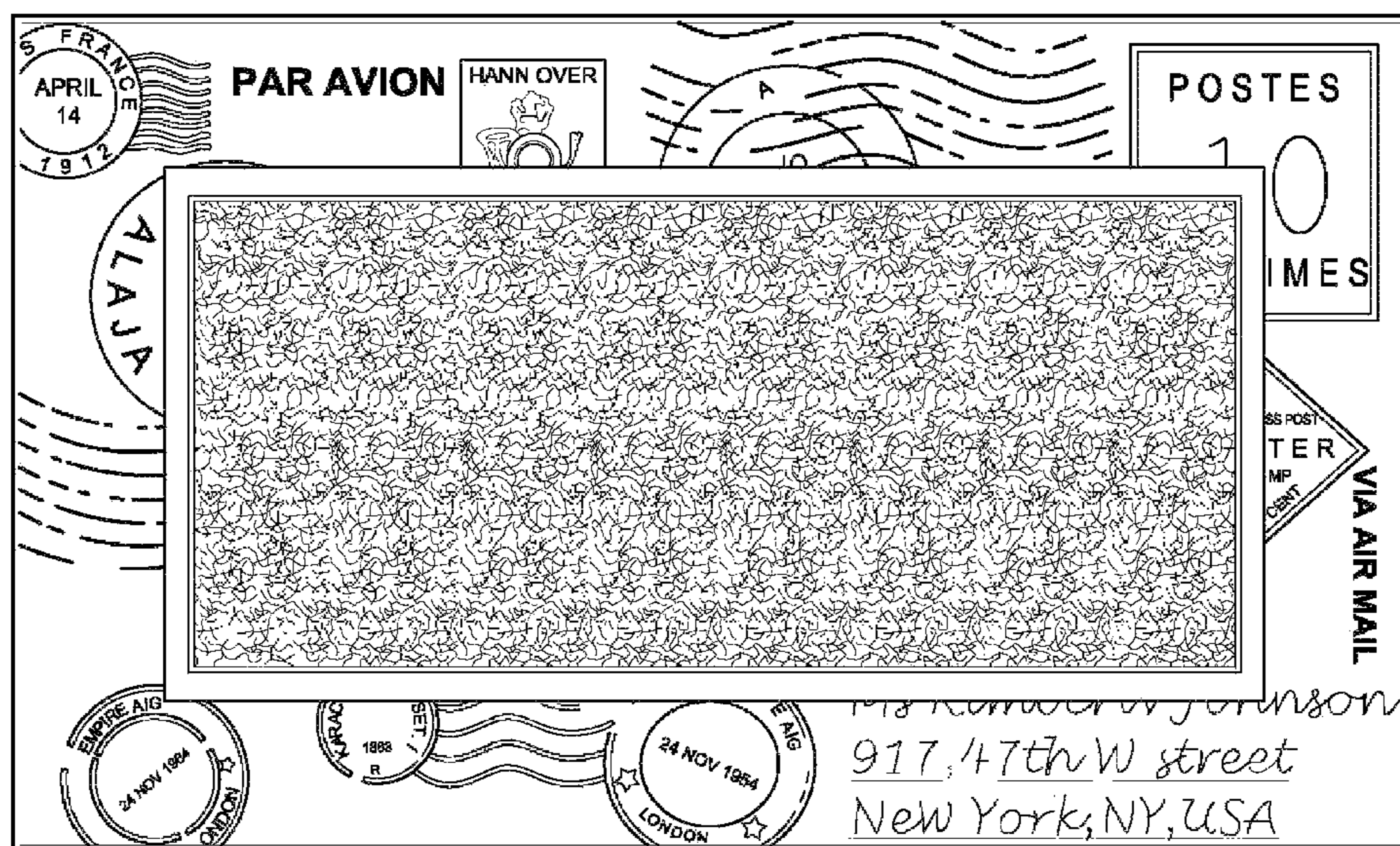

(57) **CLAIM**
The ornamental design for floor mat, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top view of a floor mat showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a bottom view of the floor mat shown in FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is perspective view of the floor mat shown in FIG. 1; FIG. 4 is a front view of the floor mat shown in FIG. 1, the unshown opposite back view being of identical appearance; FIG. 5 is a side view of the floor mat shown in FIG. 1, the unshown opposite side view being of identical appearance; and, FIG. 6 is a detail view of the lower right corner of the floor mat of FIG. 1. The broken line perimeter represents the boundary of the detail and forms no part thereof.

