FIG. 11 is a top view of a second embodiment of a tray;

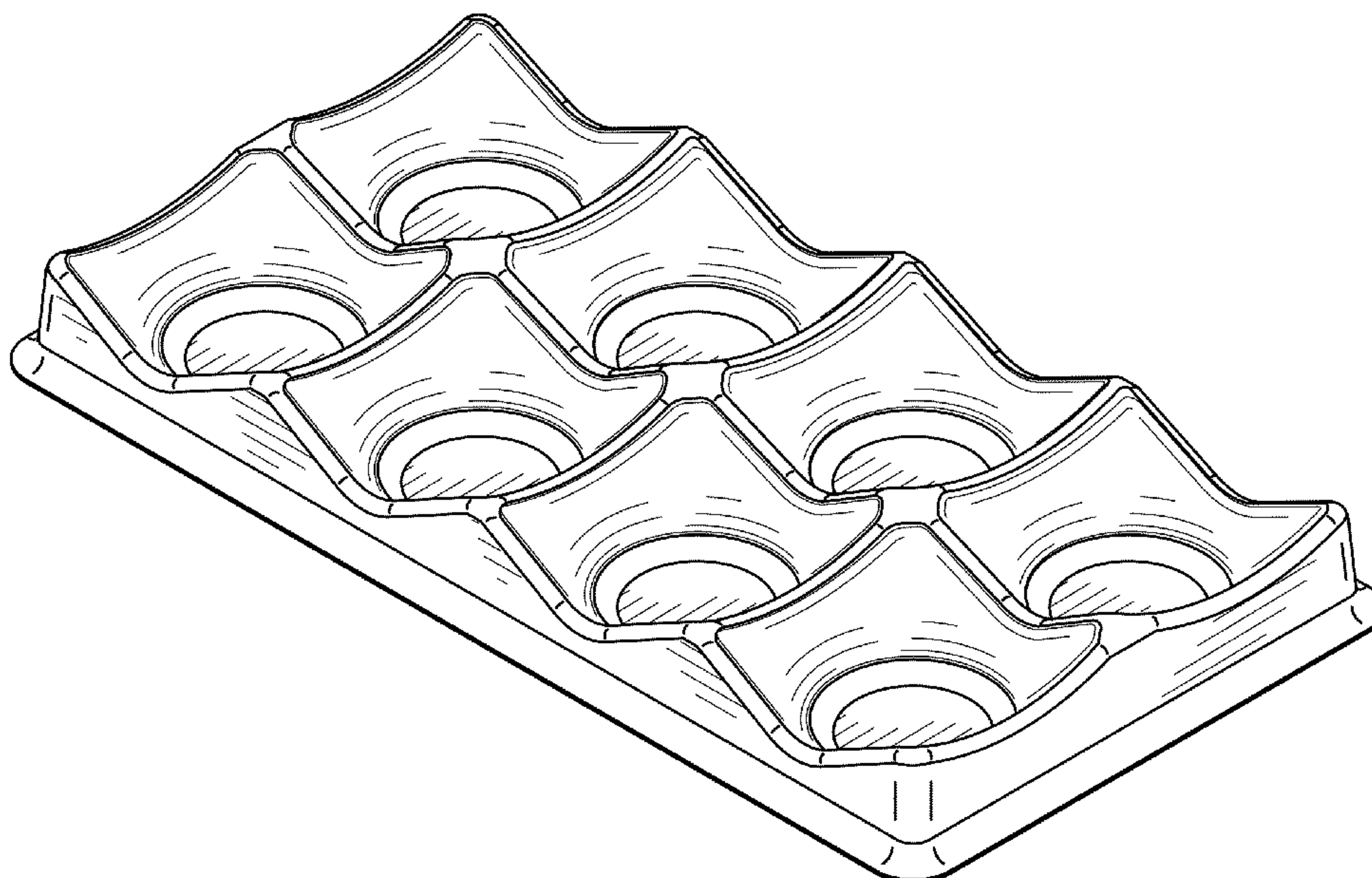
FIG. 12 is a bottom view of a second embodiment of a tray;

