FIG. 7 is a bottom view of a second embodiment of the invention;

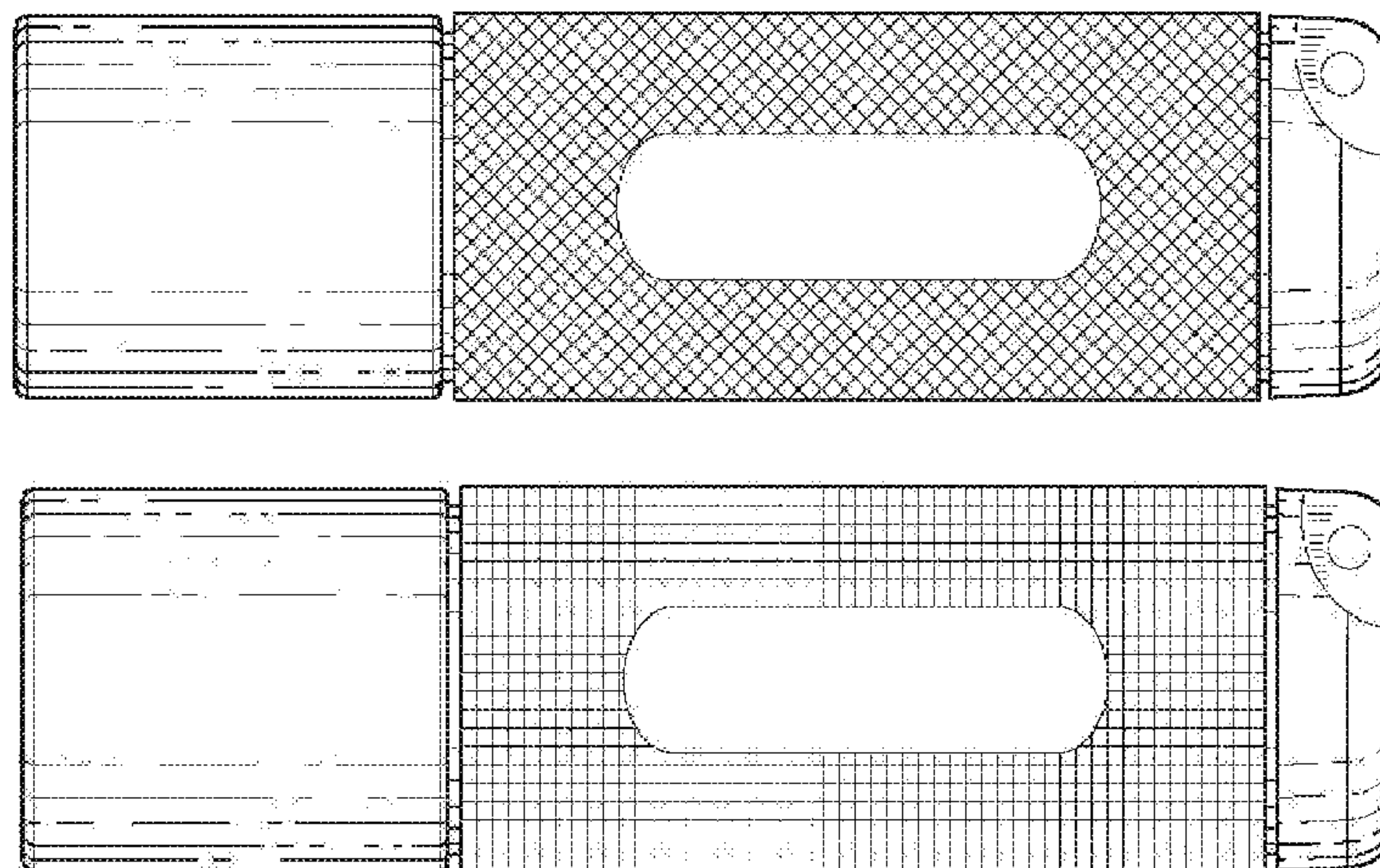
FIG. 8 is a top view of the second embodiment