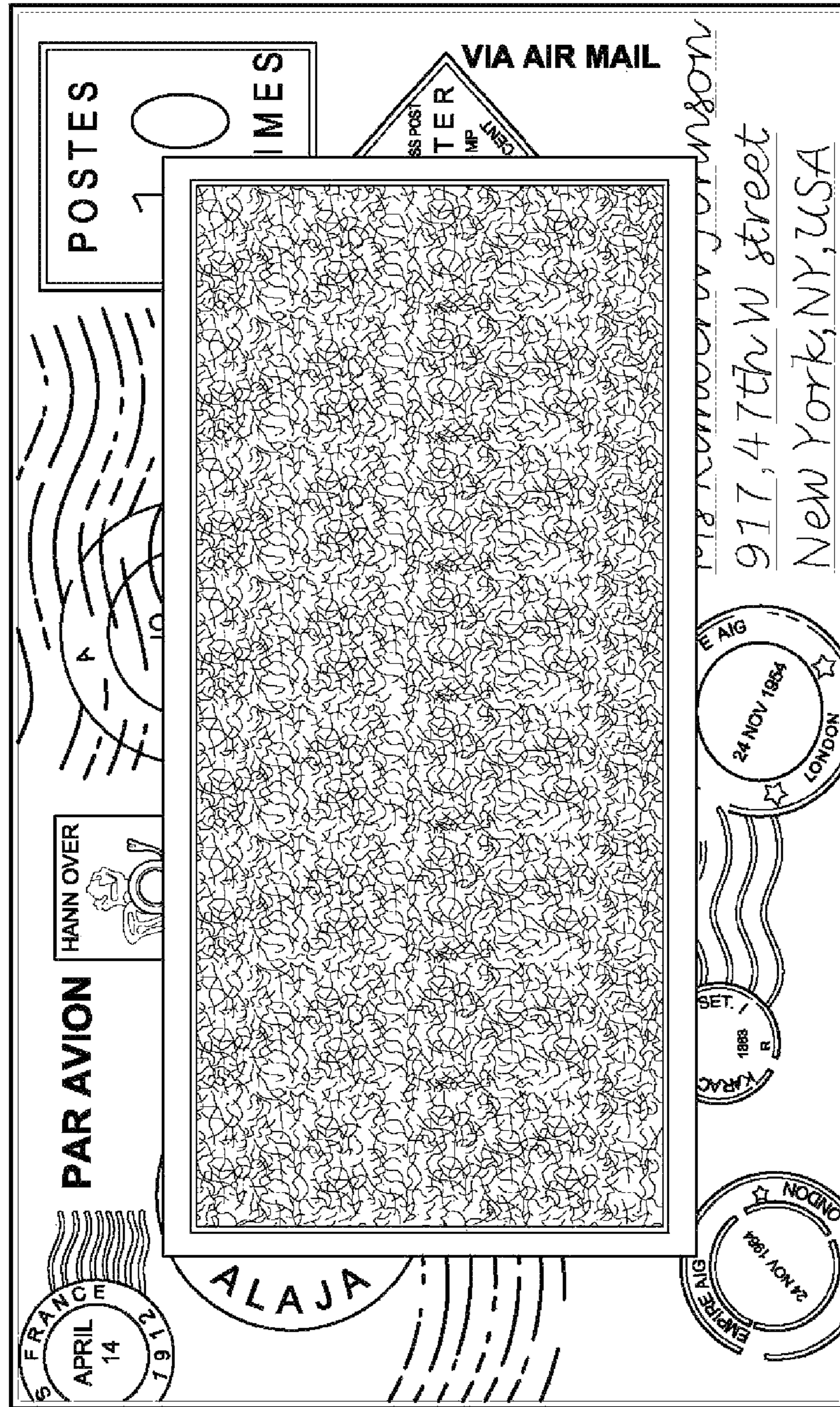

