FIG. 13 is a first side view of the second embodiment thereof;

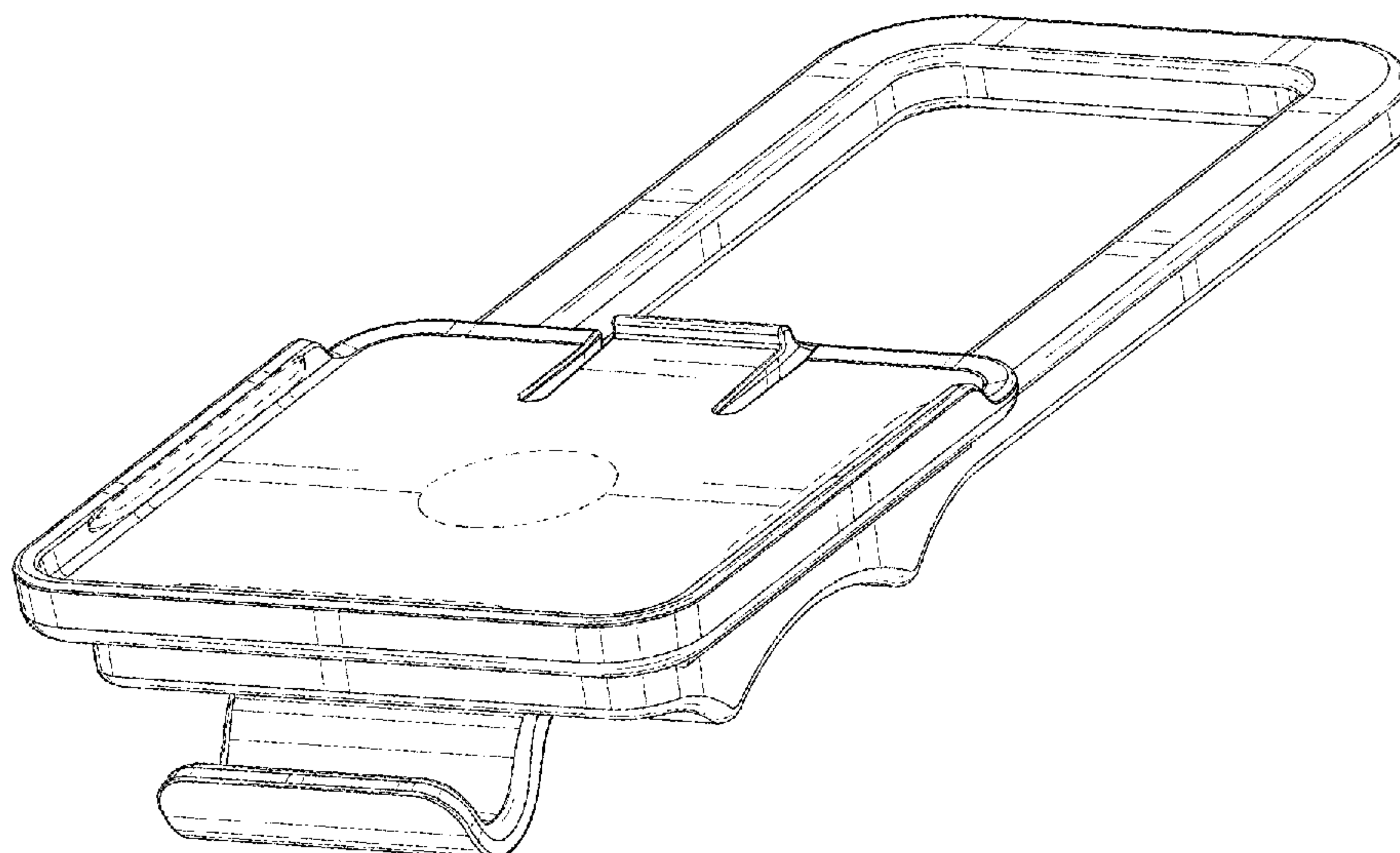
FIG. 14 is a second side view of the second embodiment

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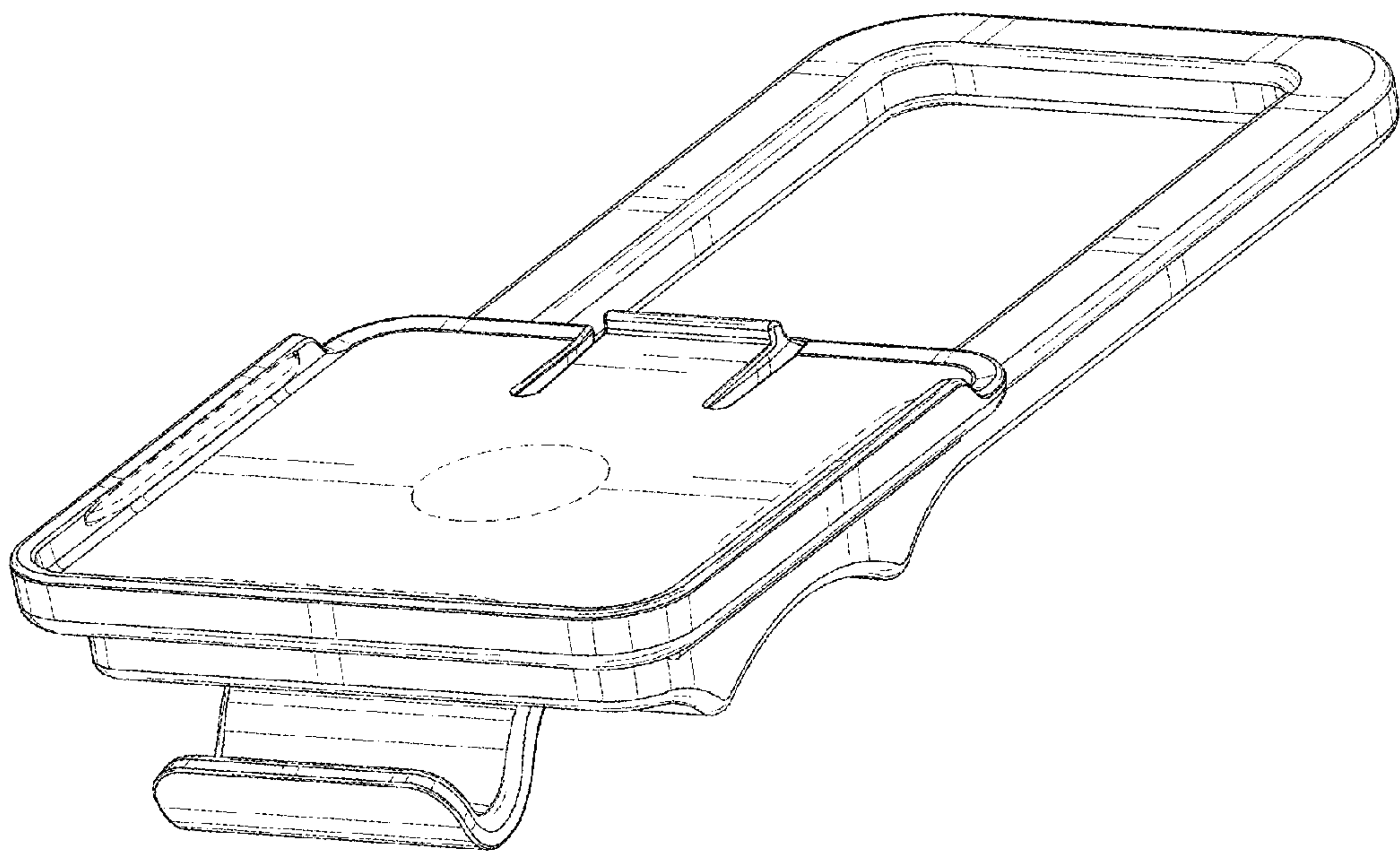

