CLAIM

The ornamental design for a box, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a box showing our new design. FIG. 2 is a top view of the design shown in FIG. 1. FIG. 3 is a bottom view of the design shown in FIG. 1, showing a lid portion overlaying a base portion. FIG. 4 is a front view of the design shown in FIG. 1. FIG. 5 is a rear view of the design shown in FIG. 1; and, FIG. 6 is a right side view of the design shown in FIG. 1; the left side view of the design is identical to the right side view. The broken lines showing a surface design in FIGS. 1 and 2 are for the purpose of showing environmental structure and form no part of the claimed design.

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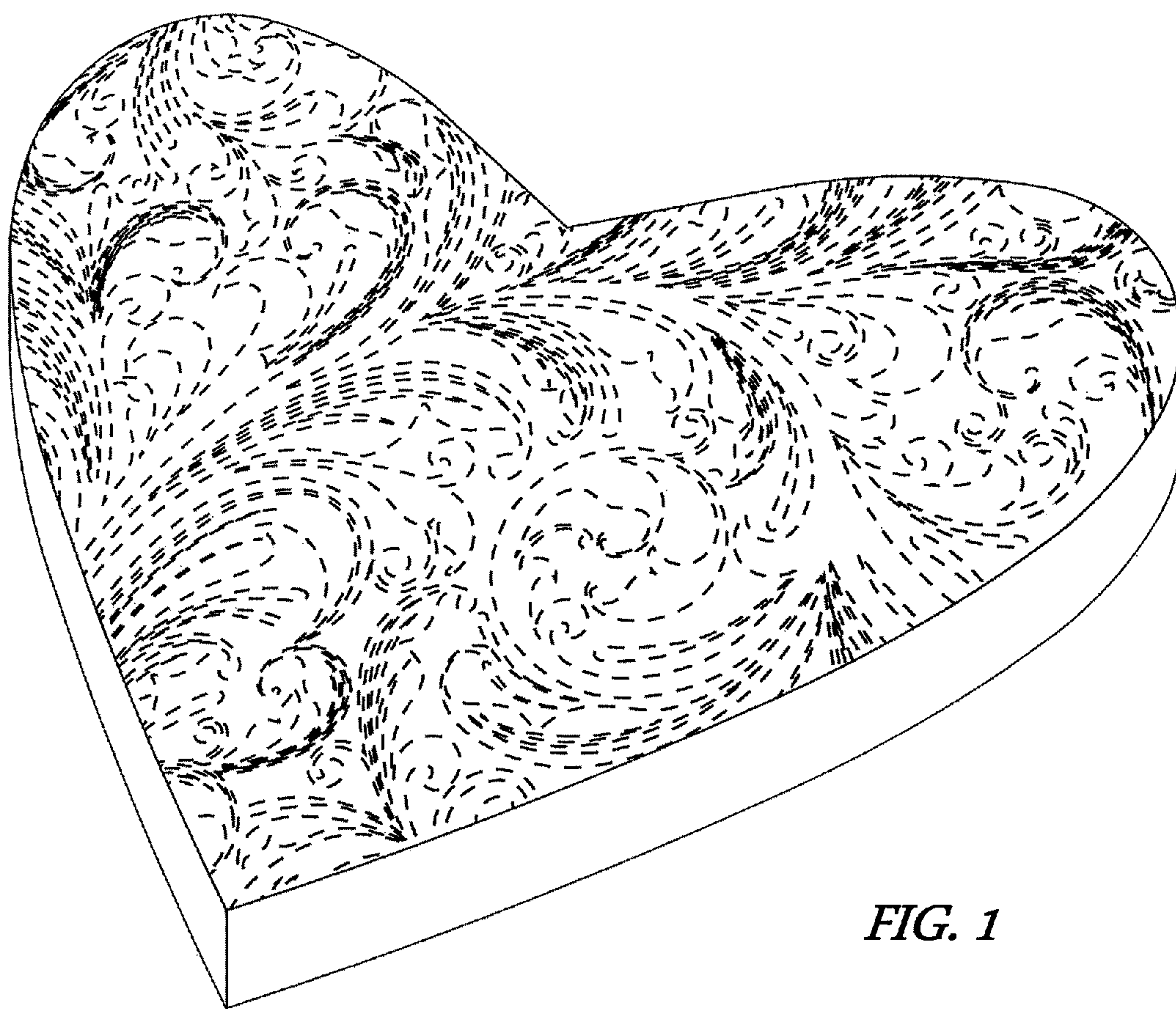

