FIG. 5 is a side view of the pet communication device.

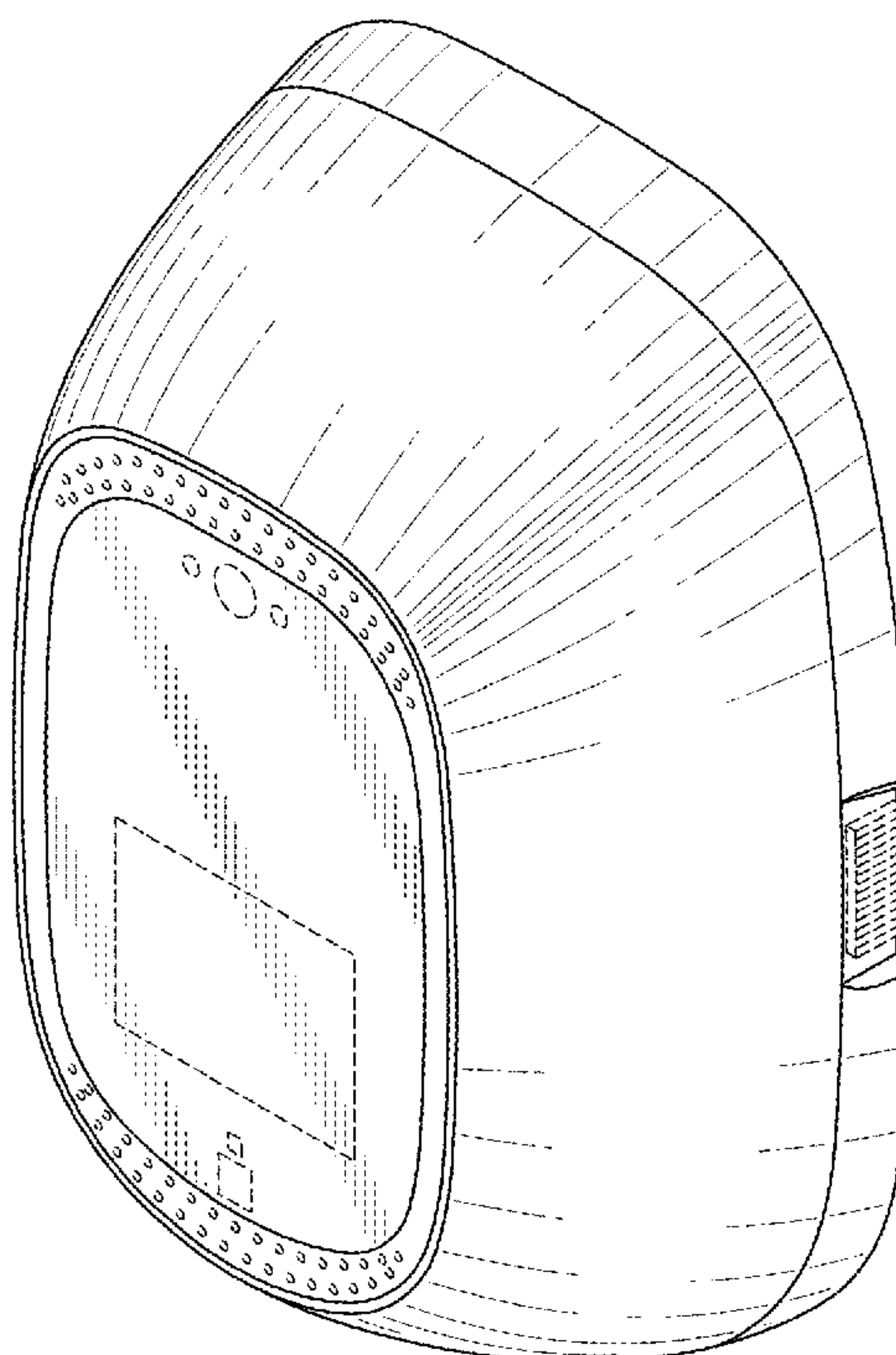
FIG. 6 is a top view of the pet