I claim the ornamental design for a golf bag stool, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 4 herewith is a left elevation view of the golf bag stool of FIG. 1.

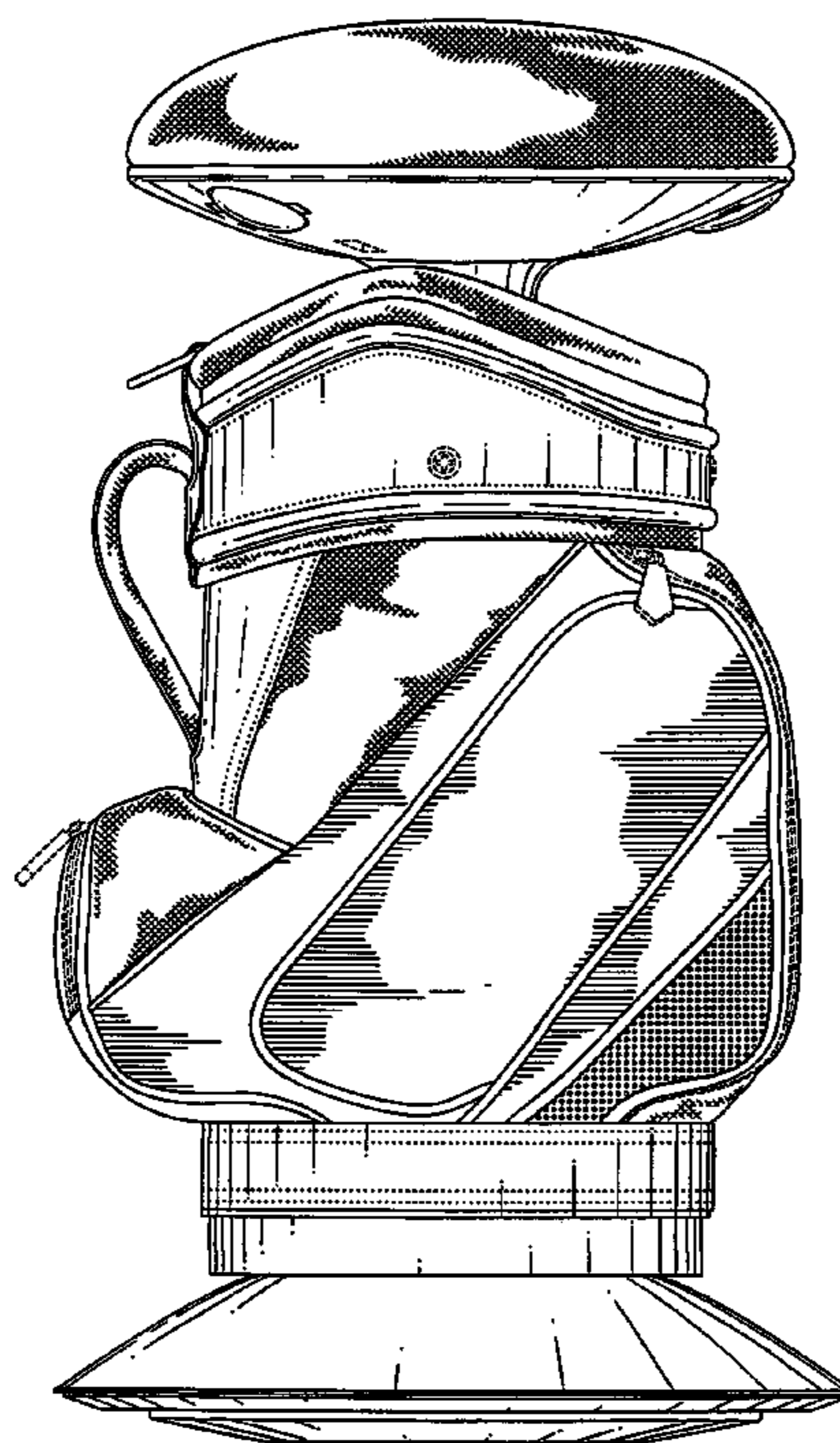
FIG. 5 herewith is a right elevation view of the golf bag stool of FIG. 1.