of the invention;

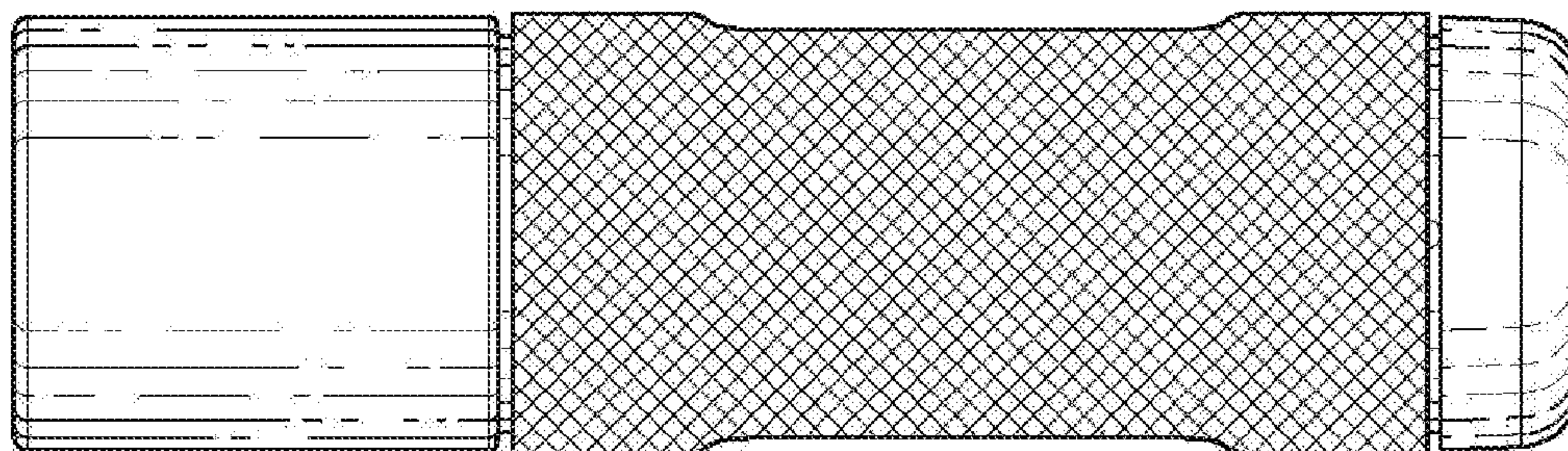

