described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of my new design for an undergar-
ment, the bottom plan view being identical thereto.

configuration, shown on a wearer.

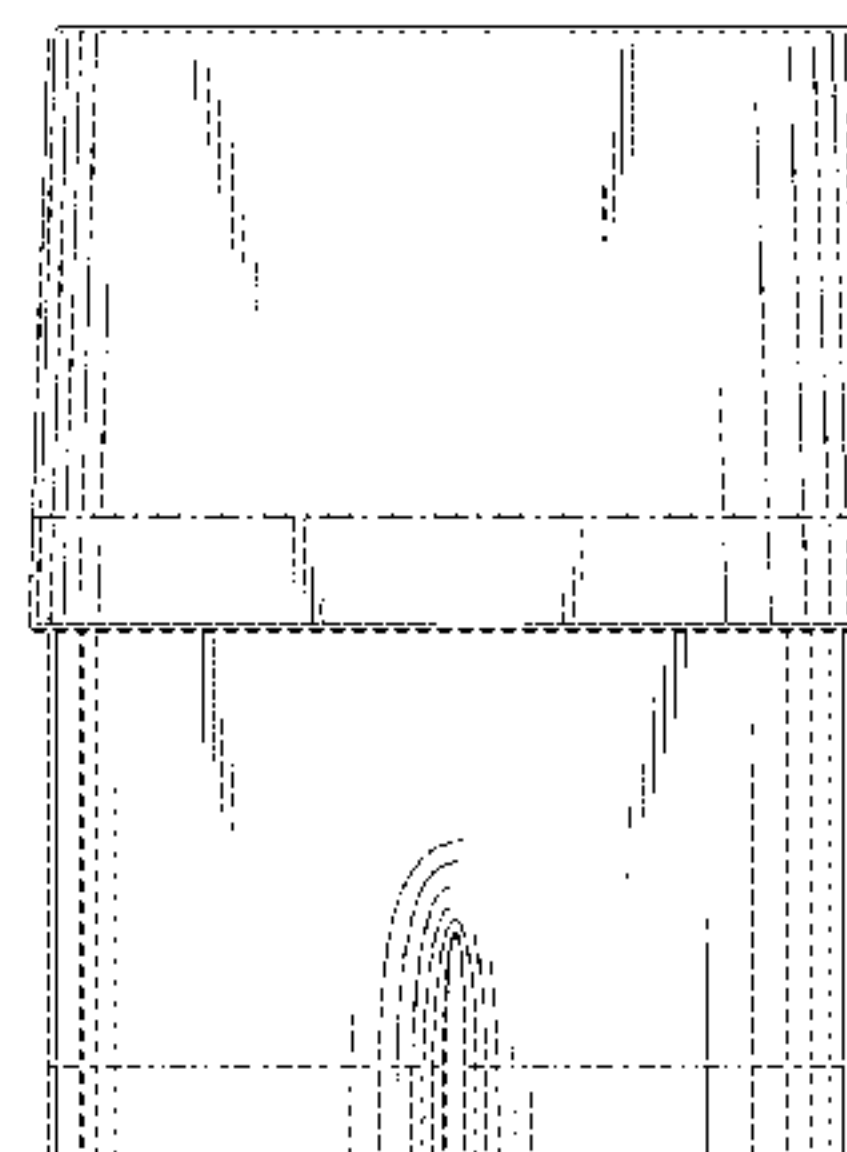
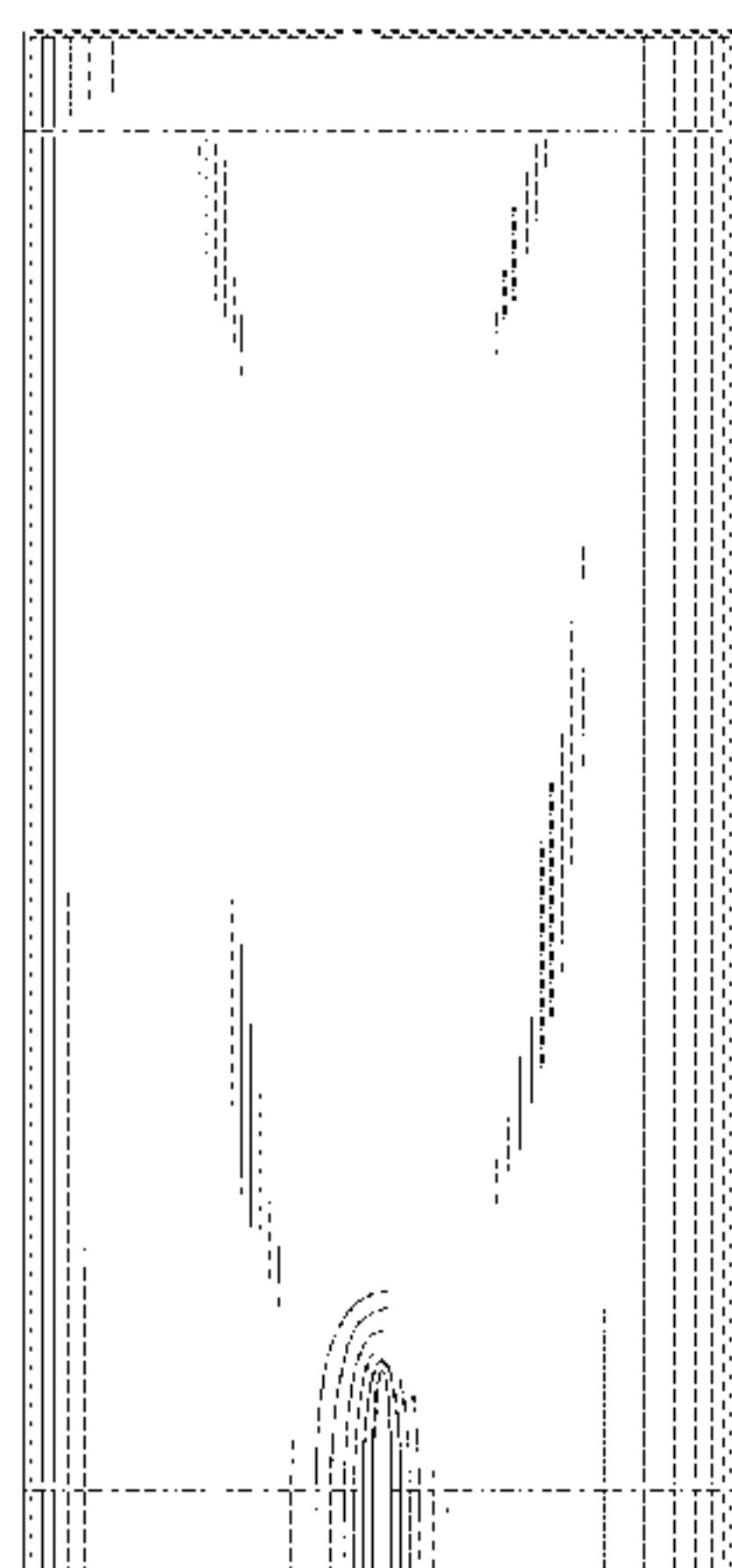
FIG. 9 is a perspective view