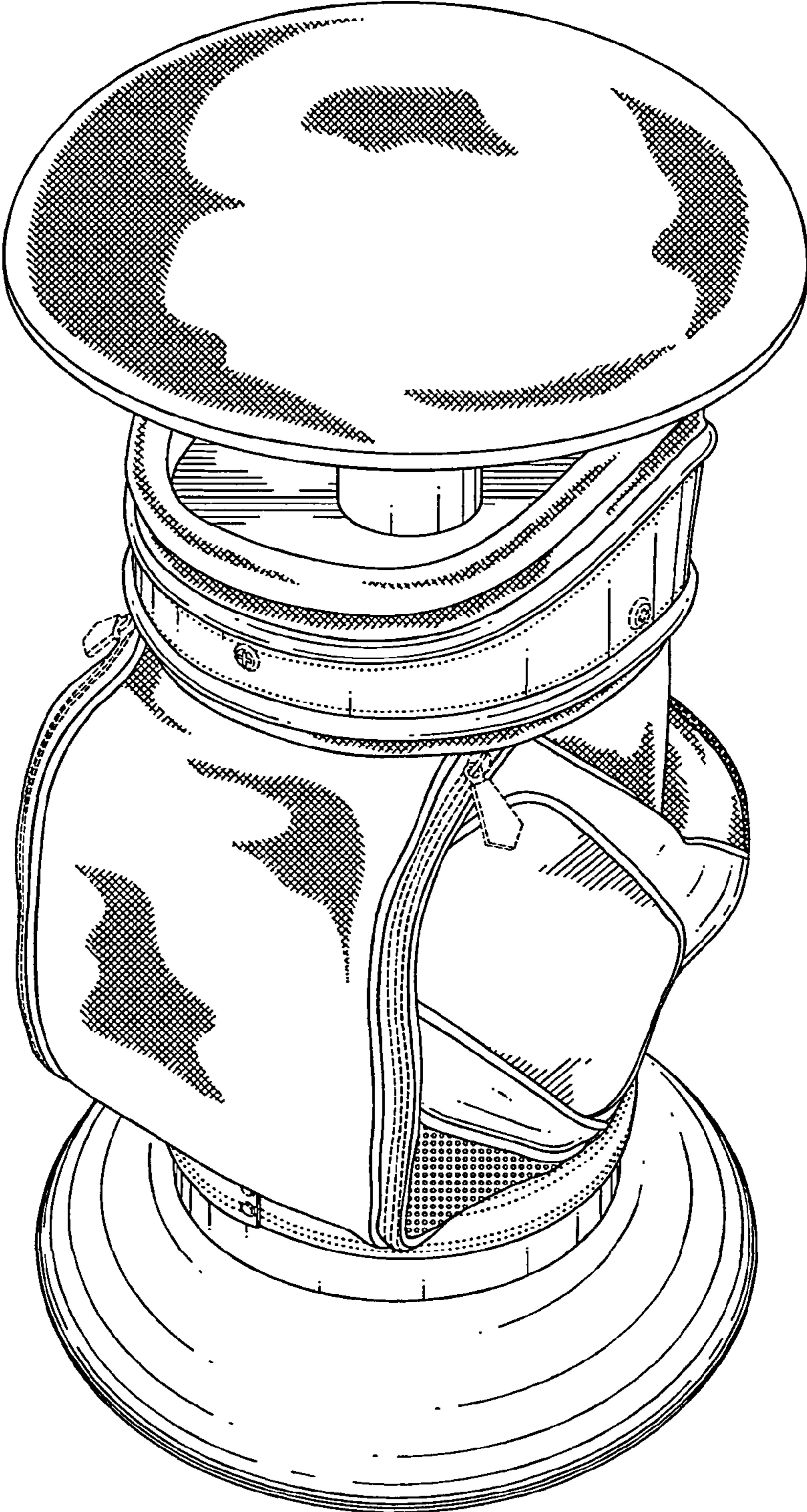