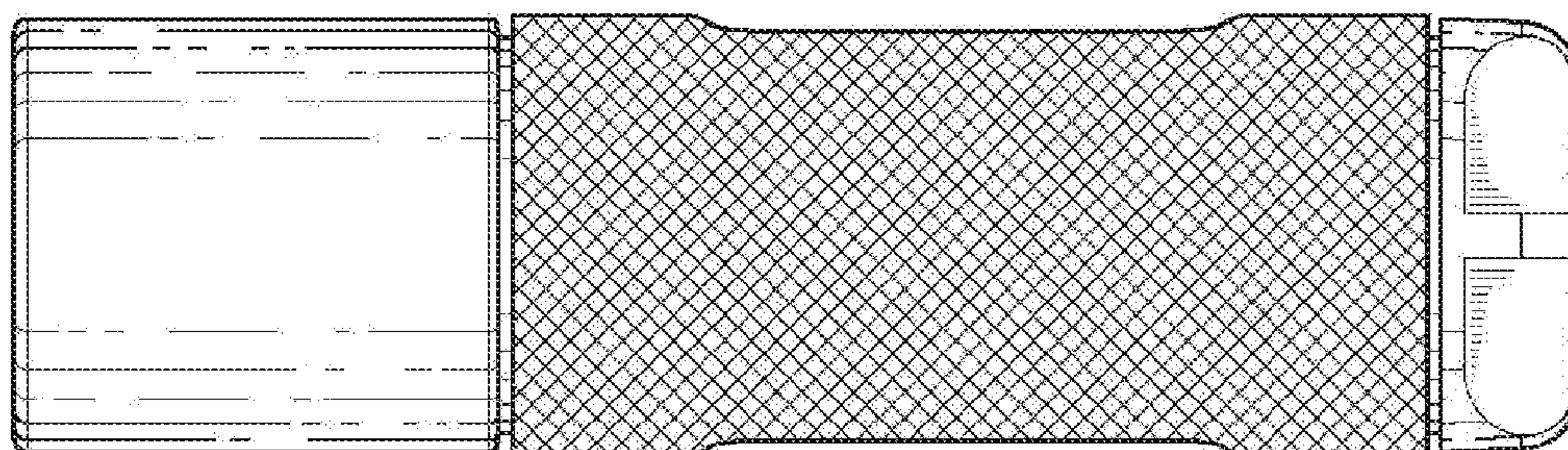

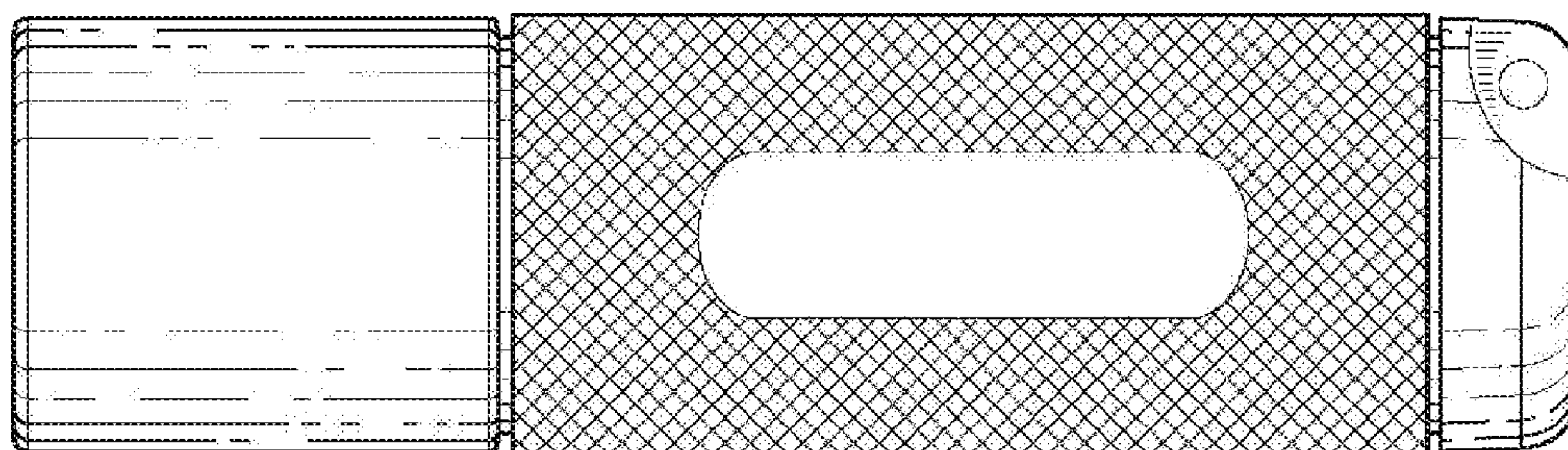