of the undergarment in the first

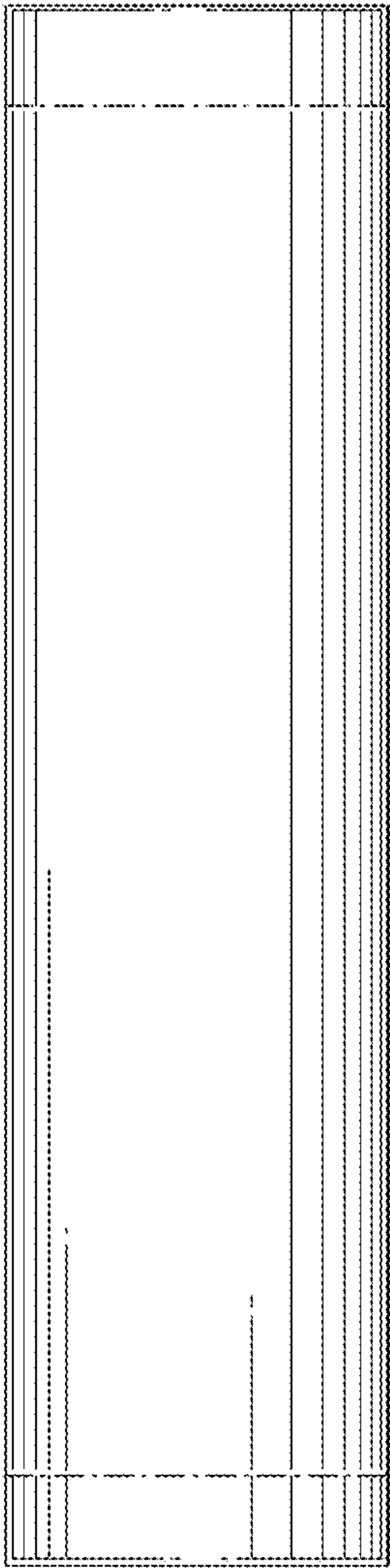

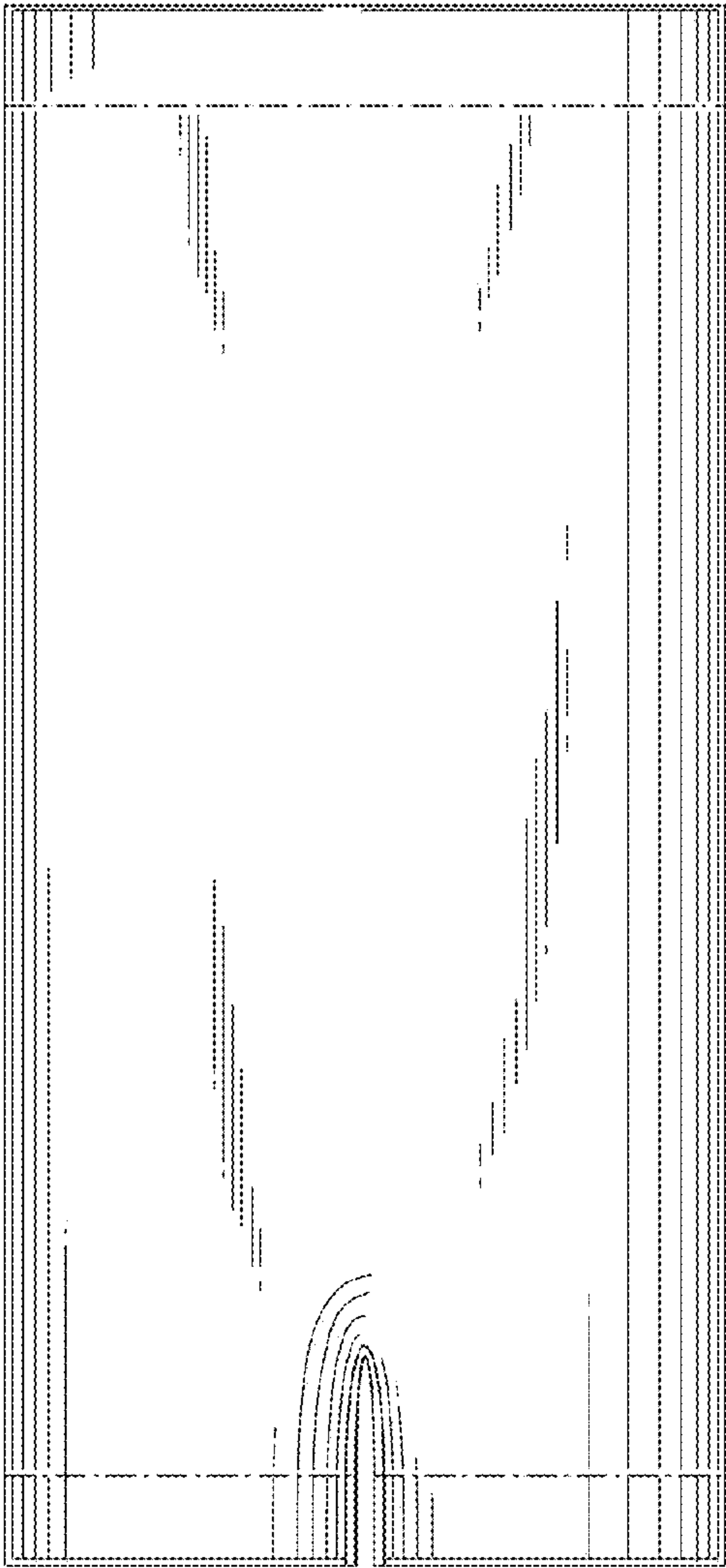