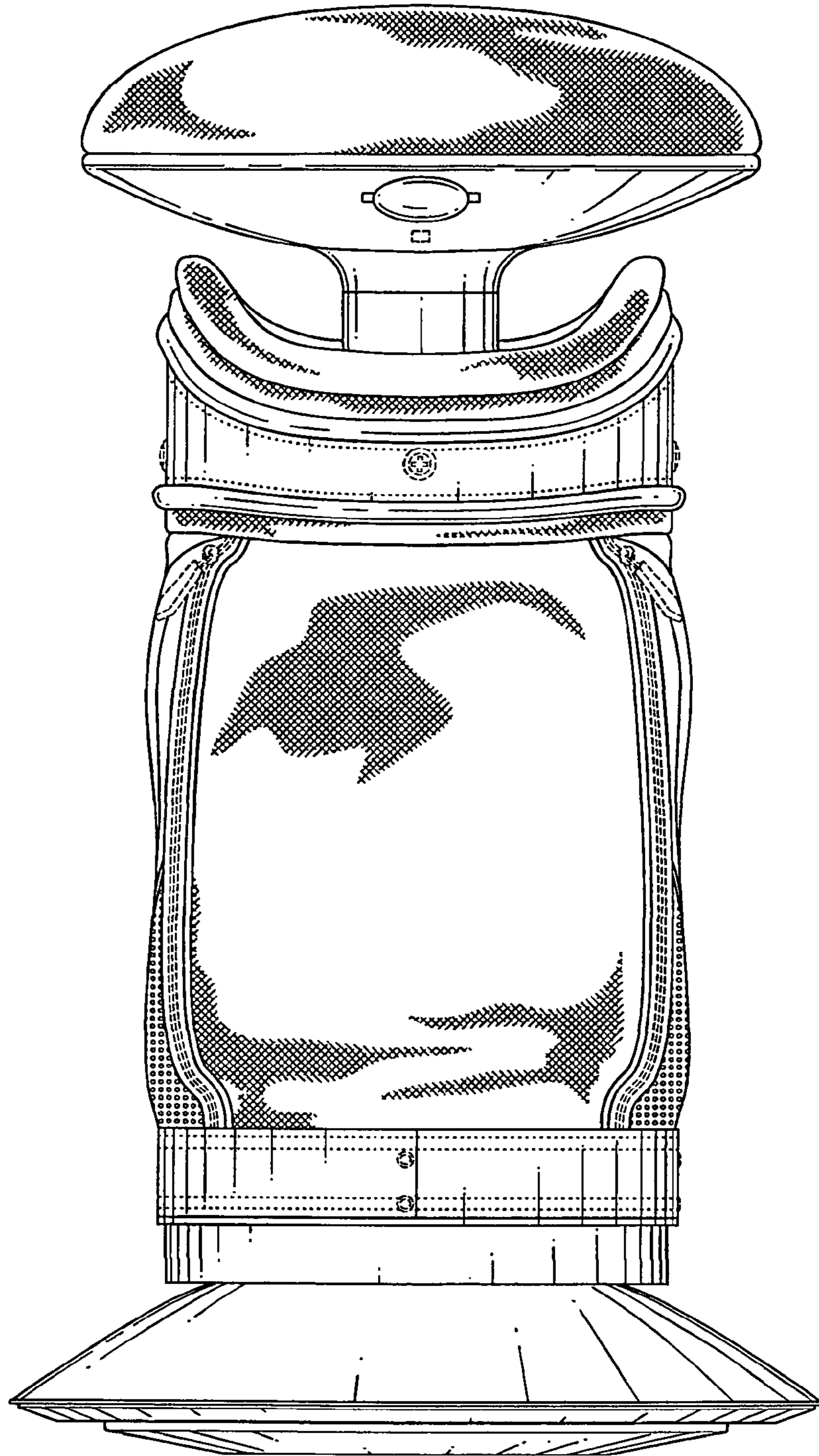