communication device; and,

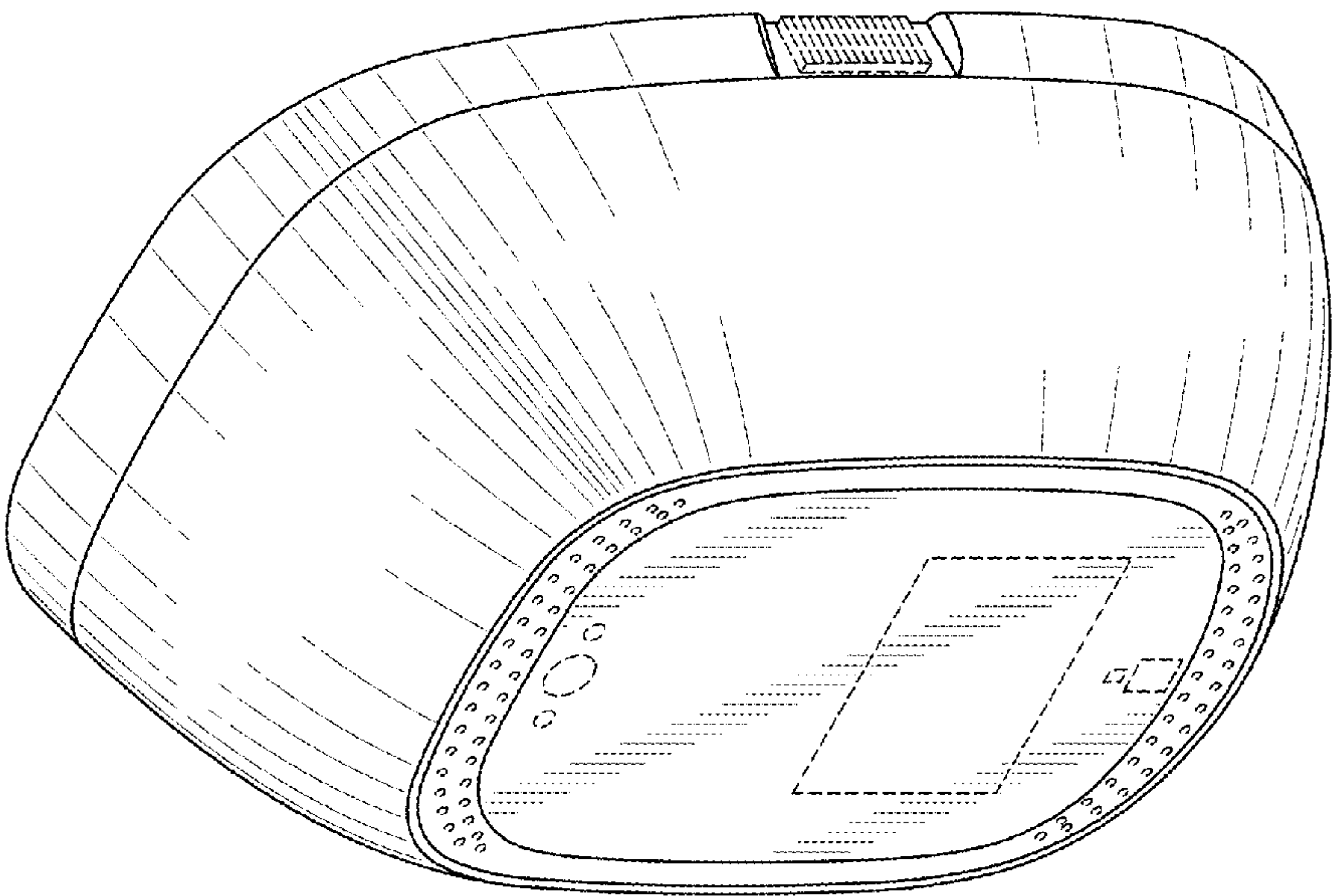

