The ornamental design for the shoe sole, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a shoe sole showing the new design.

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof.

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof.

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof.

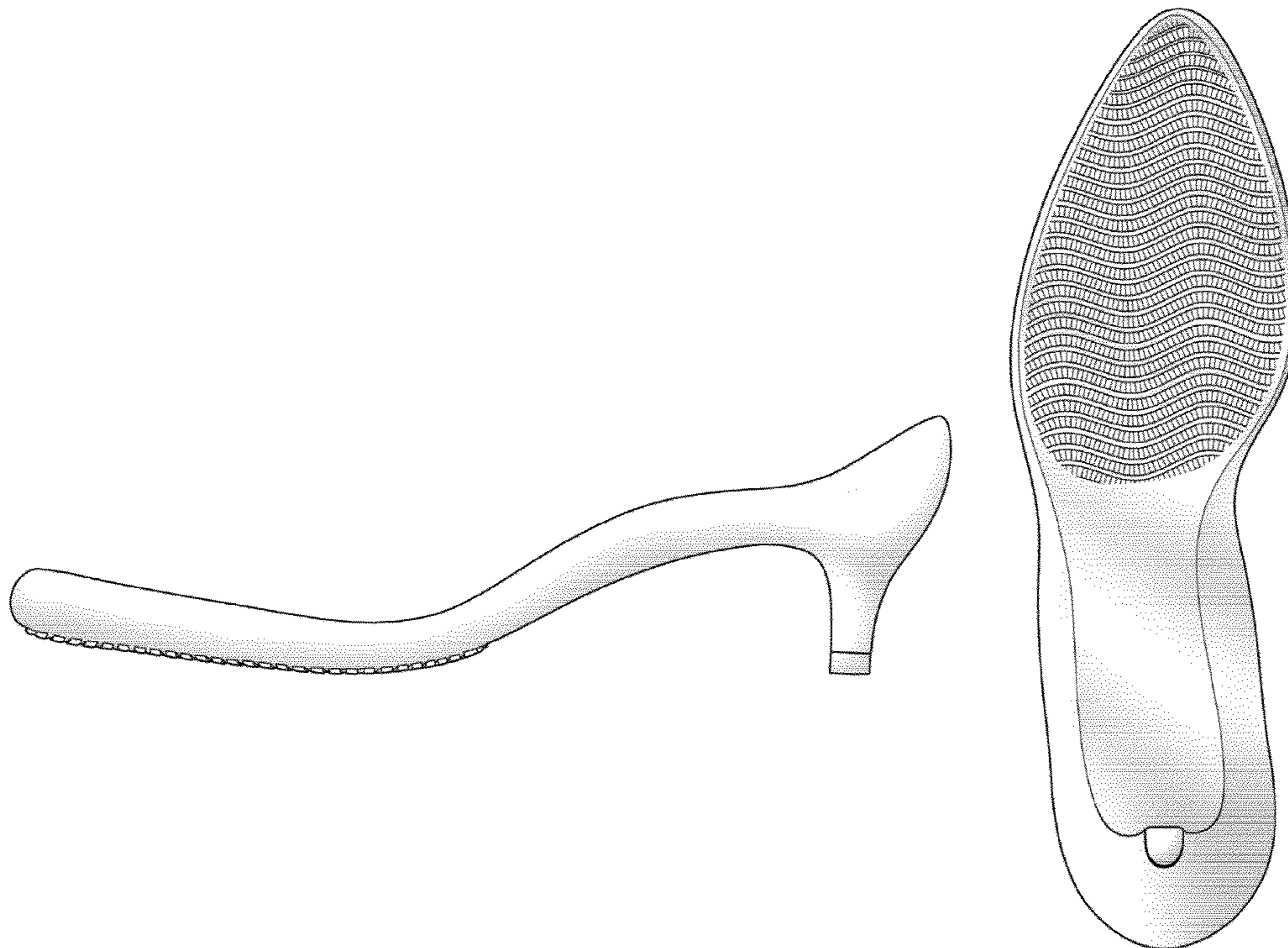
FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof.