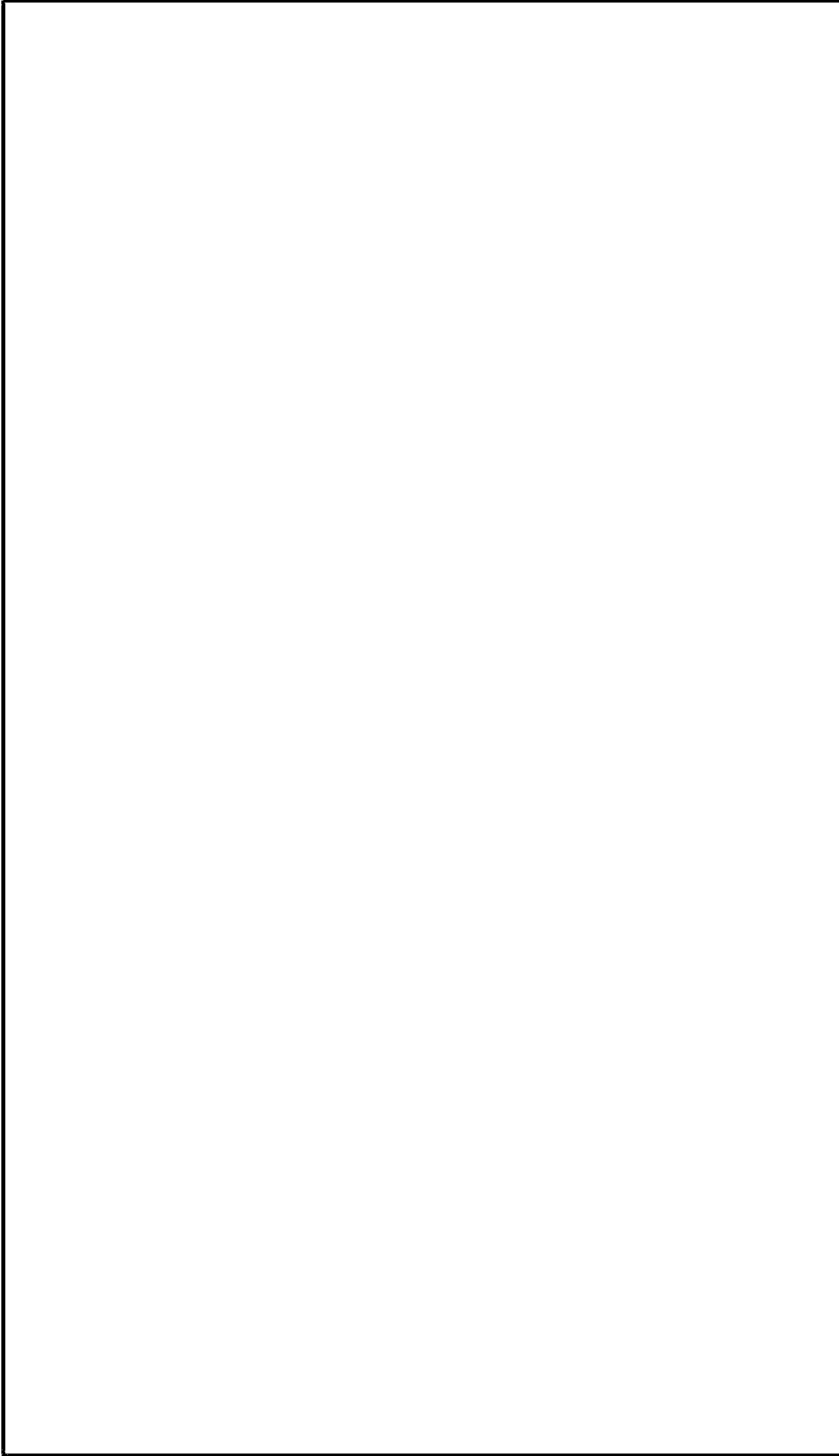