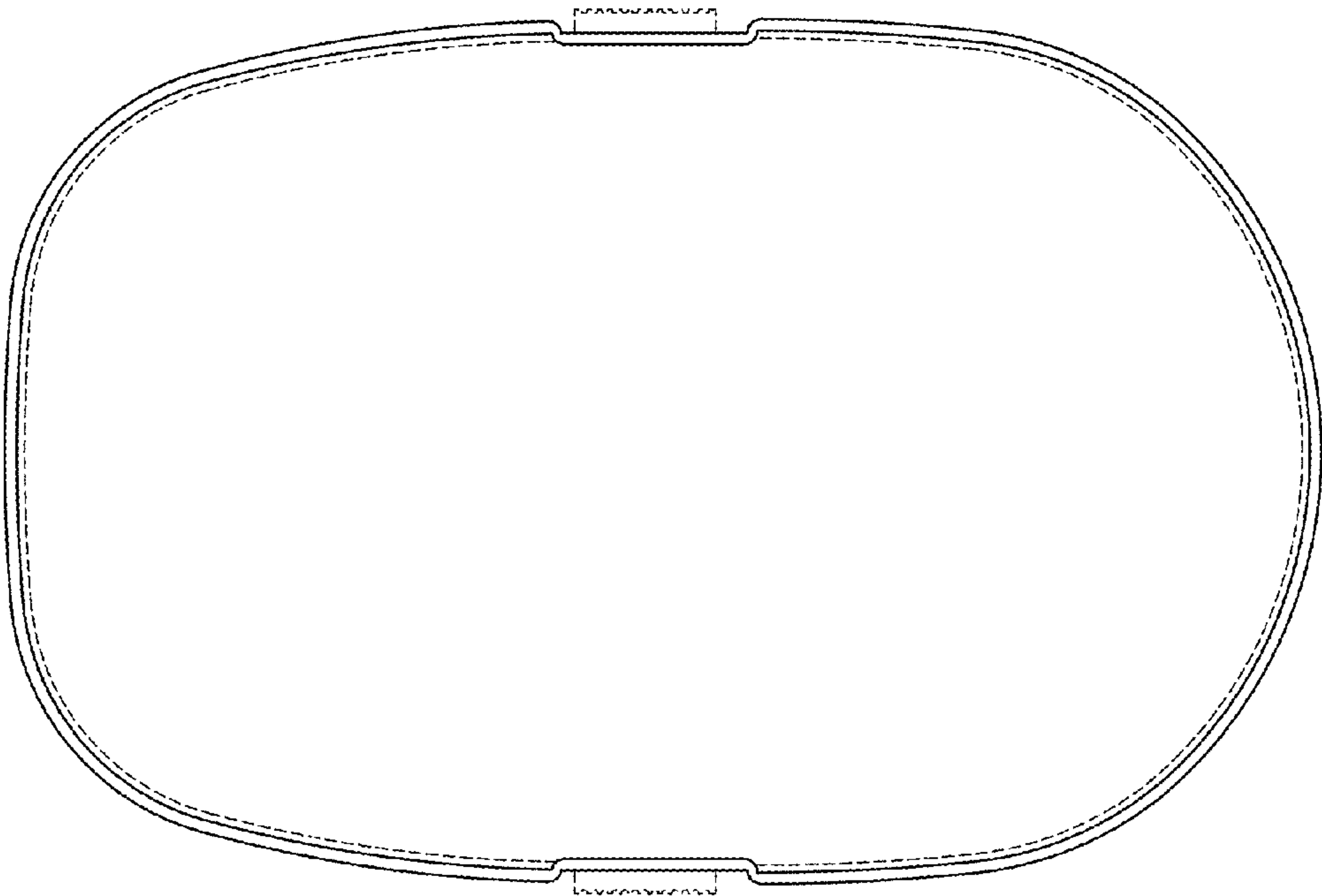

