(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a computer generated image for a
display panel or screen, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a first image of a computer
generated animated image for a display panel or screen show-
ing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of a second image of a
computer generated animated image for a display panel or
screen showing our new design;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of a third image of a com-
puter generated animated image for a display panel or screen
showing our new design; and,

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of a fourth image of a
computer generated animated image for a display panel or
screen showing our new design.

The appearance of the transitional image transitions sequen-
tially between FIGS. 1 and 2, FIGS. 1 and 3, FIGS. 1 and 4,
FIGS. 2 and 3, FIGS. 2 and 4, and FIGS. 3 and 4. The process

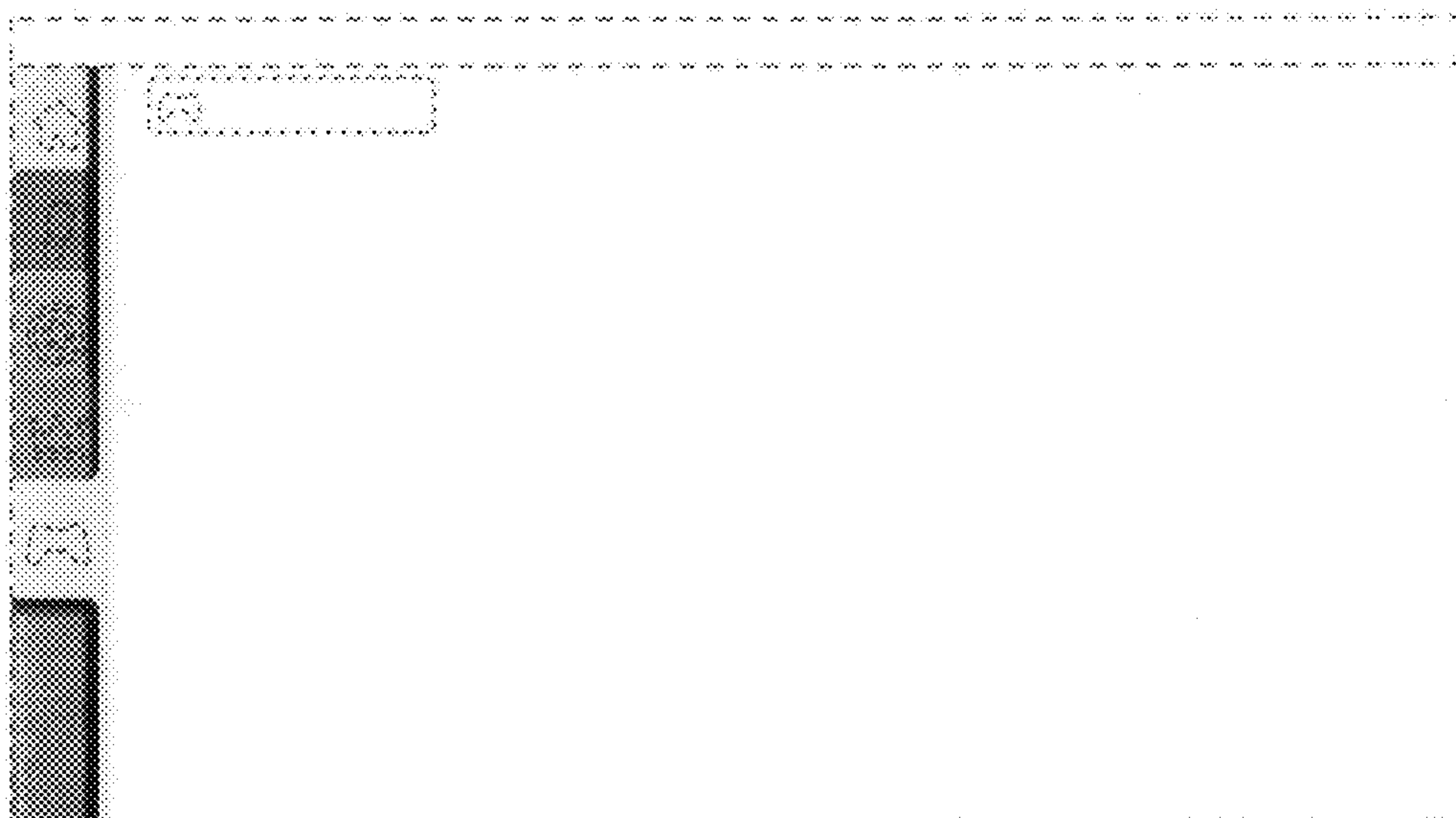

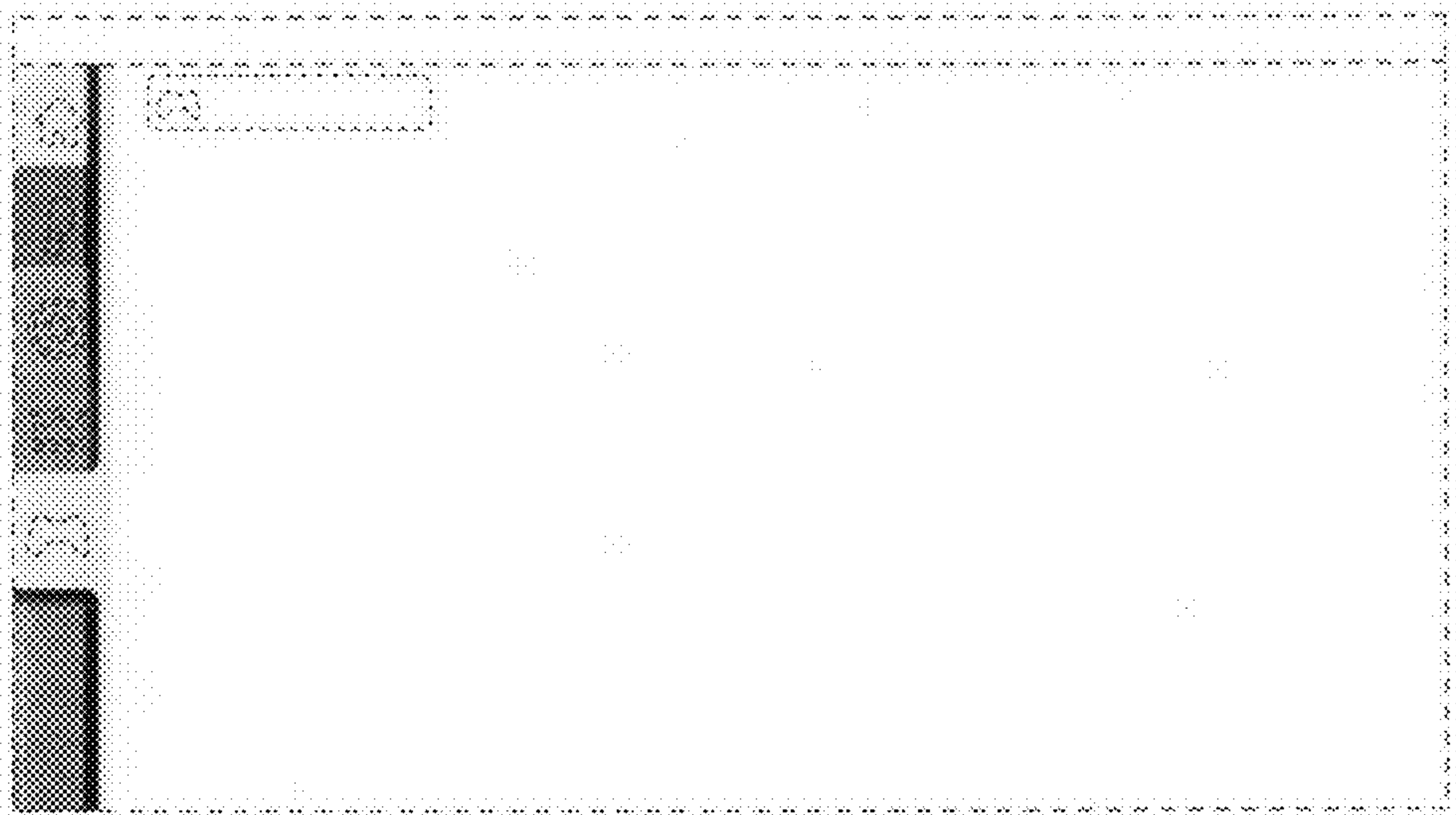
