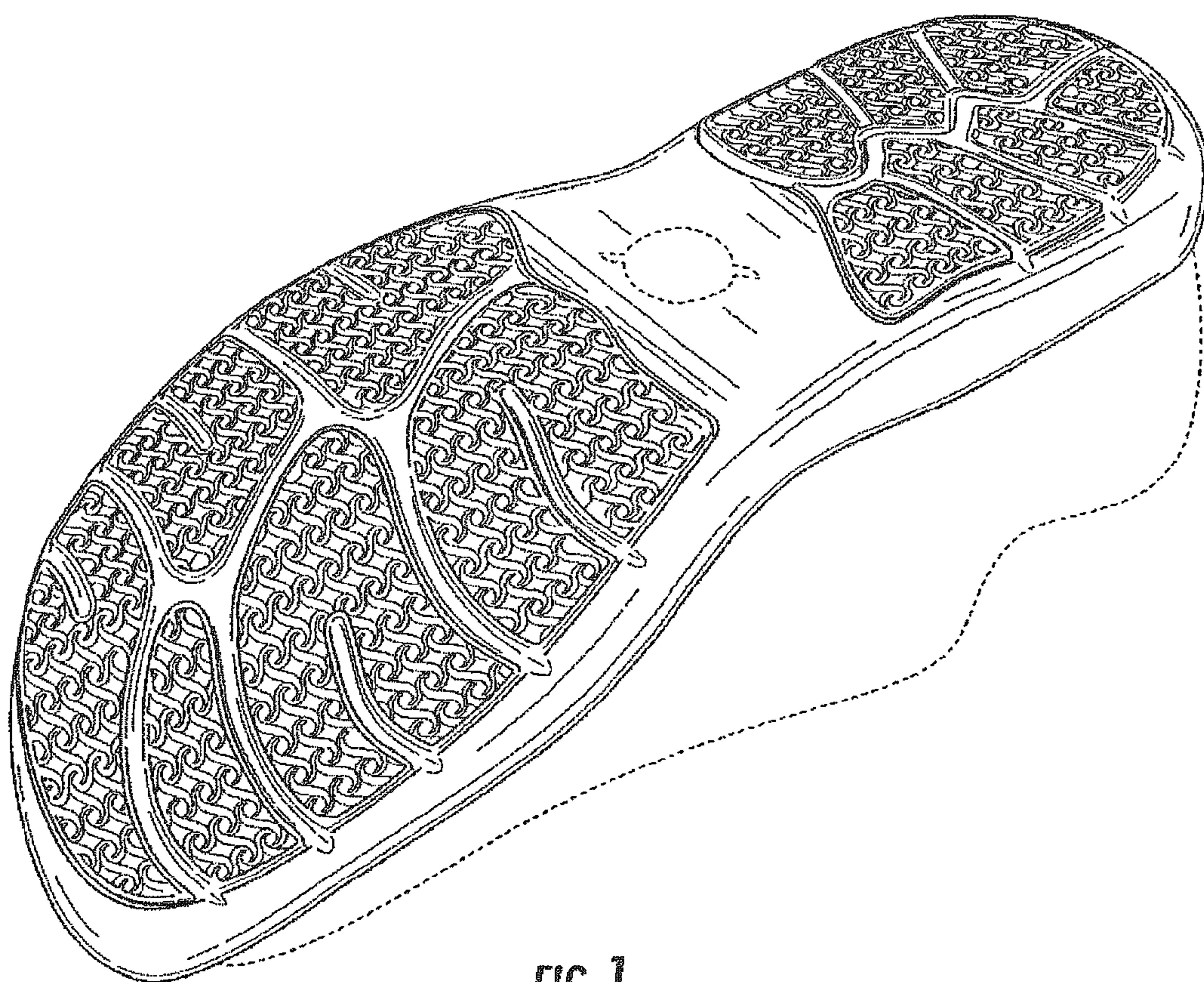

