(57) **CLAIM**

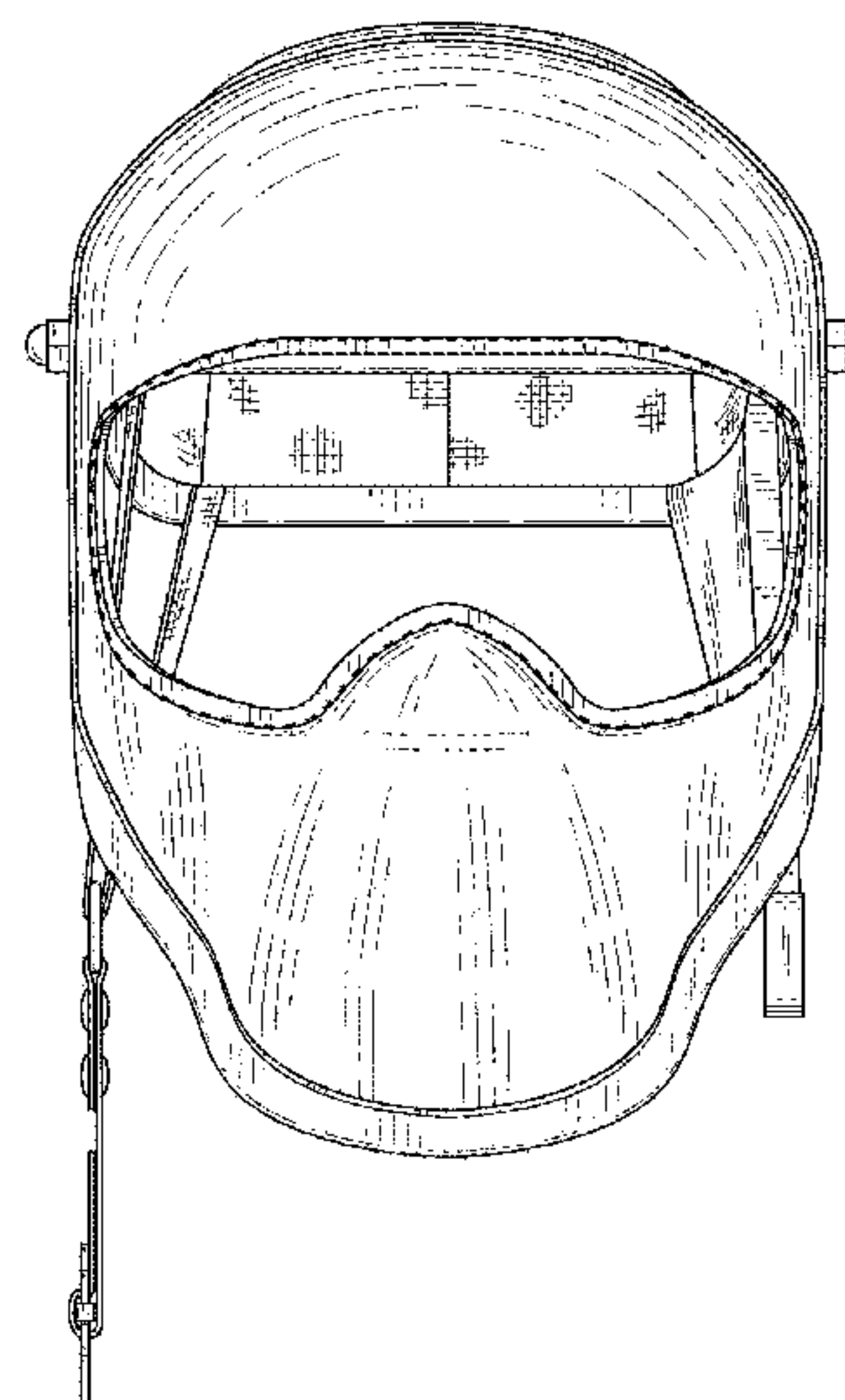
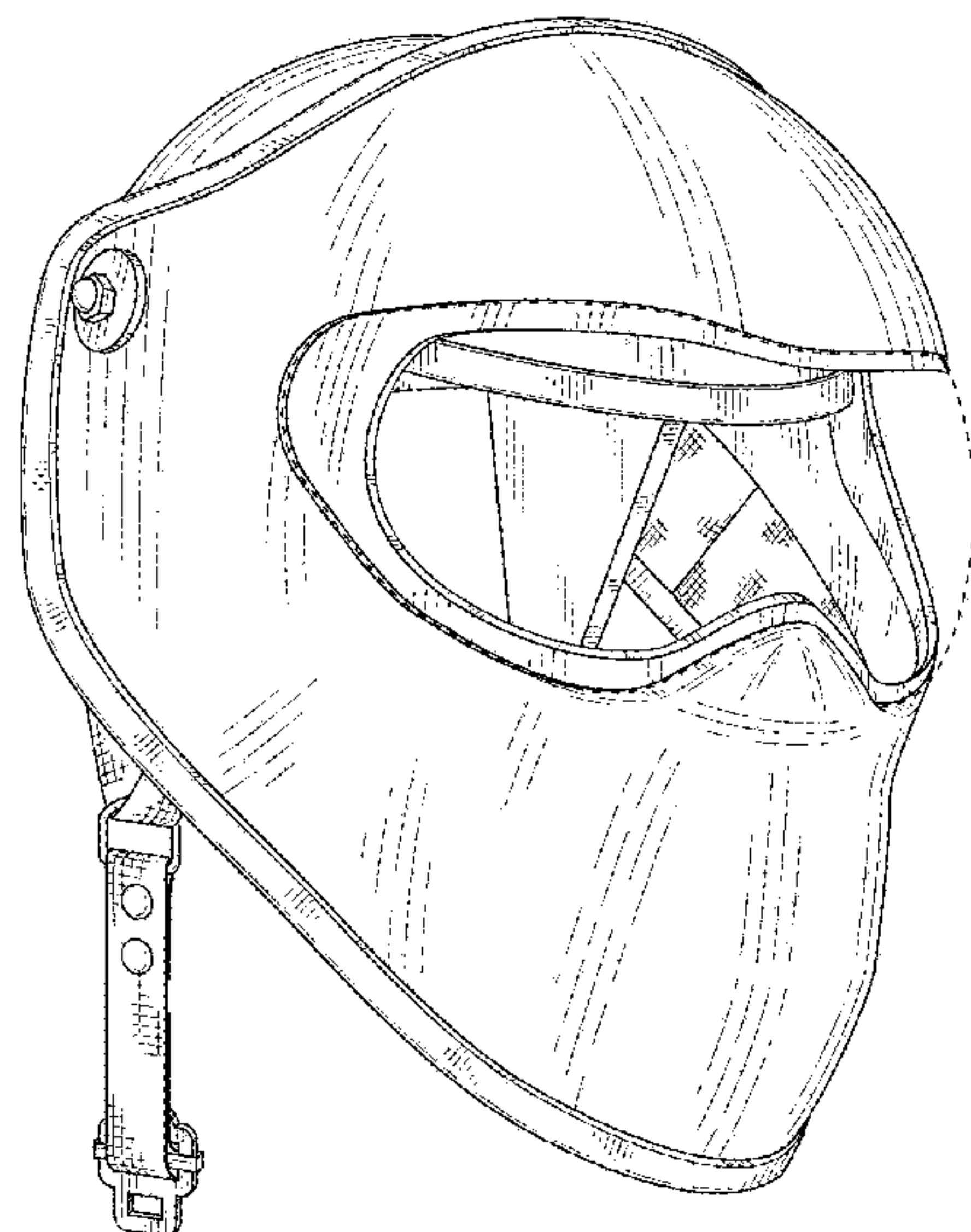
The ornamental design for a helmet with weather shield, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, left side perspective view of a helmet with weather shield showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and, FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The broken lines represent environmental structure (not conventional stitching) and form no part of the claimed design. The cross-hatch shading is understood to repeat throughout the indicated area.