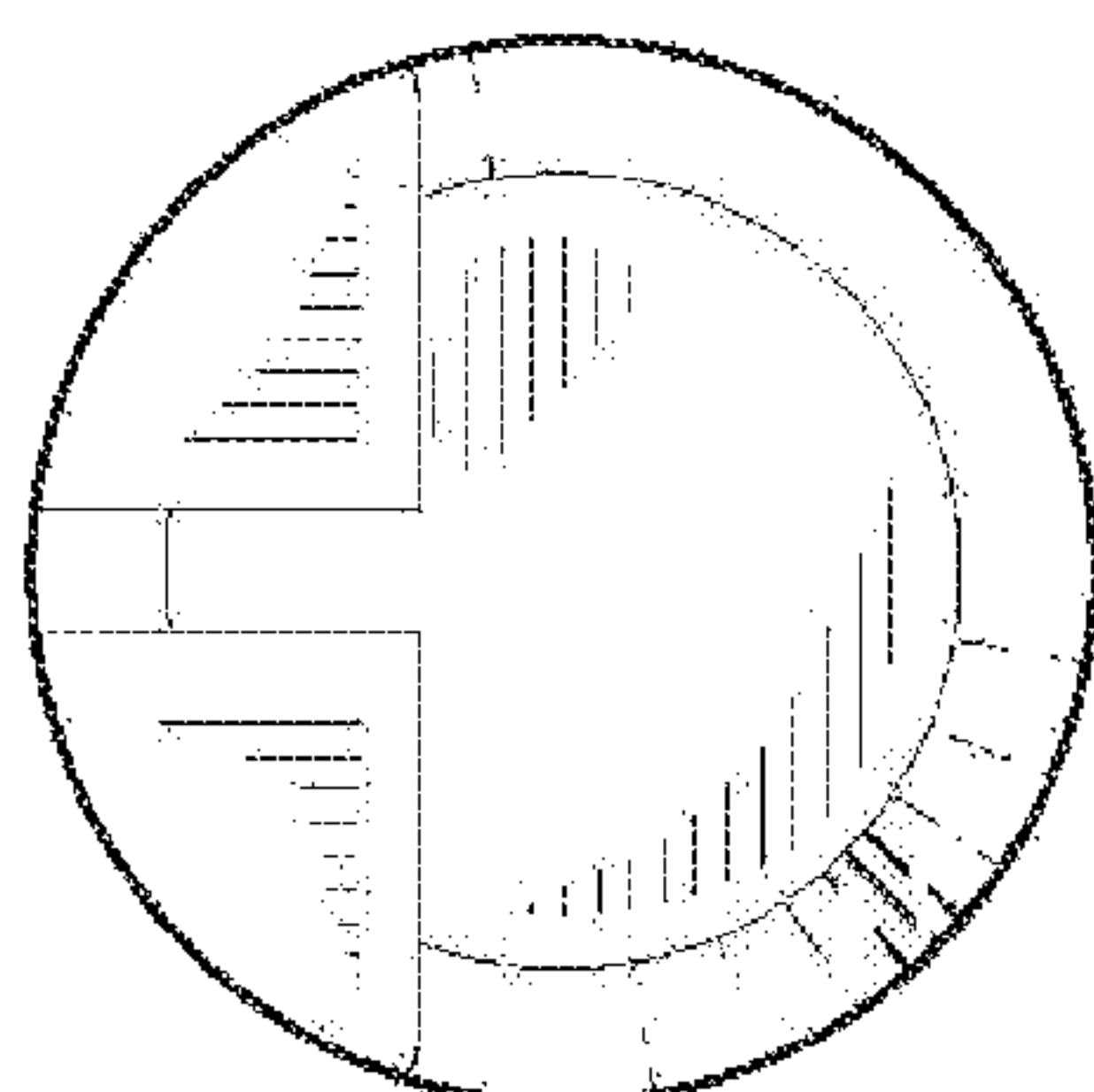

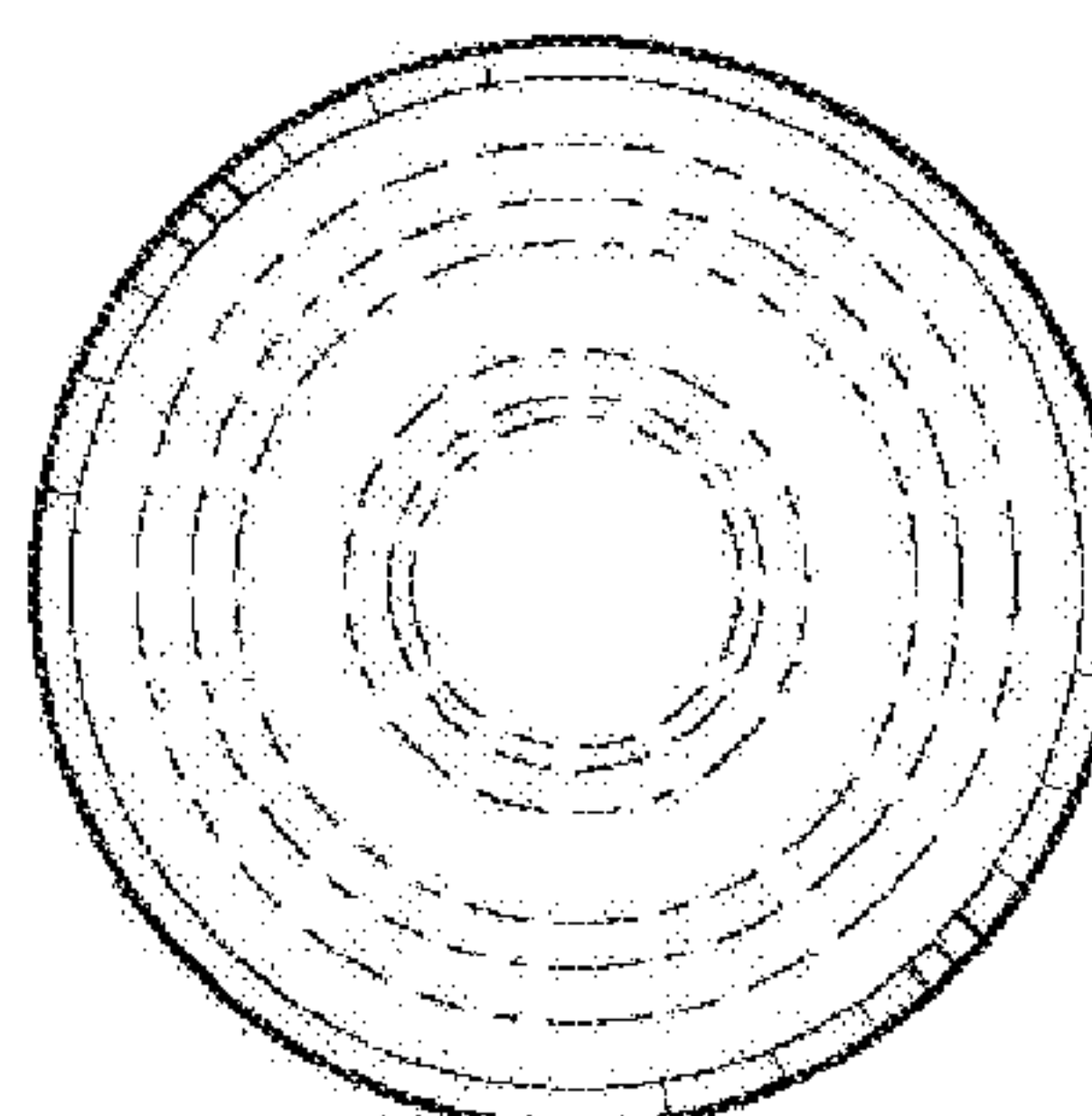