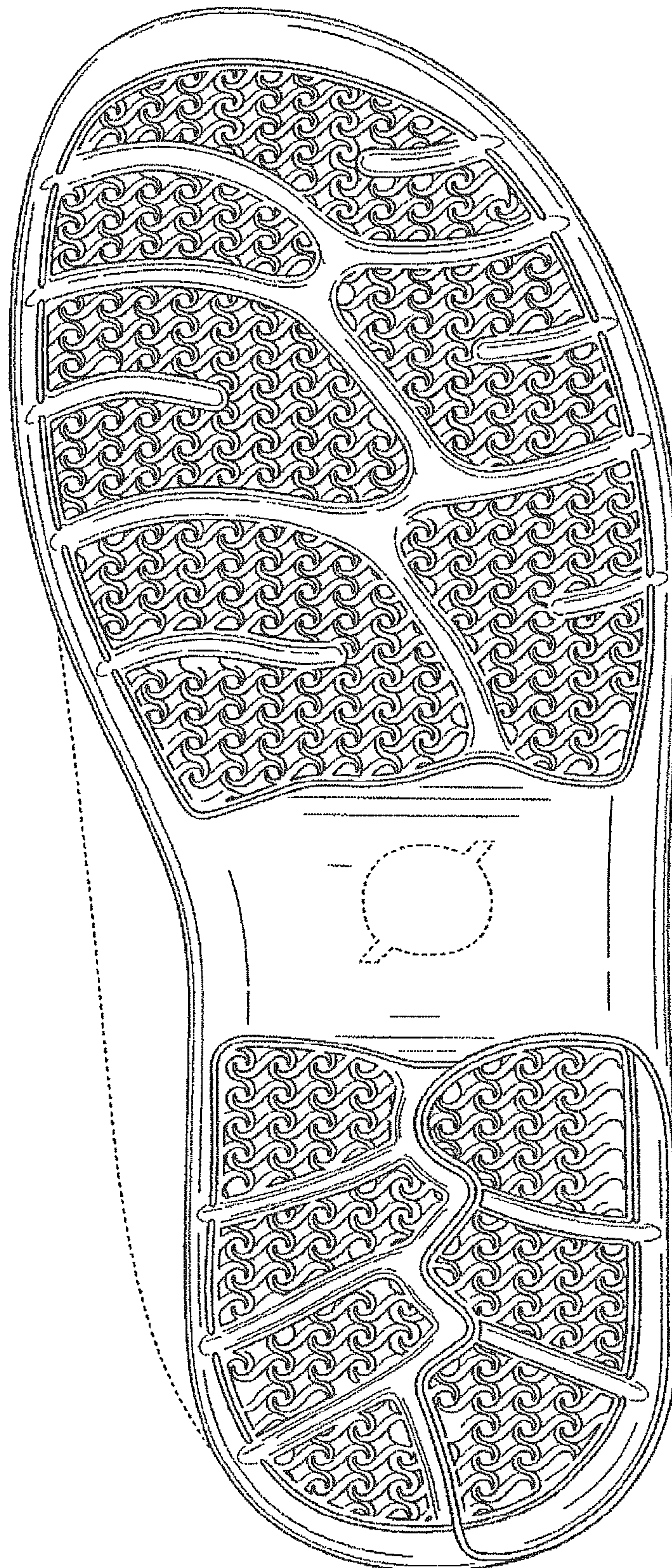