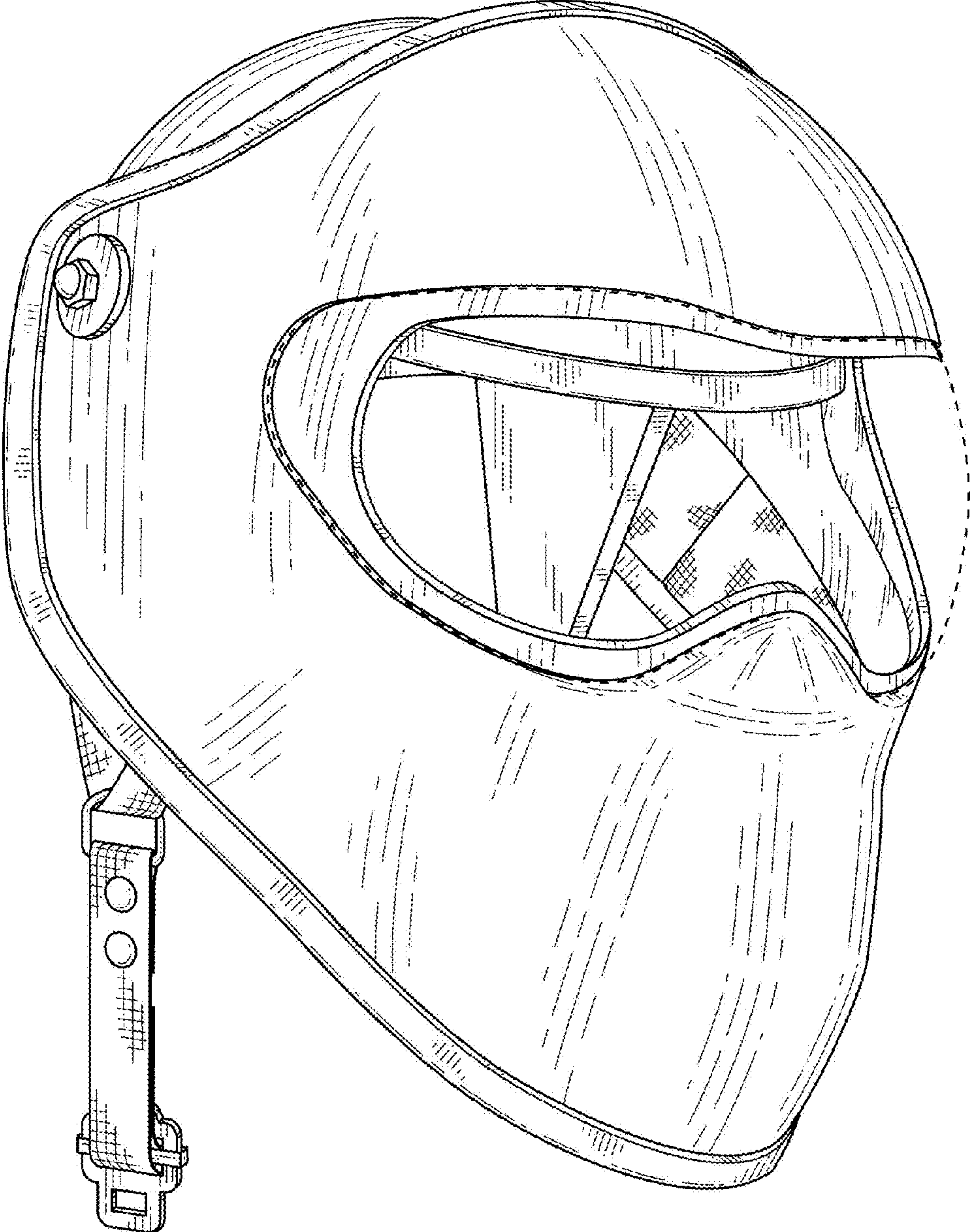

