(57) **CLAIM**

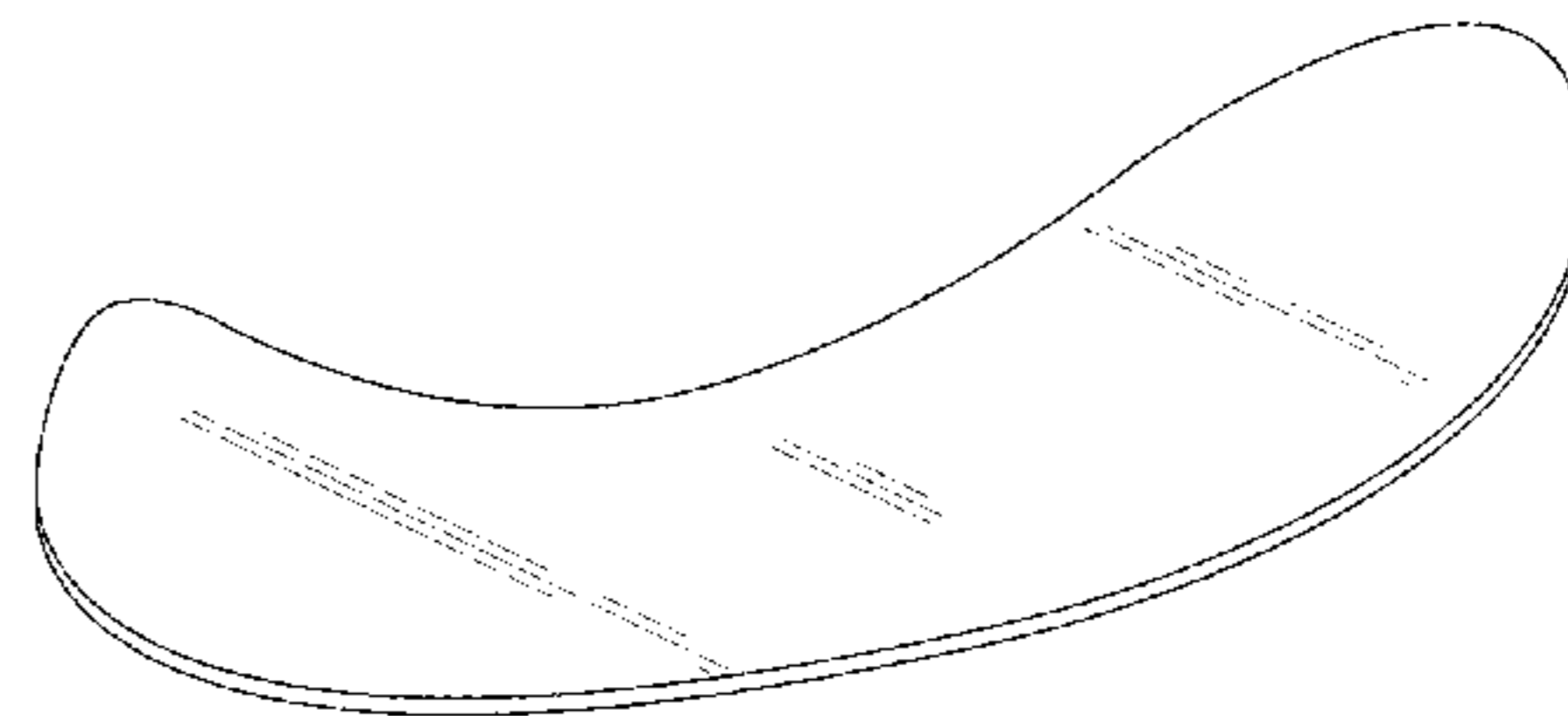
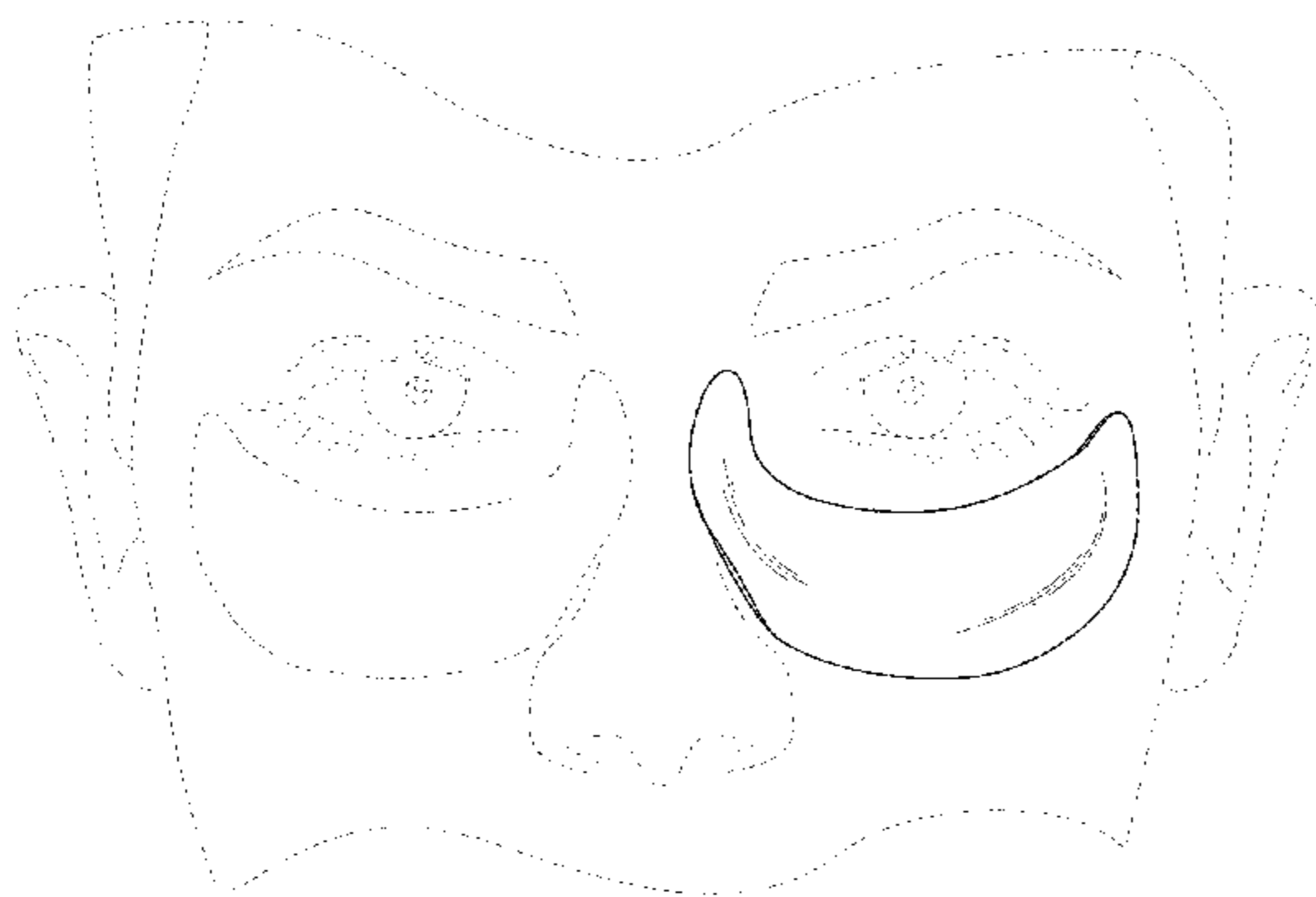
I claim the ornamental design for a facial shield for eye makeup or the like, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a facial shield for eye makeup or the like, showing my new design in a worn configuration; FIG. 2 is an enlarged perspective view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of FIG. 2; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 2; FIG. 5 is a left-side elevational view of FIG. 2; FIG. 6 is a right-side elevational view of FIG. 2; FIG. 7 is a top plan view of FIG. 2; and, FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 2.

