The ornamental design for a washing machine hose, as shown and described.

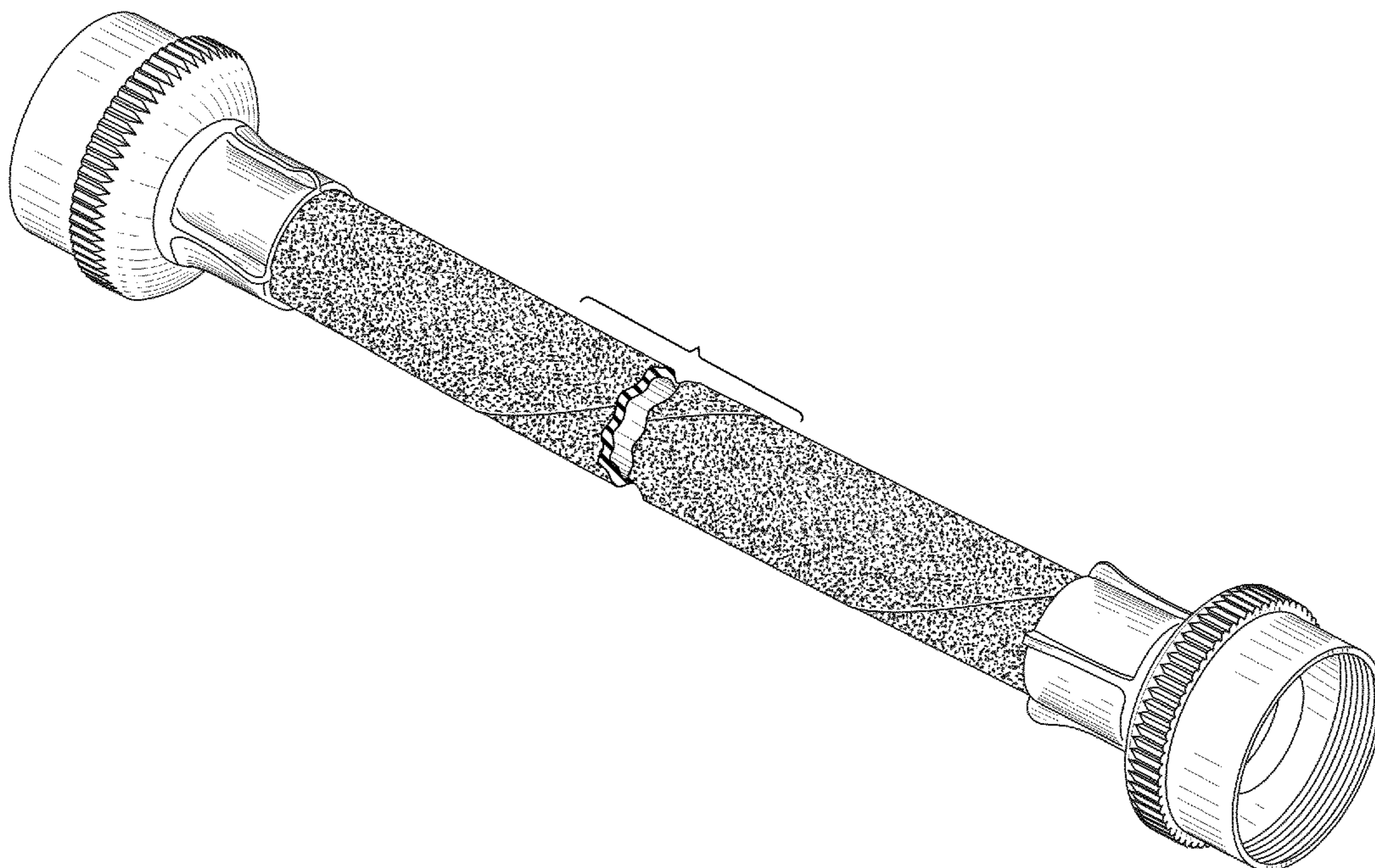
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a washing machine hose according to the present invention;  
FIG. 2 is a top view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a left side view thereof; the right side view being a mirror image thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a front view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a rear view thereof; and,  
FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof.