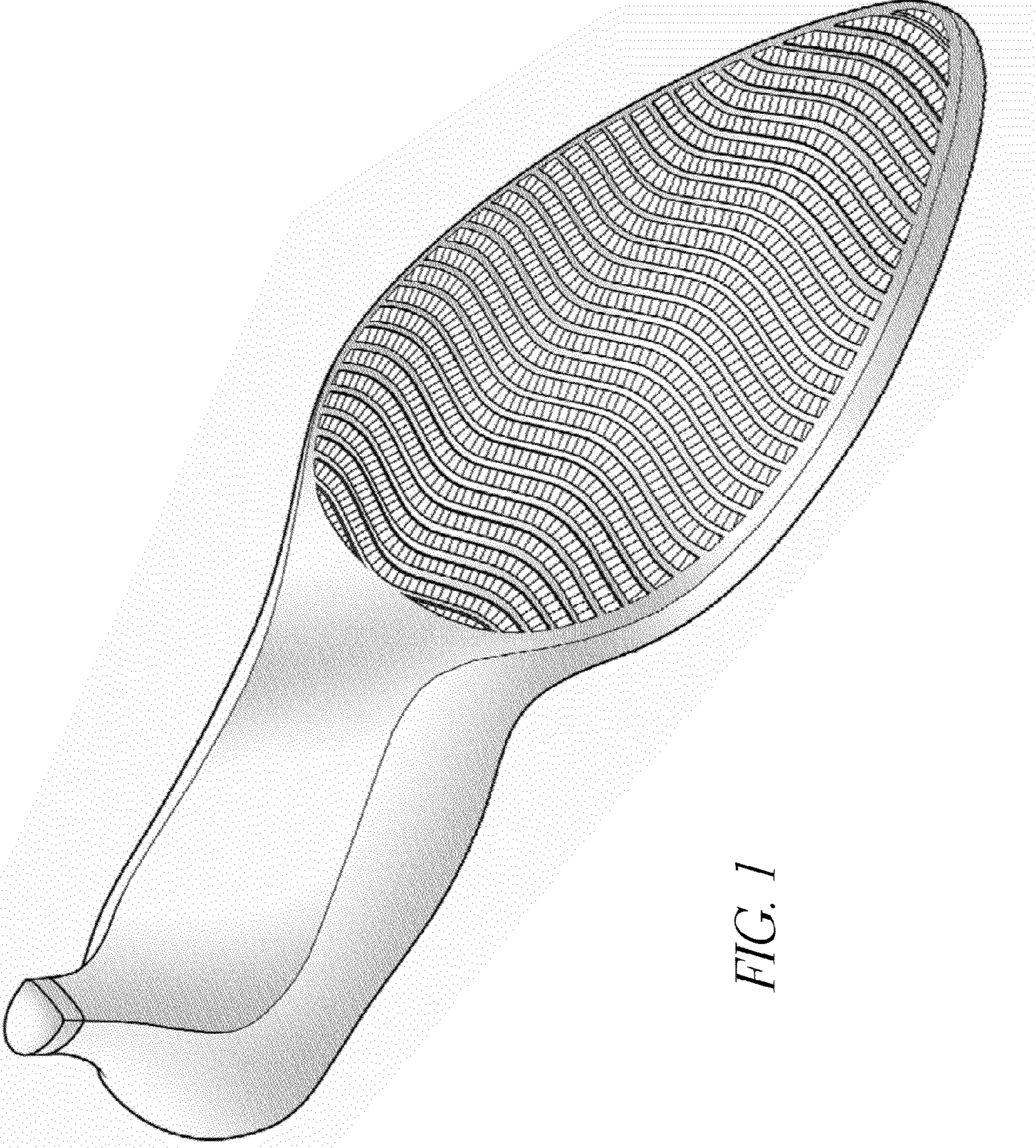