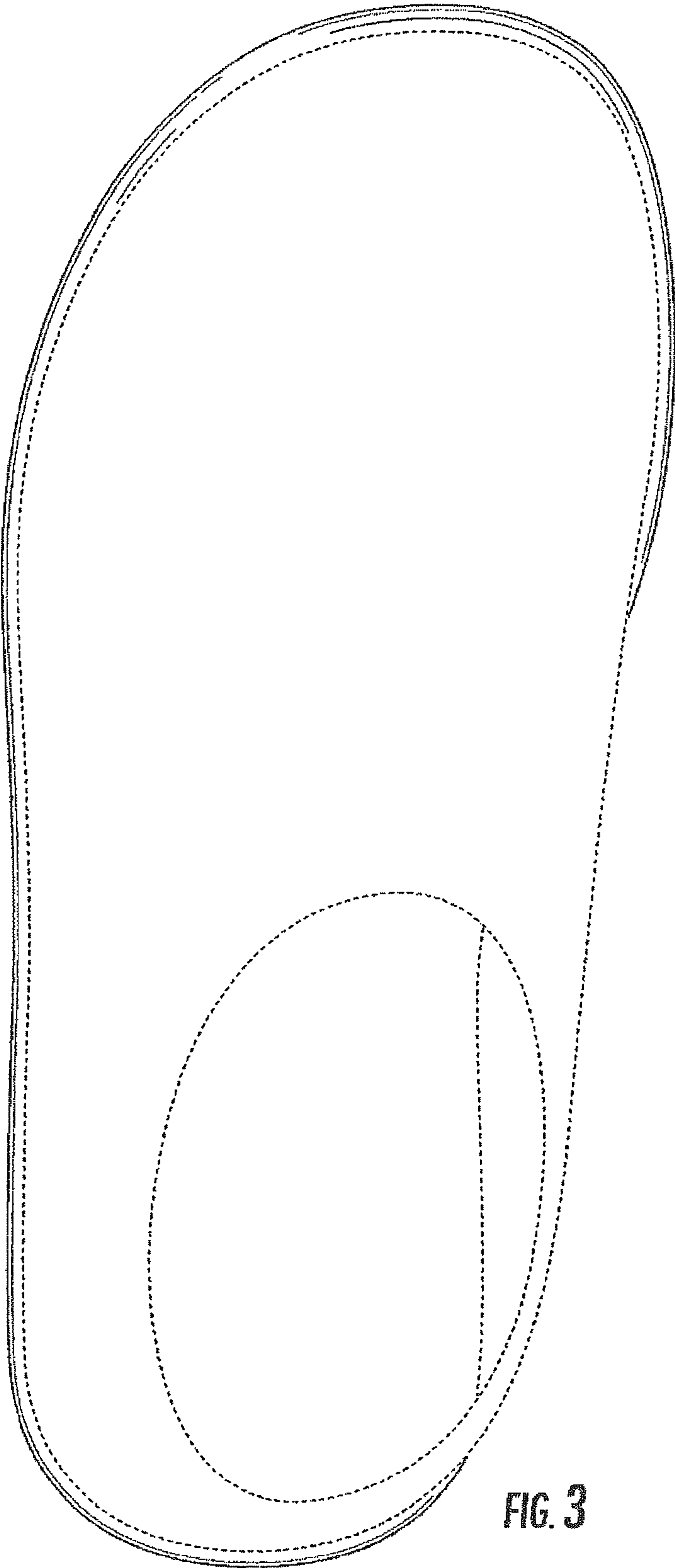