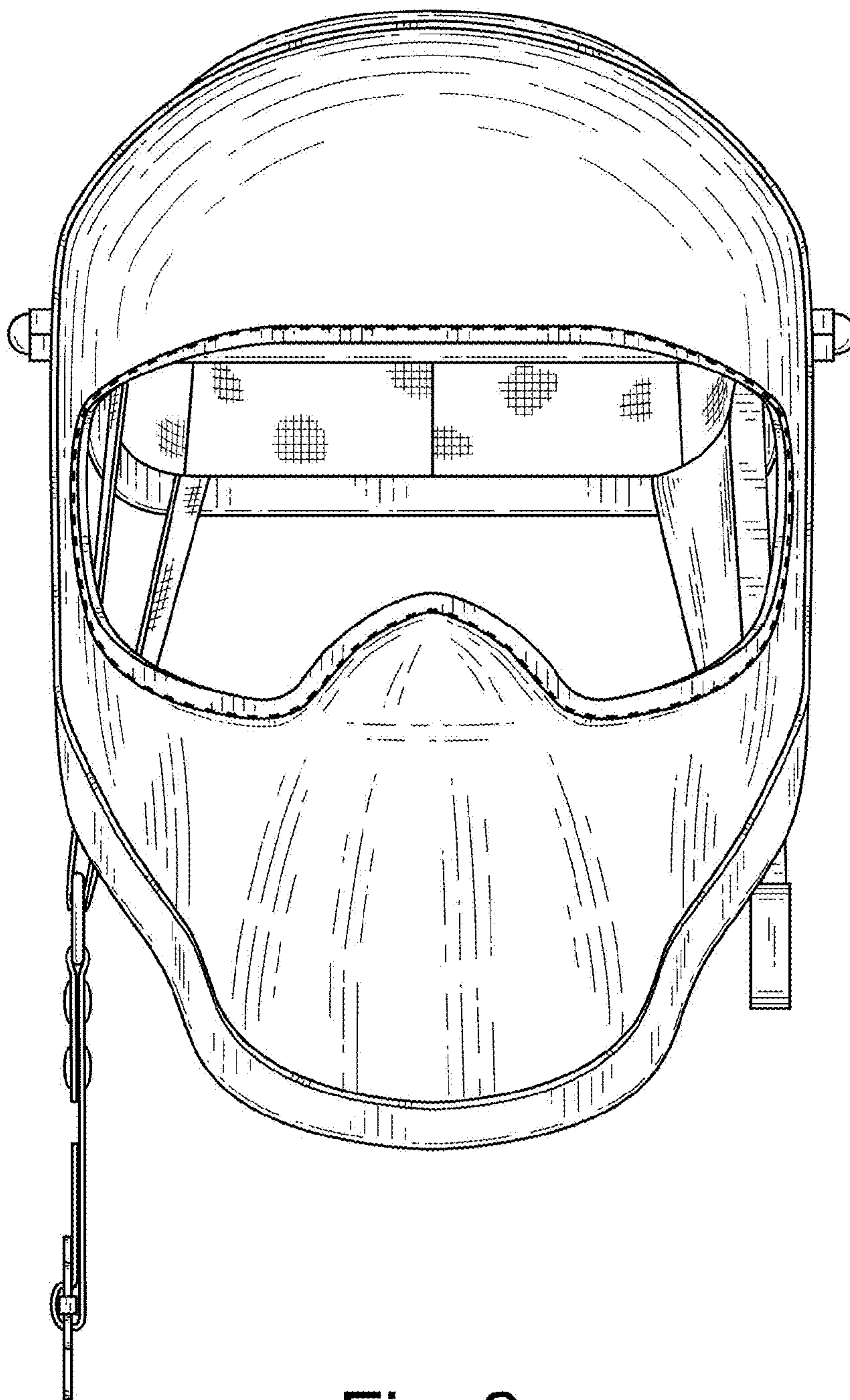