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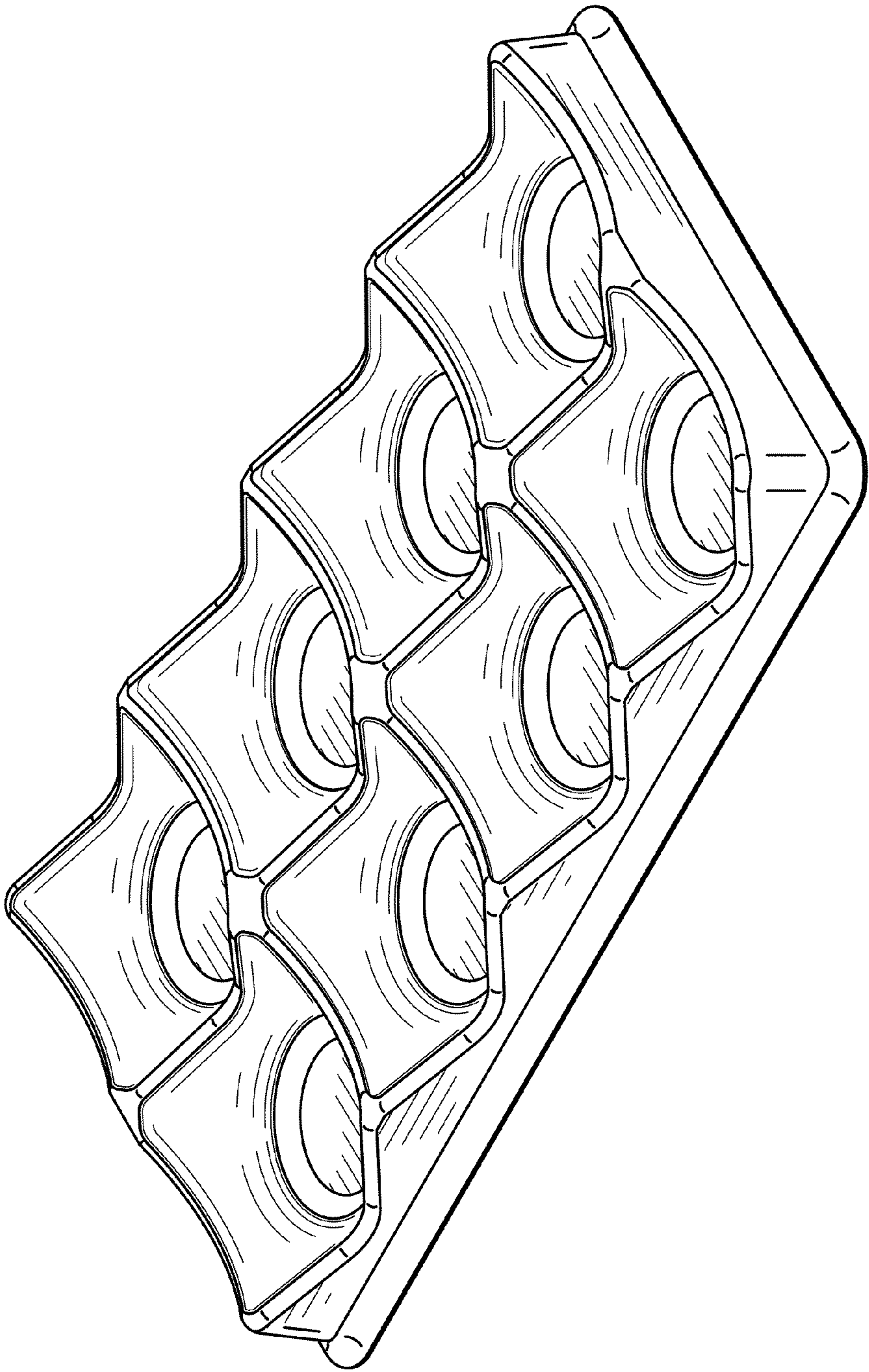