The broken lines showing a person's face in FIG. 1 depict environmental matter and form no part of the claimed design.

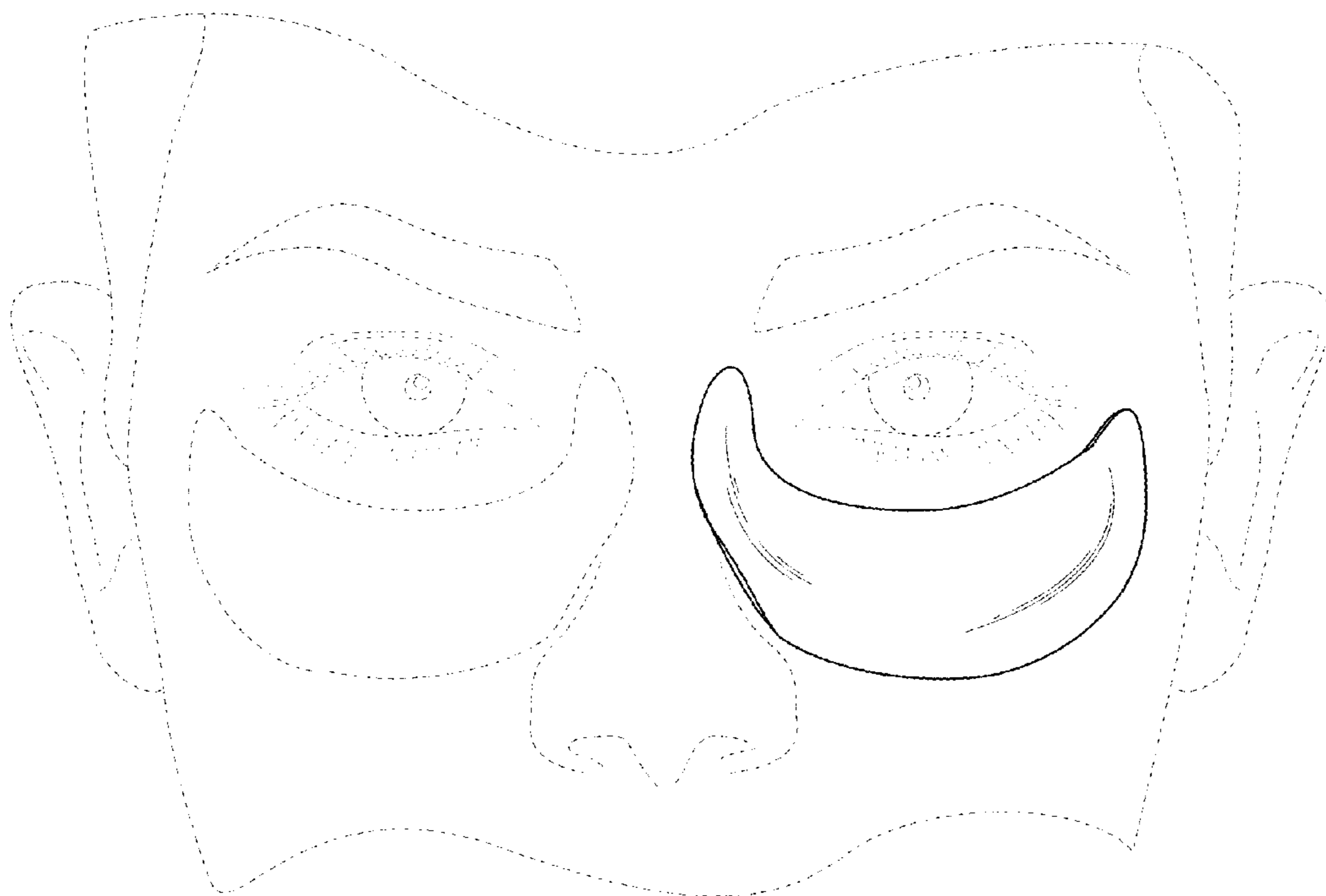

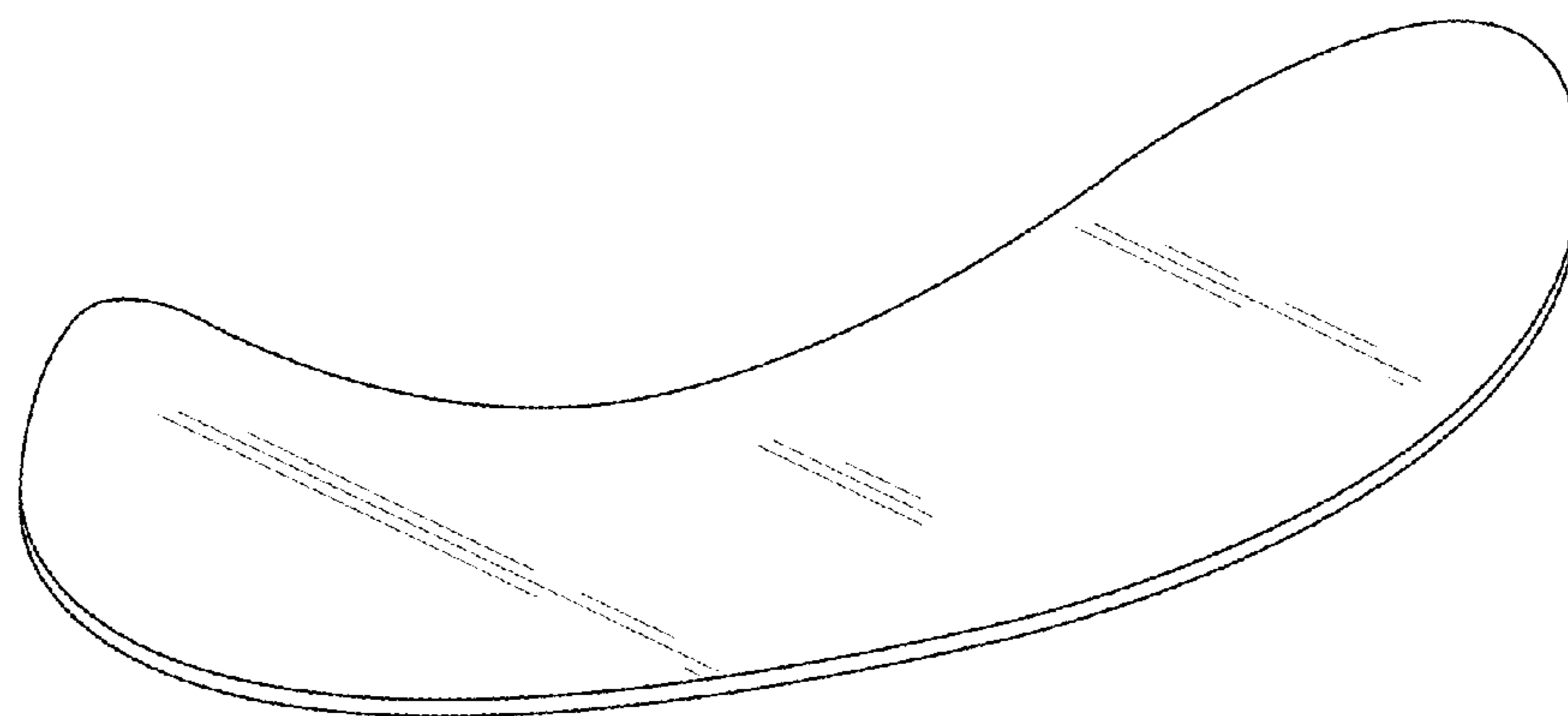