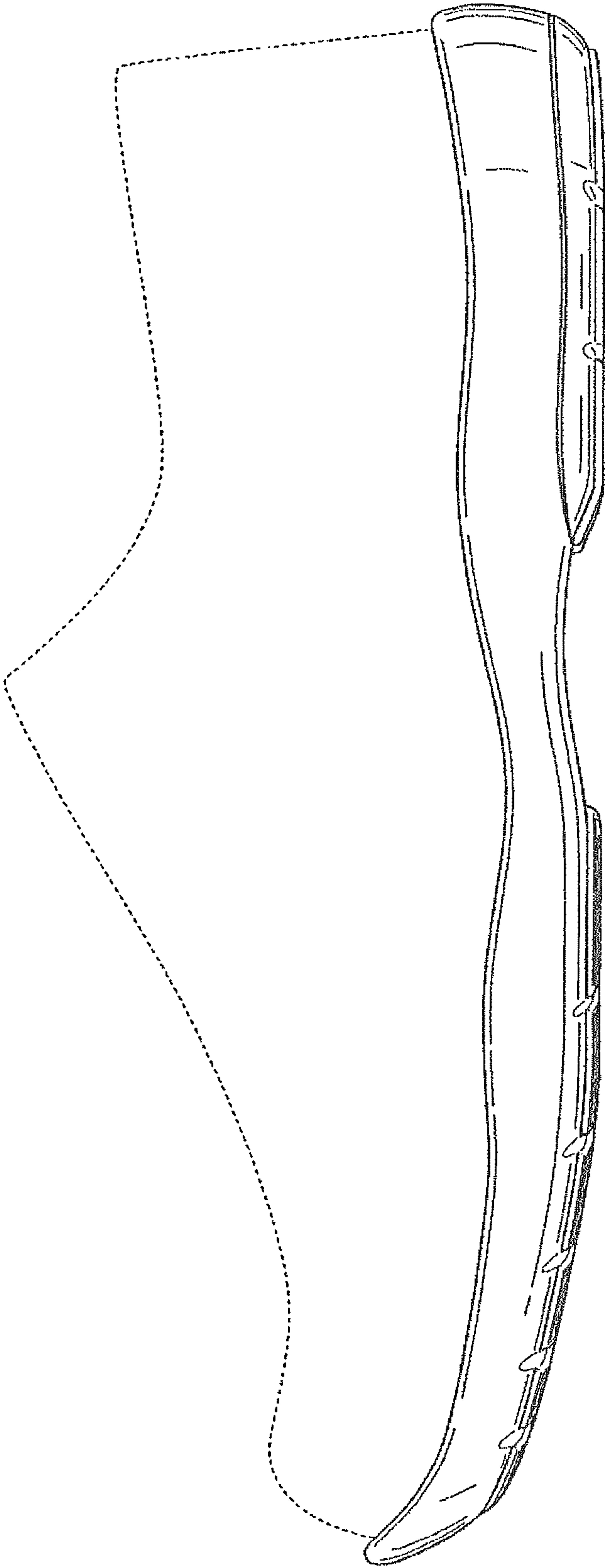

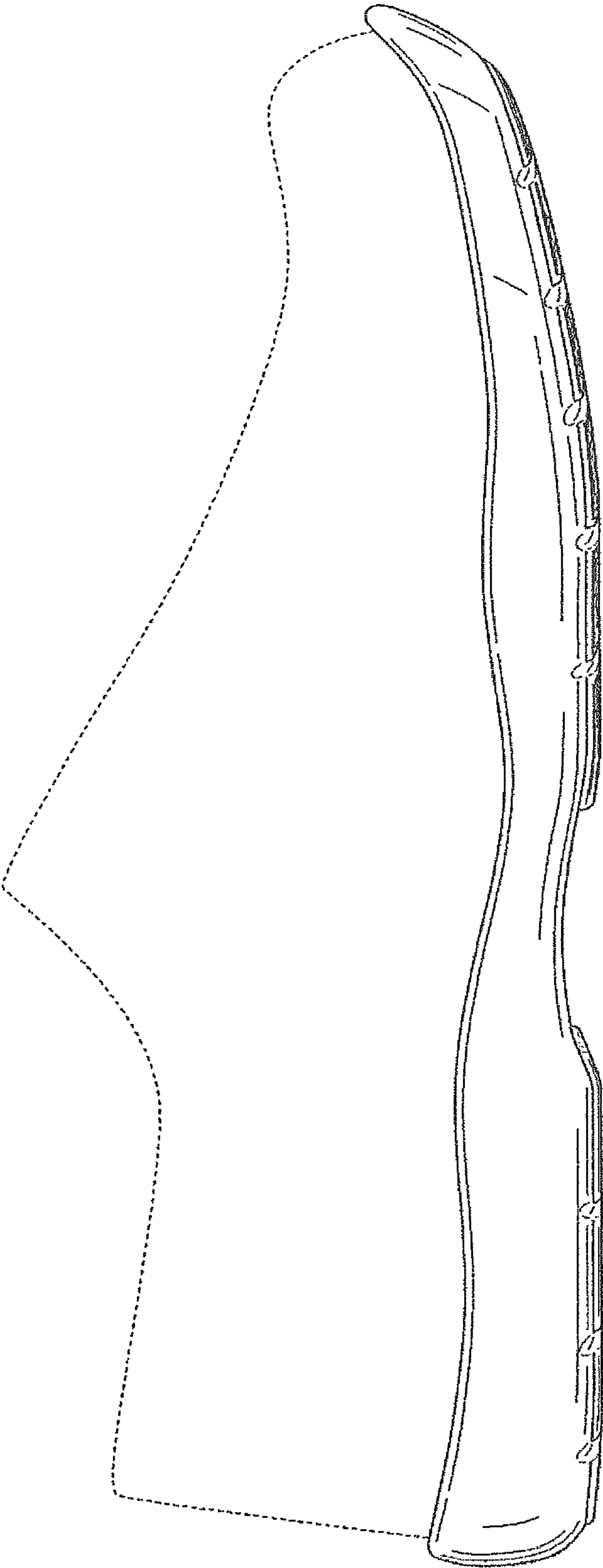