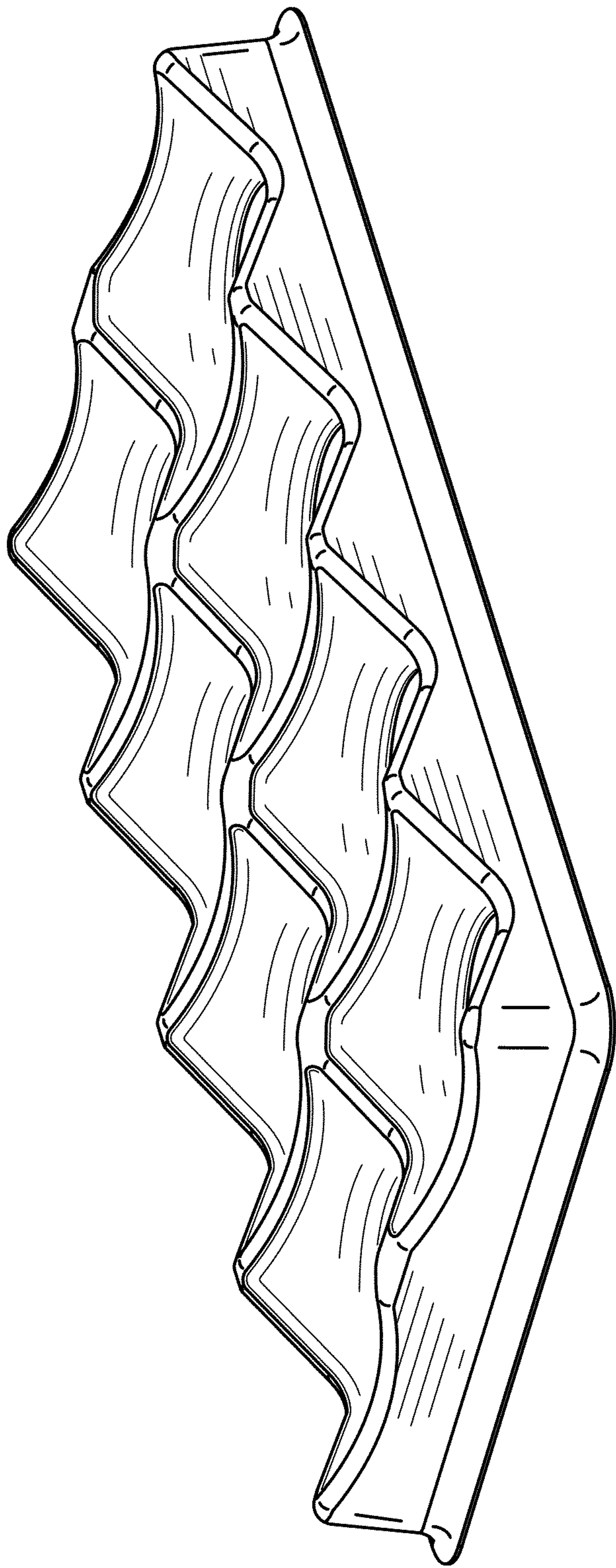

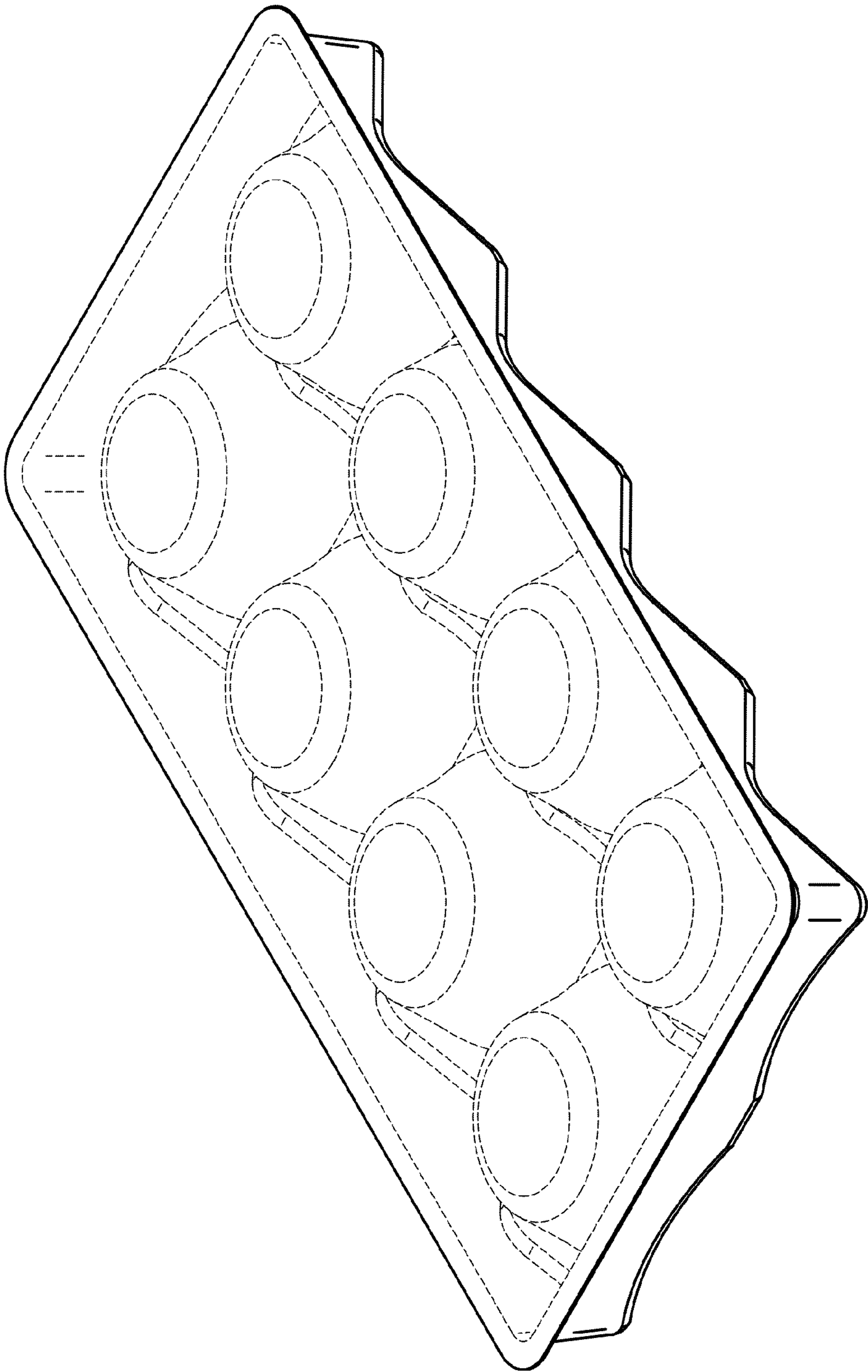