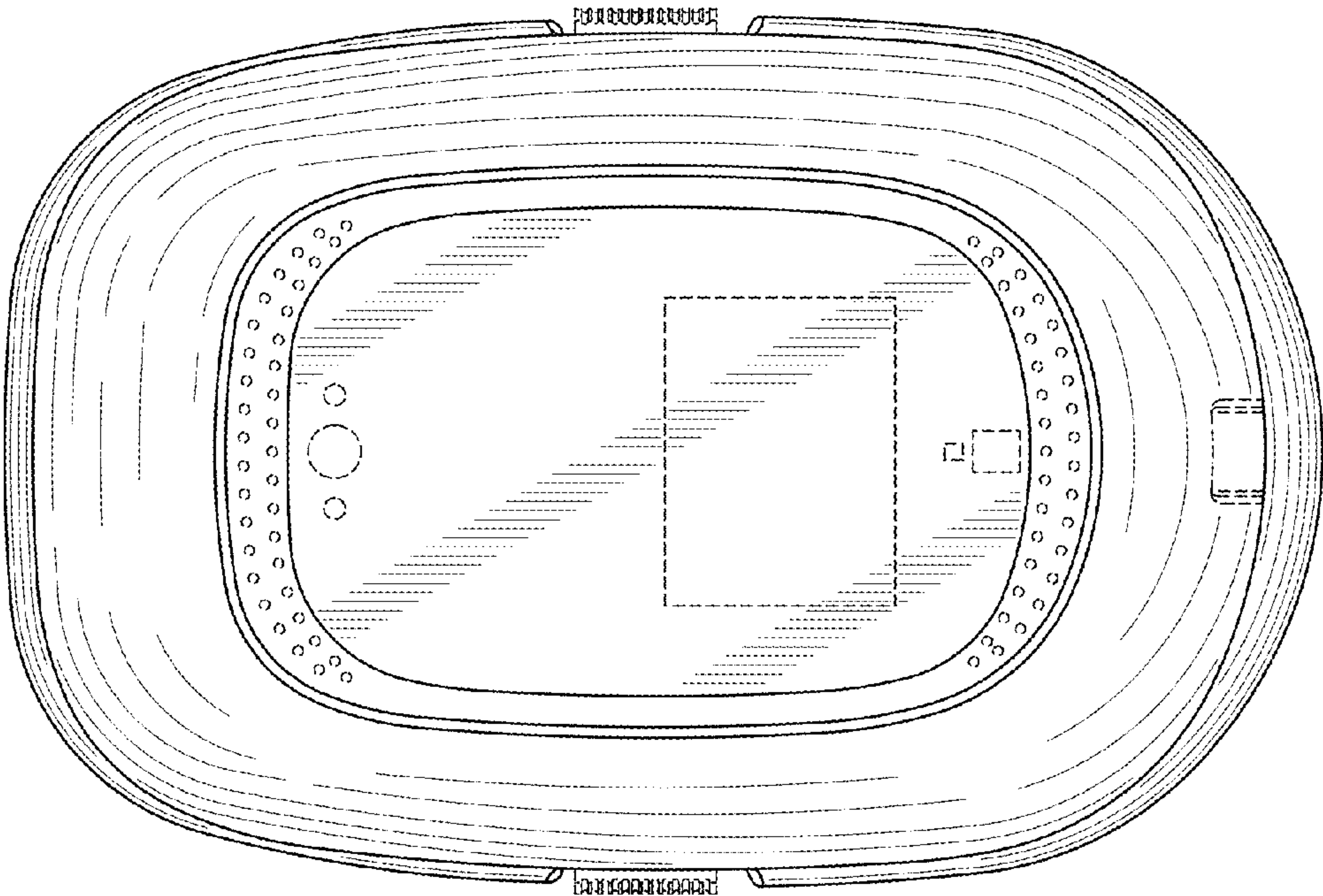

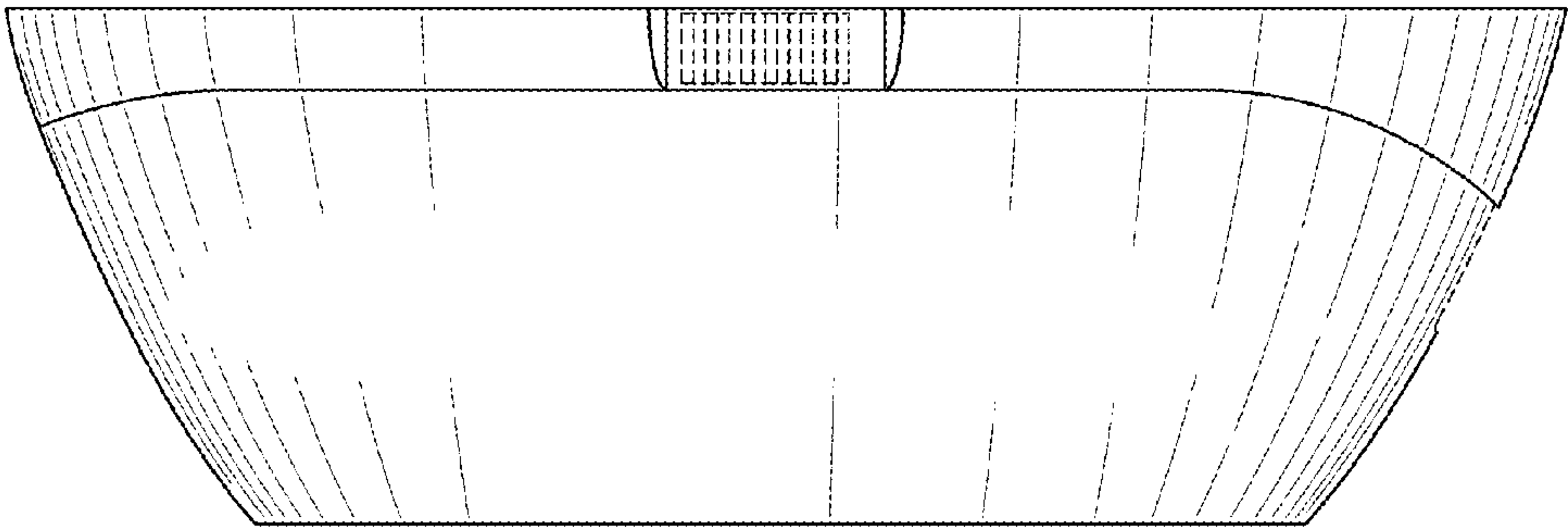