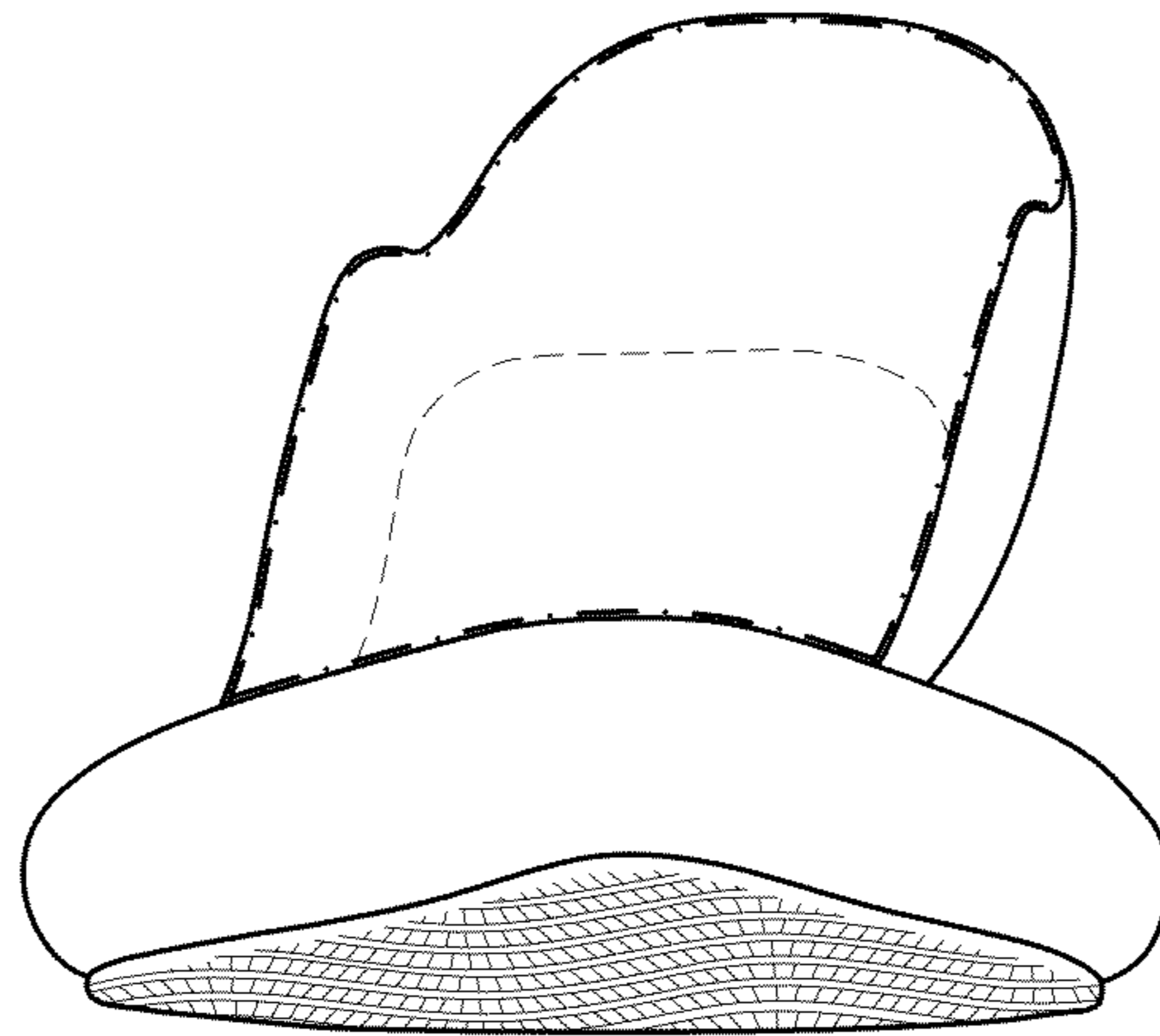

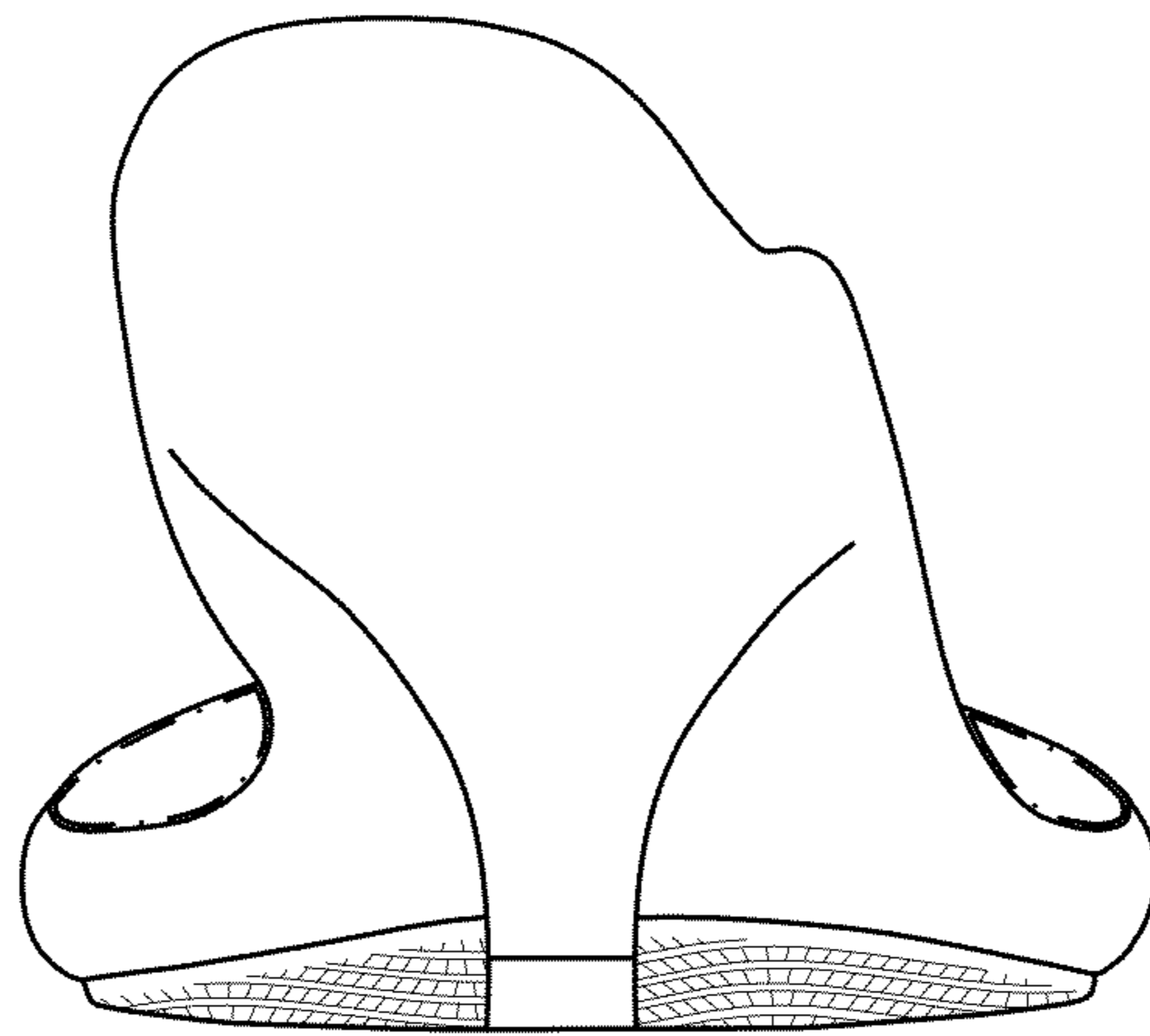