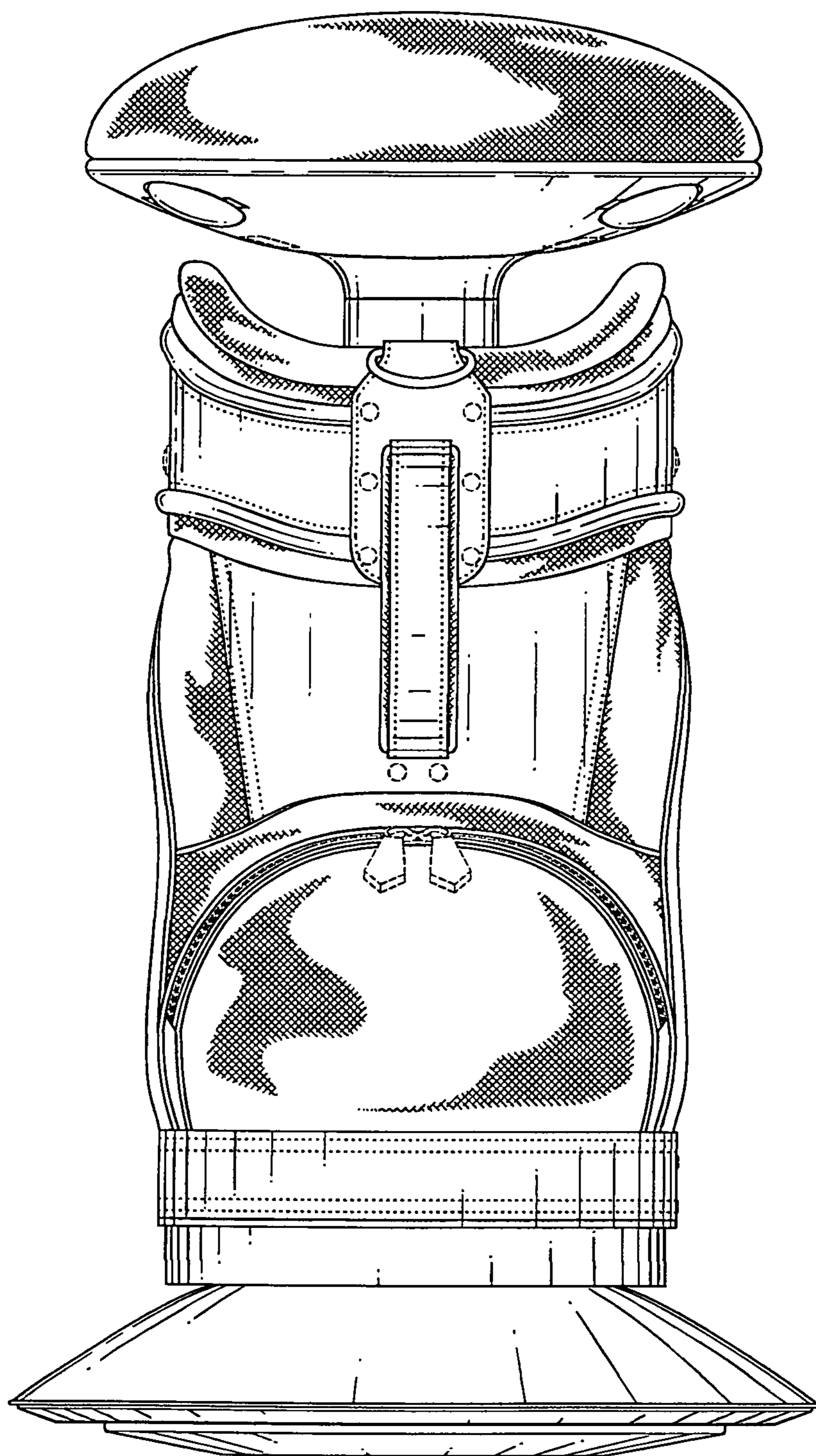