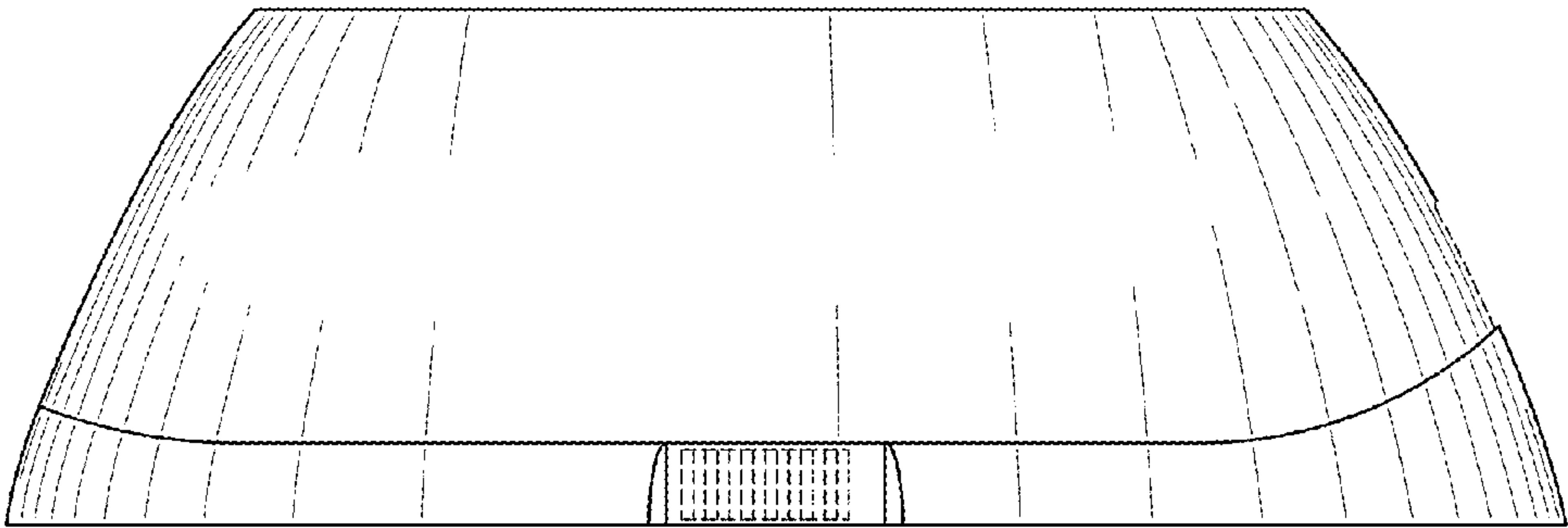