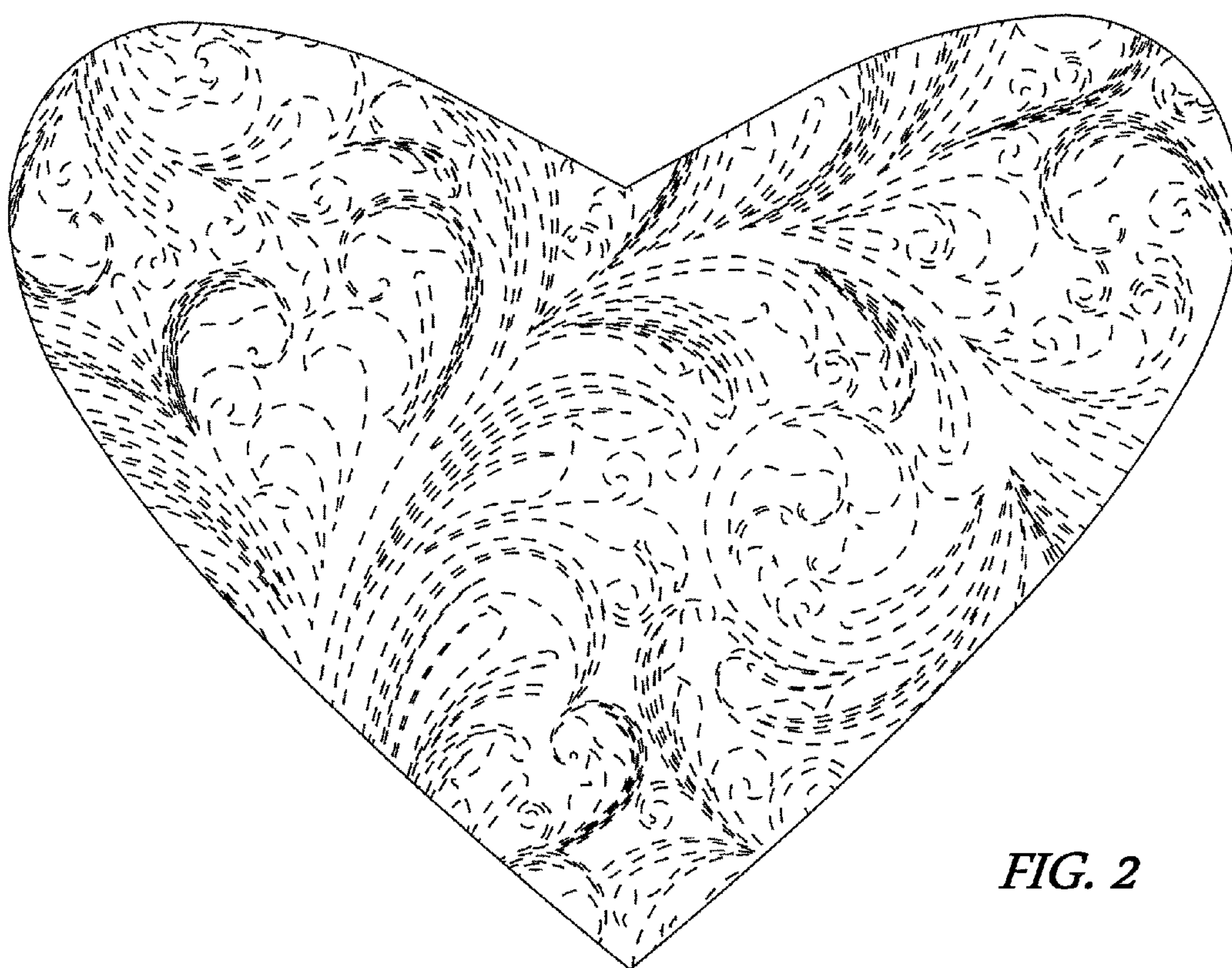

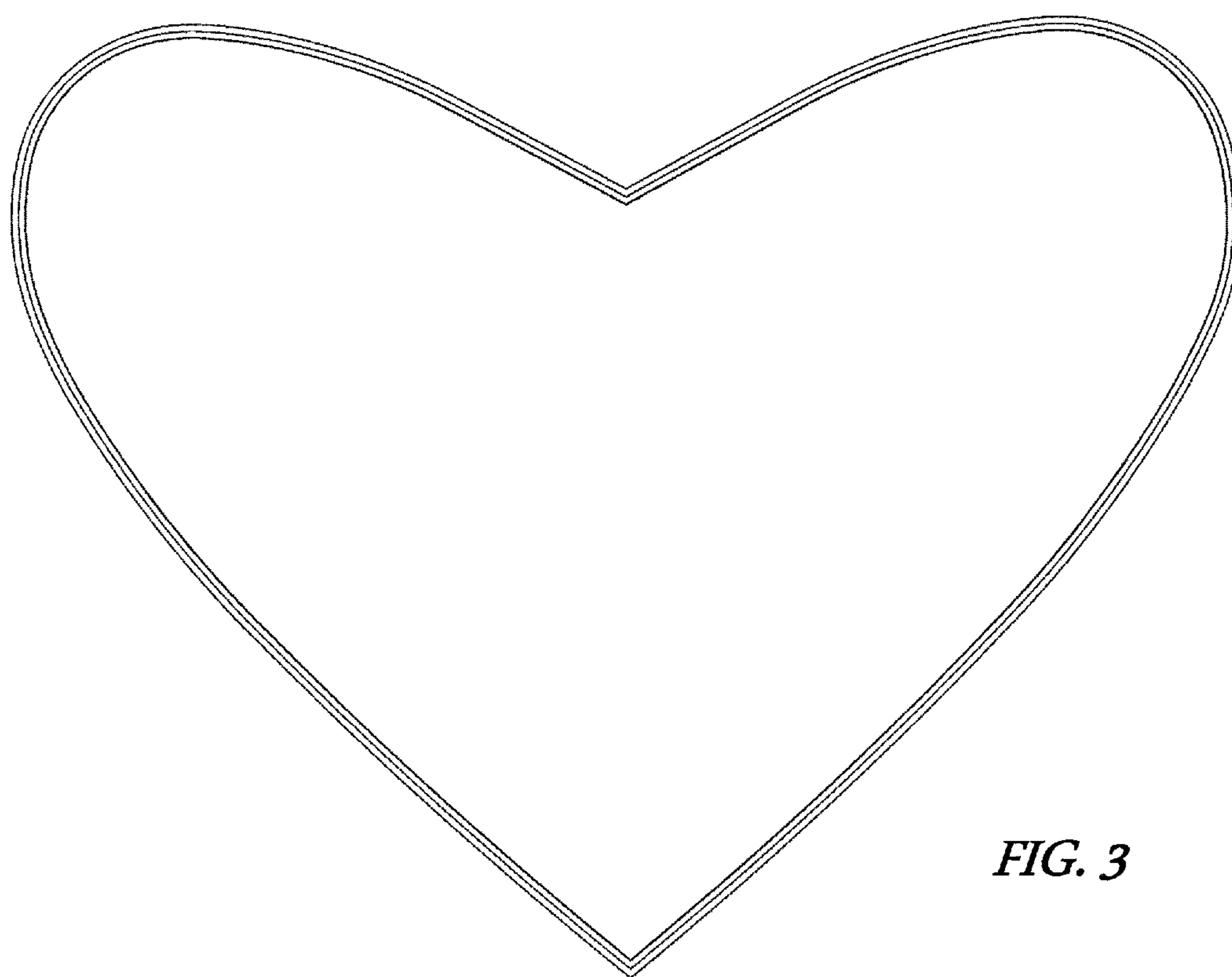