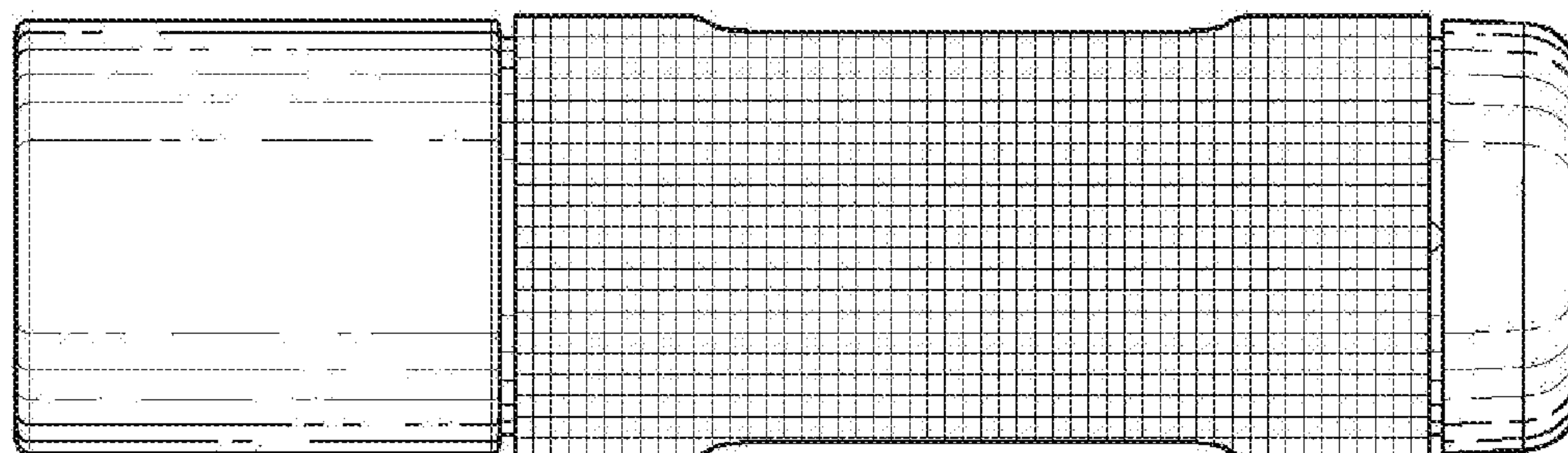