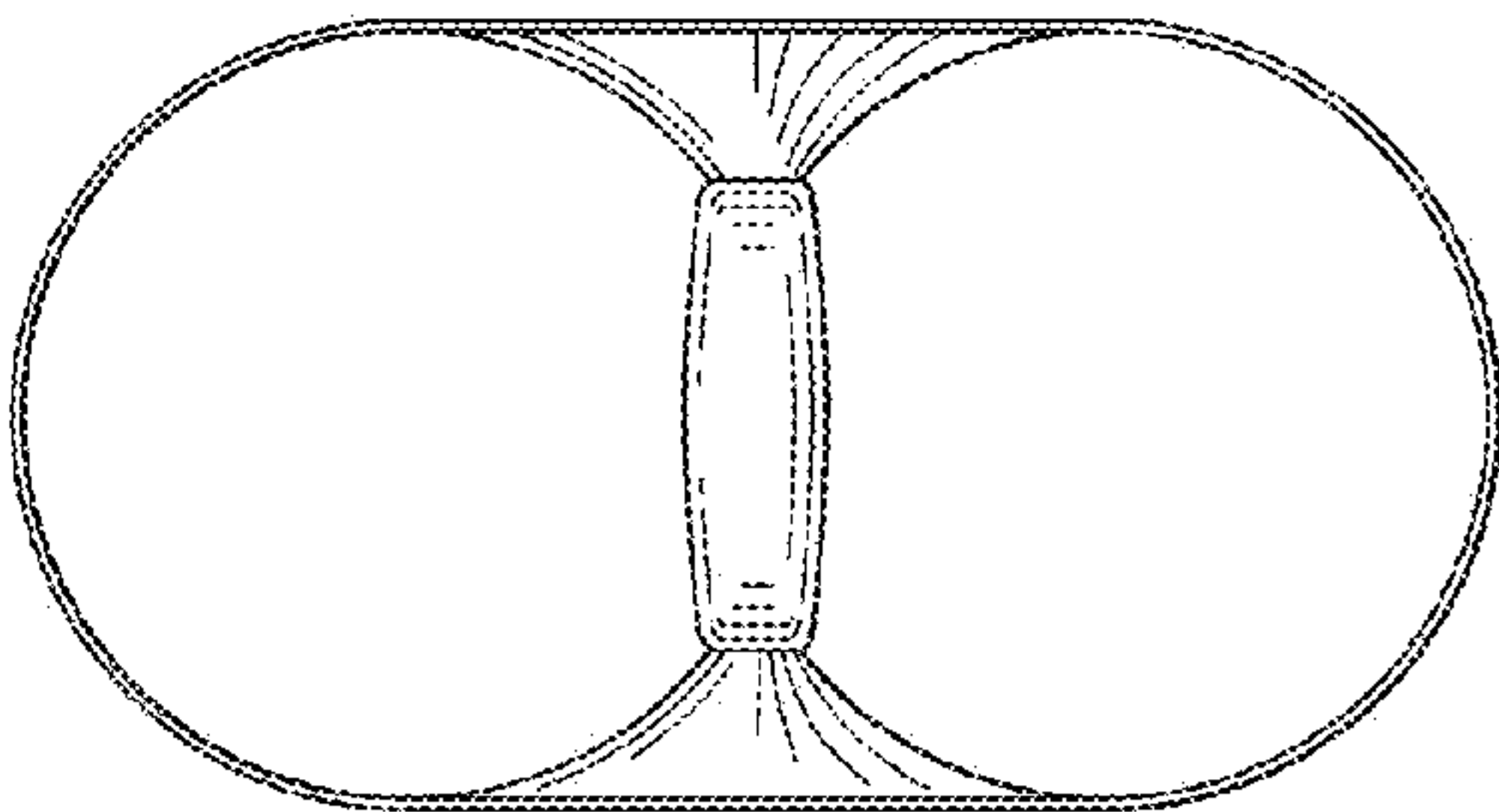

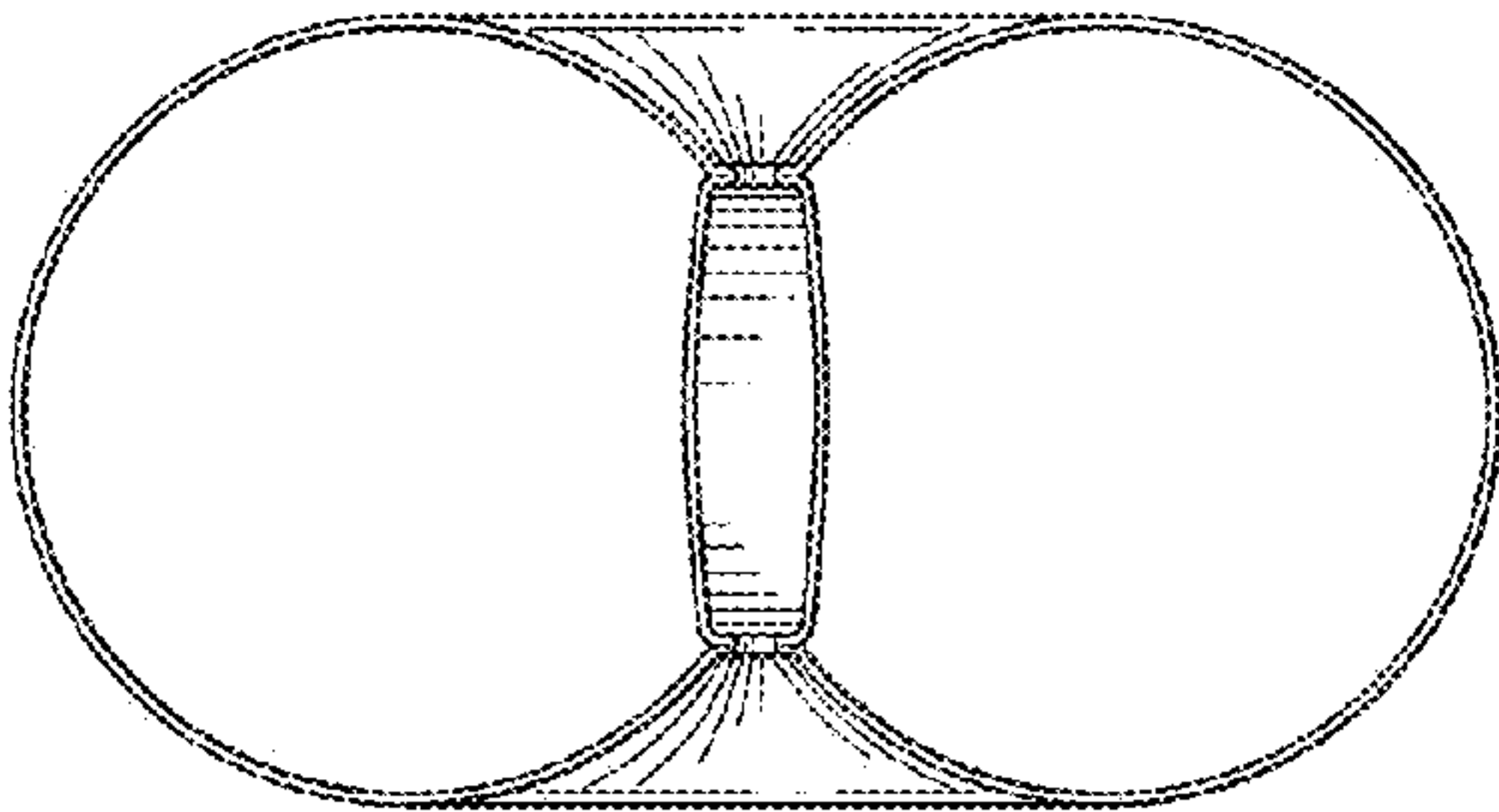