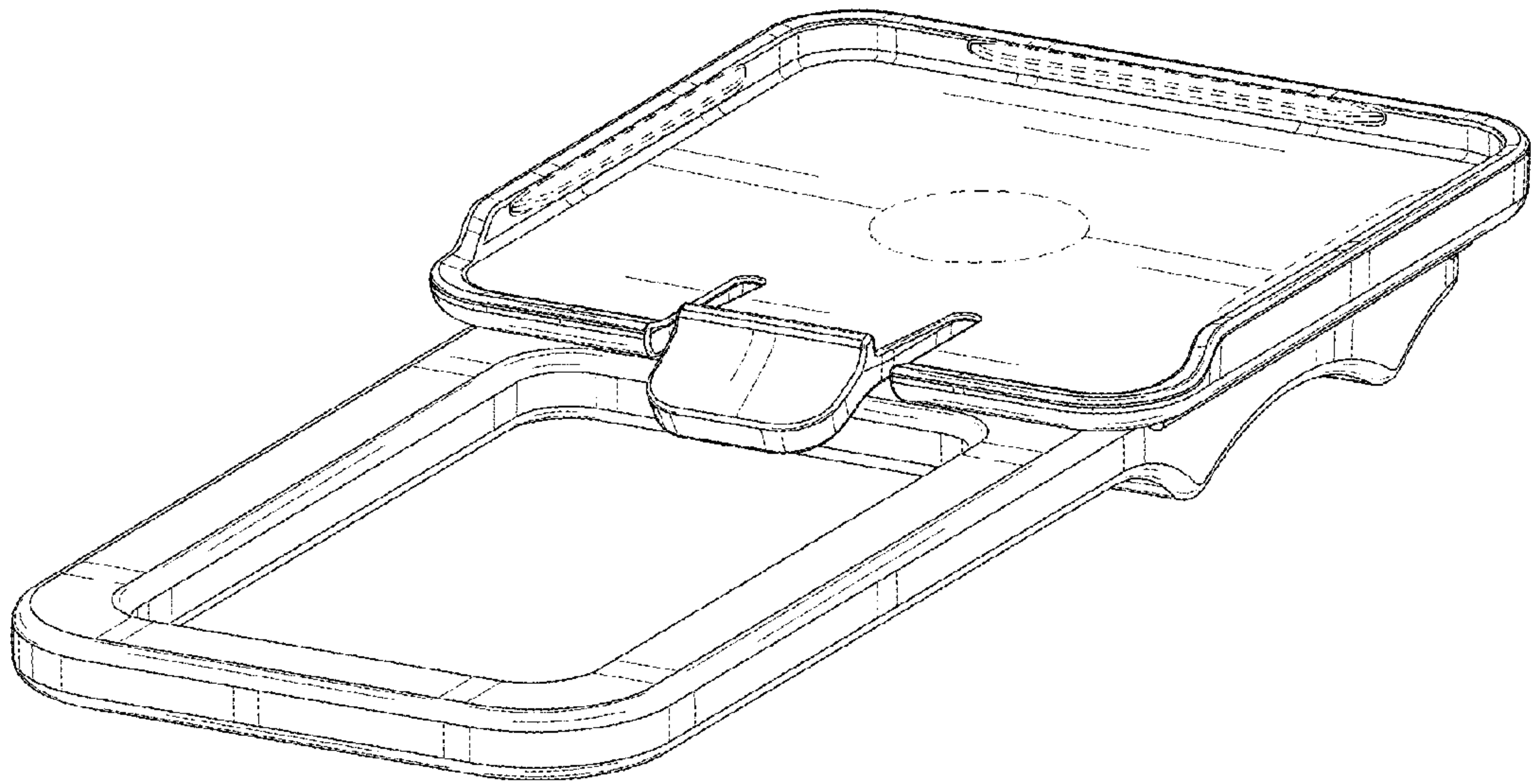

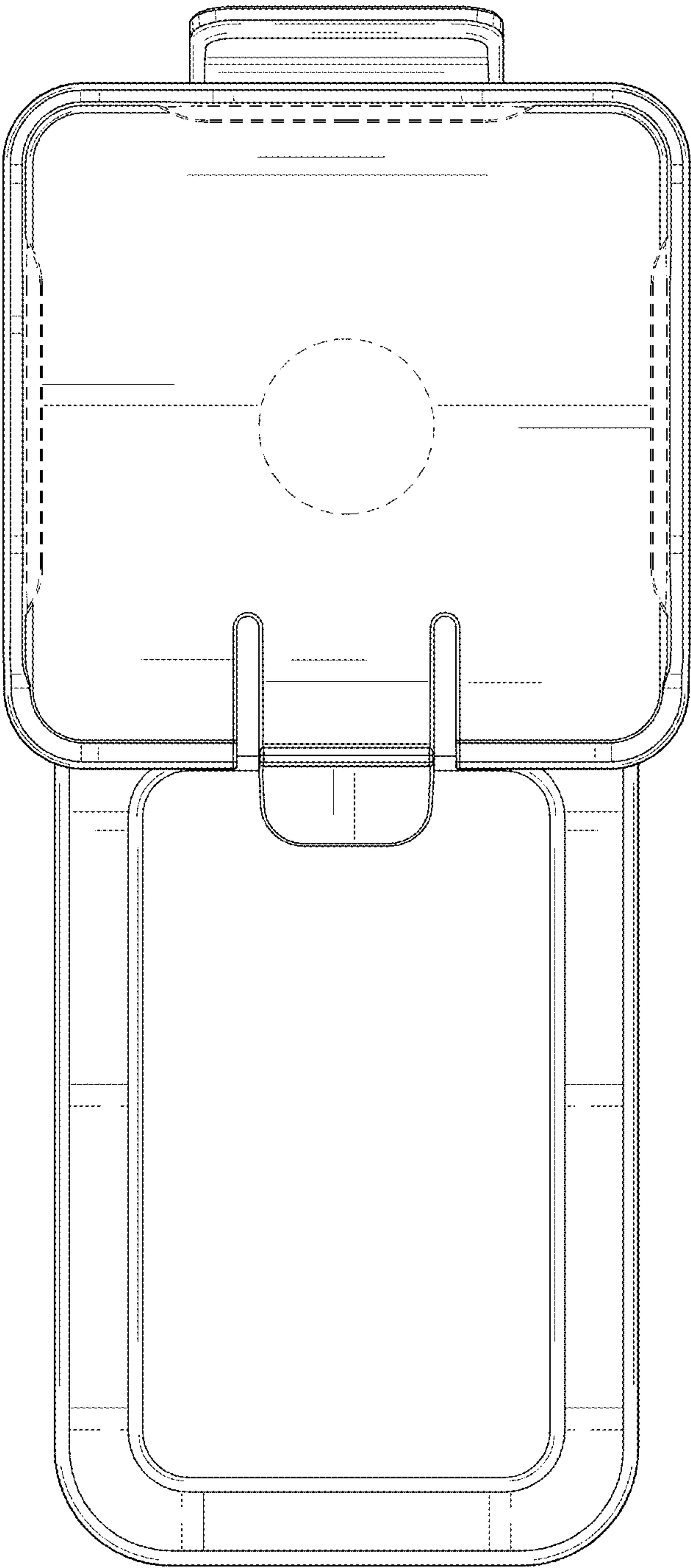