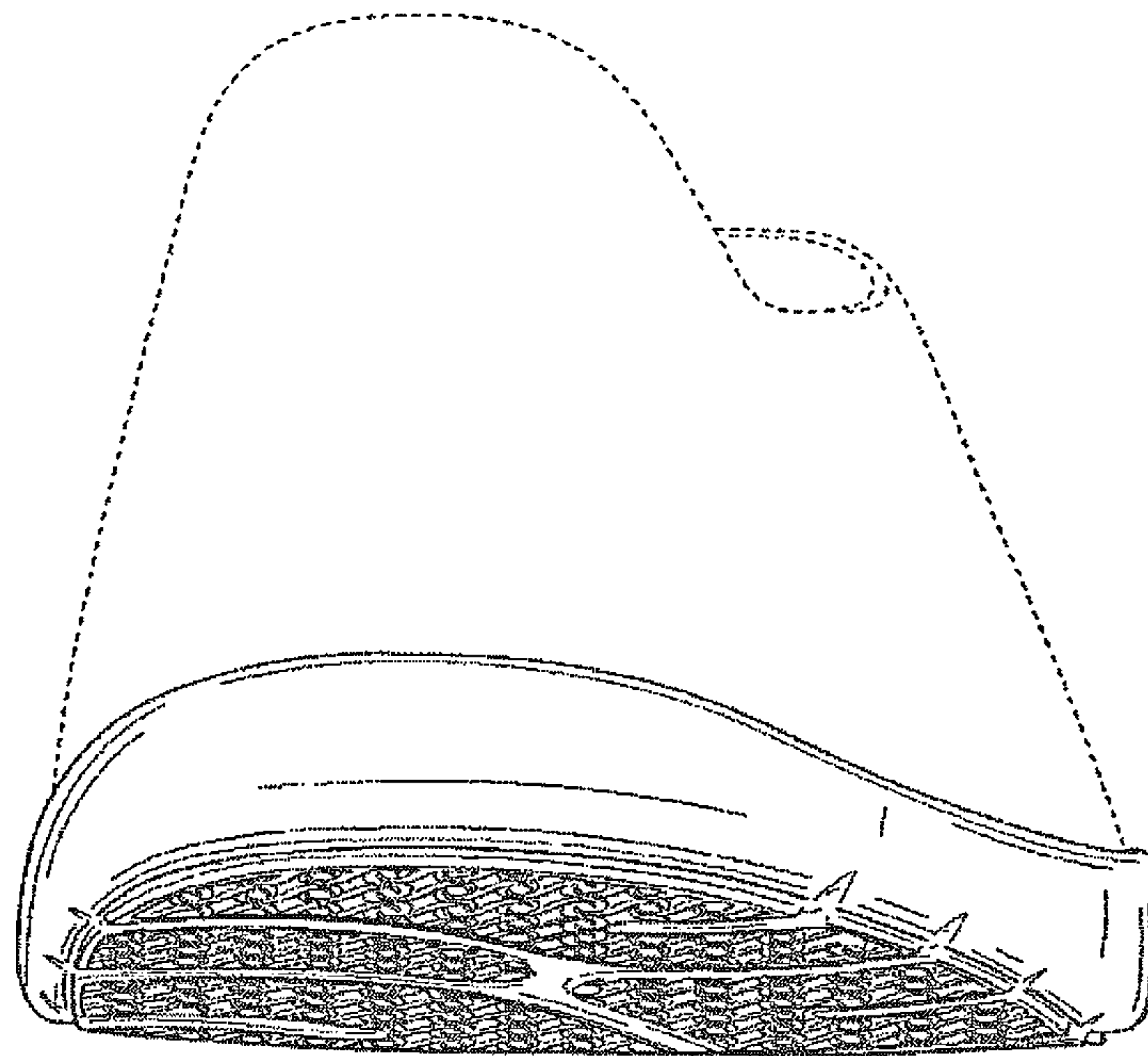