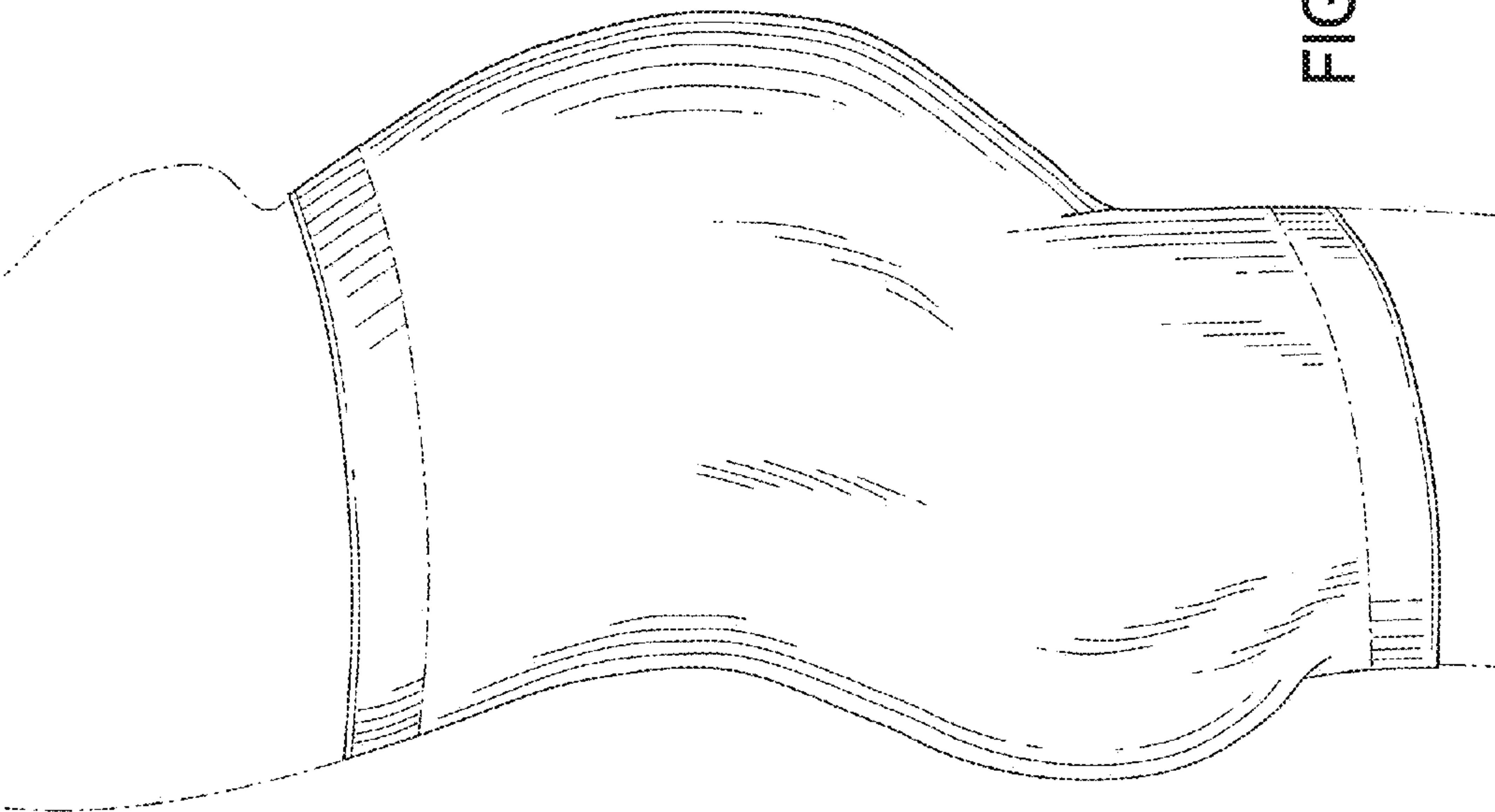

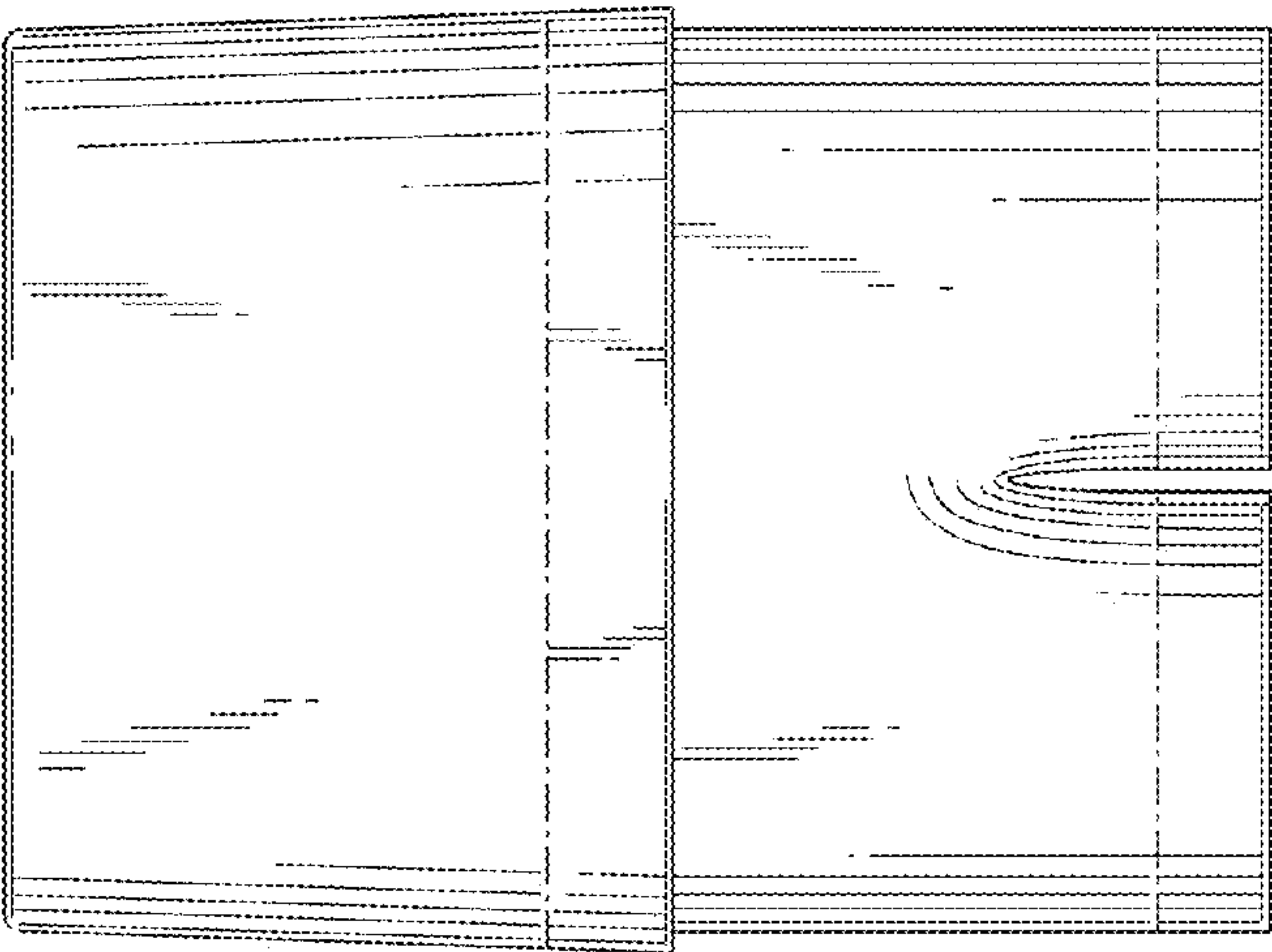