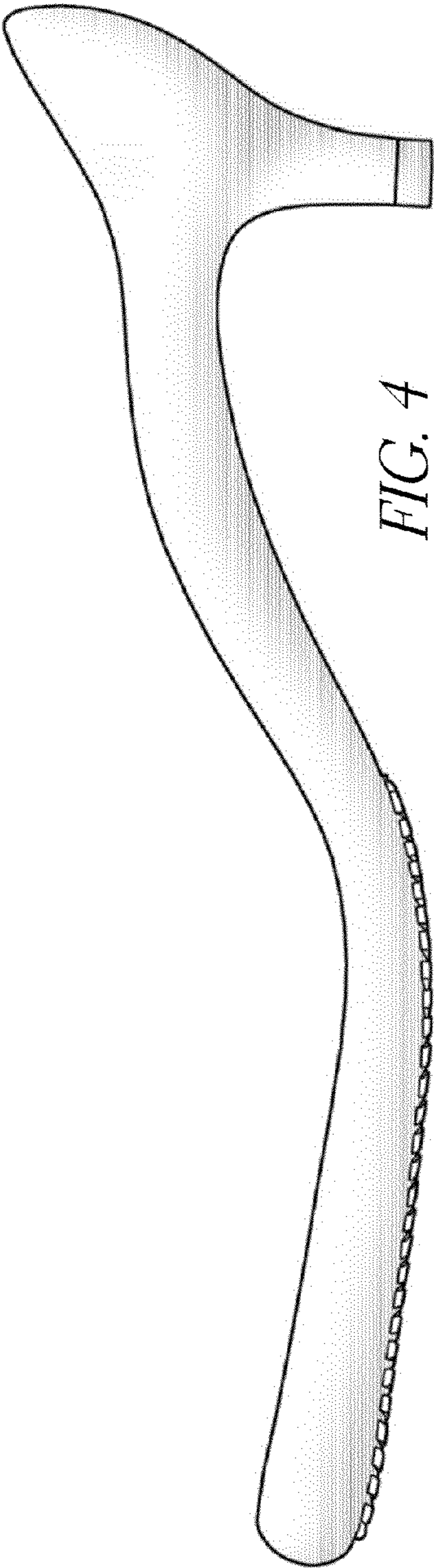