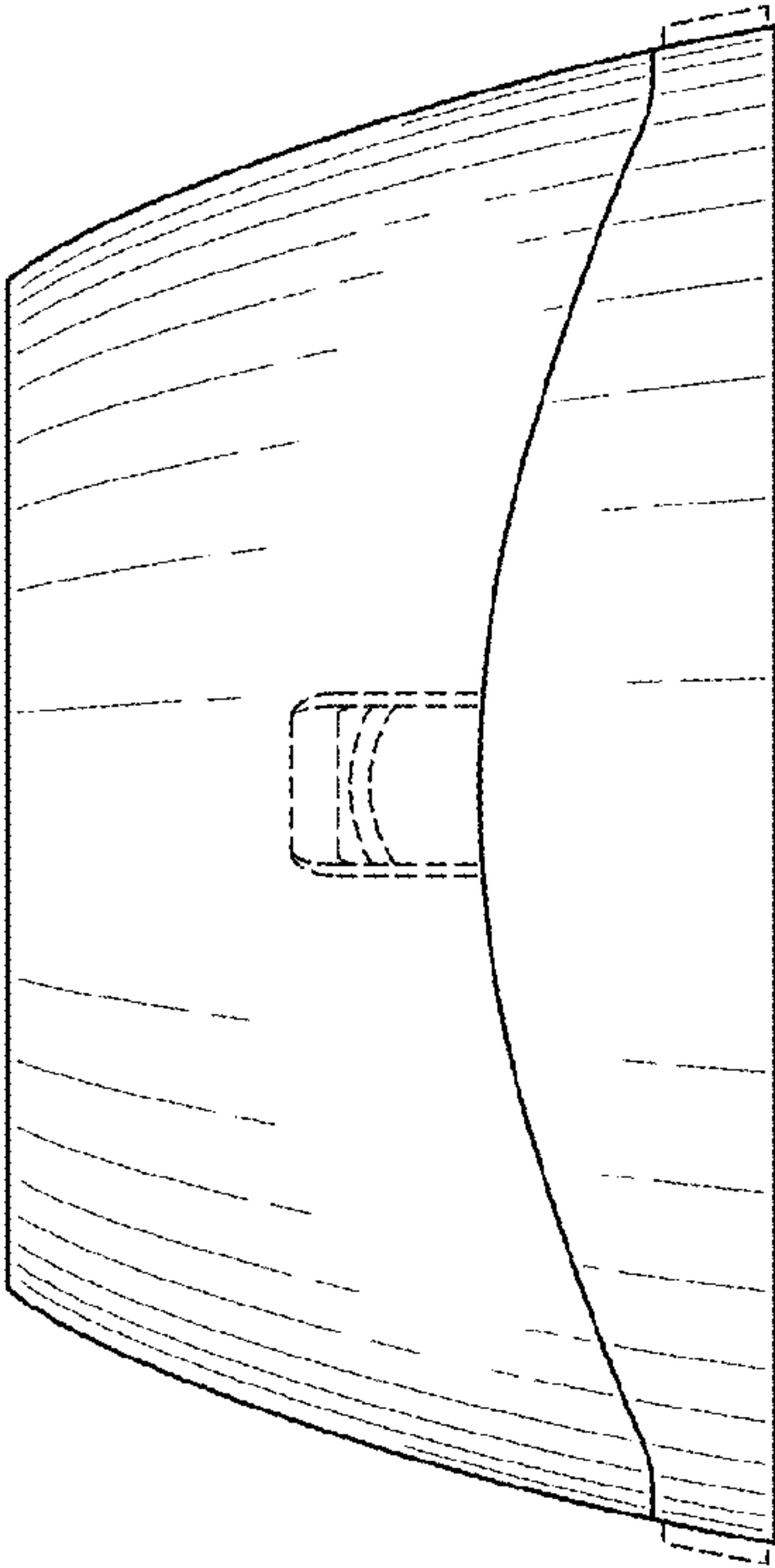

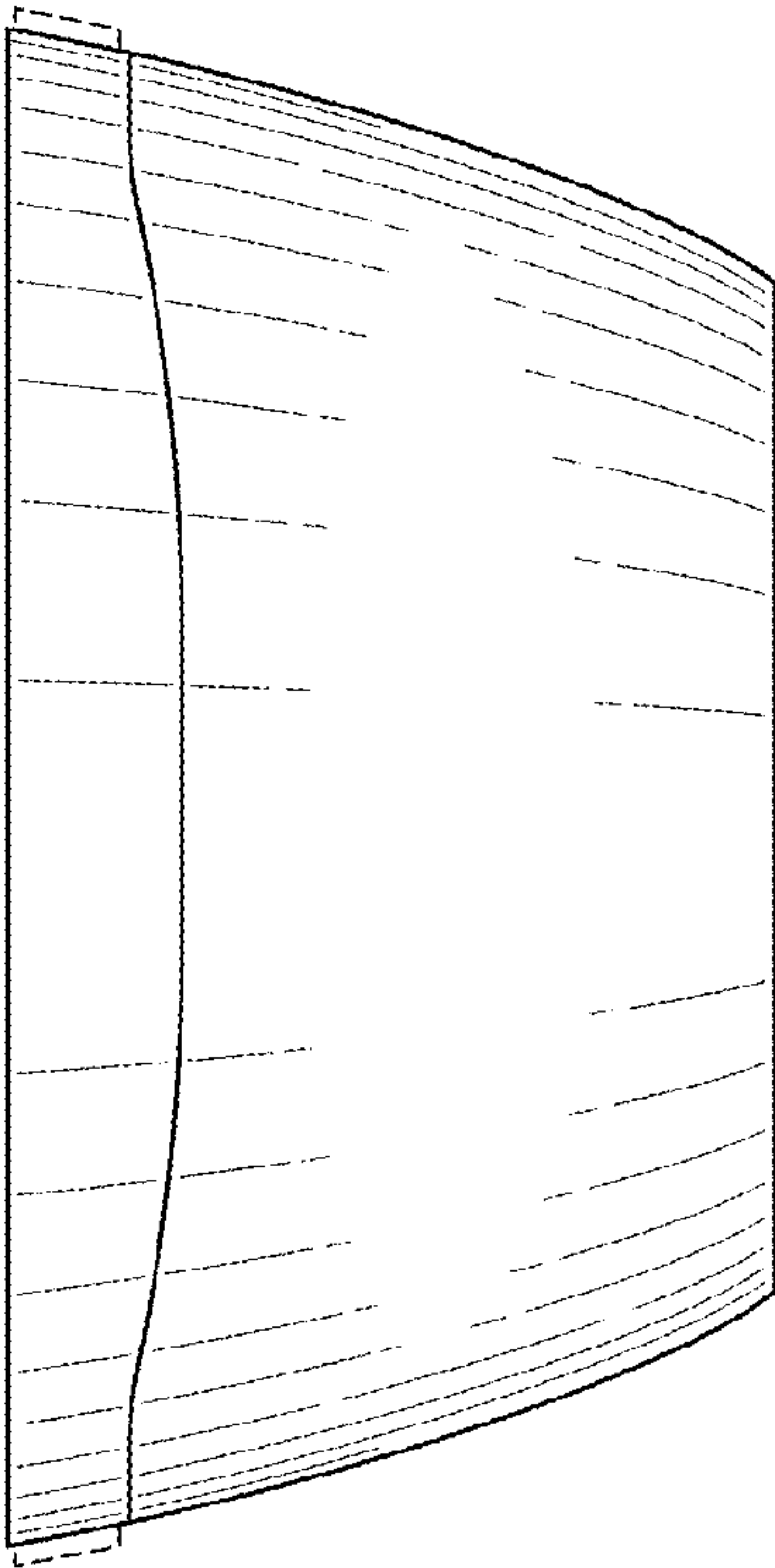