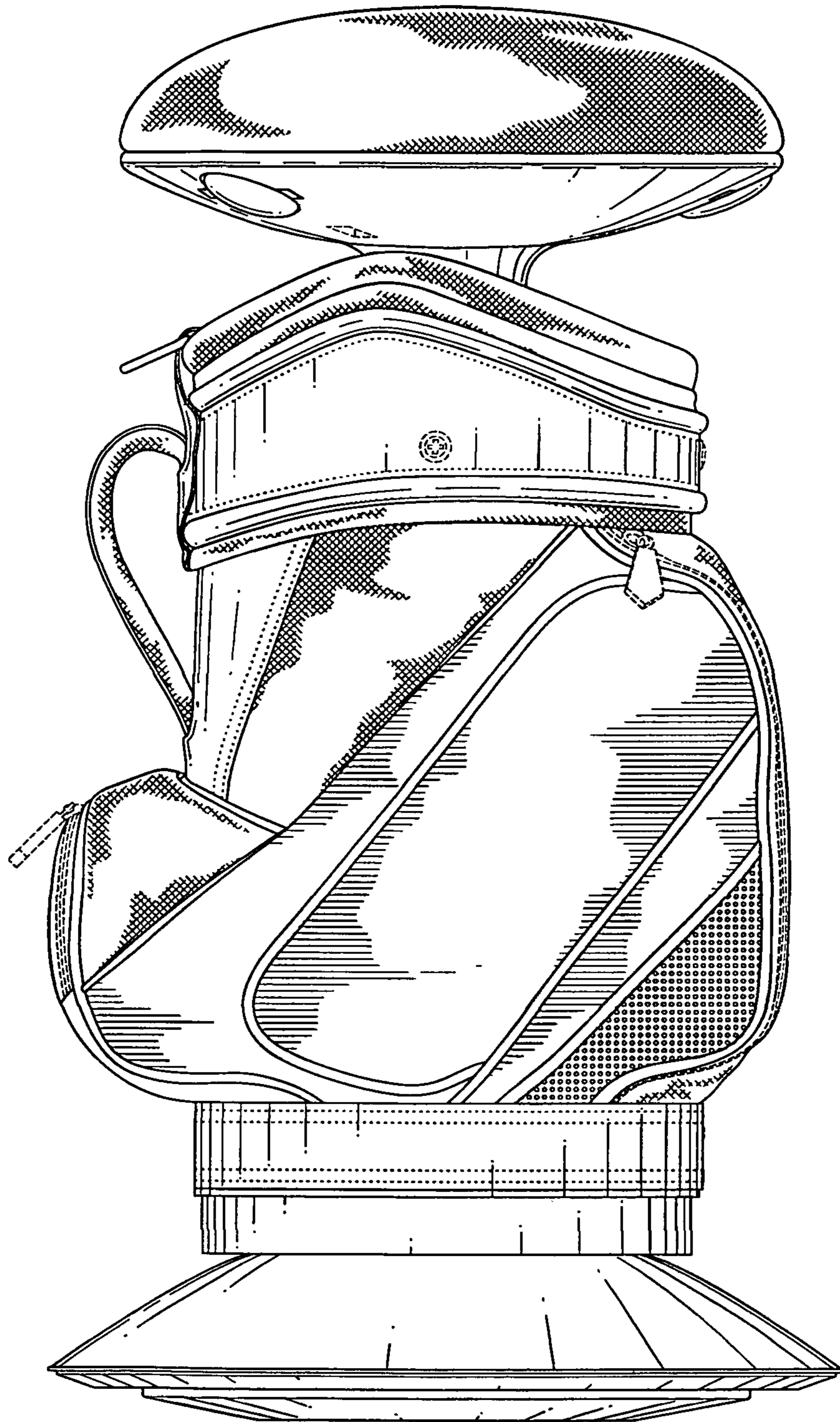