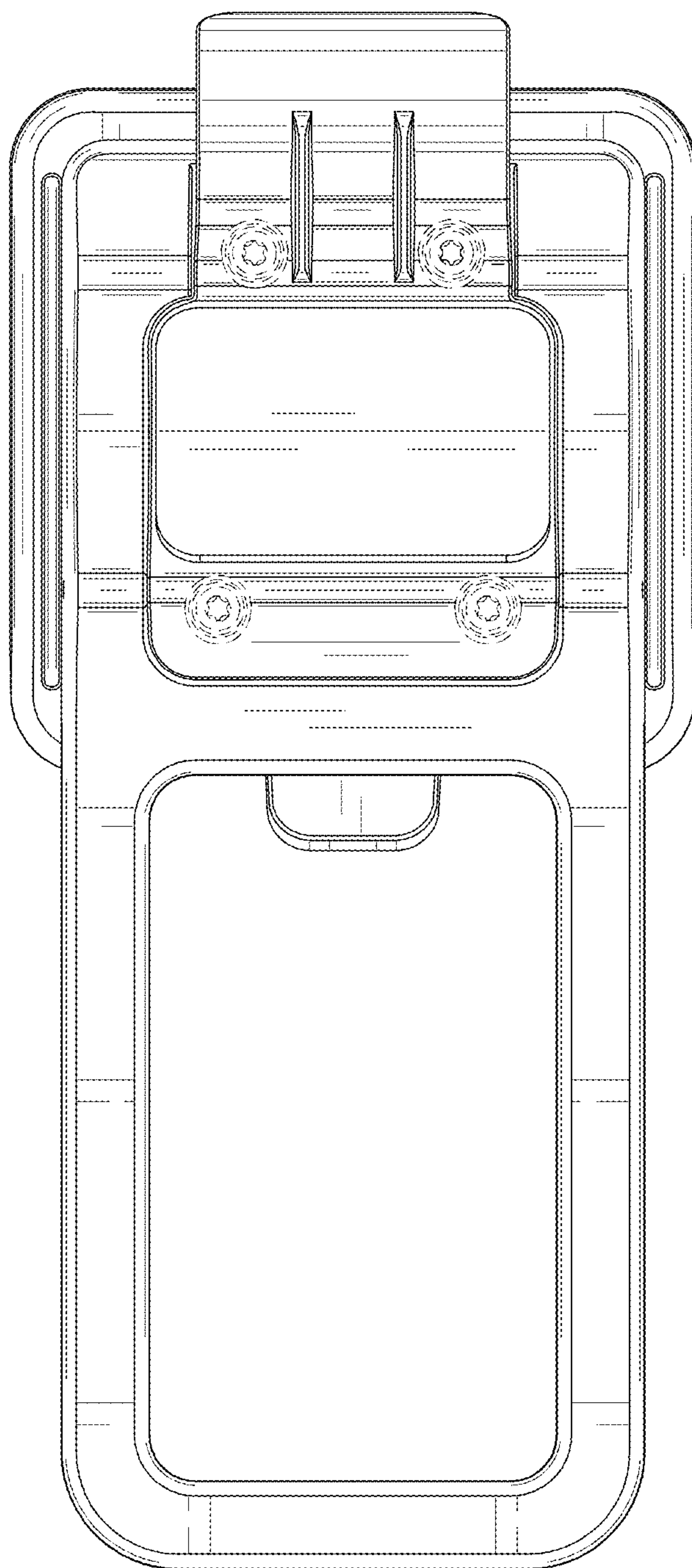

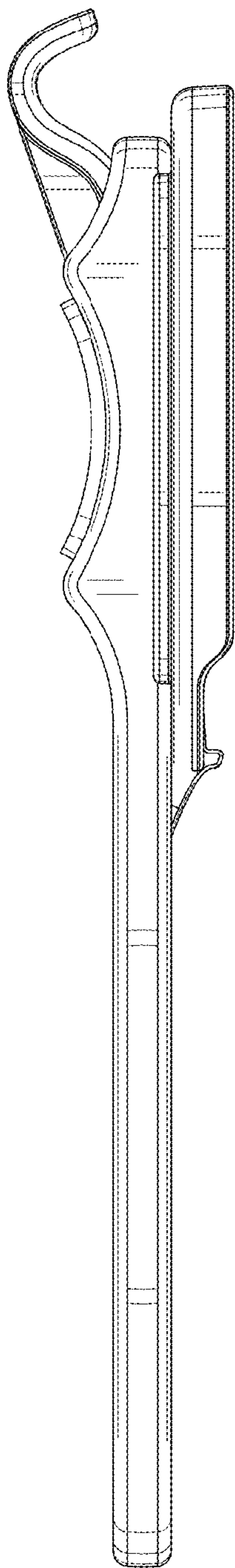