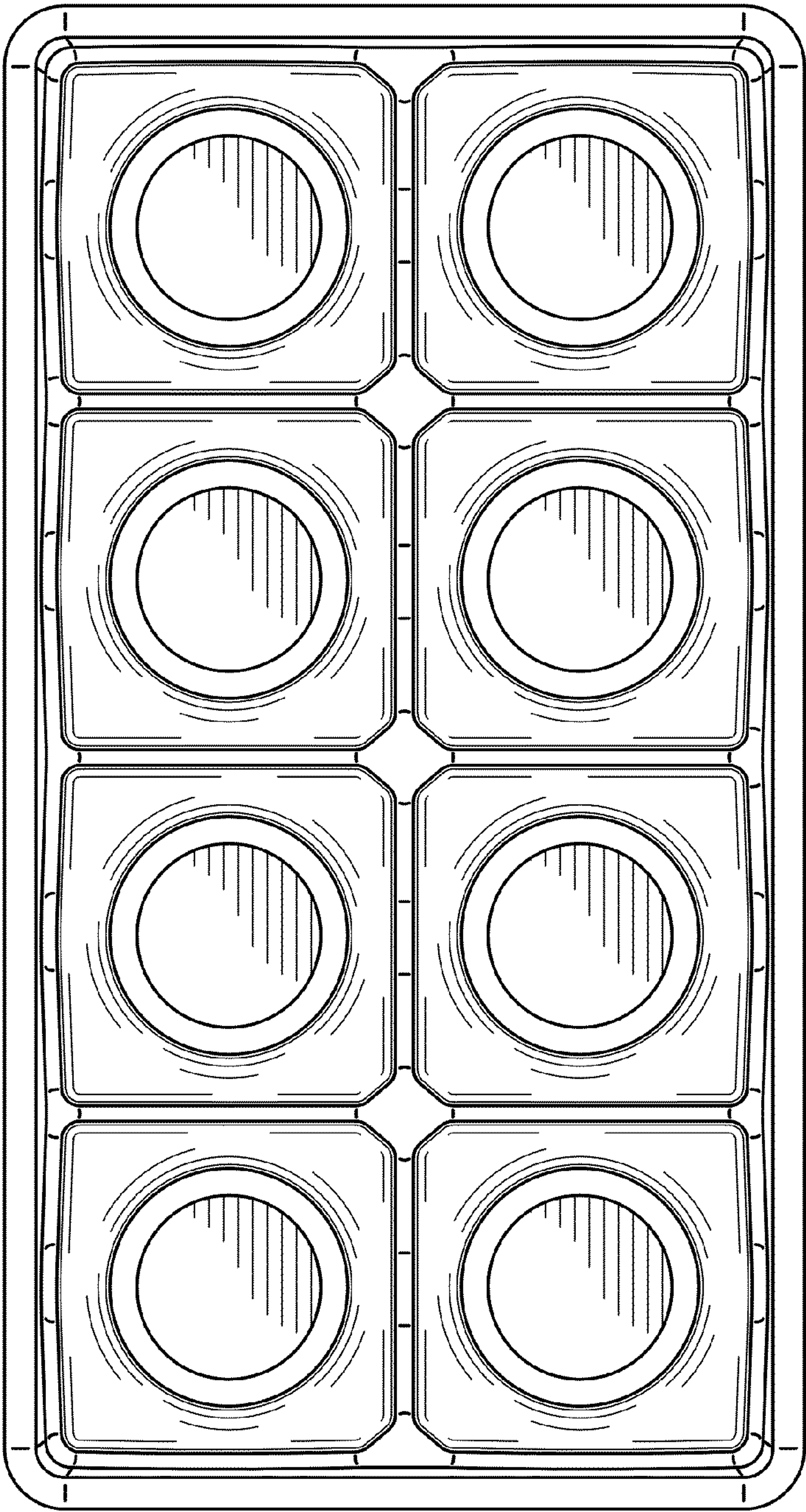

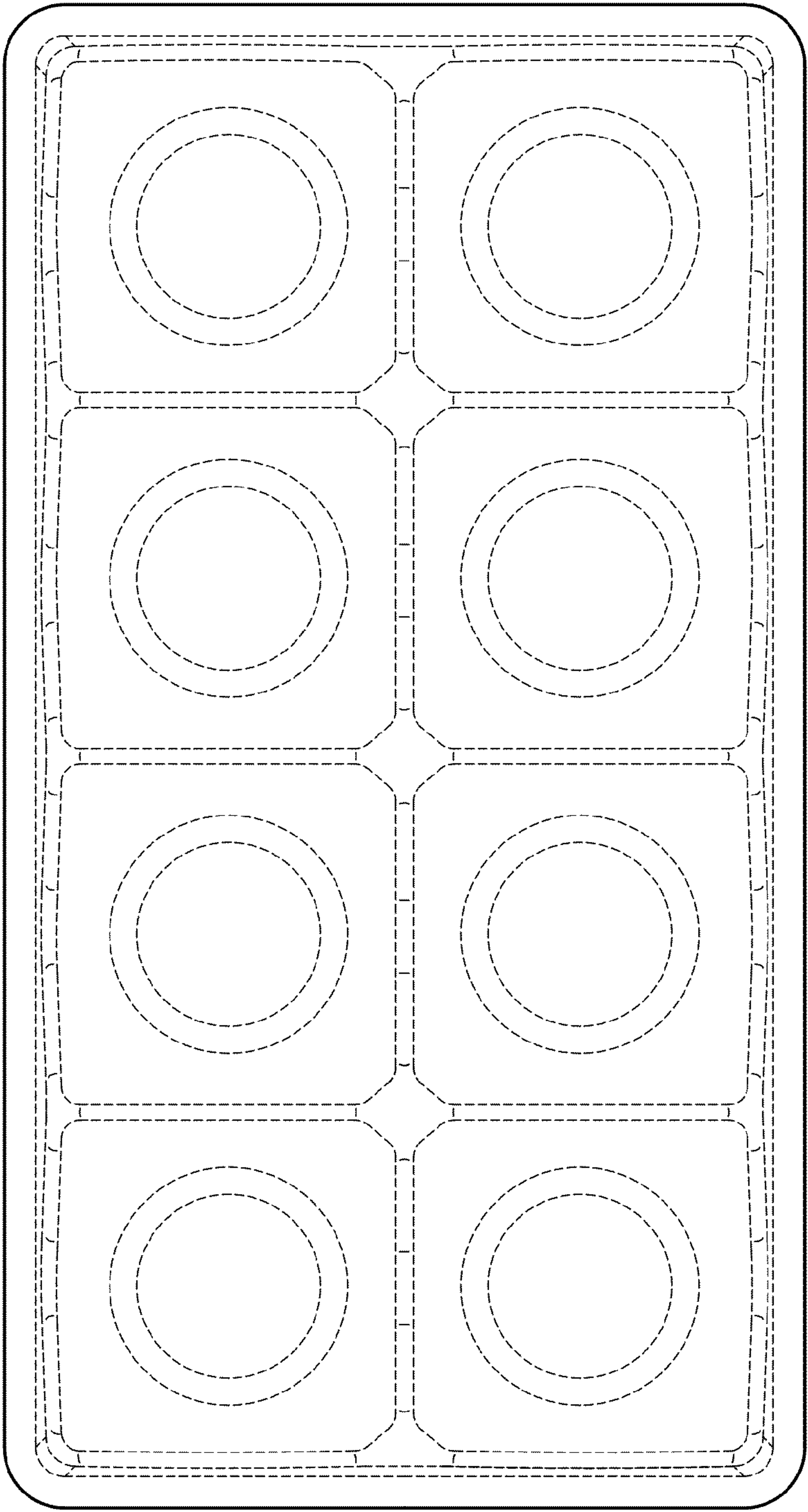