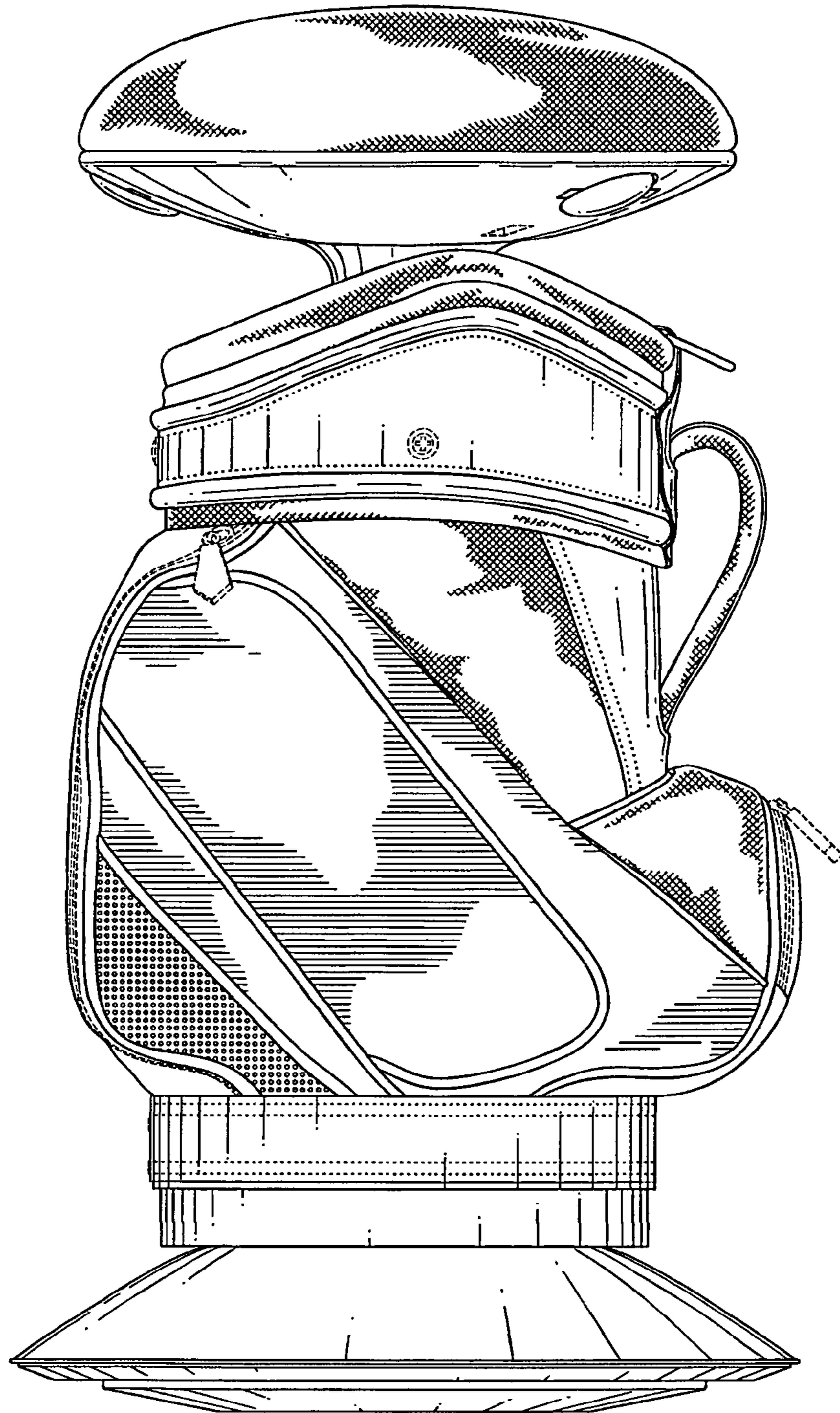