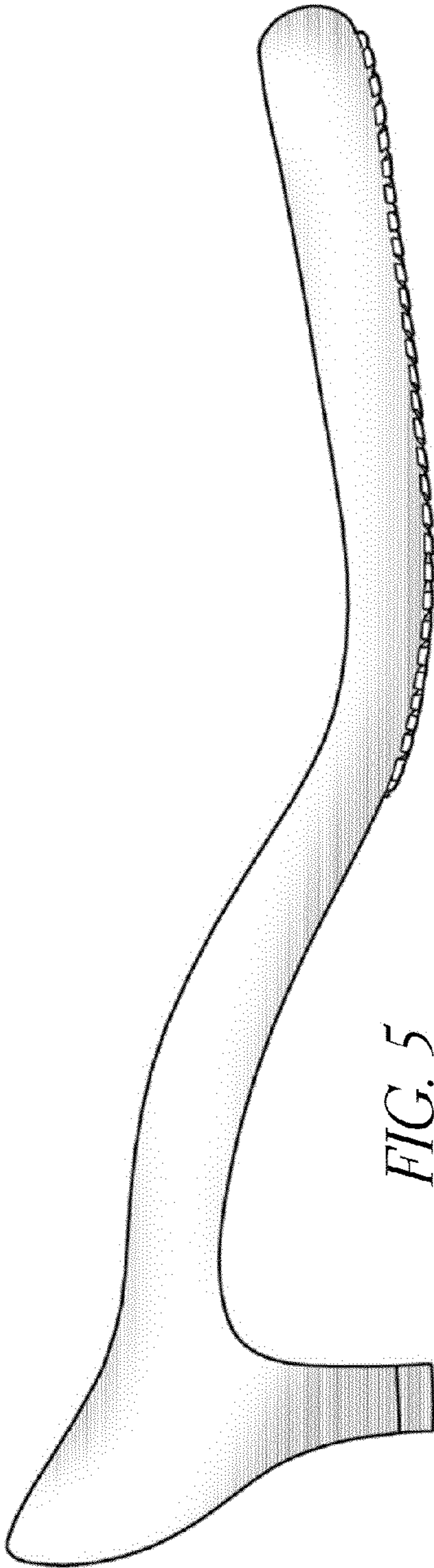

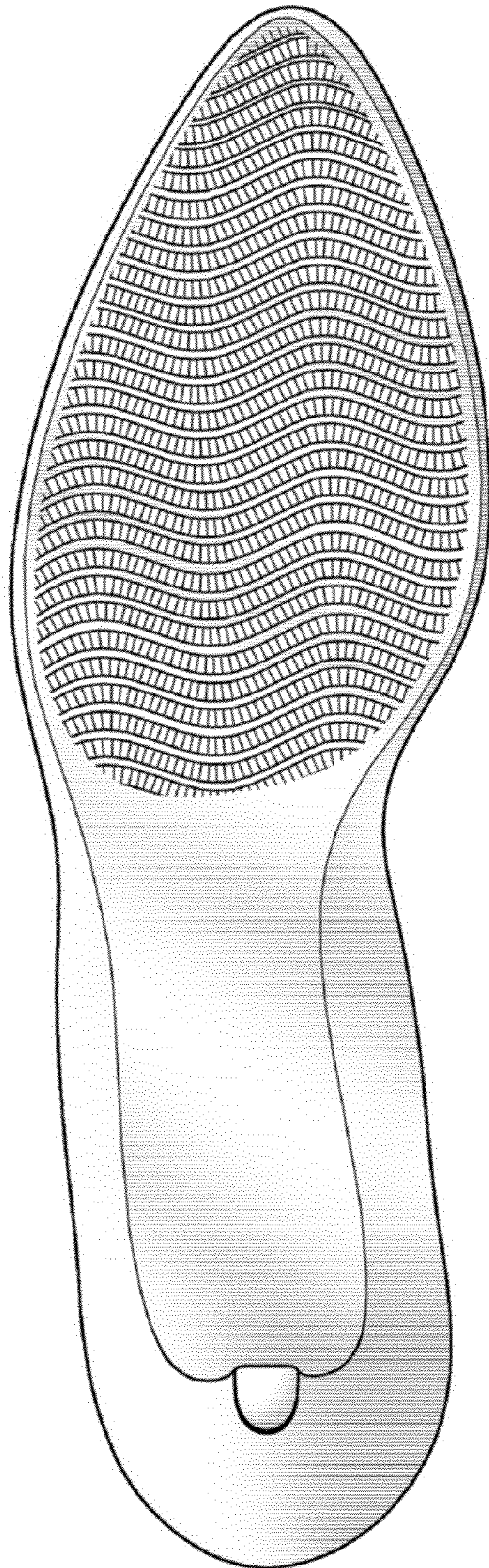