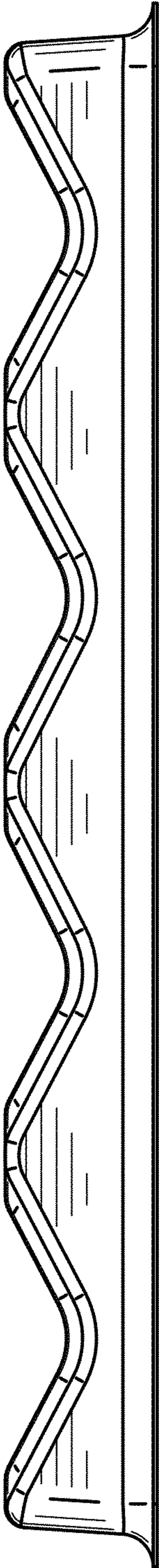

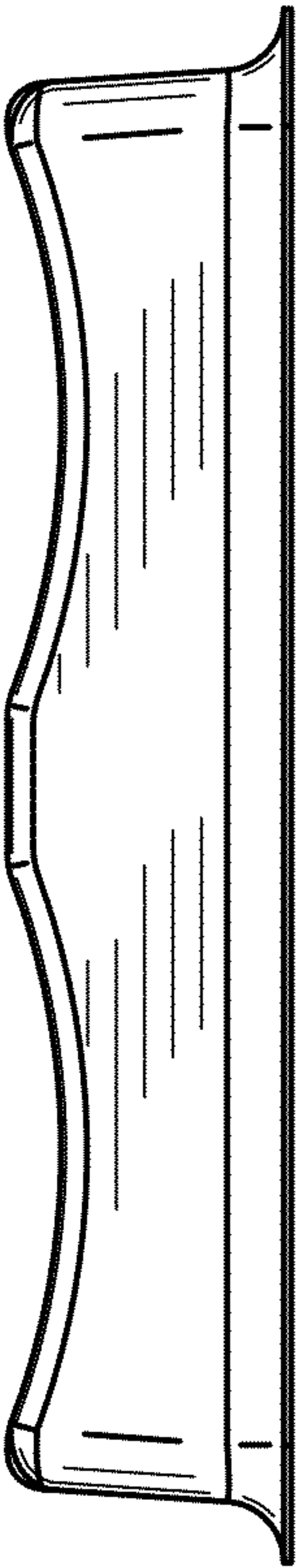