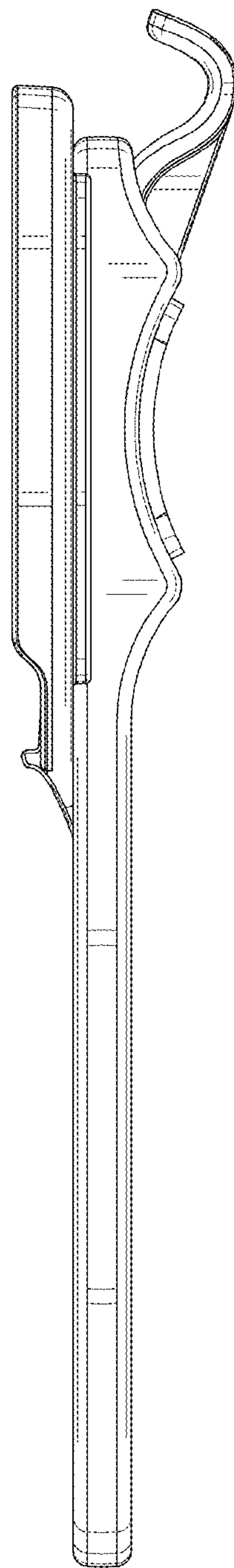

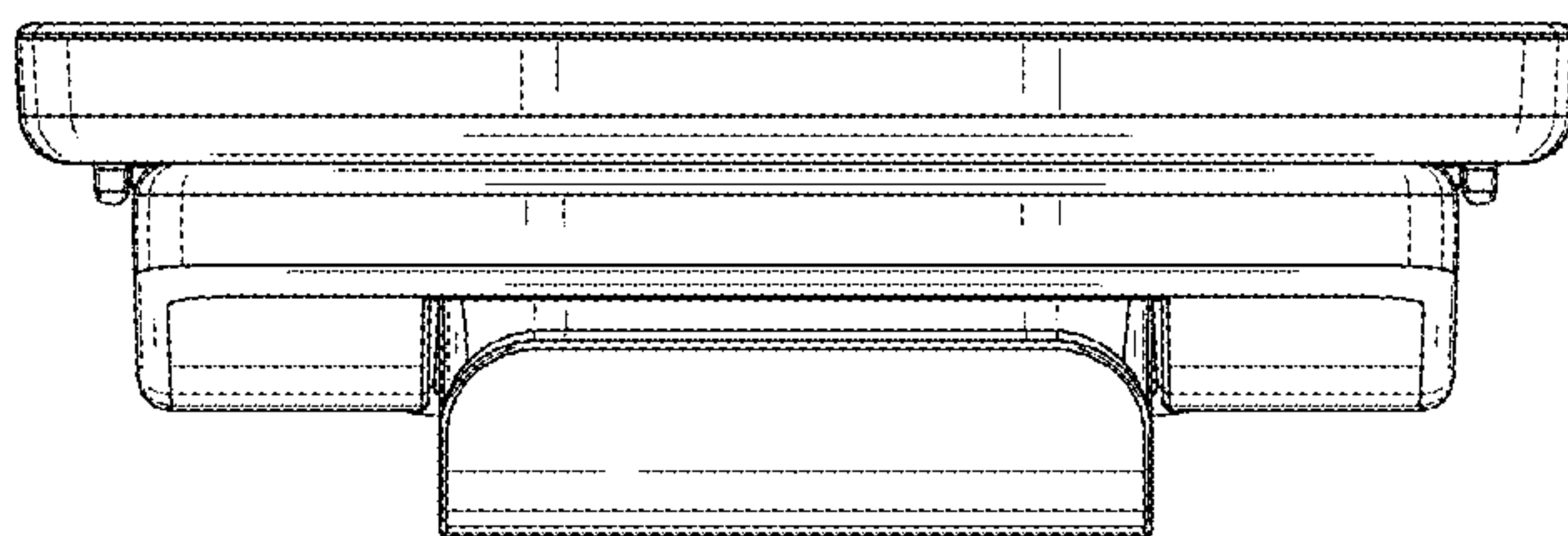