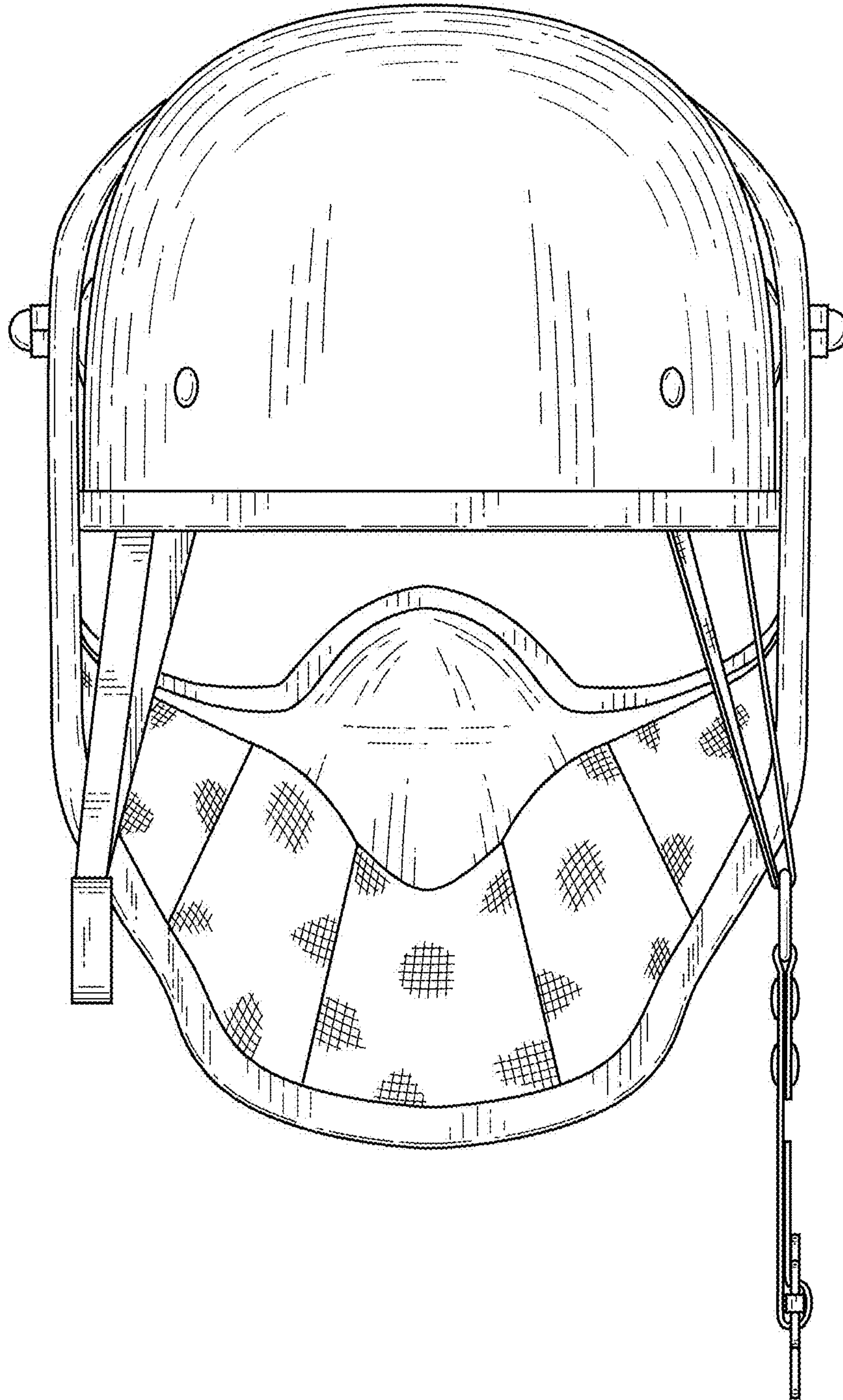