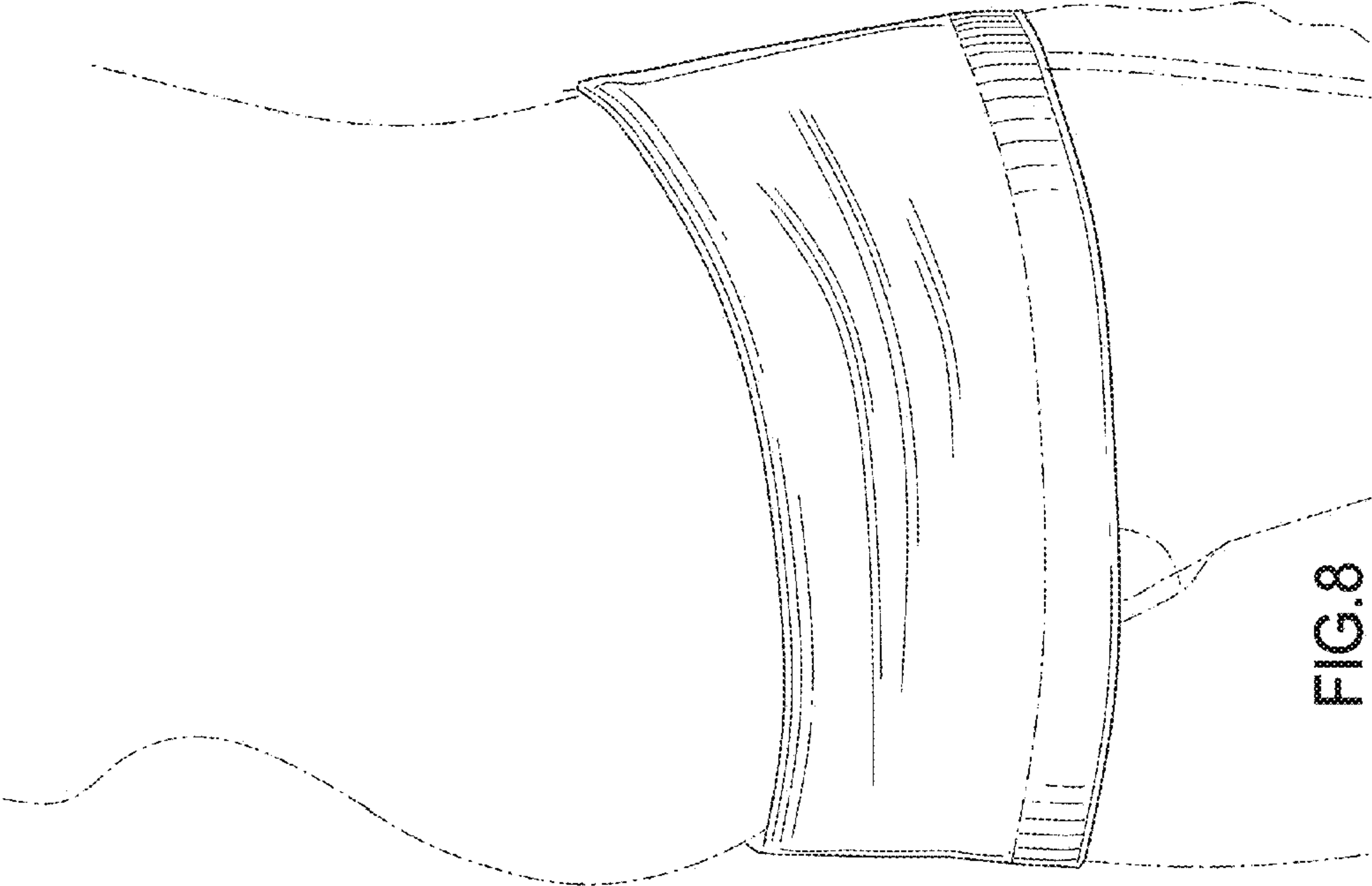

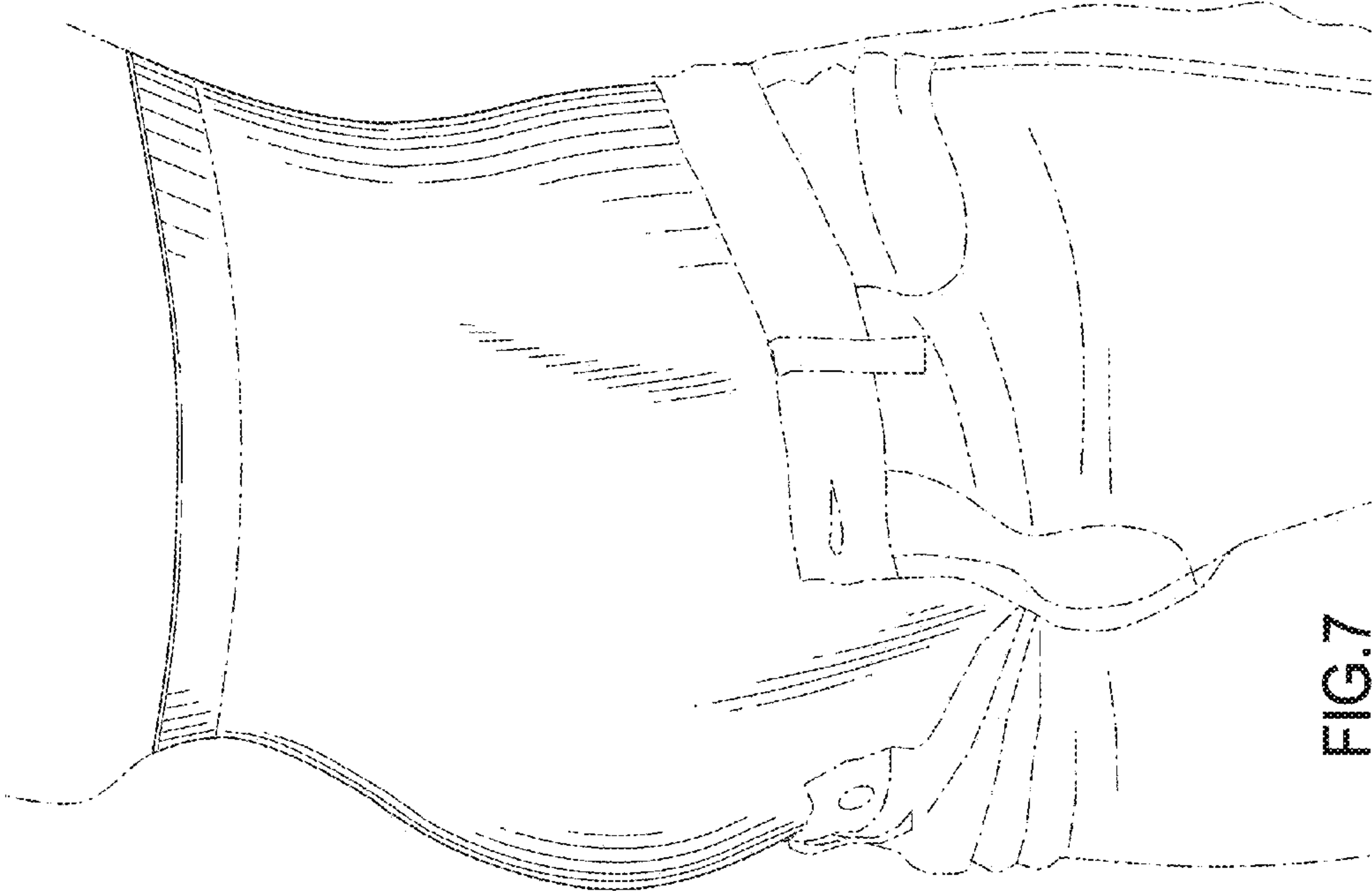

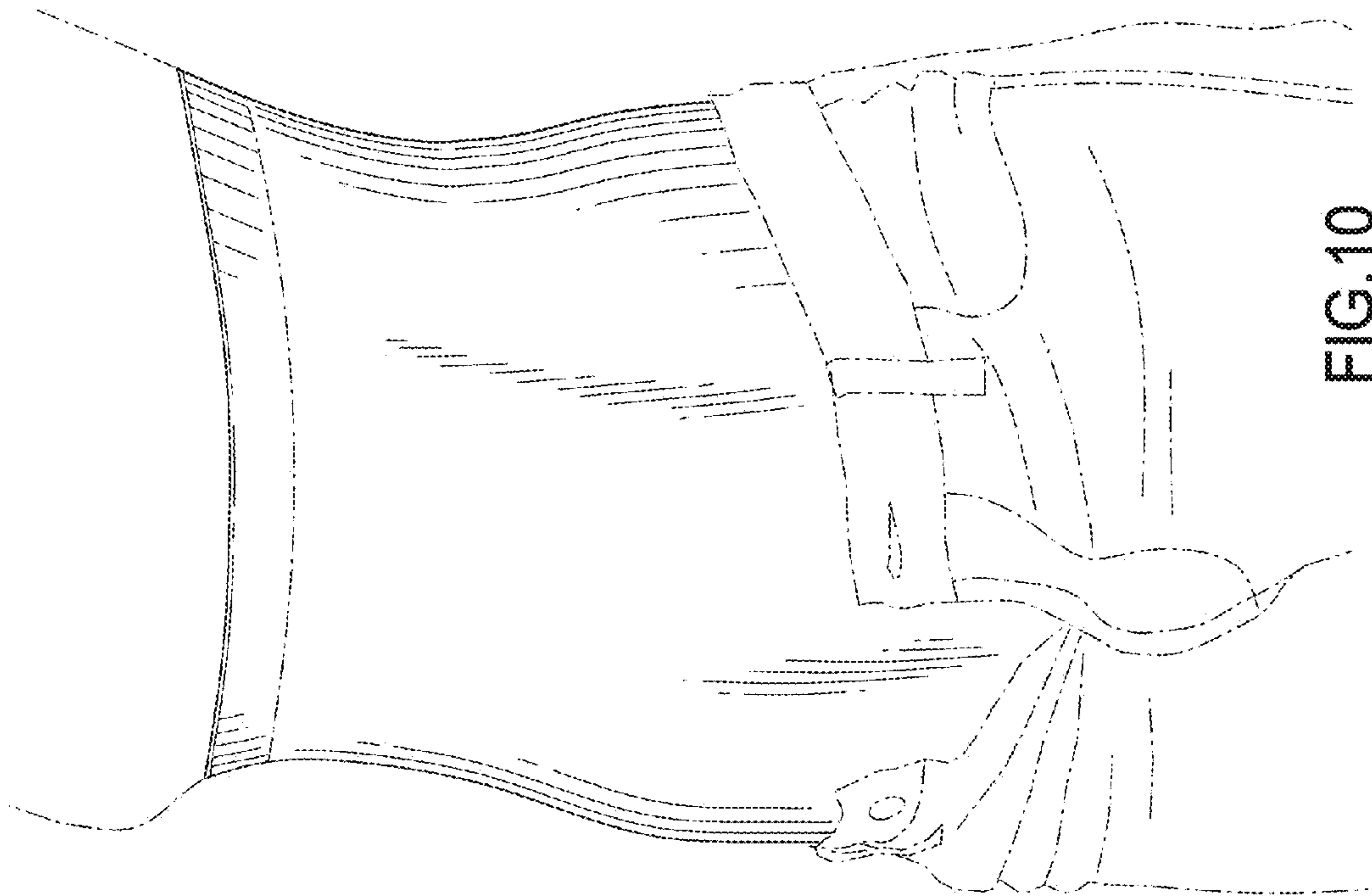