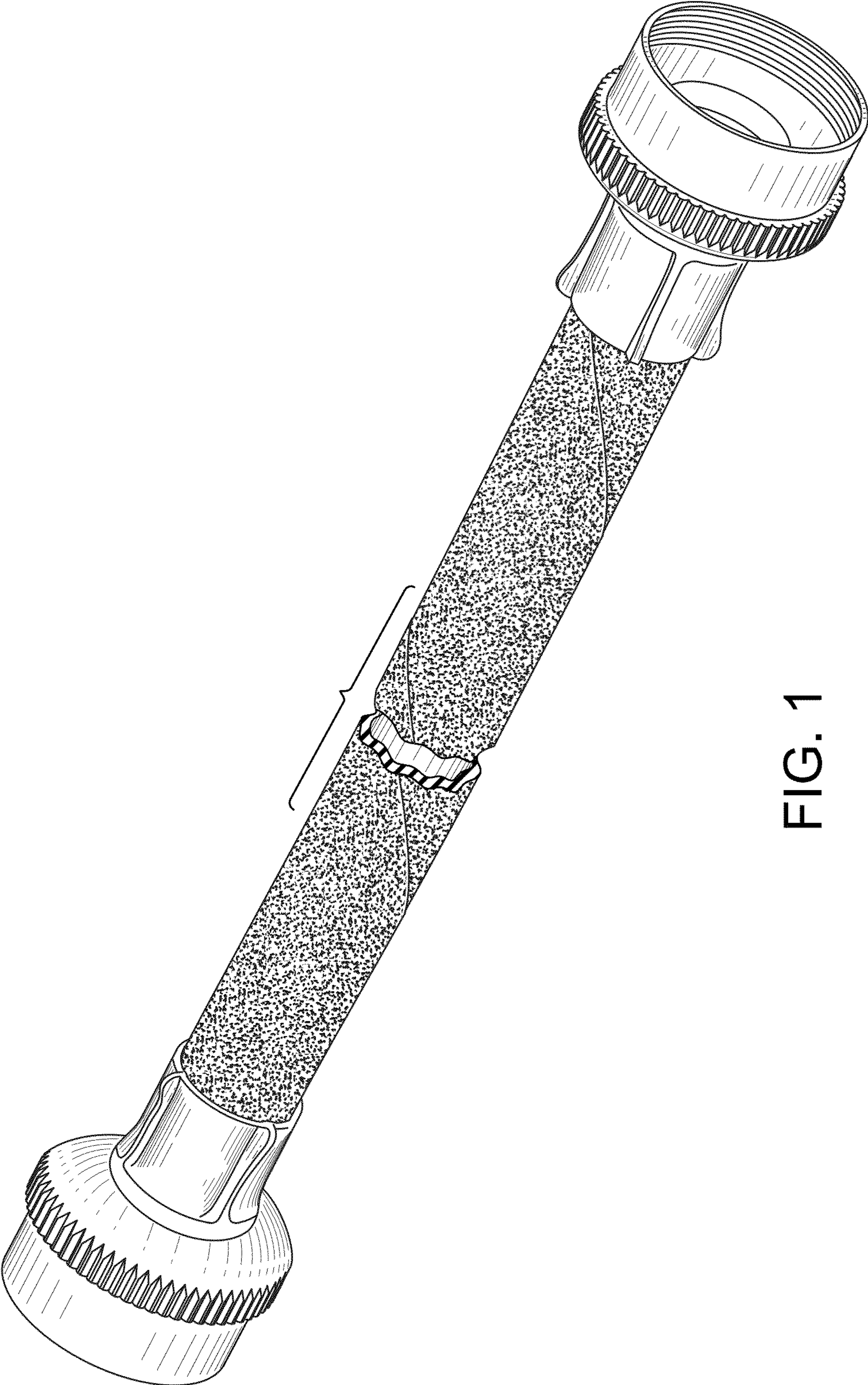

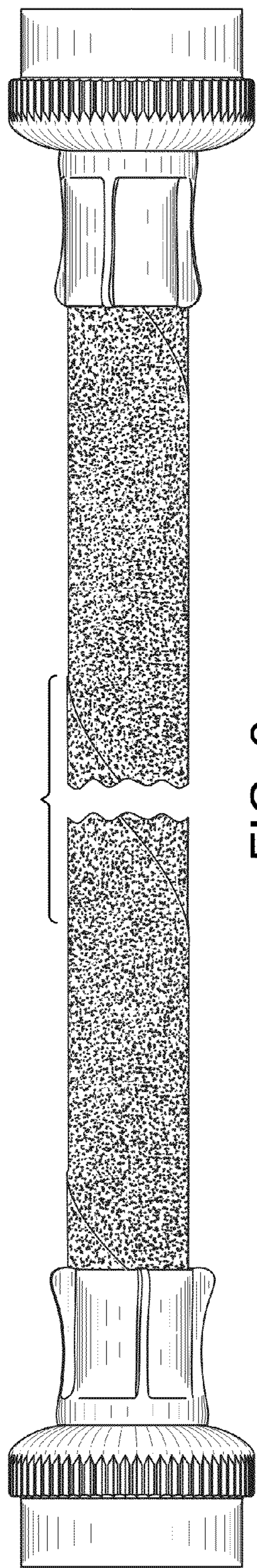