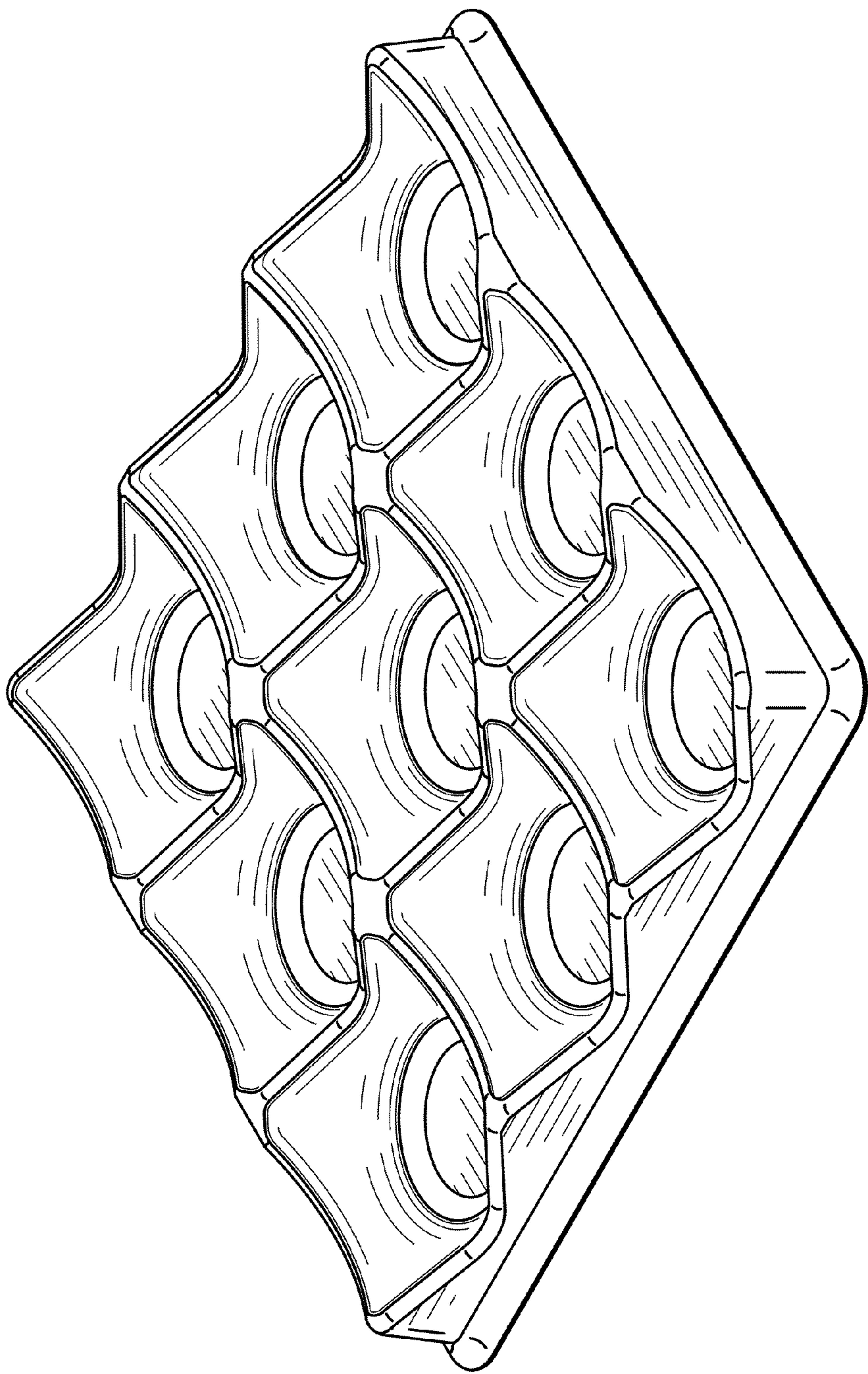

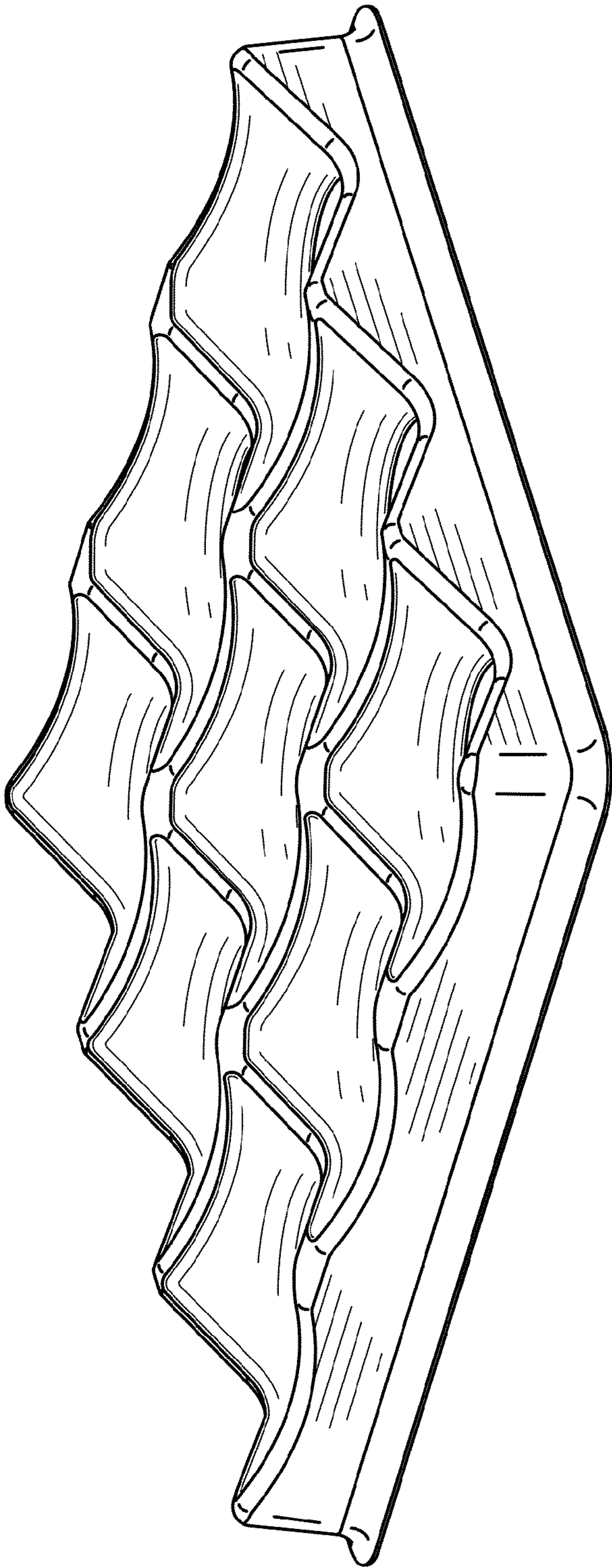

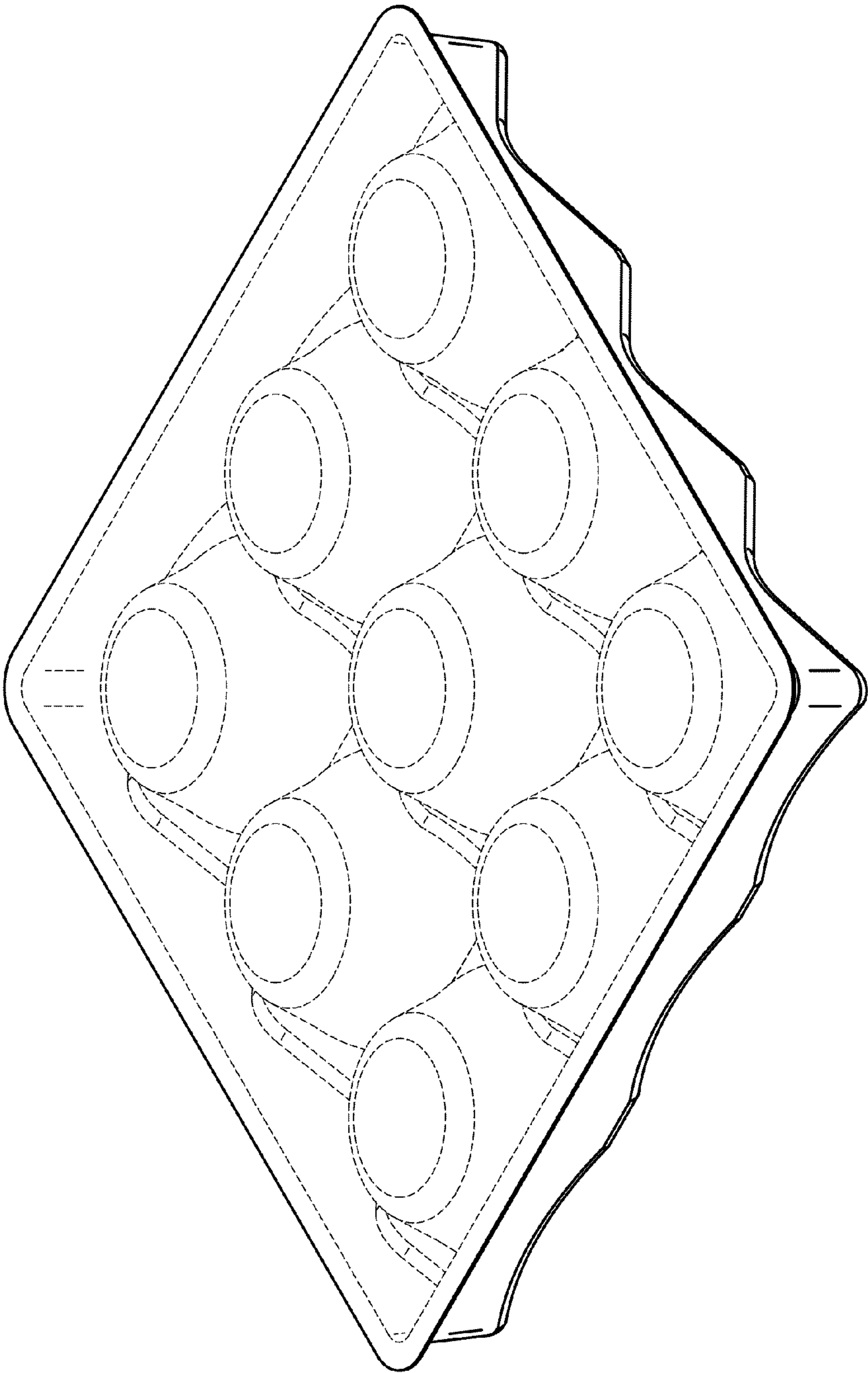