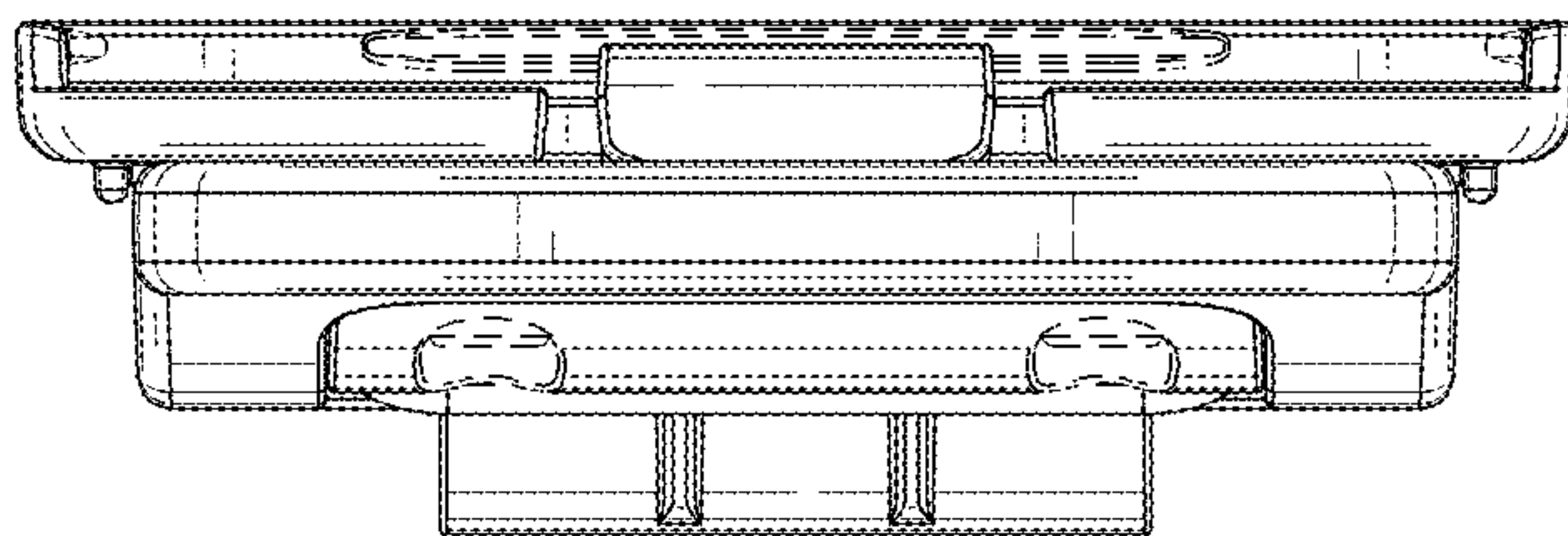

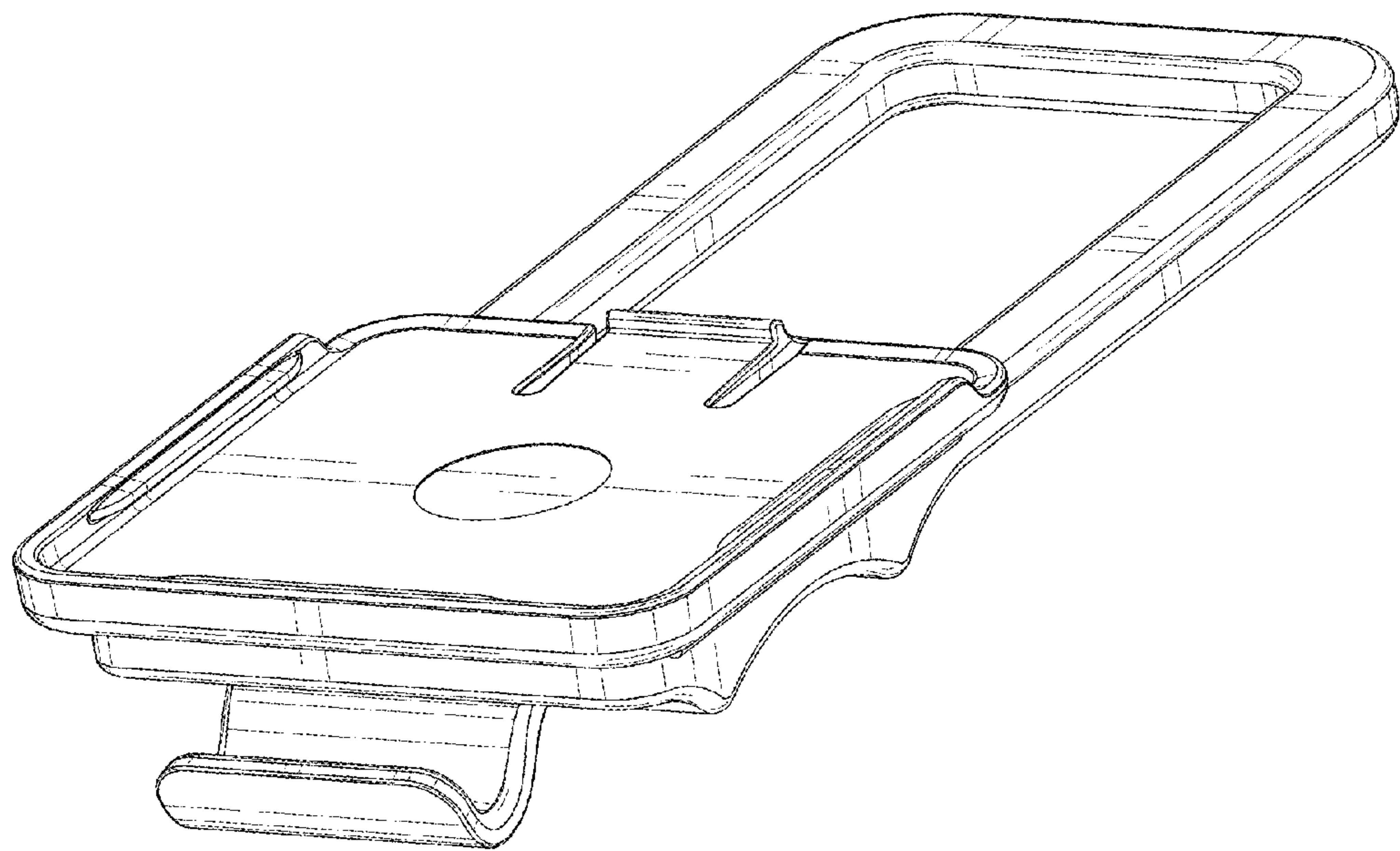

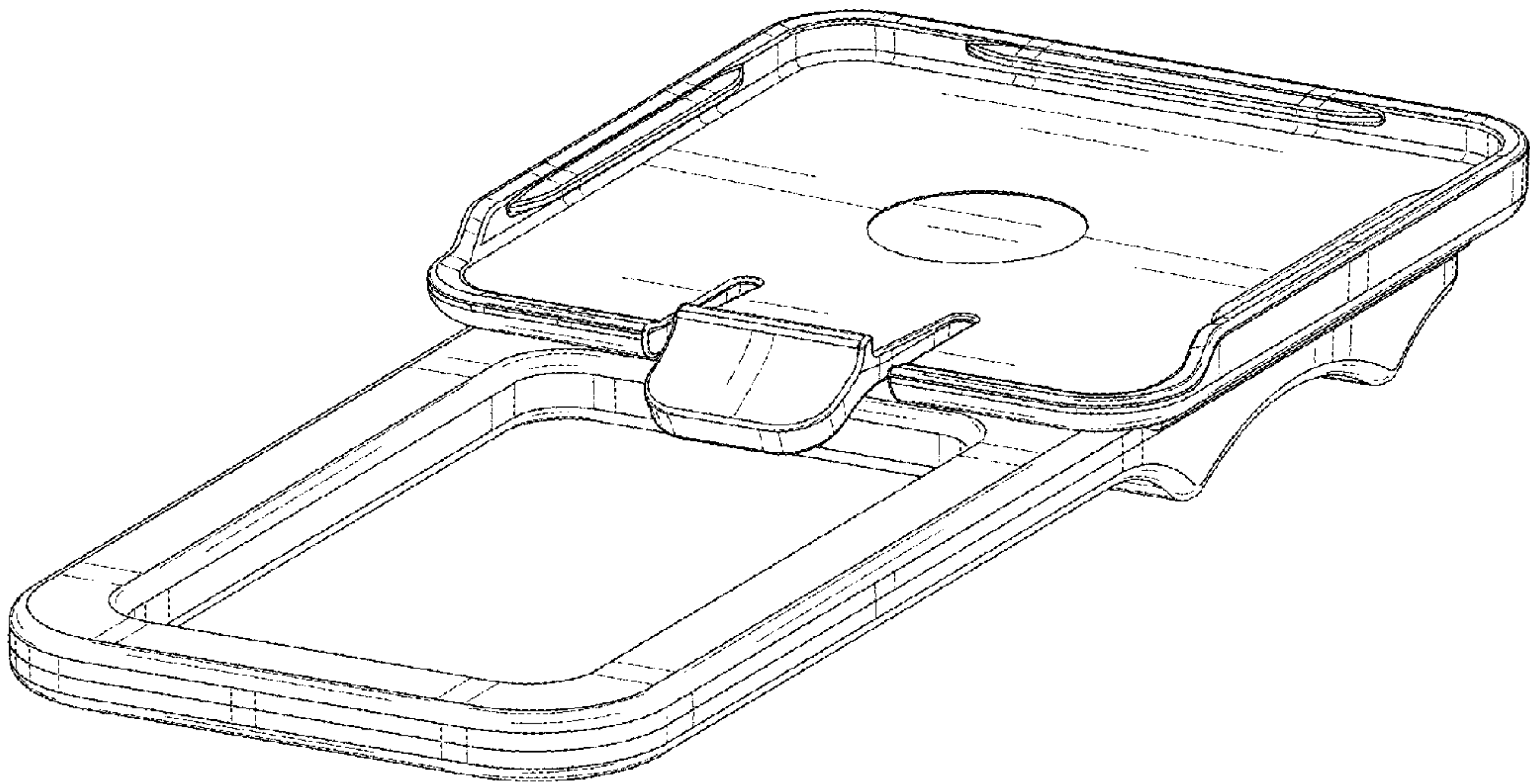