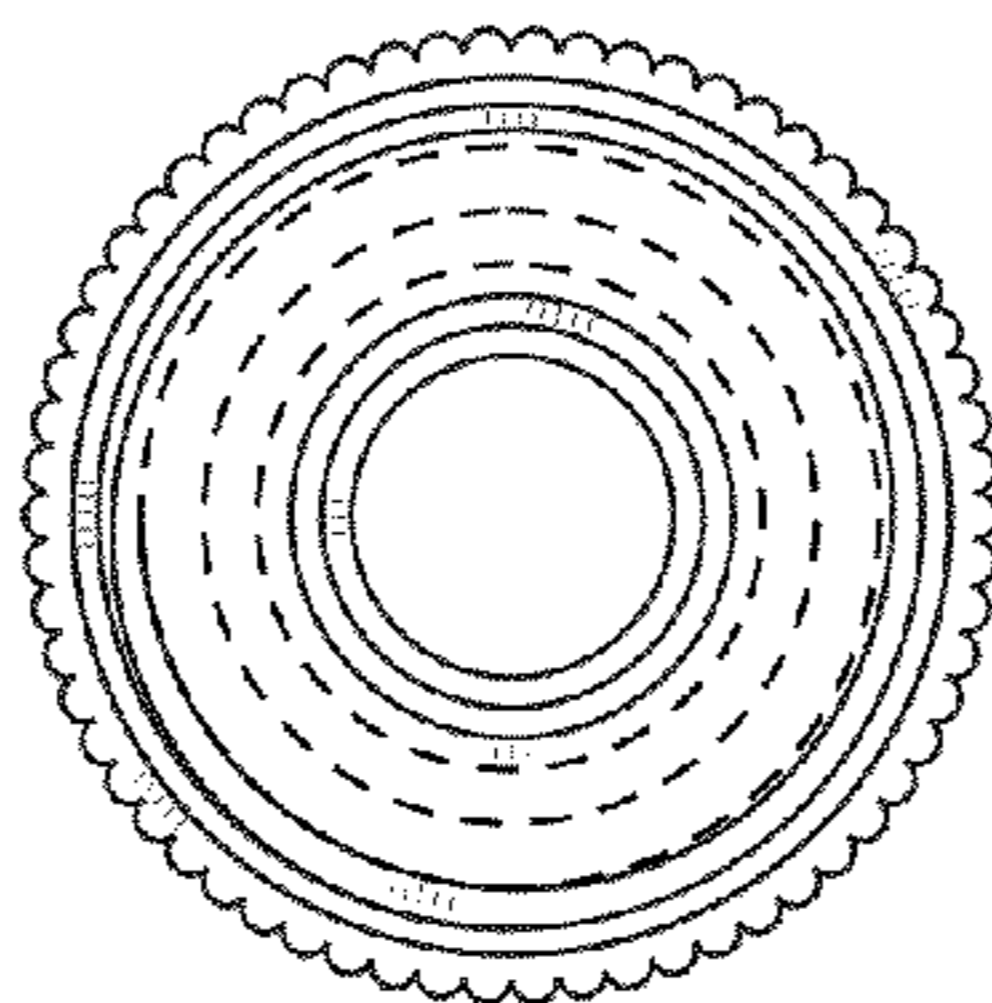

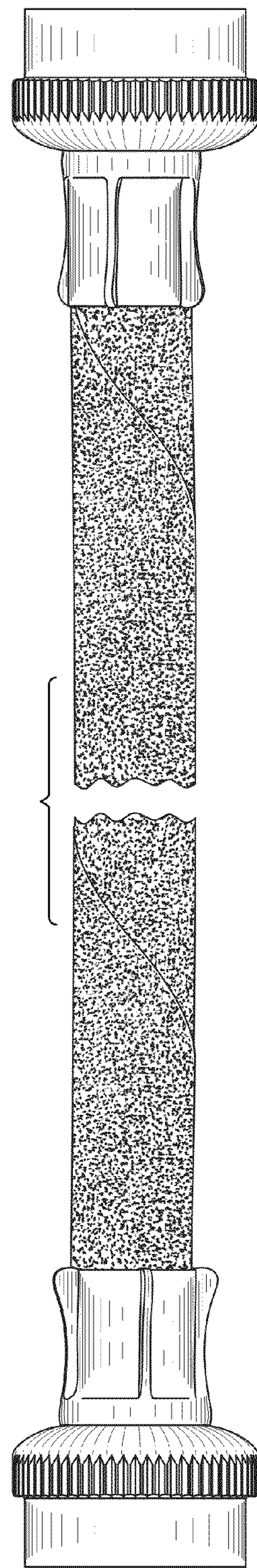