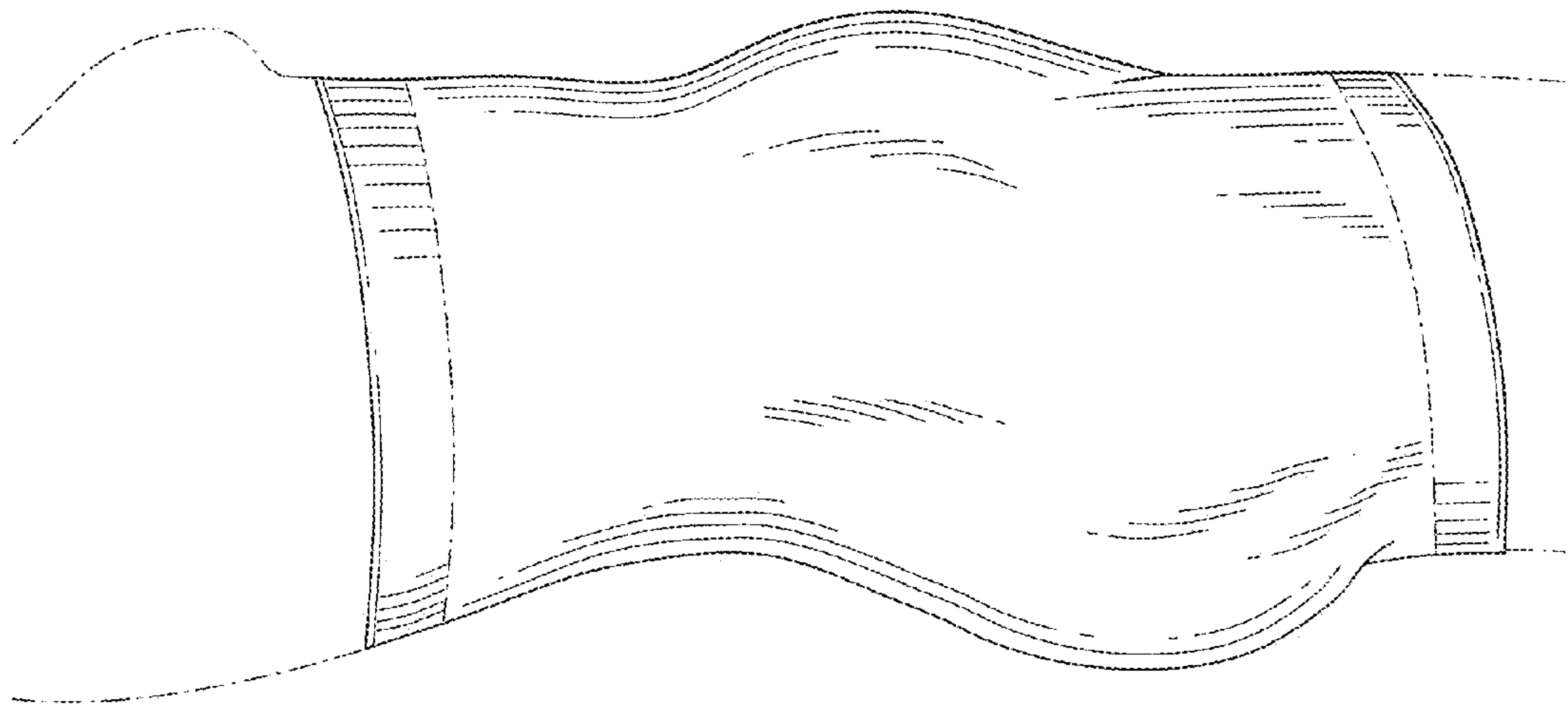

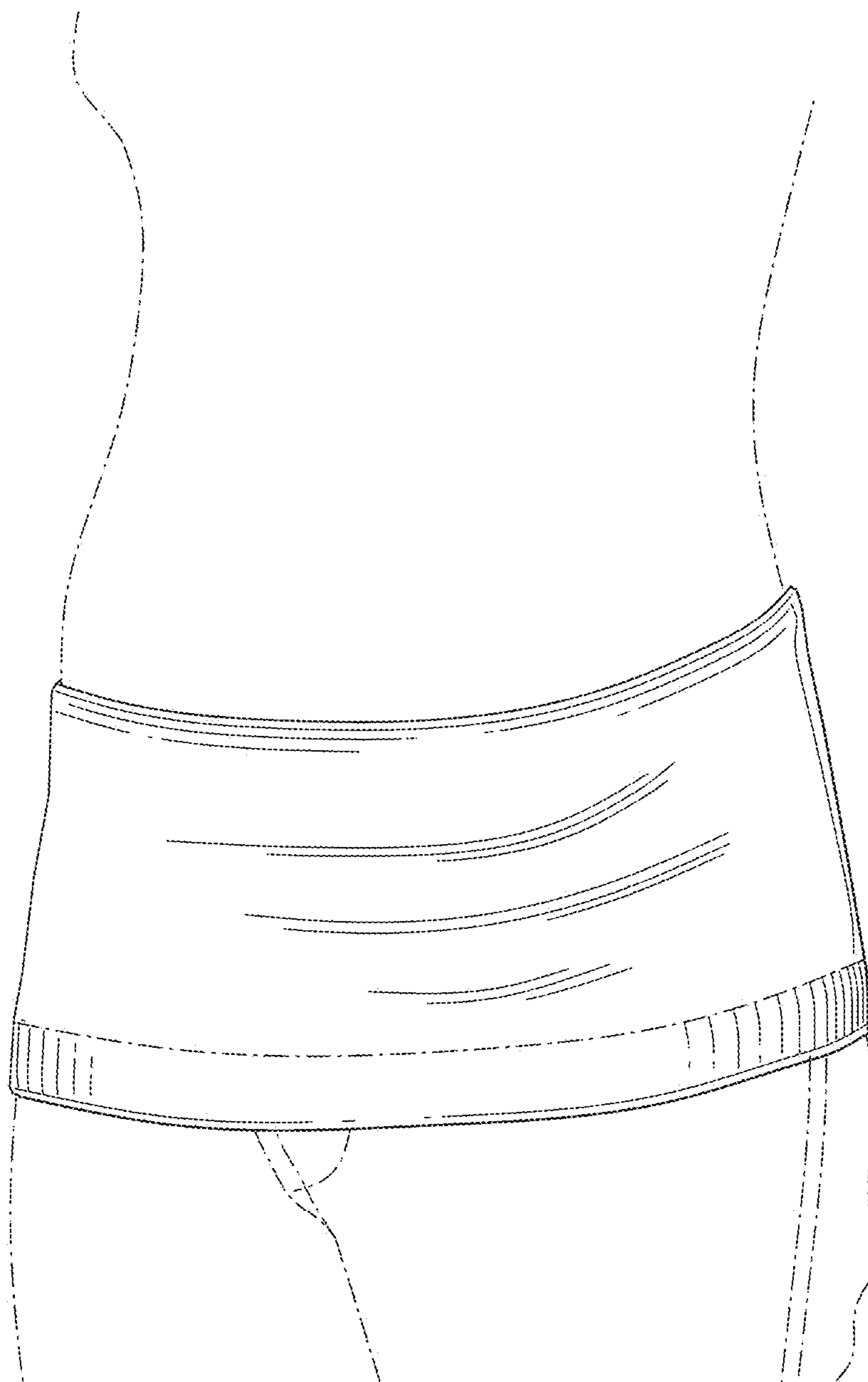