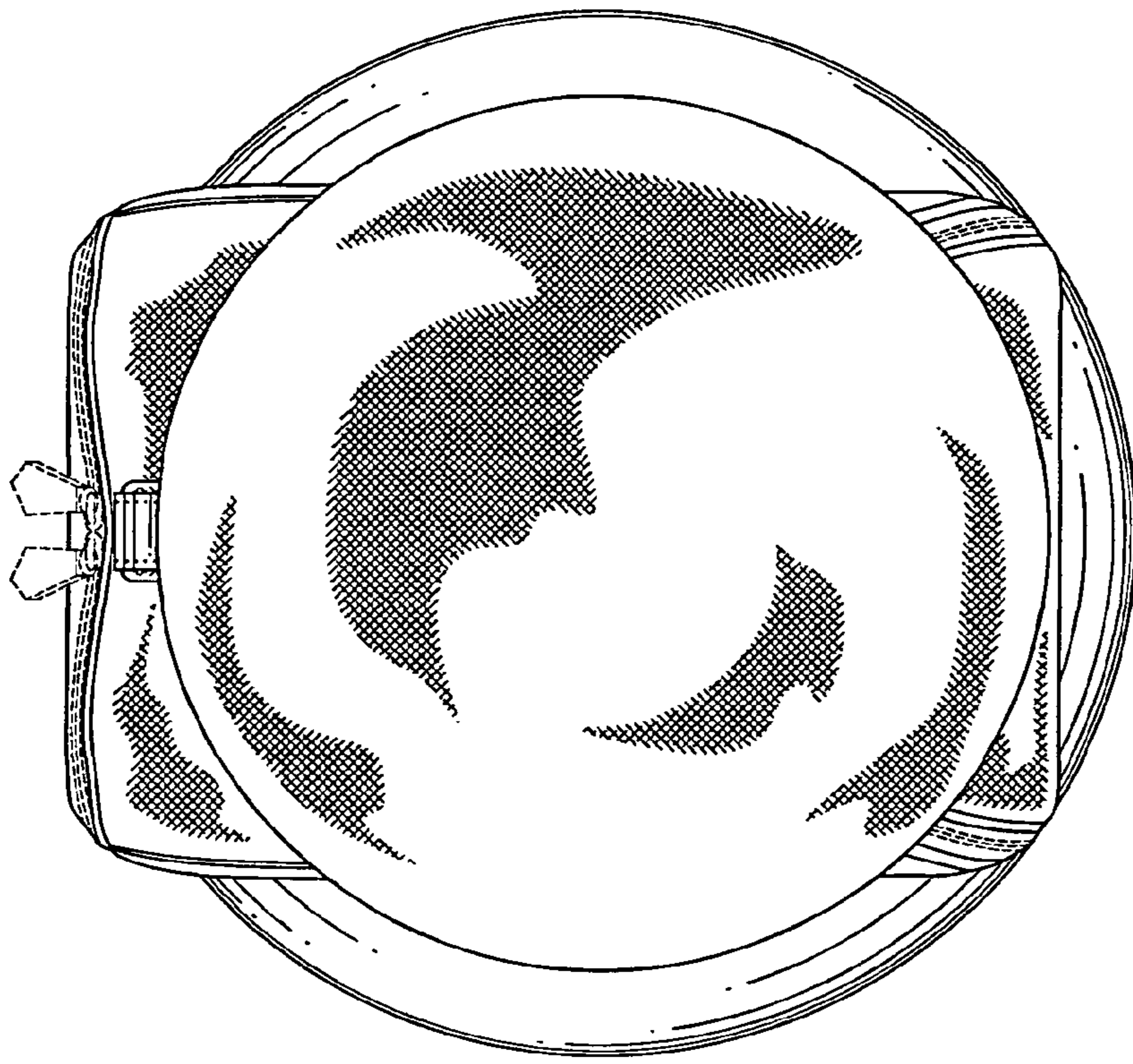