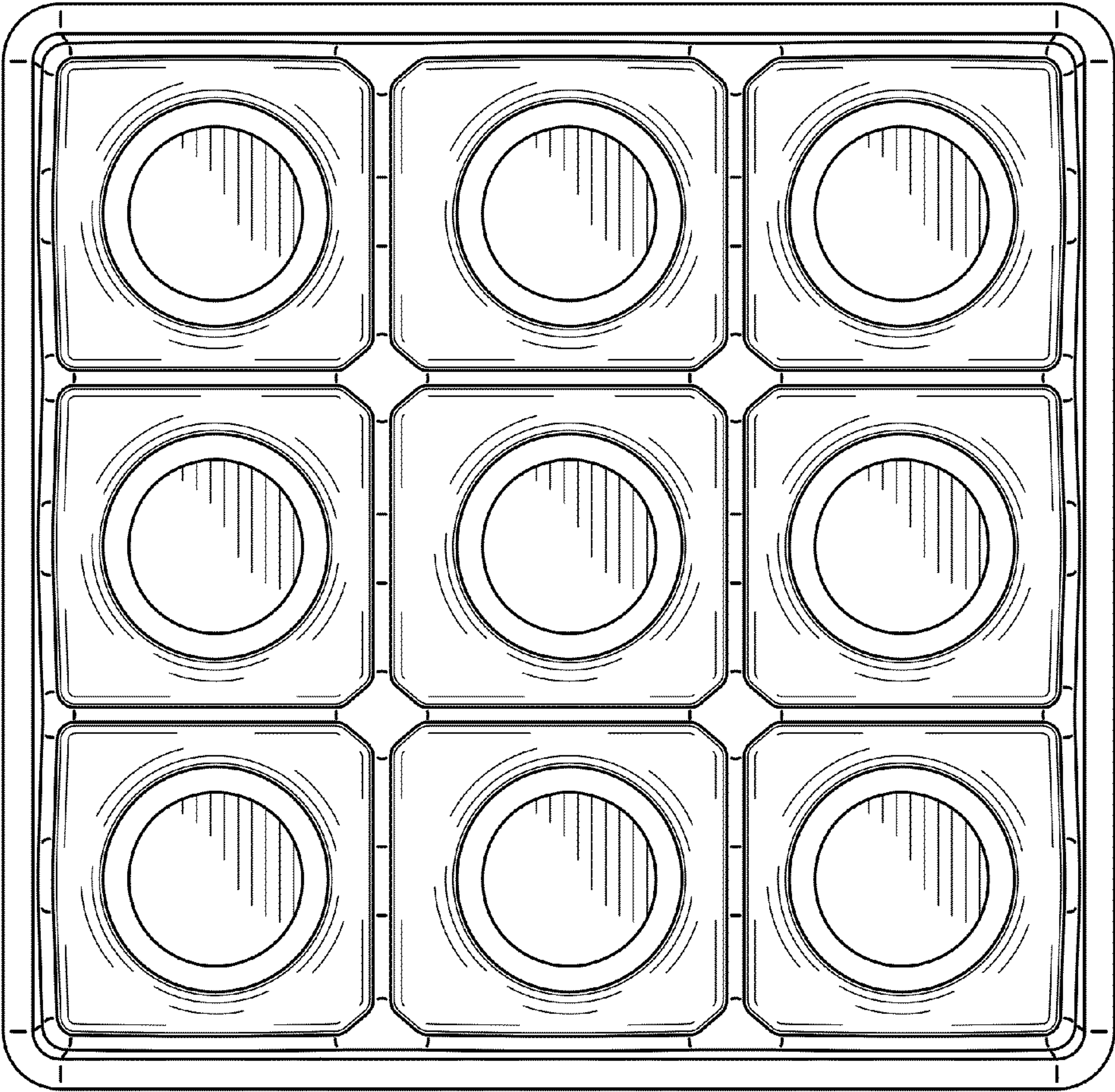

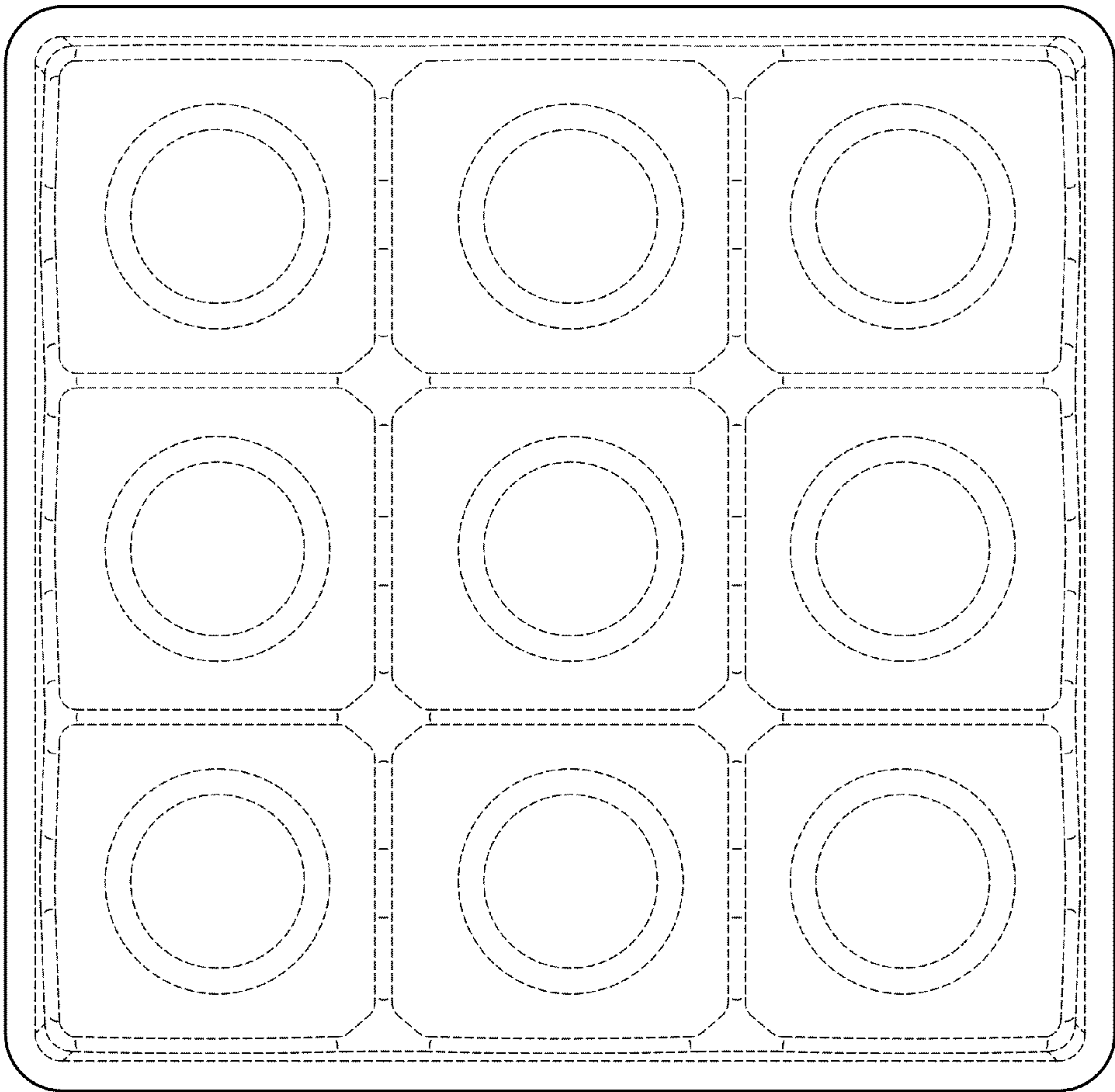