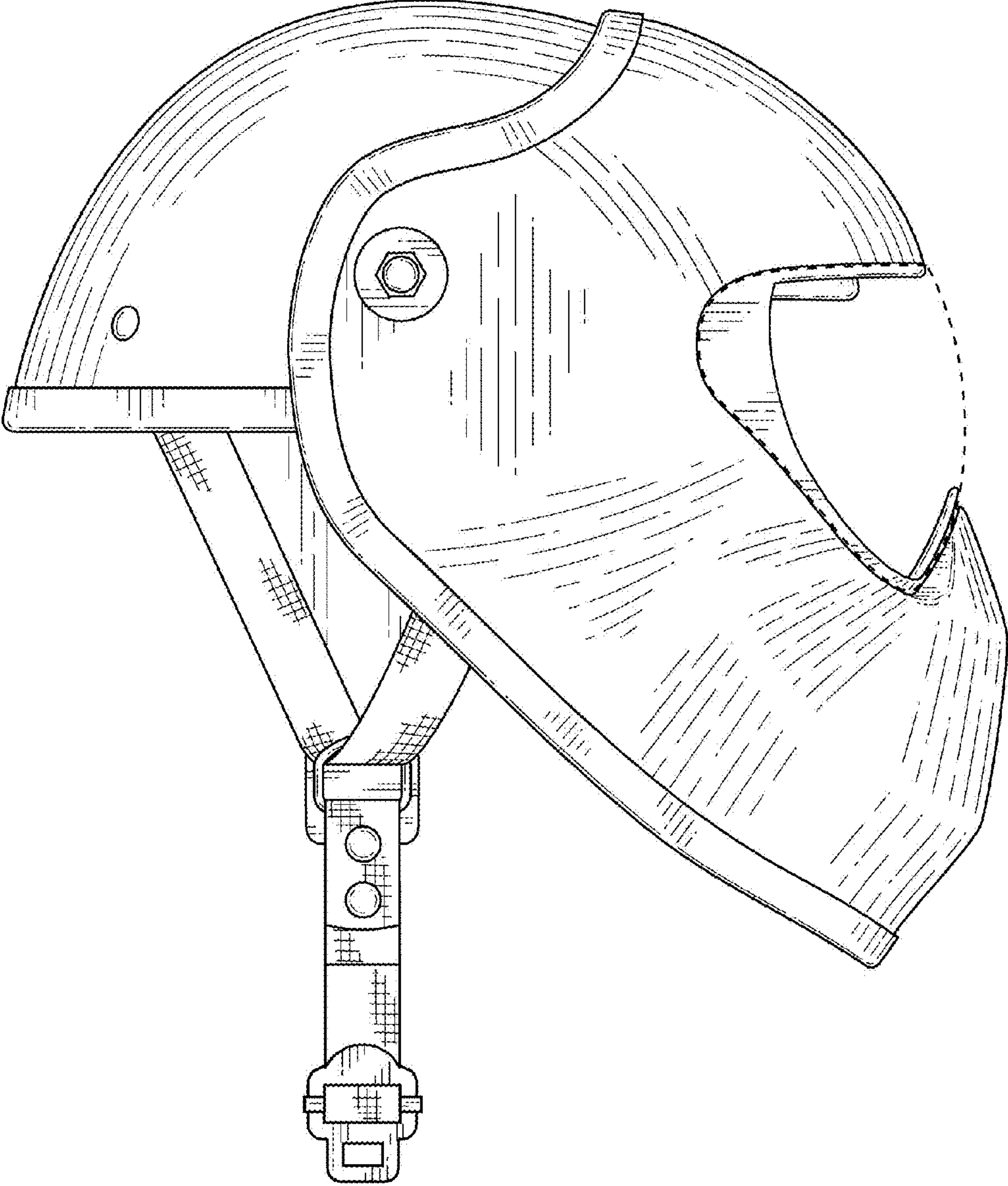

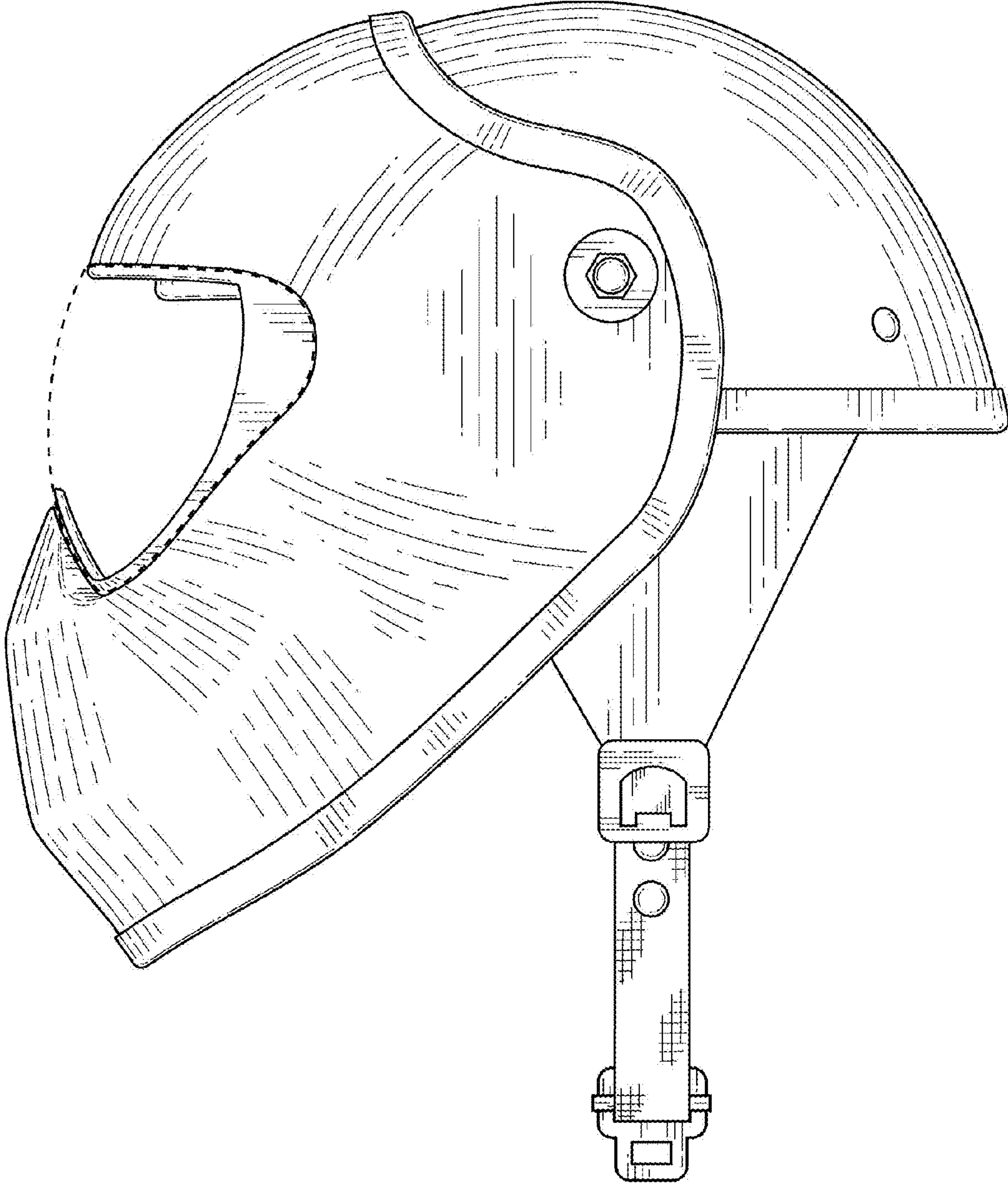