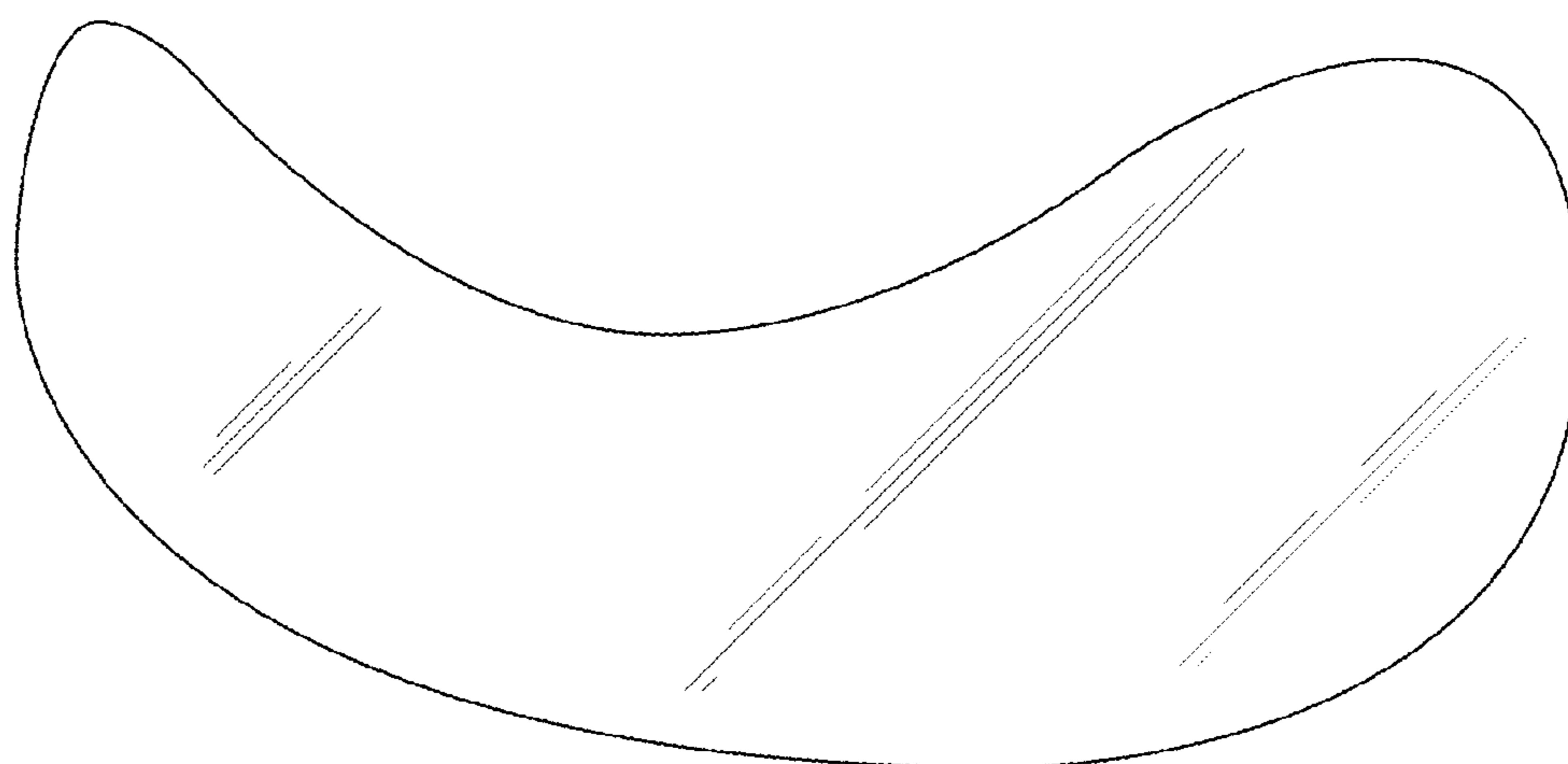

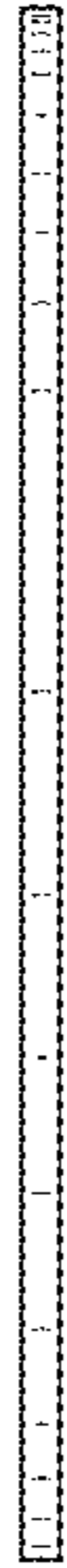