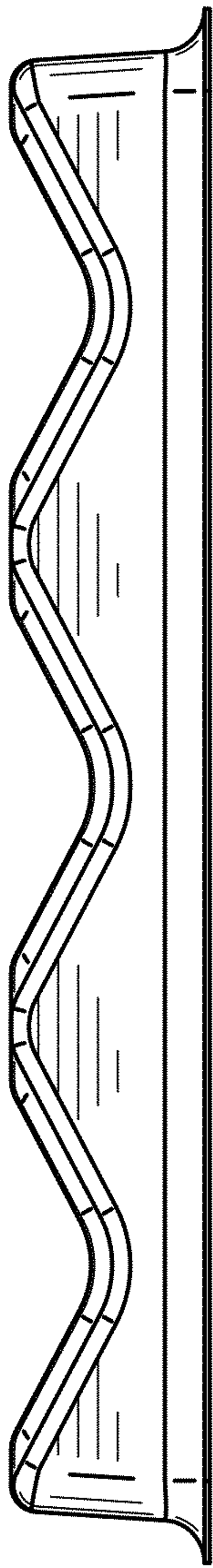

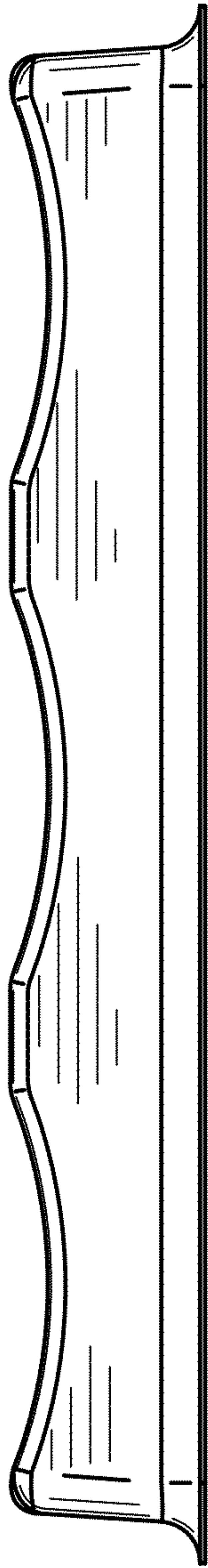