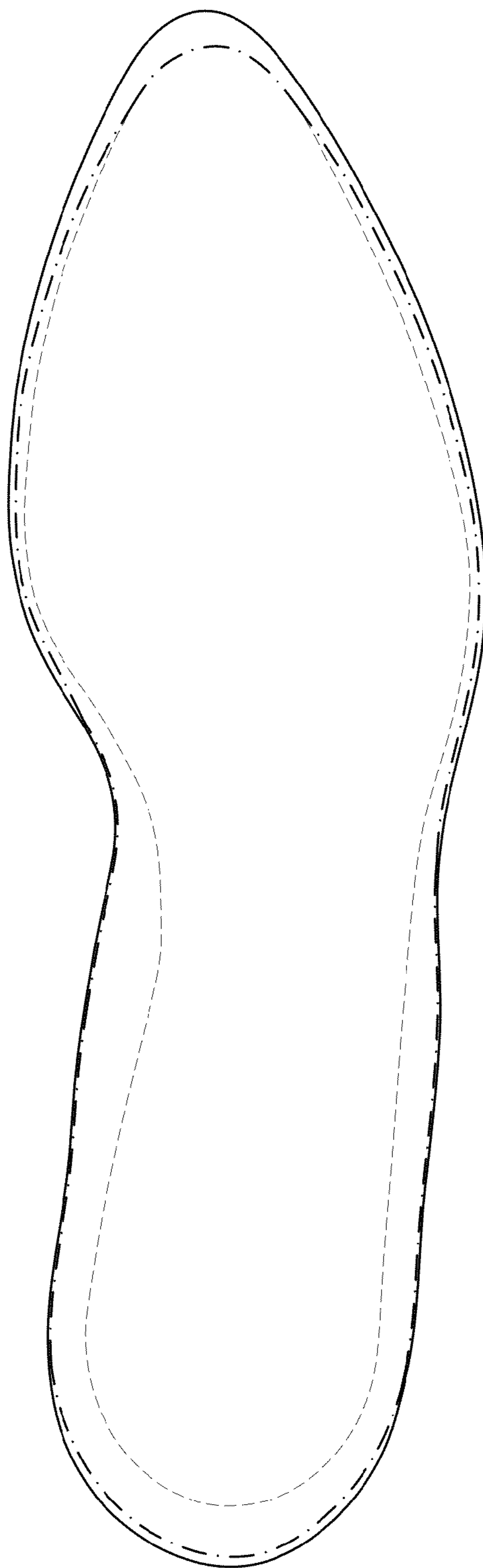