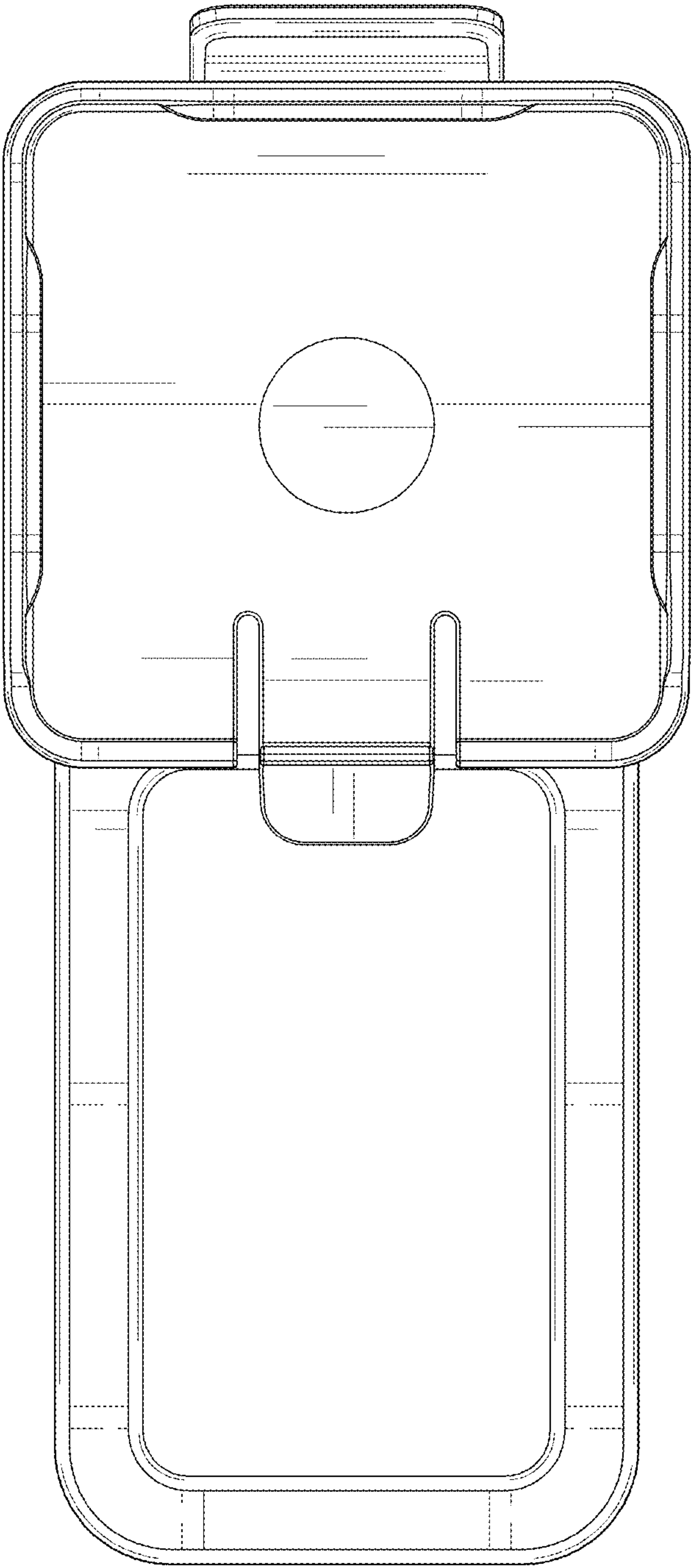

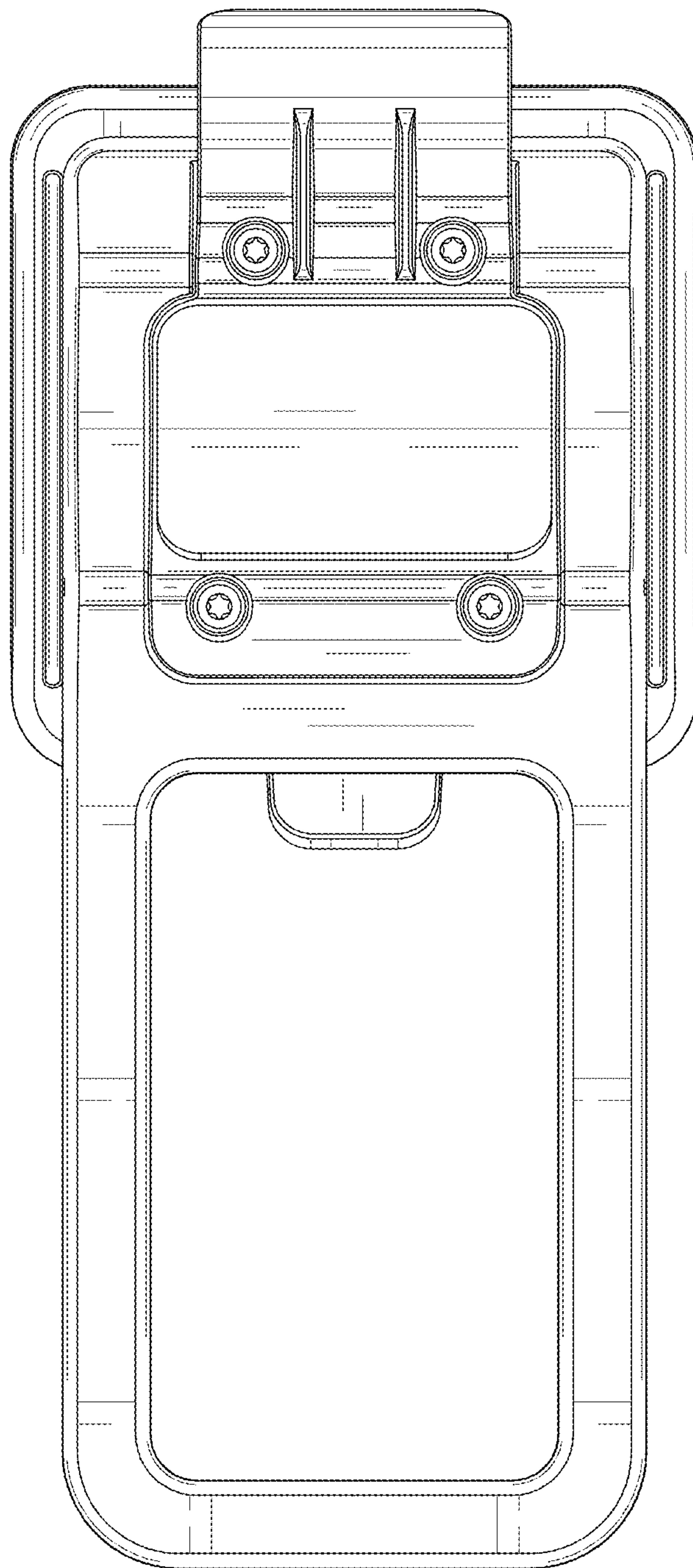