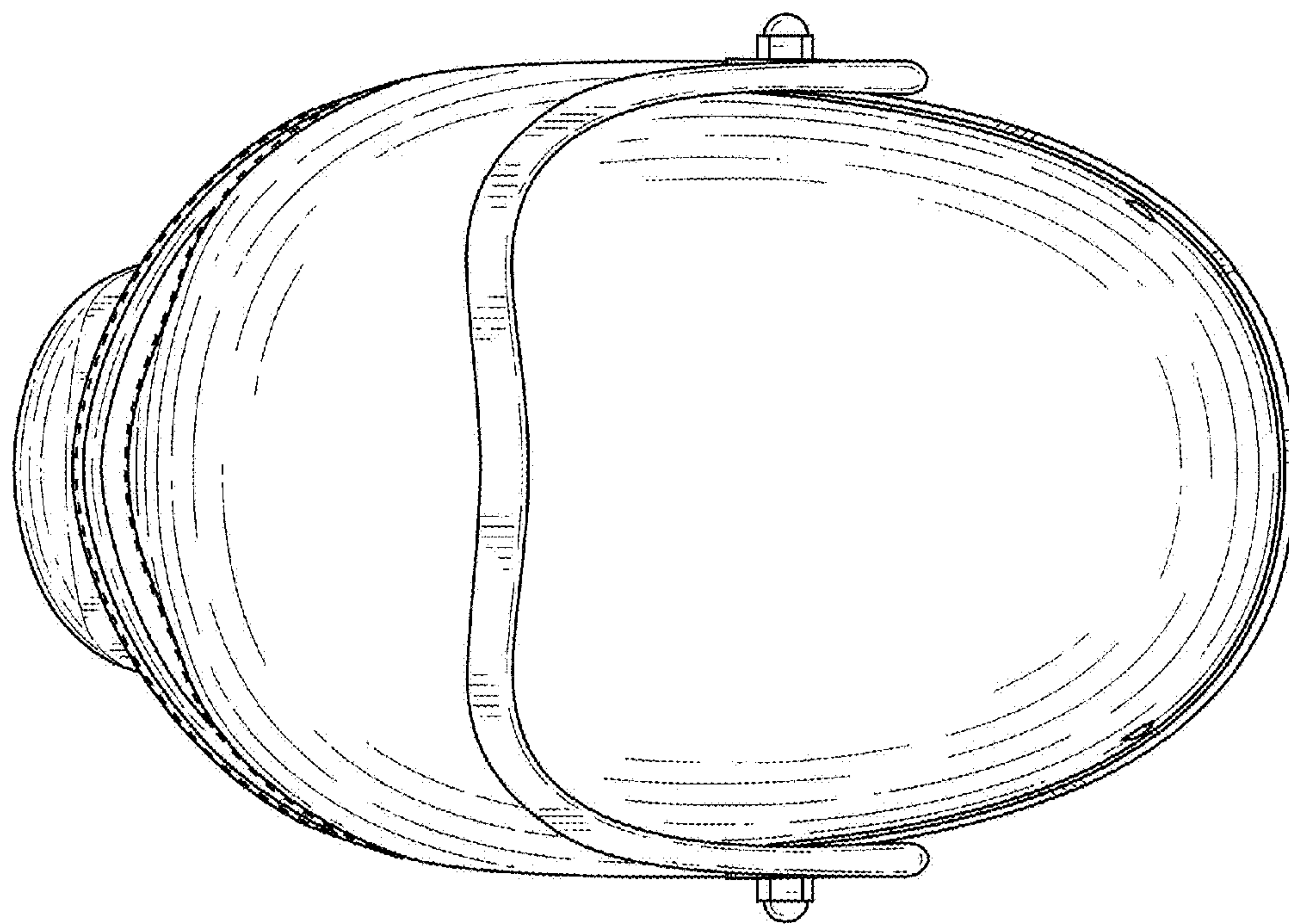