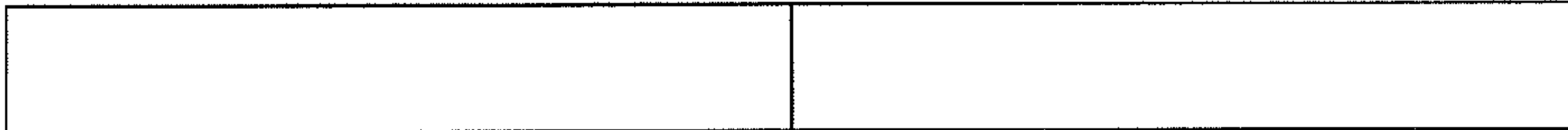

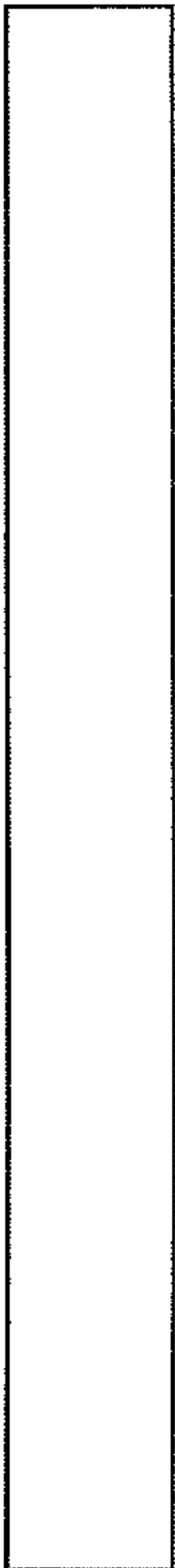