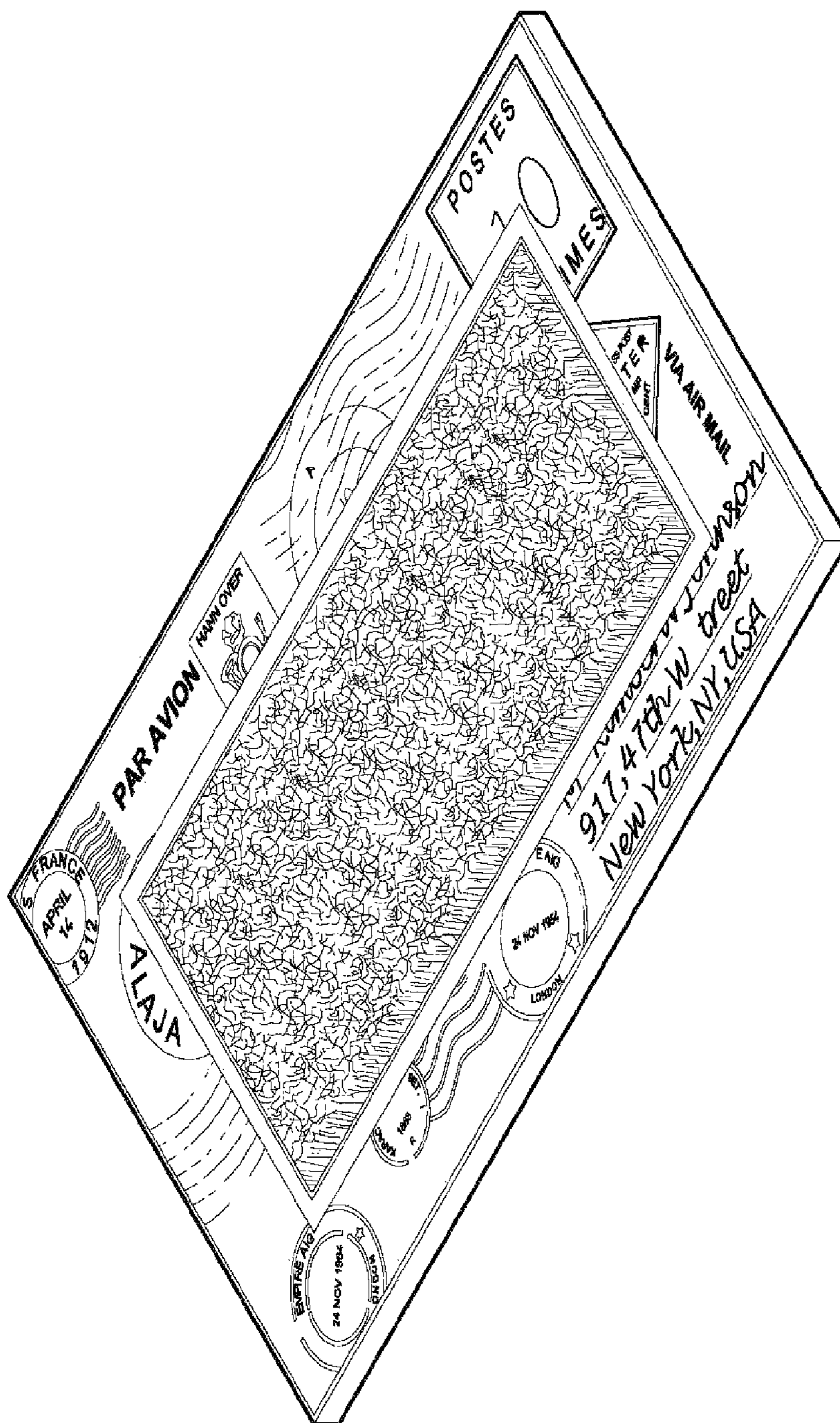

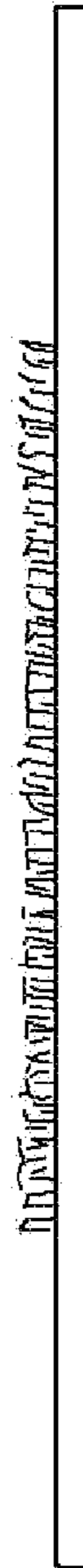