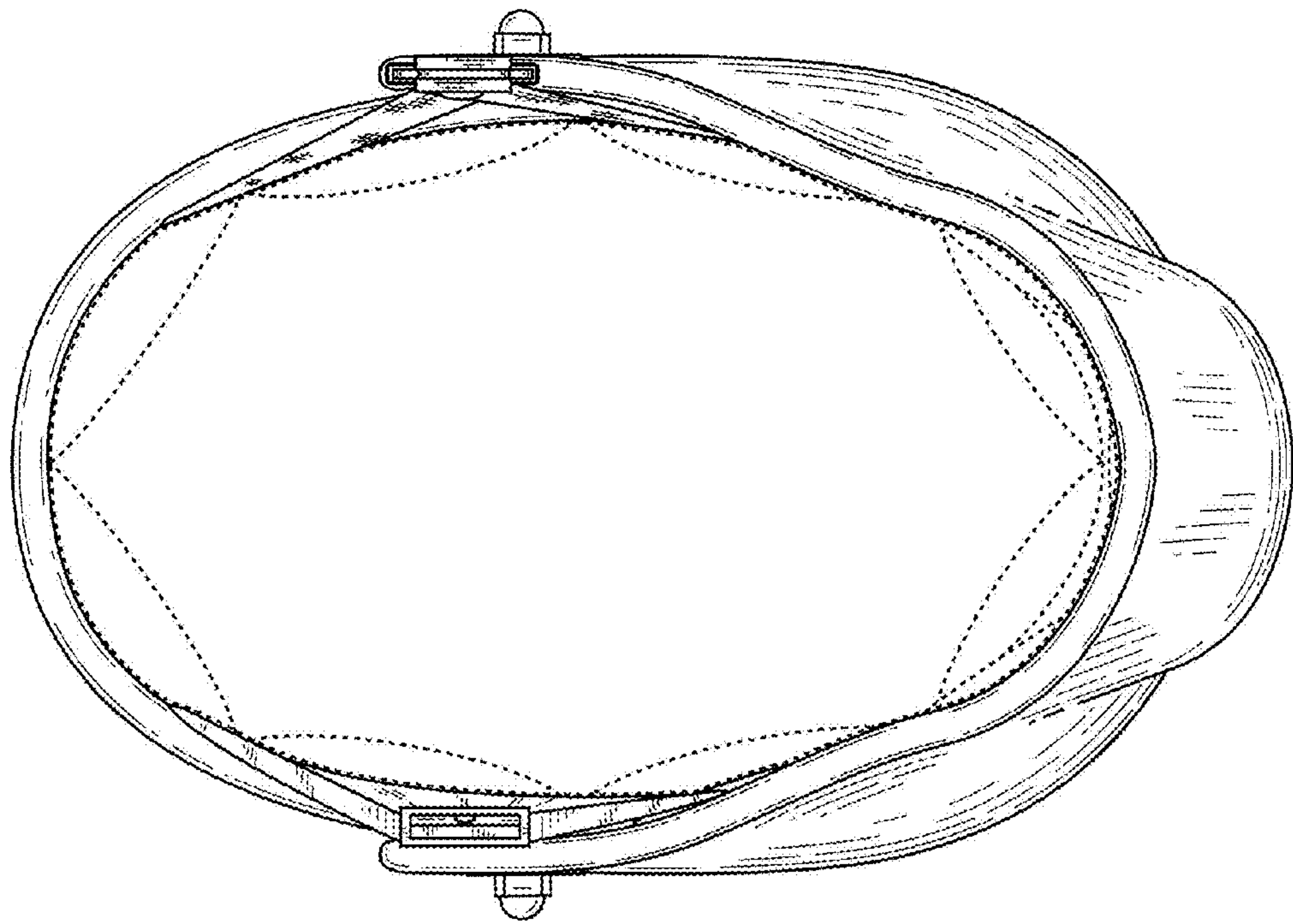