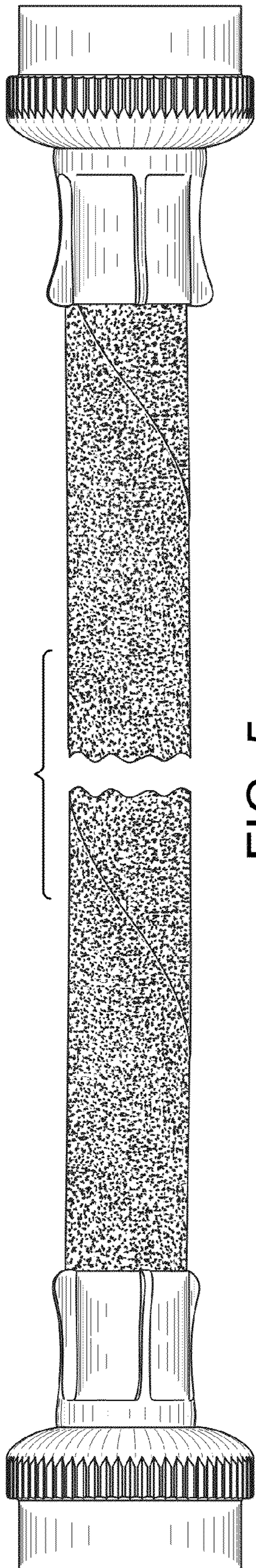

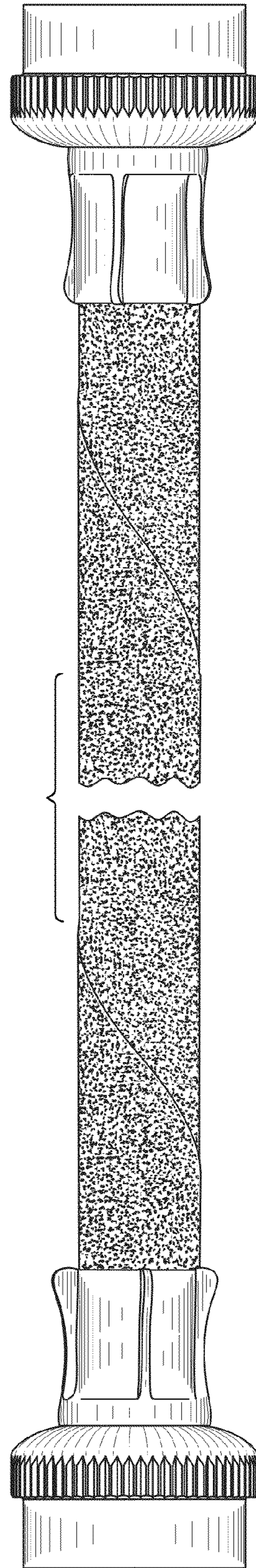