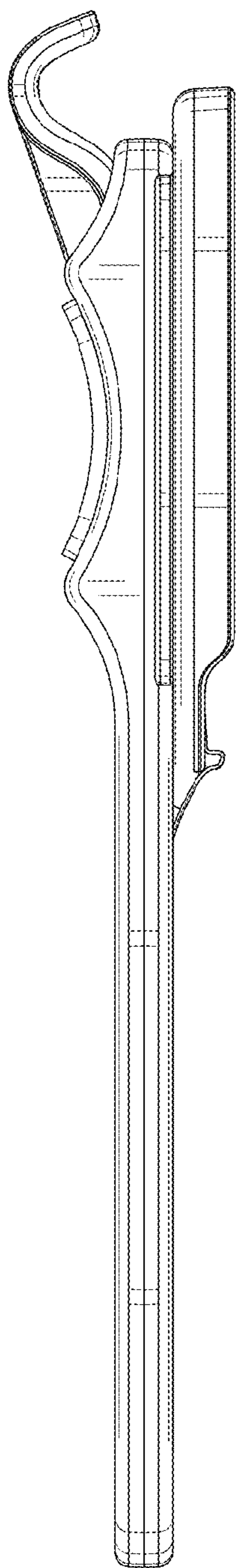

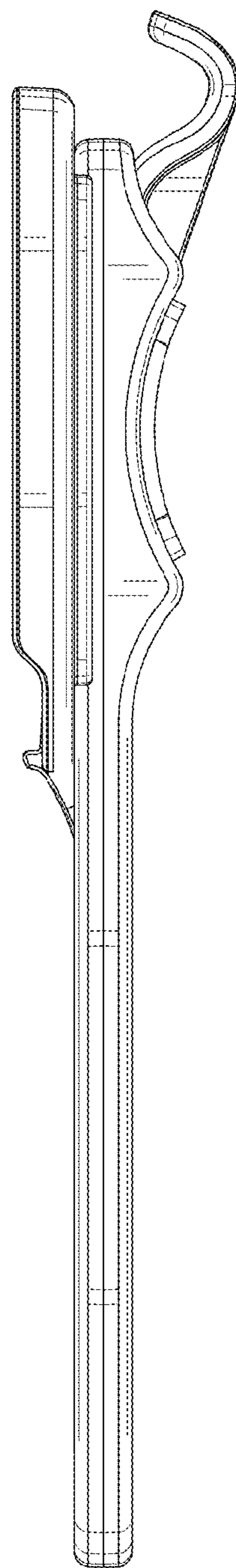