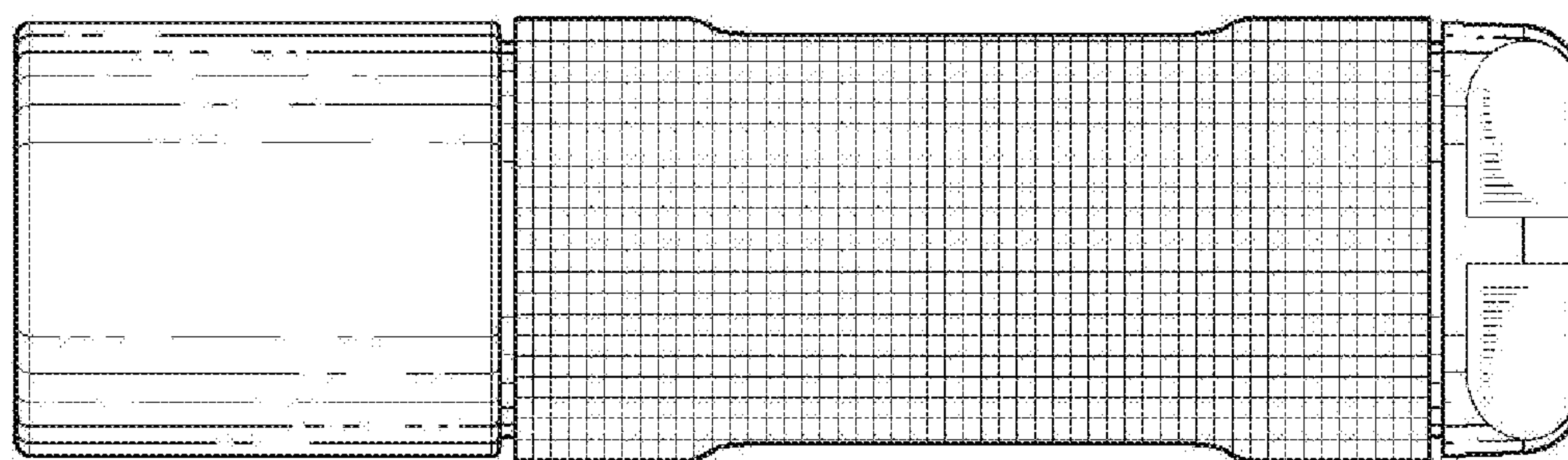

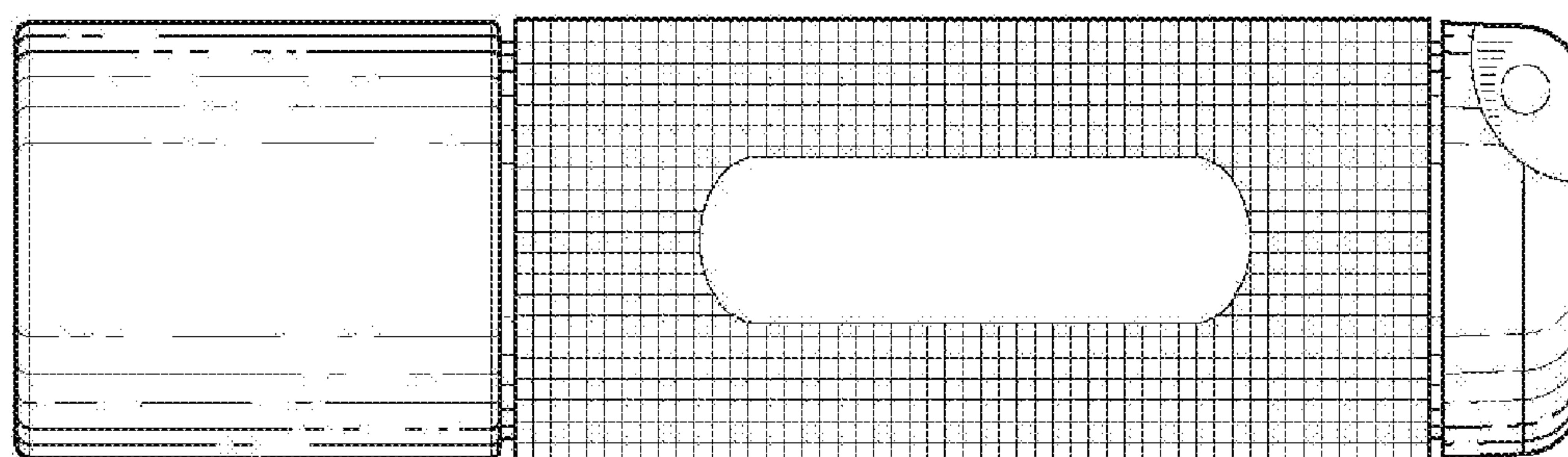