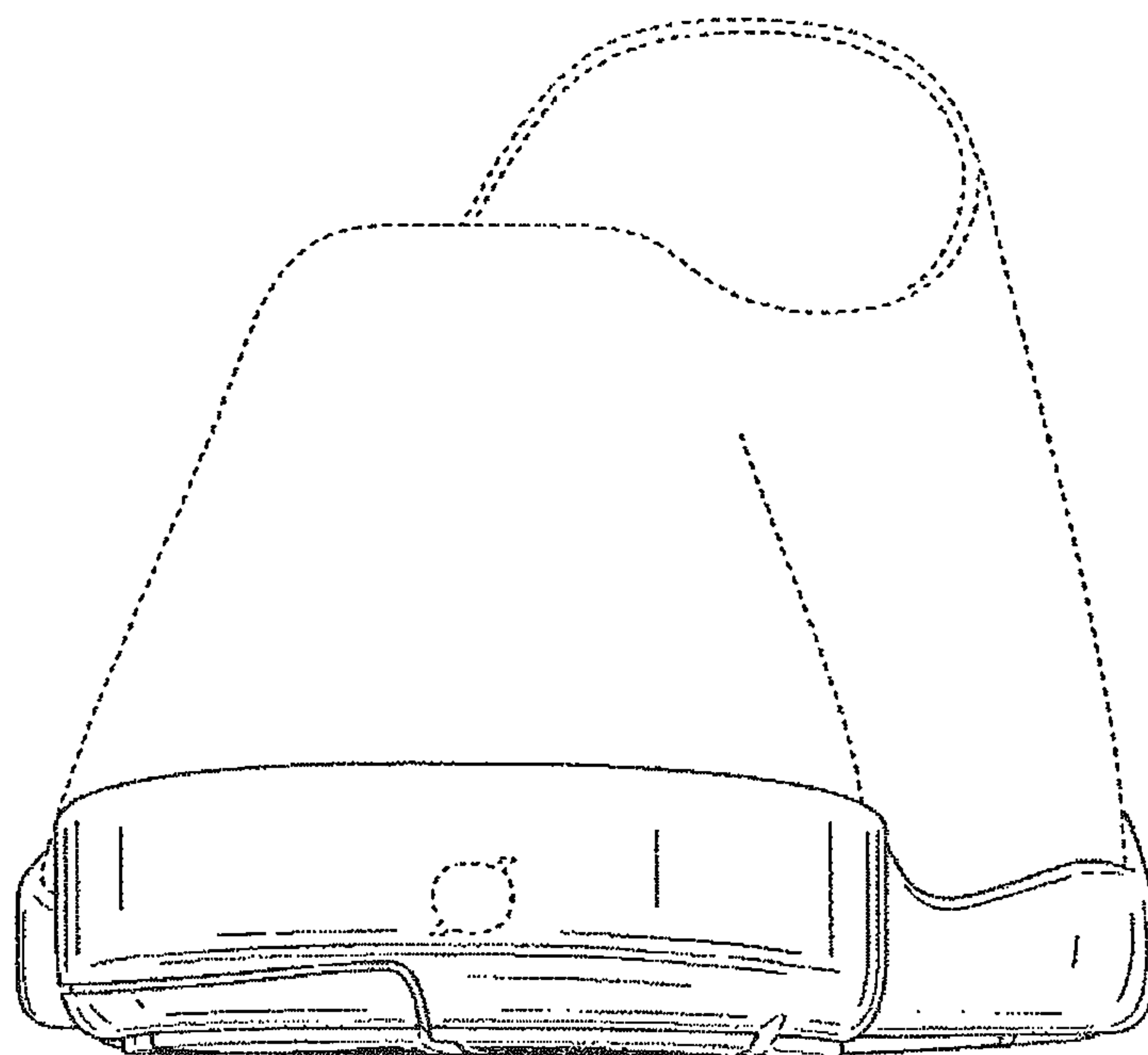