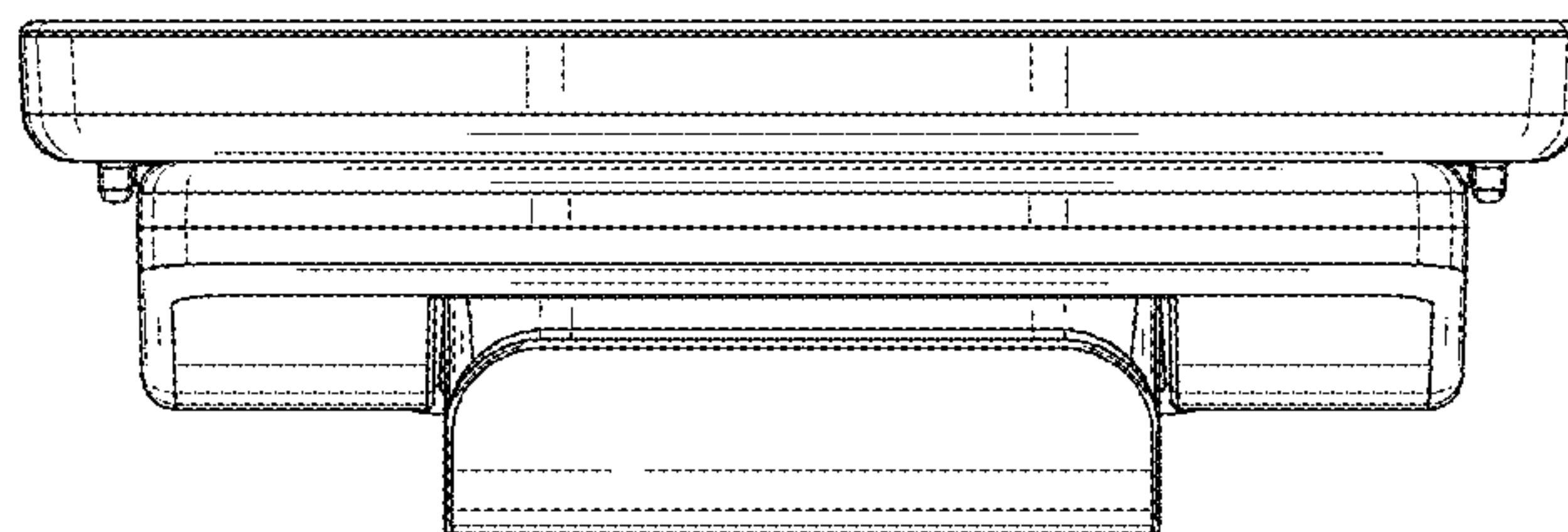

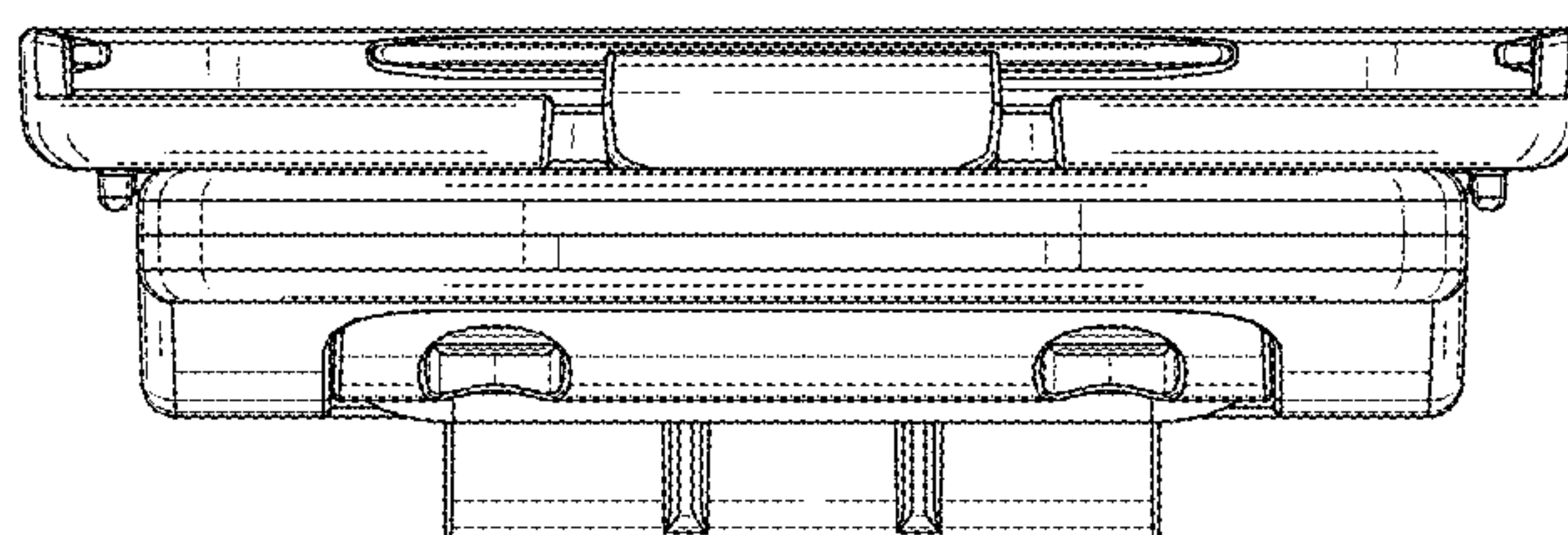