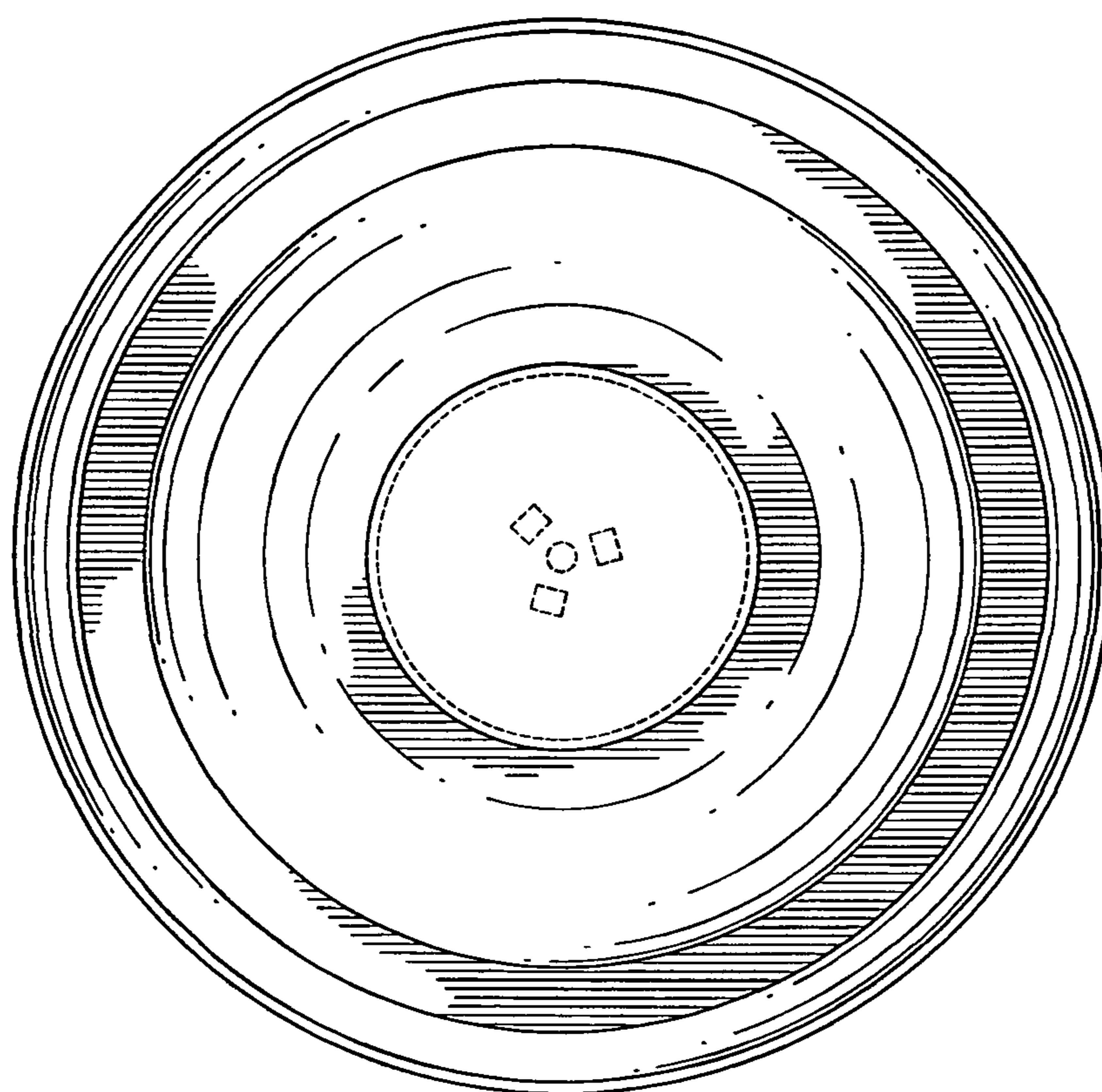