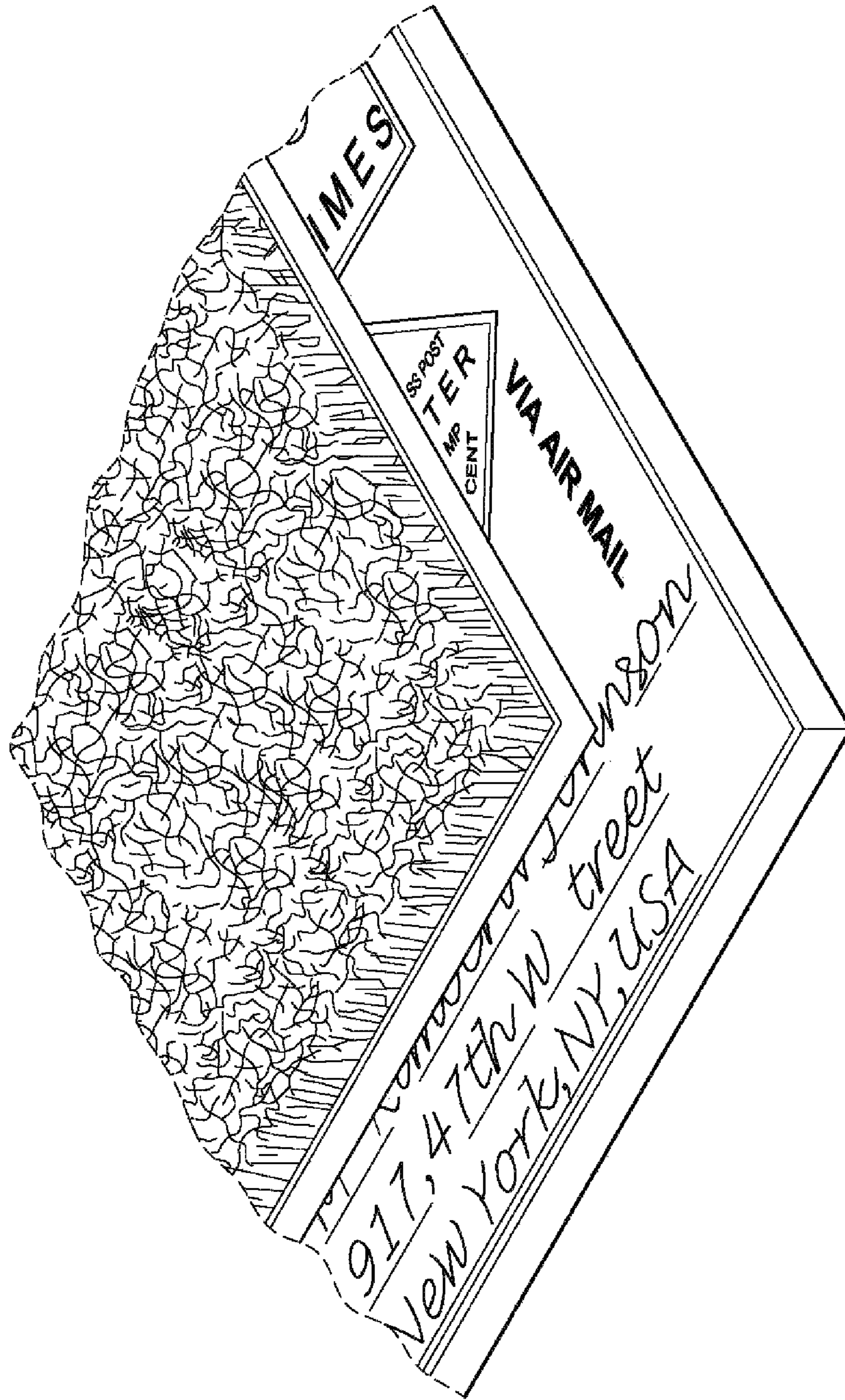