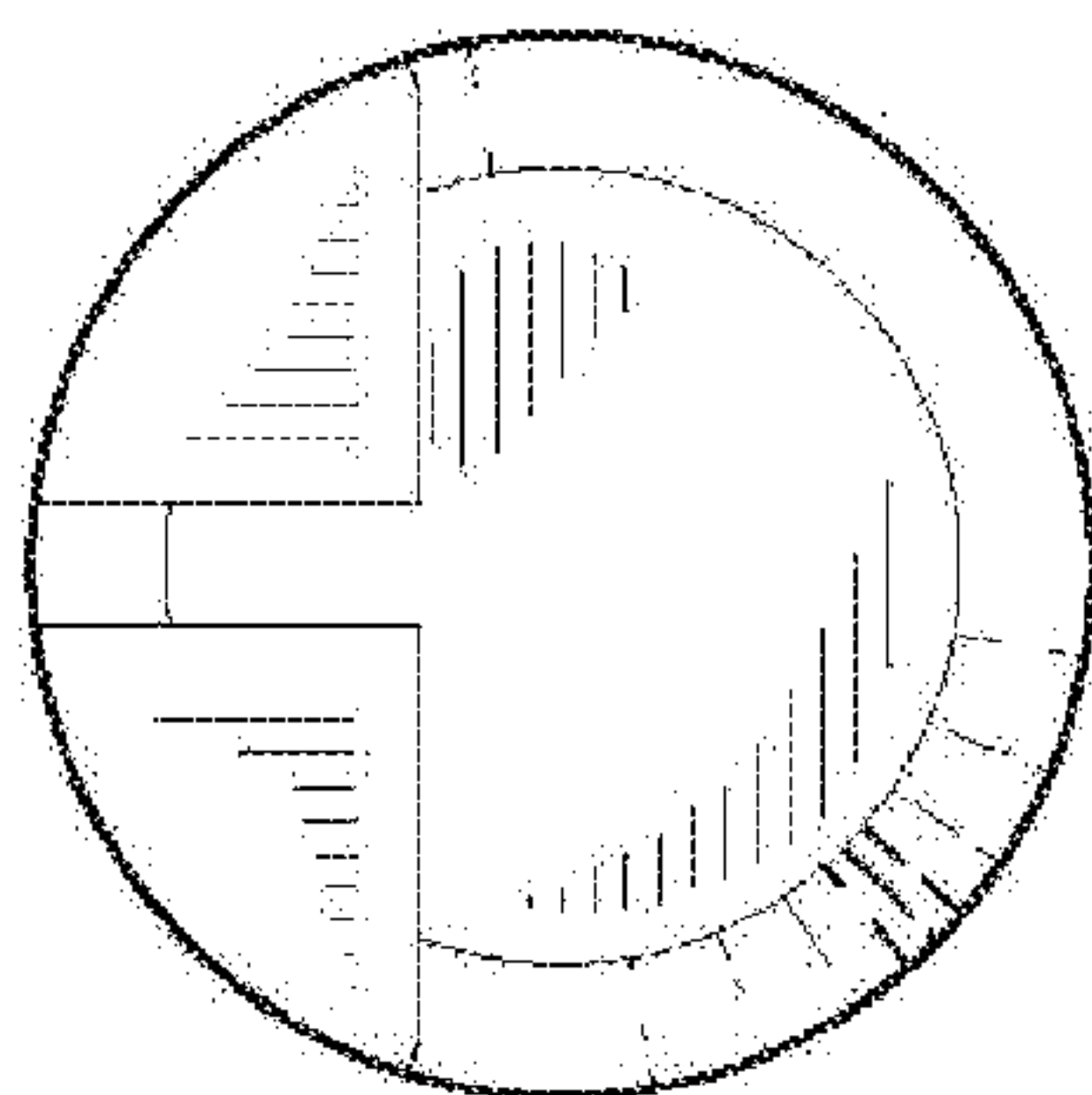

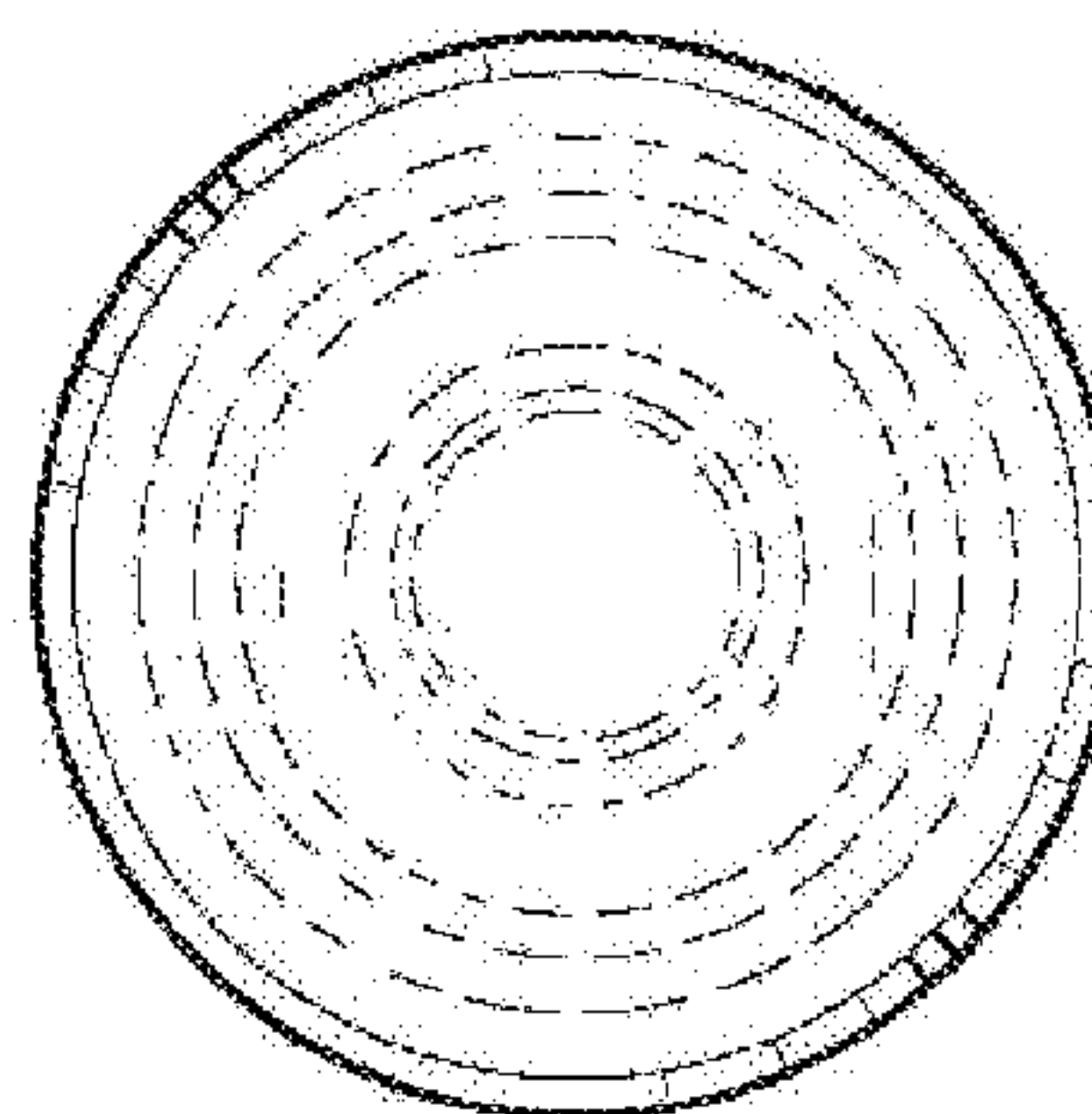
